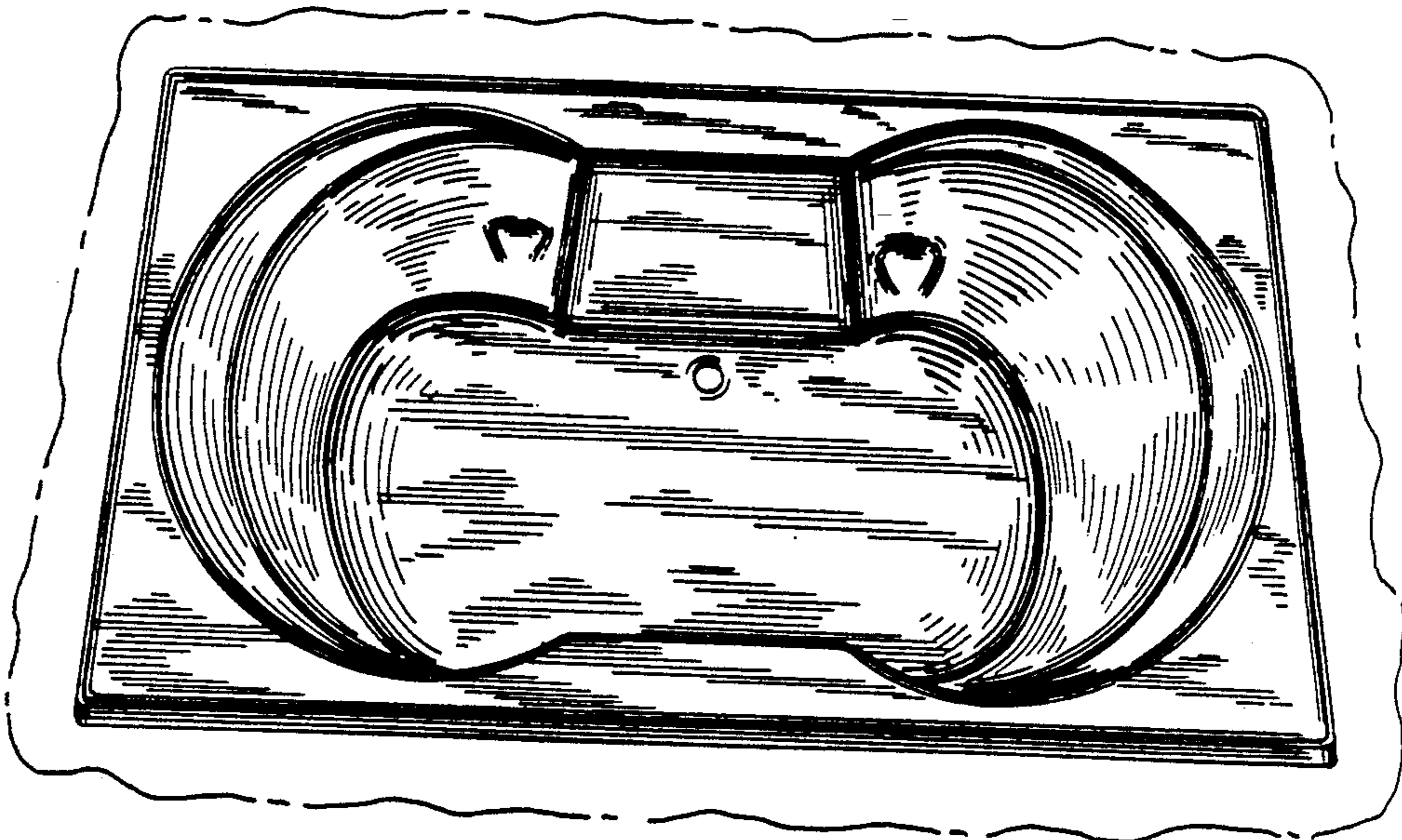
[57] CLAIM

 The fragmentary broken line representations of decks in FIGS. 1, 2, 8 and 9 are for the purpose of illustration only.



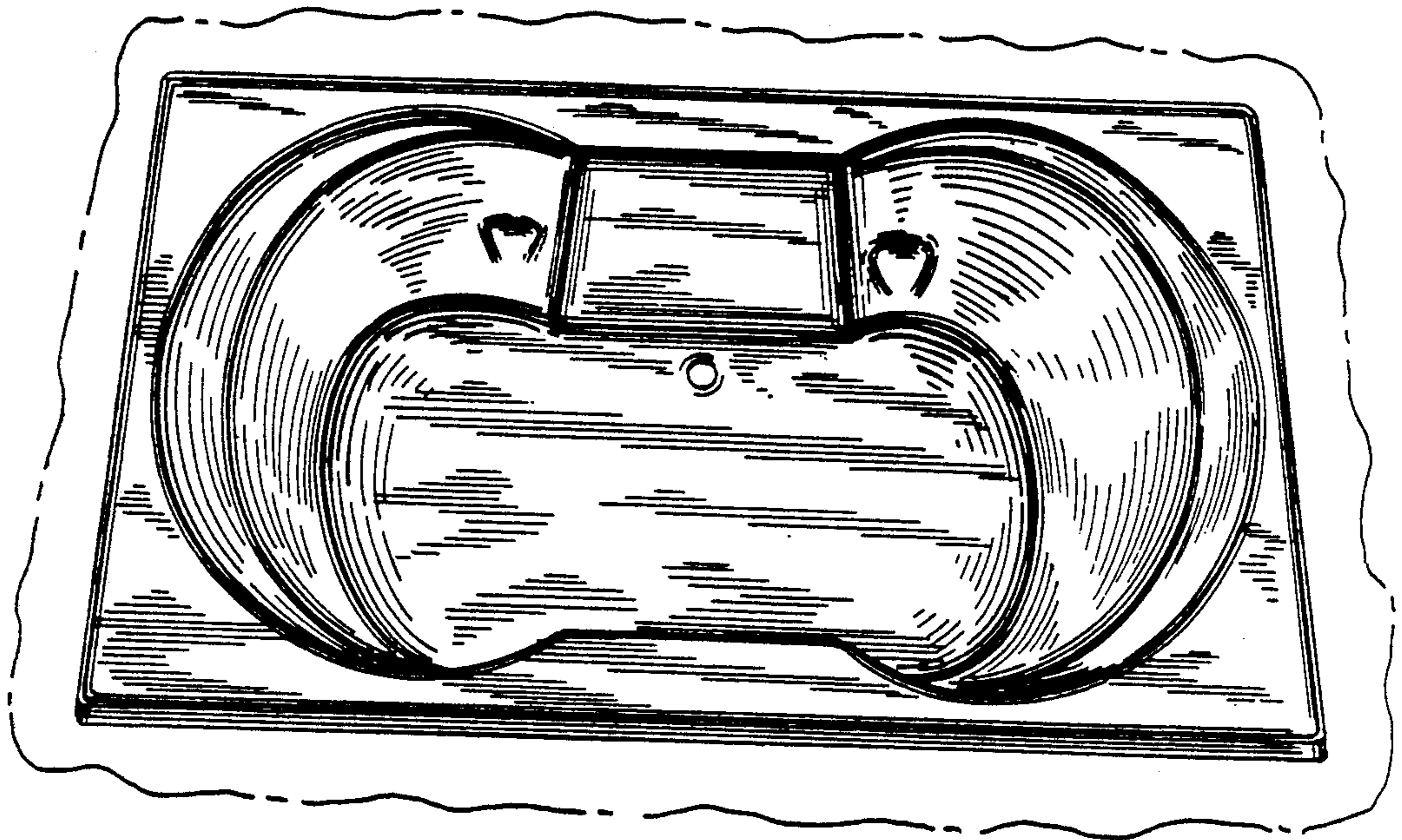

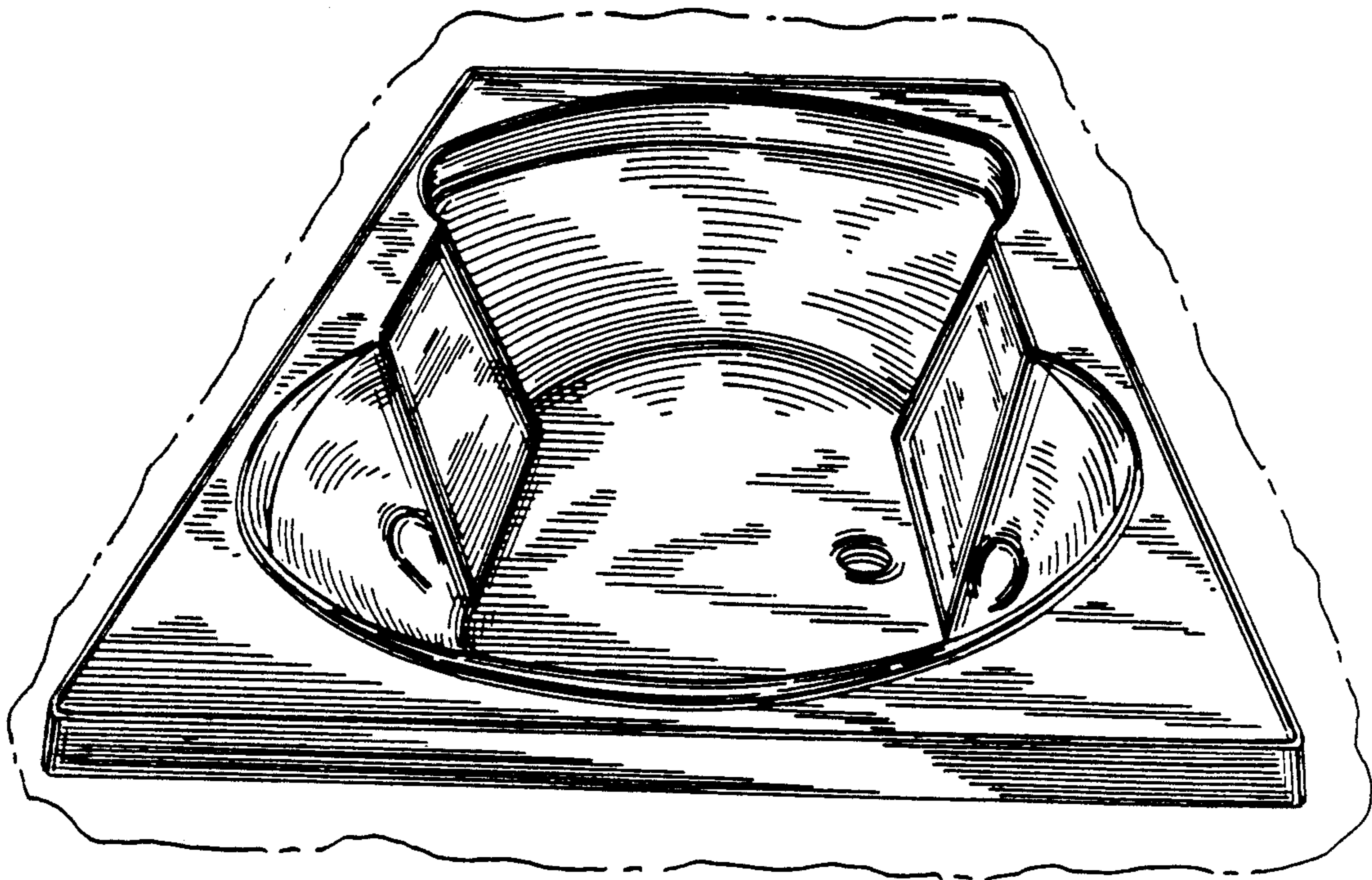

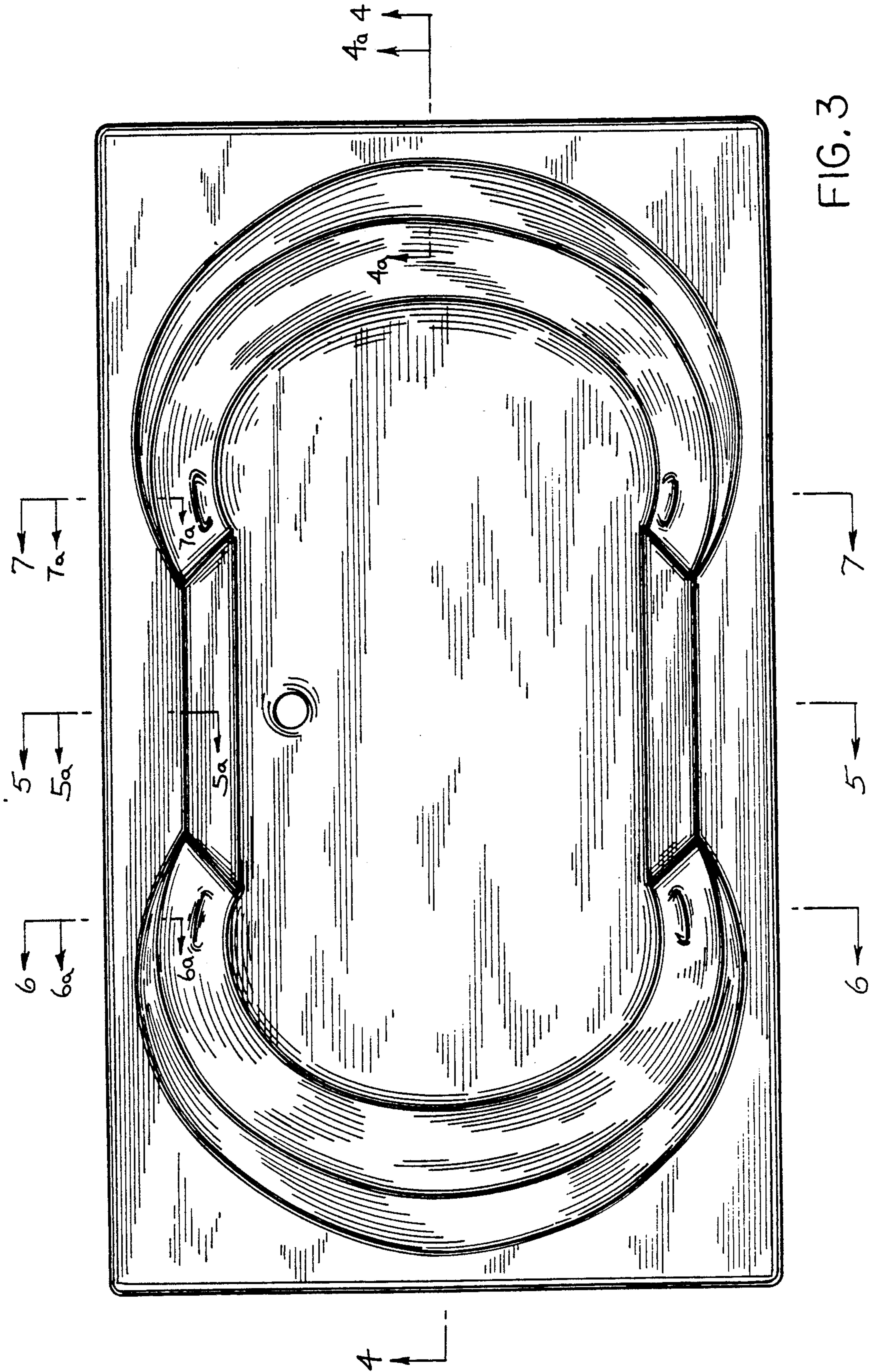

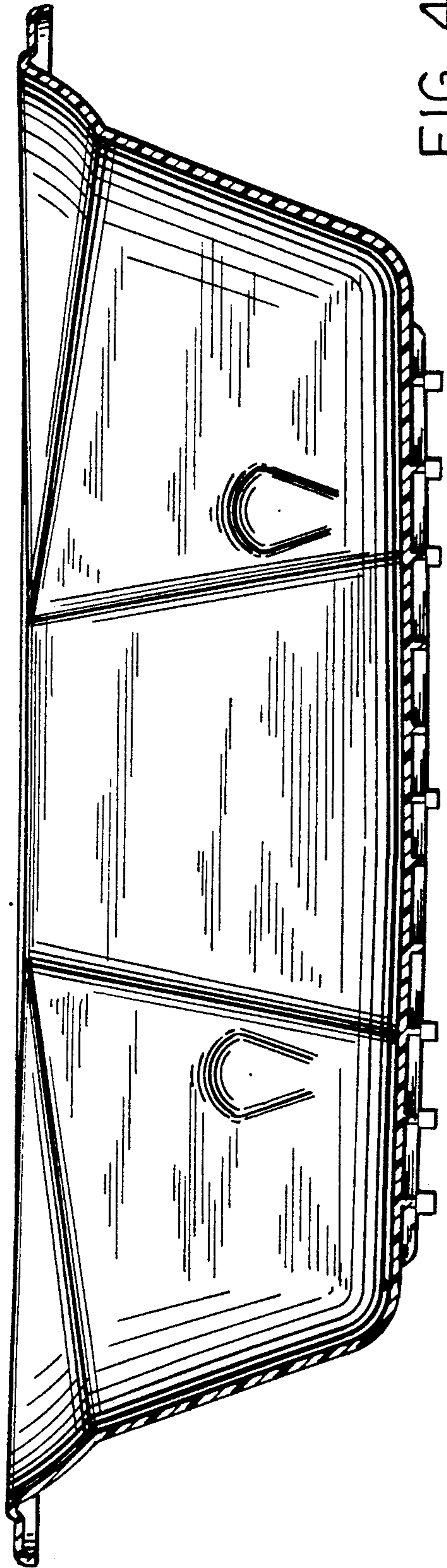

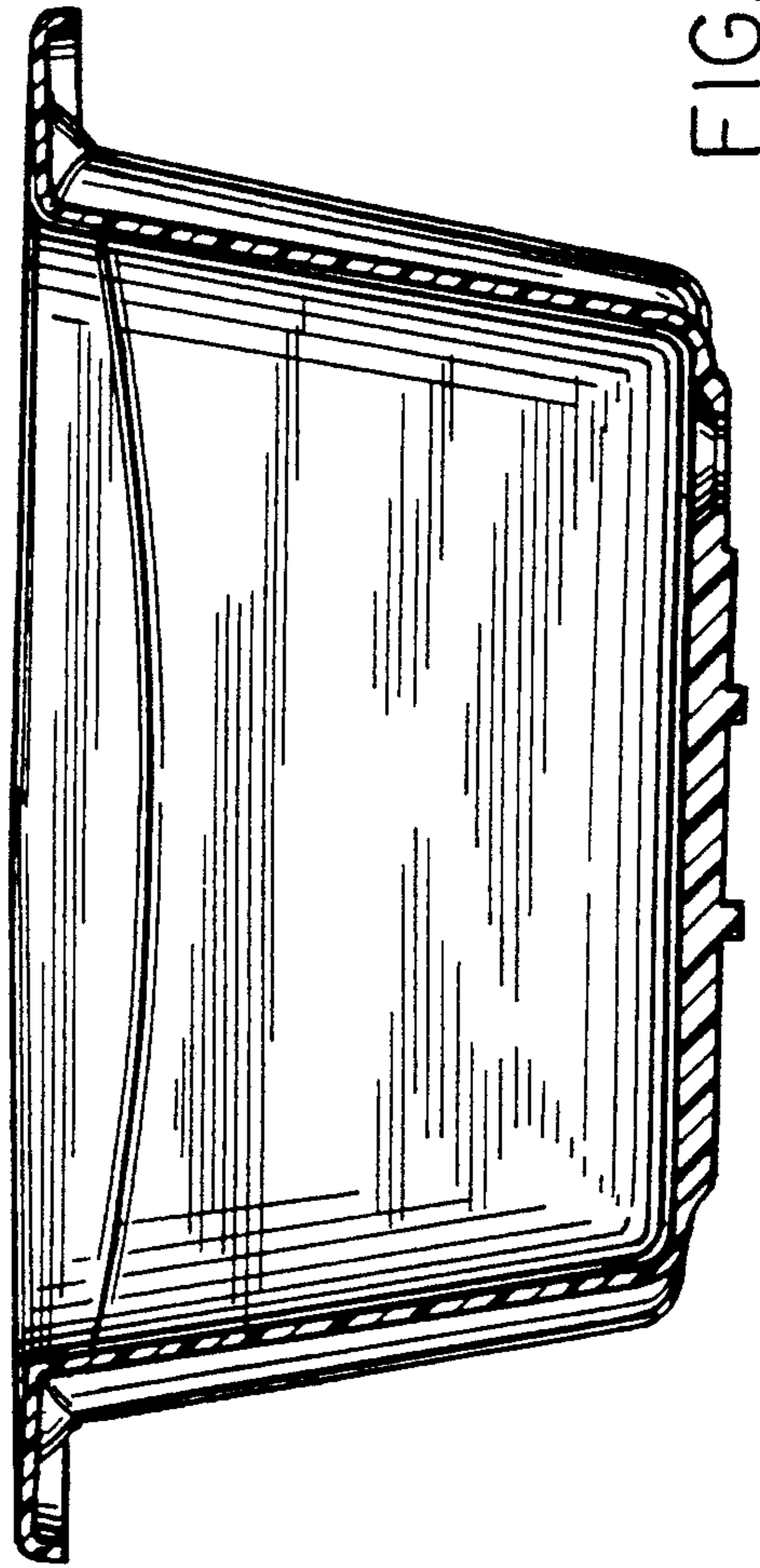

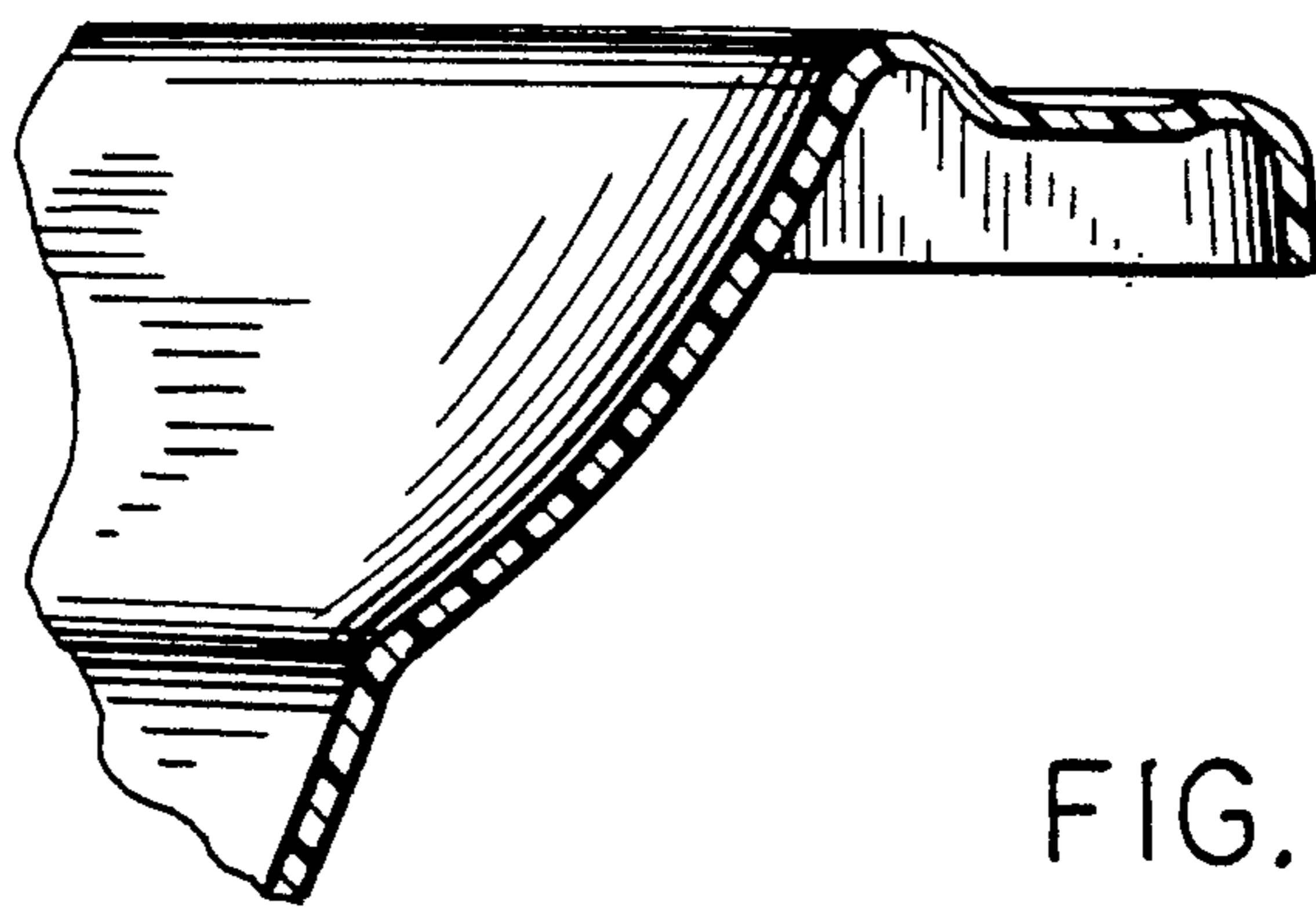

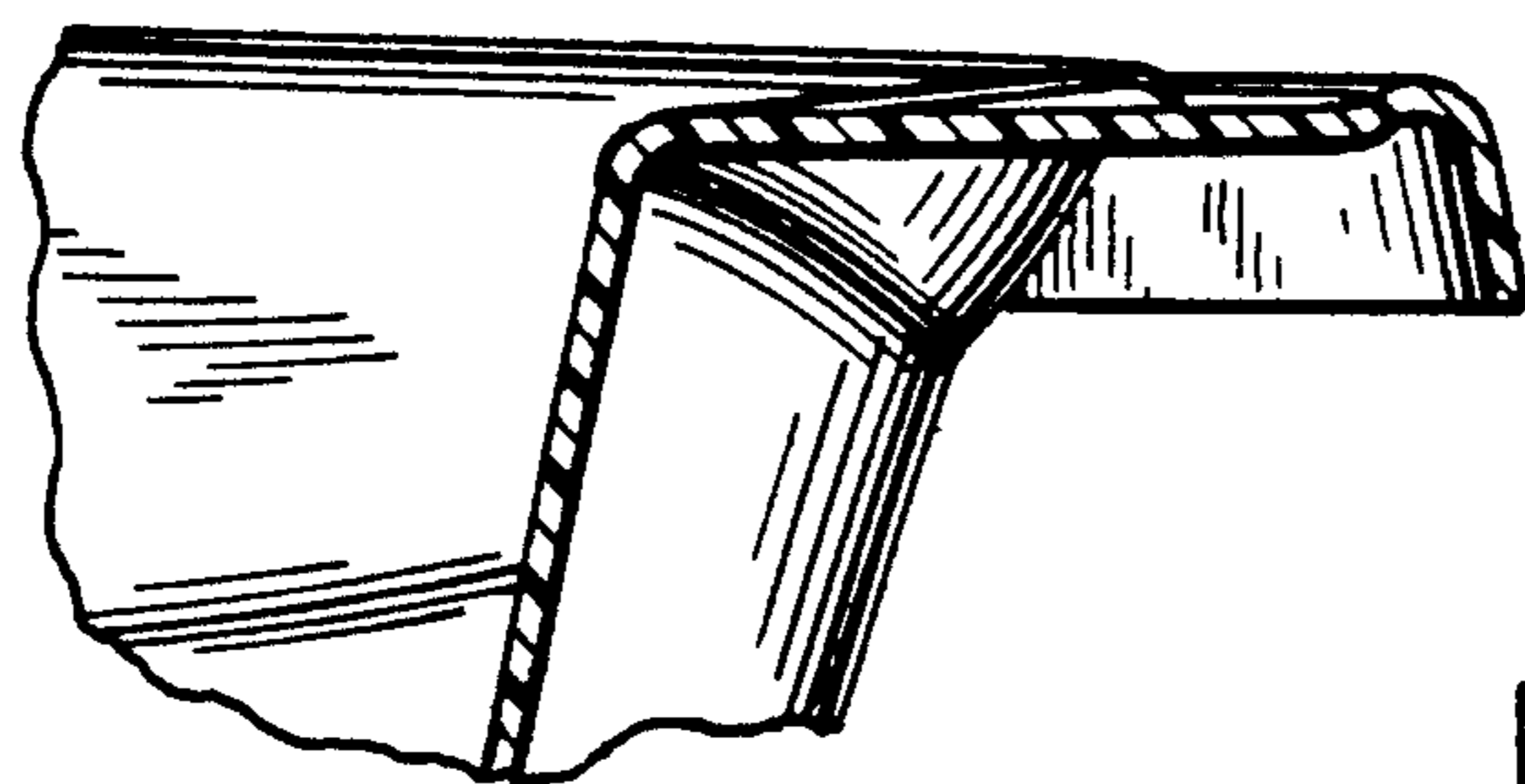

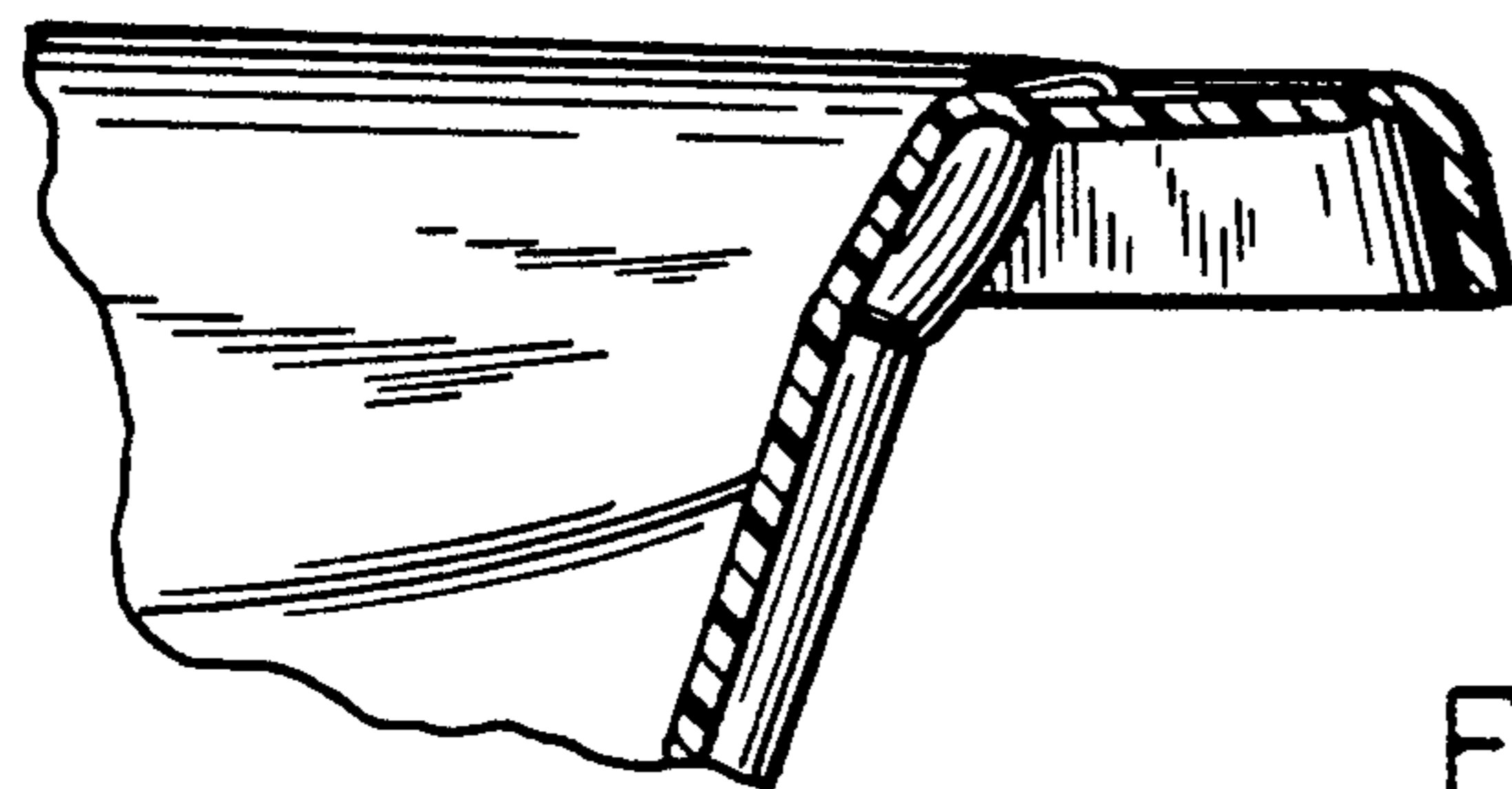

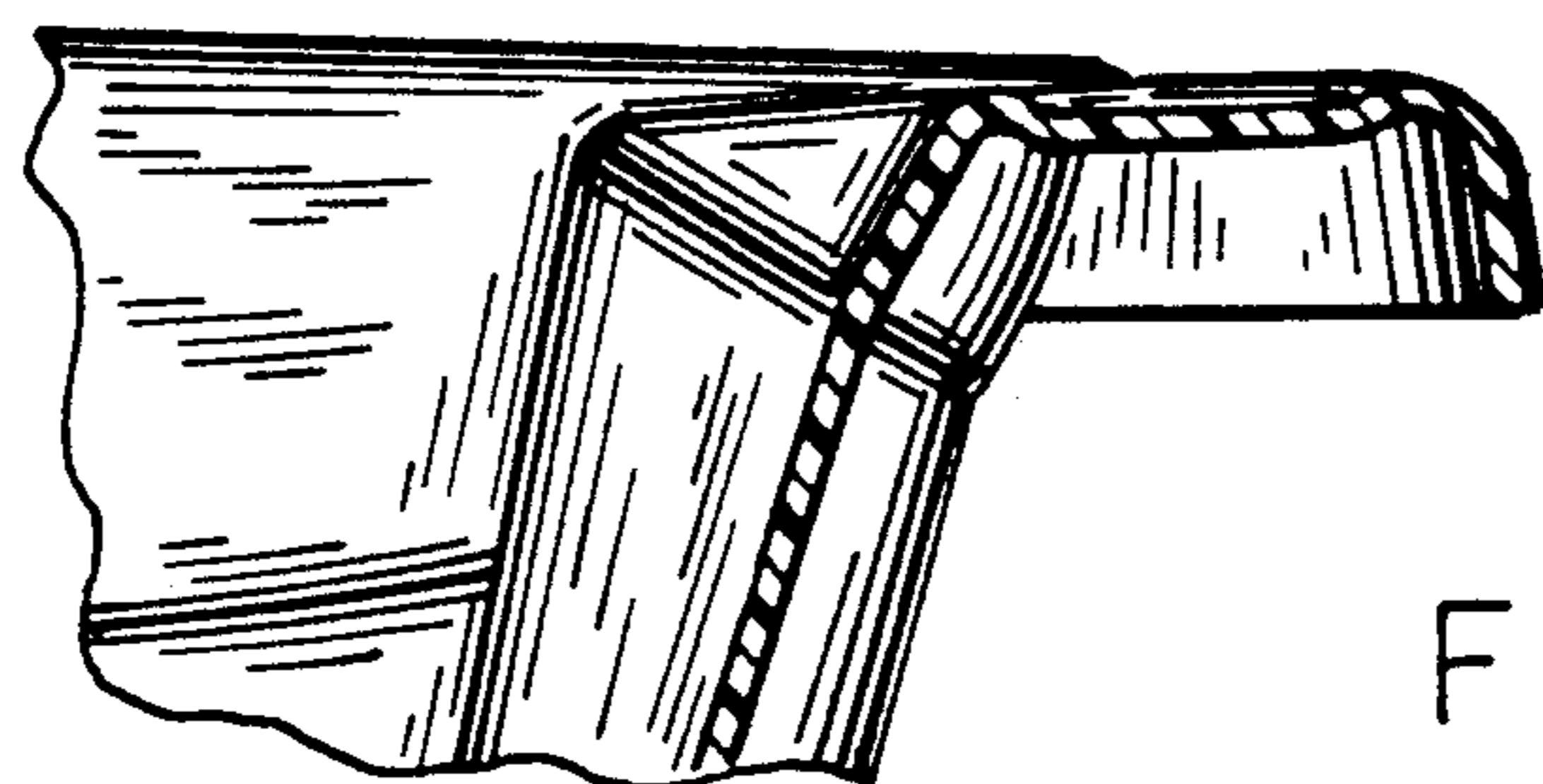

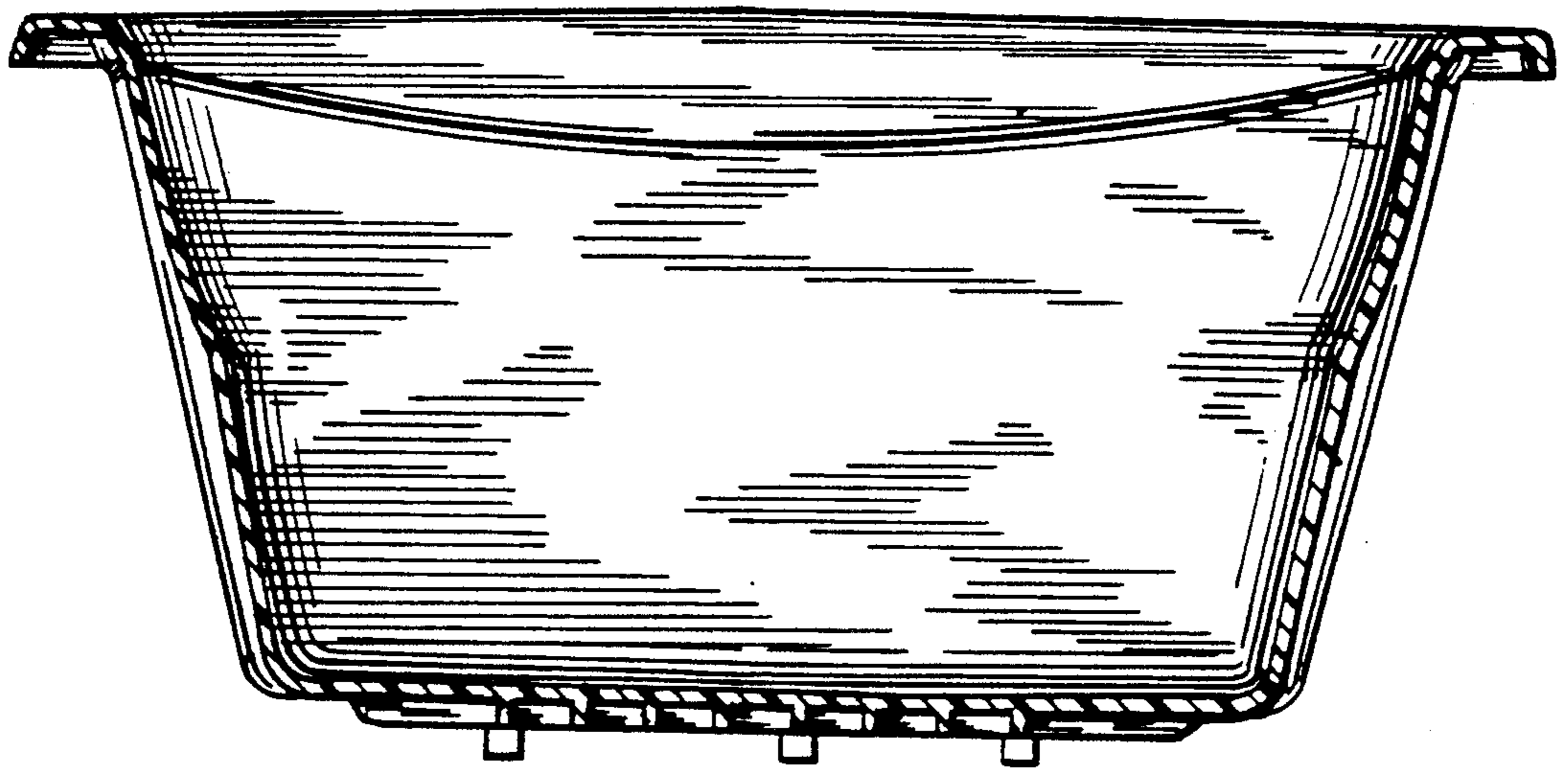

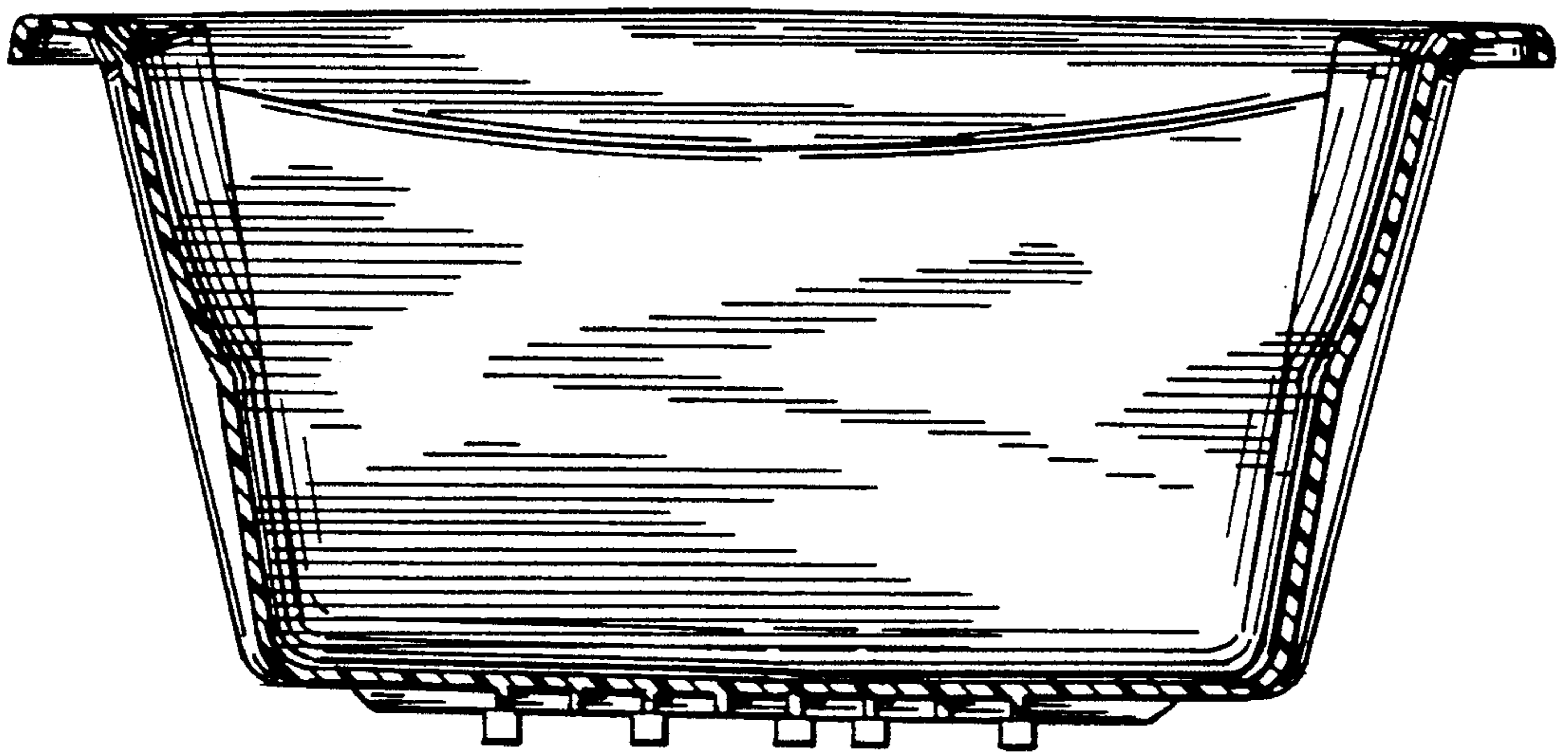

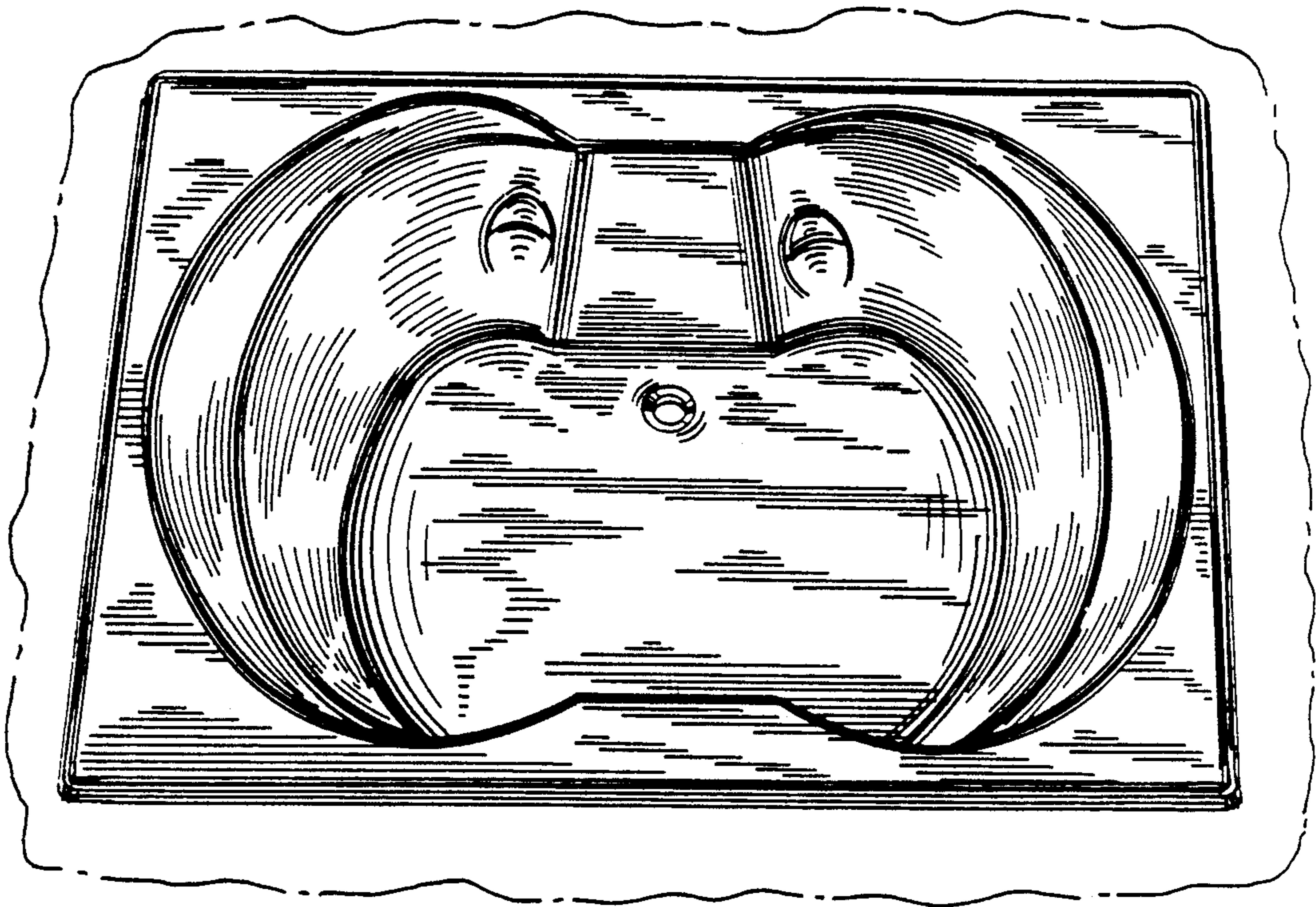

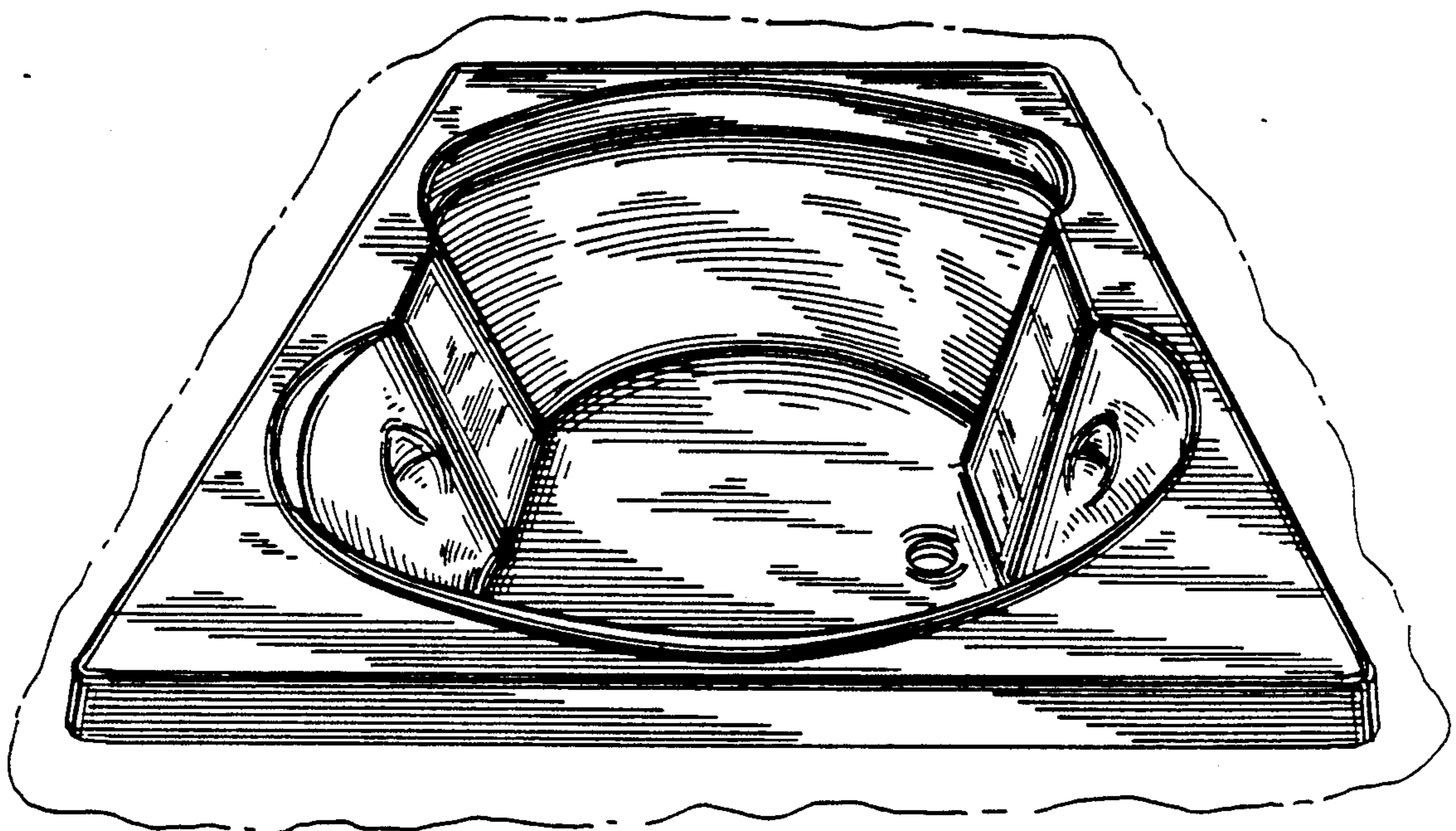
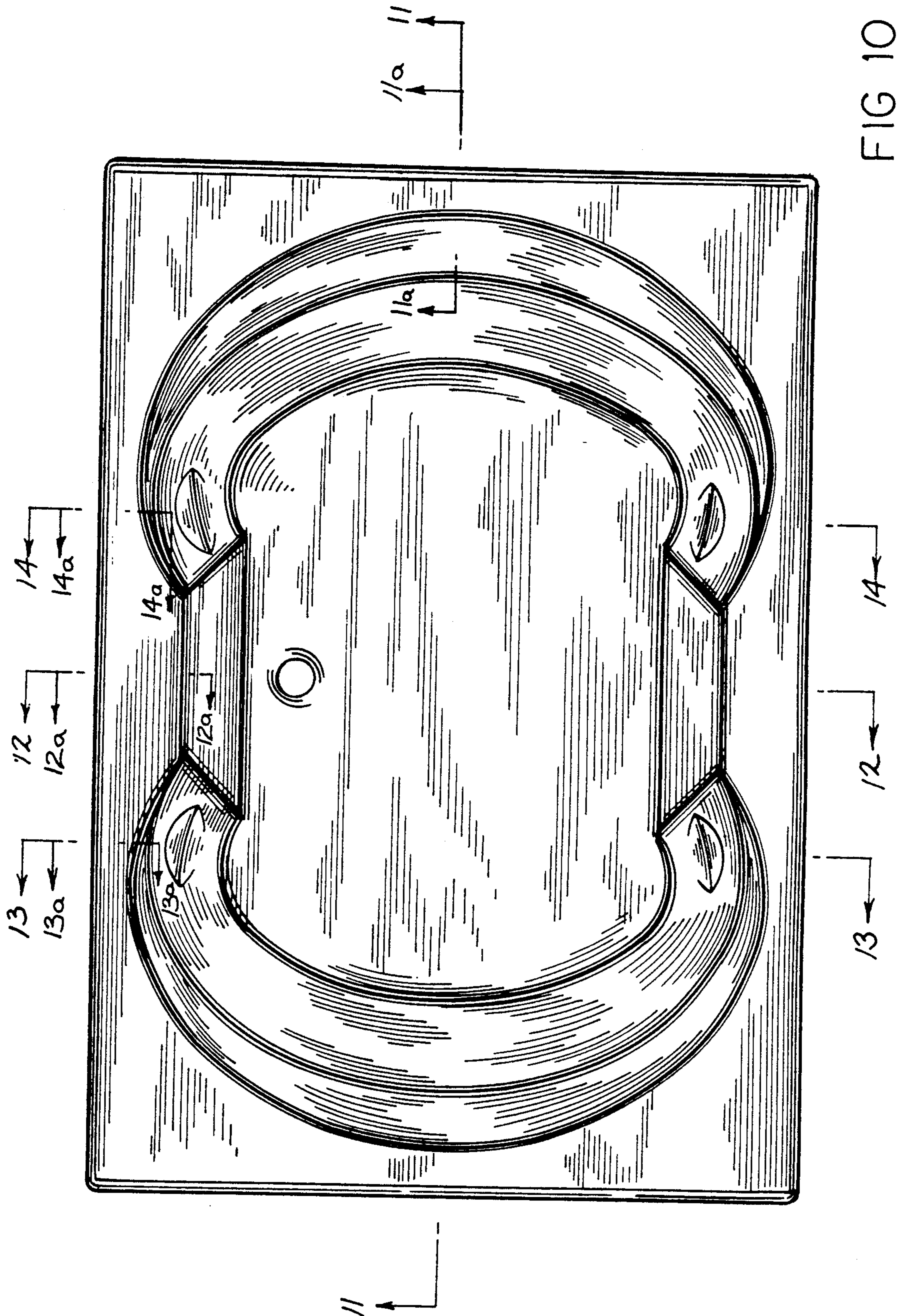

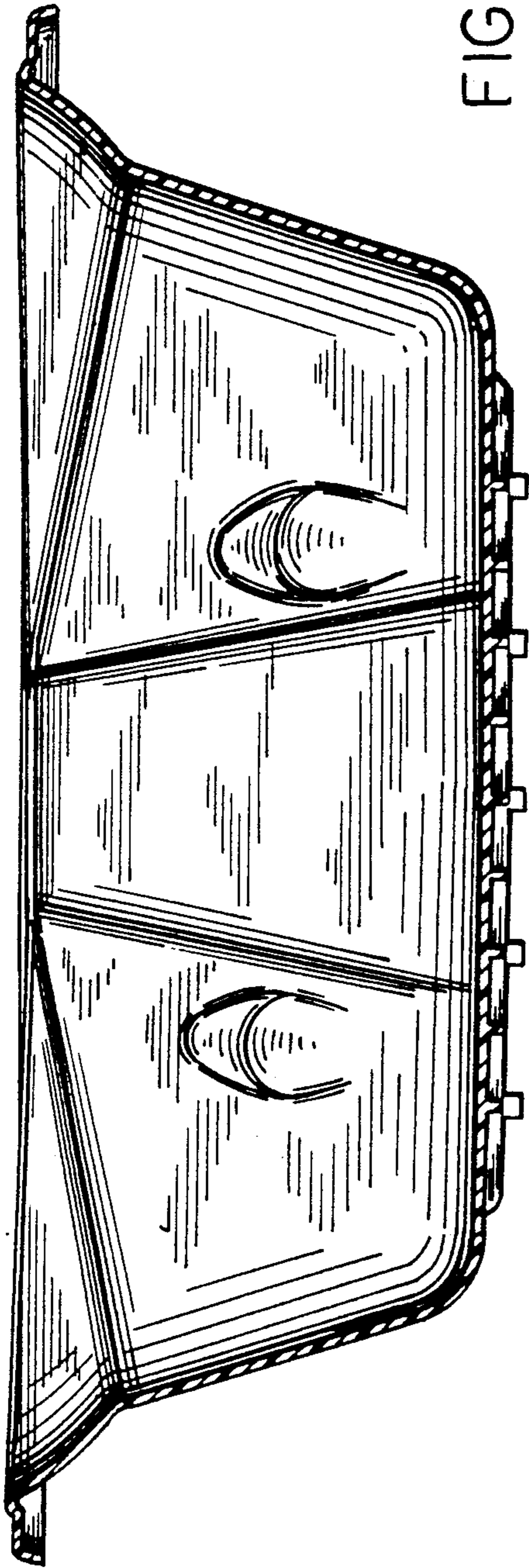

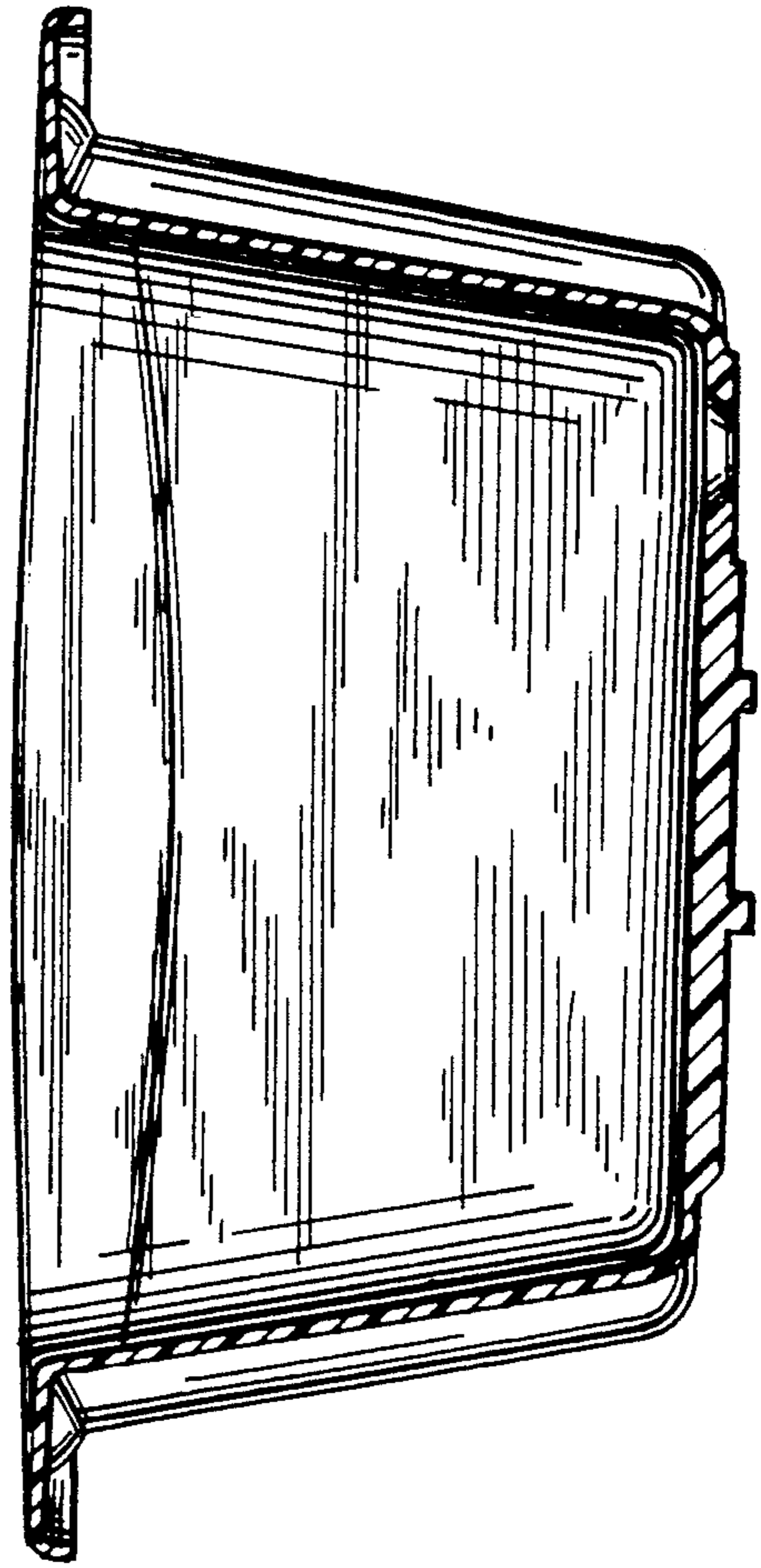

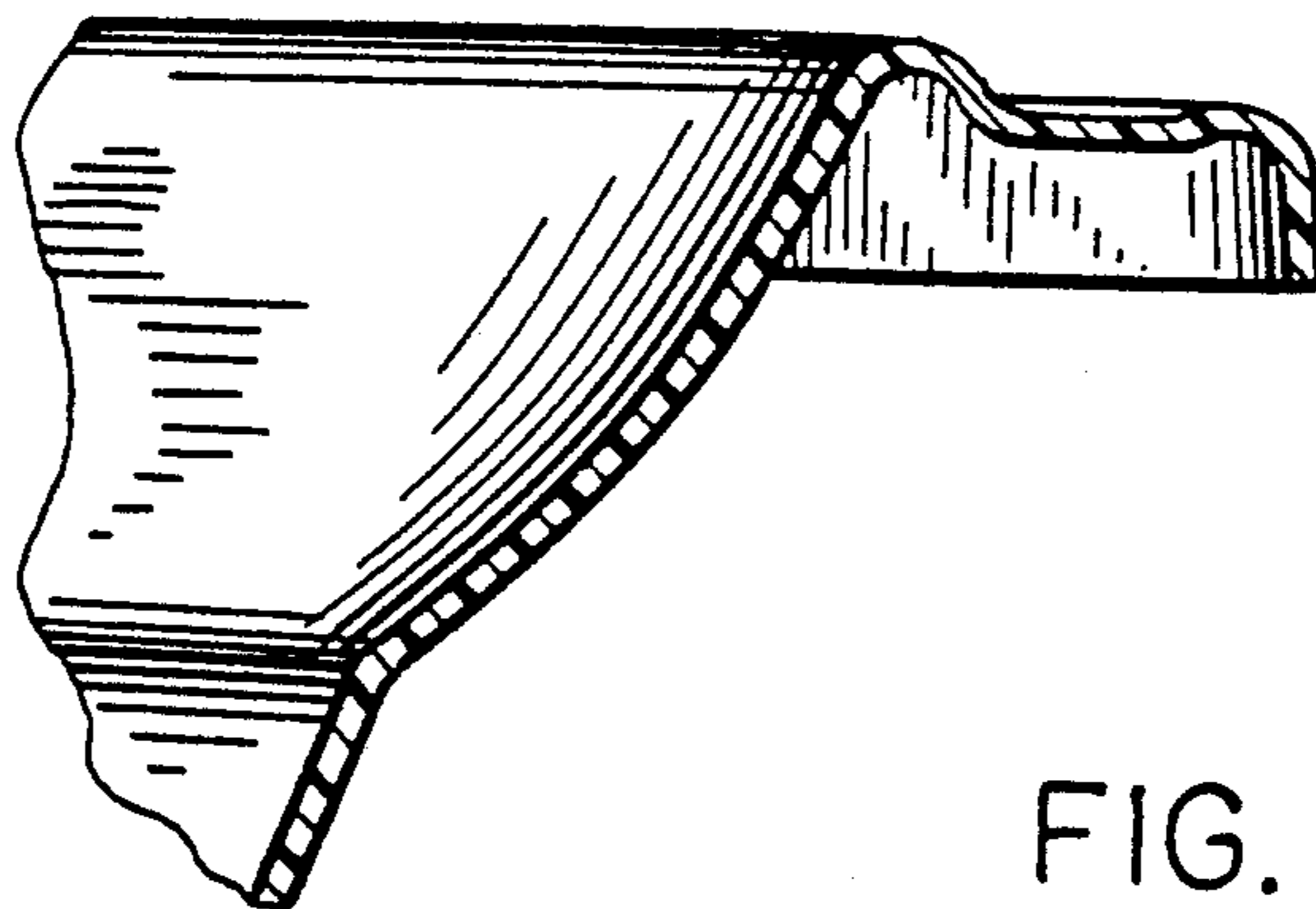

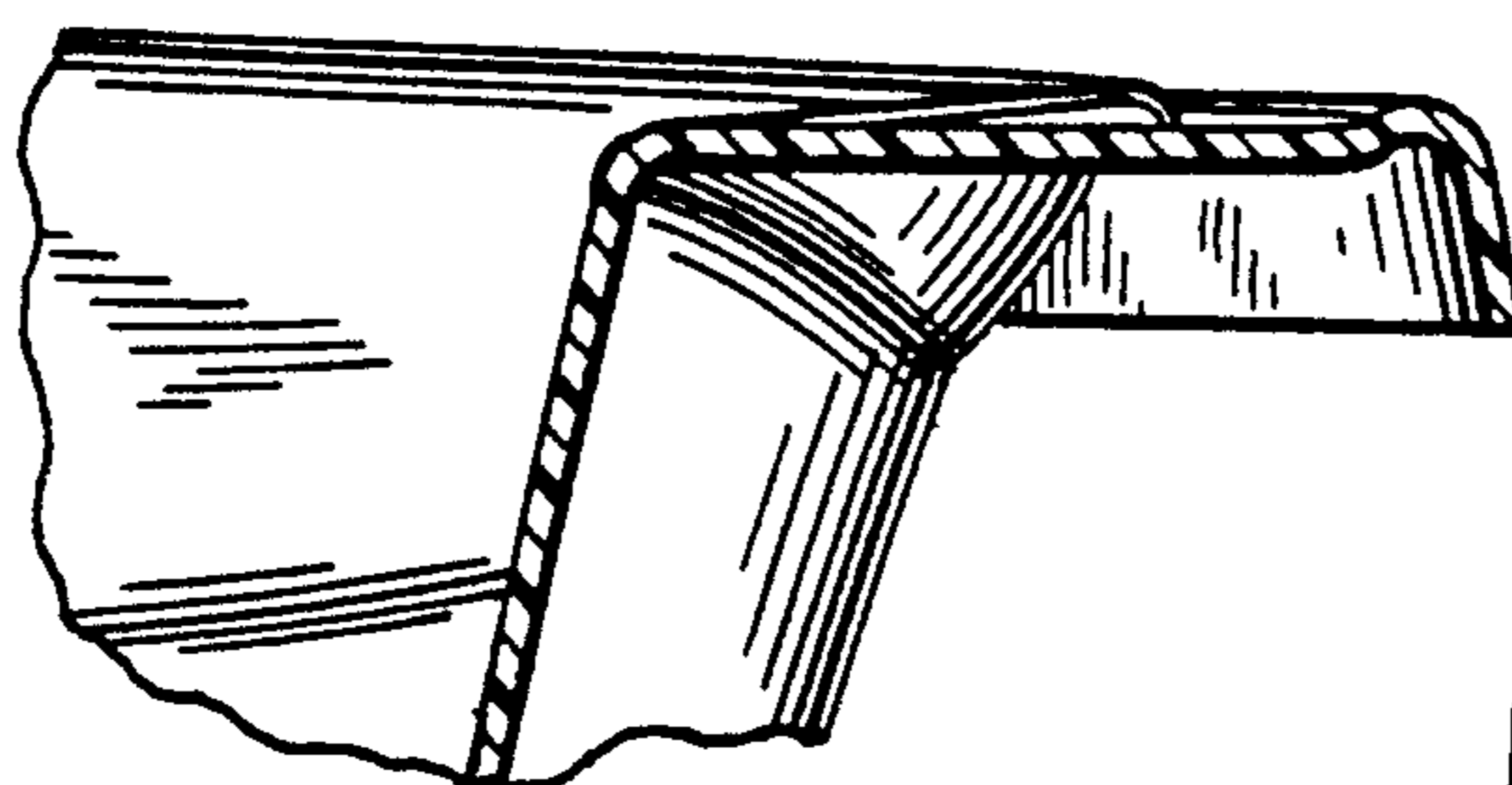

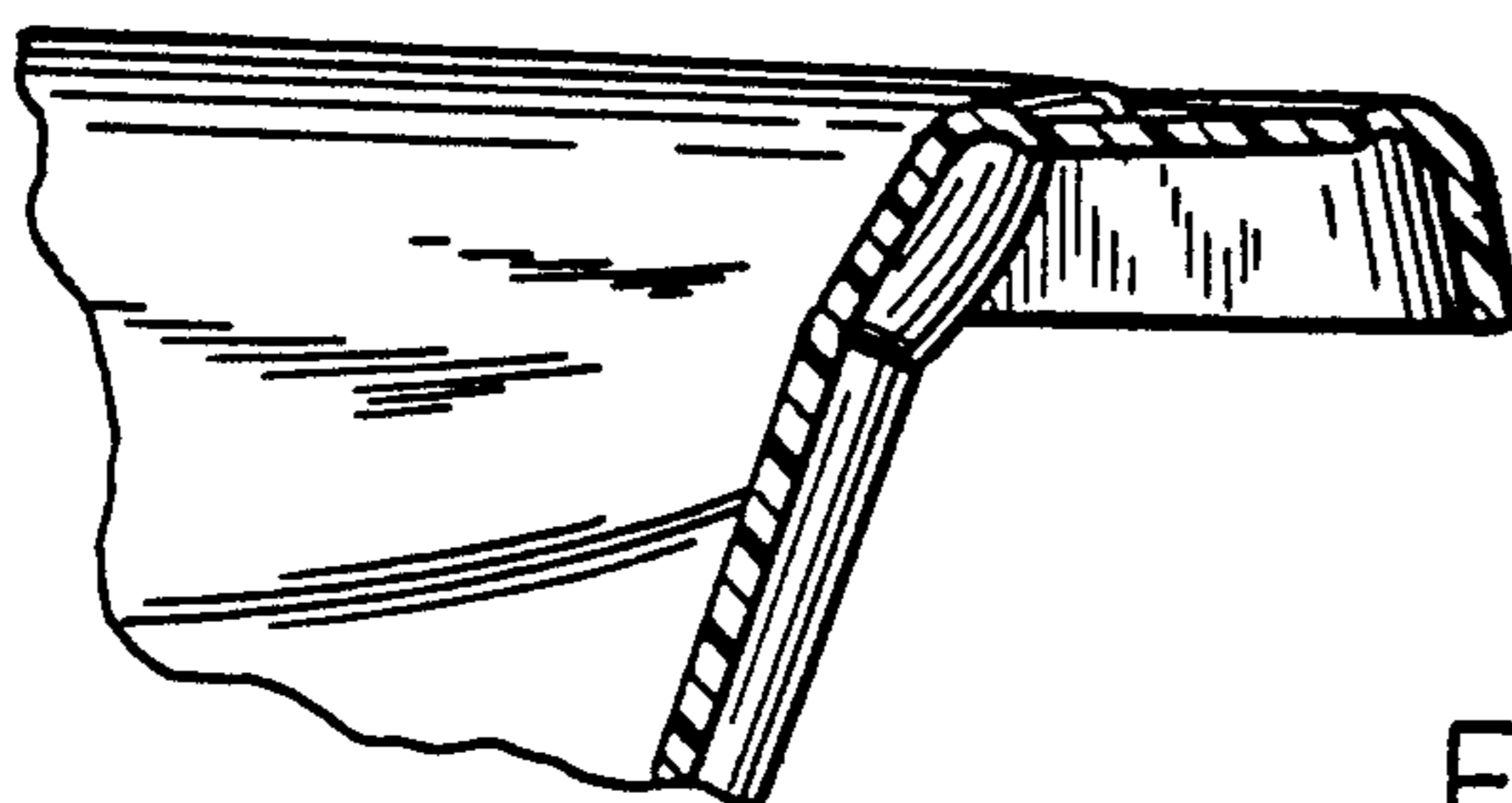

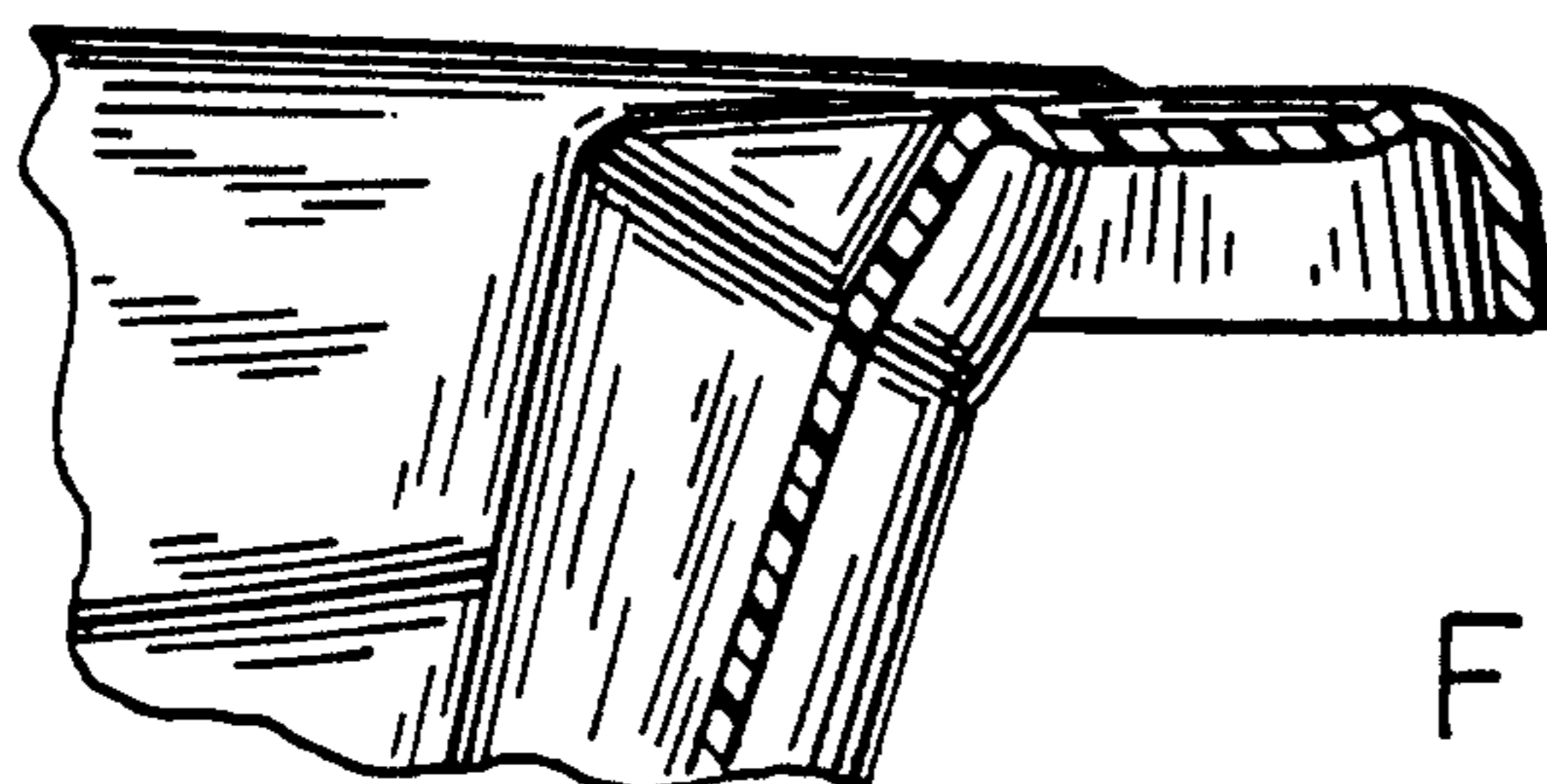

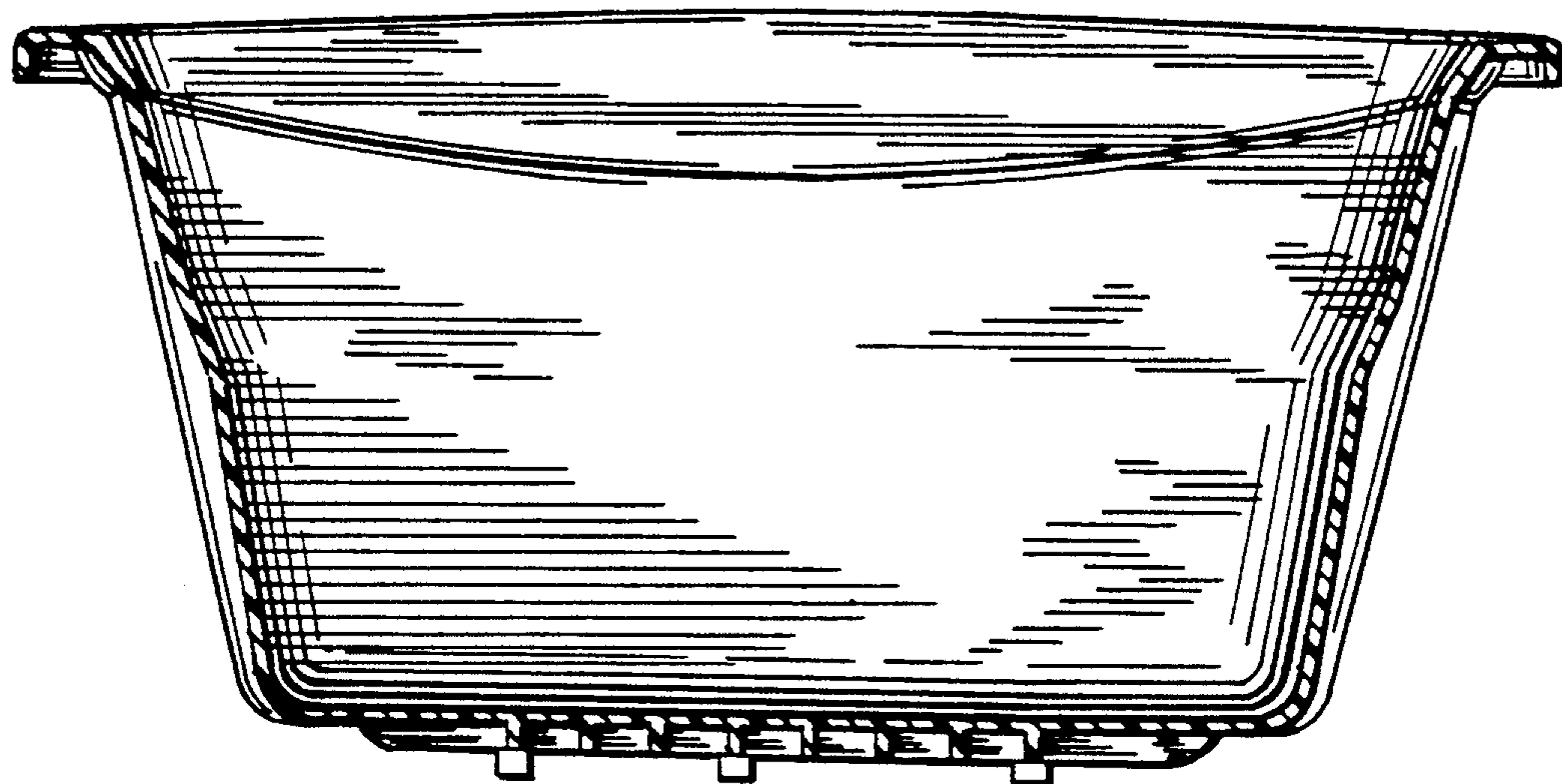

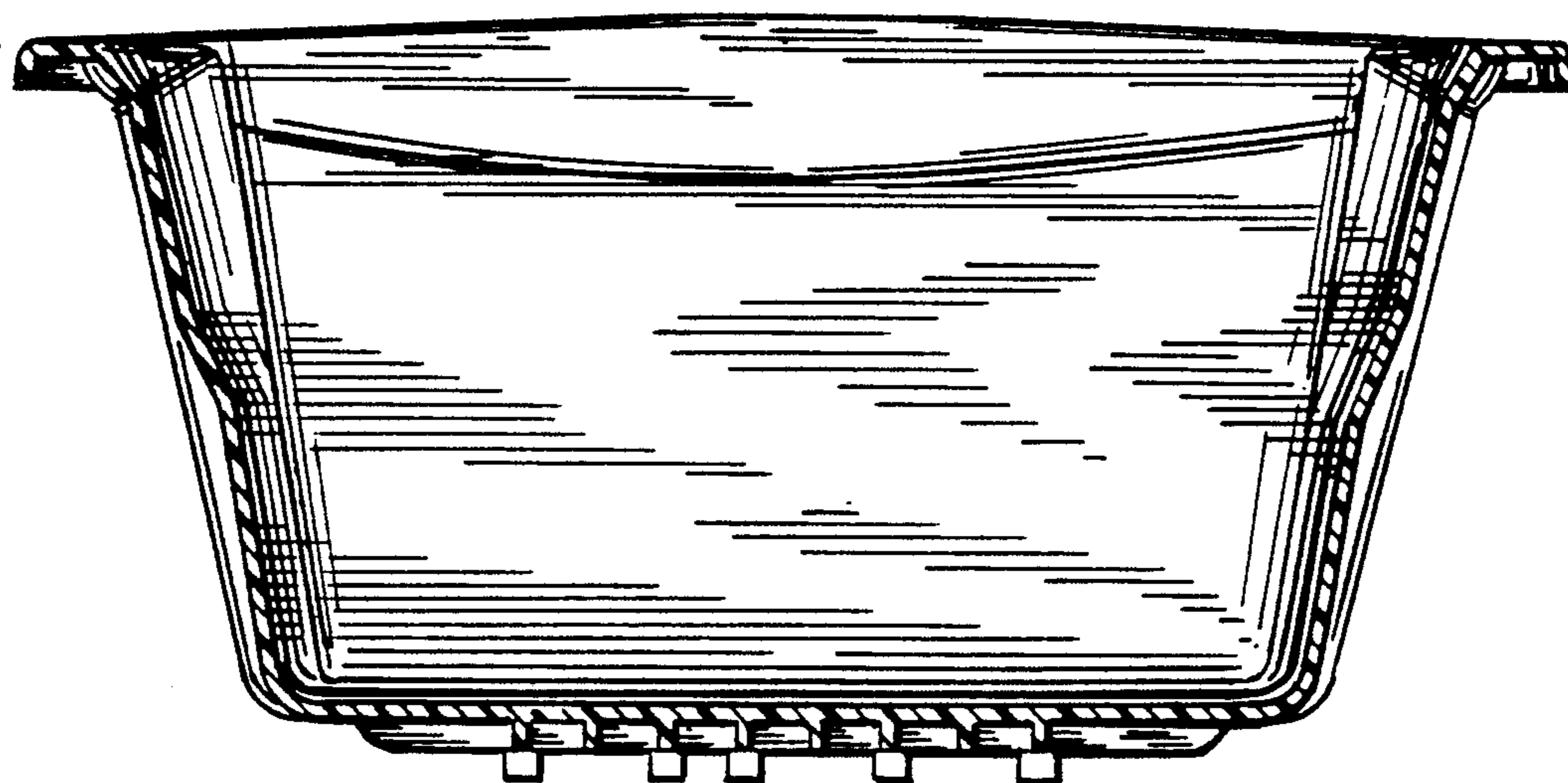
