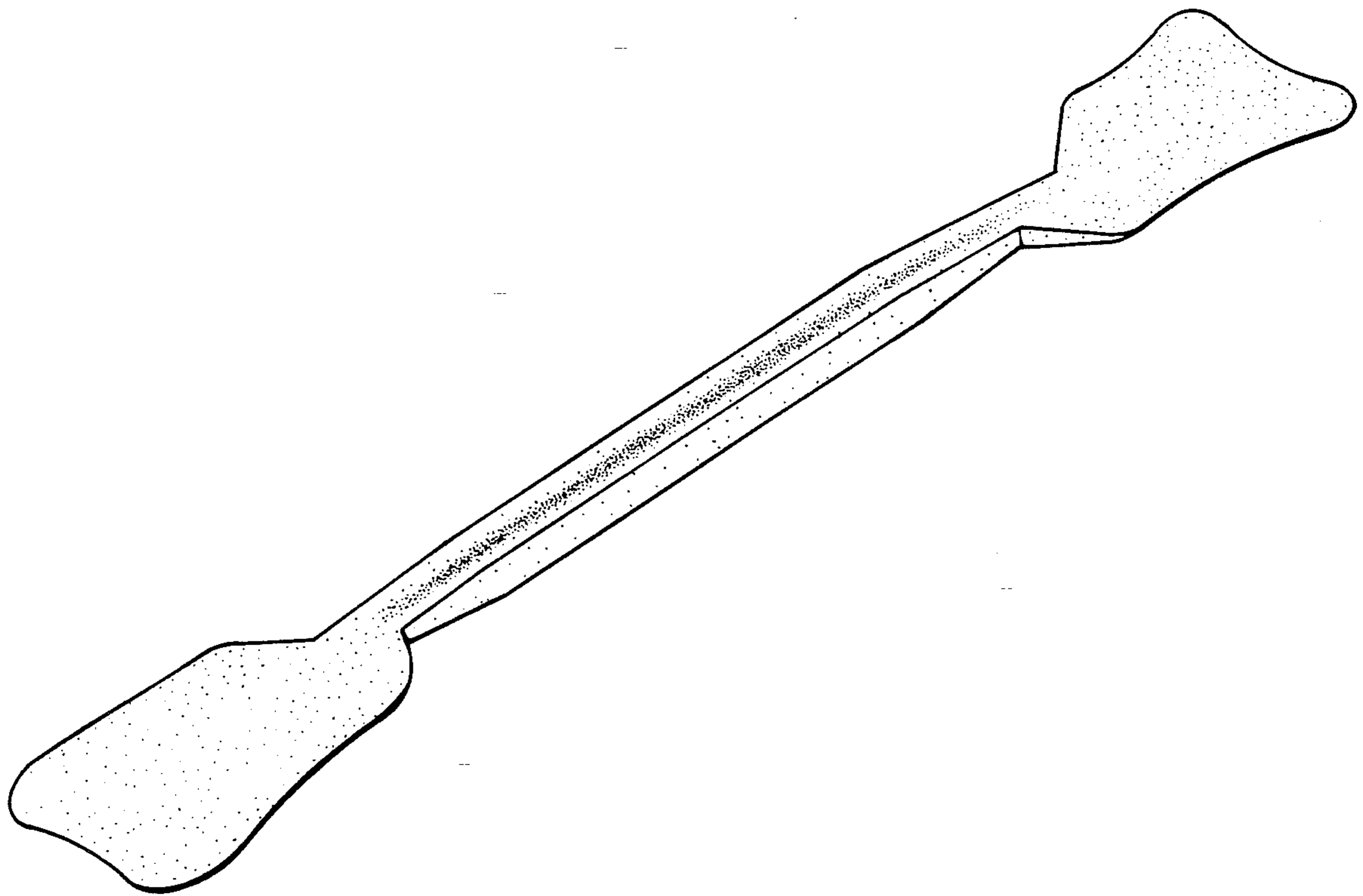

The ornamental design for a scraper for jars of baby food, as shown and described.



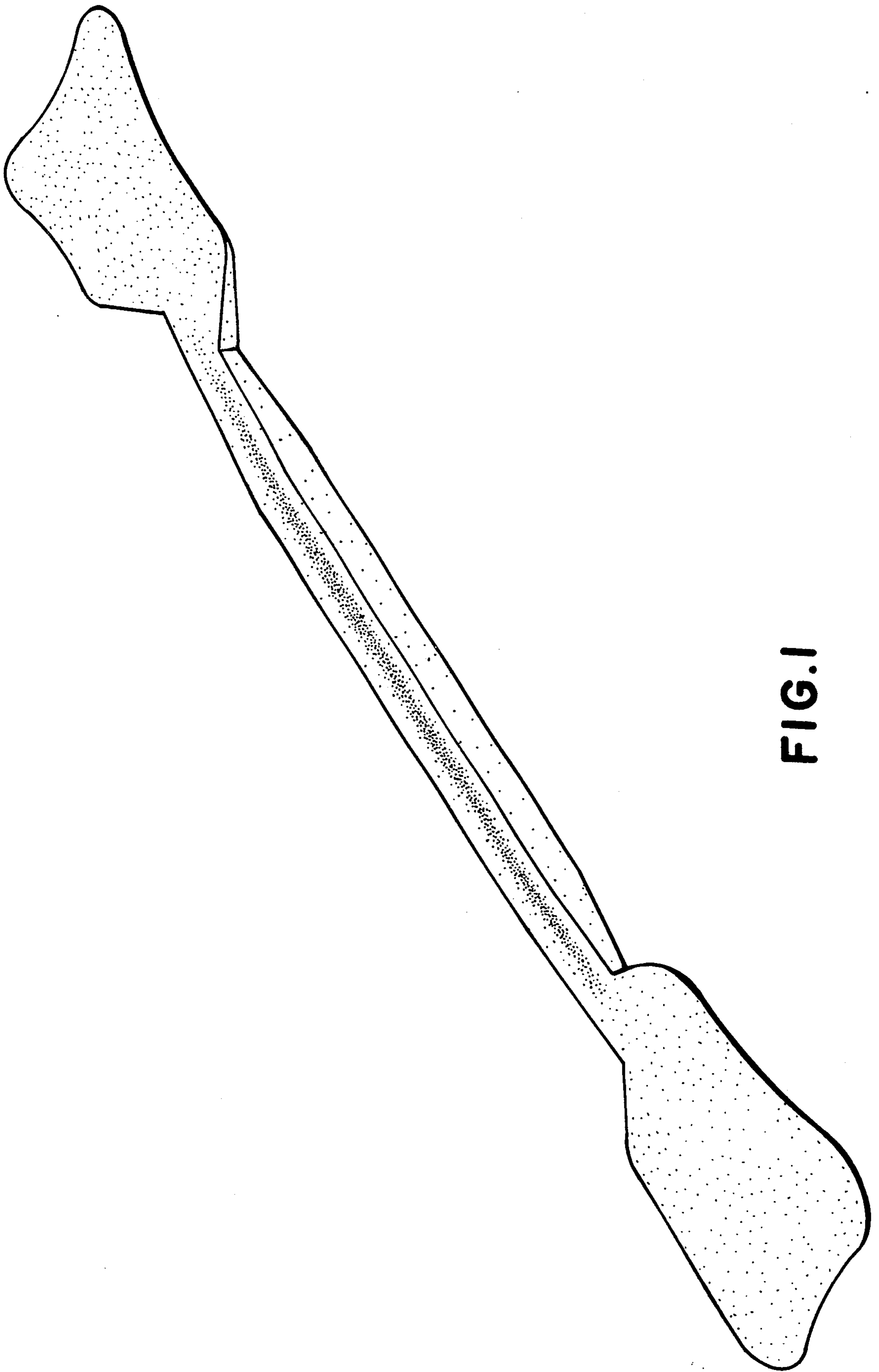

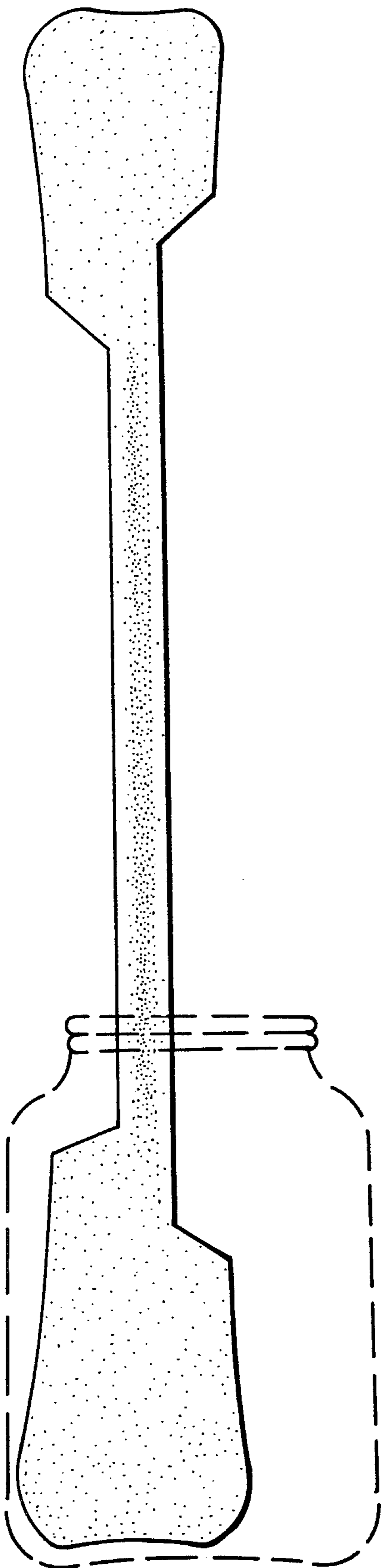

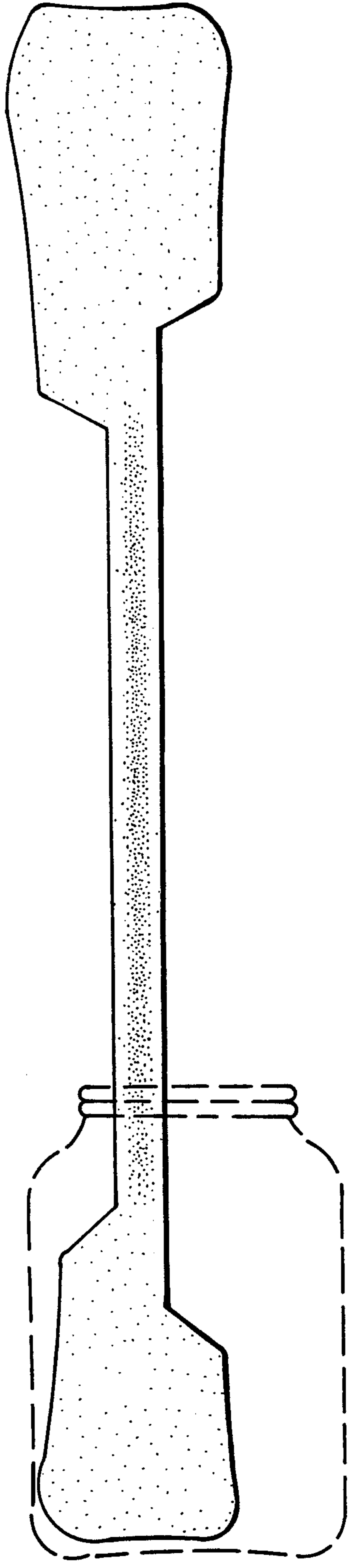

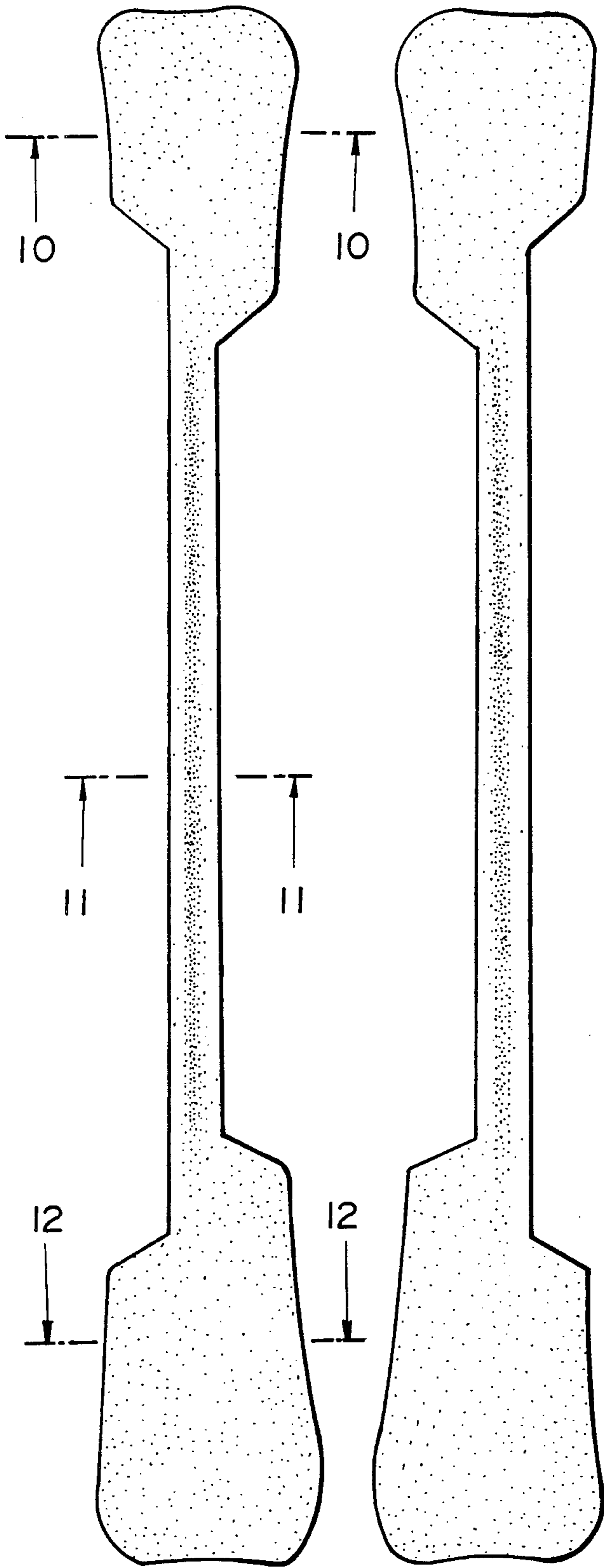

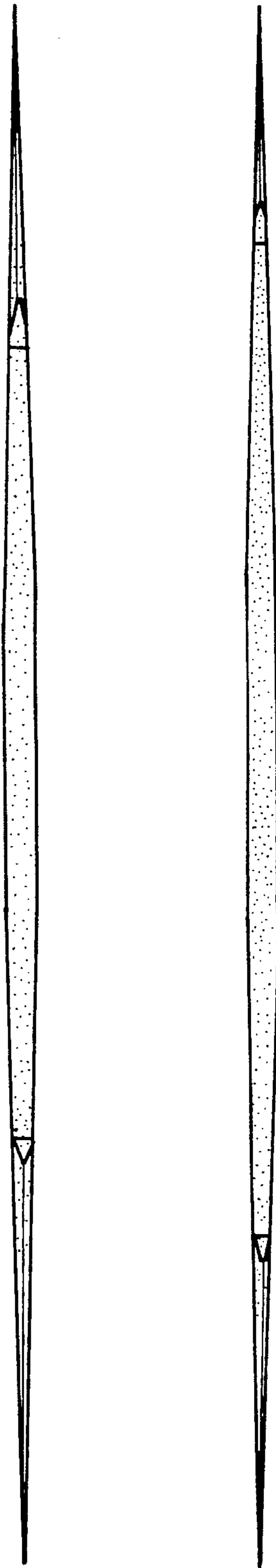

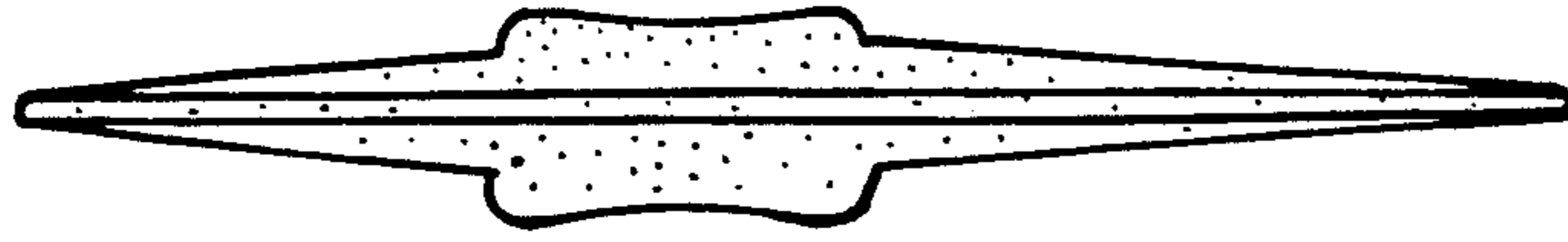

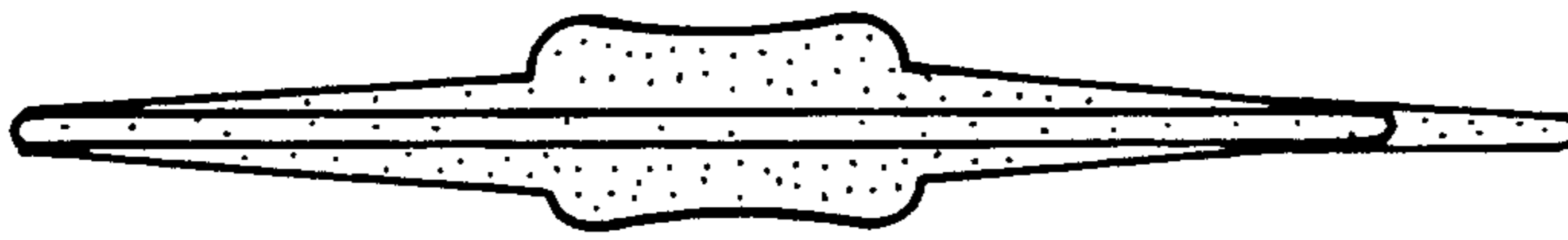
