[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an accessory shoe for a camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right rear perspective view of an accessory shoe for a camera showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof.

The broken line portions of the drawing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

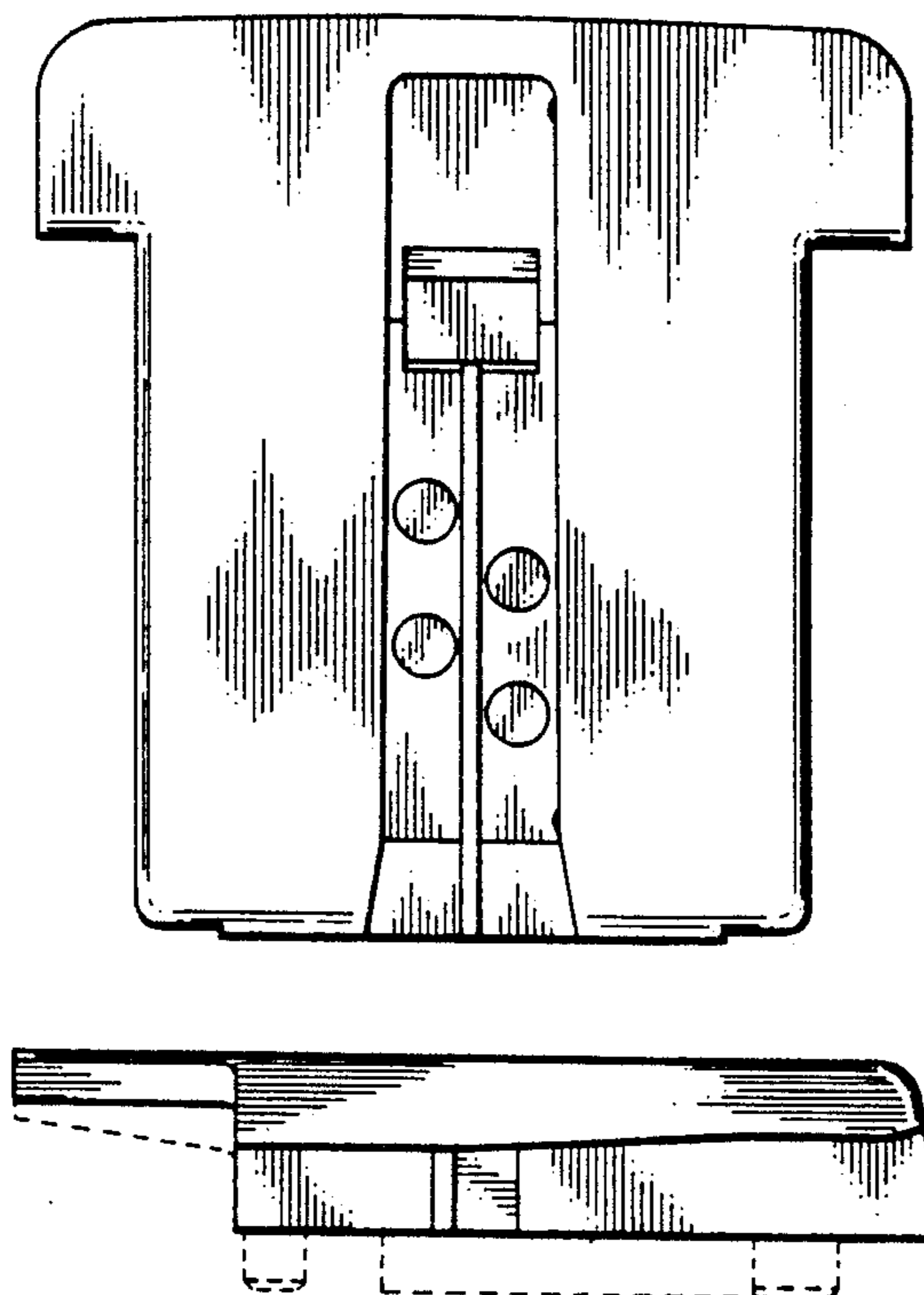

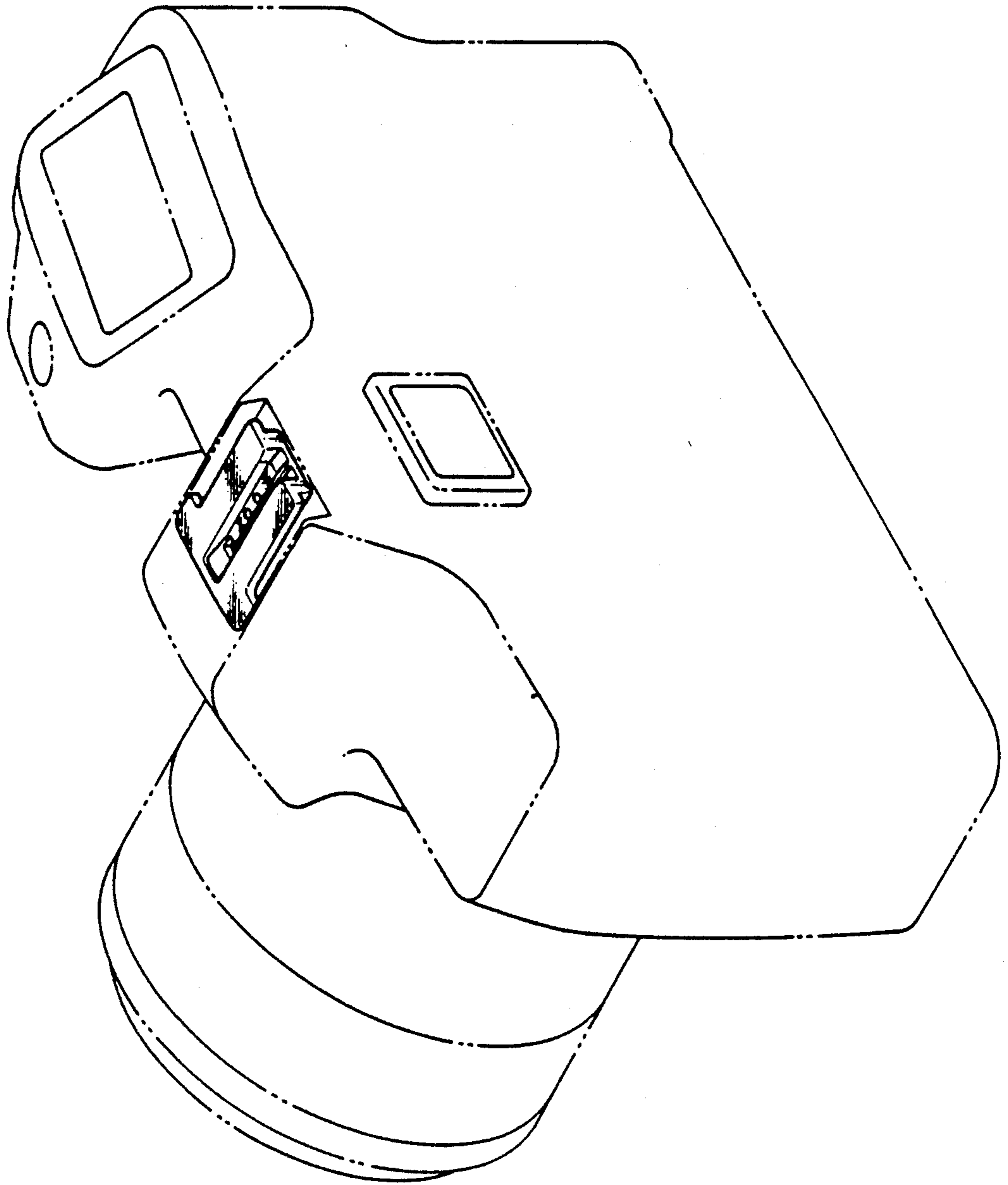

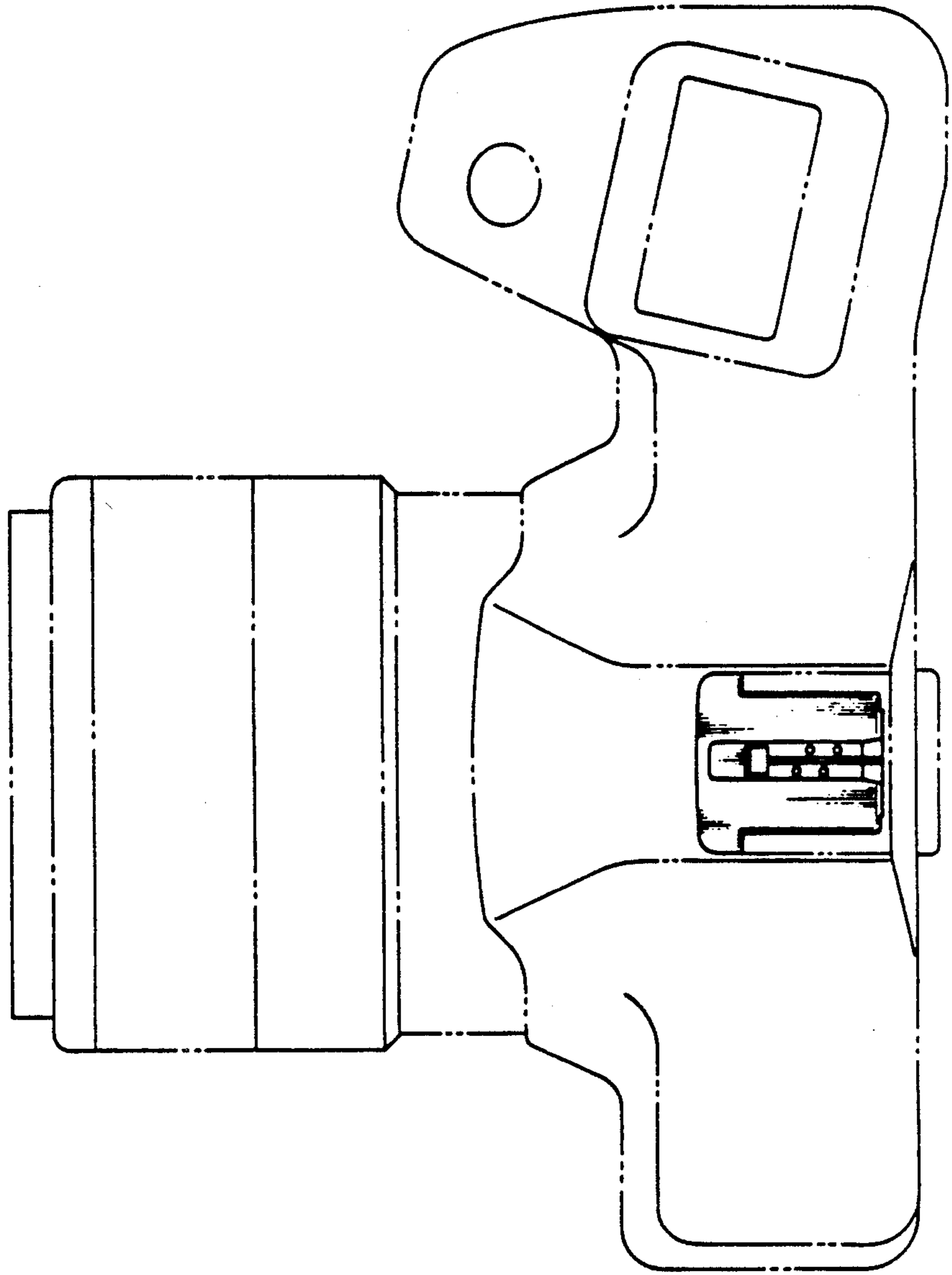

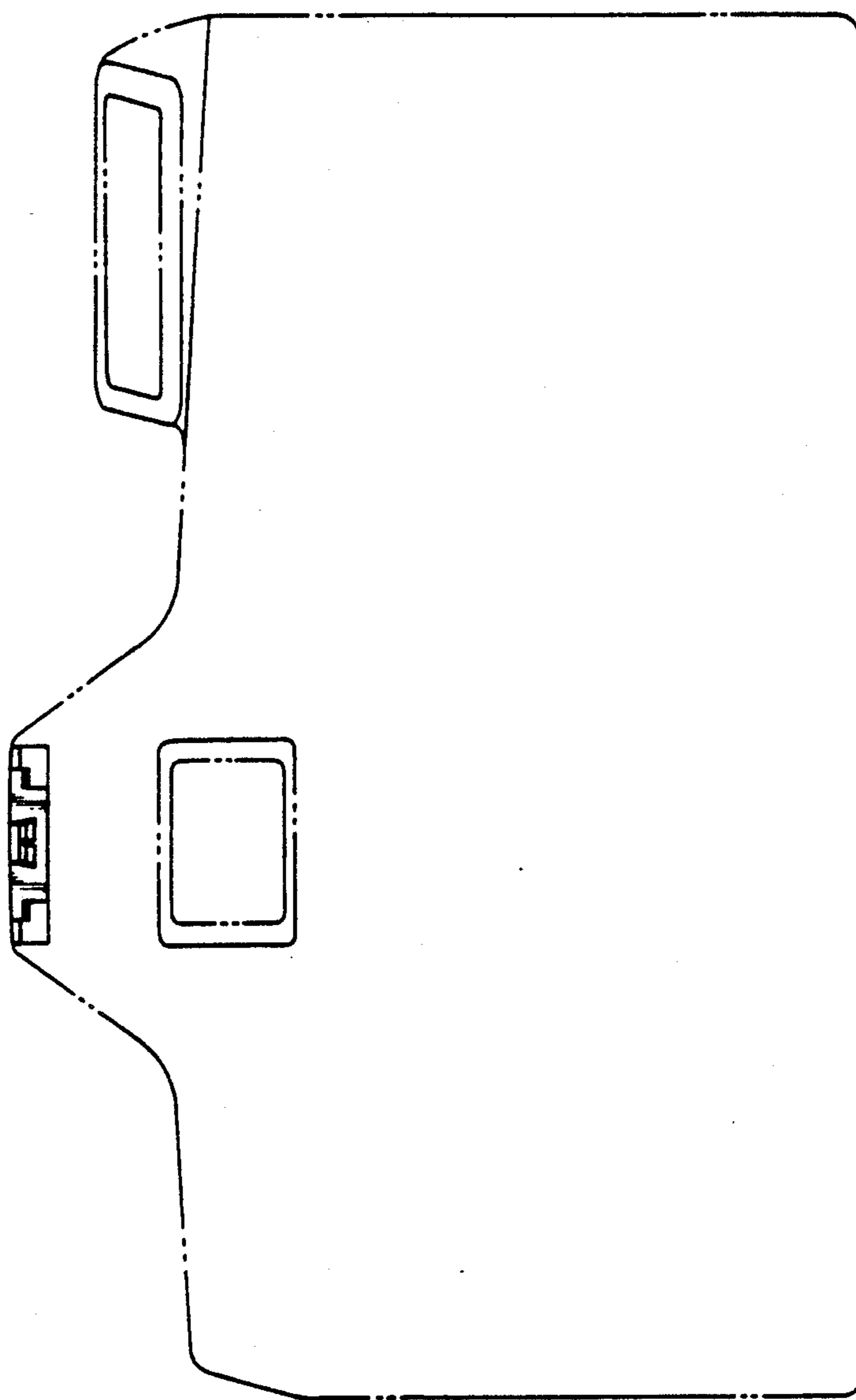

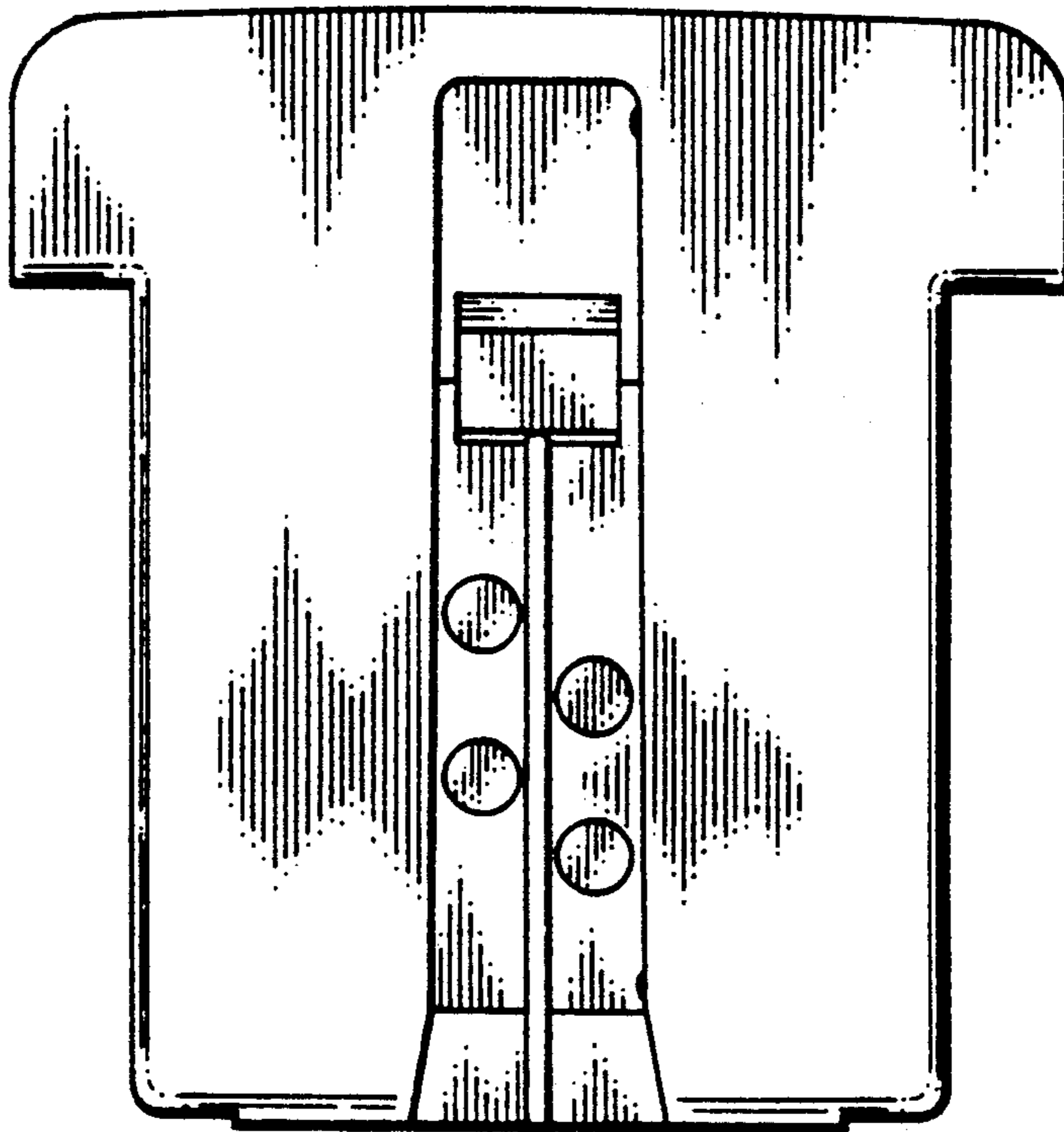

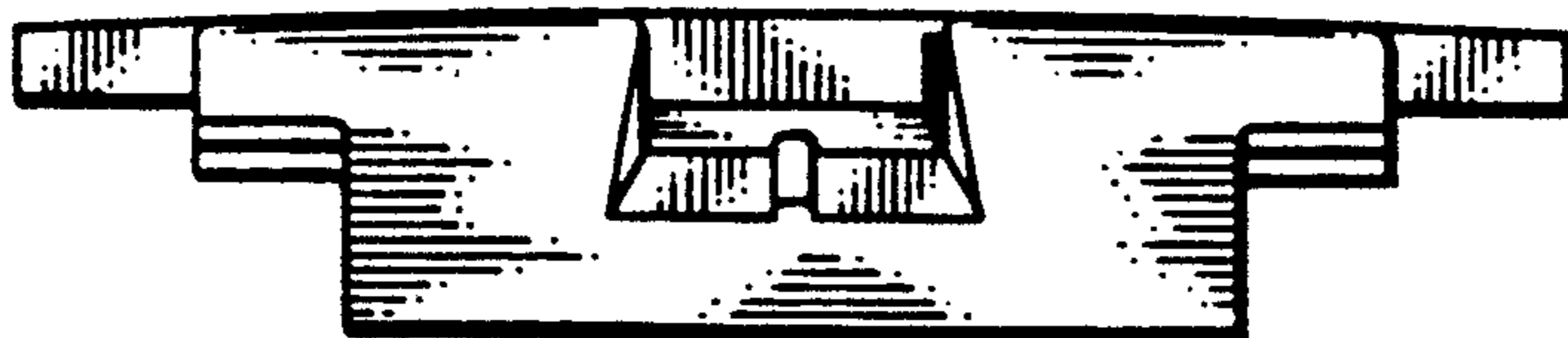
