DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a blade-type fuse block showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom surface being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

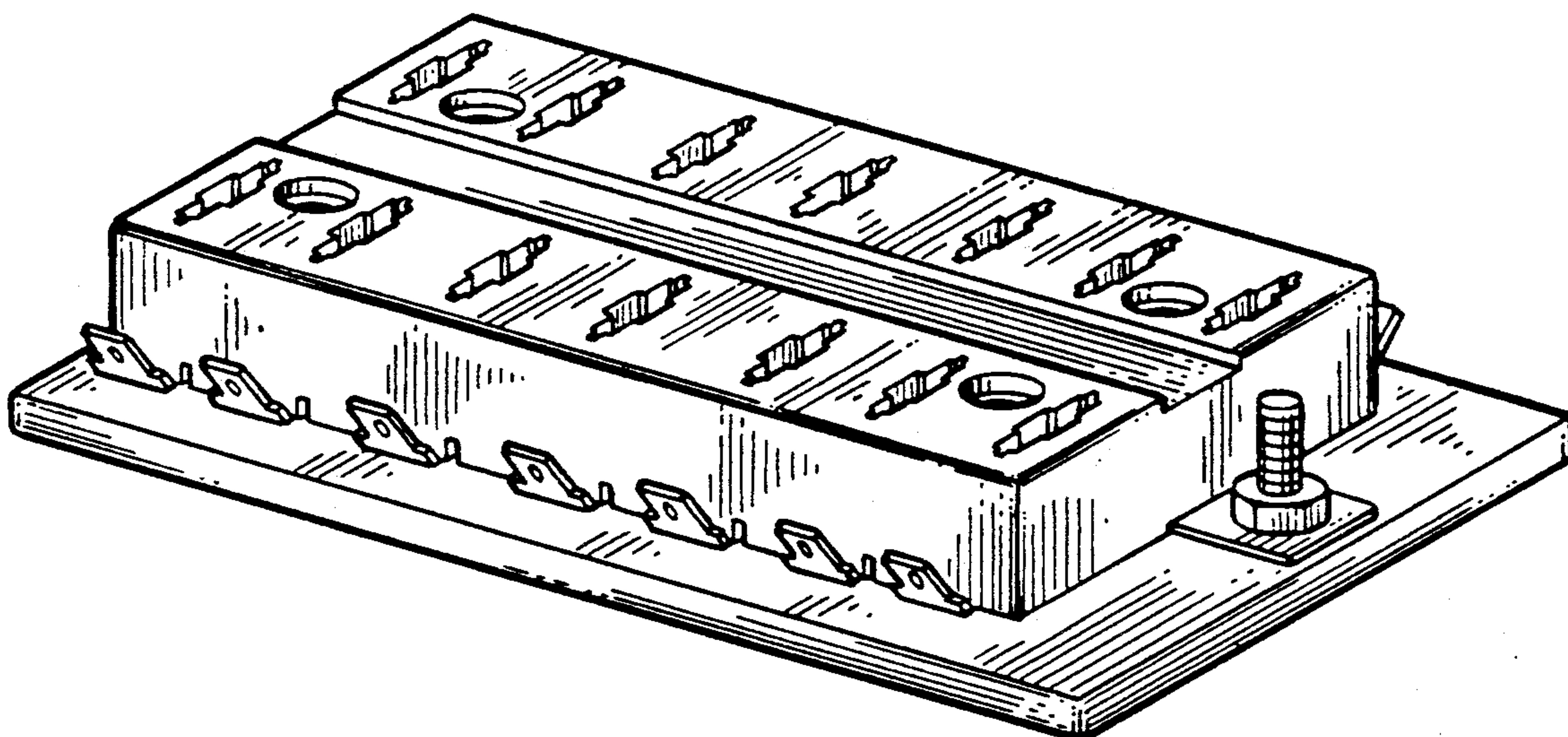

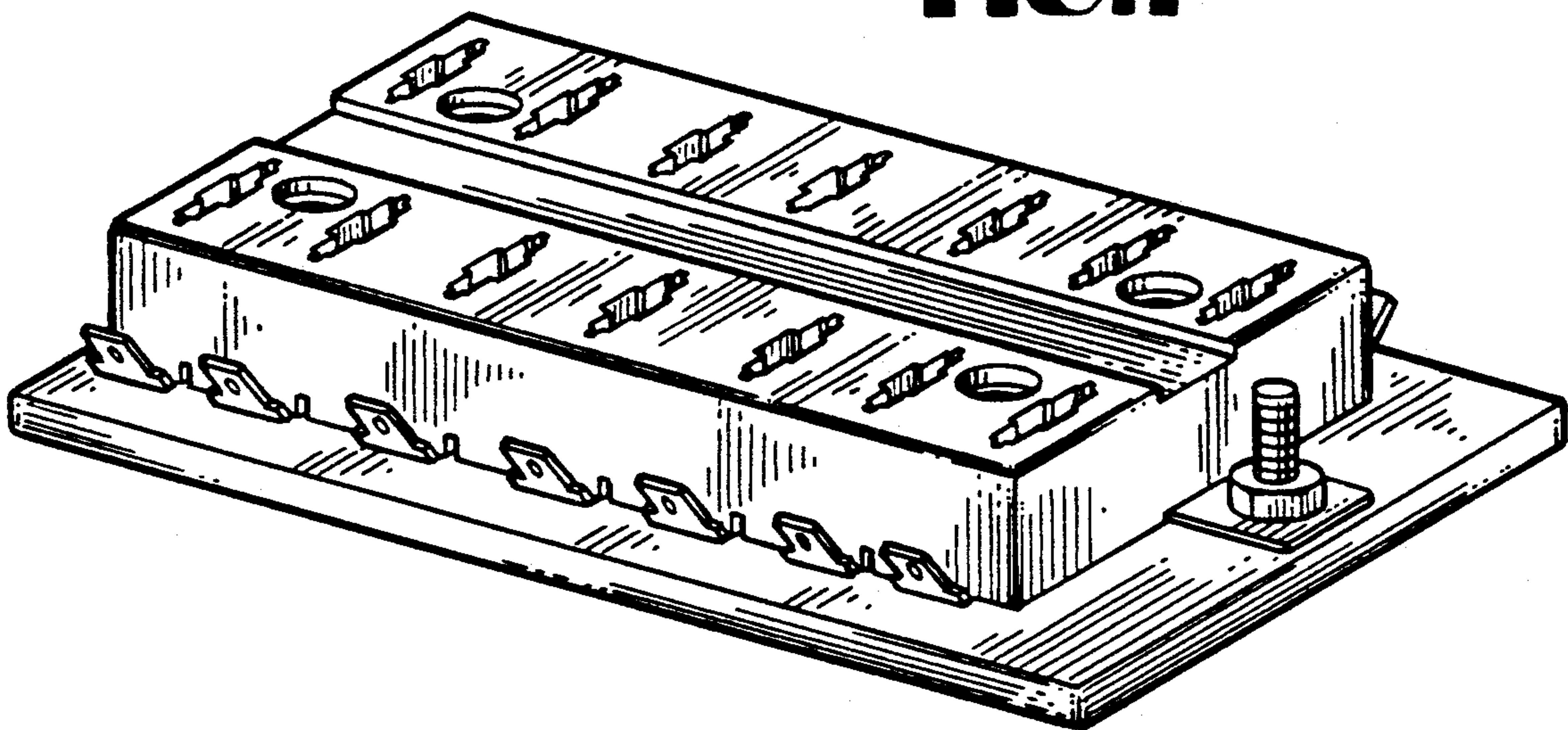

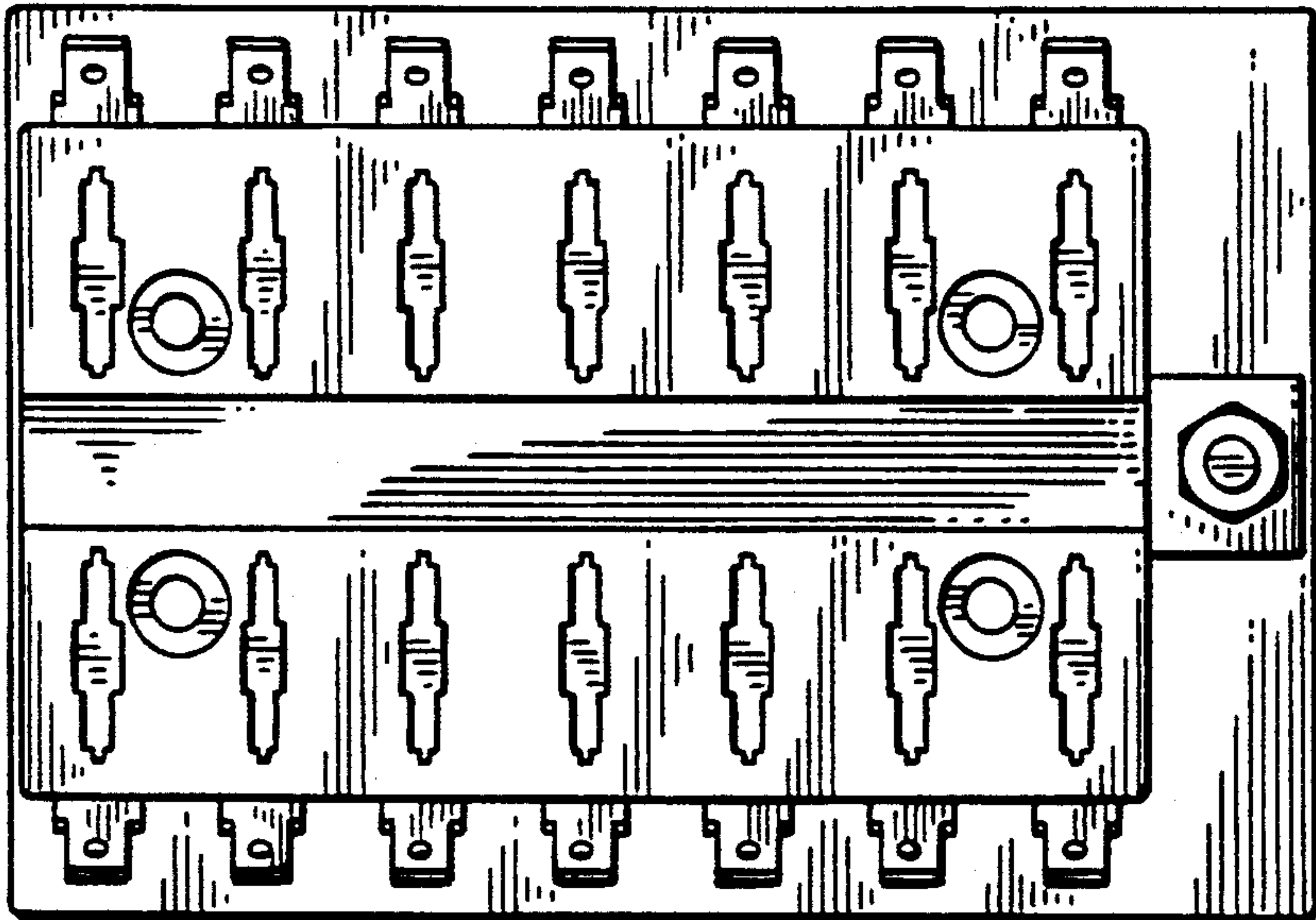

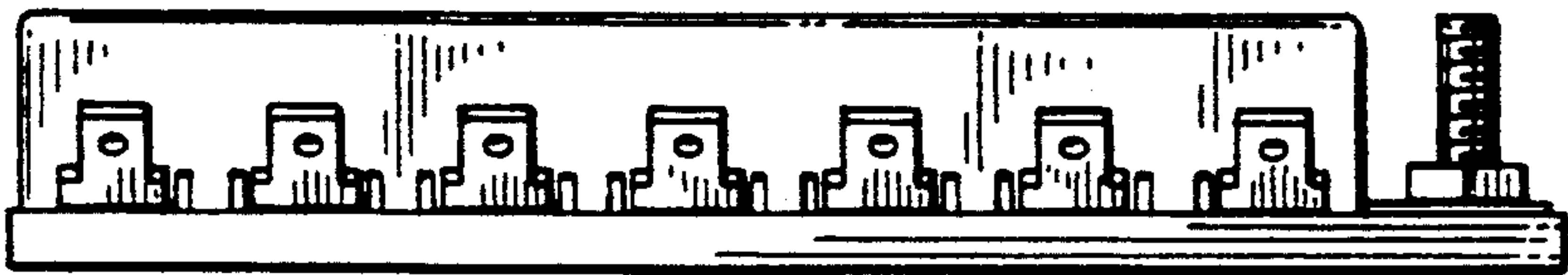

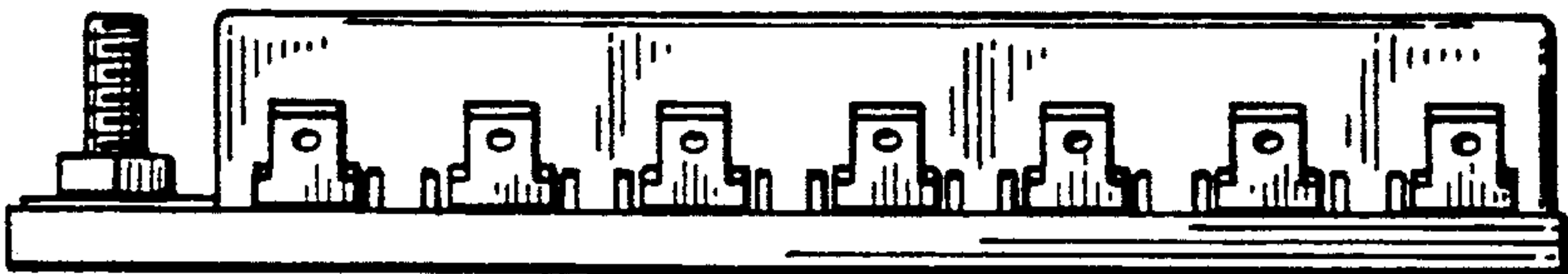
