DESCRIPTION

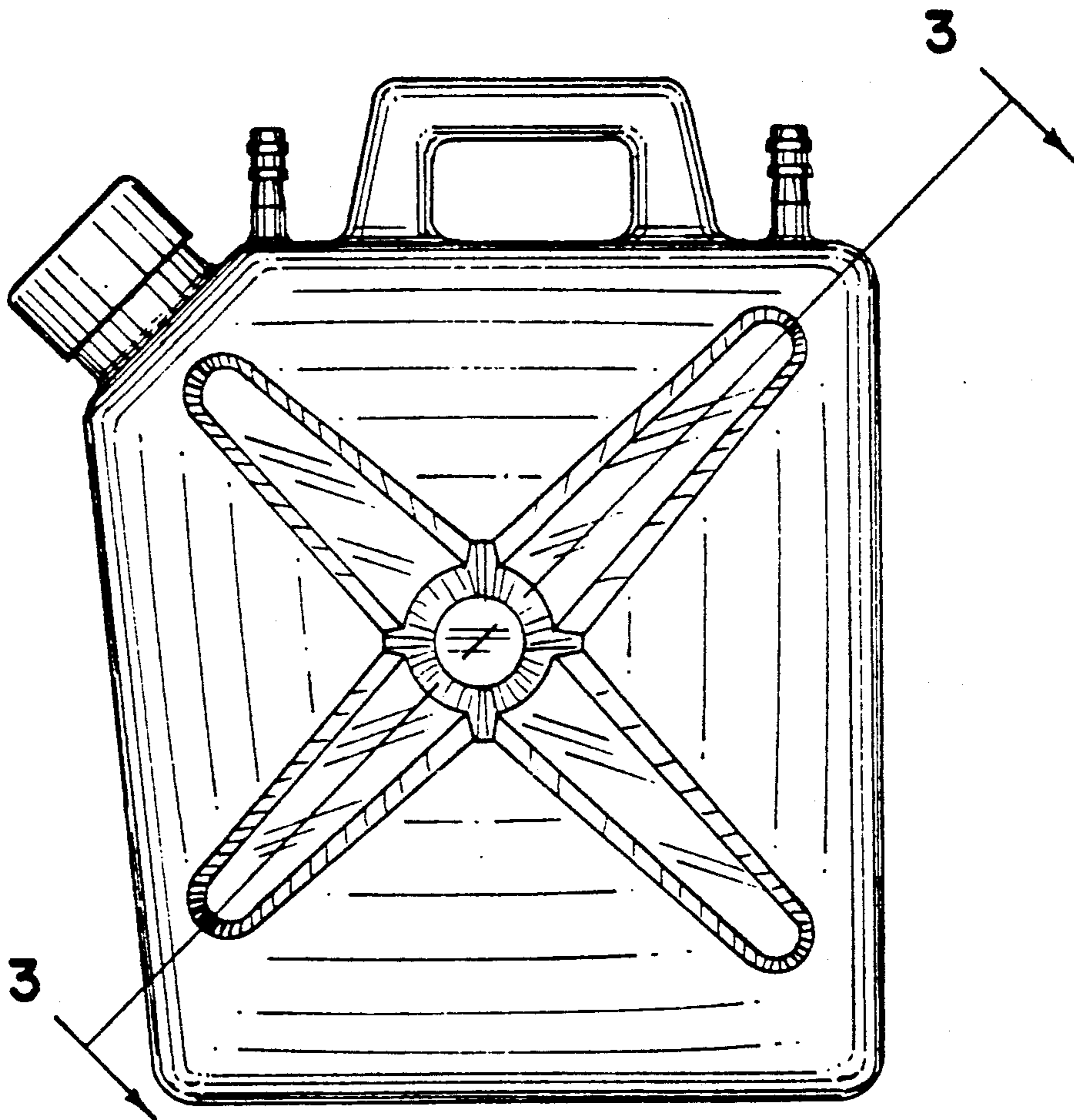
FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view from above of a combined bottle and cap or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side is a mirror image thereto;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof.

The bottom of the bottle is unornamented.



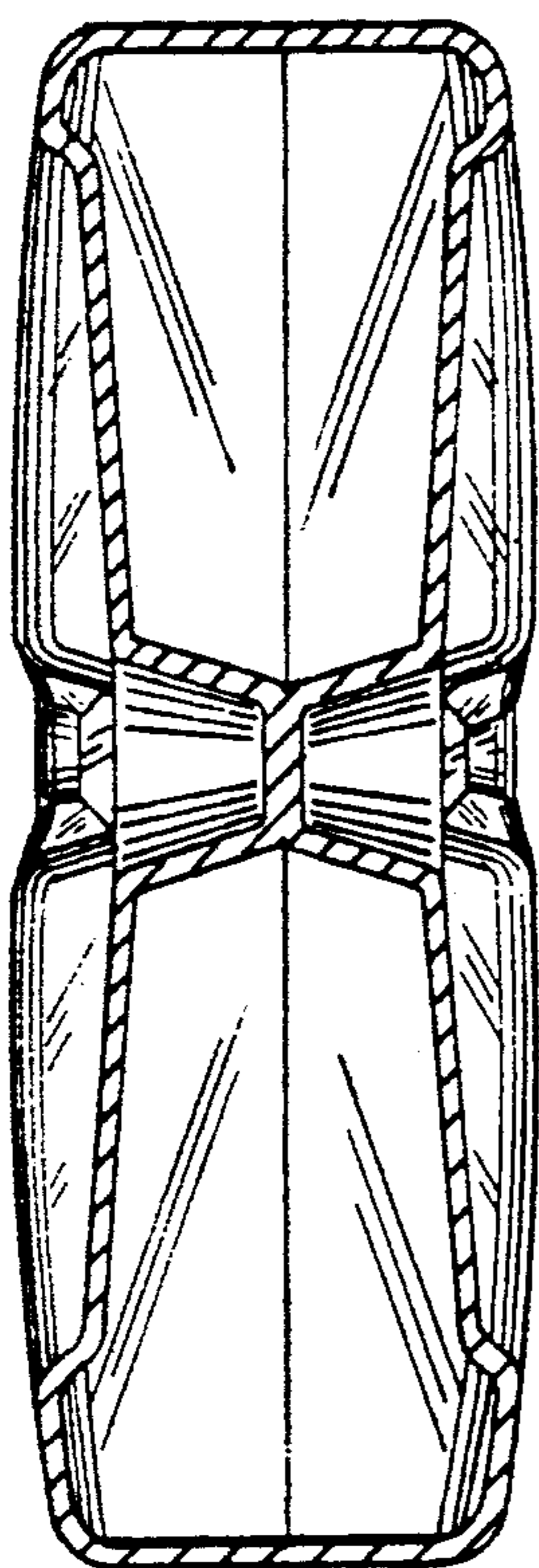

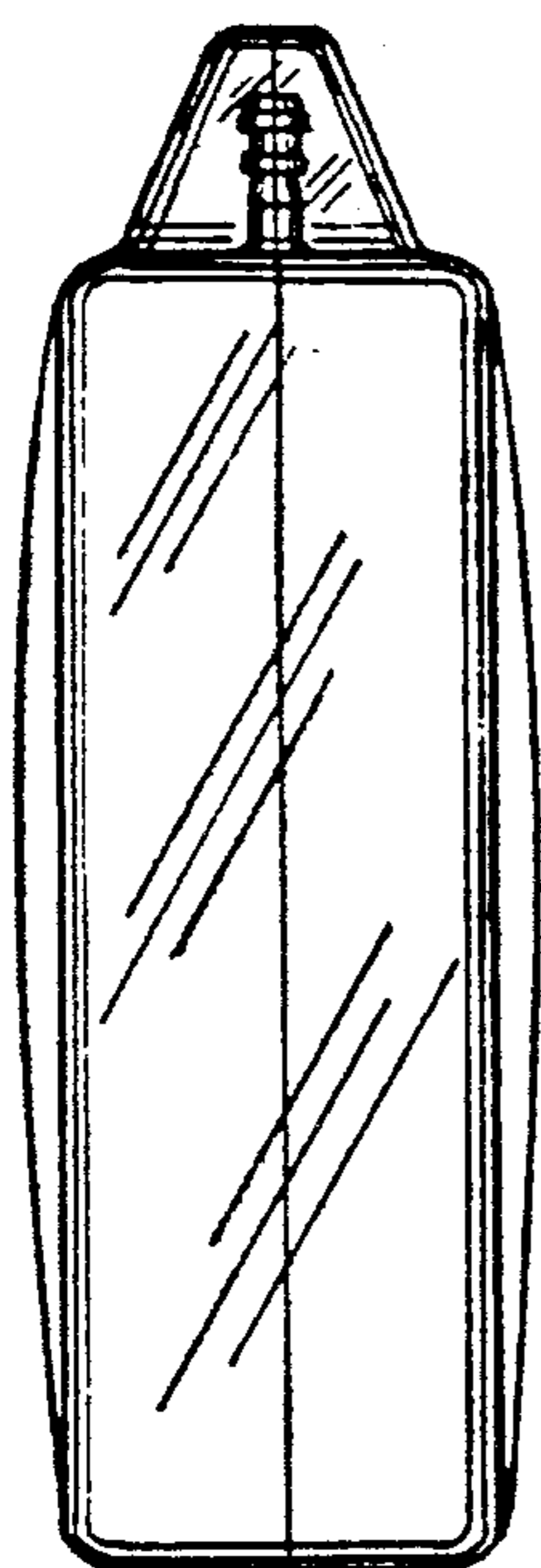

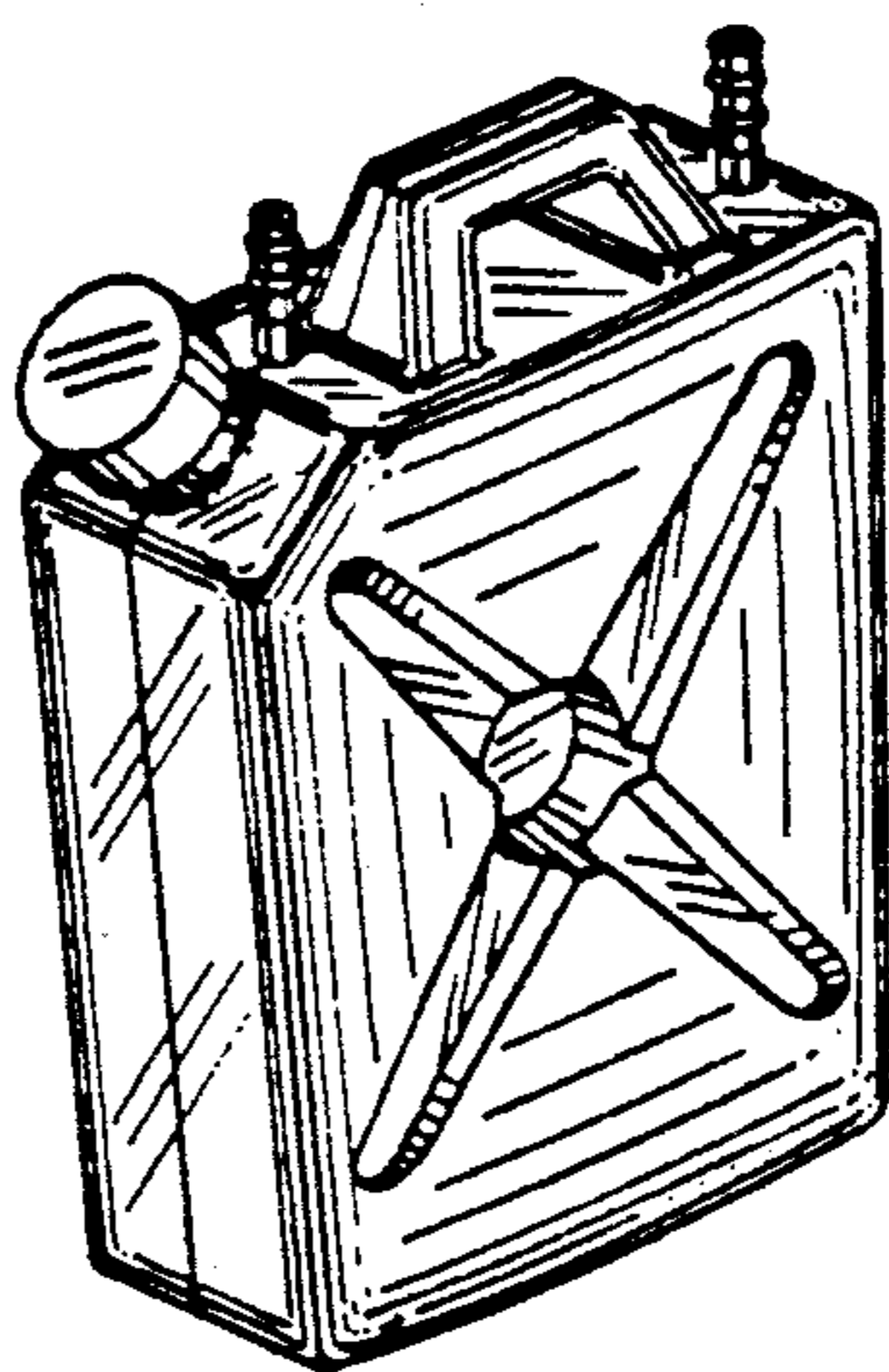

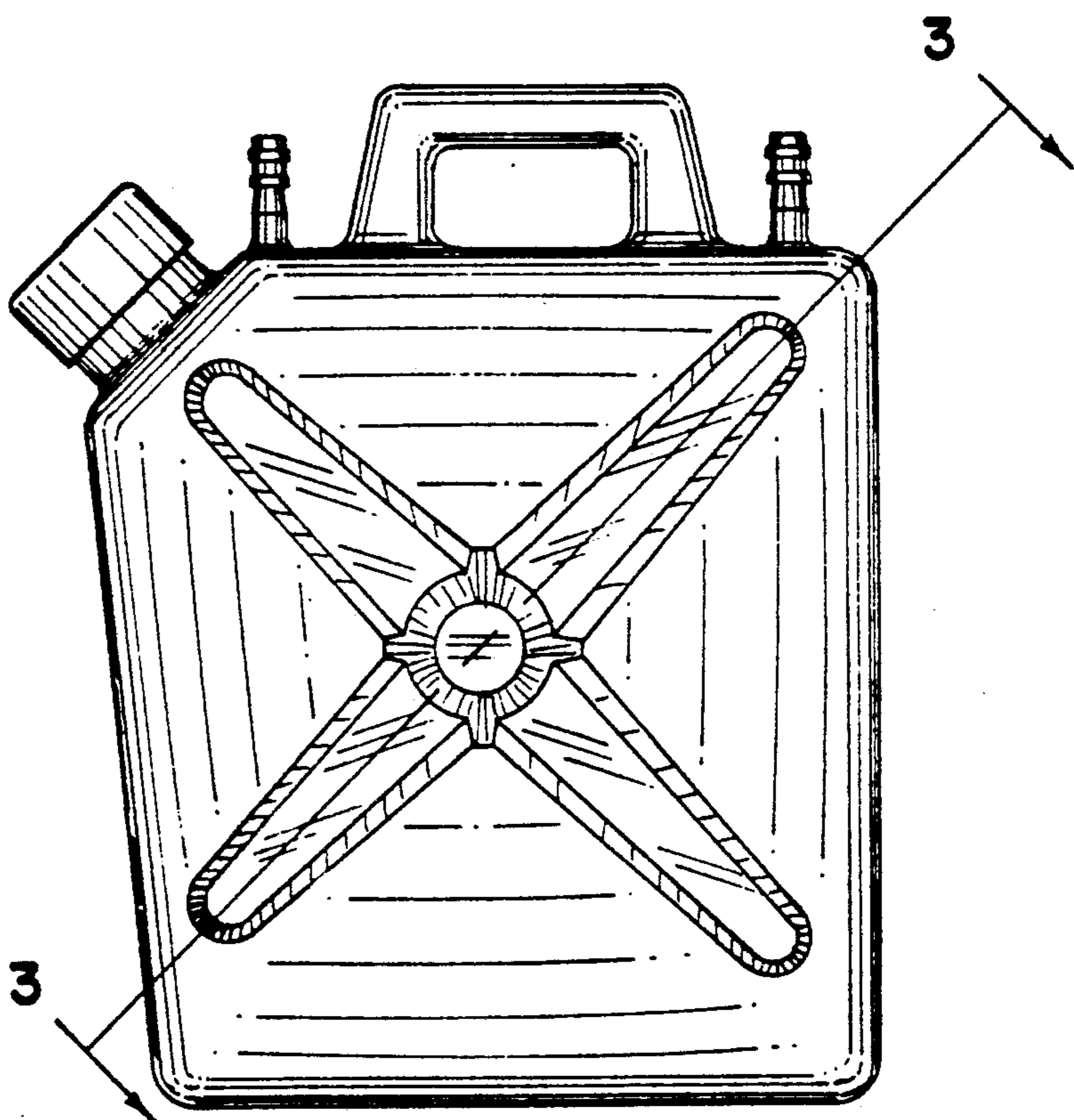
