The ornamental design for a vehicle security enclosure, as shown and described.

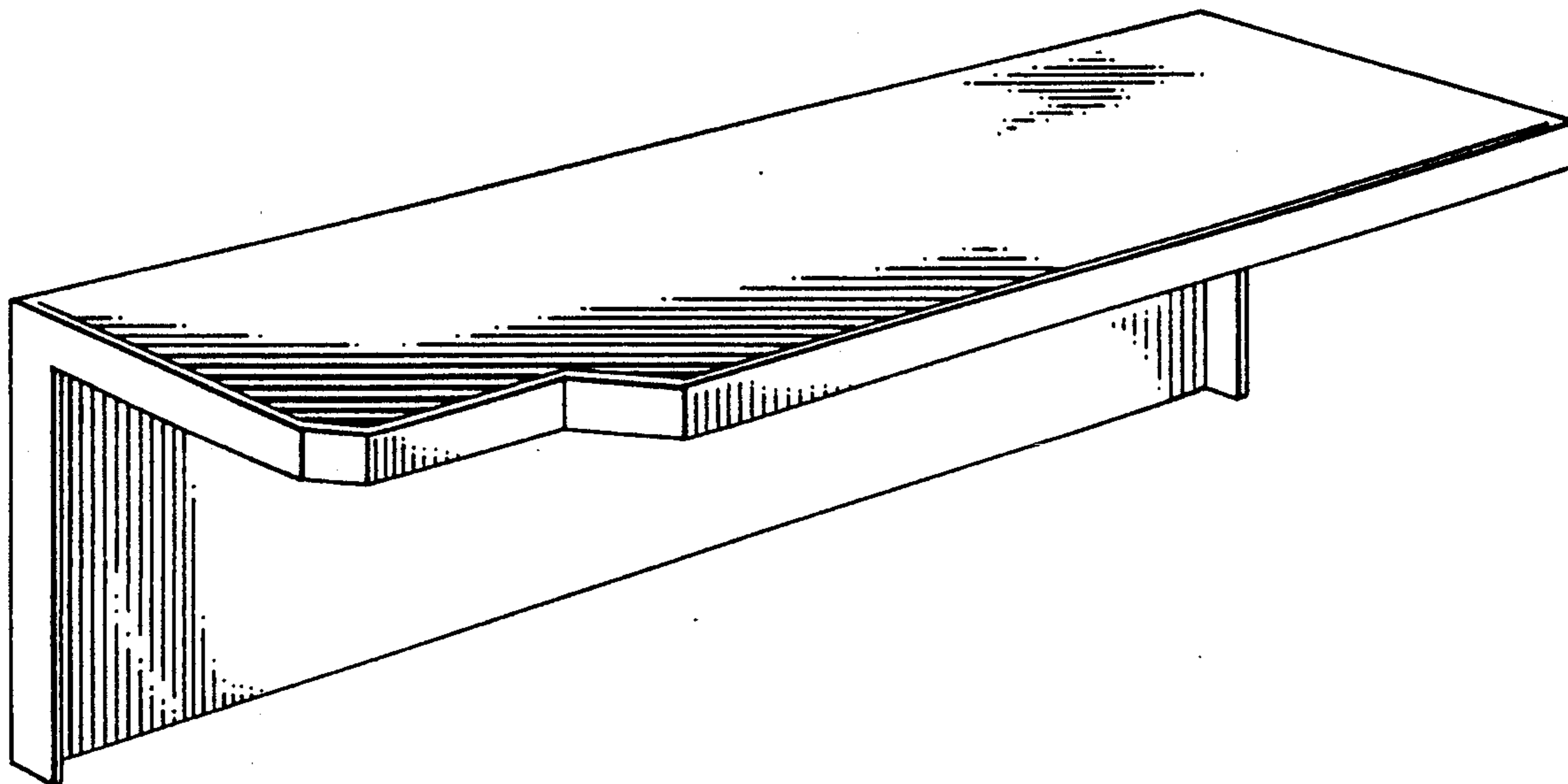
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is perspective view of a vehicle security enclosure which illustrates my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a front perspective view thereof on a reduced scale as installed on the deck of a vehicle, the broken lines being shown for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

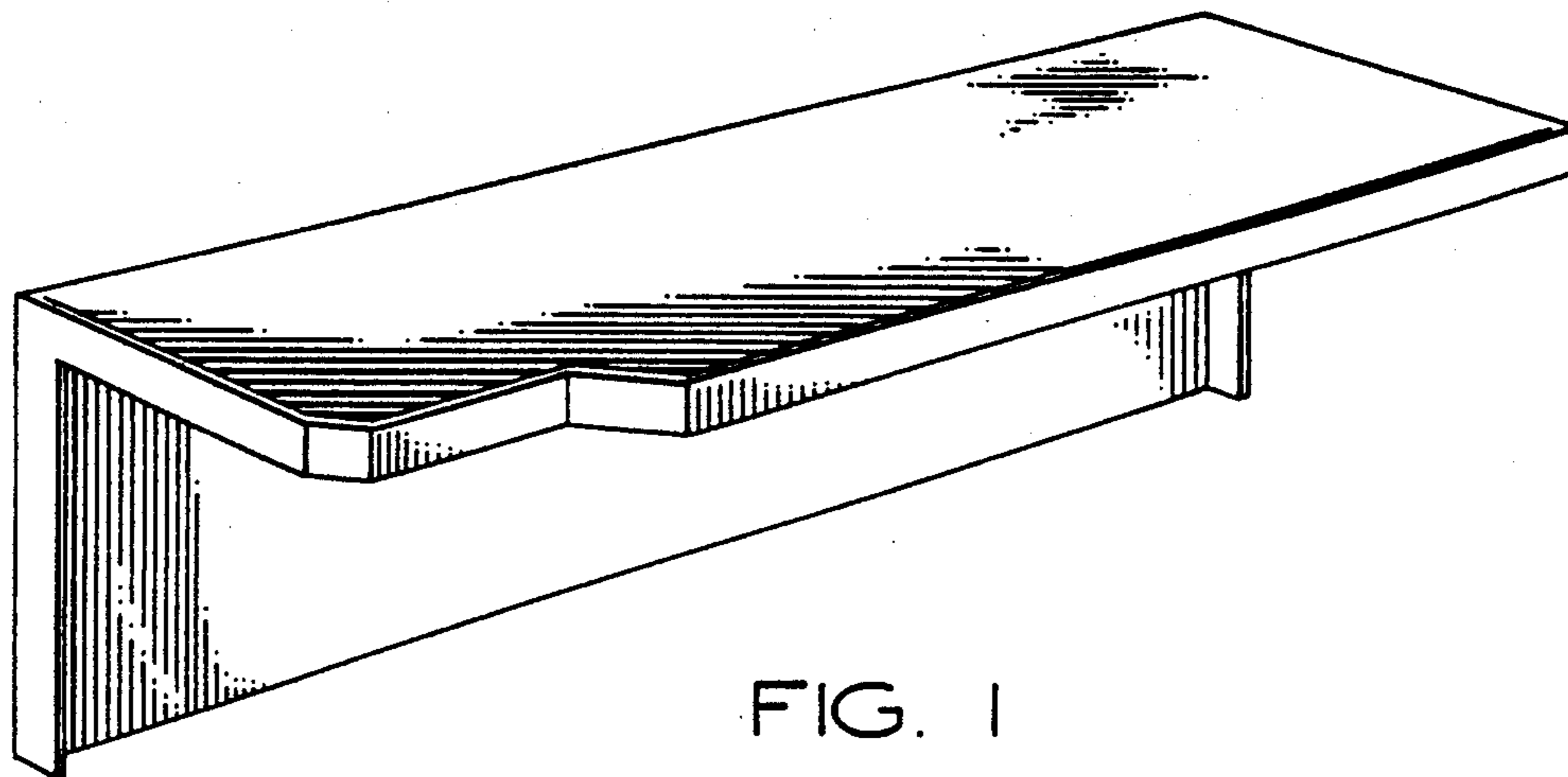

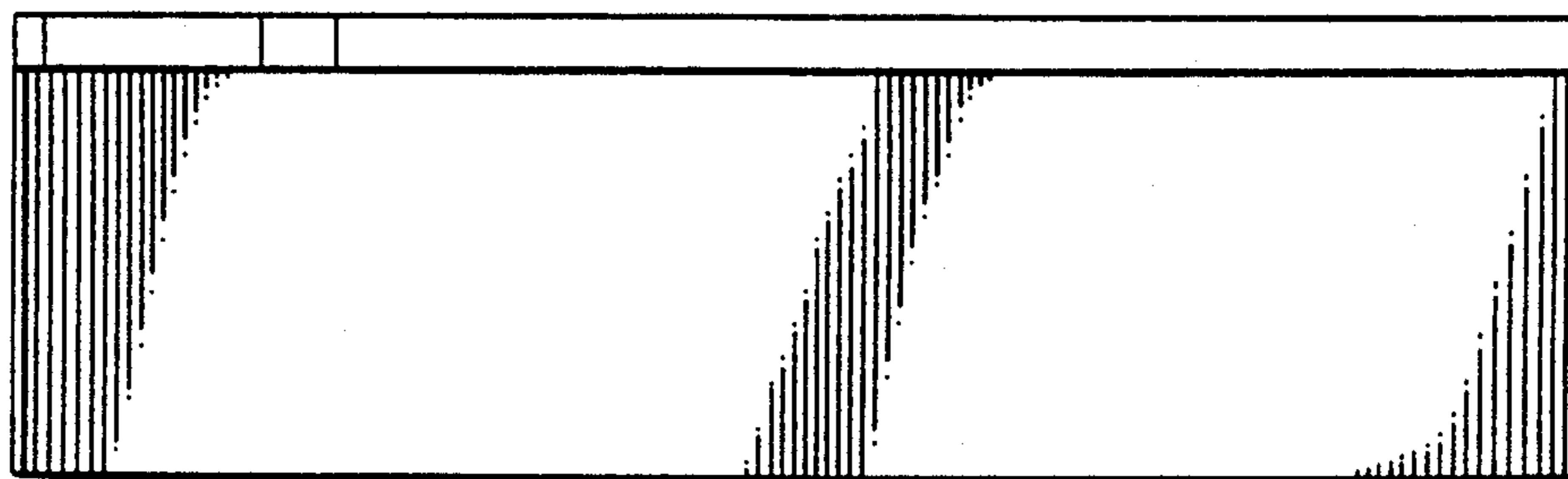

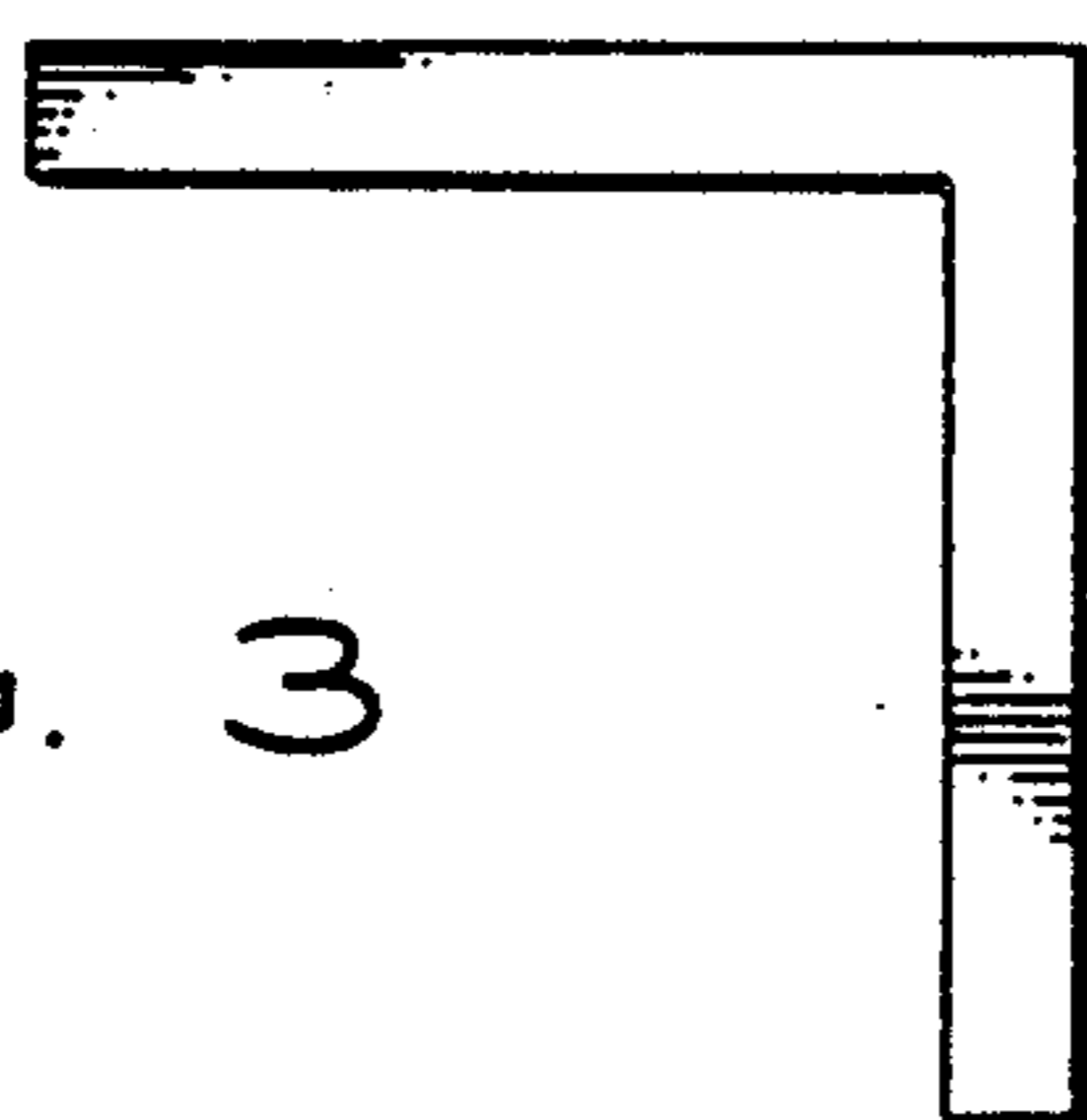

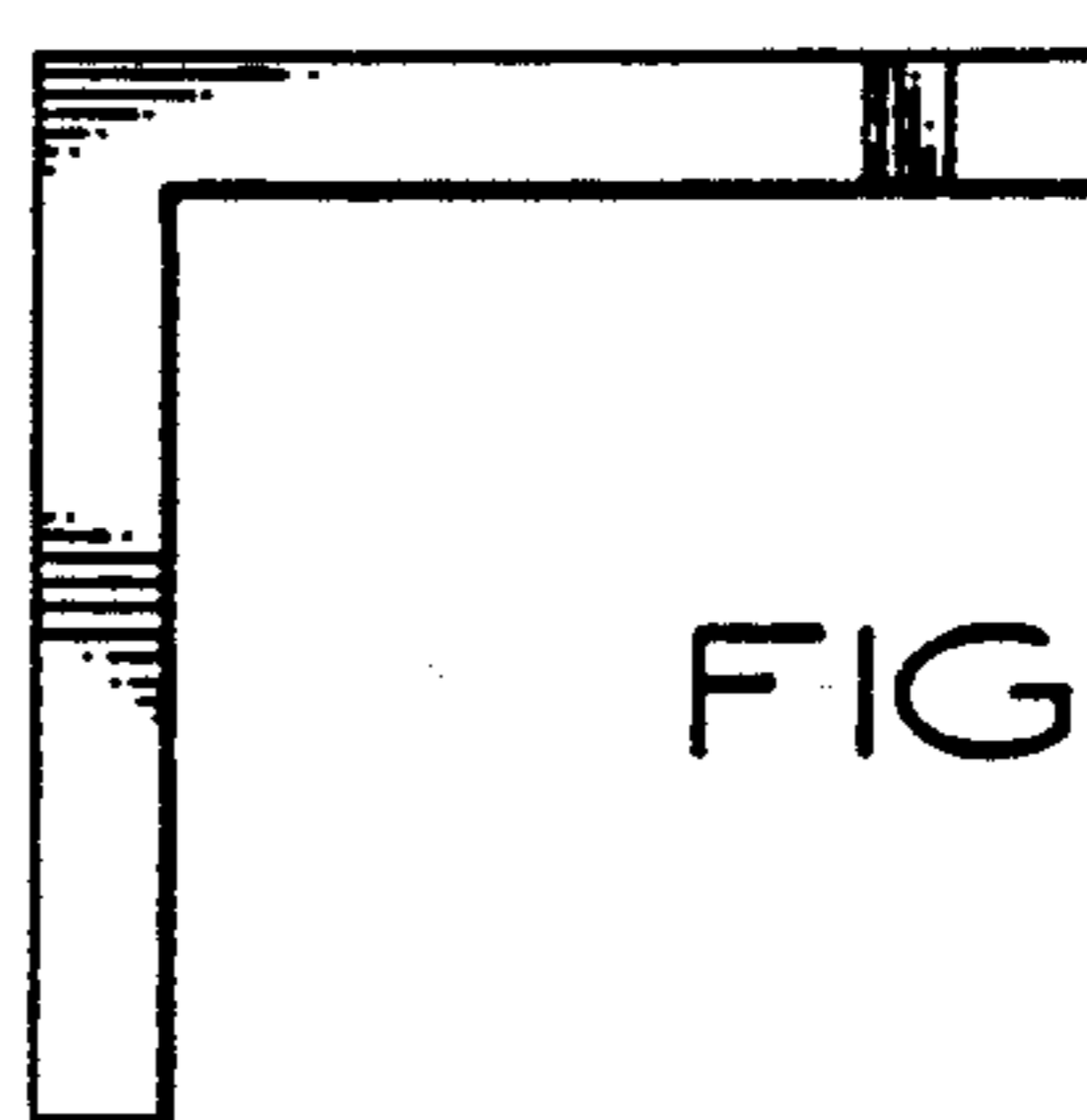

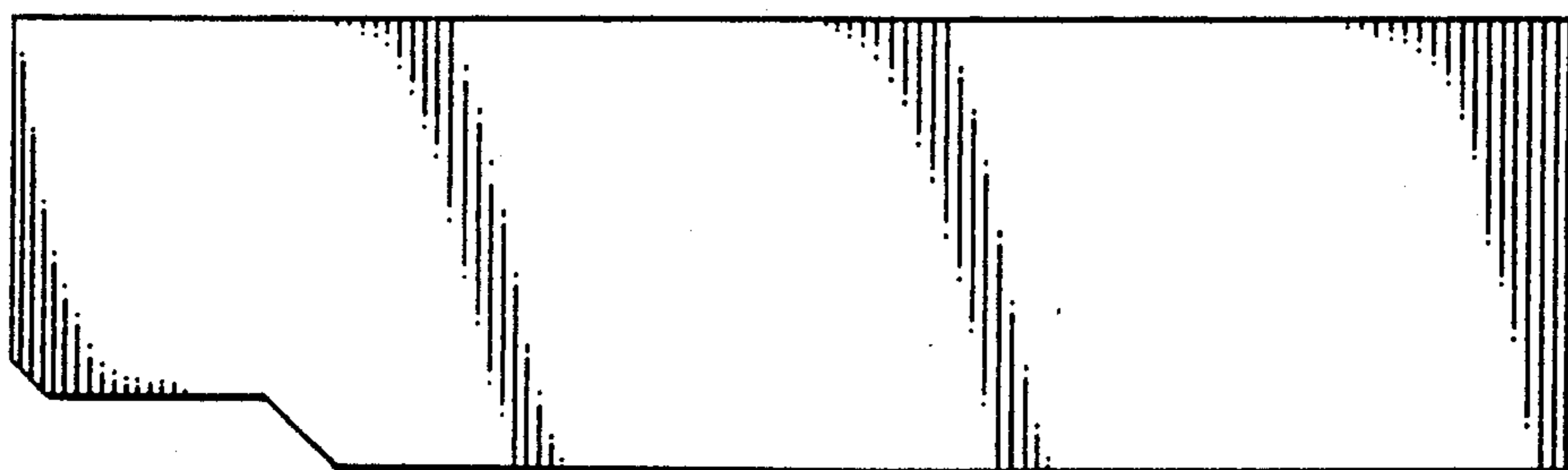

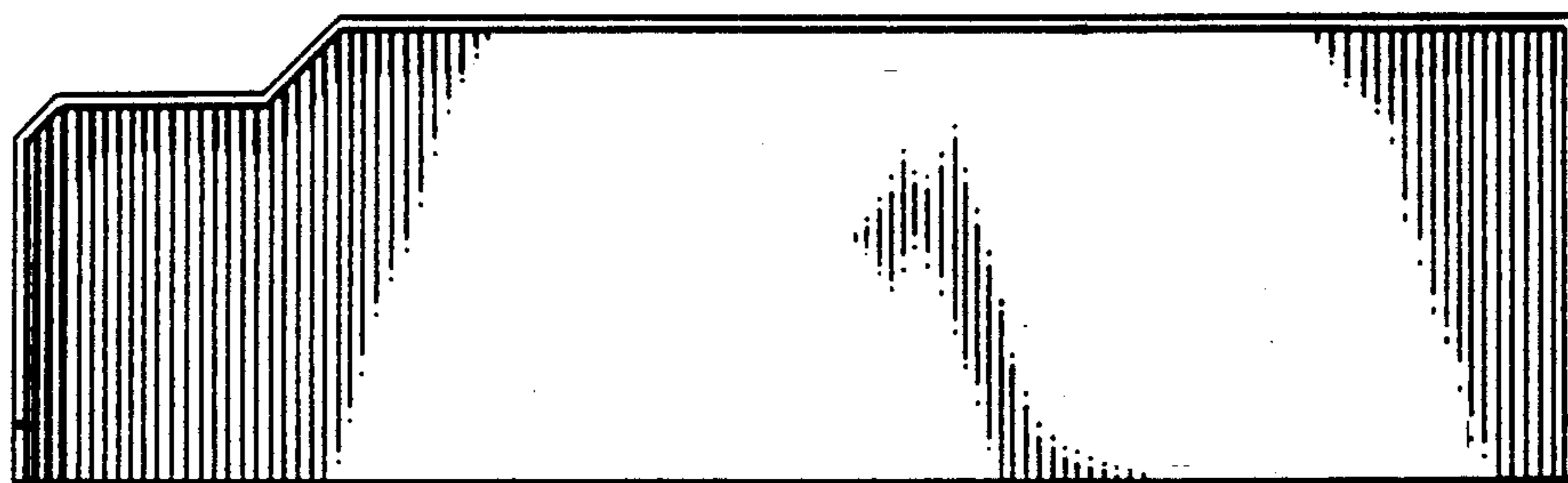

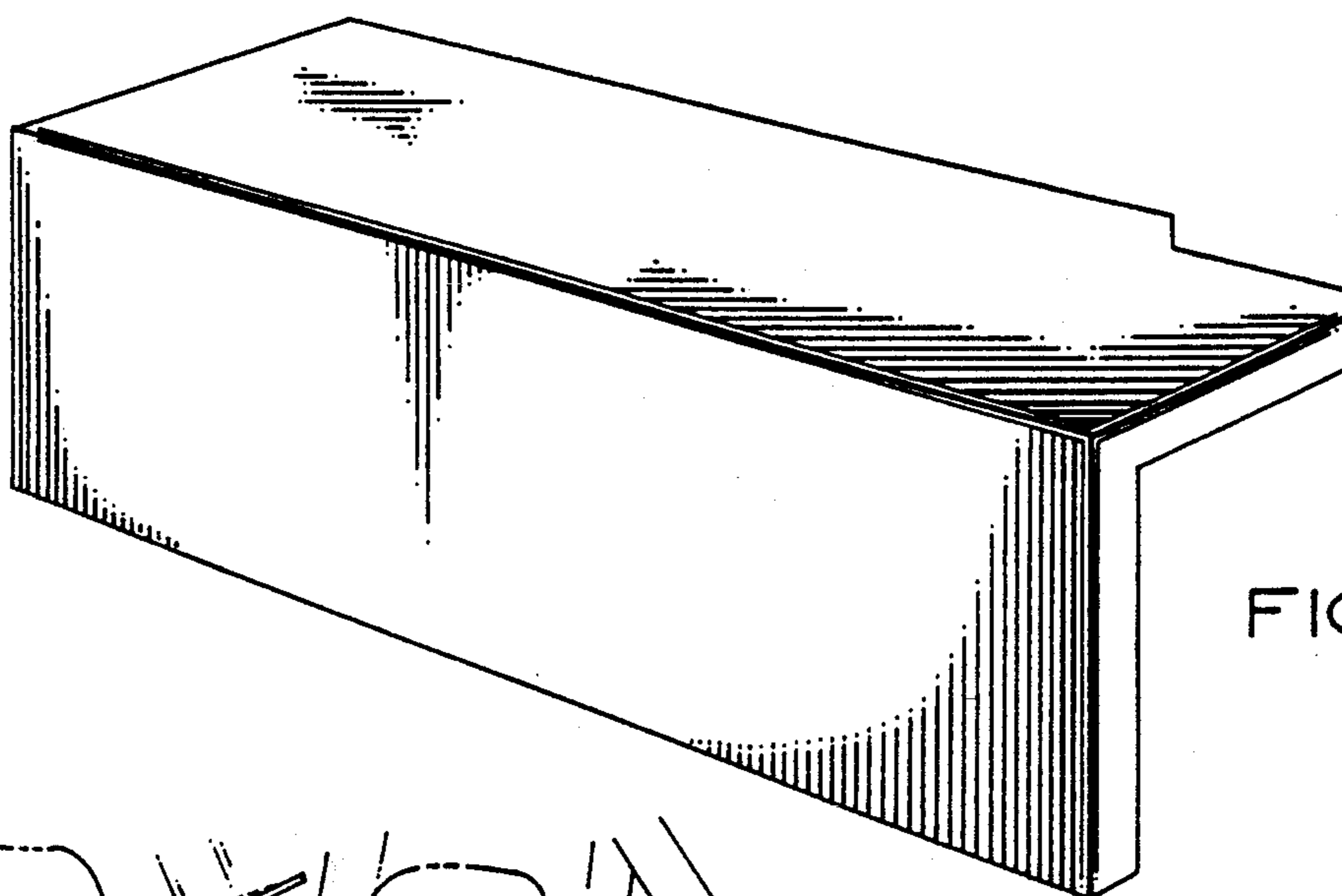

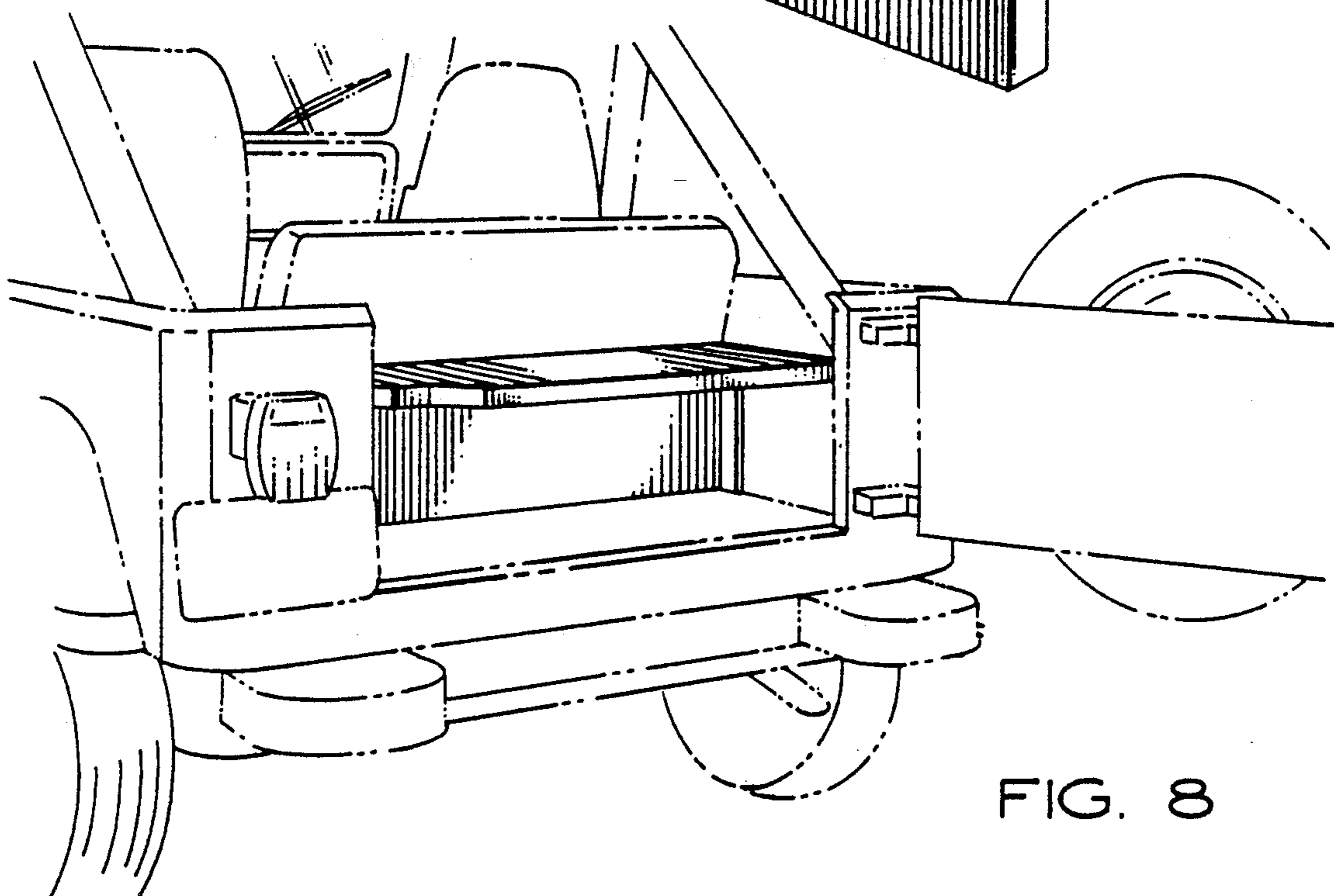
