DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of an earring showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment.

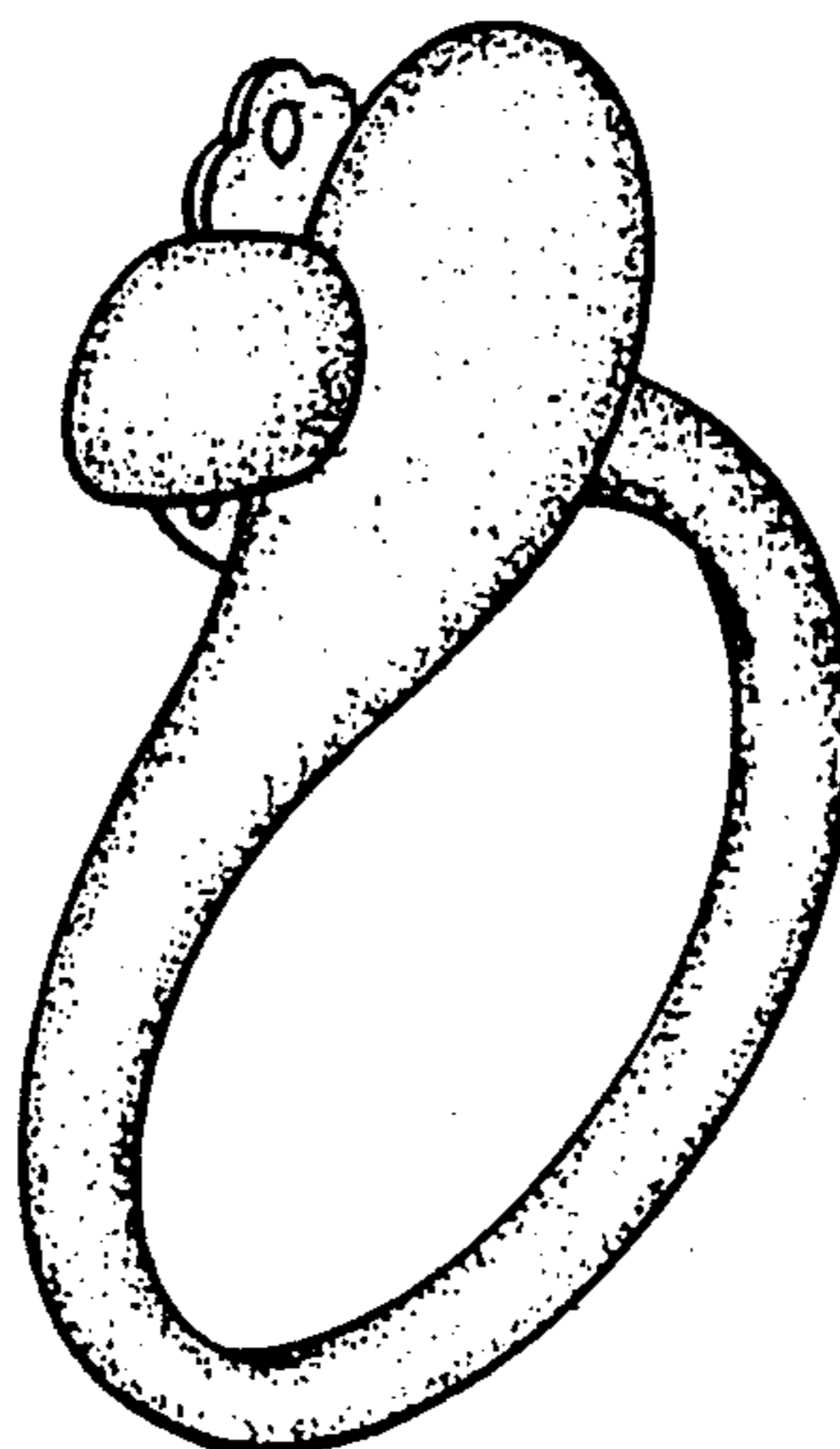

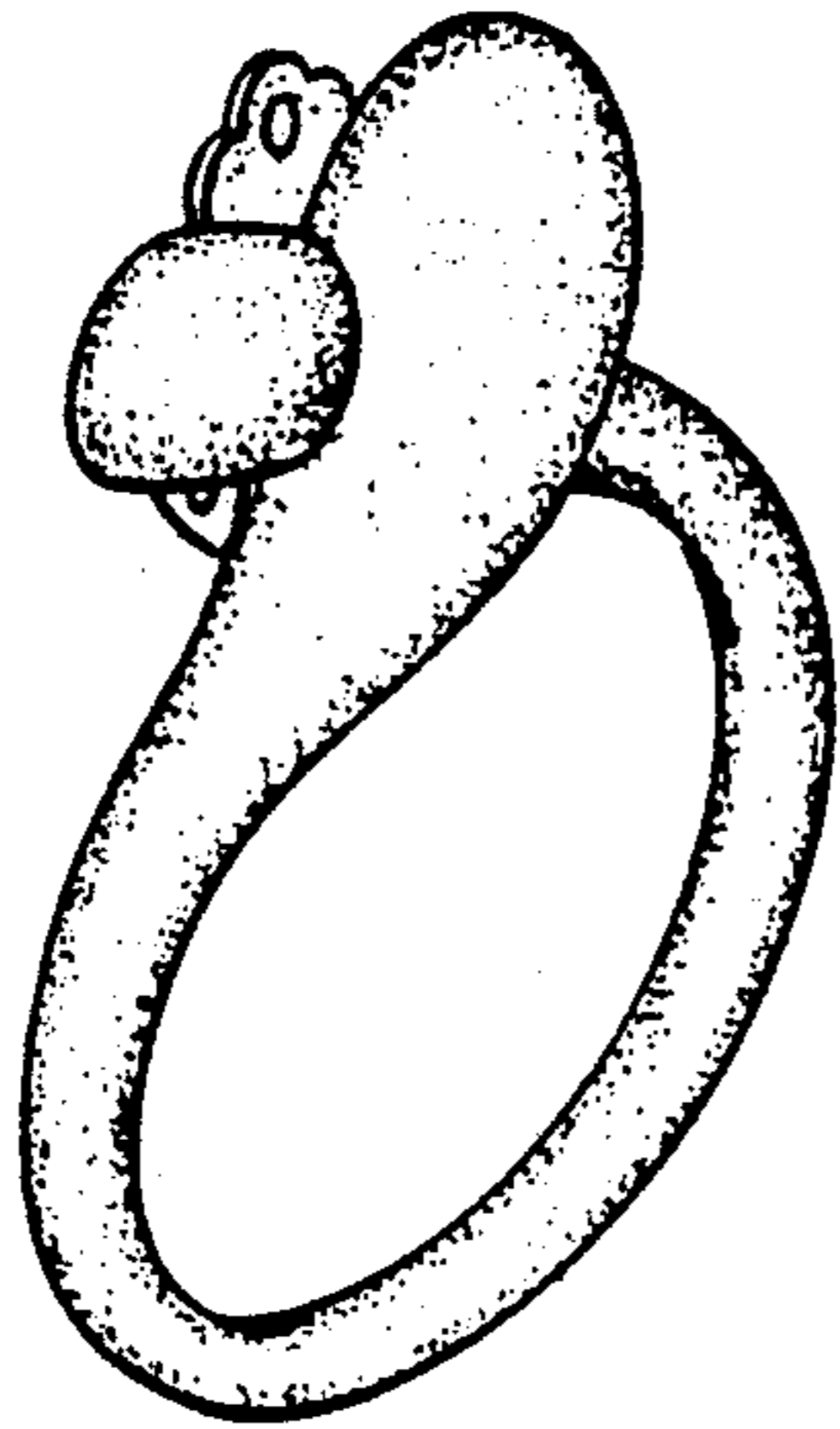

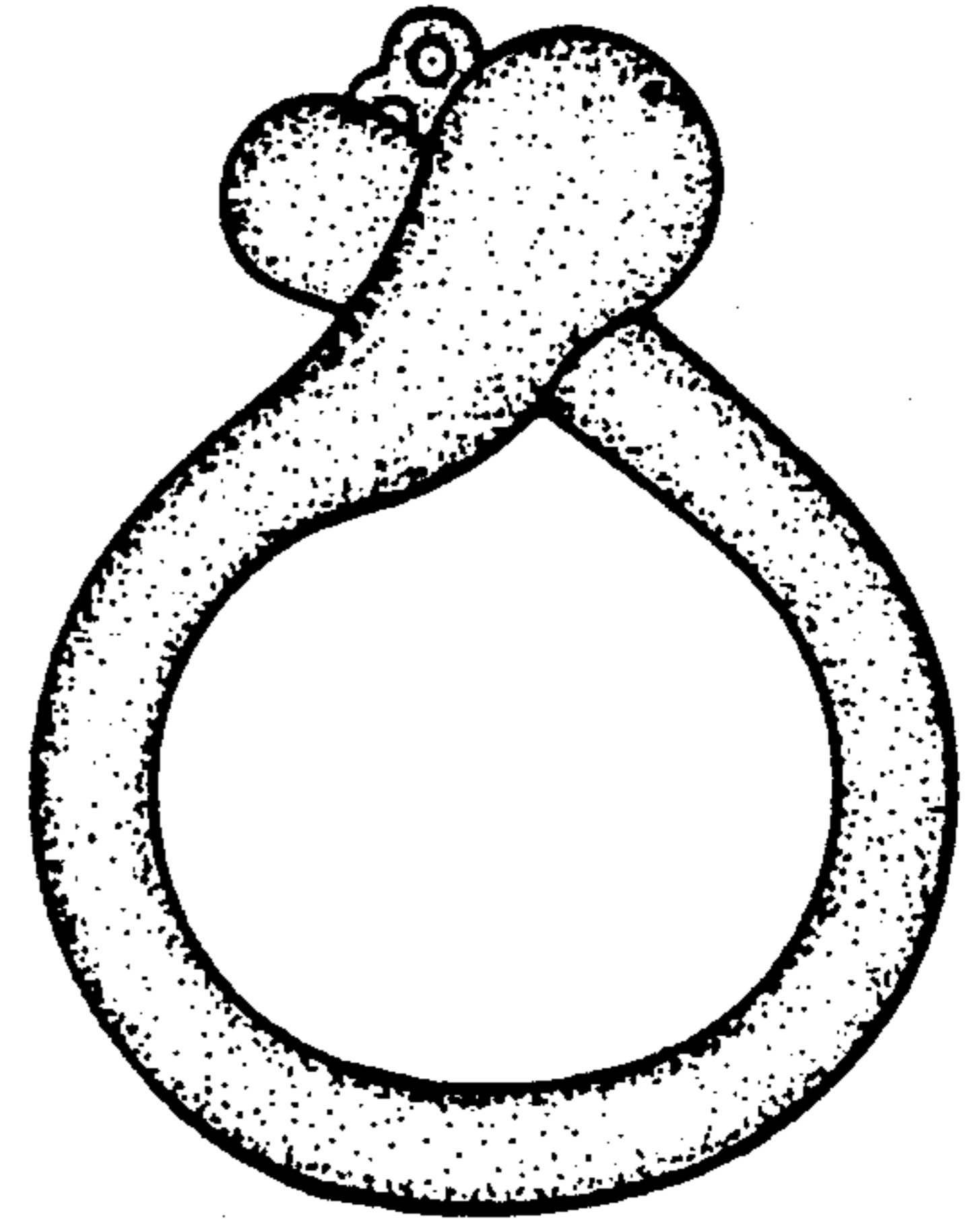

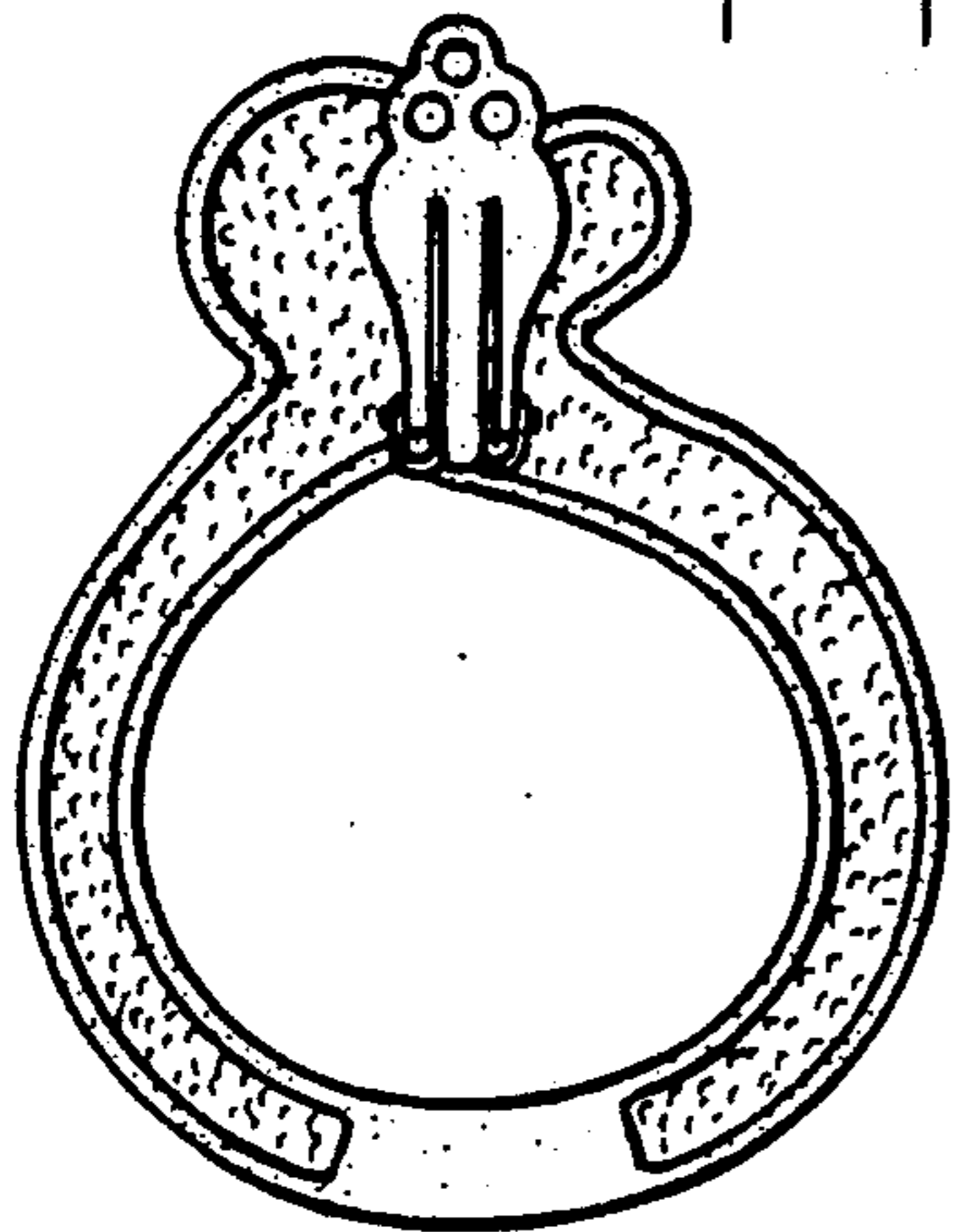

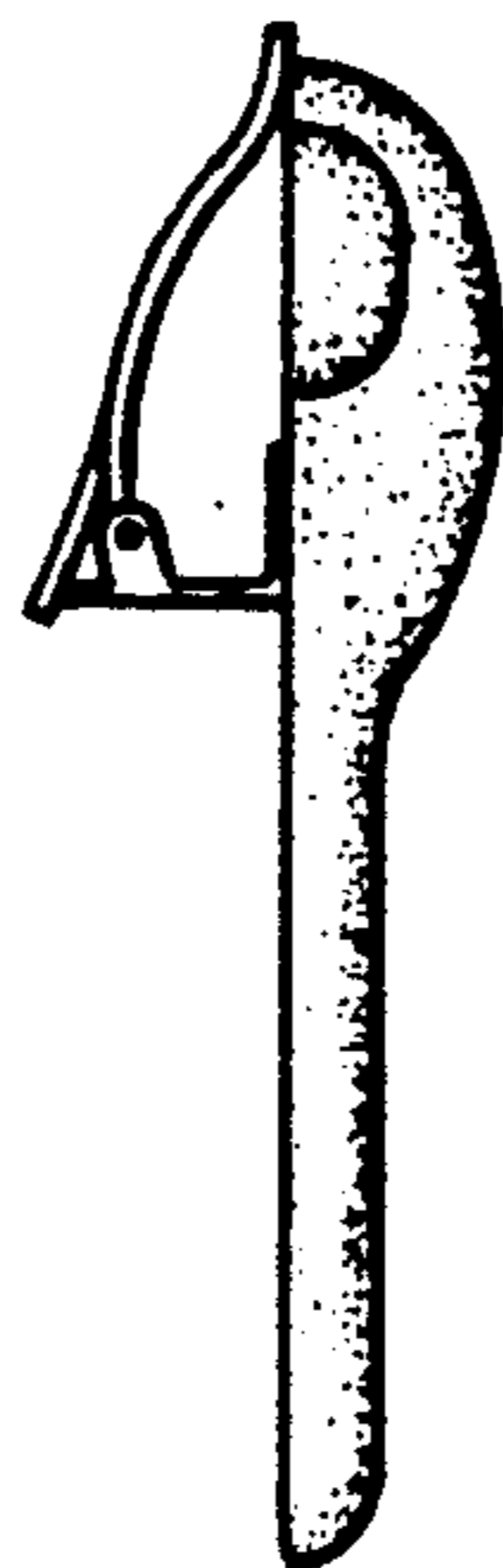
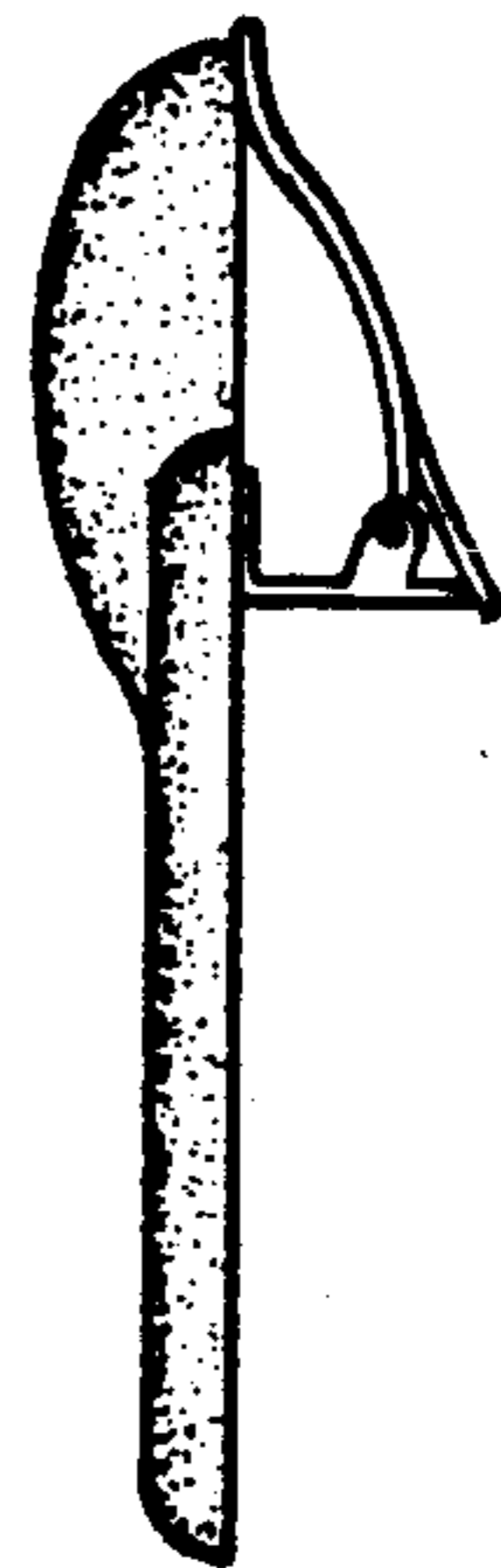

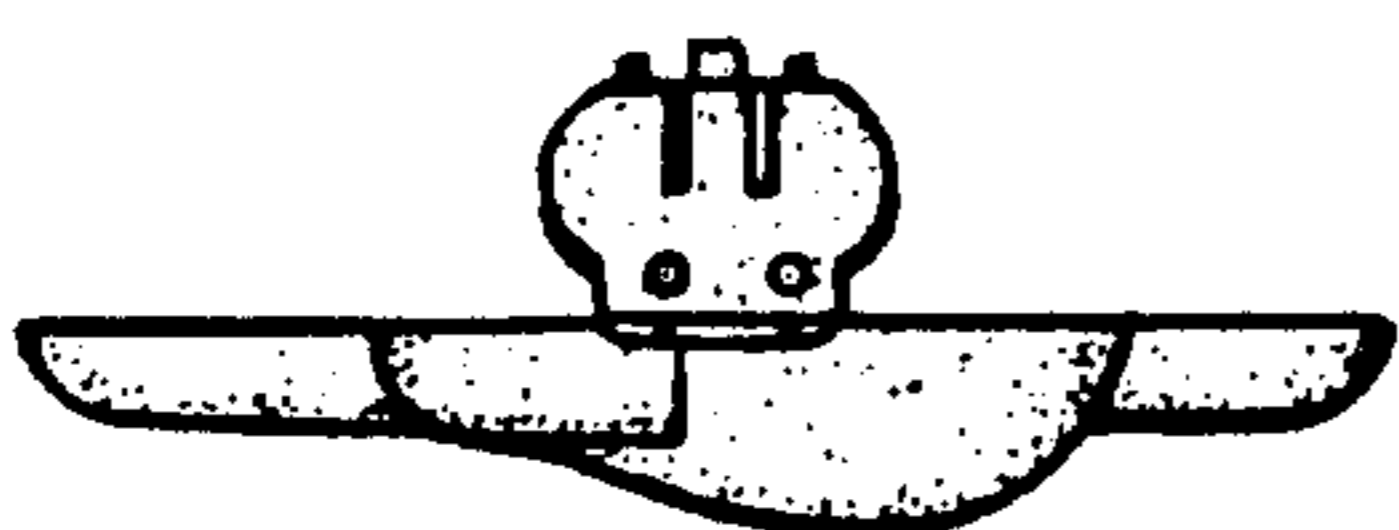

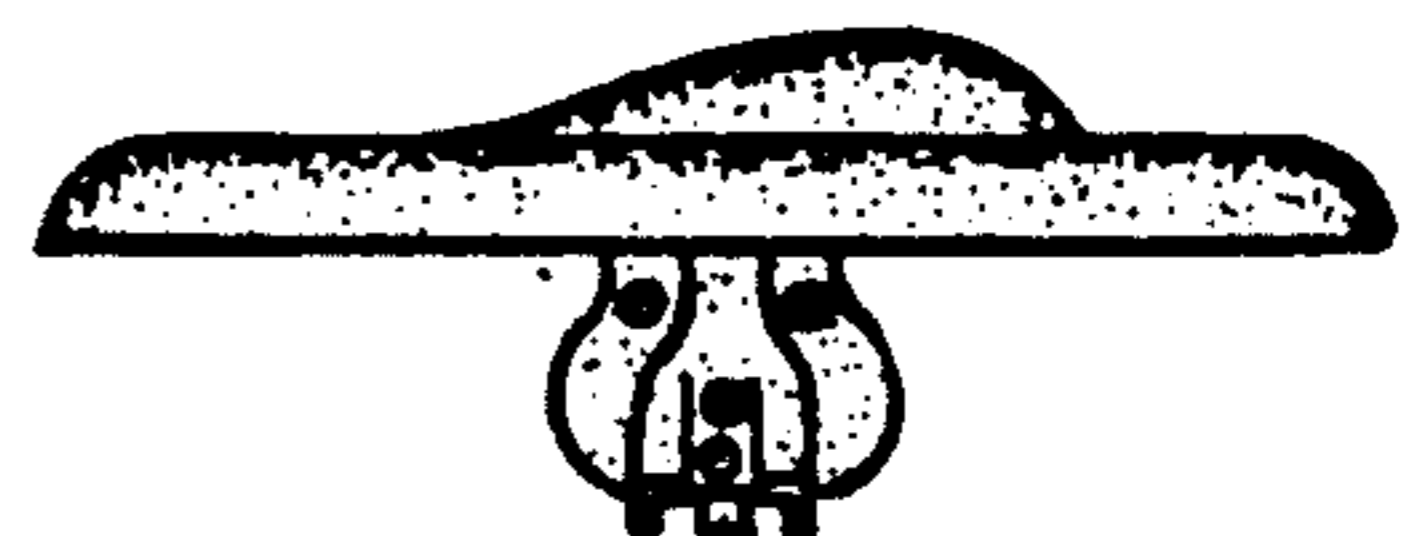

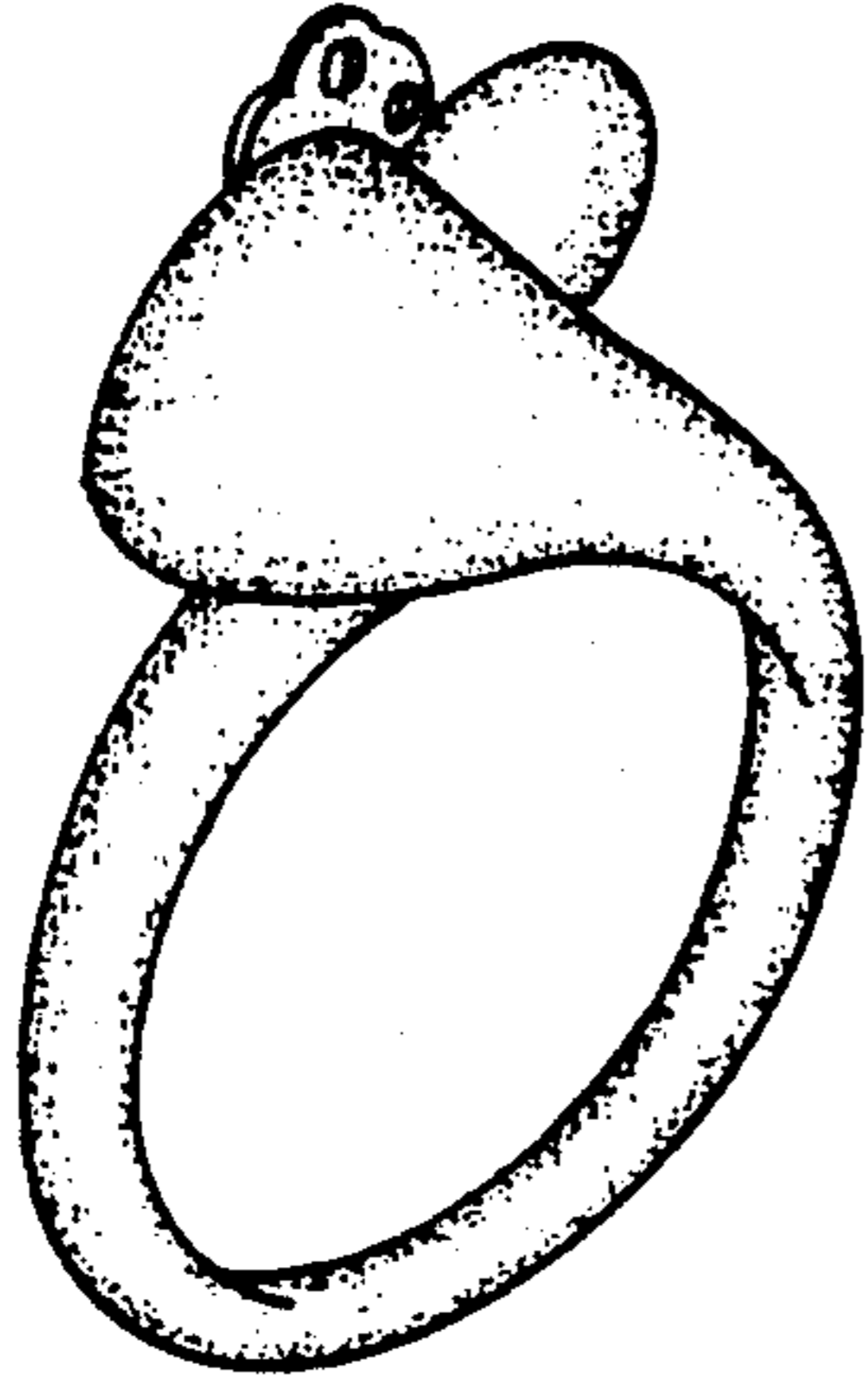

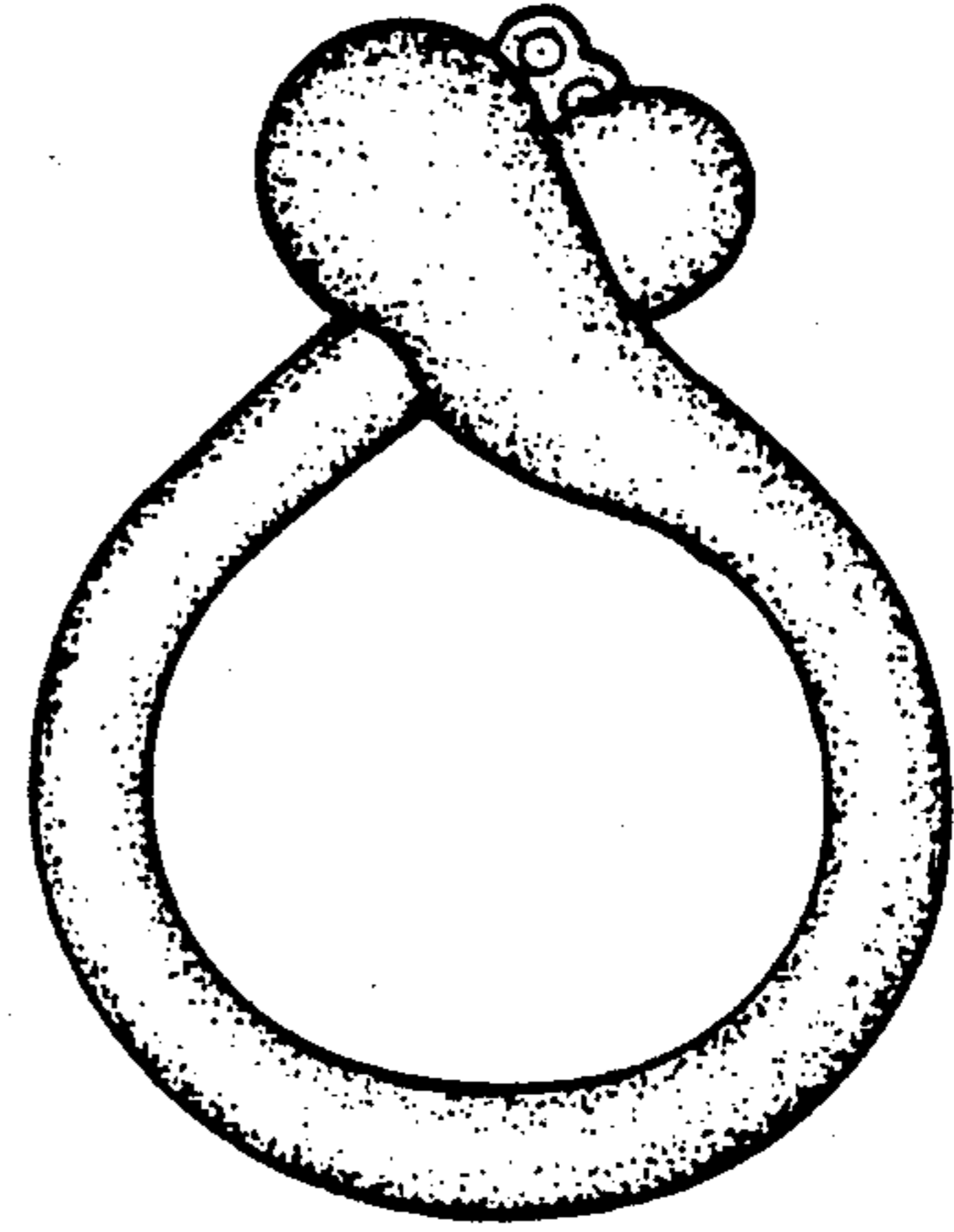

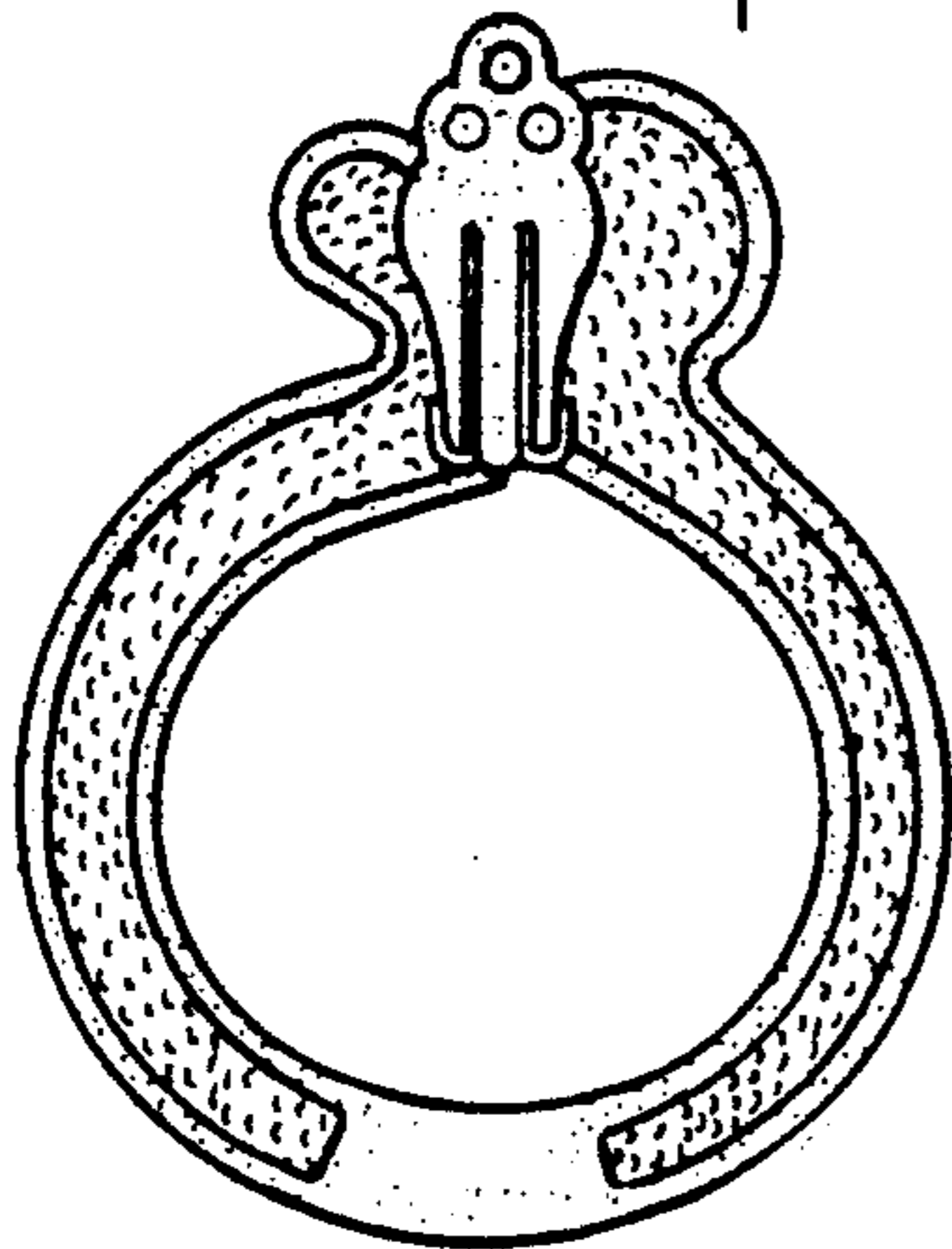

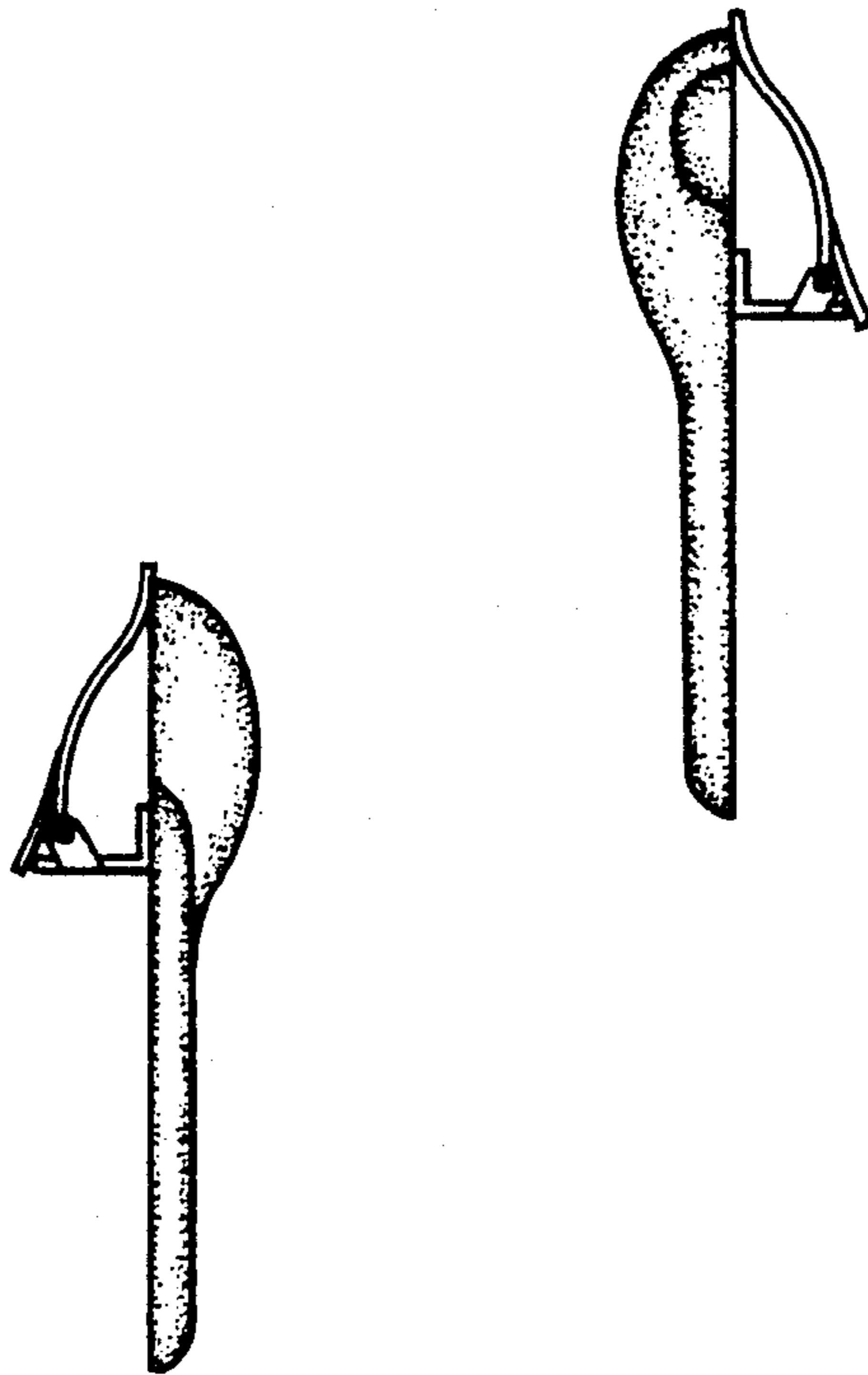

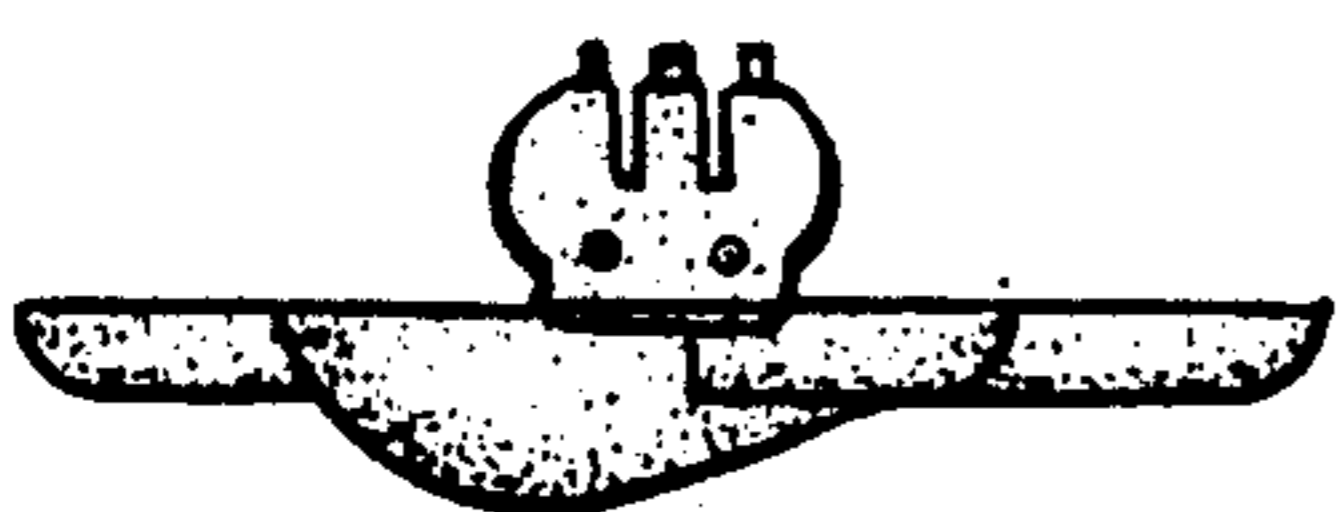

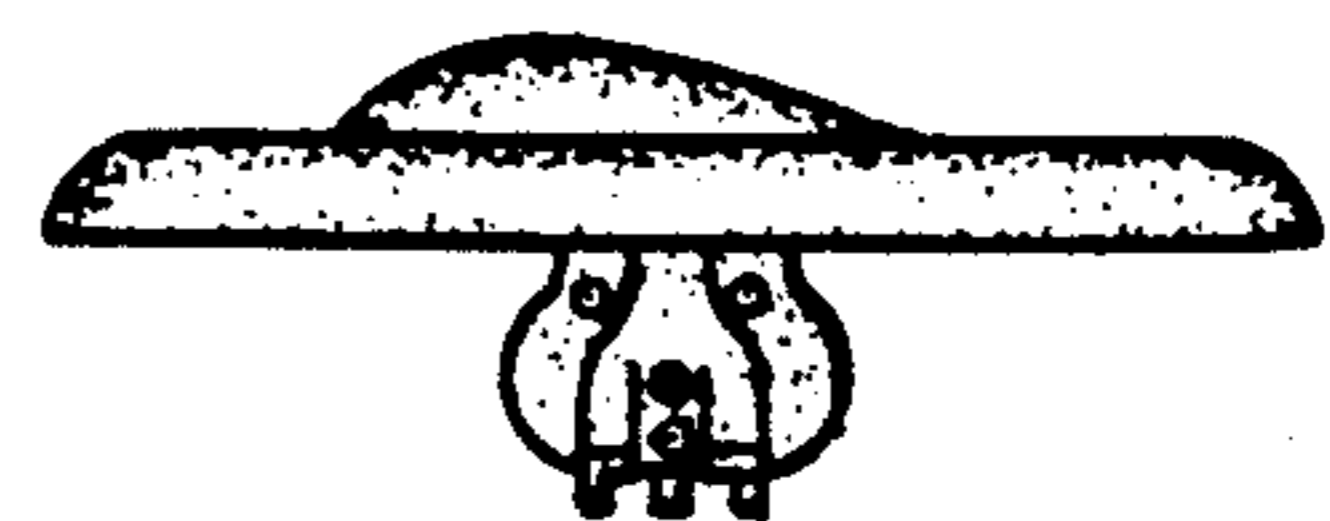
