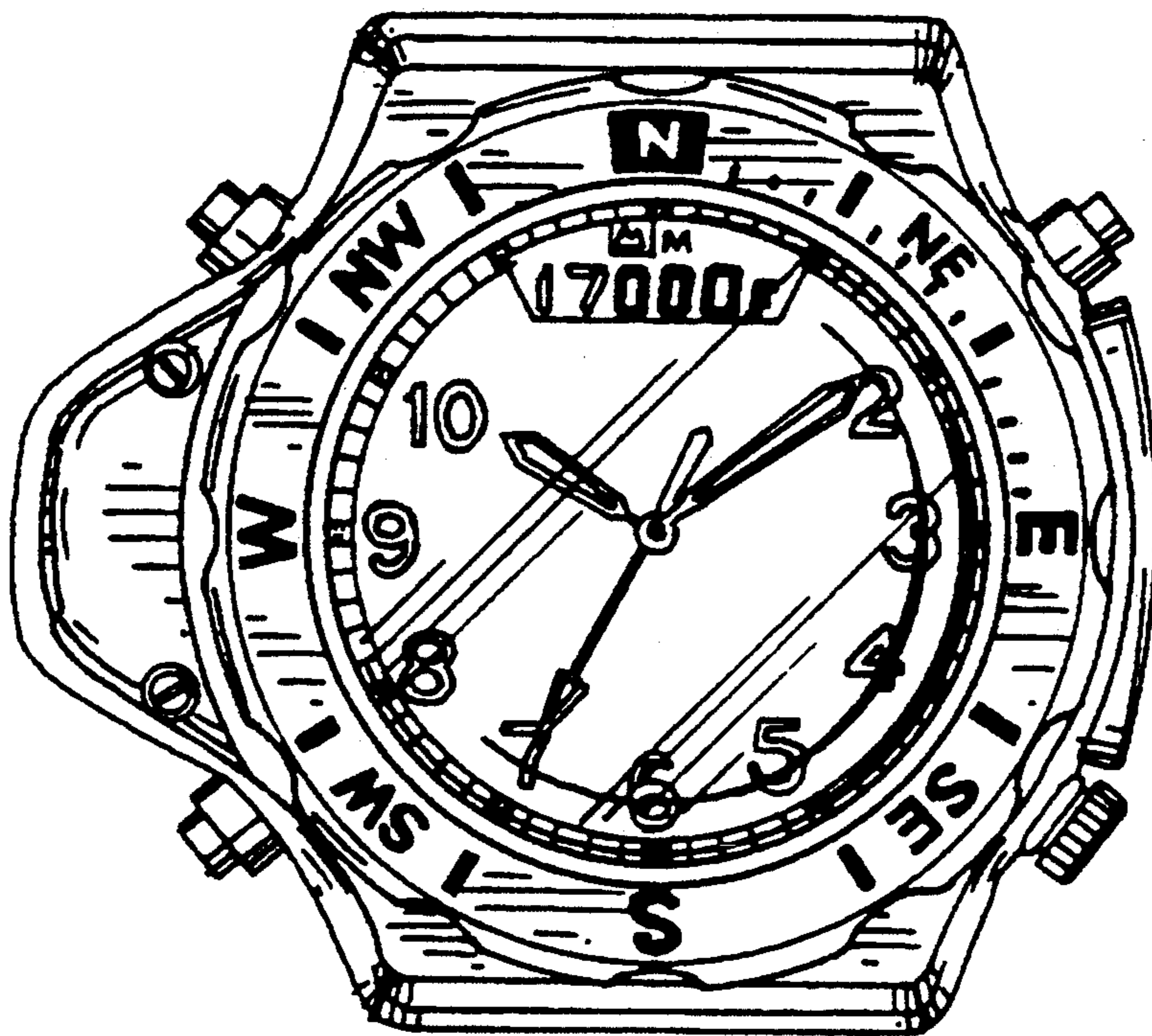

FIG. 7 is a left side perspective view thereof.



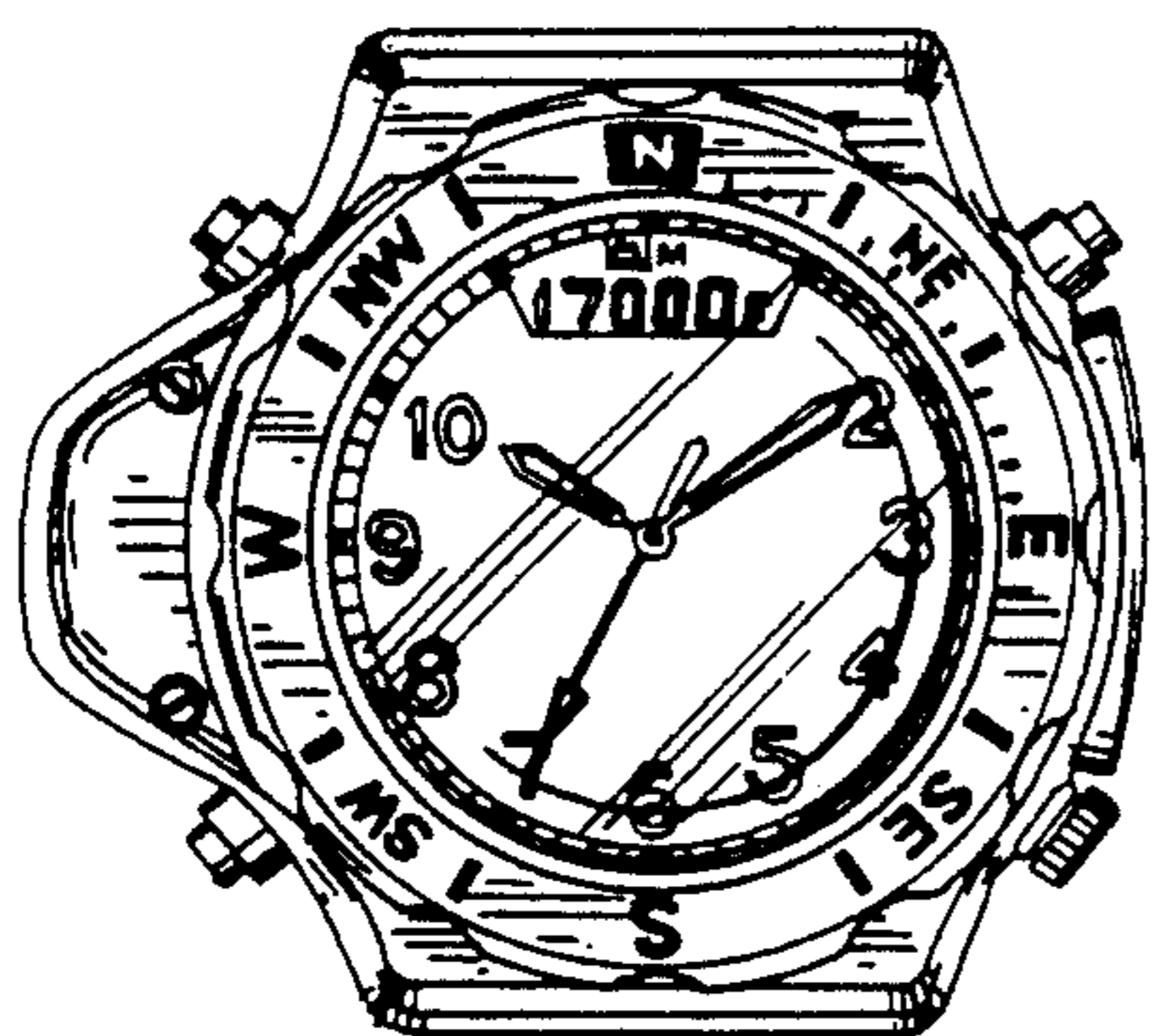

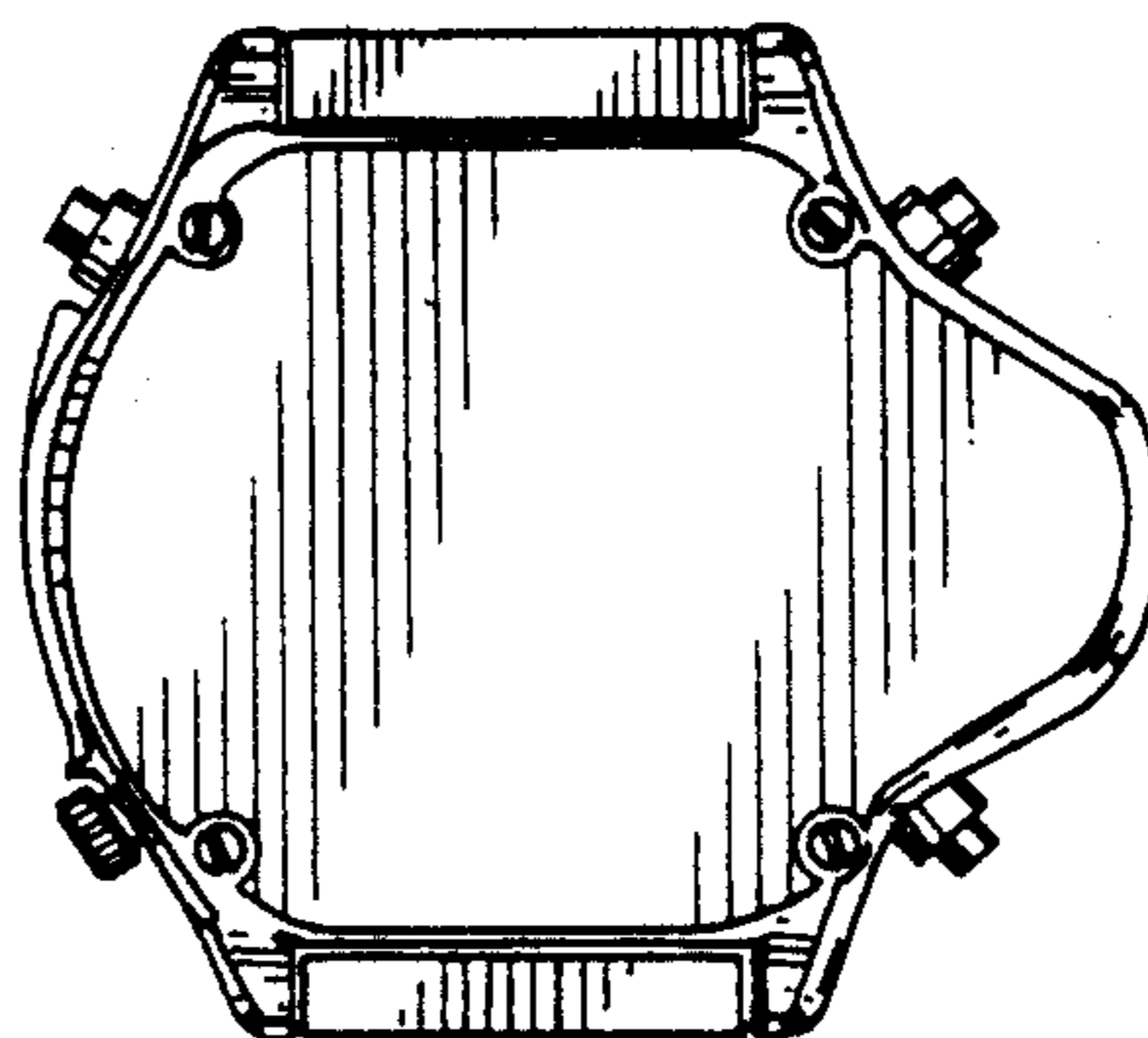

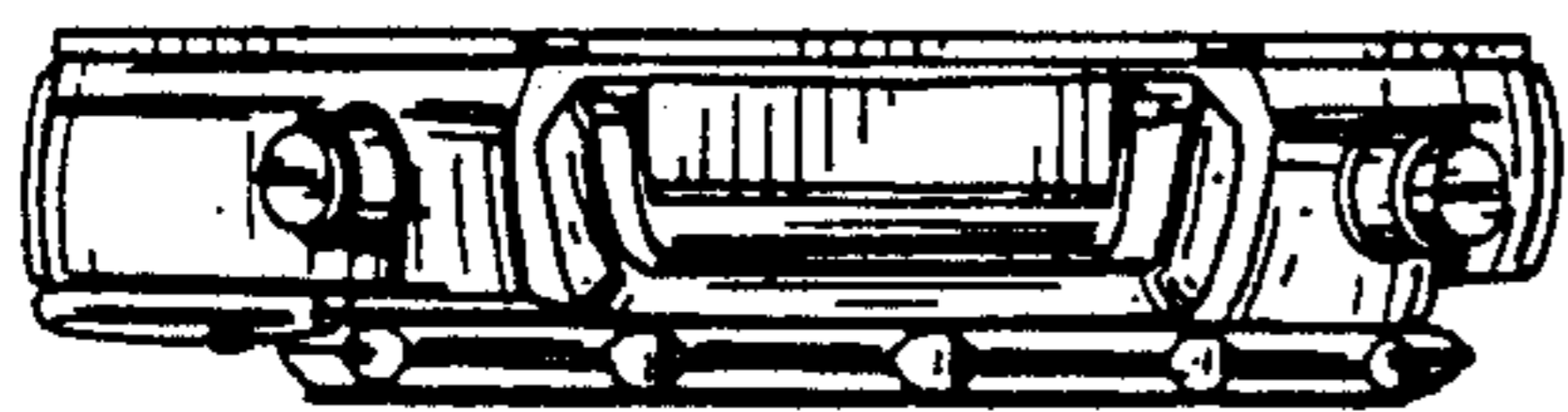

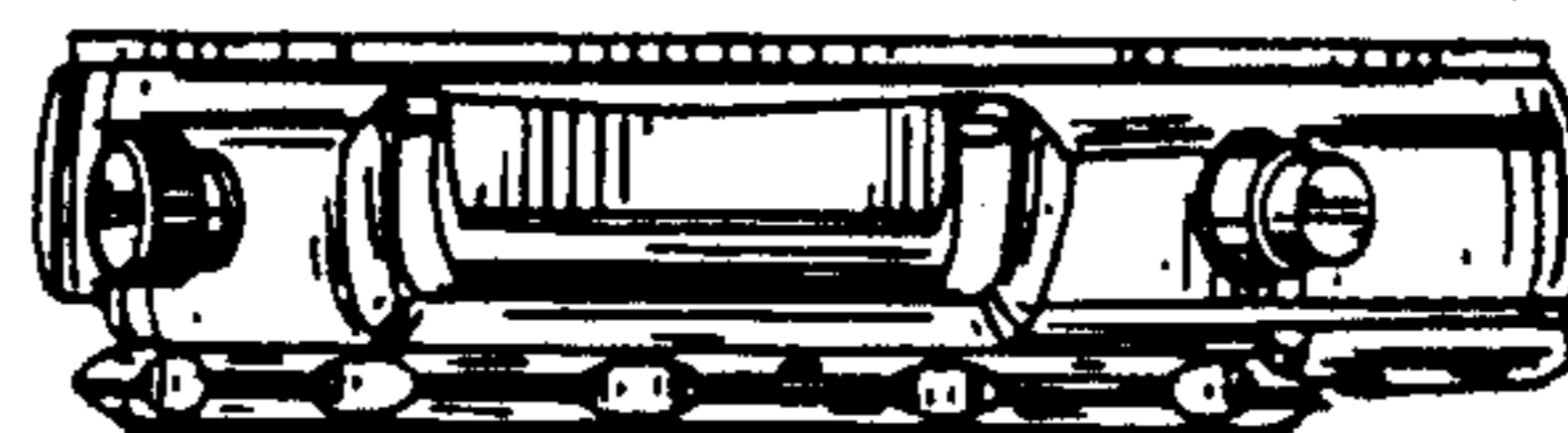

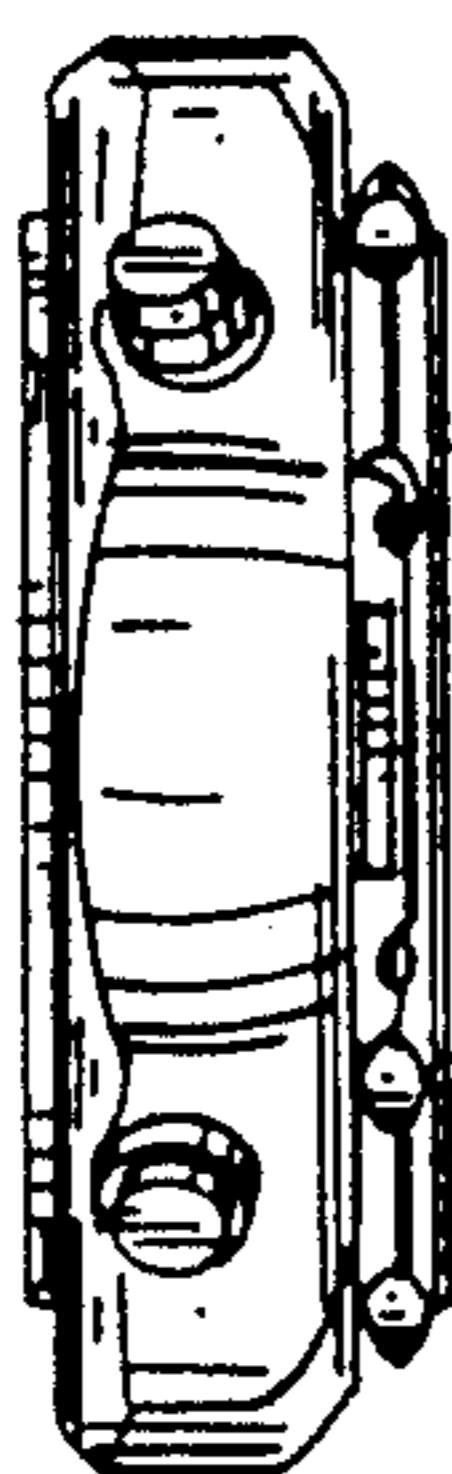

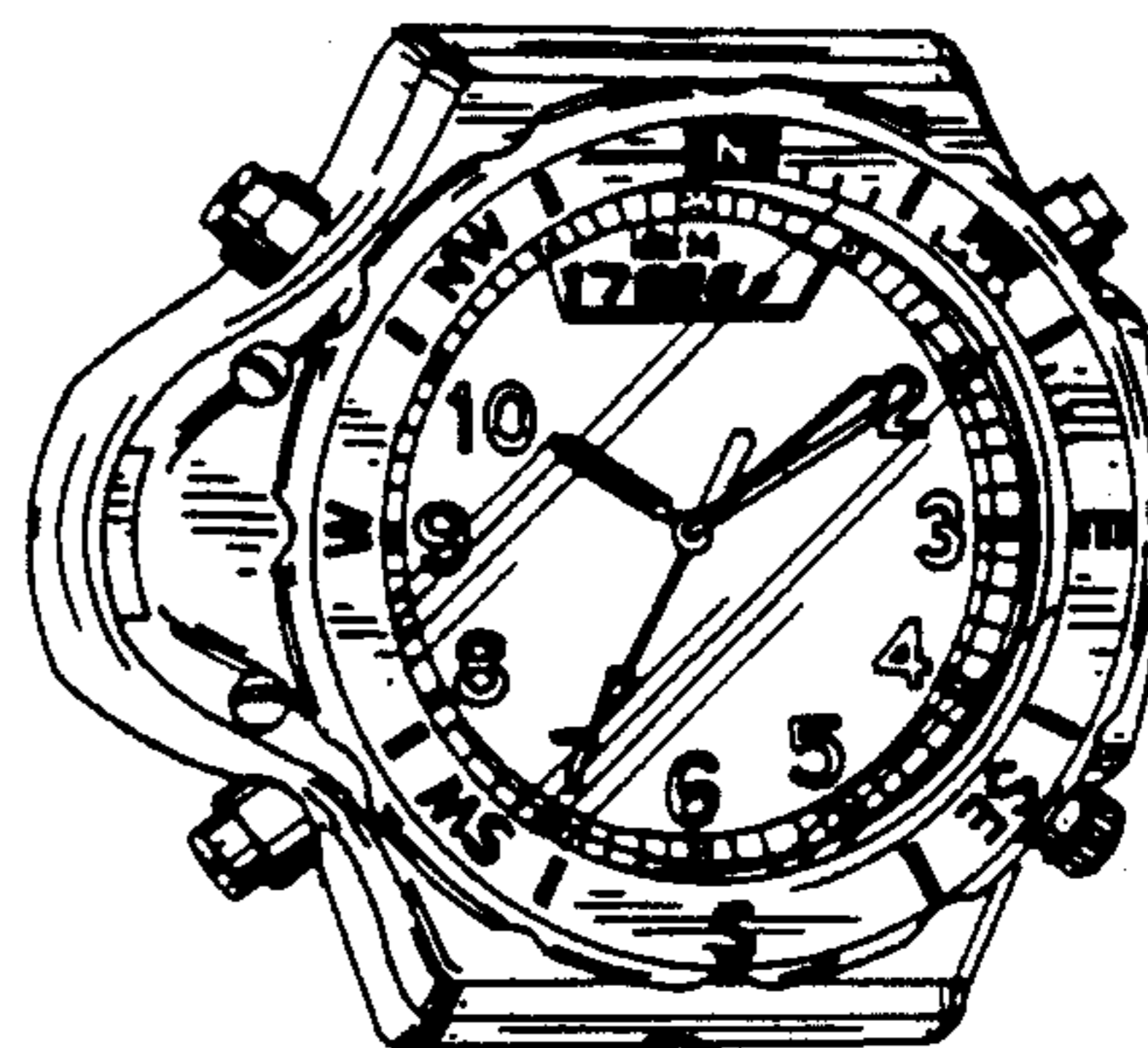
