[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a data converter for digital communication with a telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front left side perspective view of a data converter for digital communication with a telephone showing my new design, the telephone handset being removed and shown inverted;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

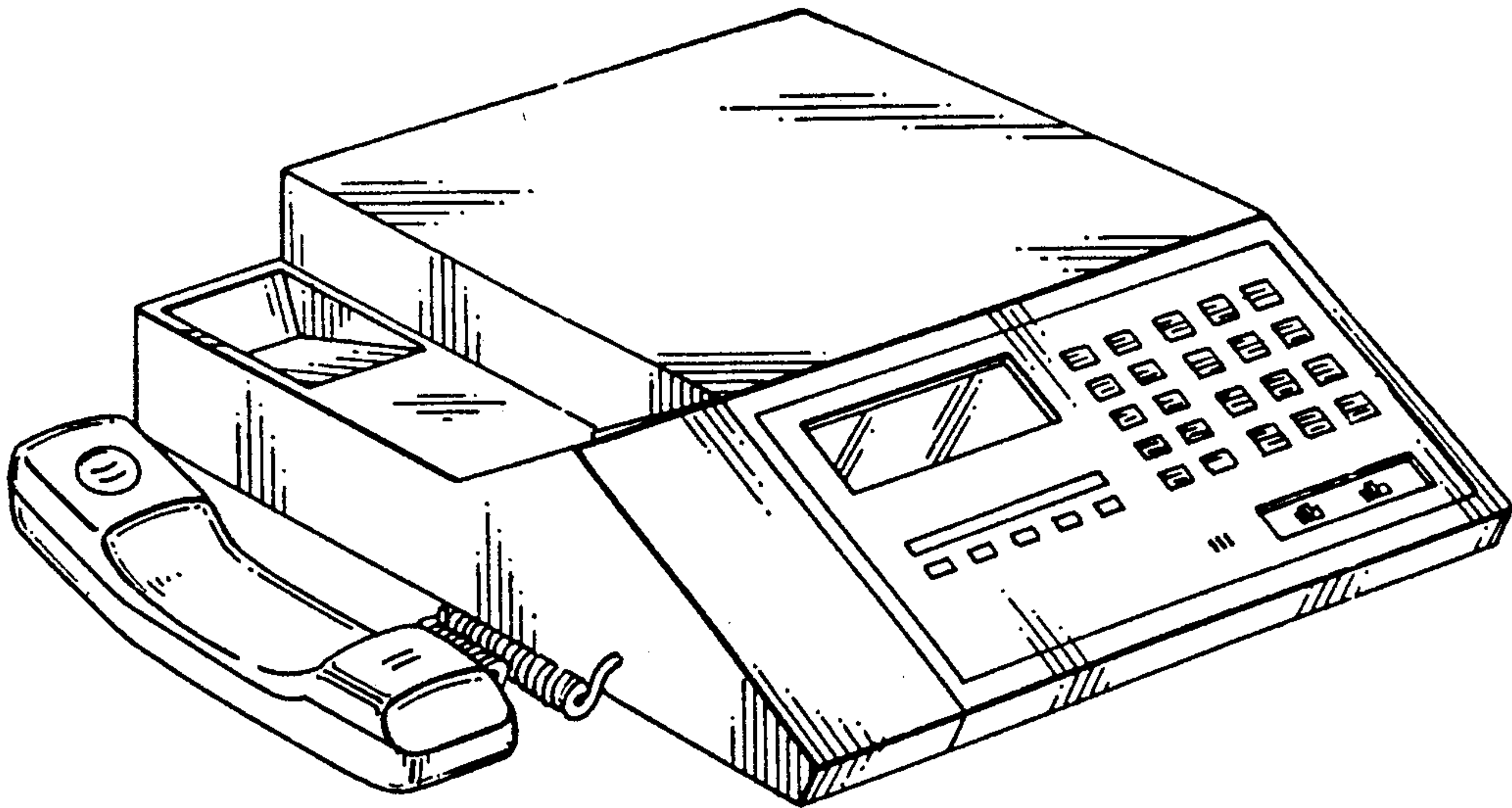

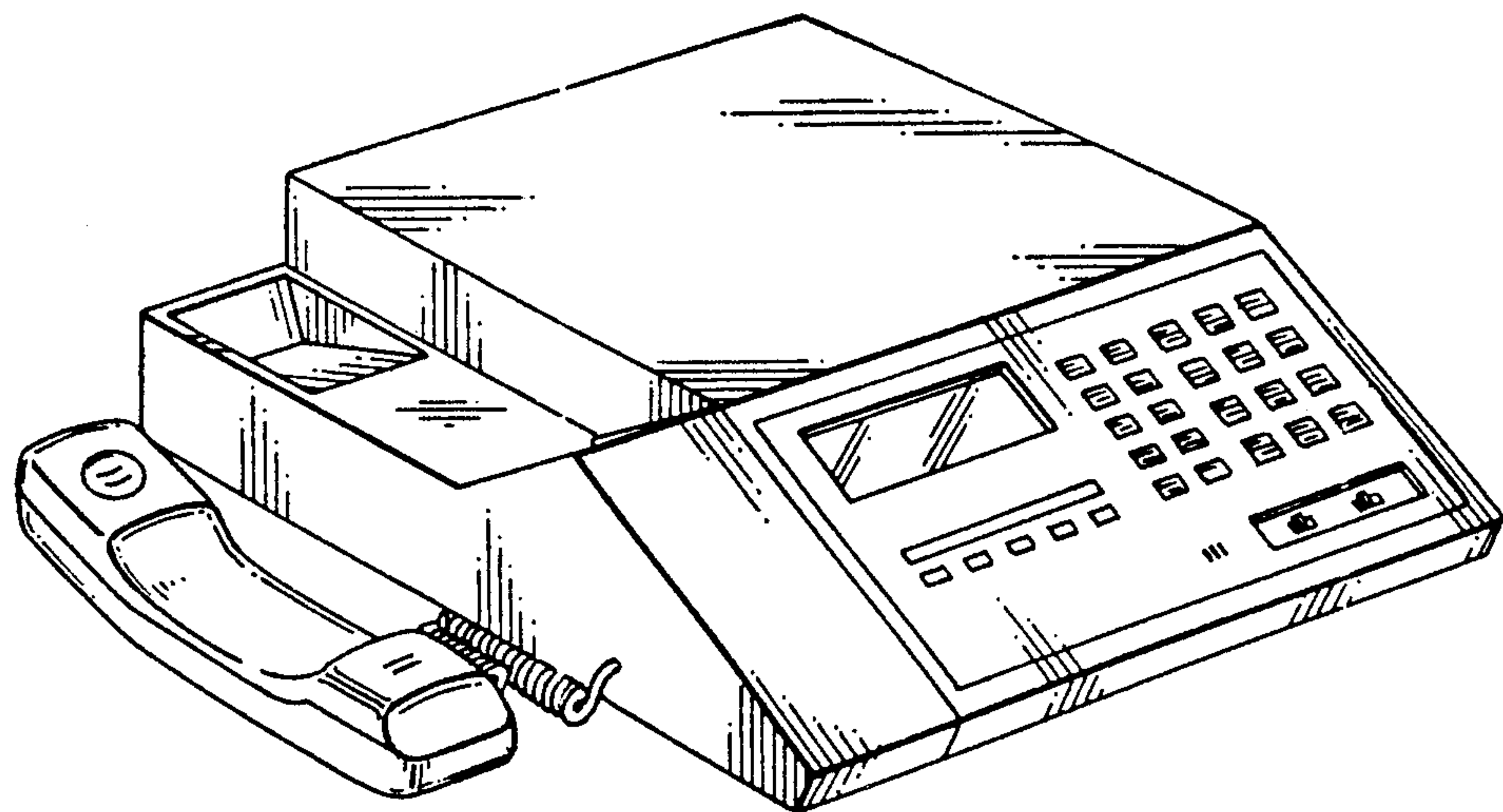

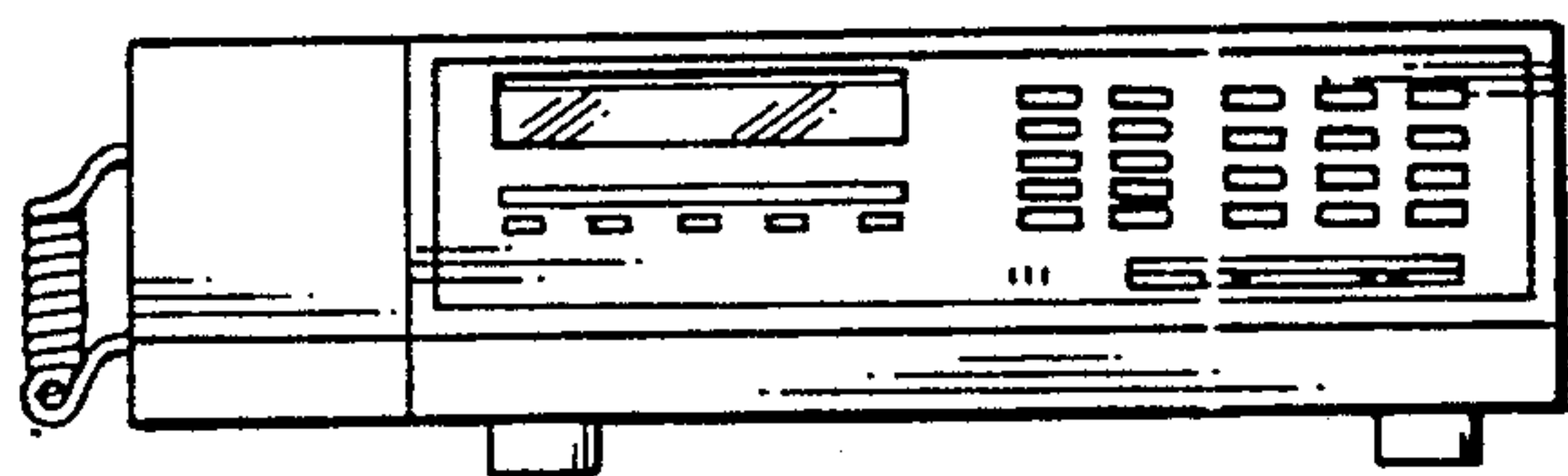

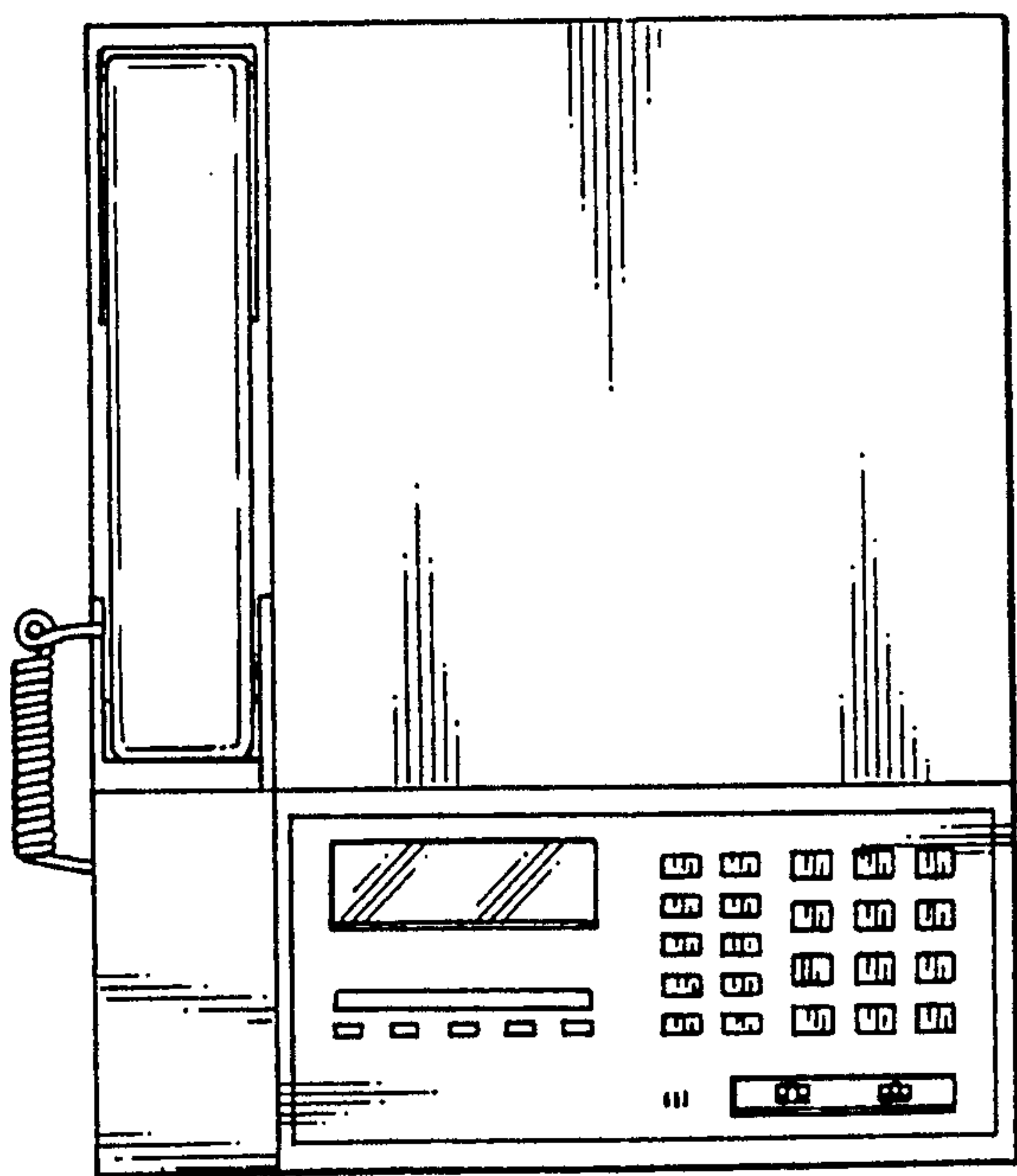

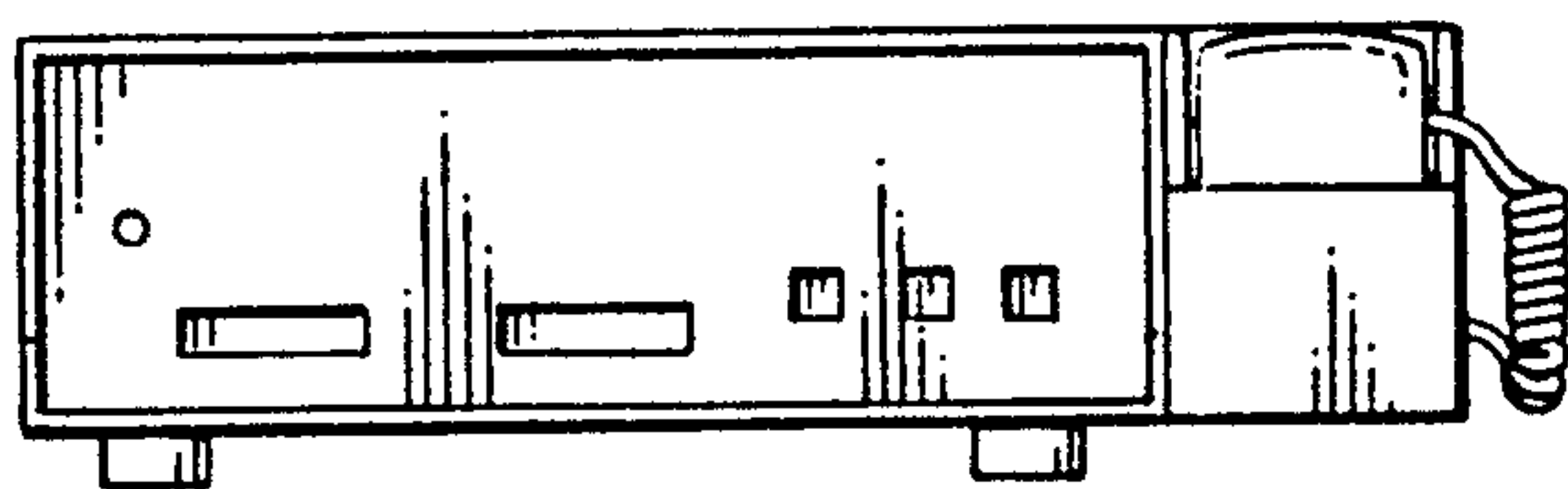

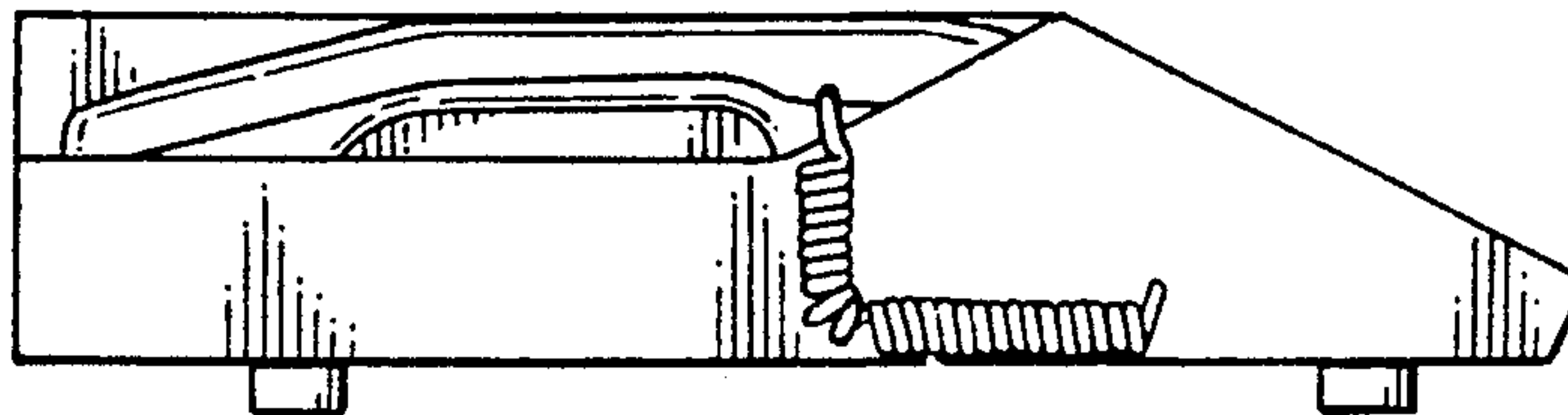

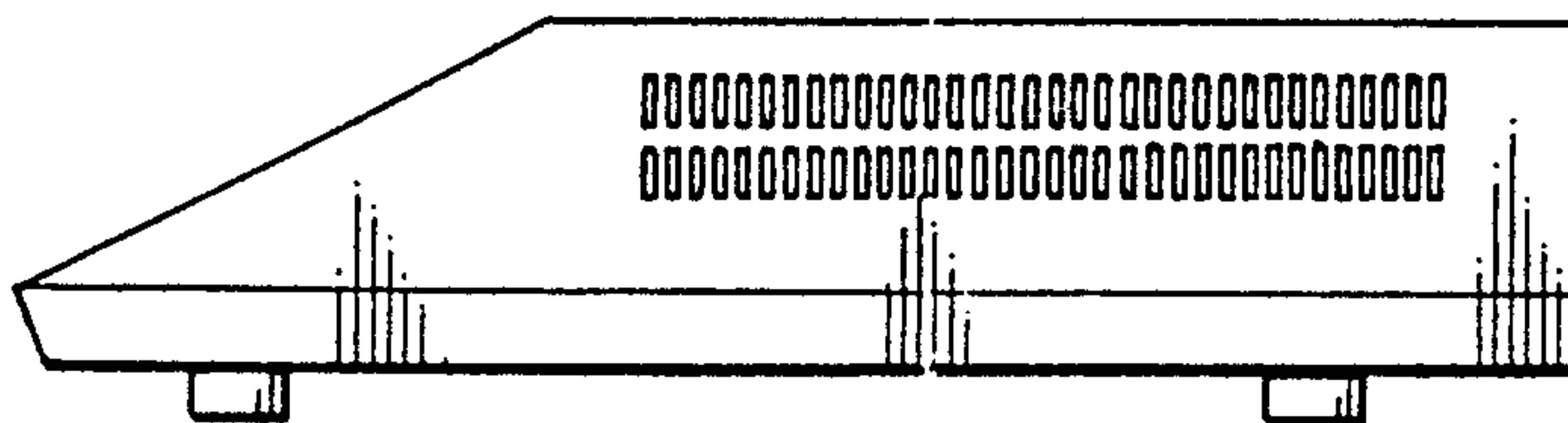
