[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for novelty eyeglasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front, perspective view of novelty eyeglasses showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a left rear perspective view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.
