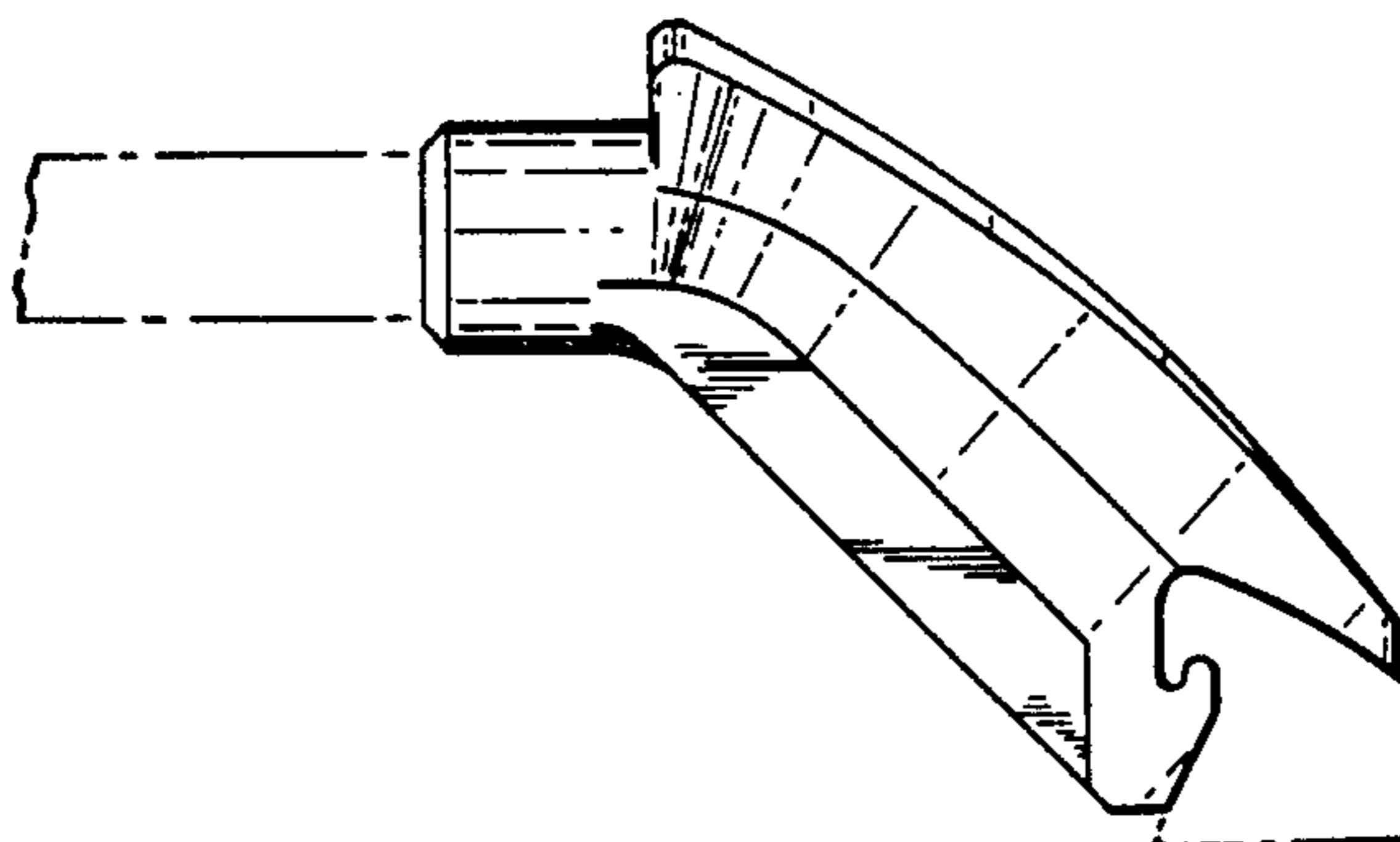
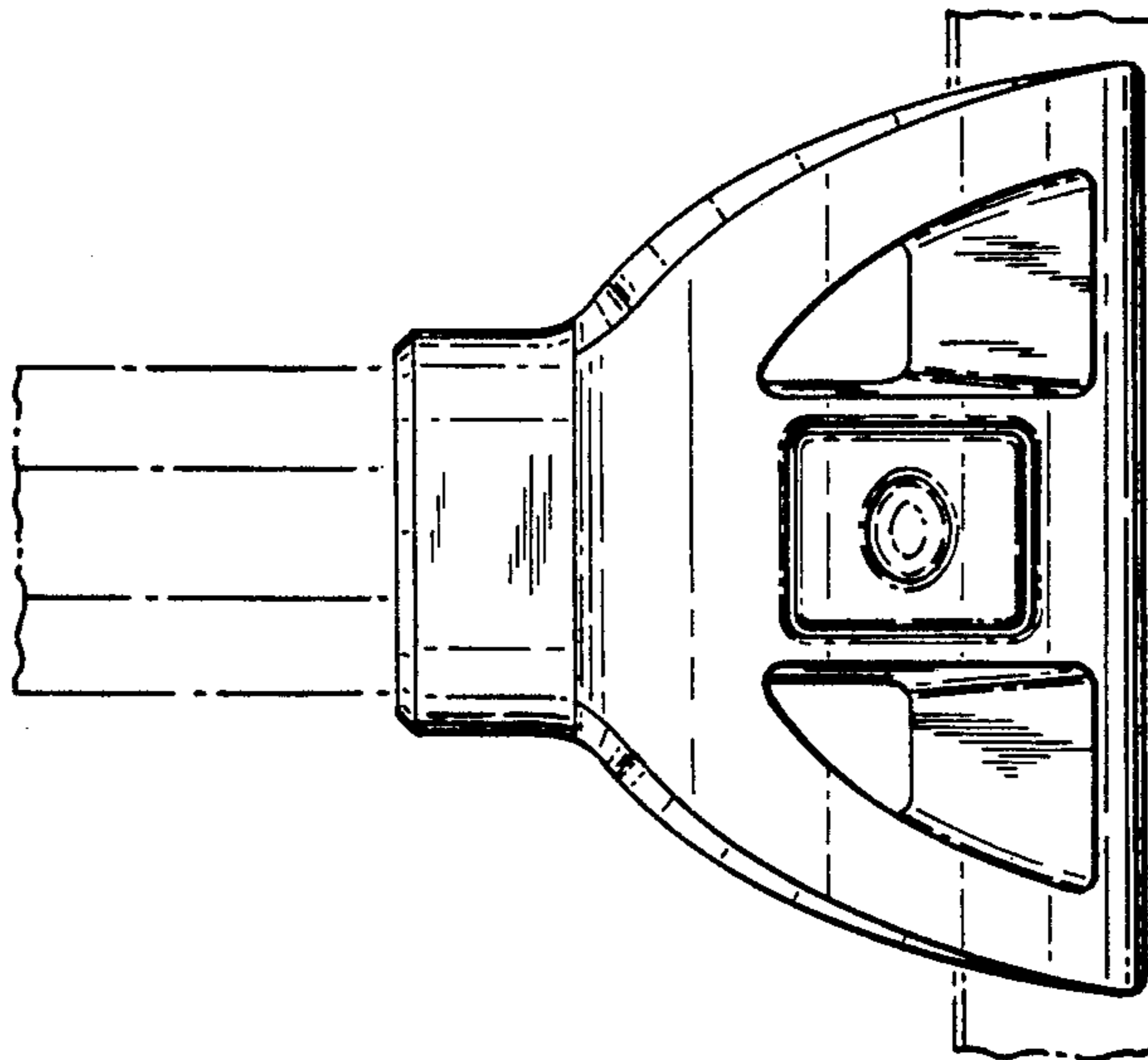

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a crossbar support for an article carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a crossbar support for an article carrier showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



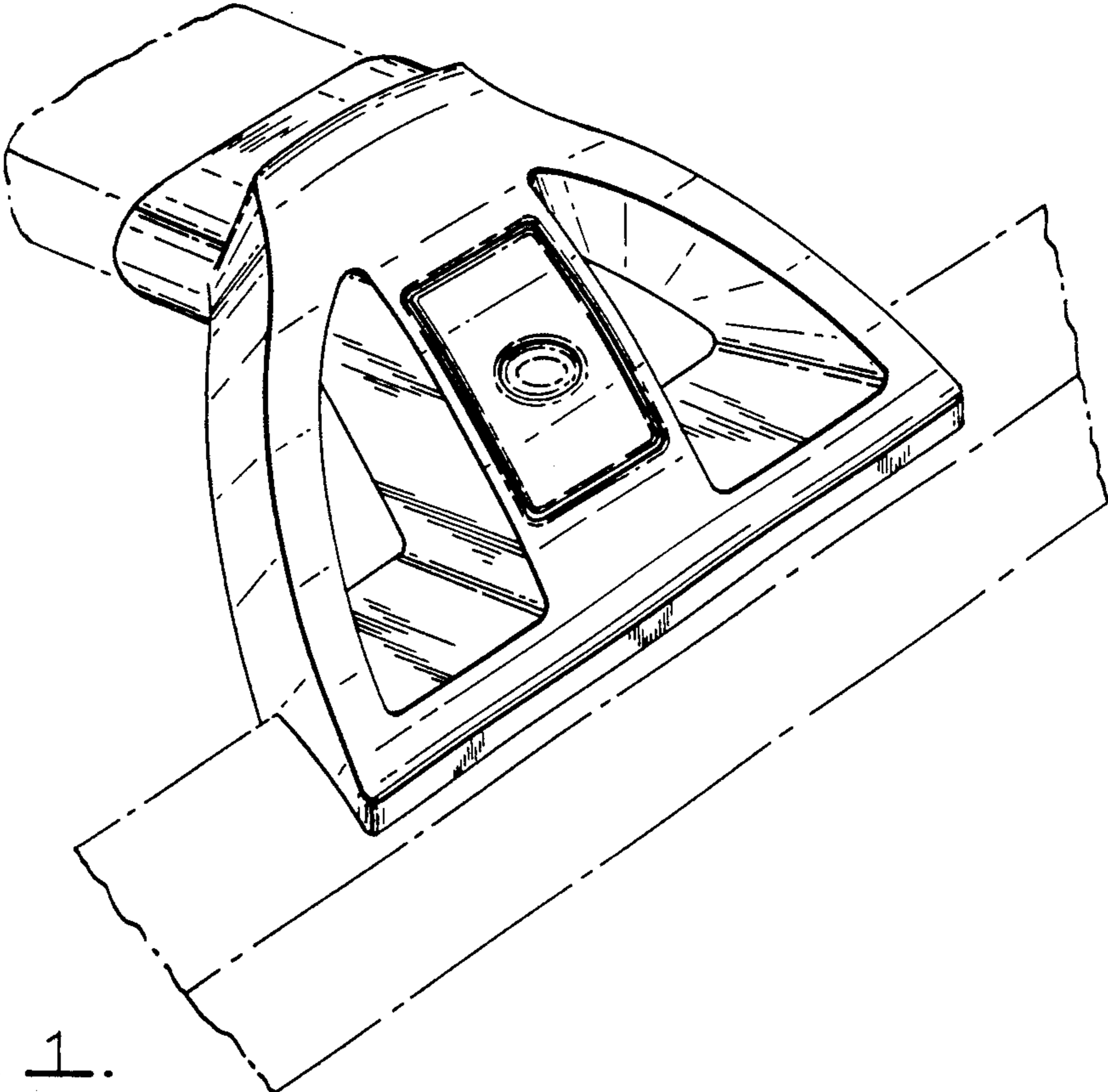

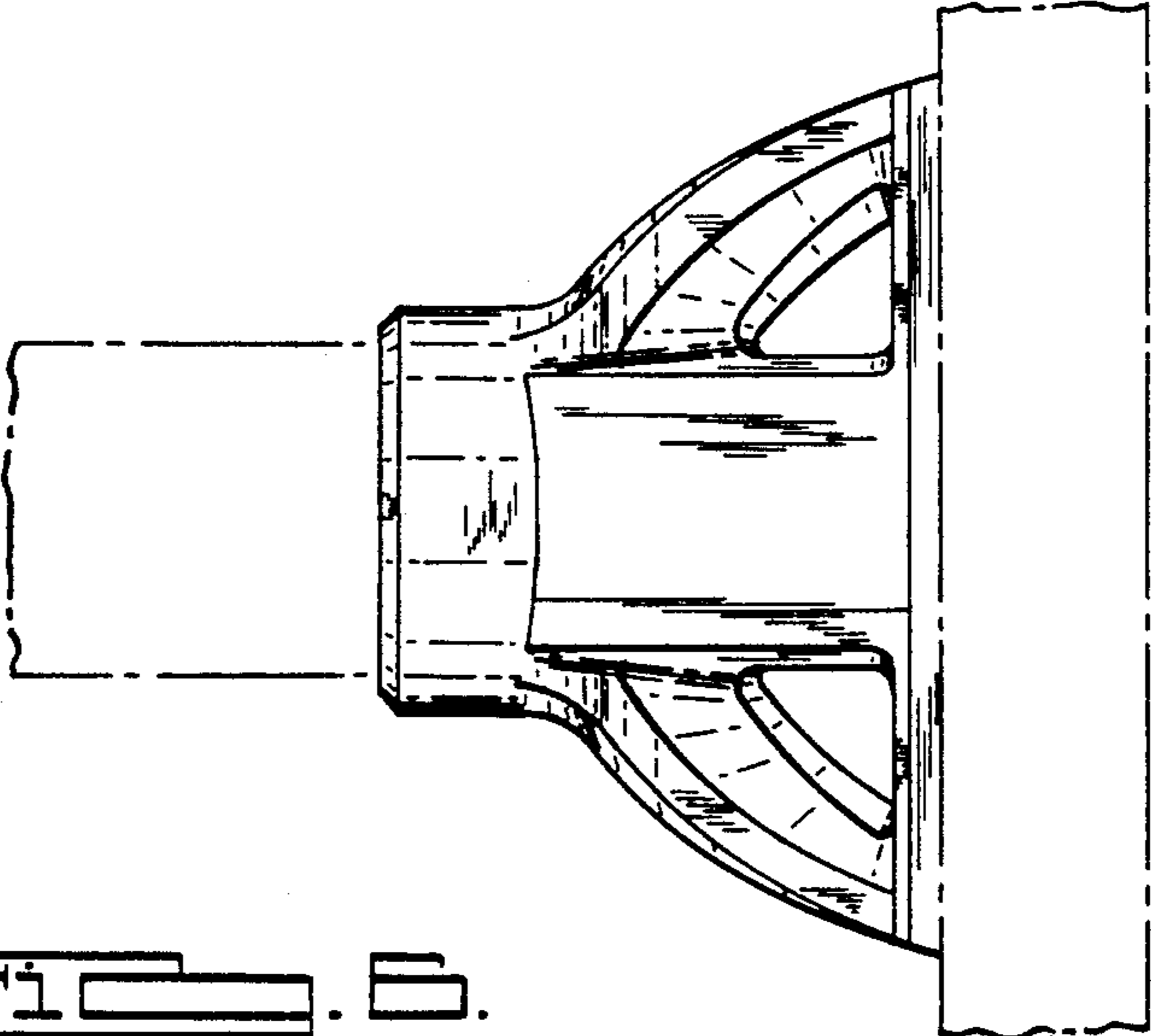
