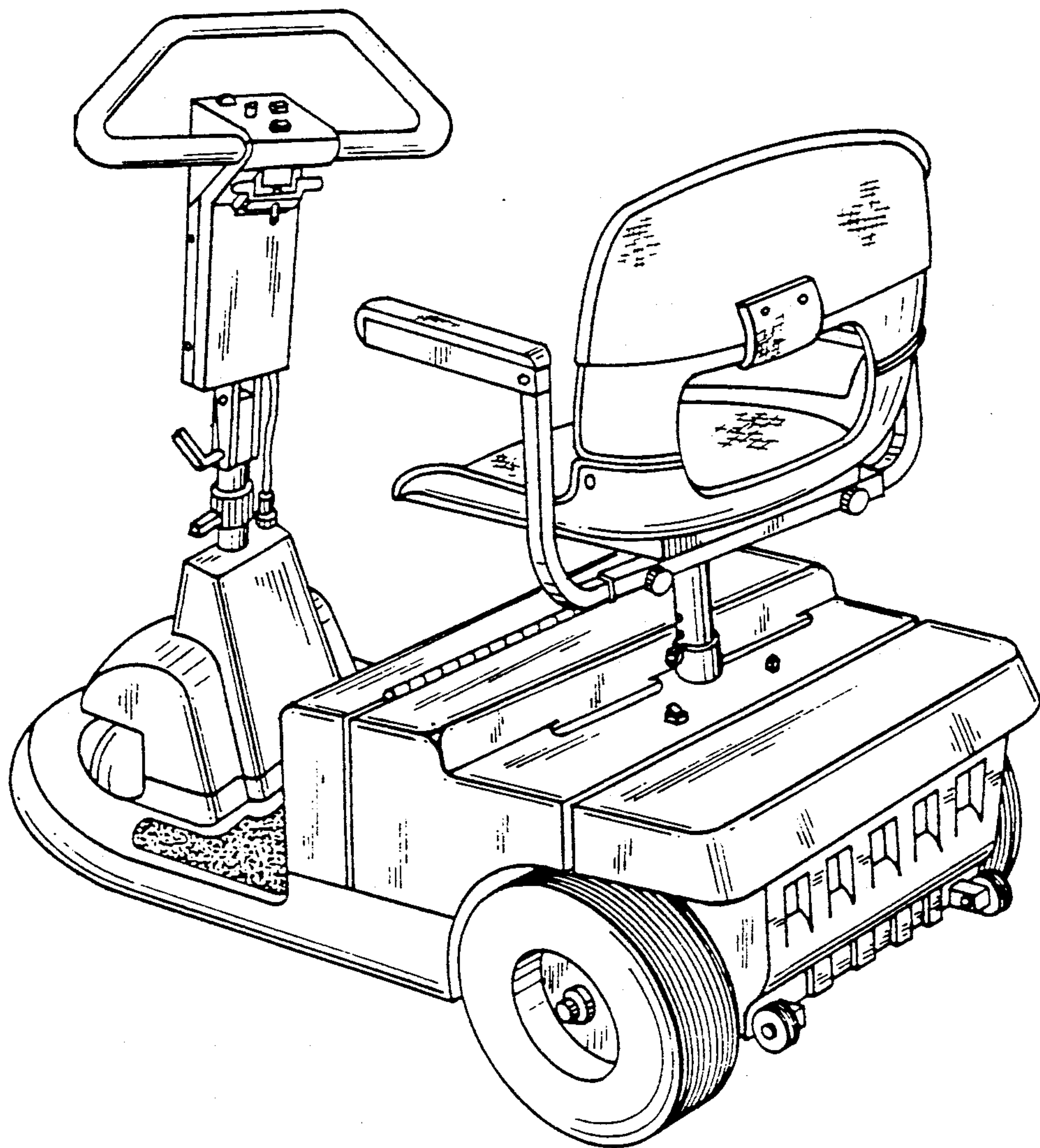

The undisclosed bottom is flat and unornamented.



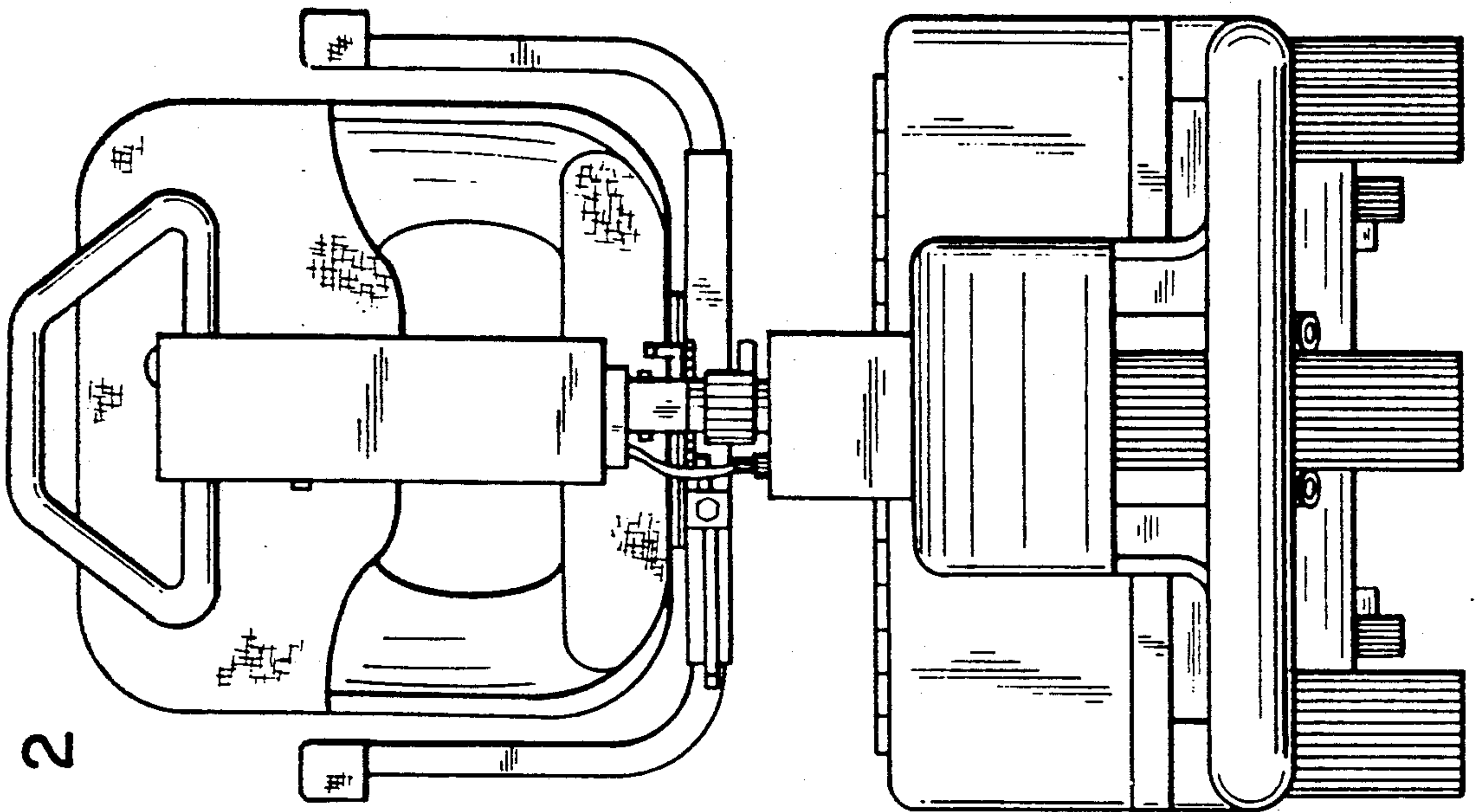

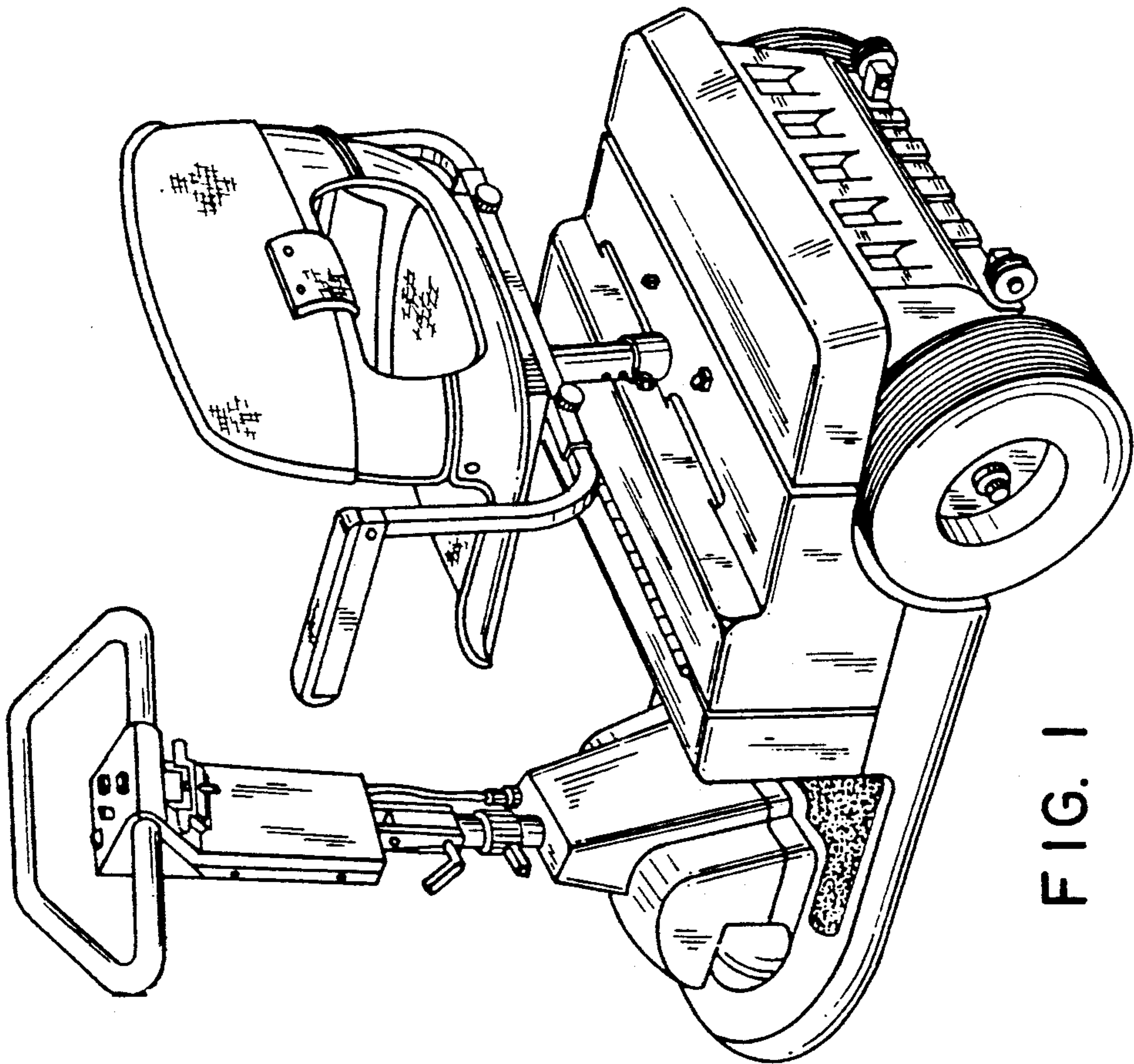

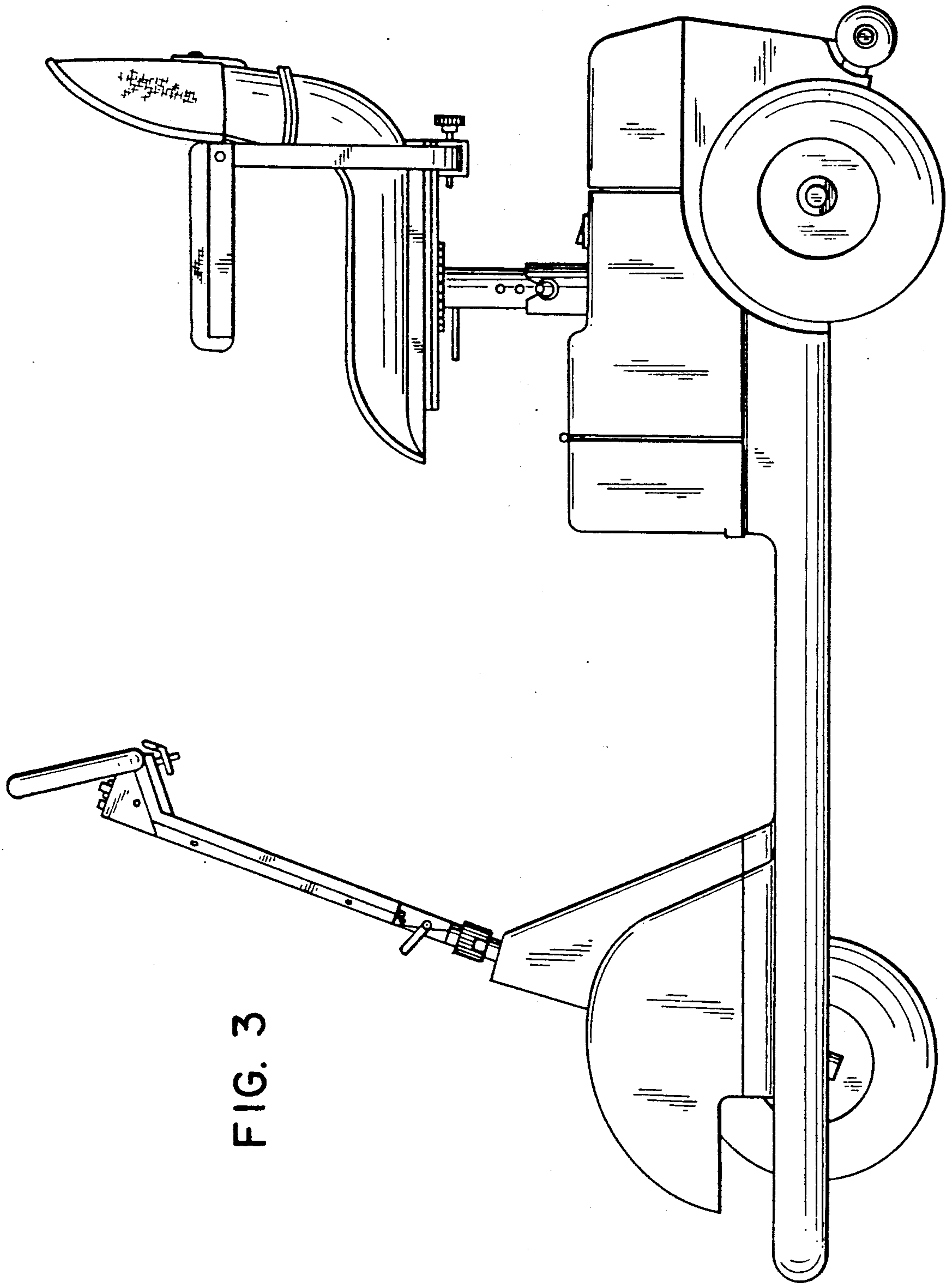
