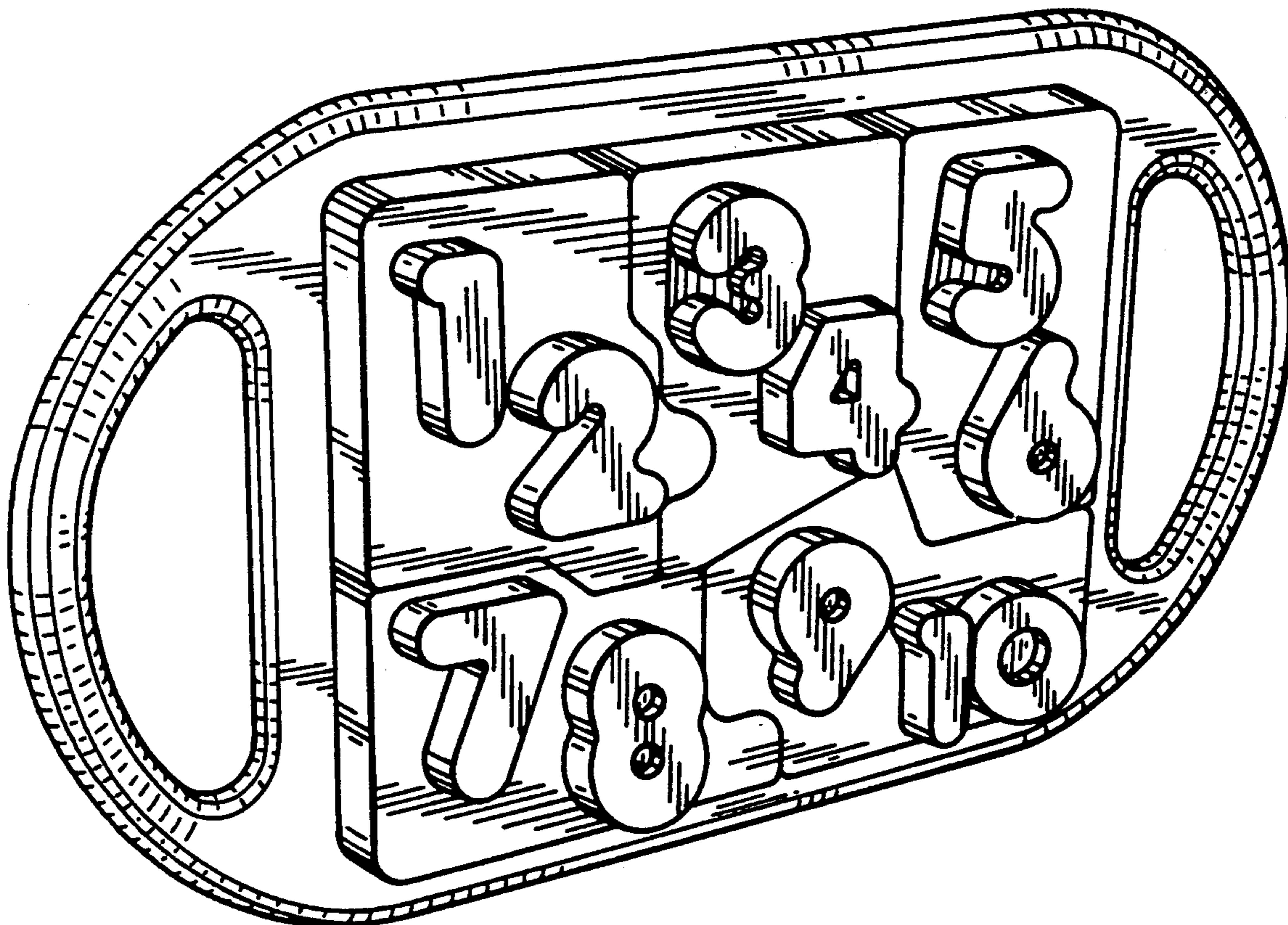

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a toy puzzle showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



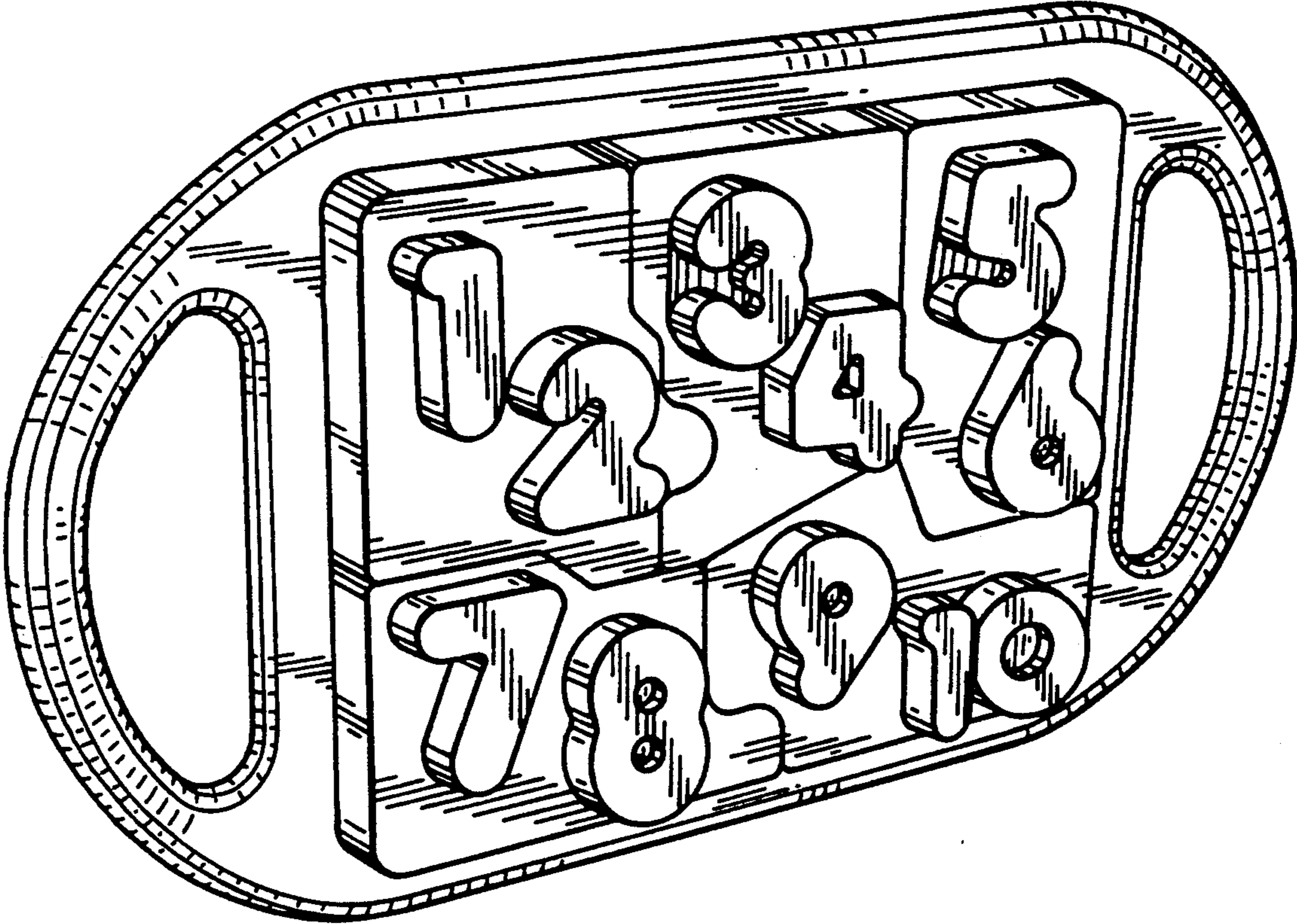

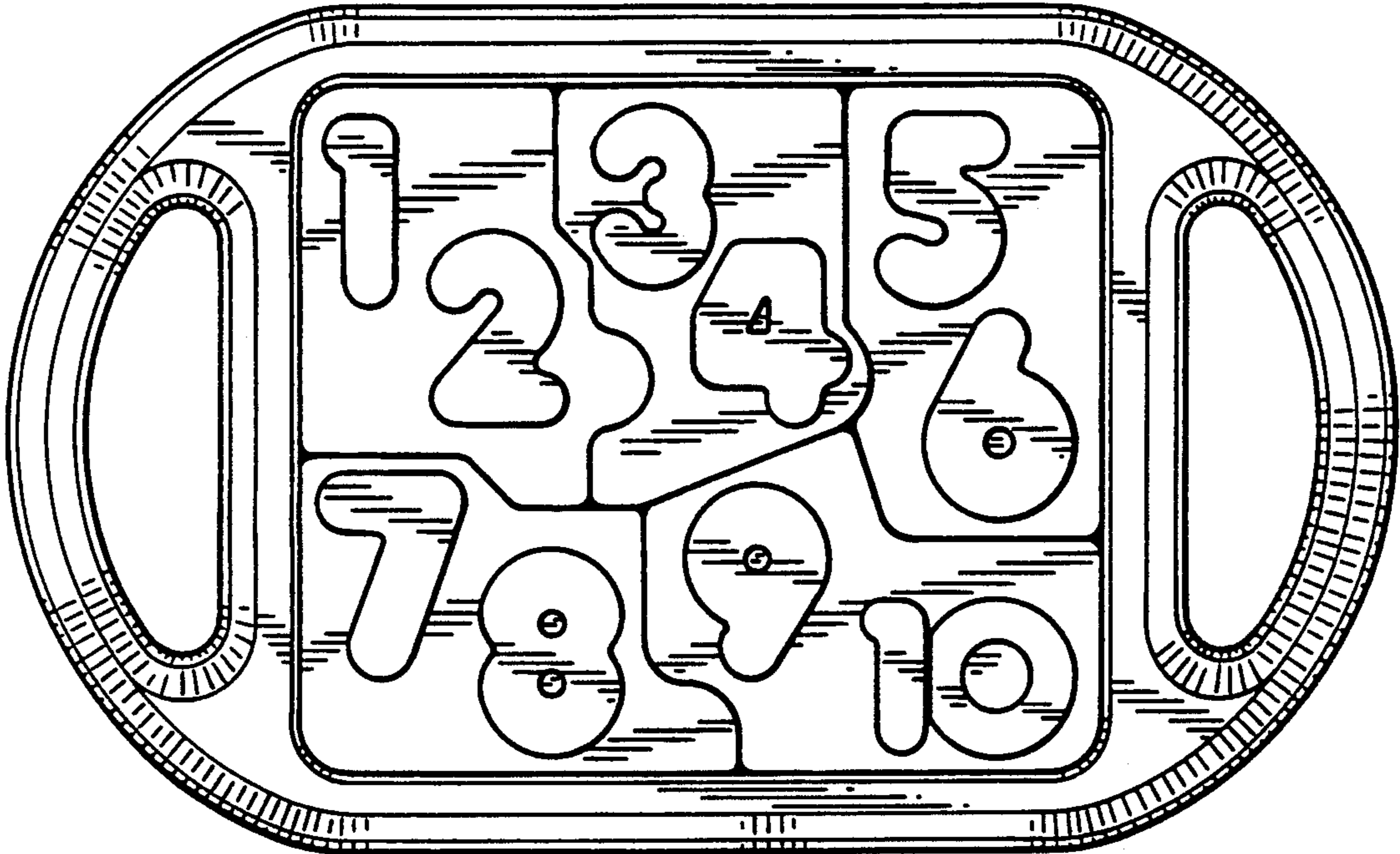

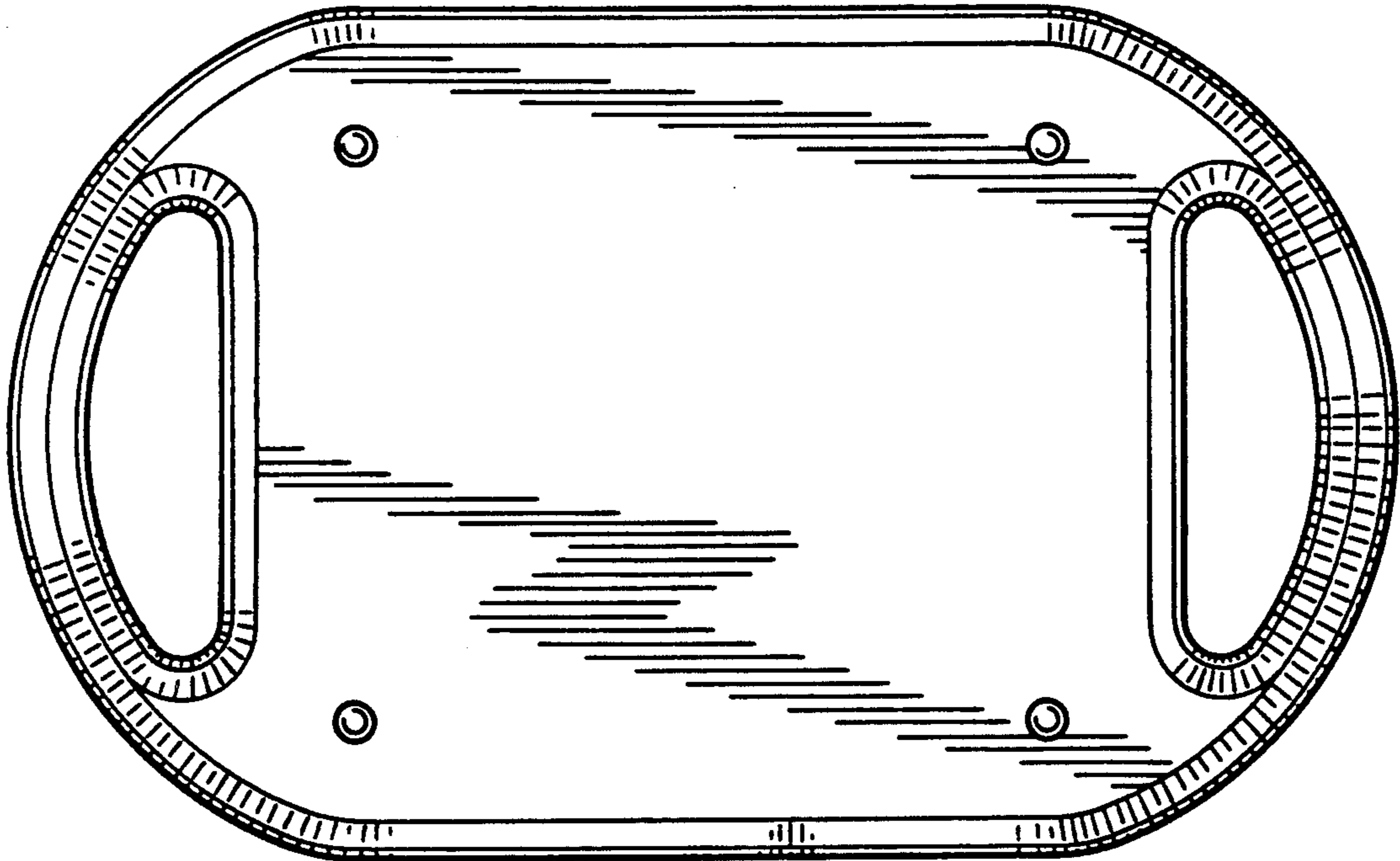

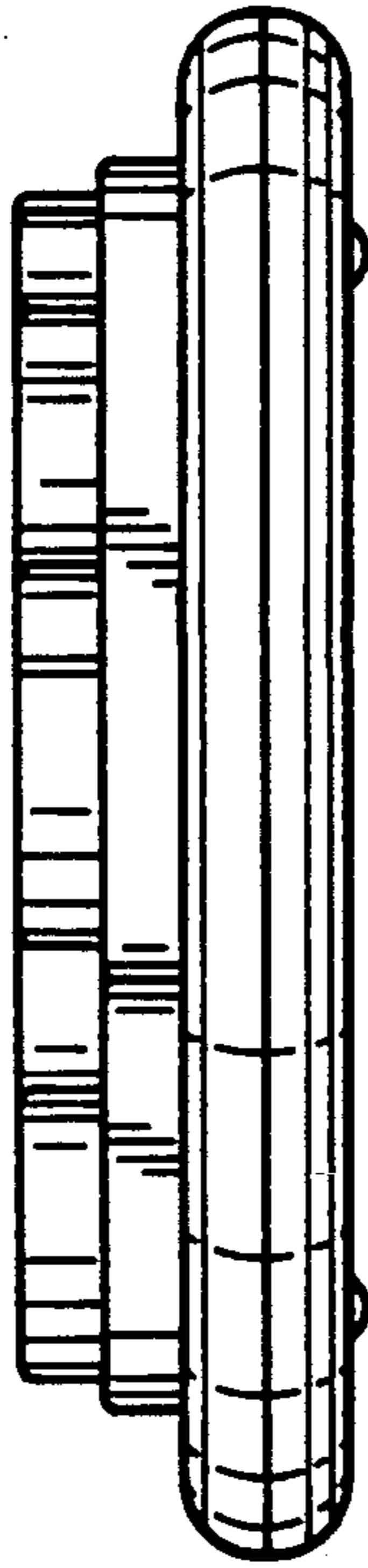

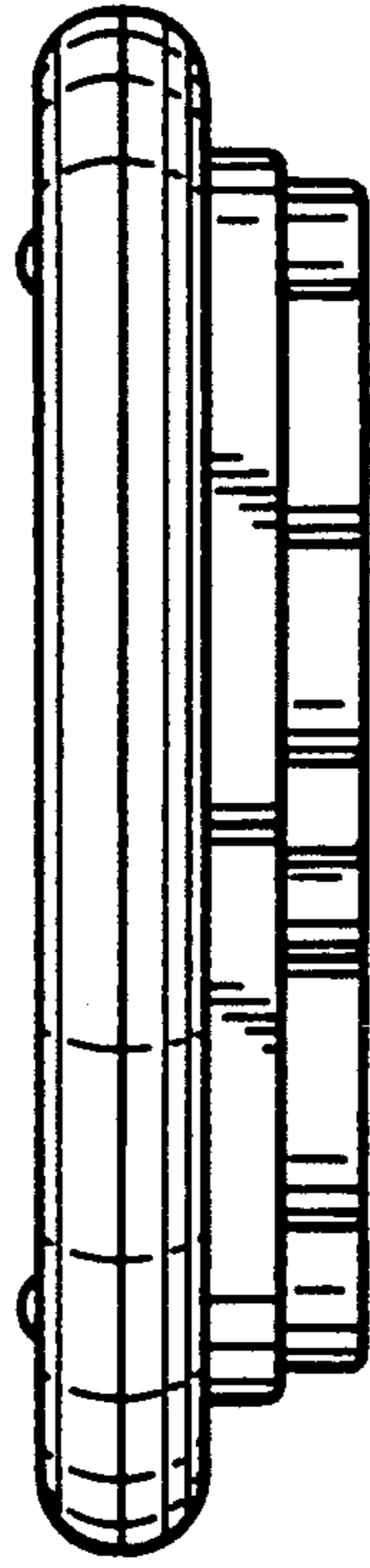

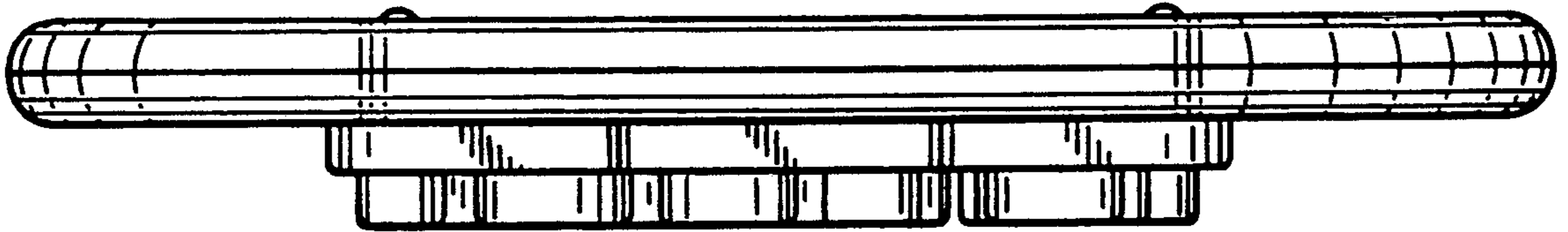

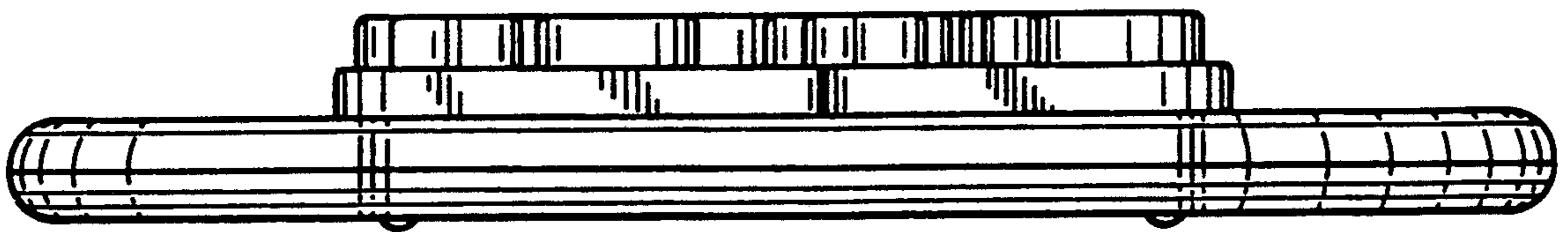
