[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a recliner pane for tanning apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a recliner pane for tanning apparatus, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a longitudinal cross-sectional view taken along line IV—IV of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a transverse cross-sectional view taken along line V—V of FIG. 3; FIG. 6 is another front perspective view thereof; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 8 is an end elevational view thereof.

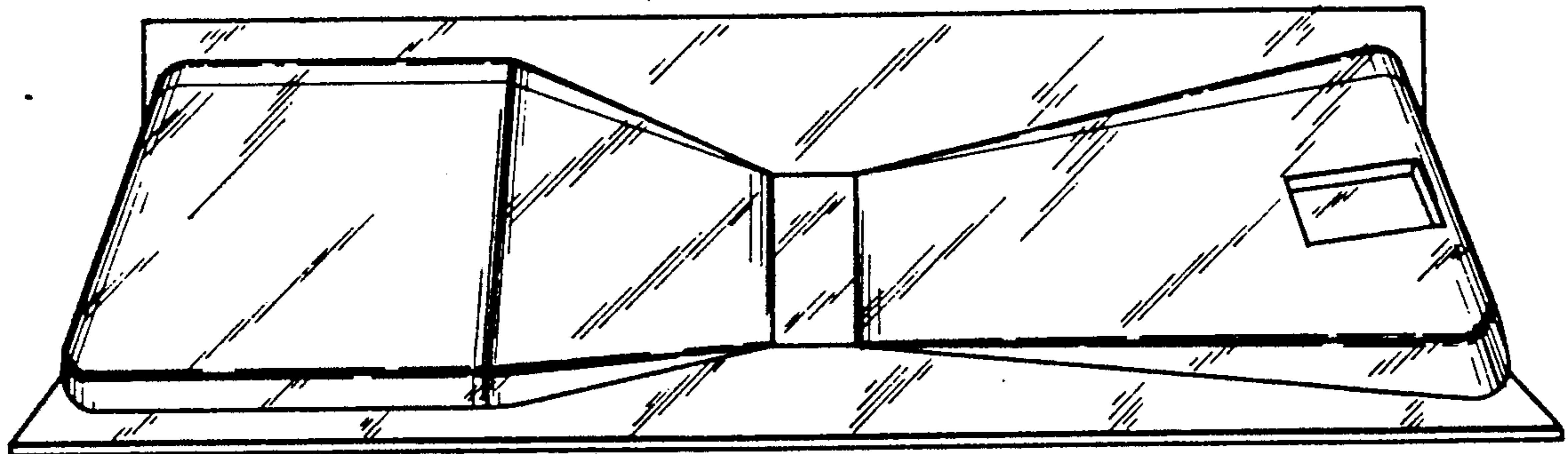

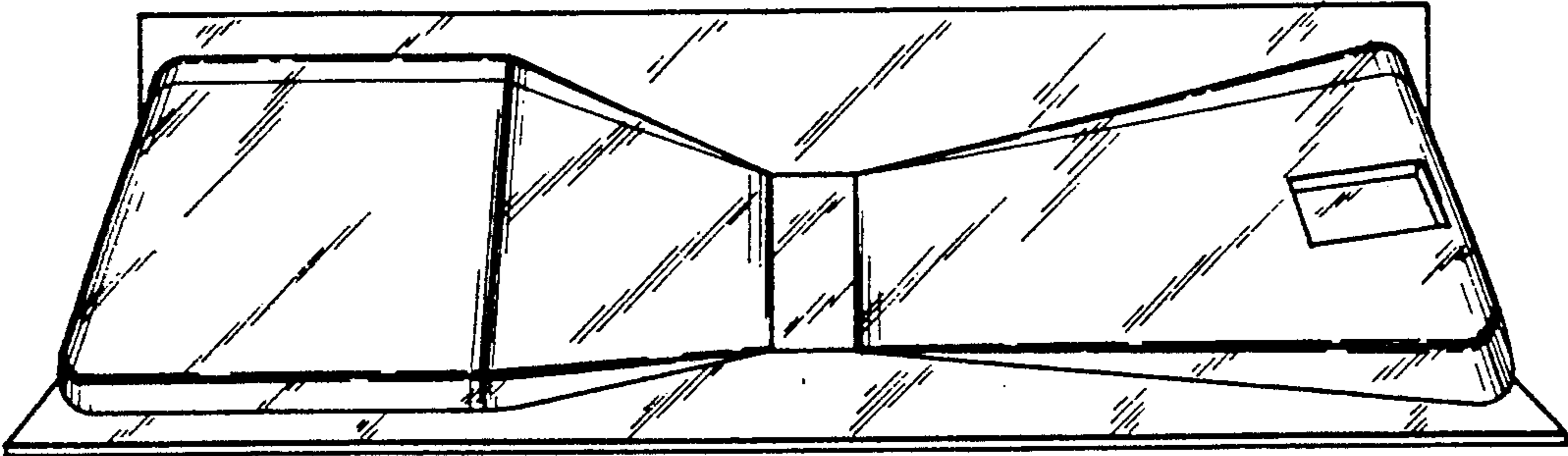

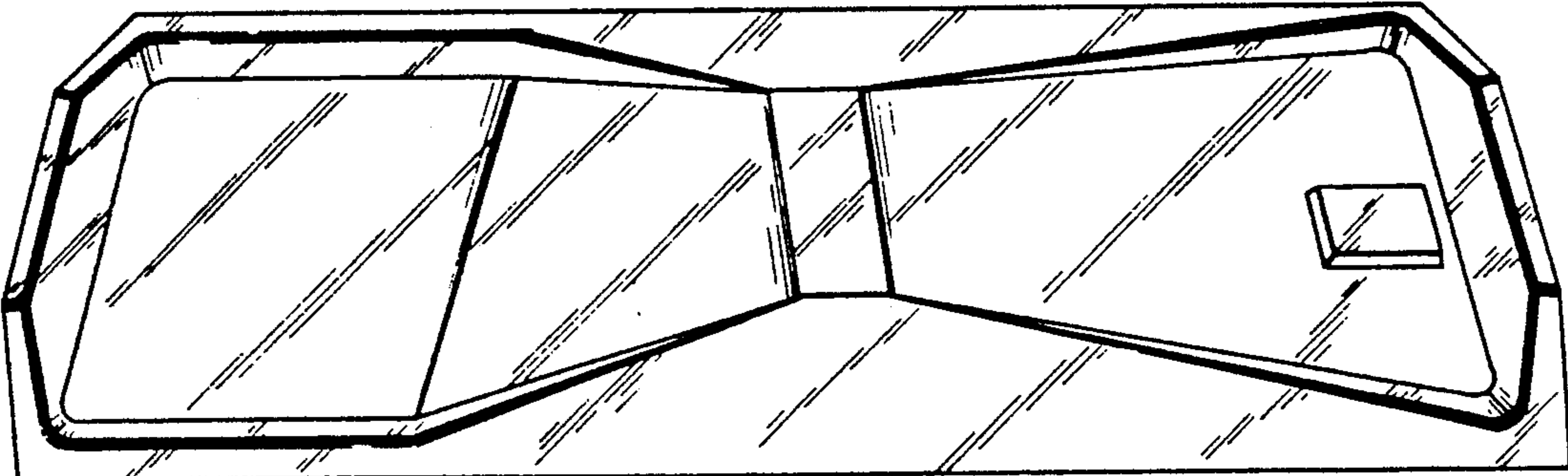

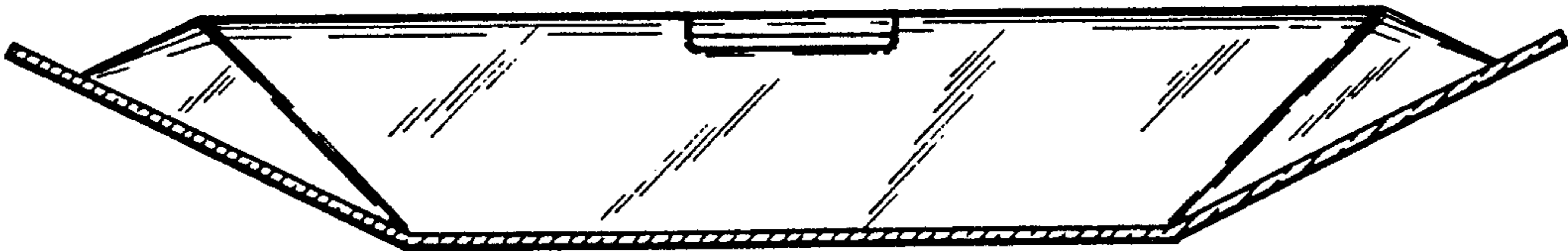

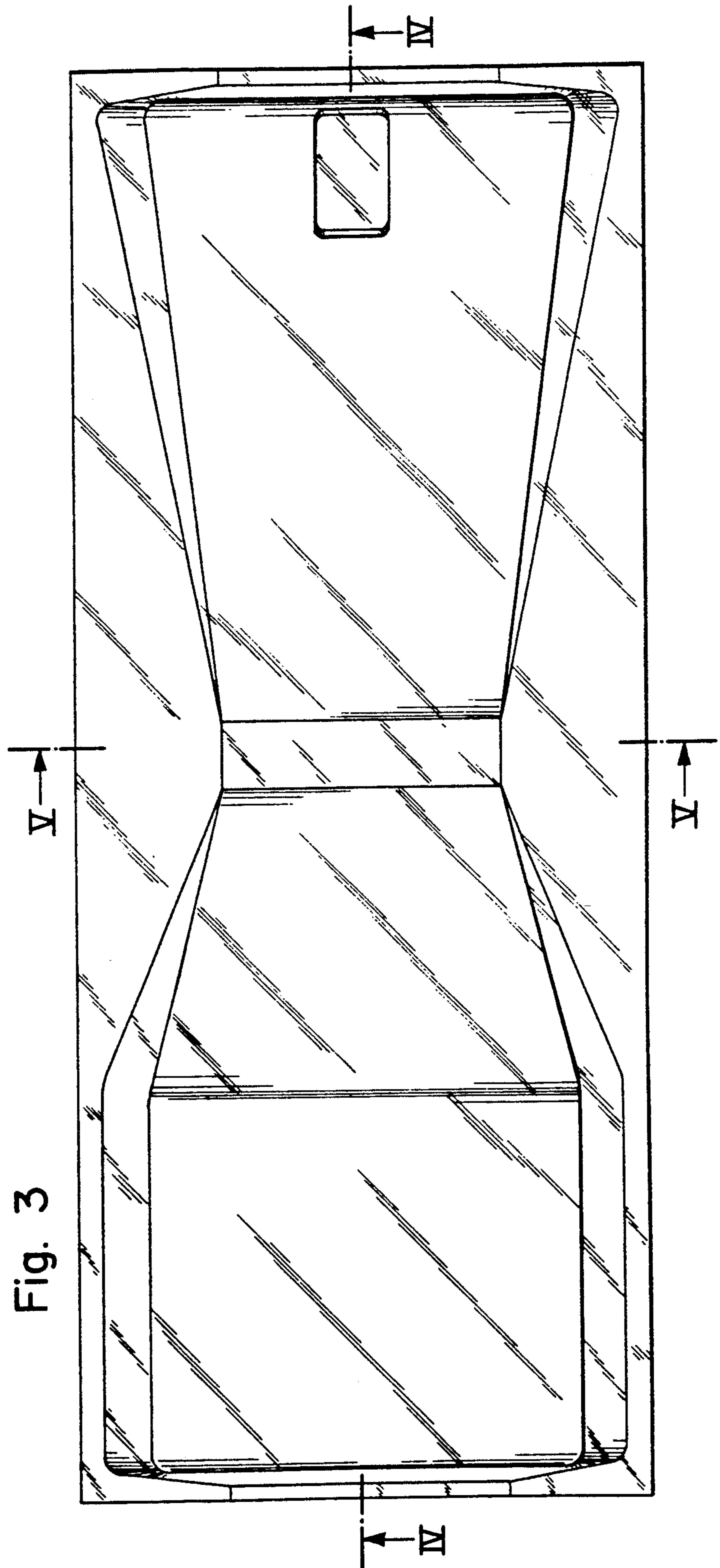

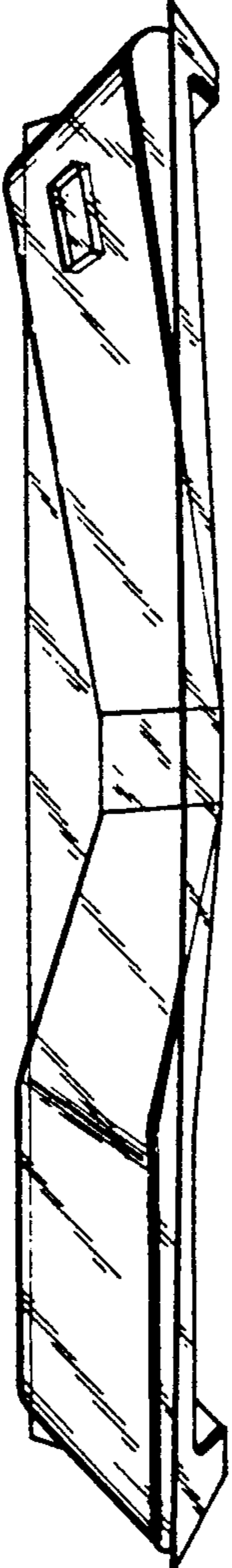

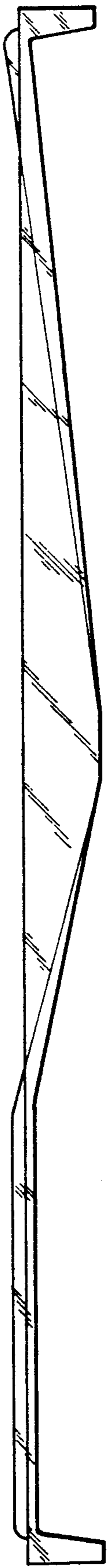
