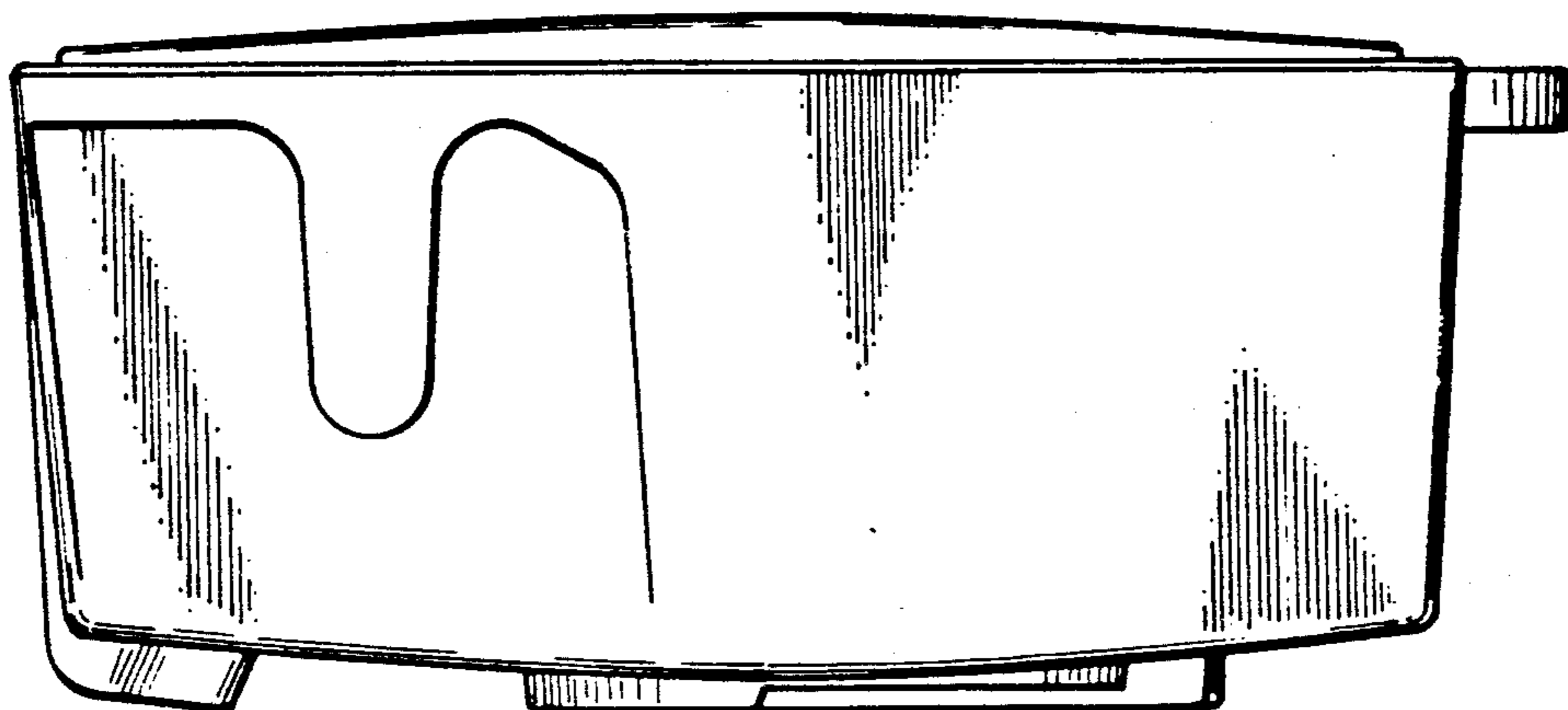
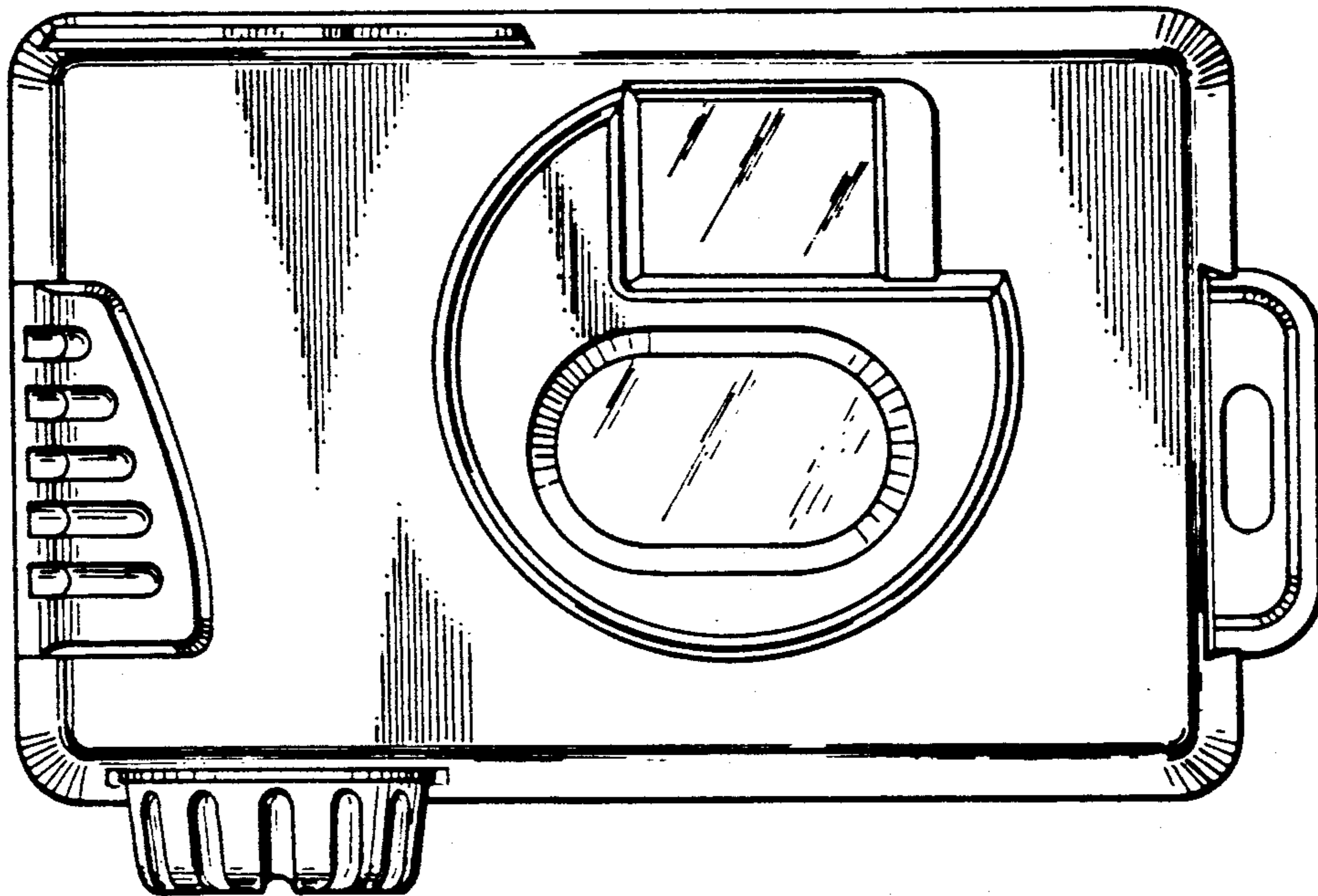

FIG. 6 is a left-side elevation thereof.



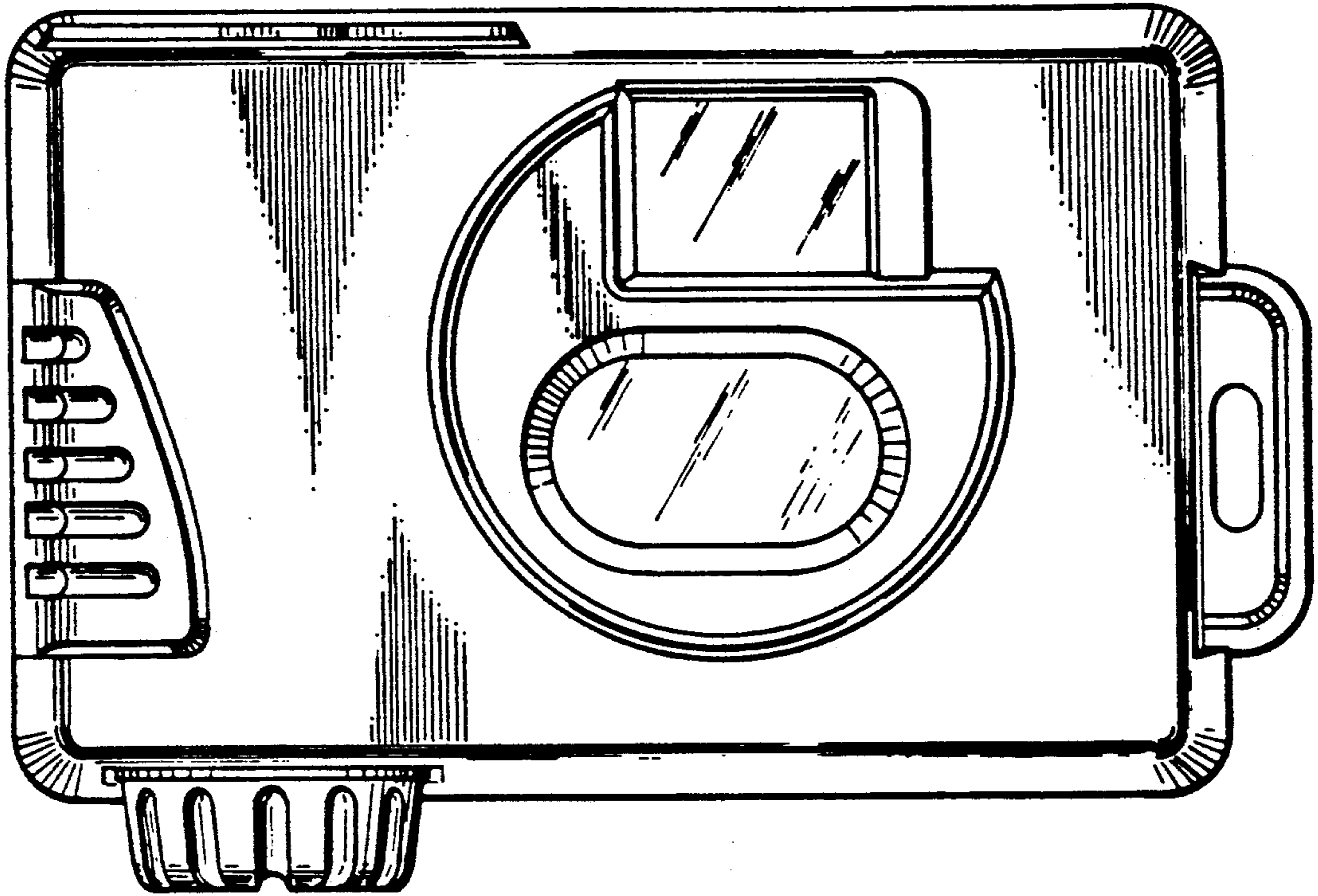

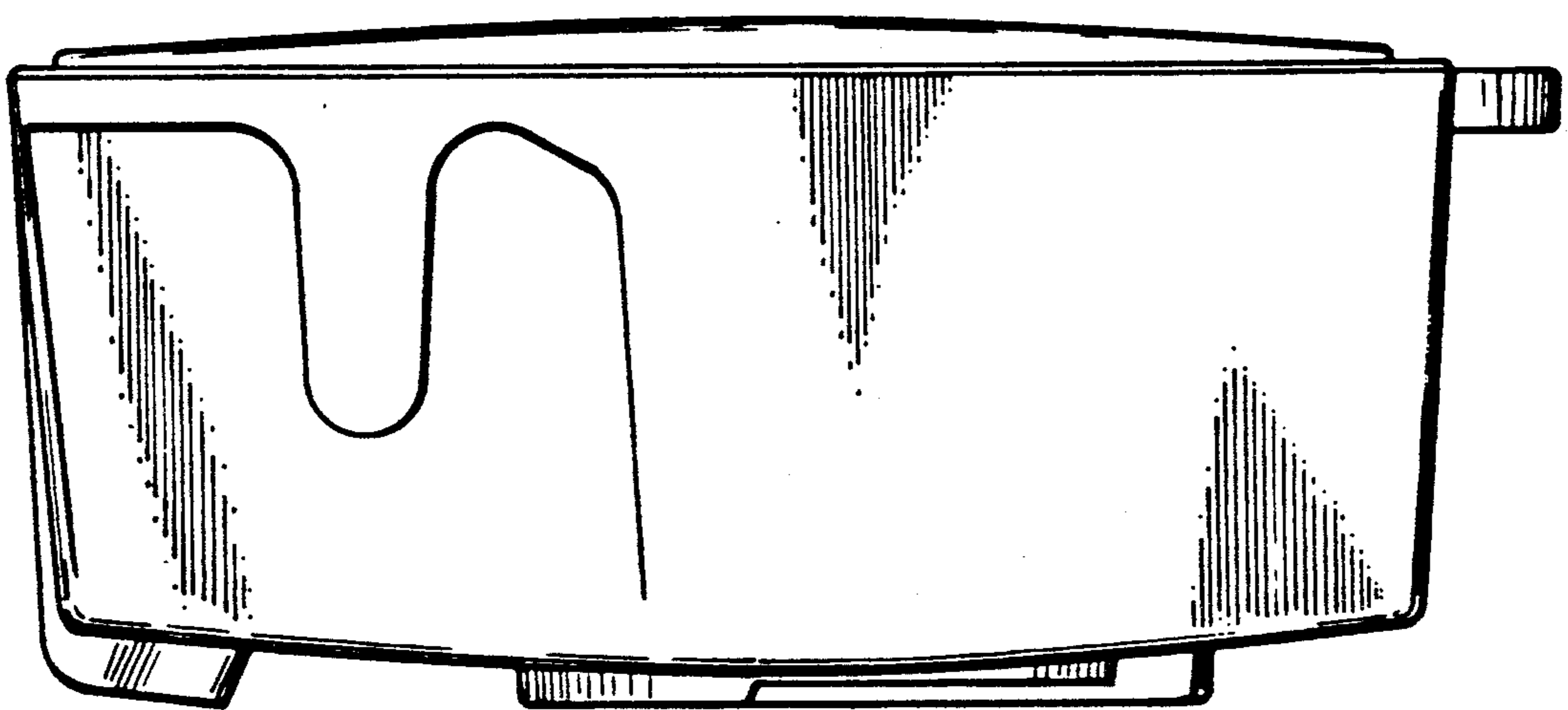

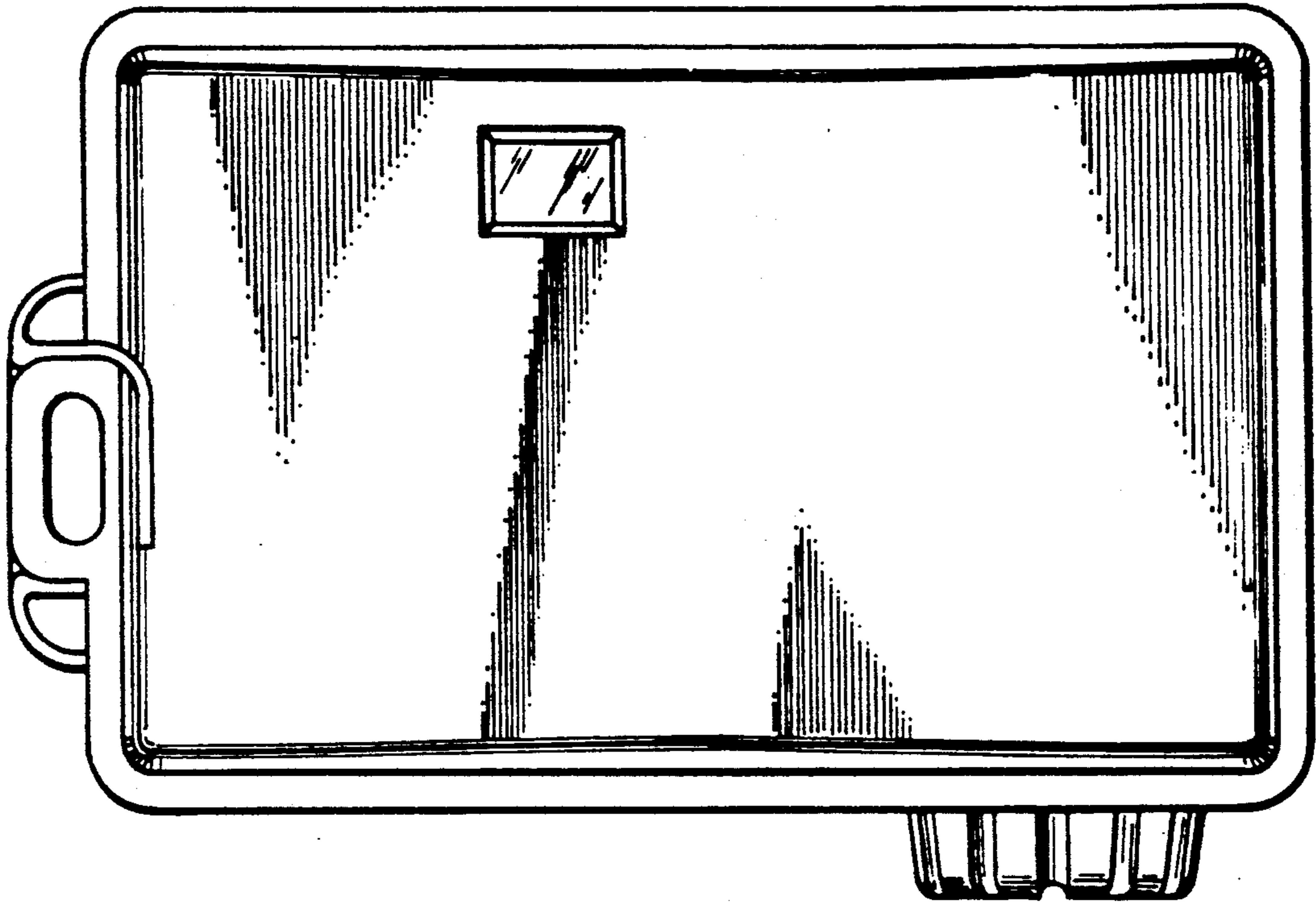

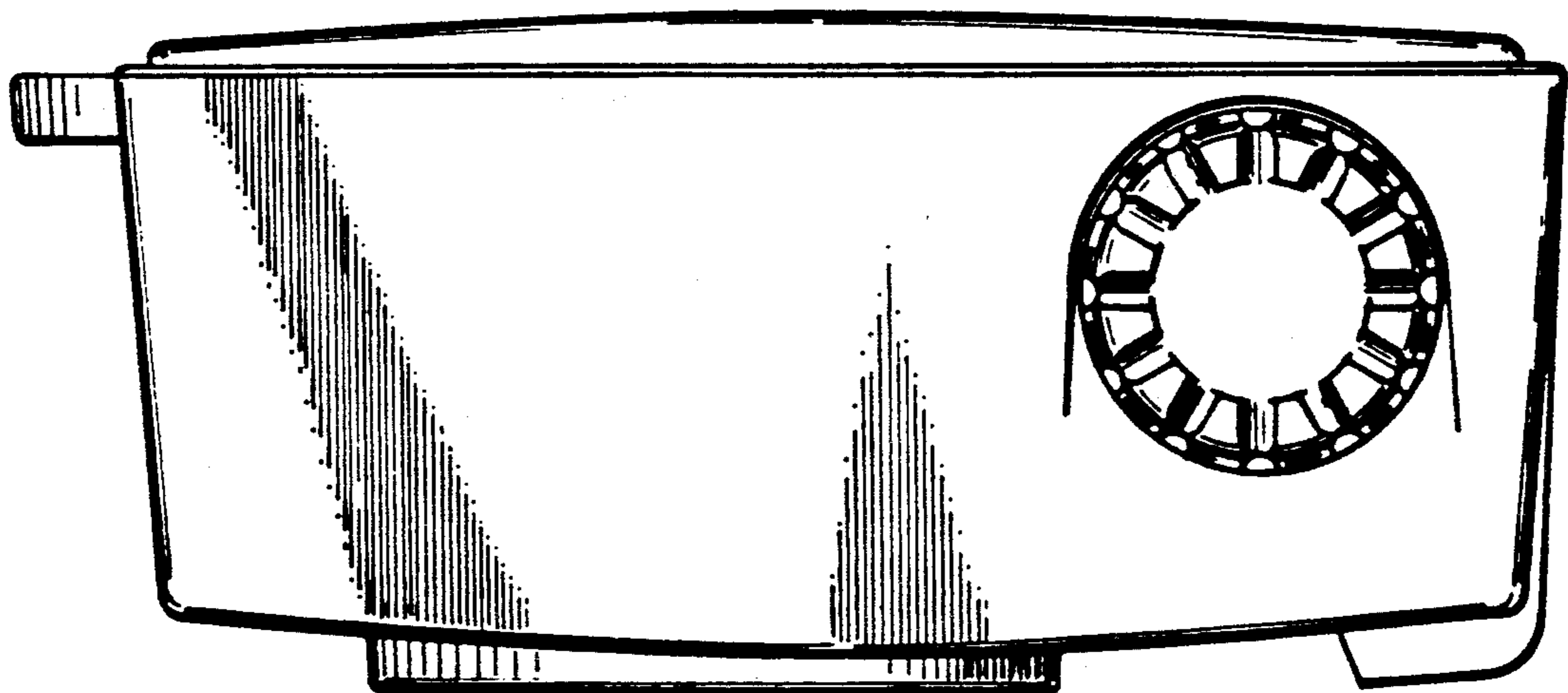

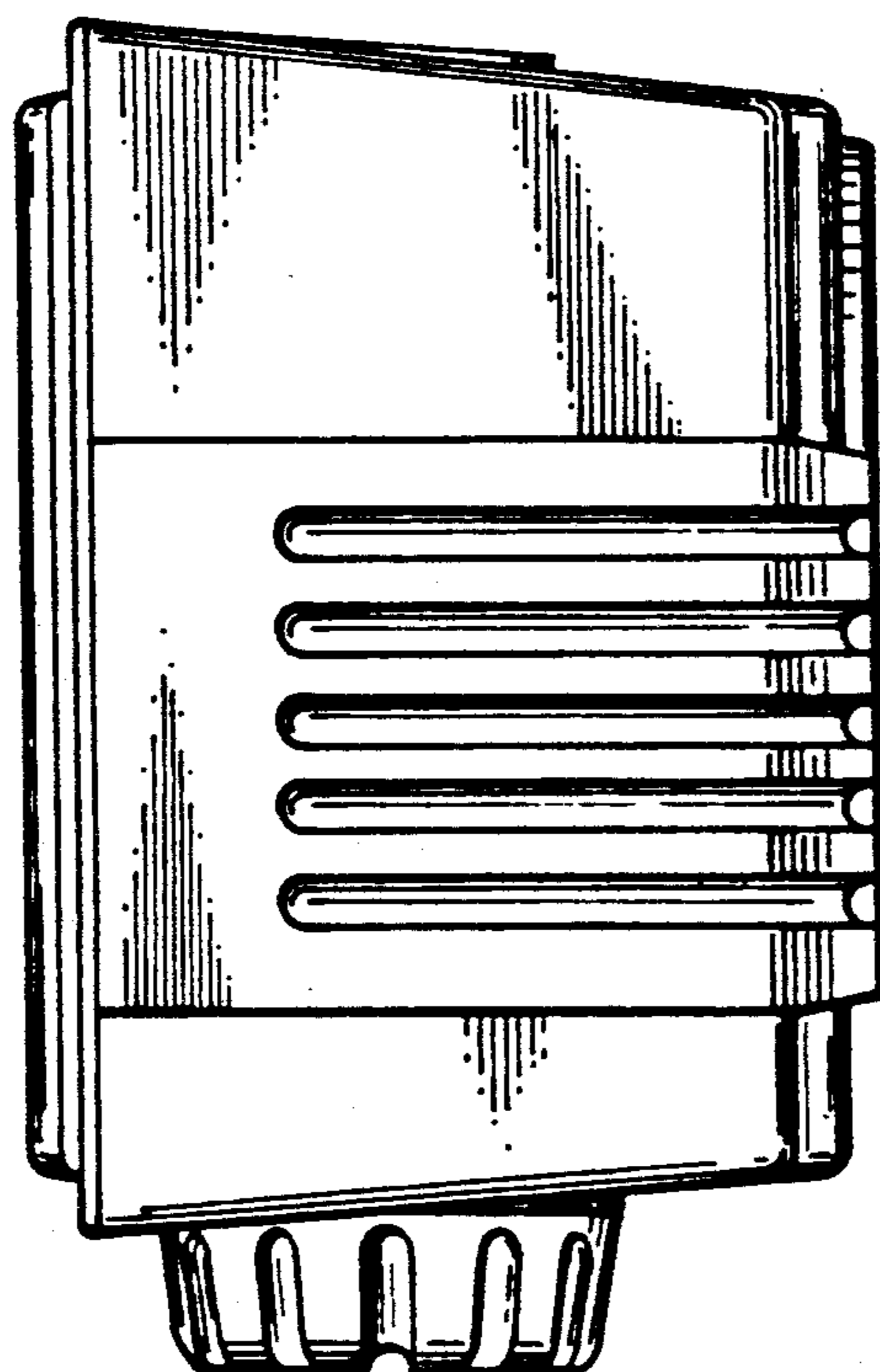
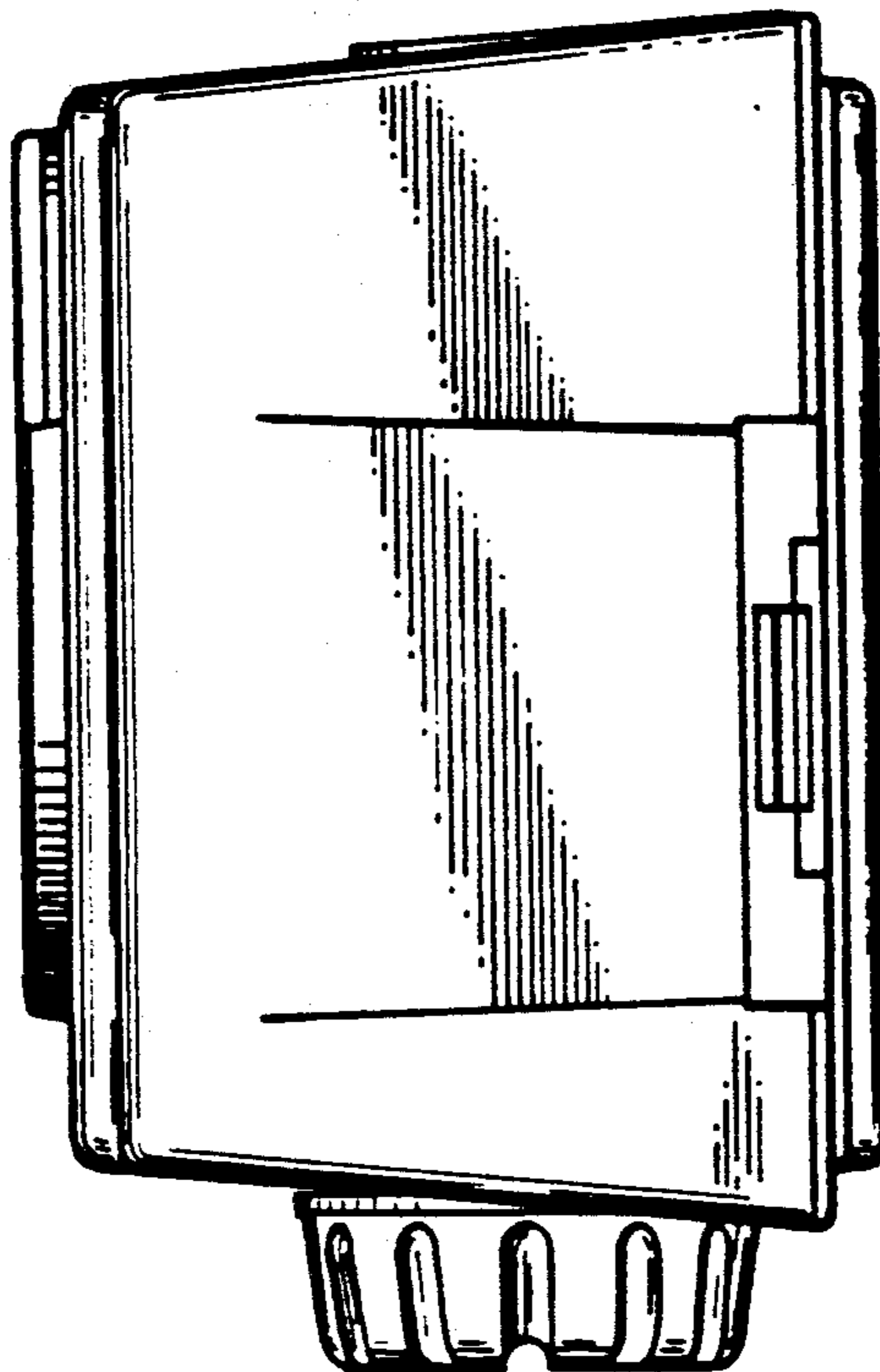
