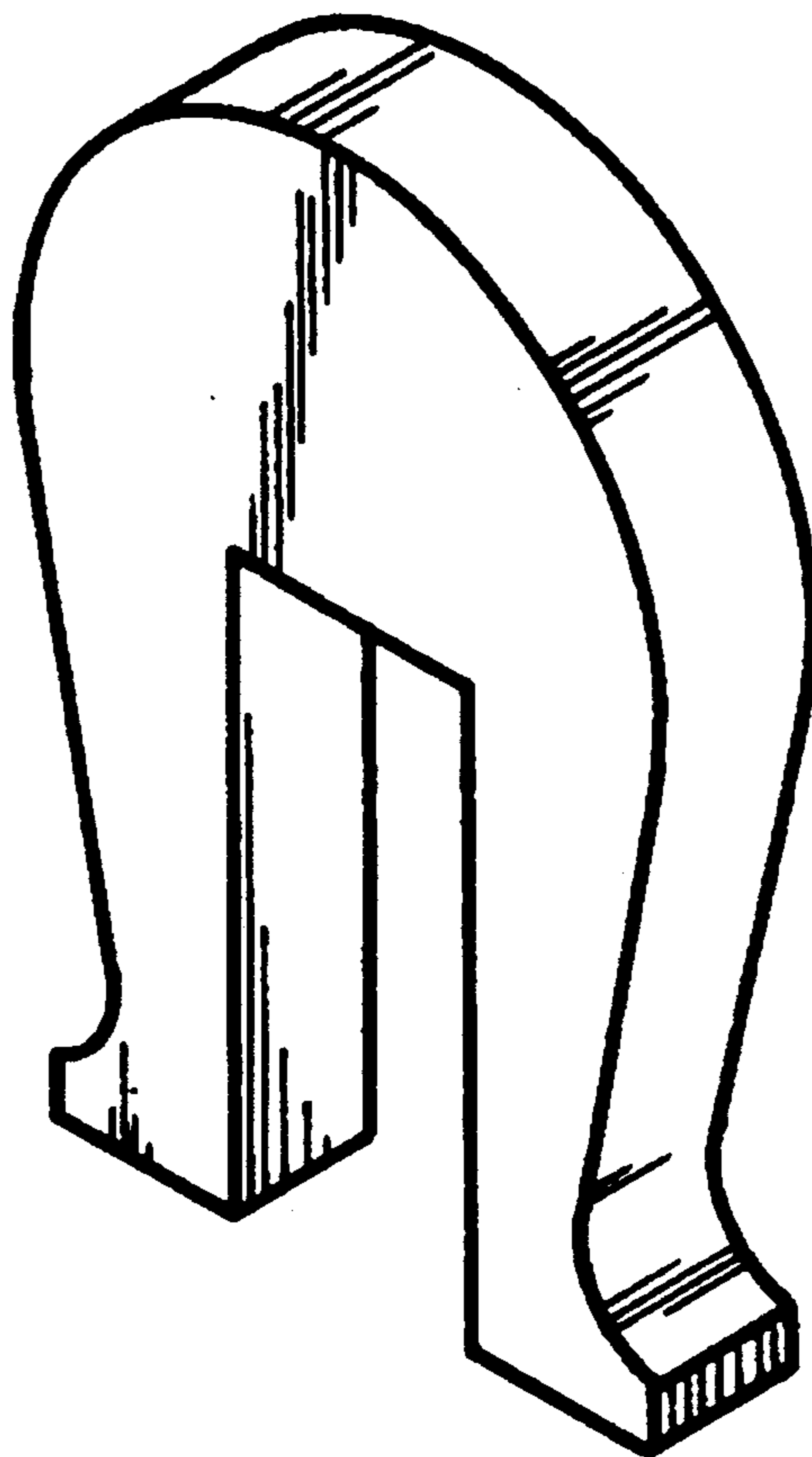

The ornamental design for a golf ball tee setter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf ball tee setter showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1, the opposite side being identical;
 FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1; the opposite side being identical;
 FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of FIG. 8; and
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 8.
 The tee is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



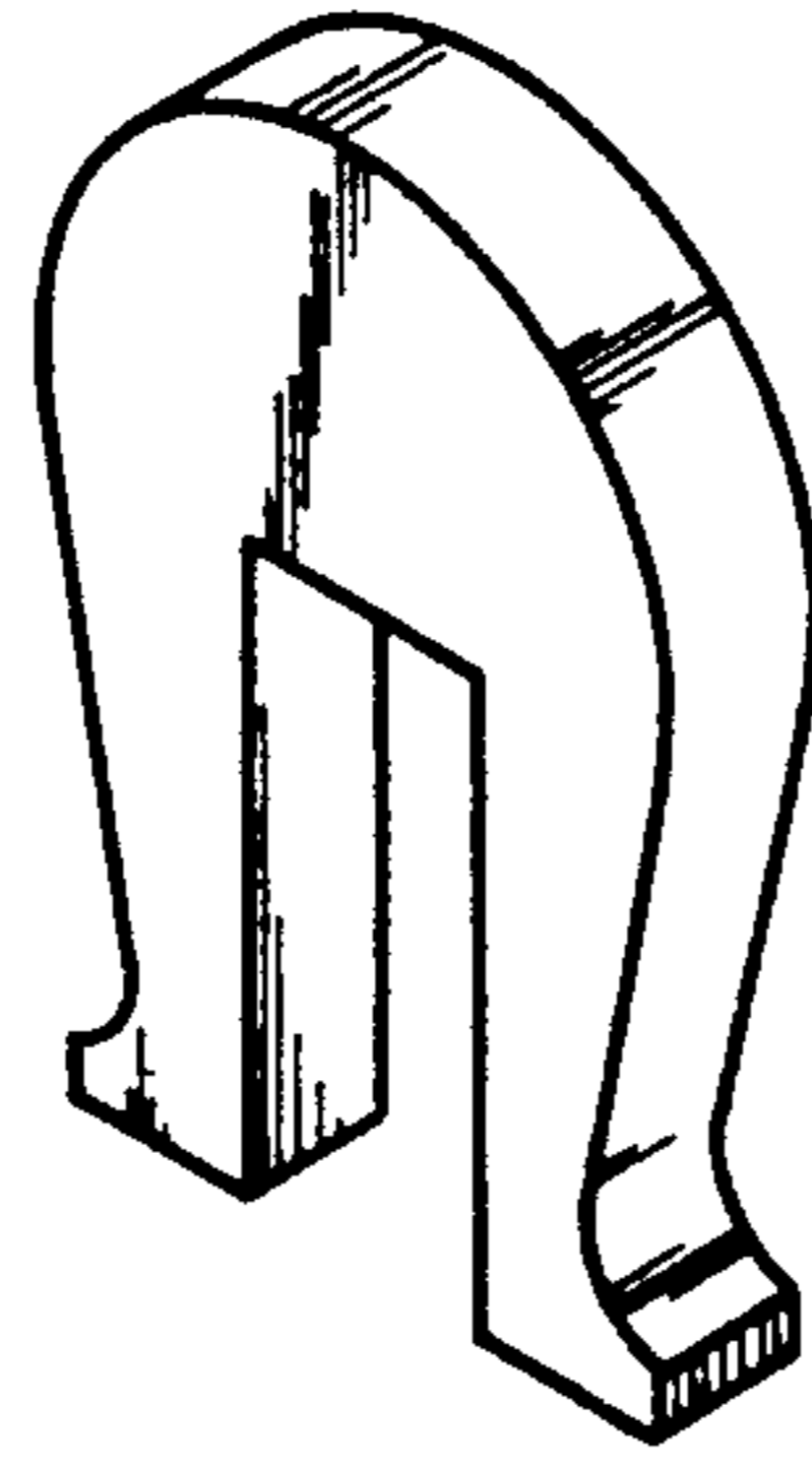

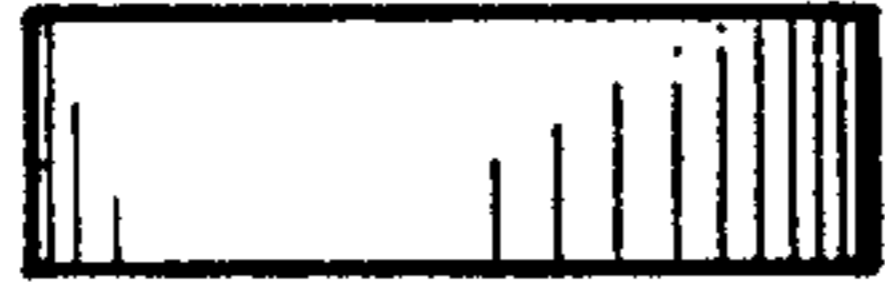

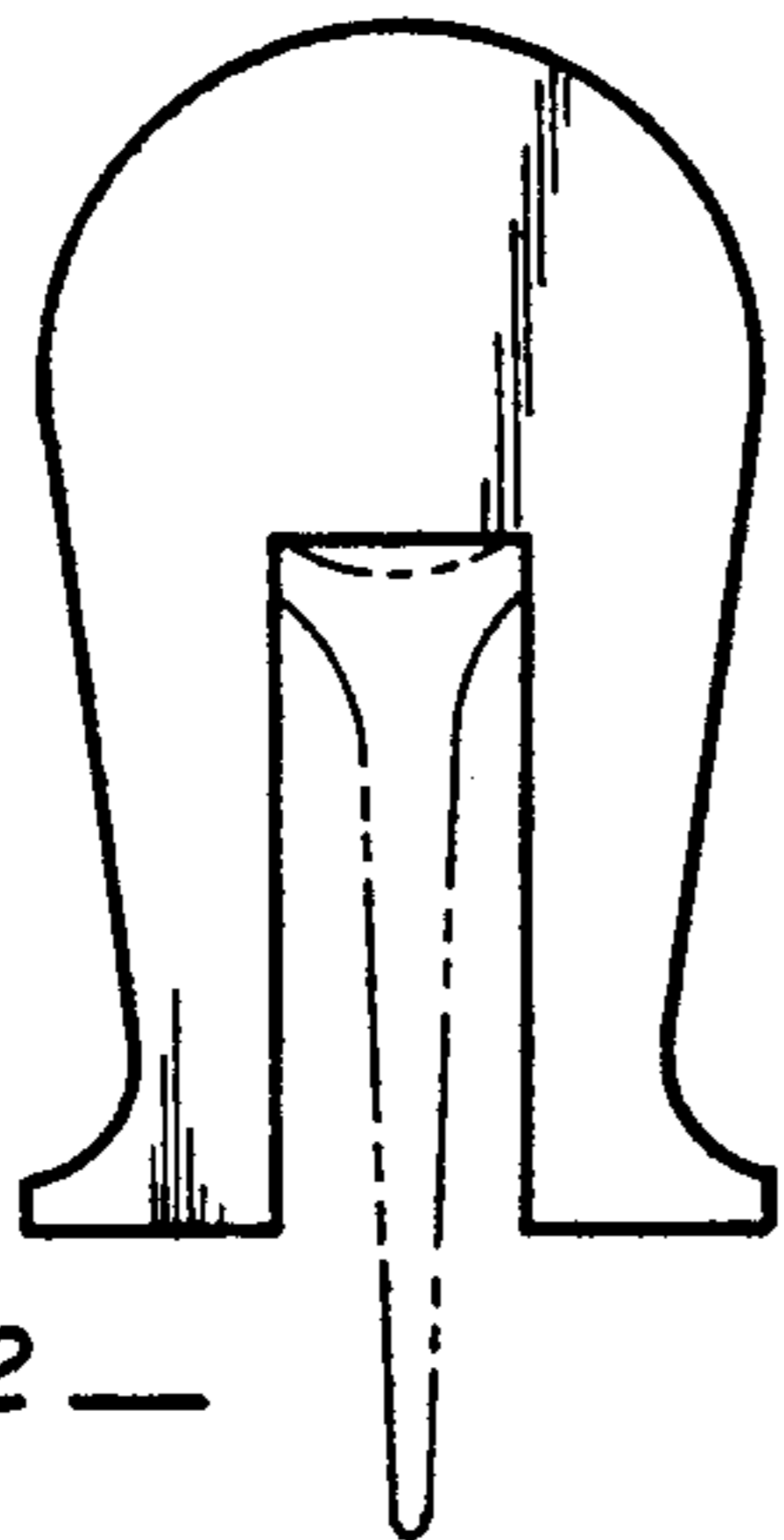

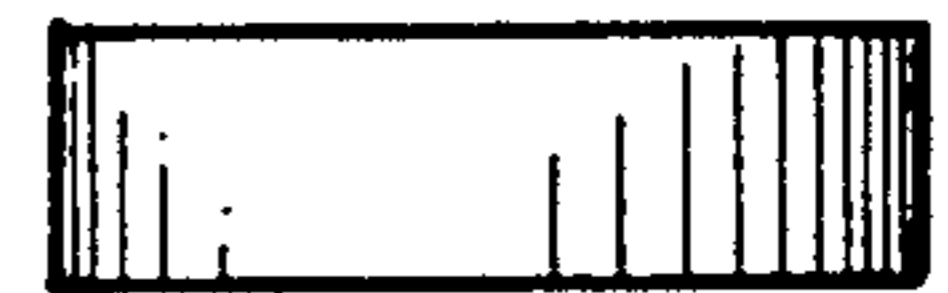
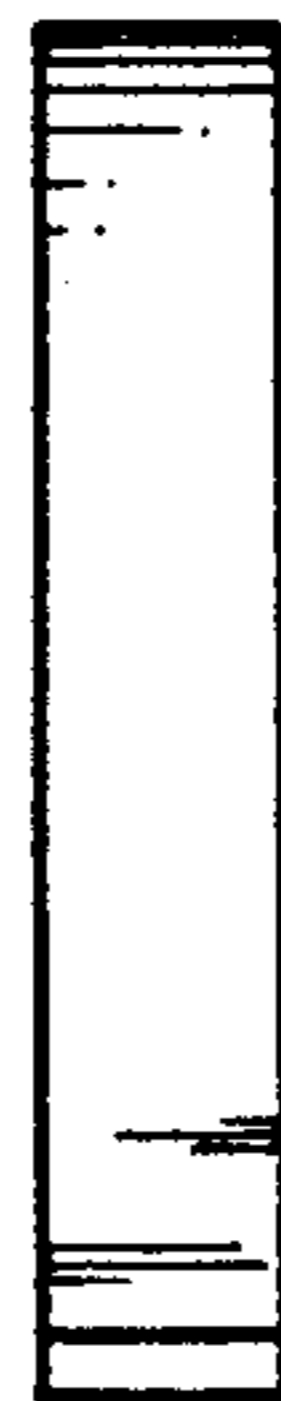

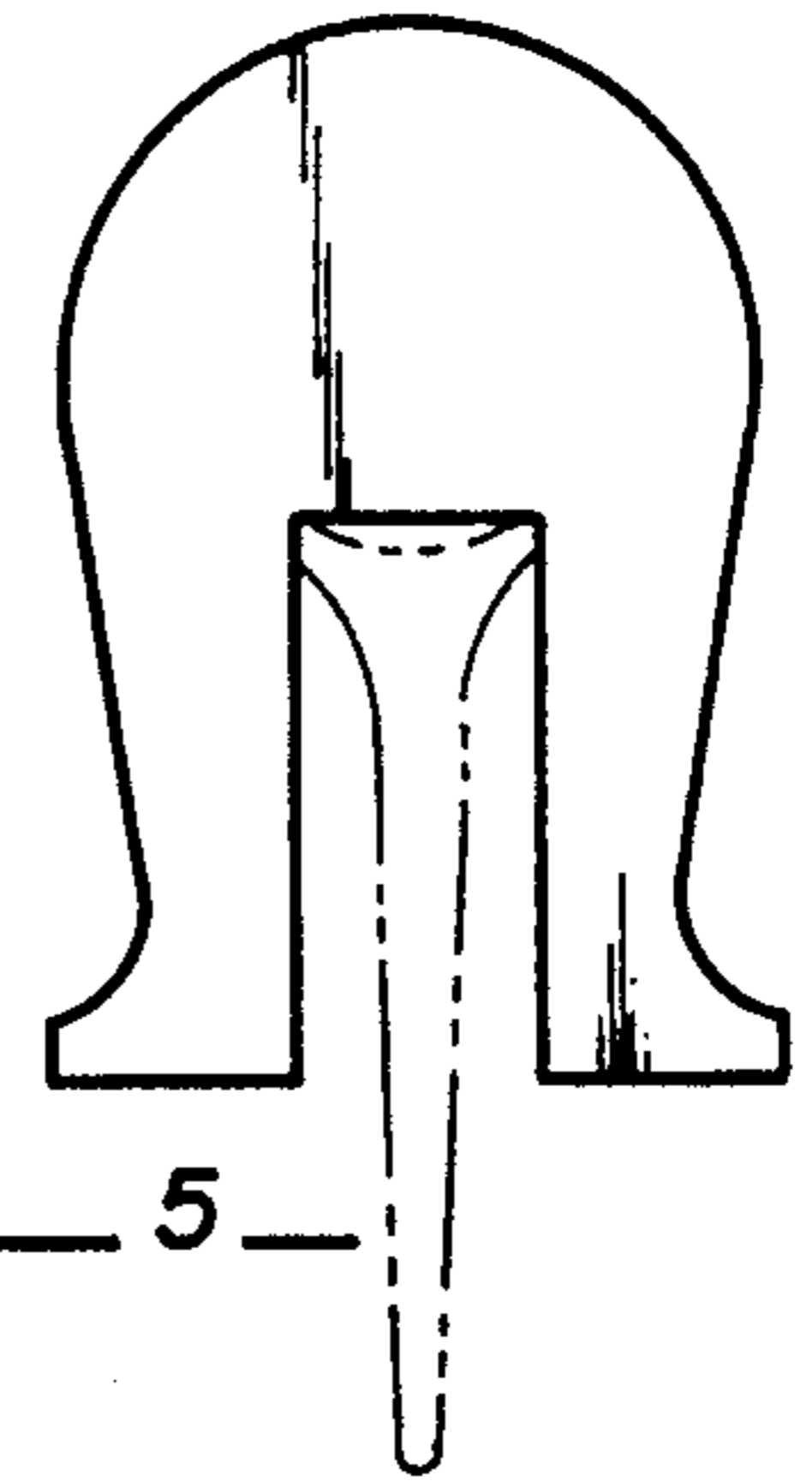

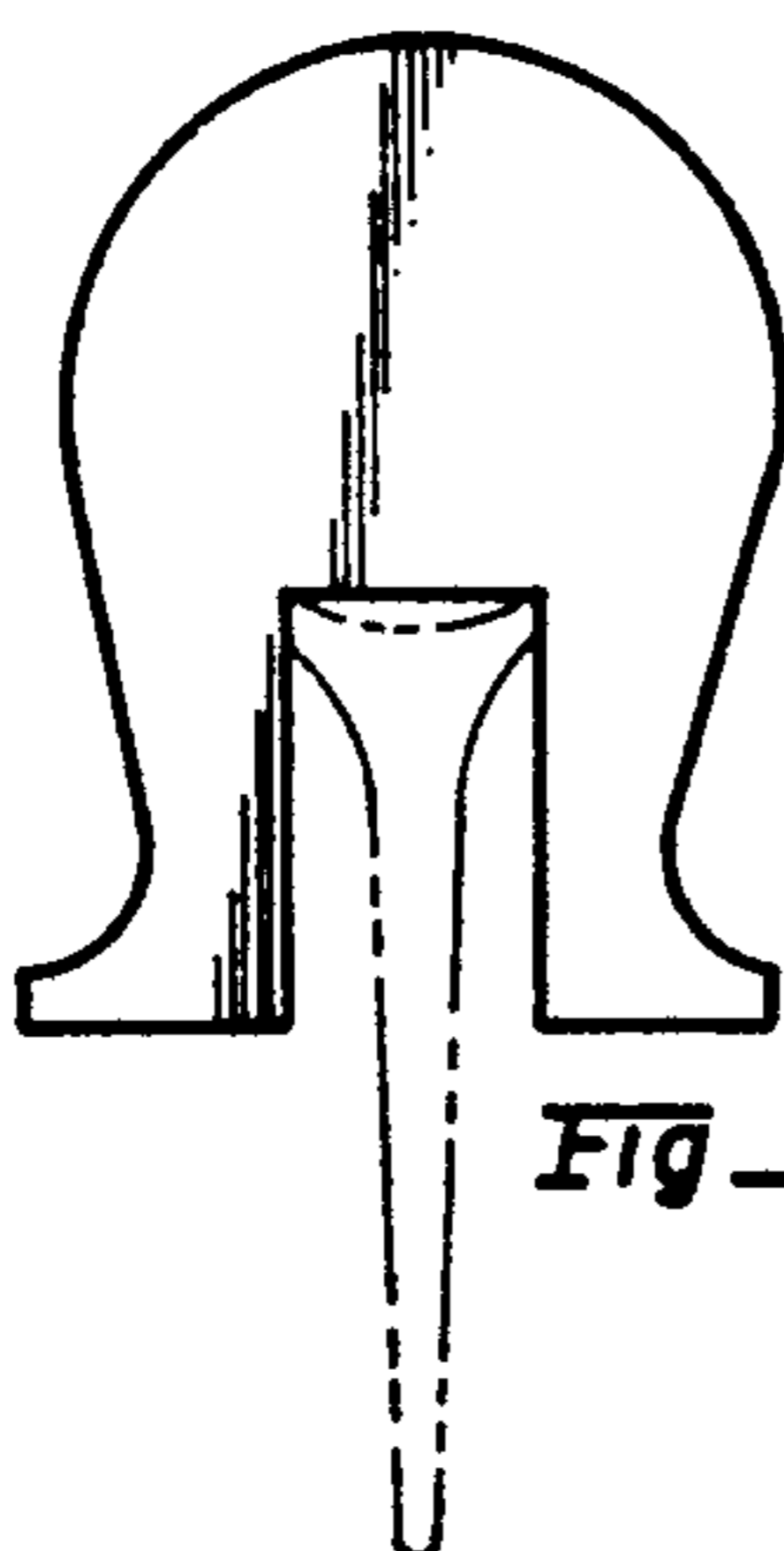
