

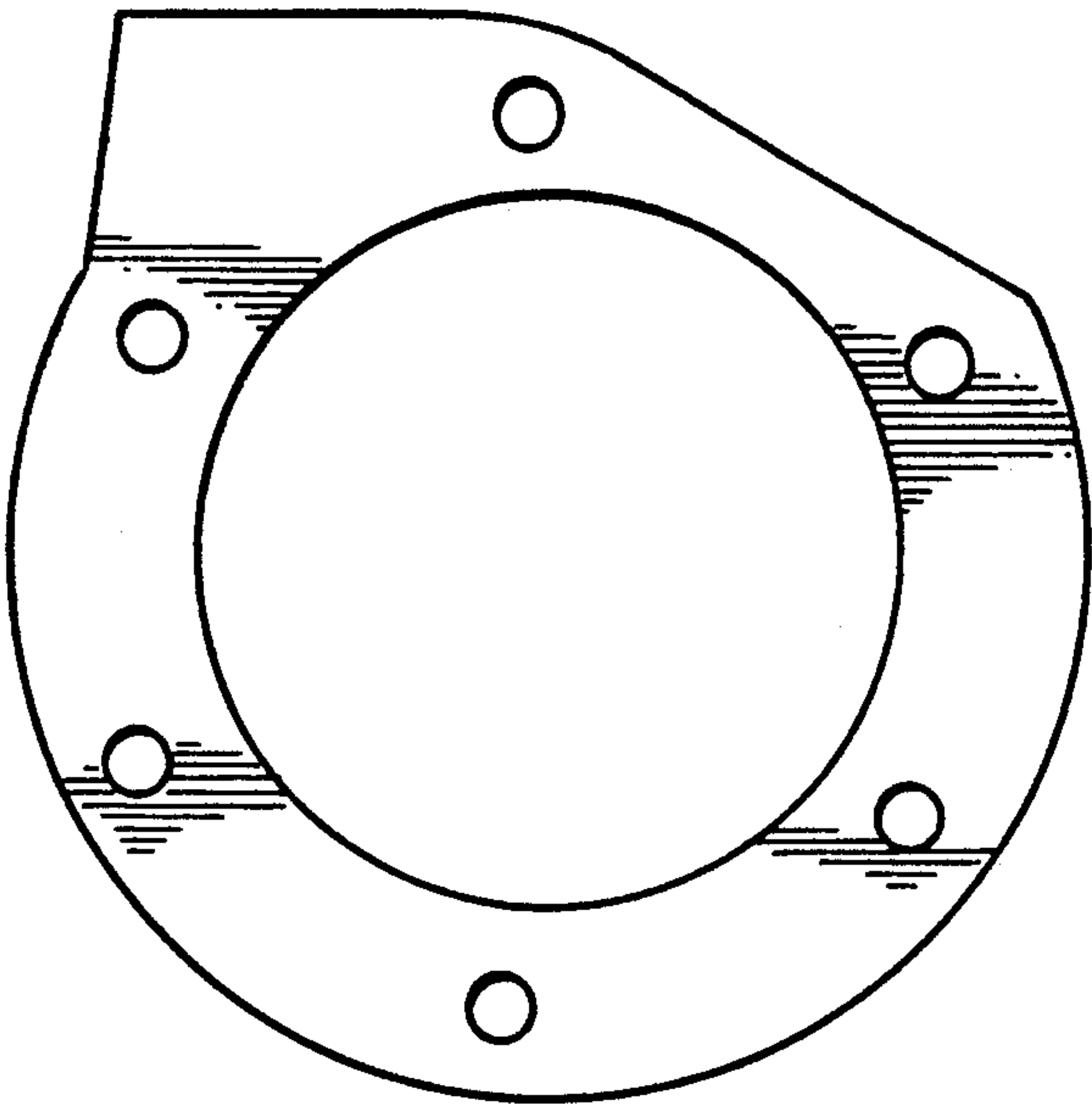

DESCRIPTION

differential showing my new design, the rear being a

scale.



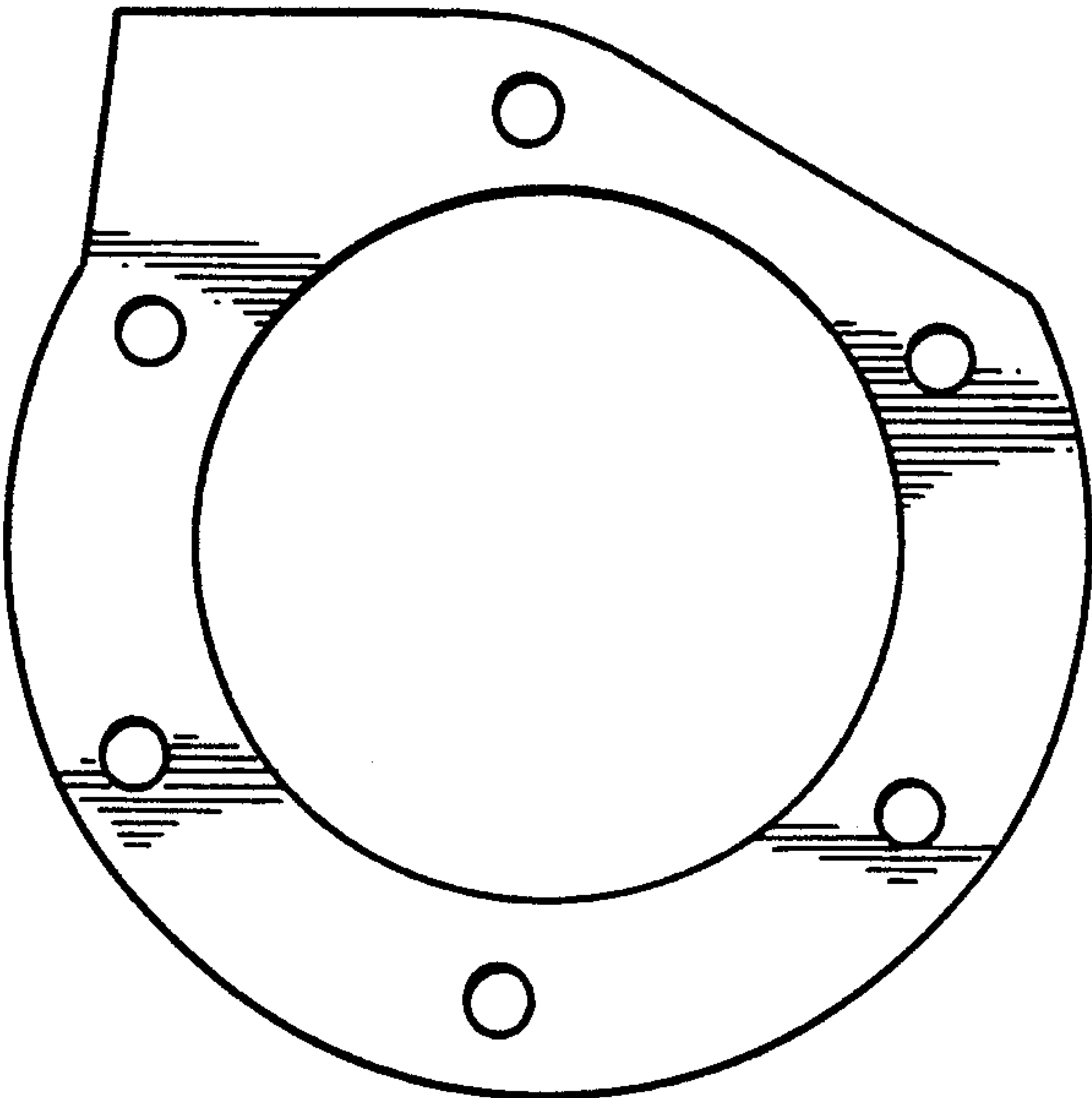

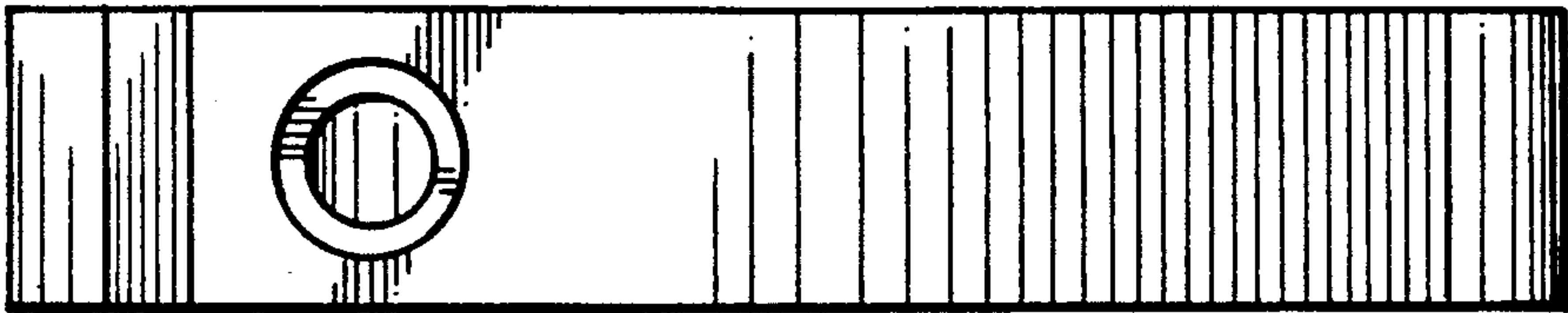

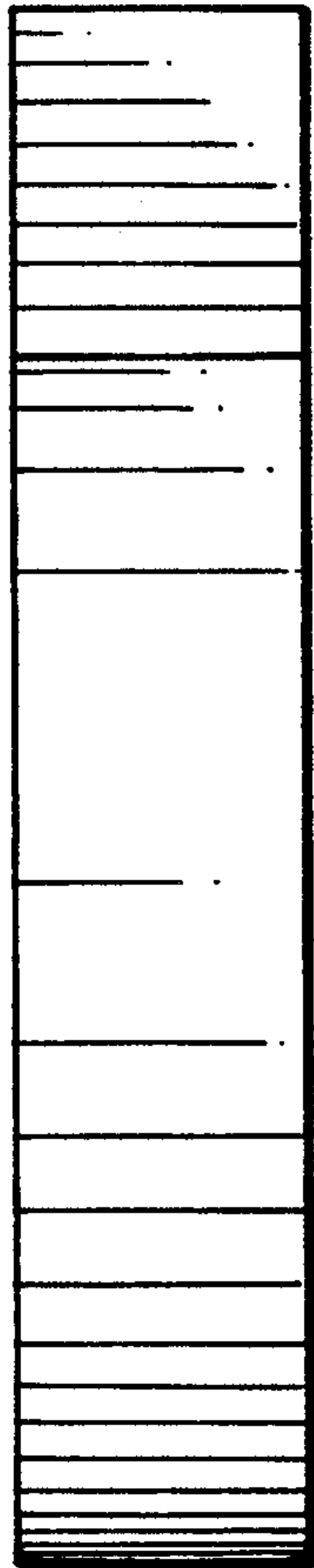

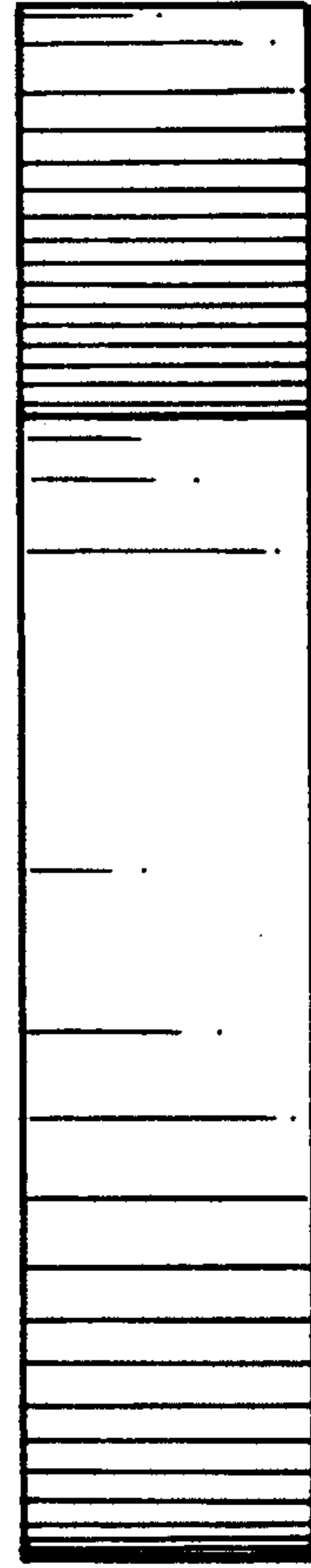

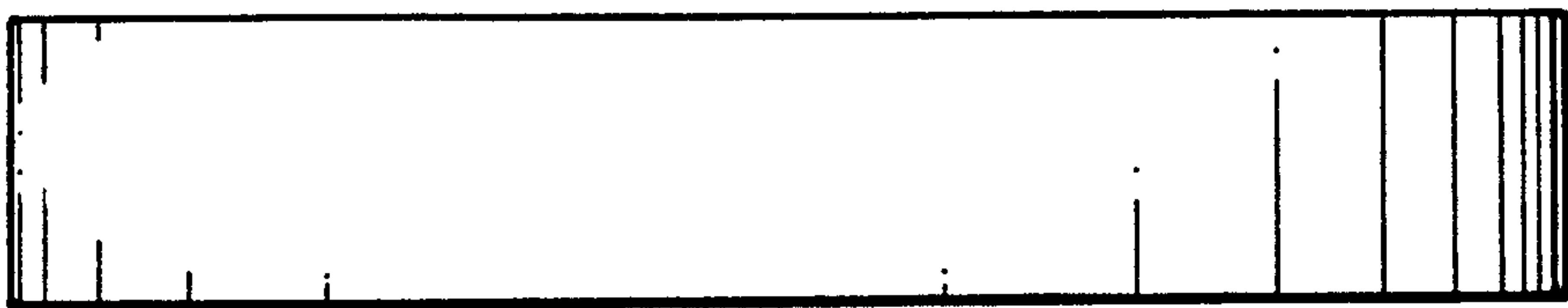
