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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a digital audio disc player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a digital audio disc player showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof, shown with the disc tray drawn out.

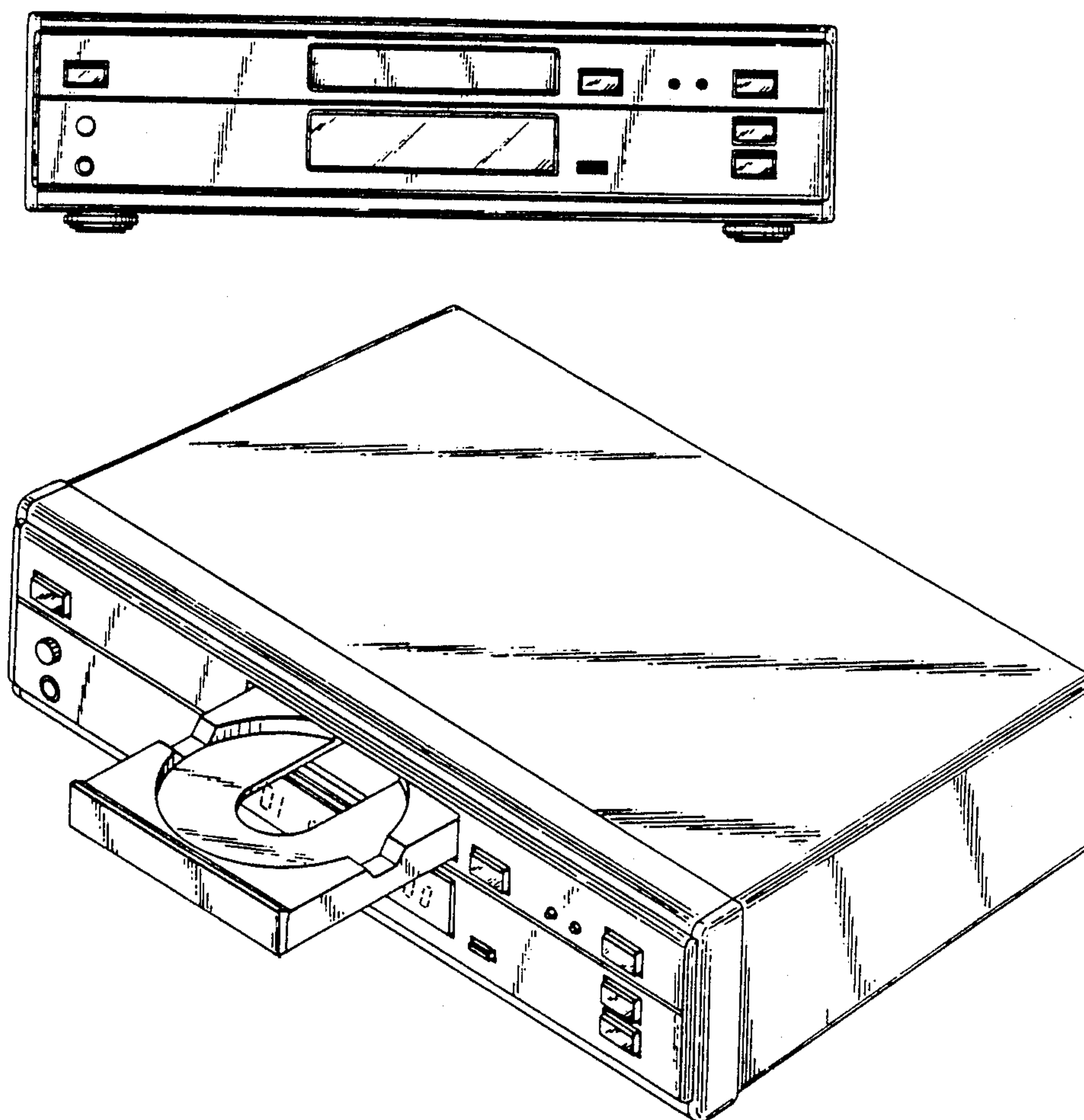

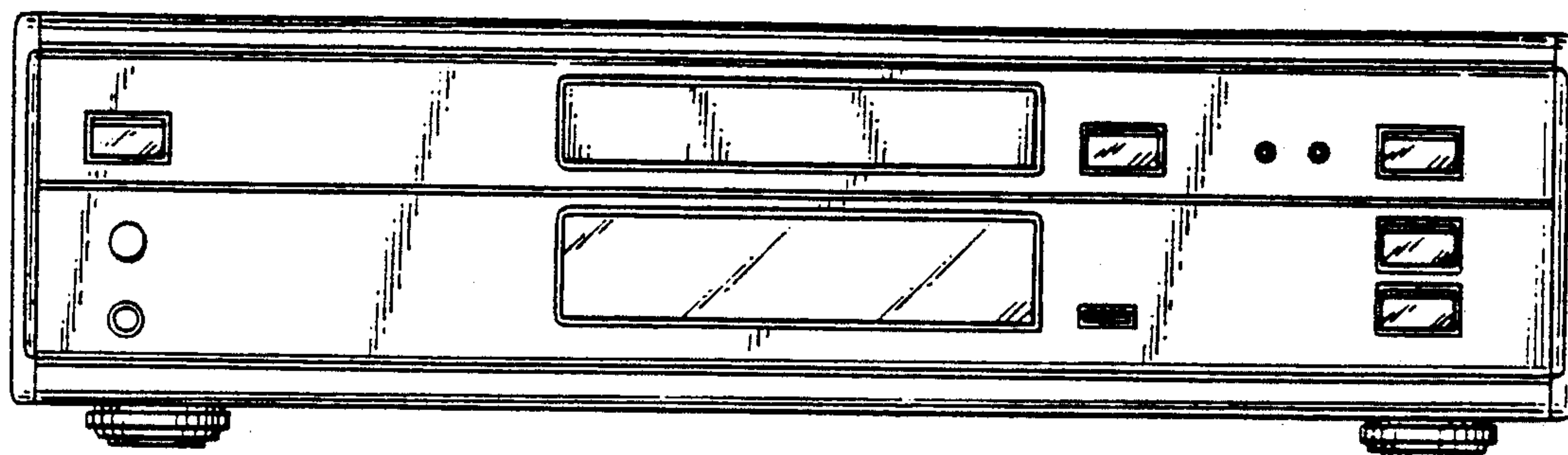

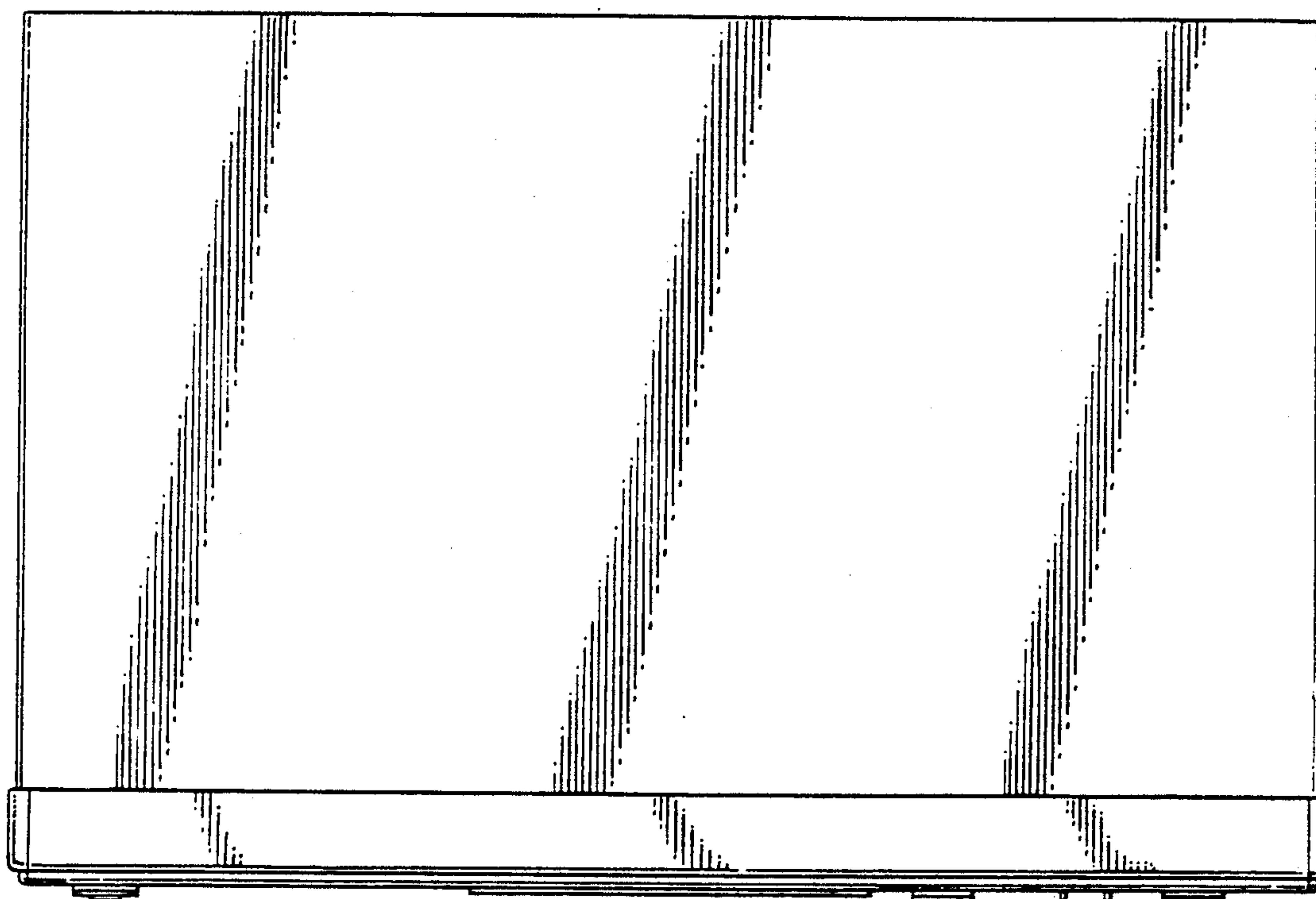

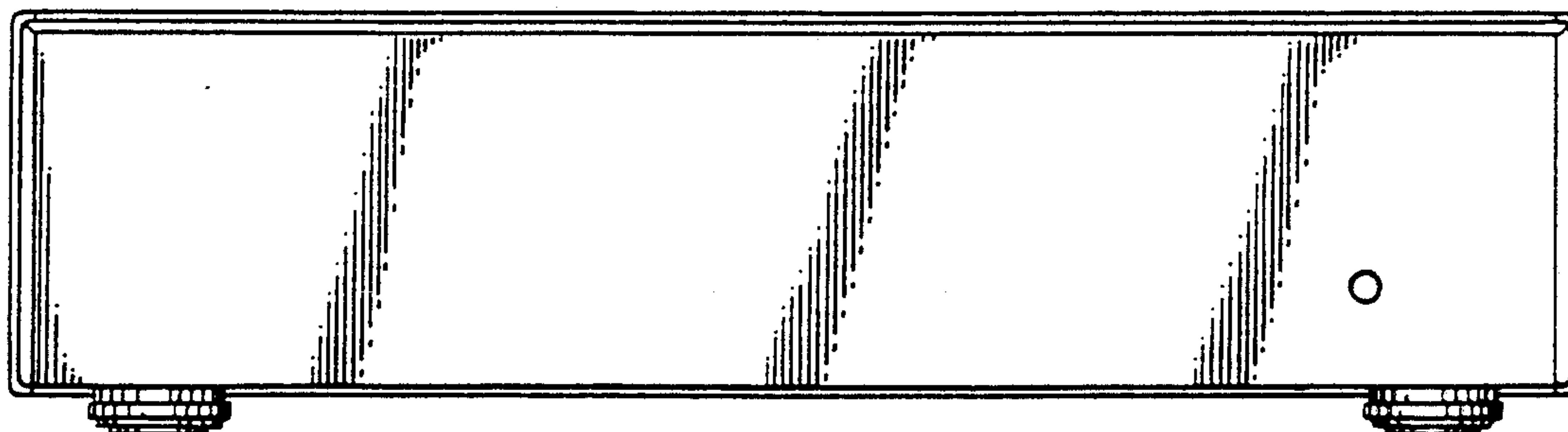

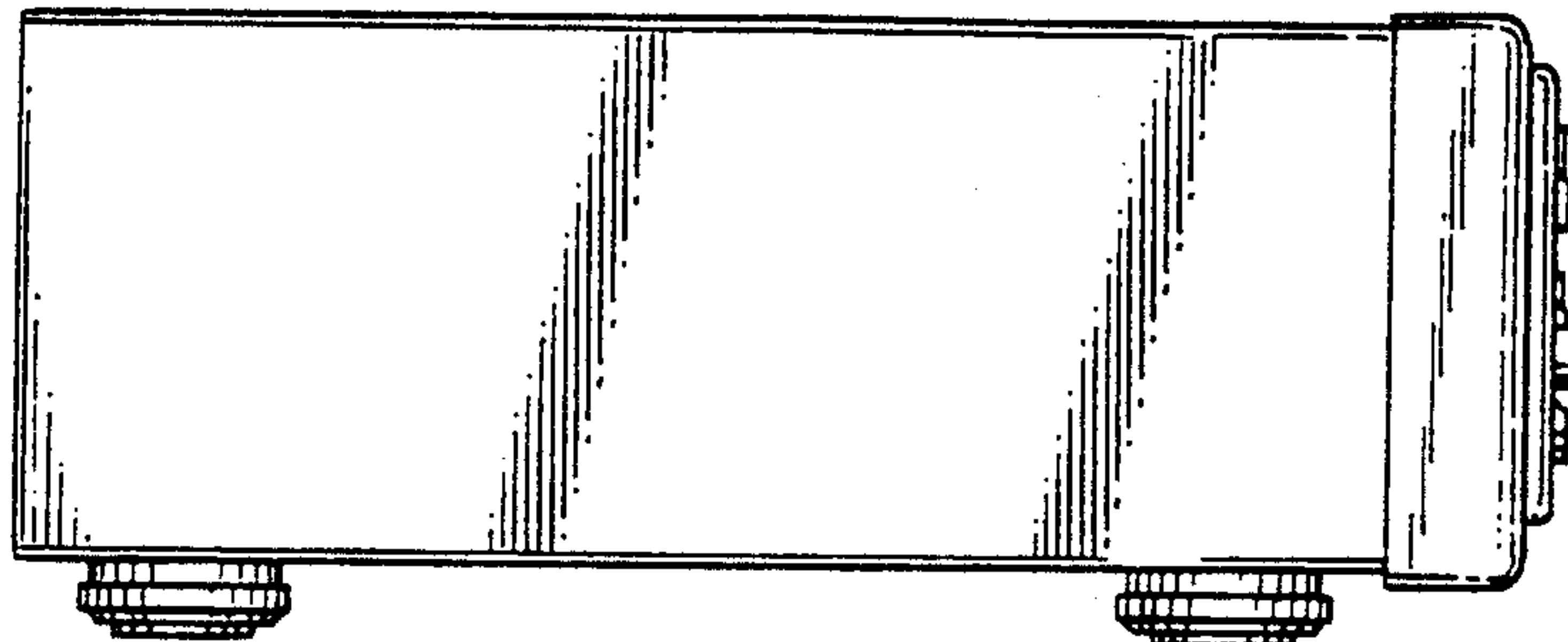

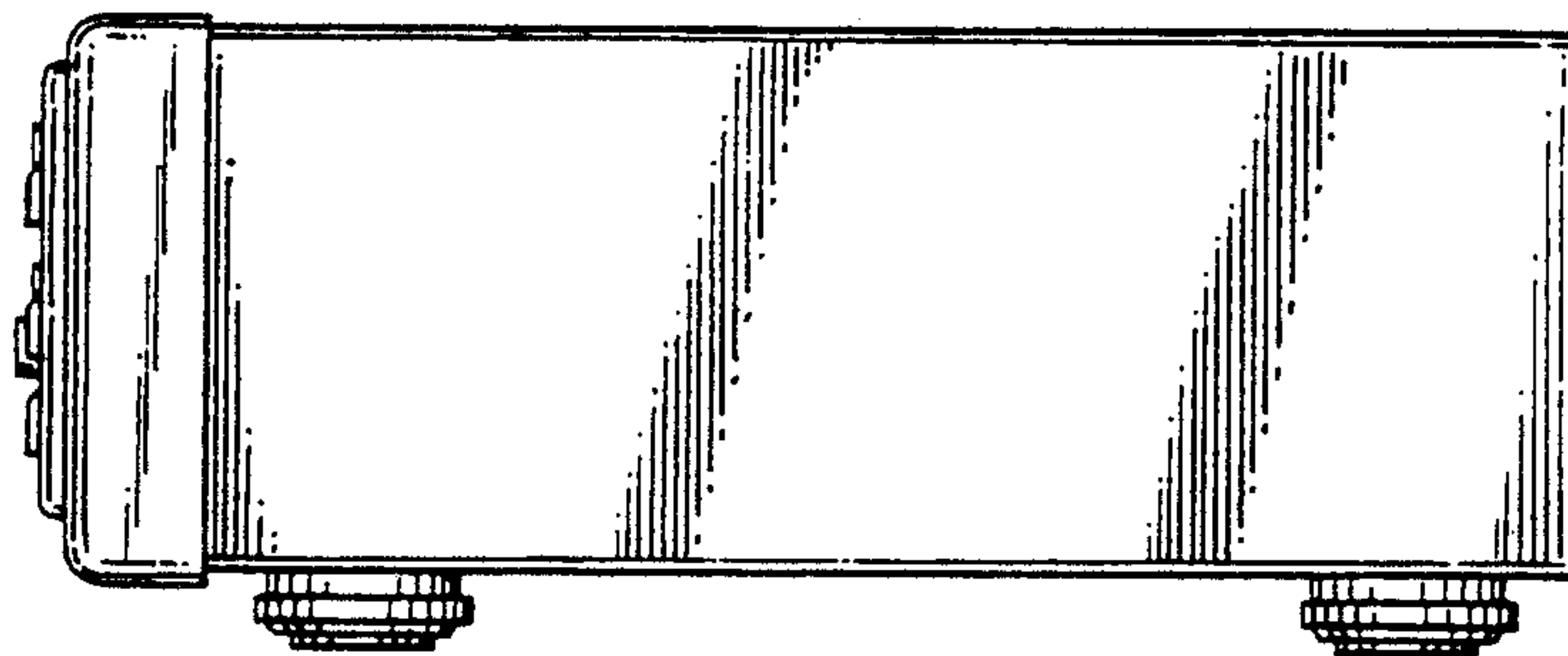
