DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken, from the top, front
and right side of a faucet showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left
side being the same as the right side shown;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

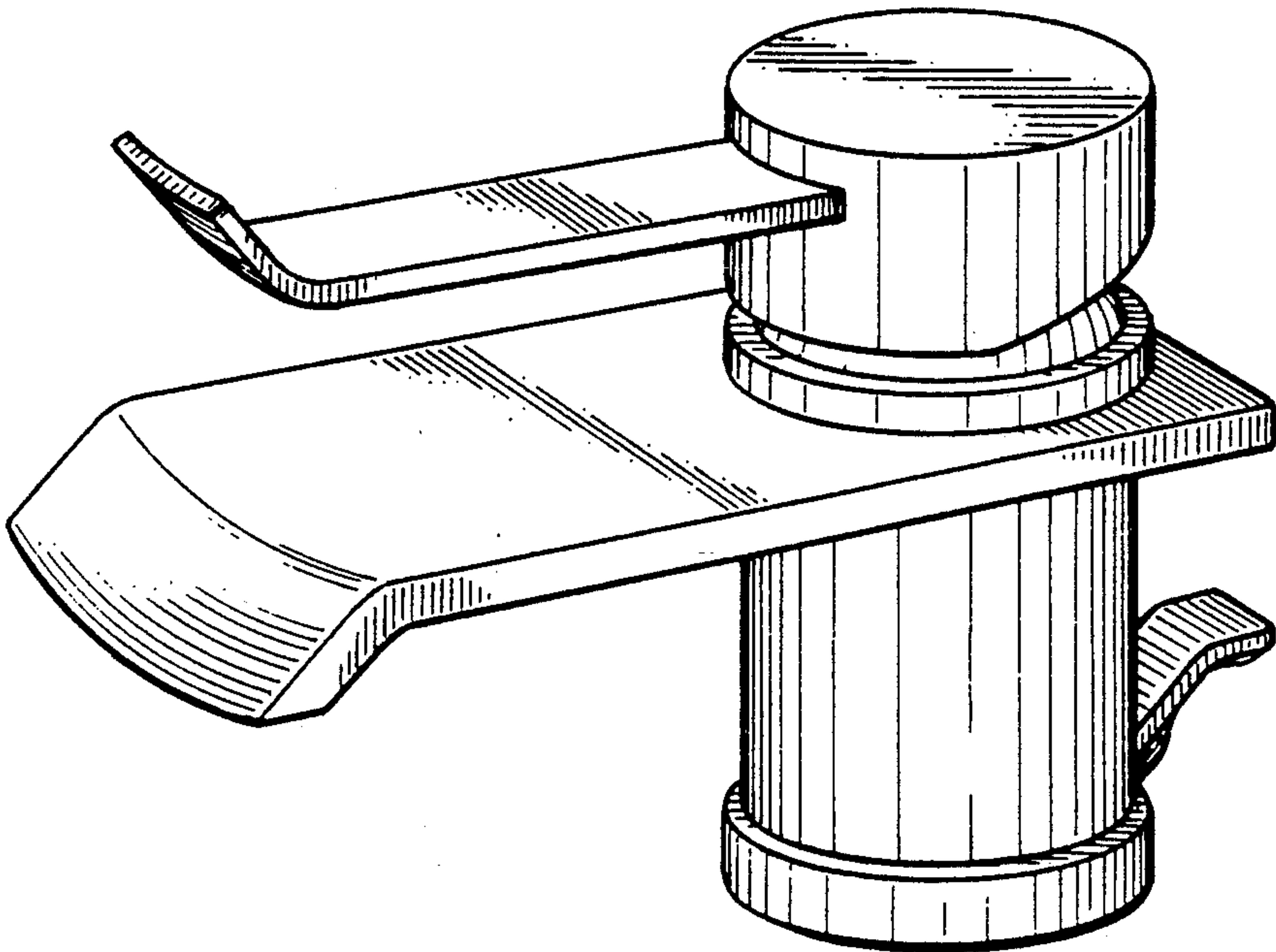

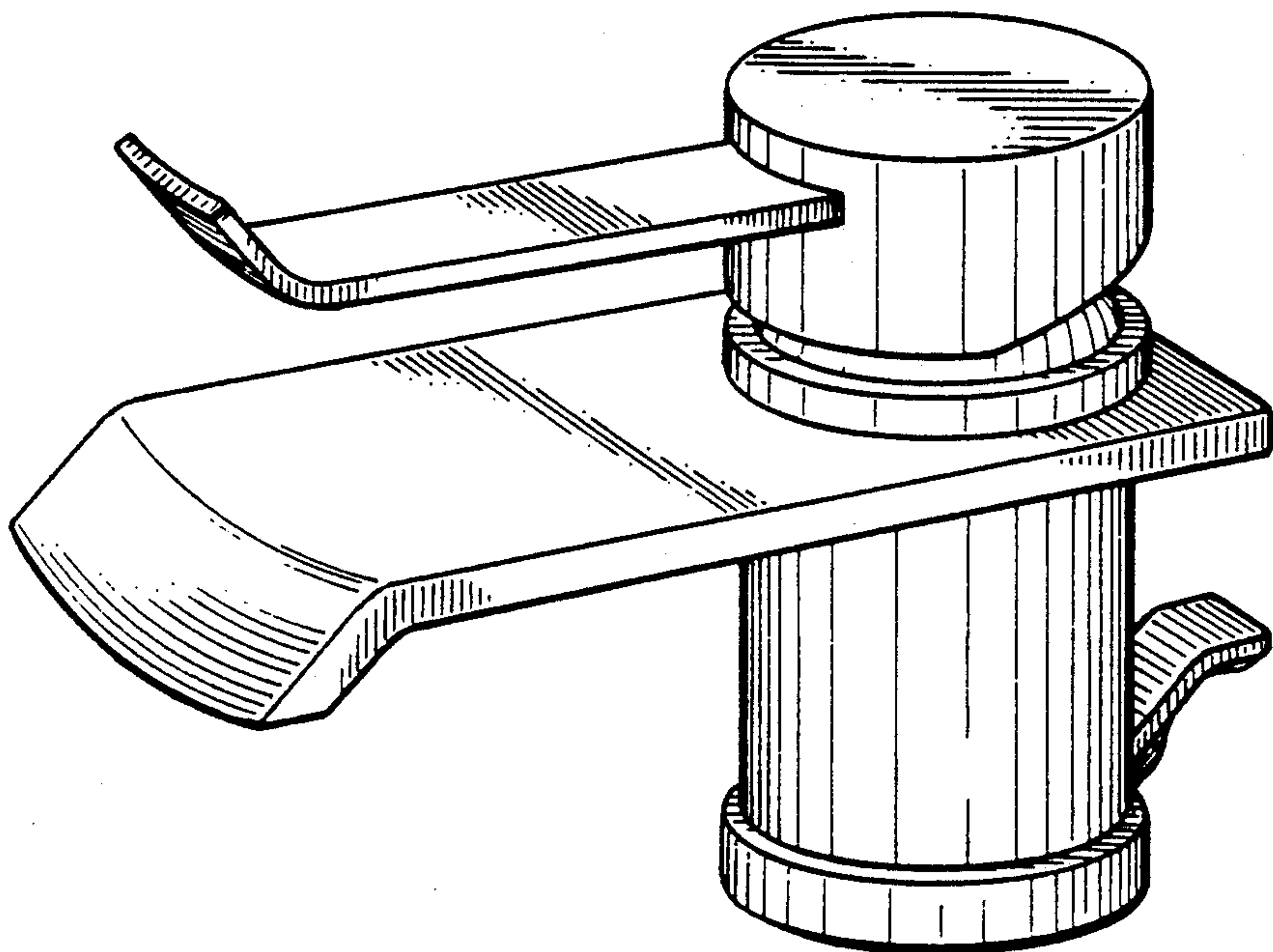

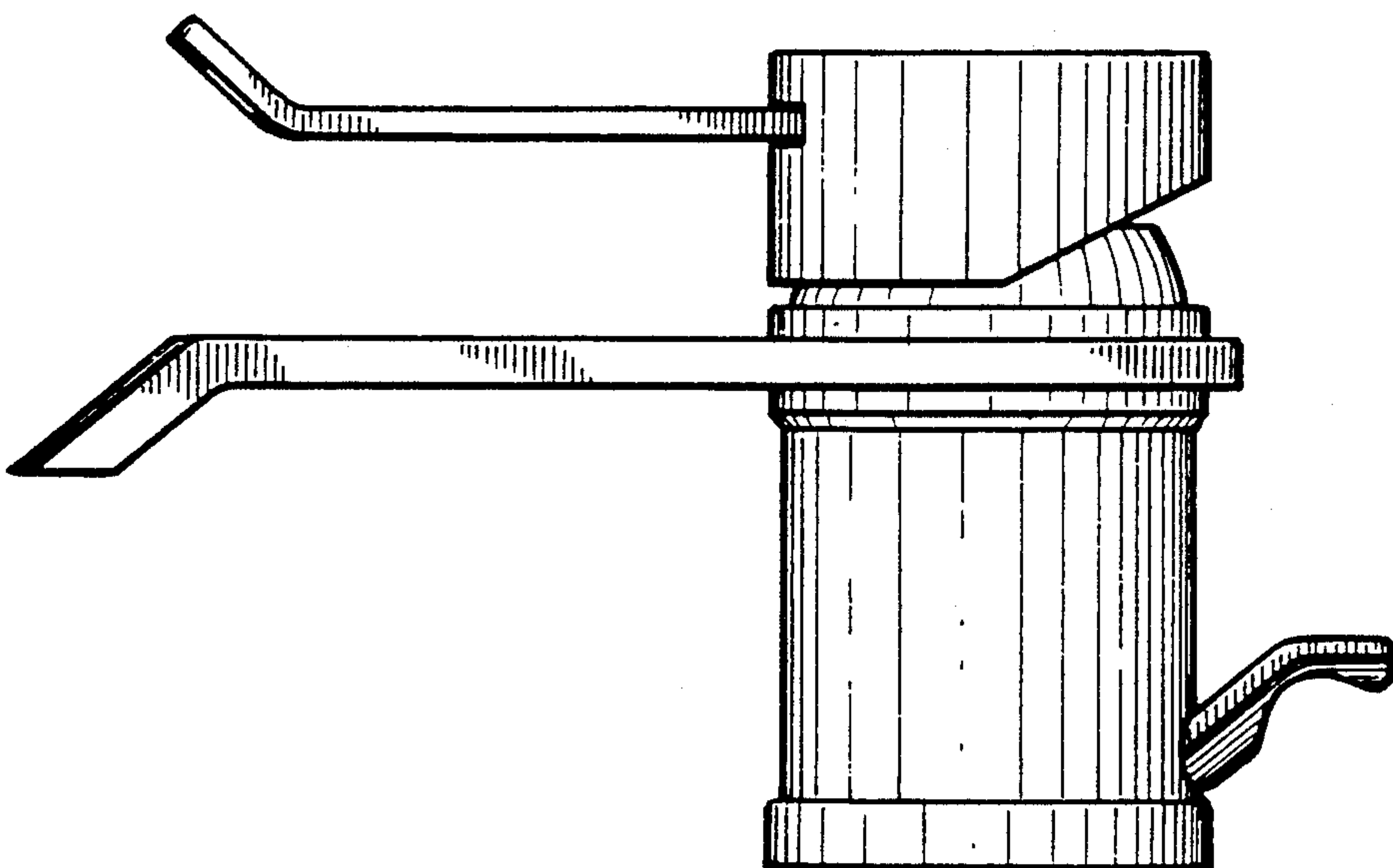

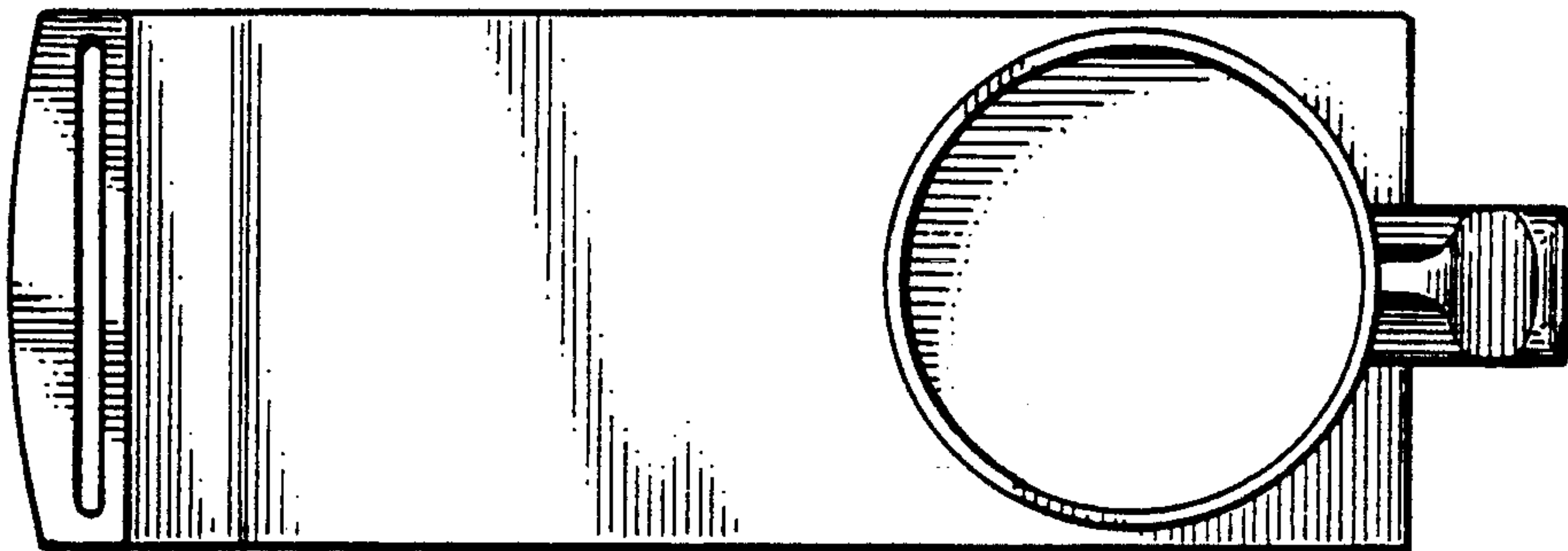

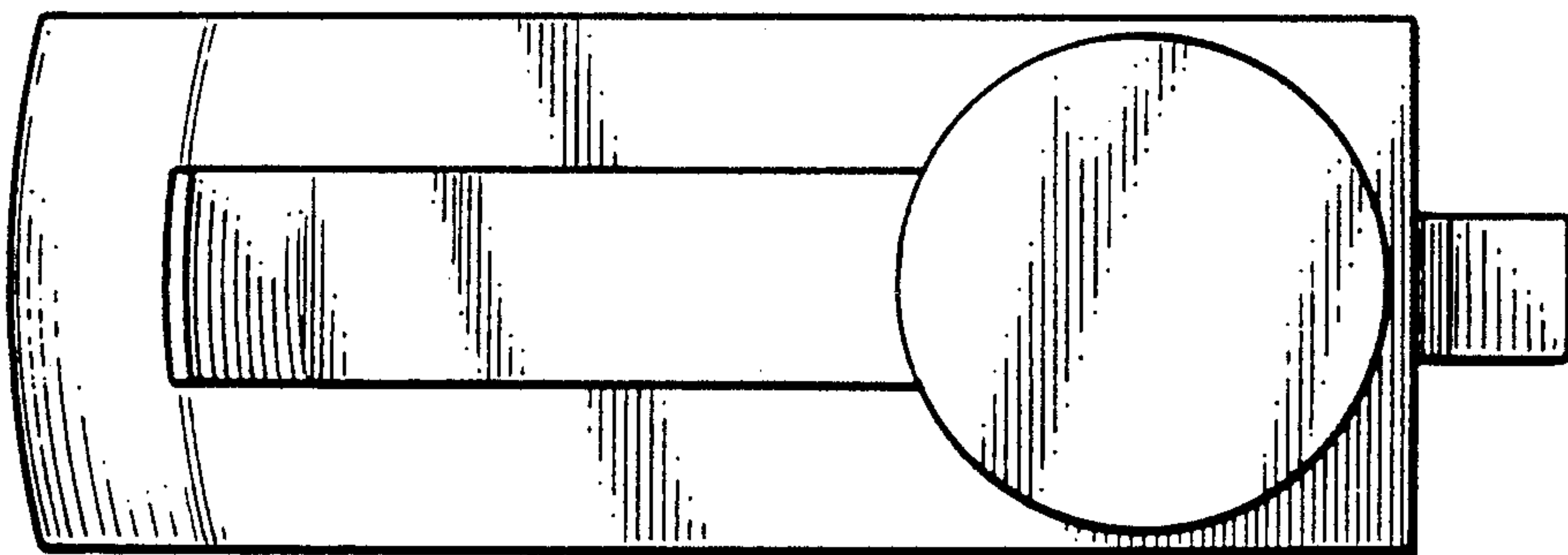

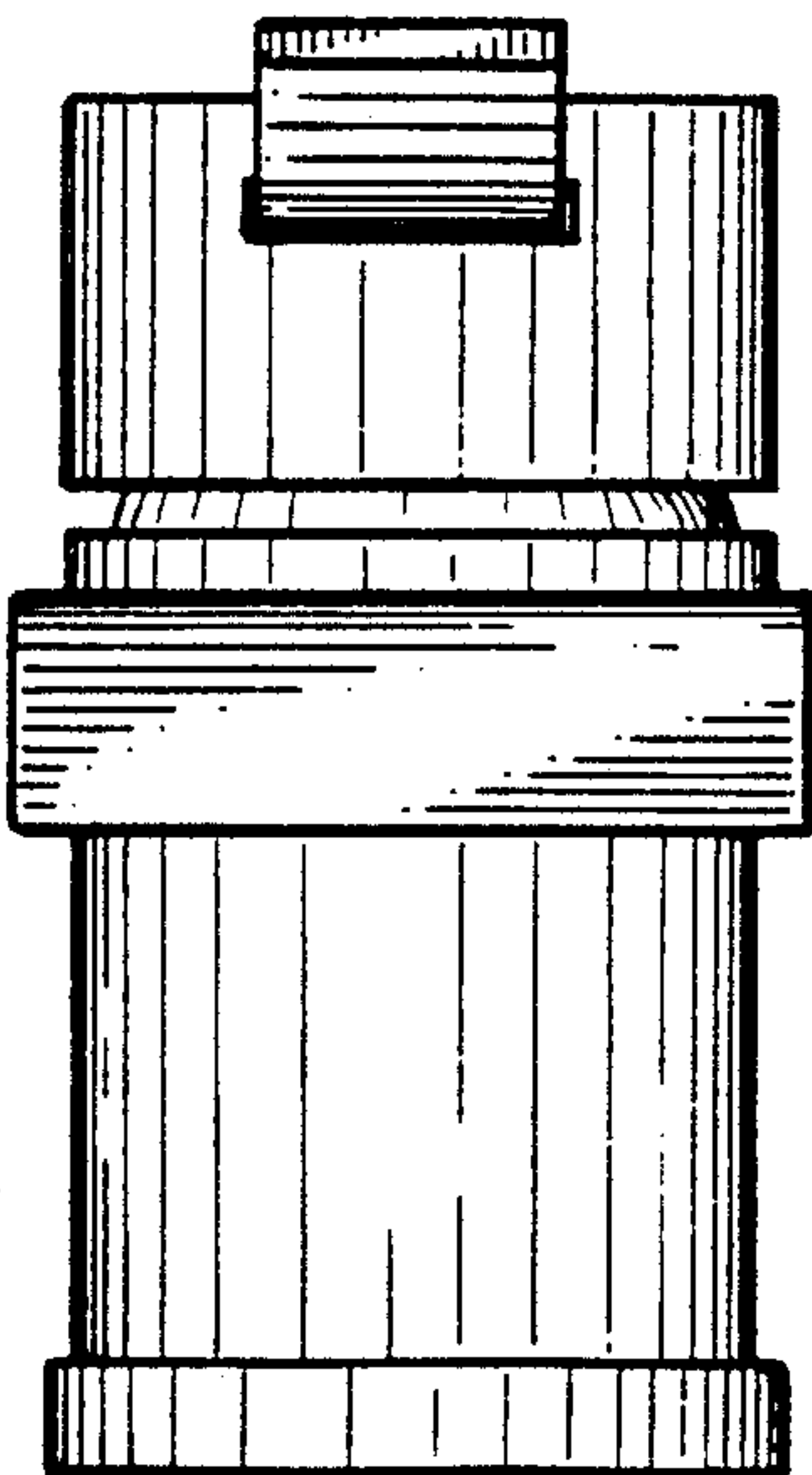
