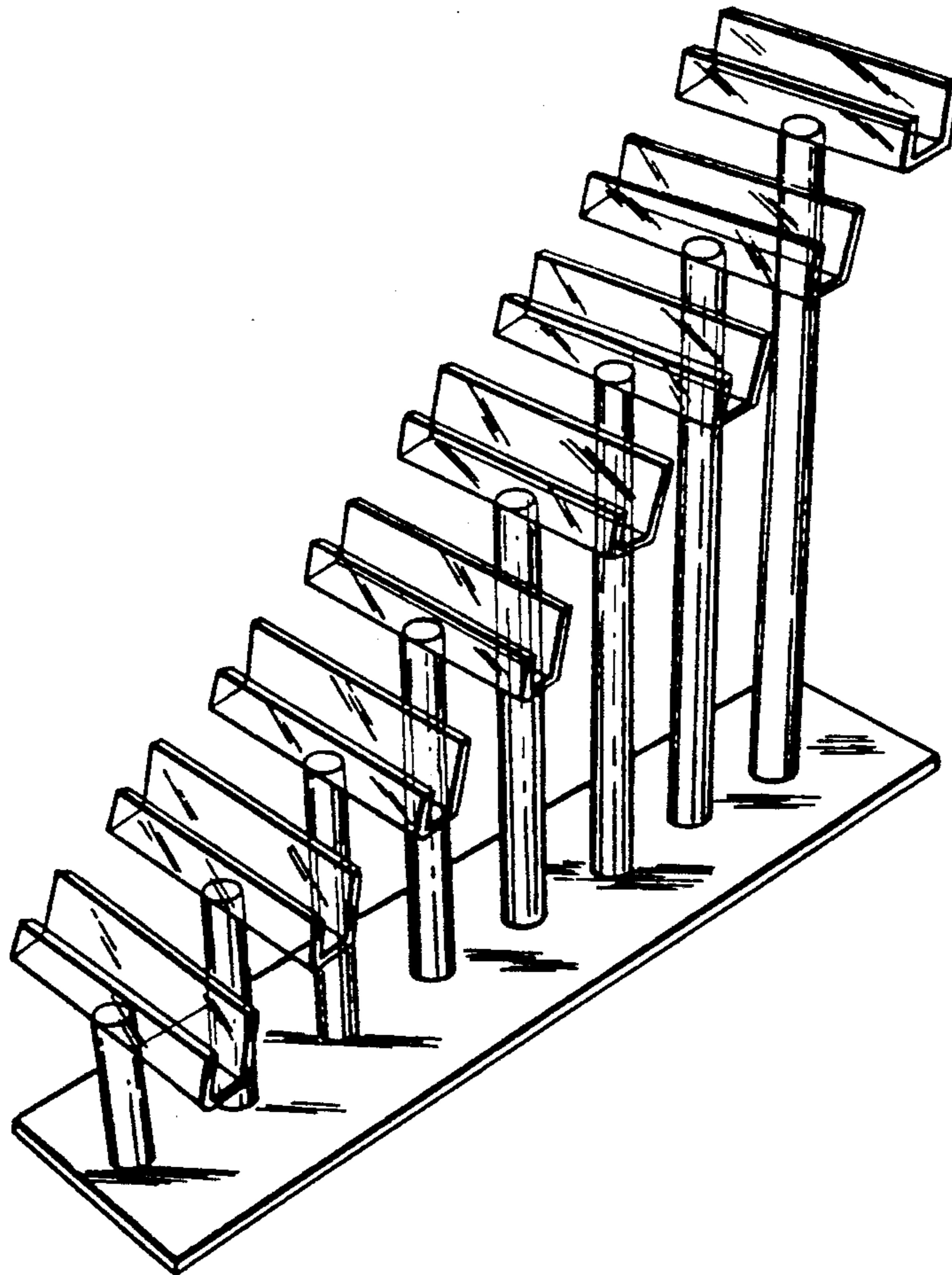

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an eyeglass display rack, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;
 FIGS. 2-6 have been drawn on a reduced scale with respect to FIG. 1.



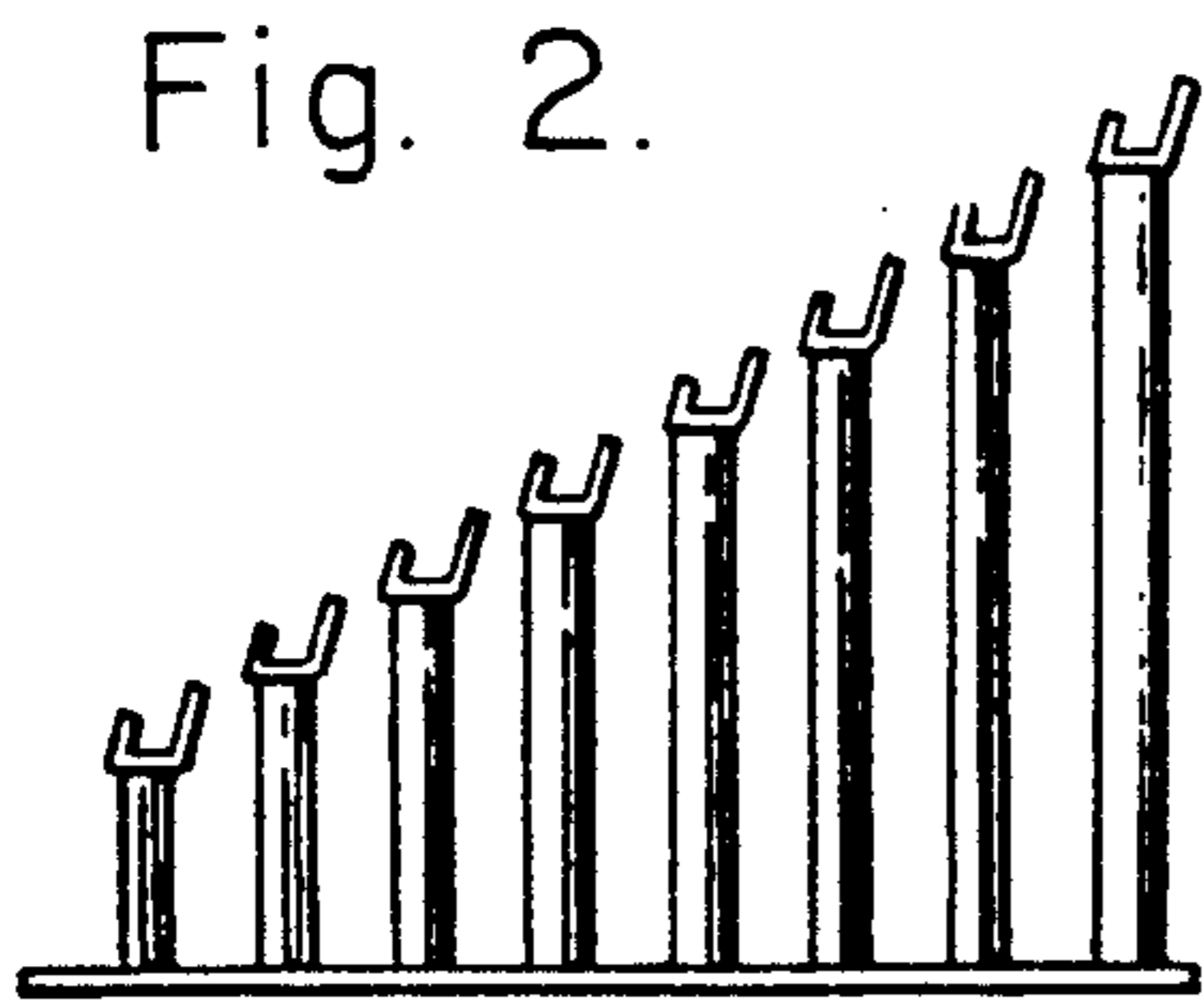
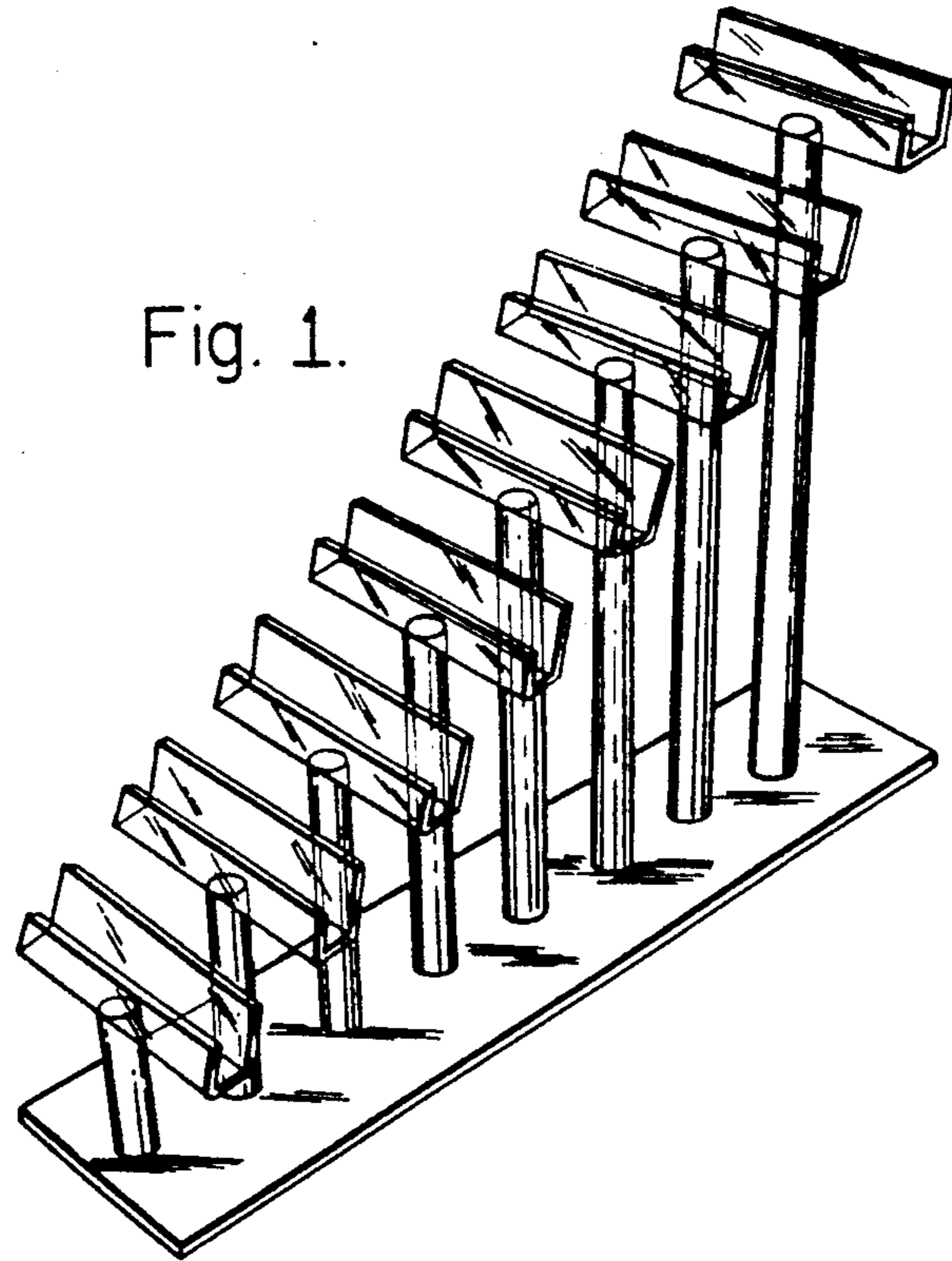

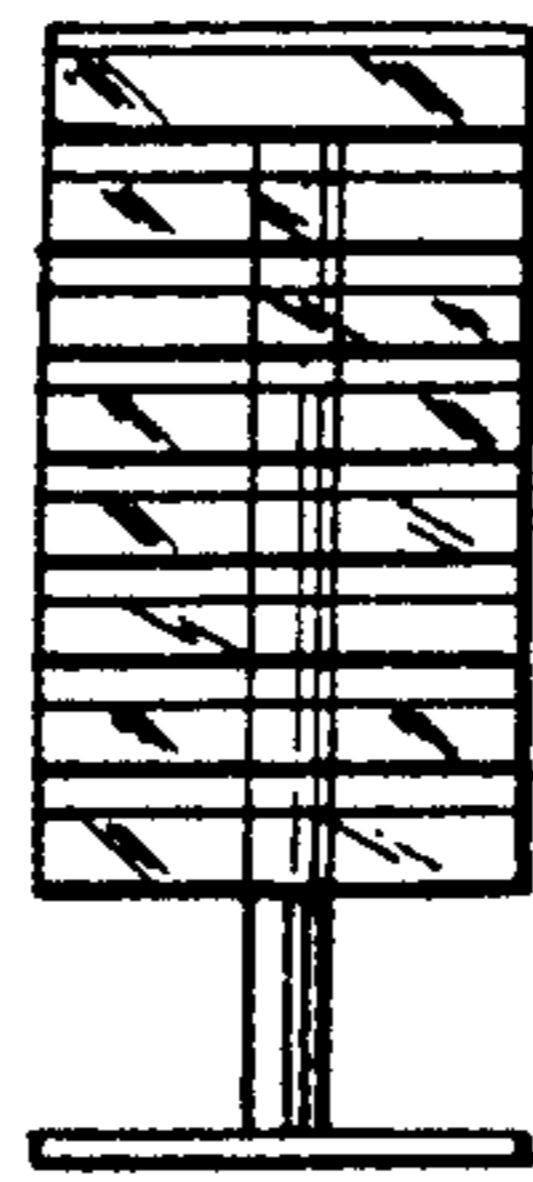

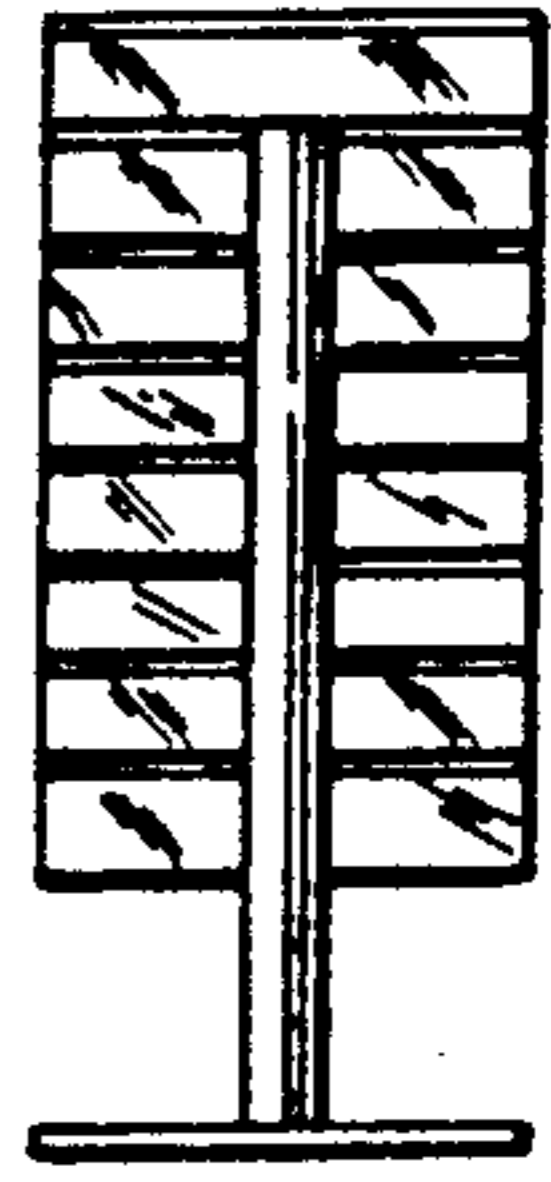
