The ornamental design for a stuffed toy horse, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stuffed toy horse, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevation of one side thereof, the other side being substantially a mirror image except for the mane;

FIG. 3 is a top plan thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front end view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear end view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective showing a different embodiment thereof;

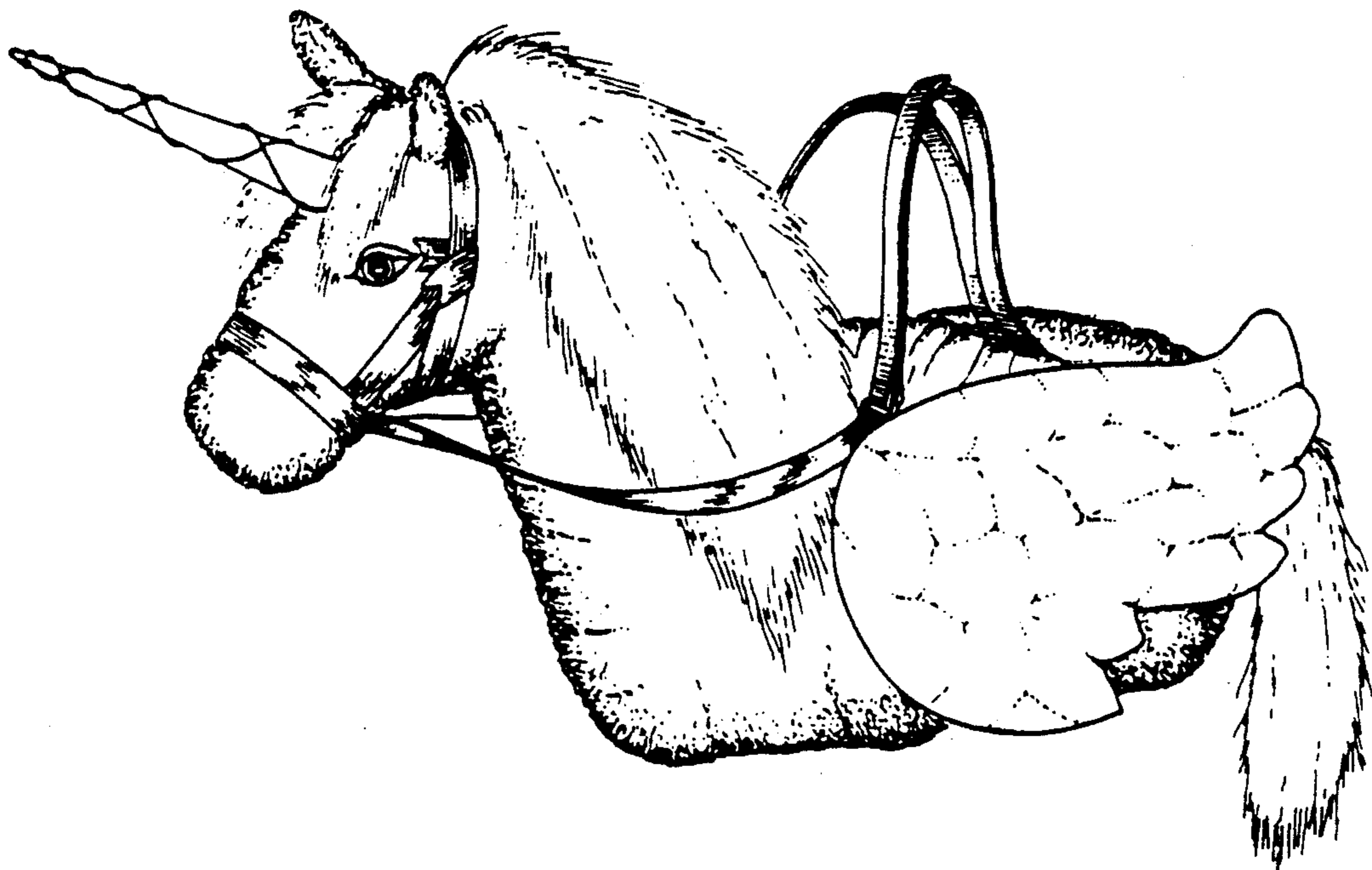
FIG. 8 is an elevation of one side thereof; the other side being substantially a mirror image except for the mane;

FIG. 12 is a rear end view thereof.



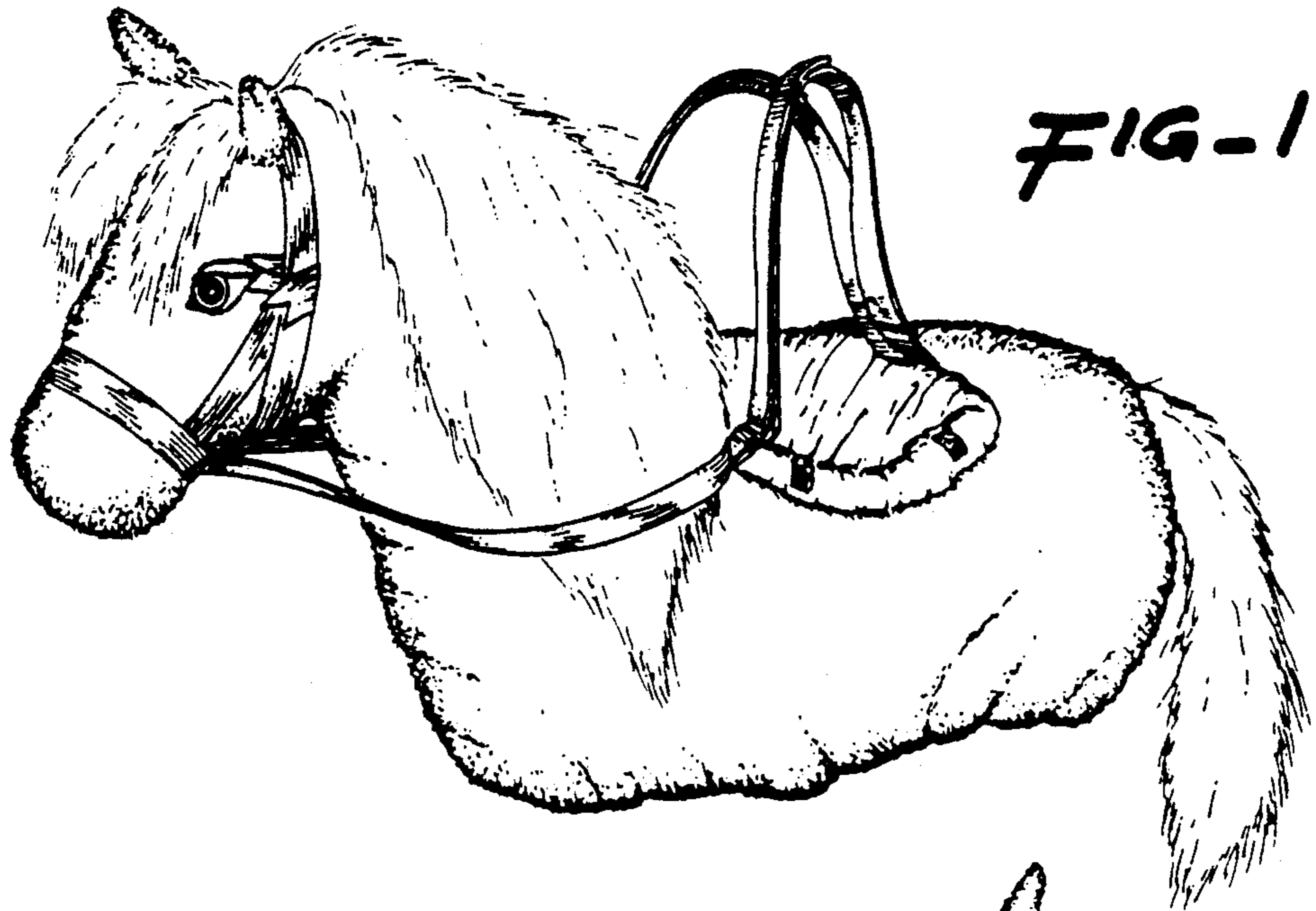

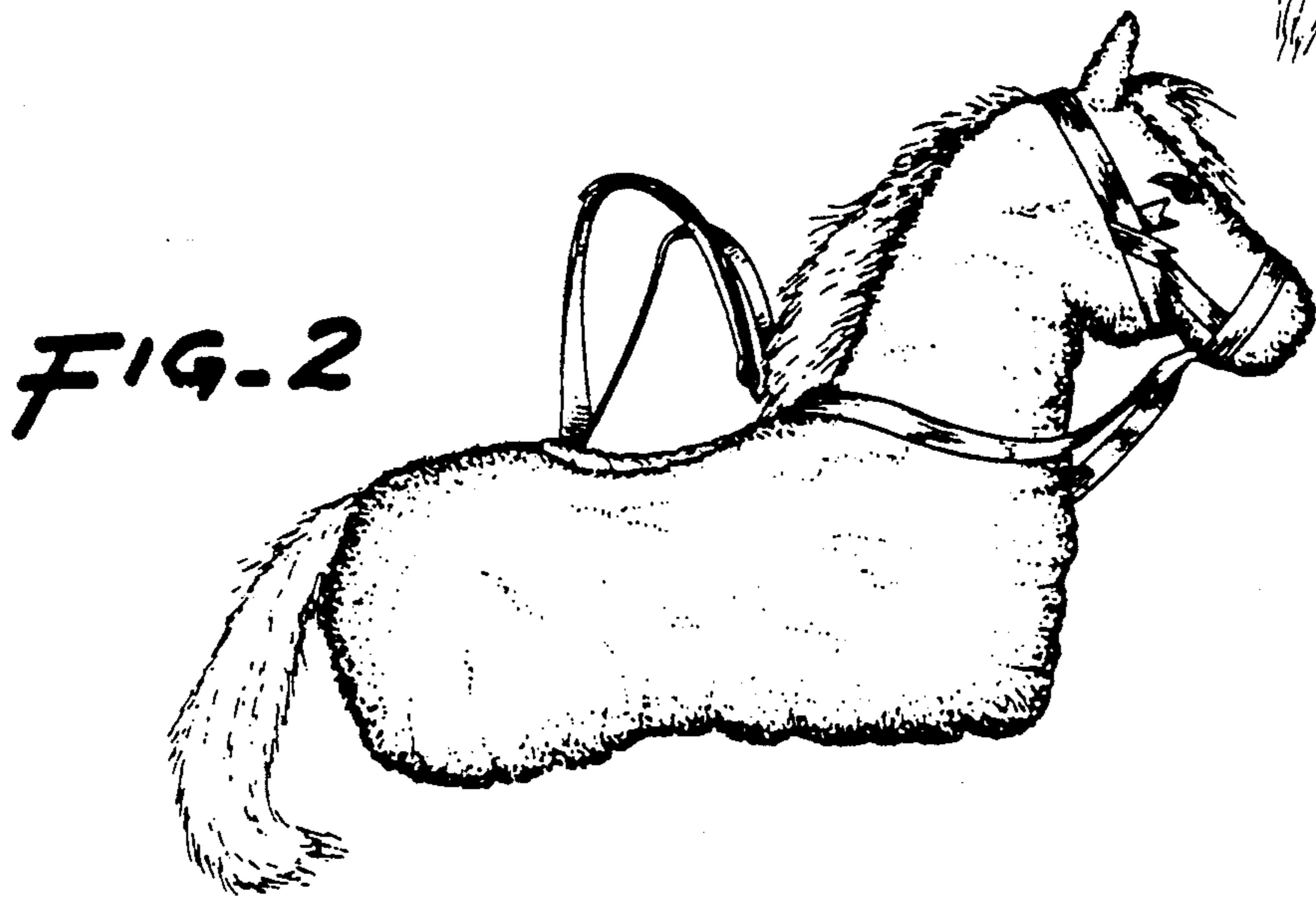

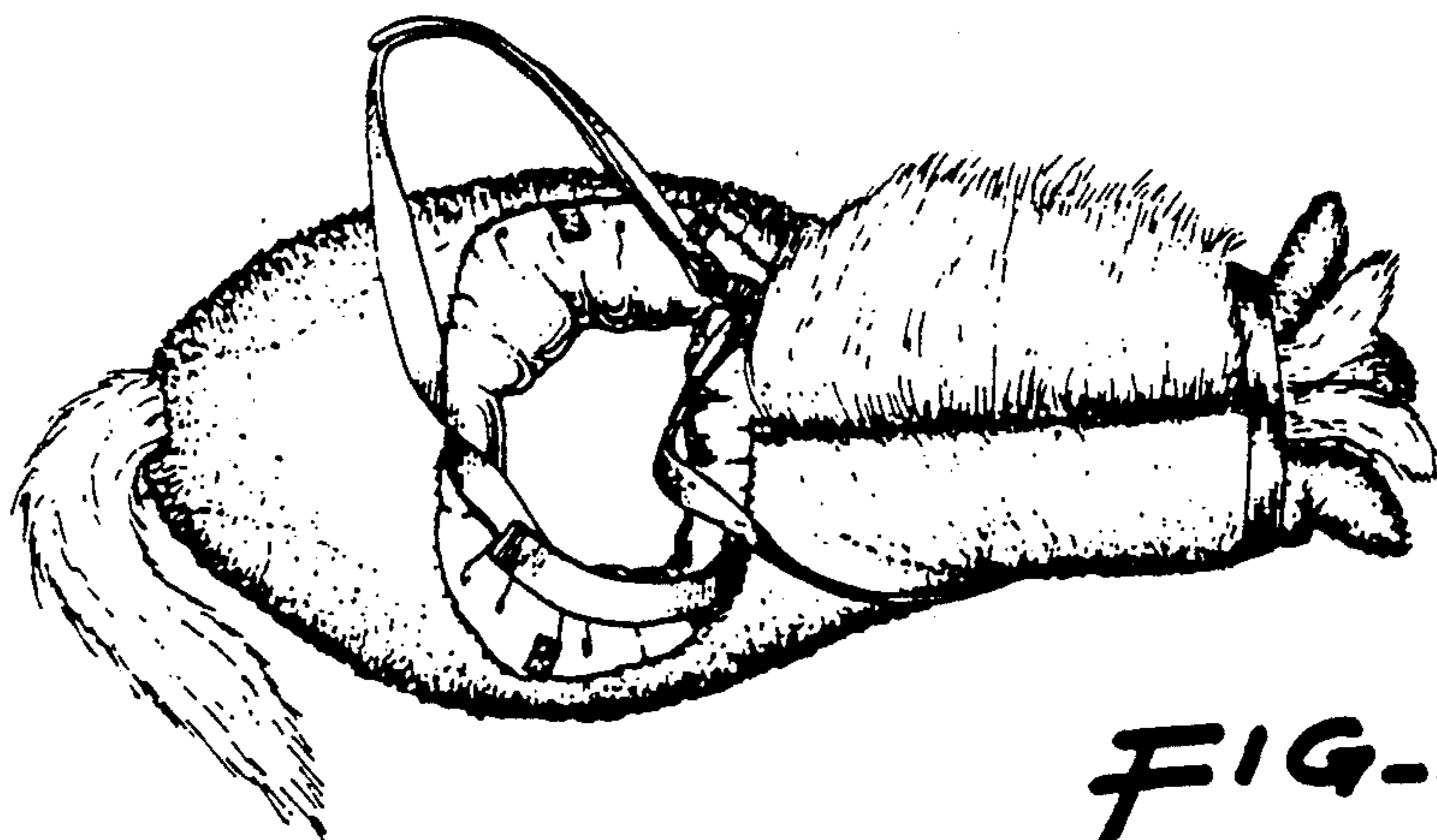

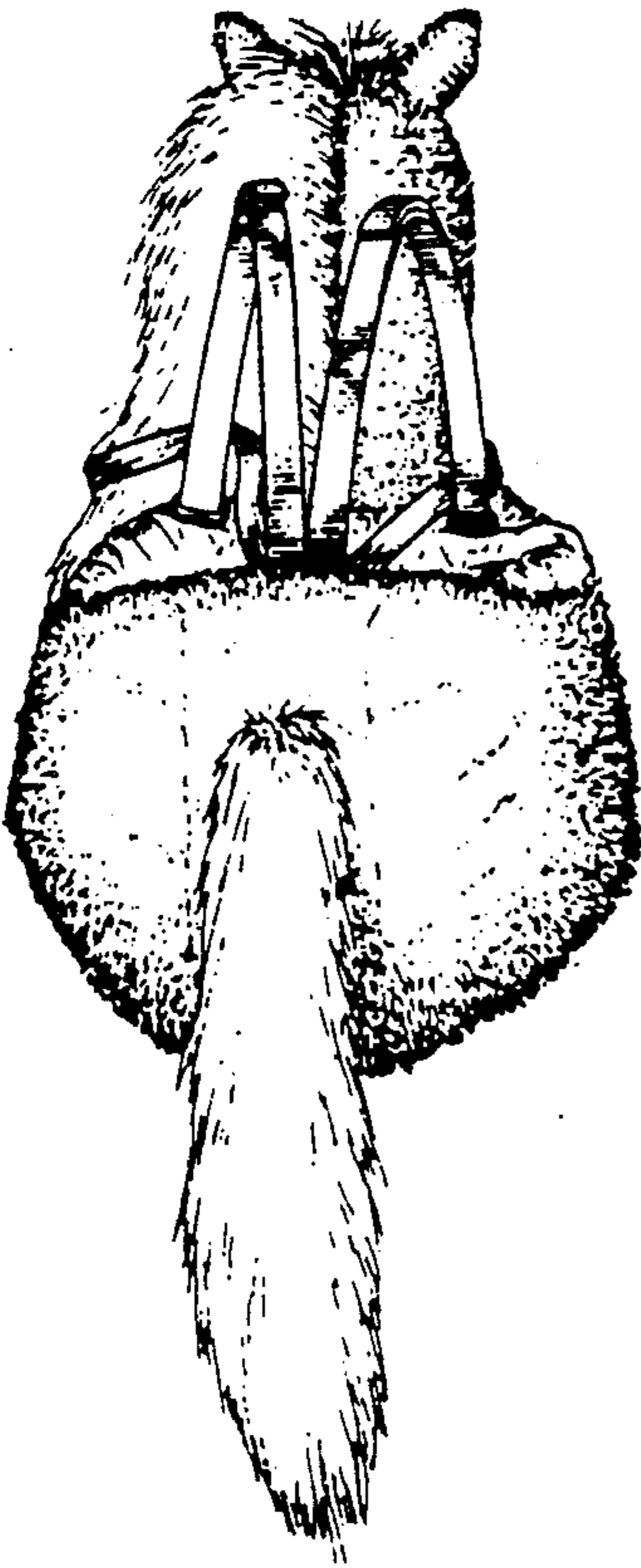
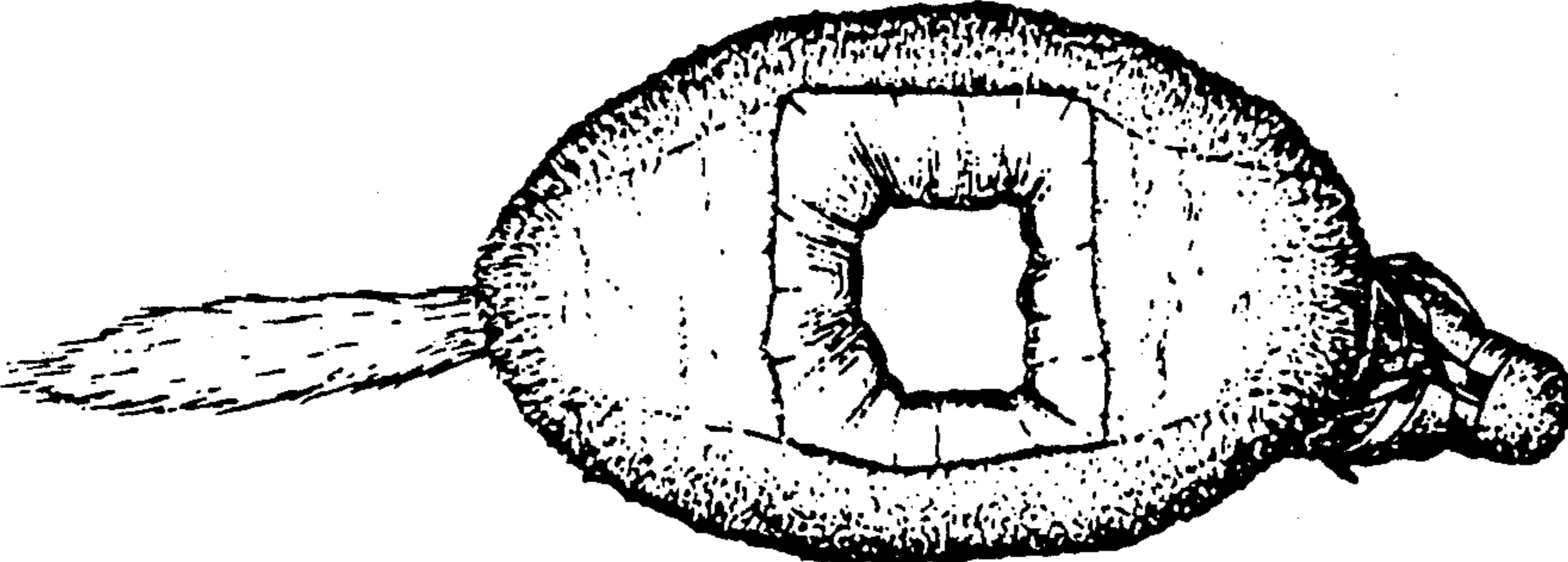

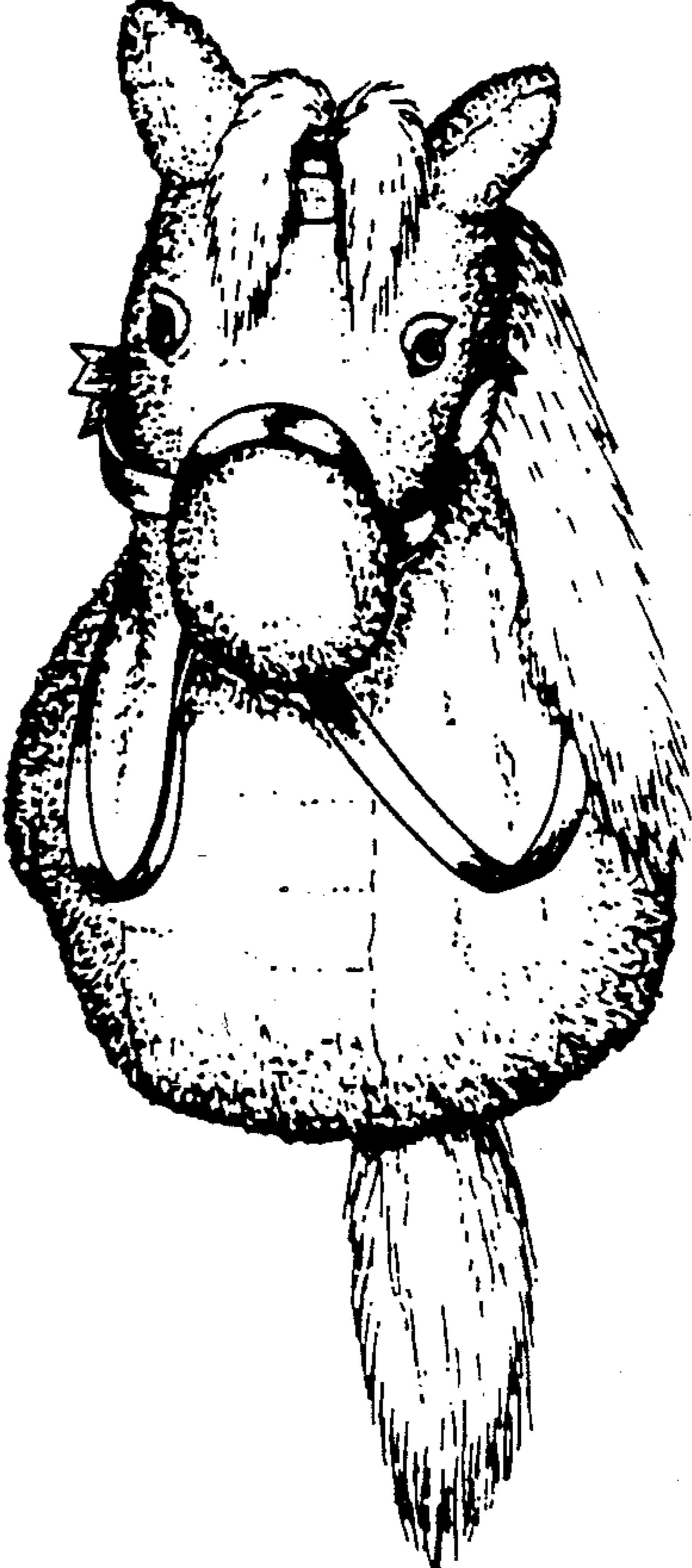

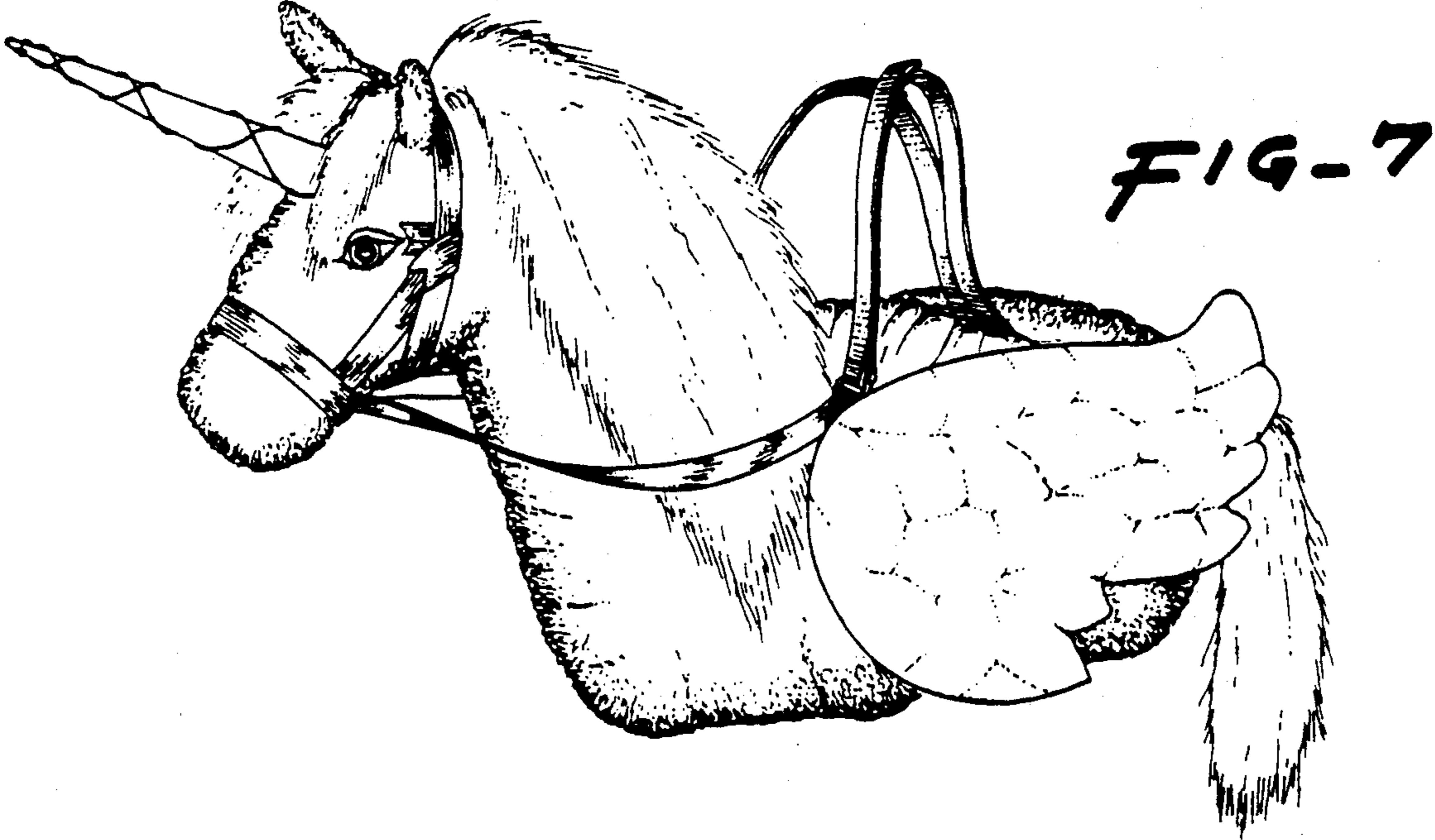

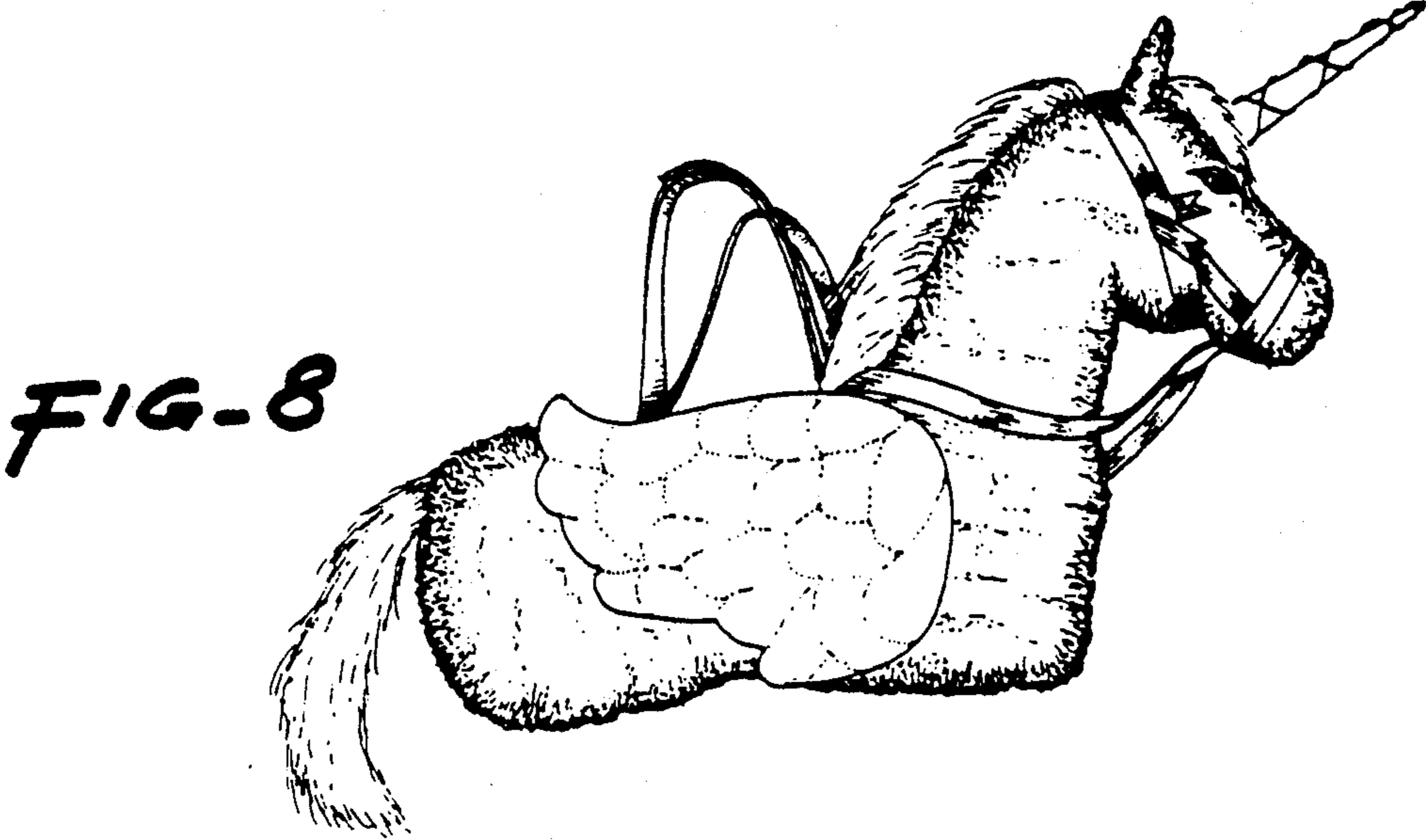

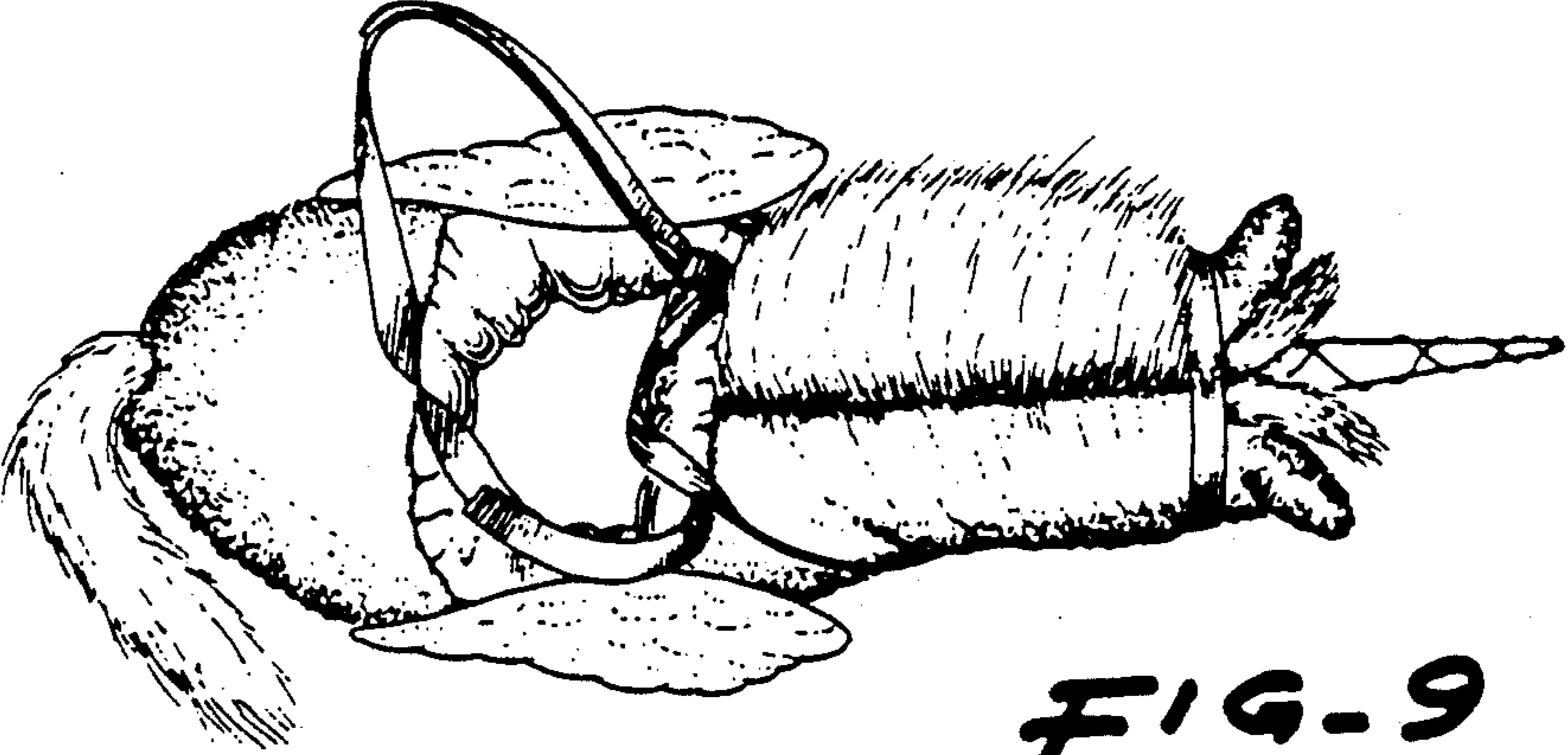

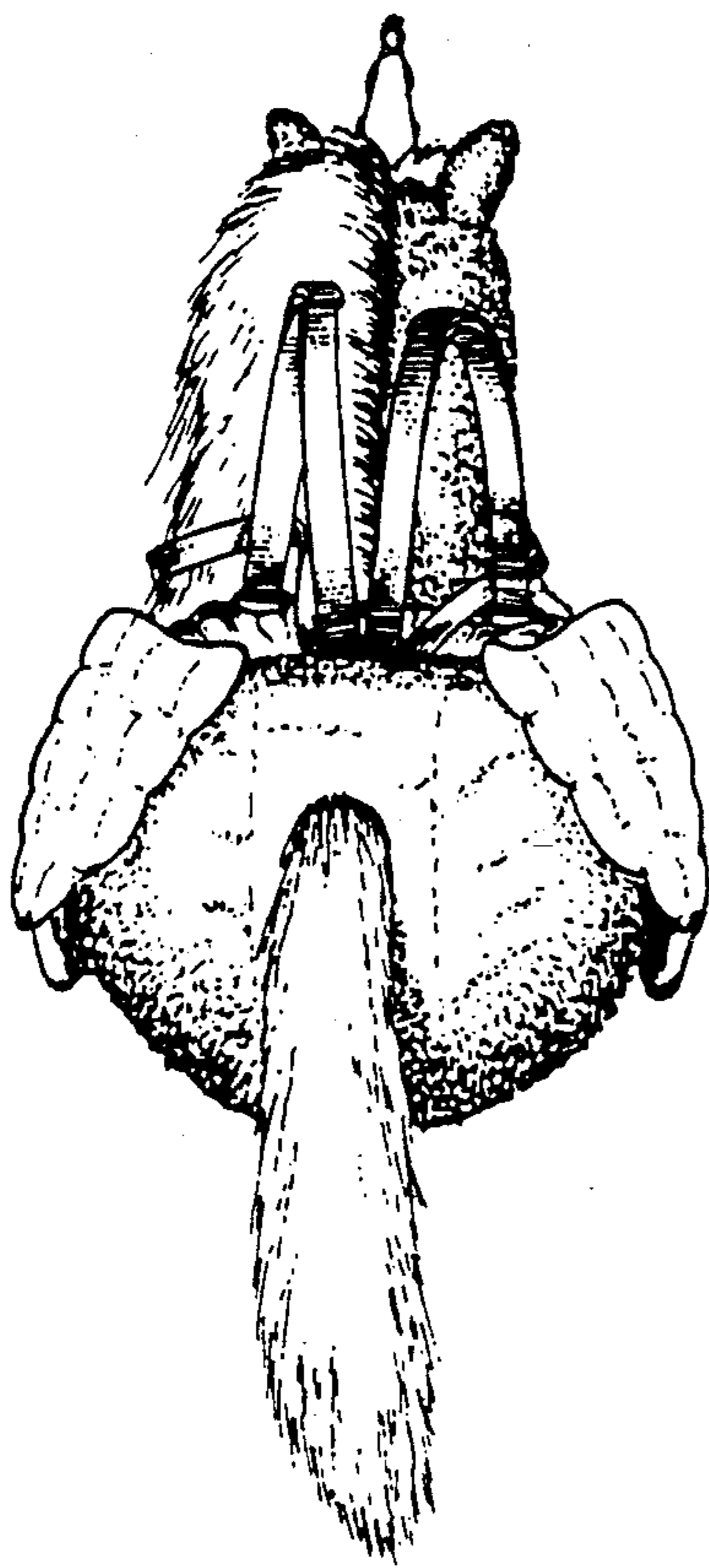
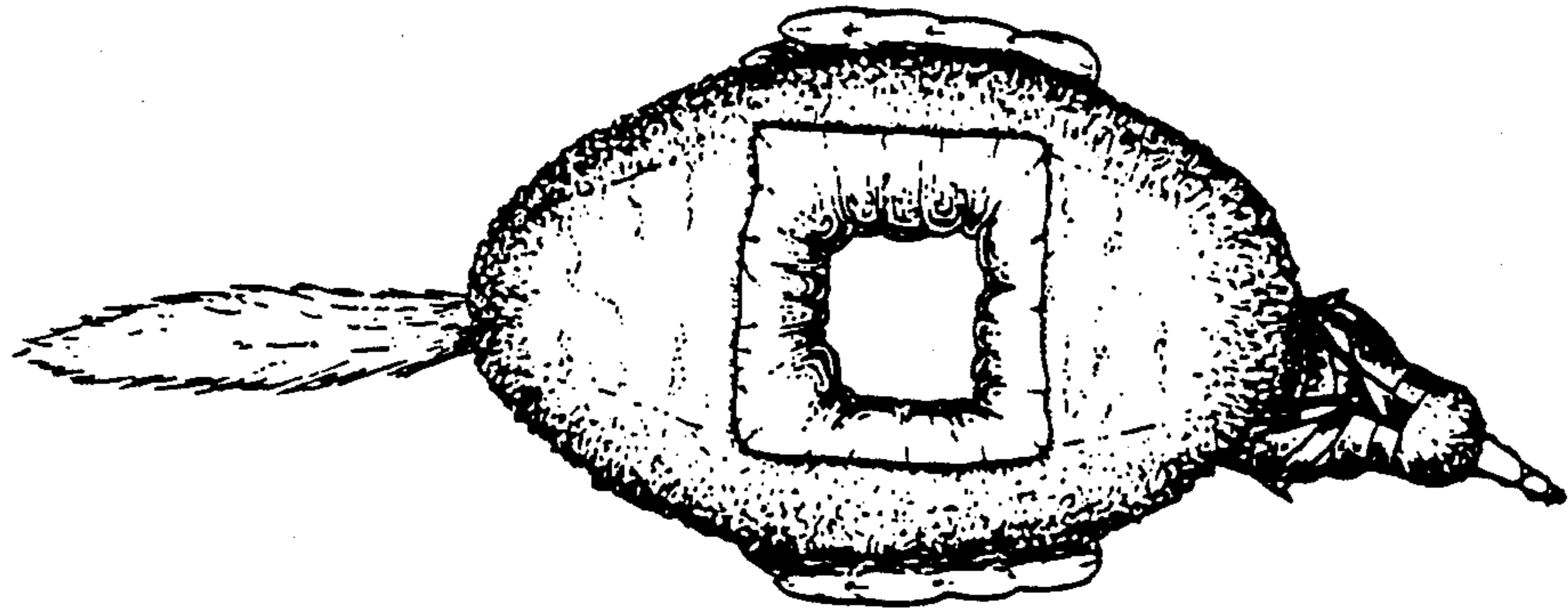

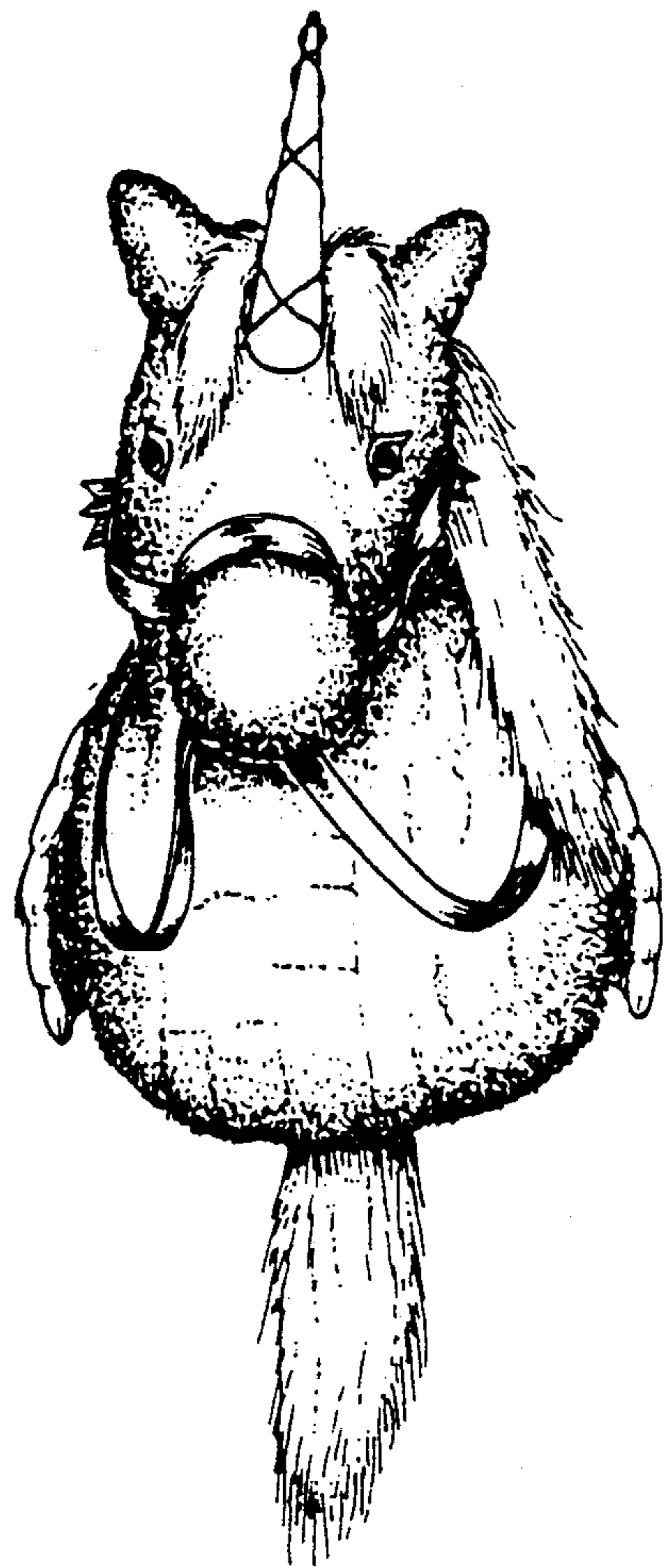
