The ornamental design for a surgical pin tip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a surgical pin tip showing our new design, the pin, one pin tip and leg being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the outer part thereof; FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the inner part thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the inner part thereof.

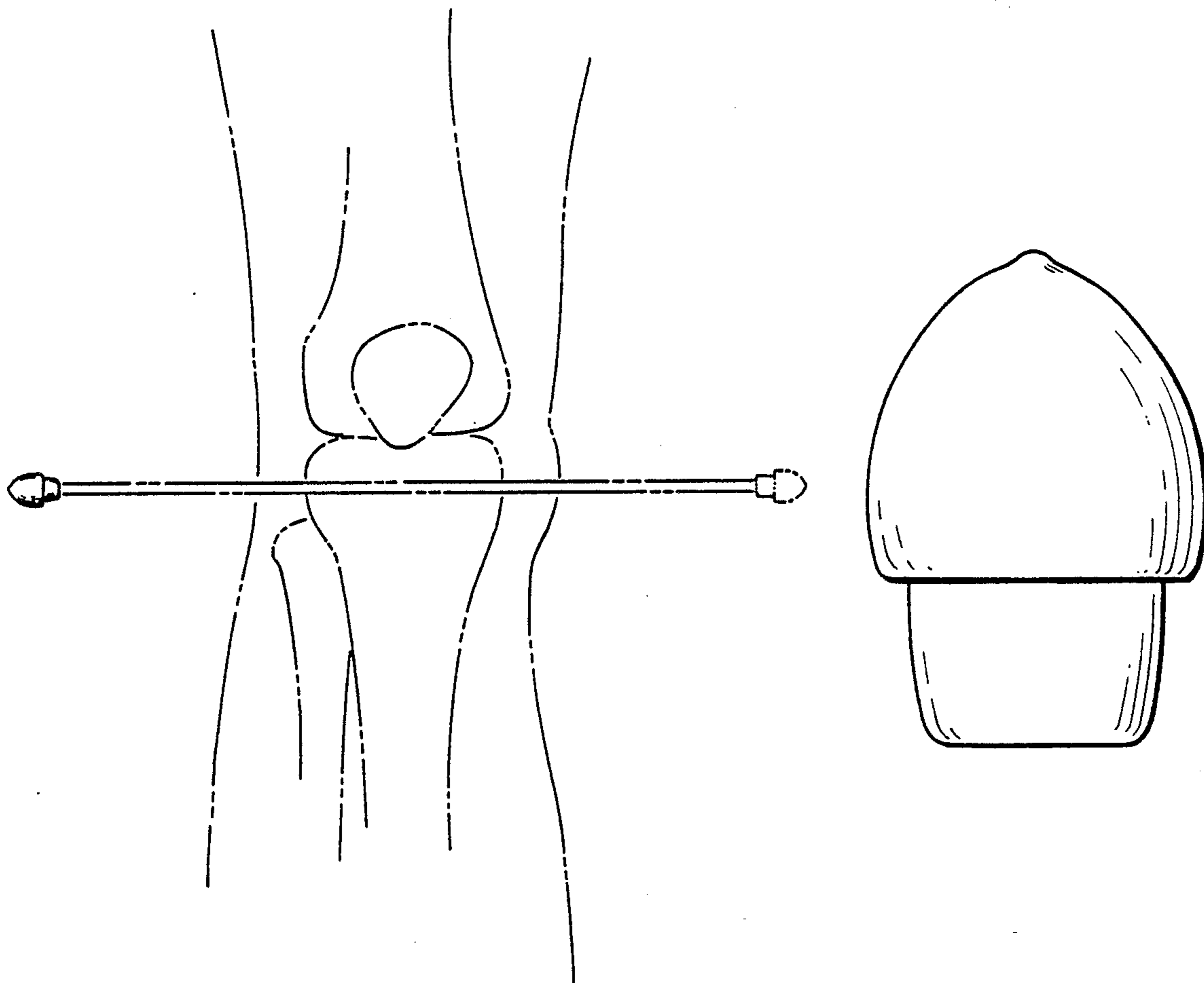

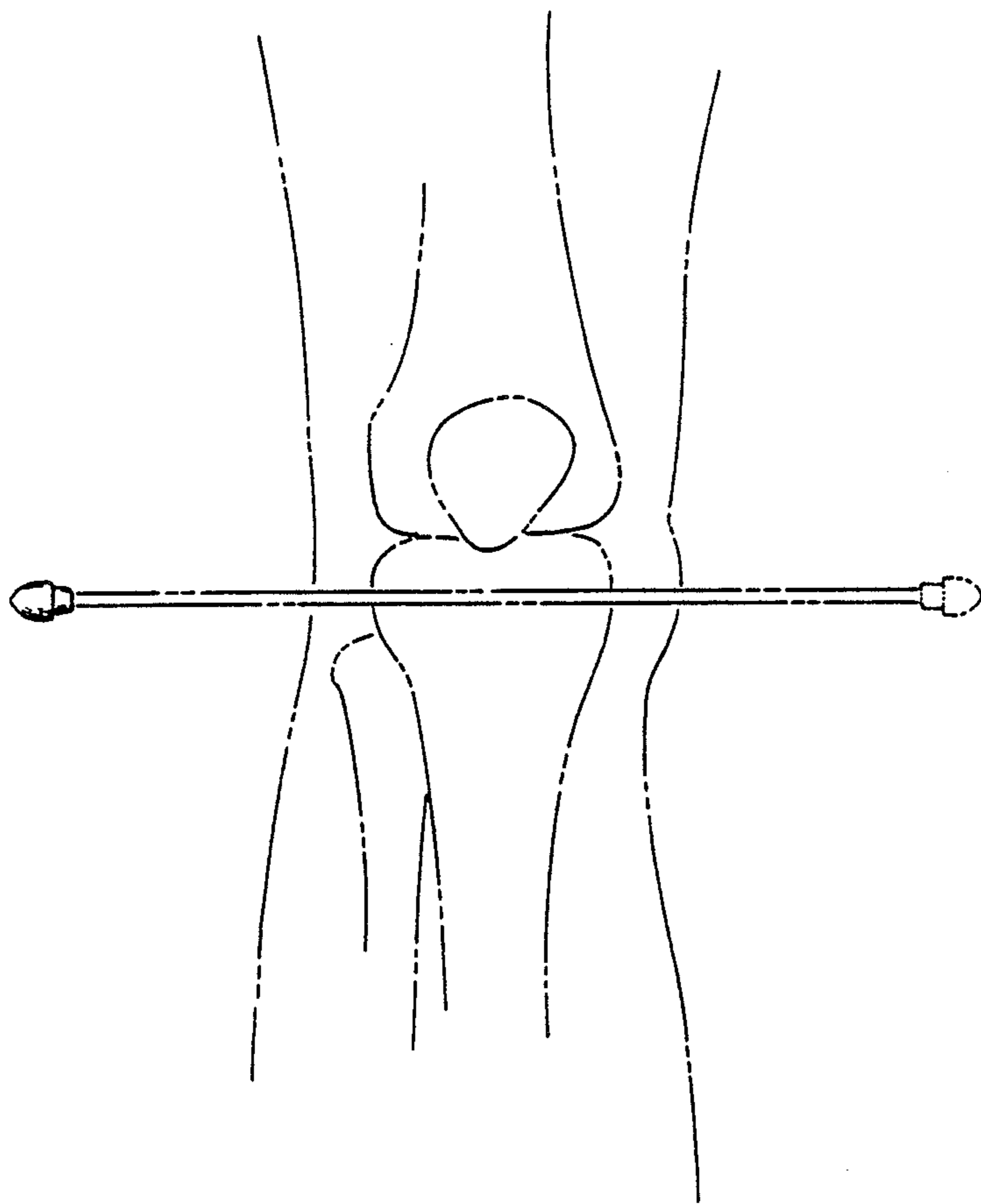

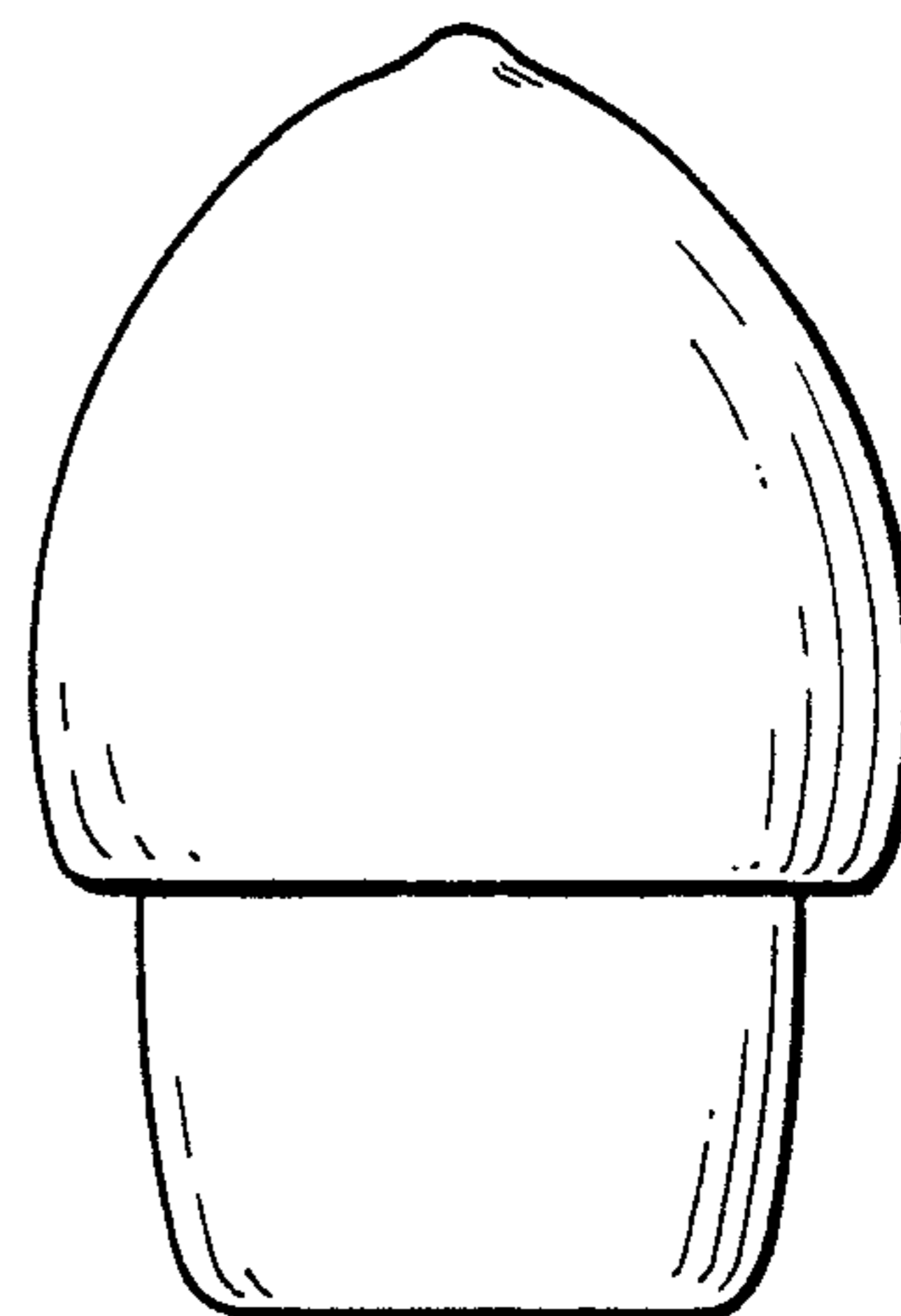

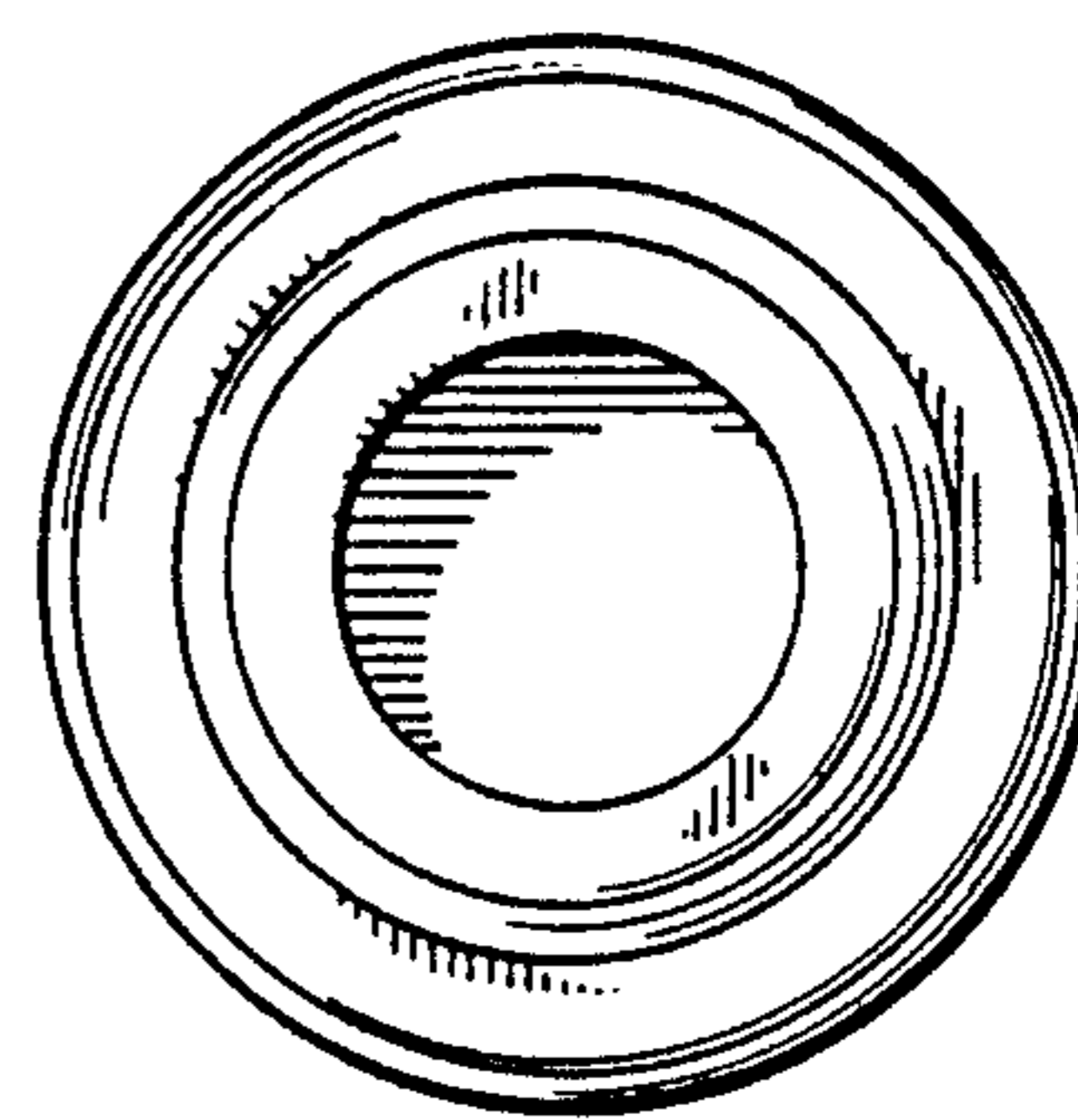

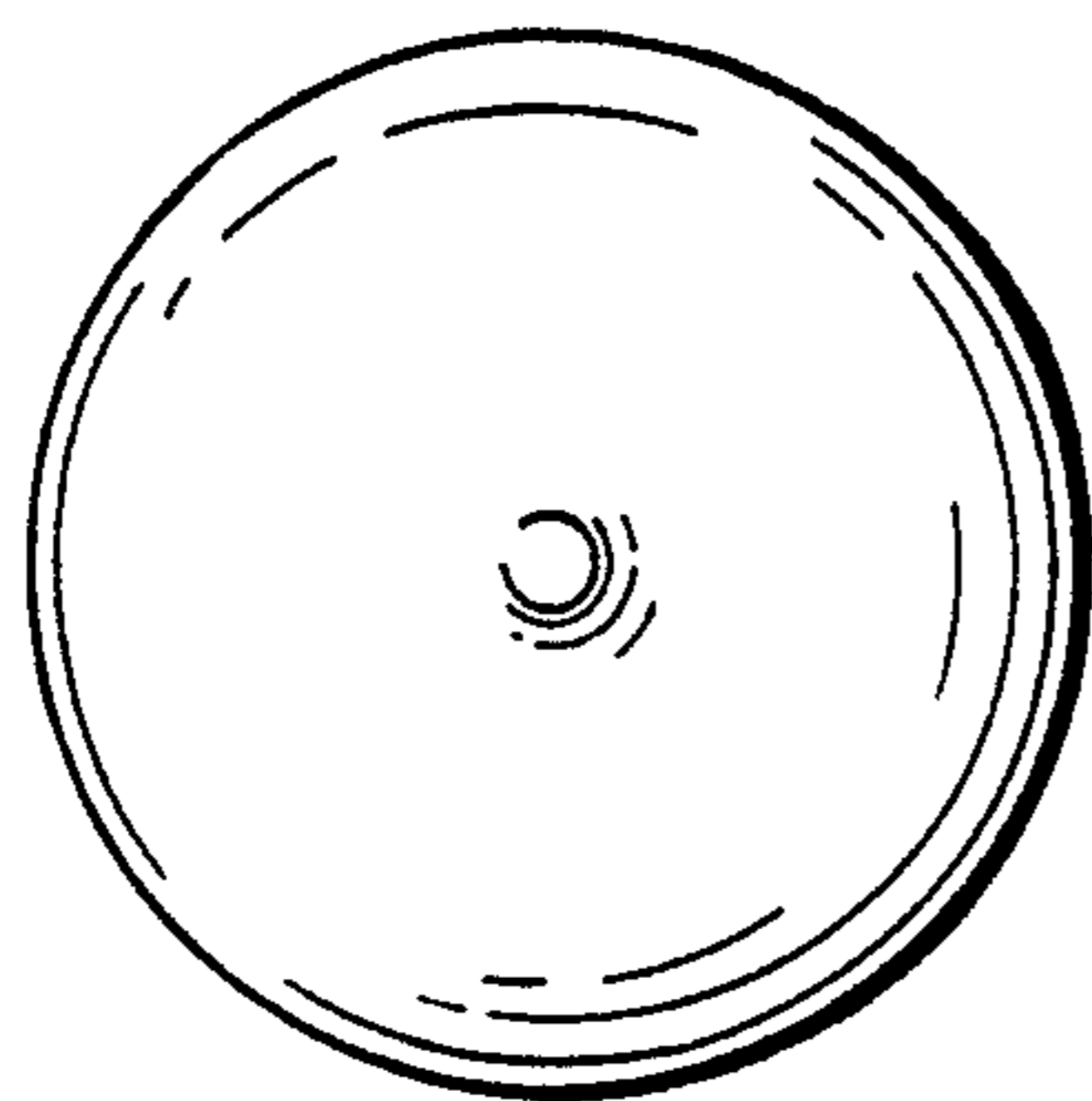

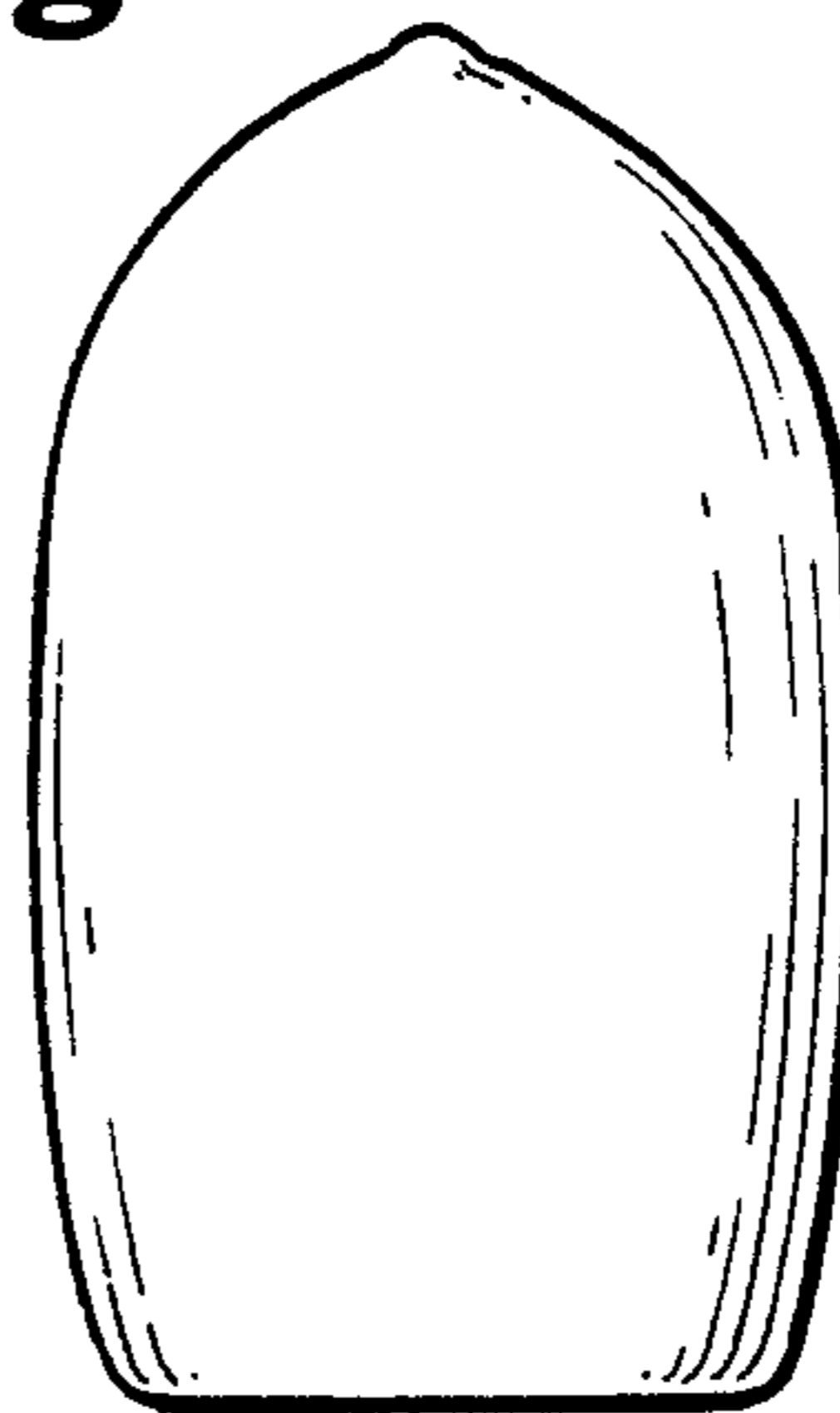

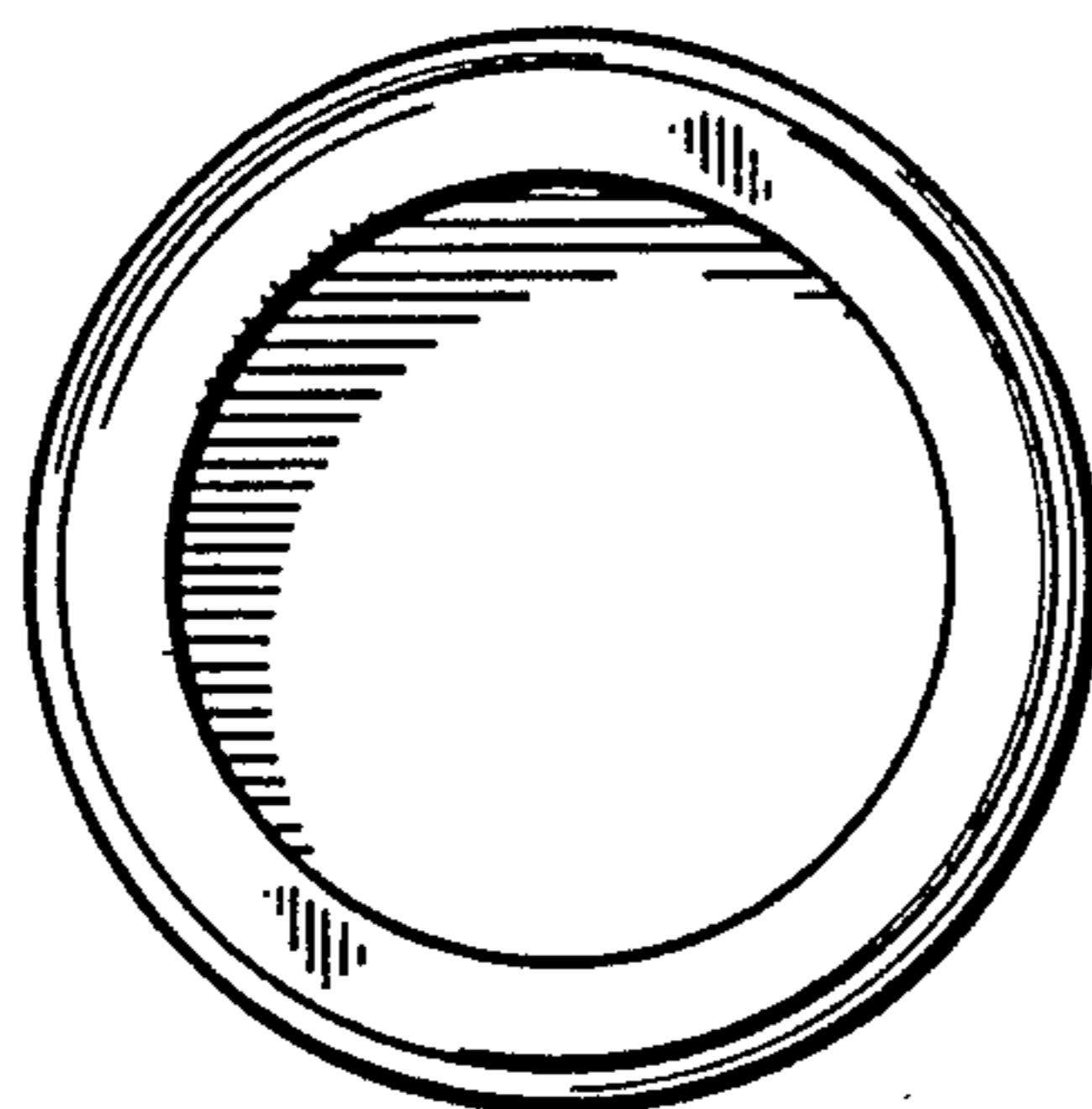
