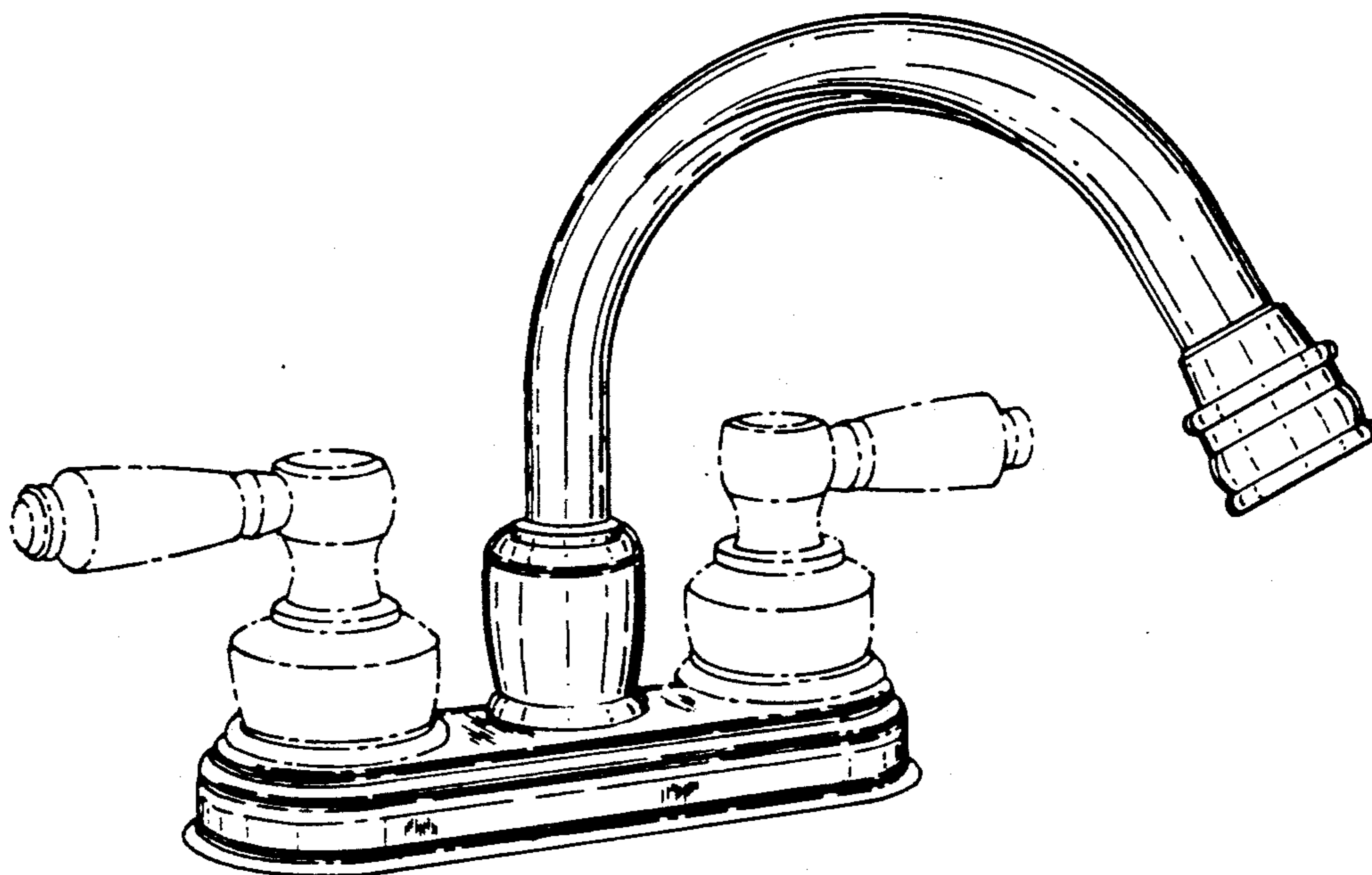

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a faucet body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a faucet body showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a modified form of the faucet body shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 6, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 6;
FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 6; and
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 6.
The broken line showing faucet handles in FIGS. 1-10 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.



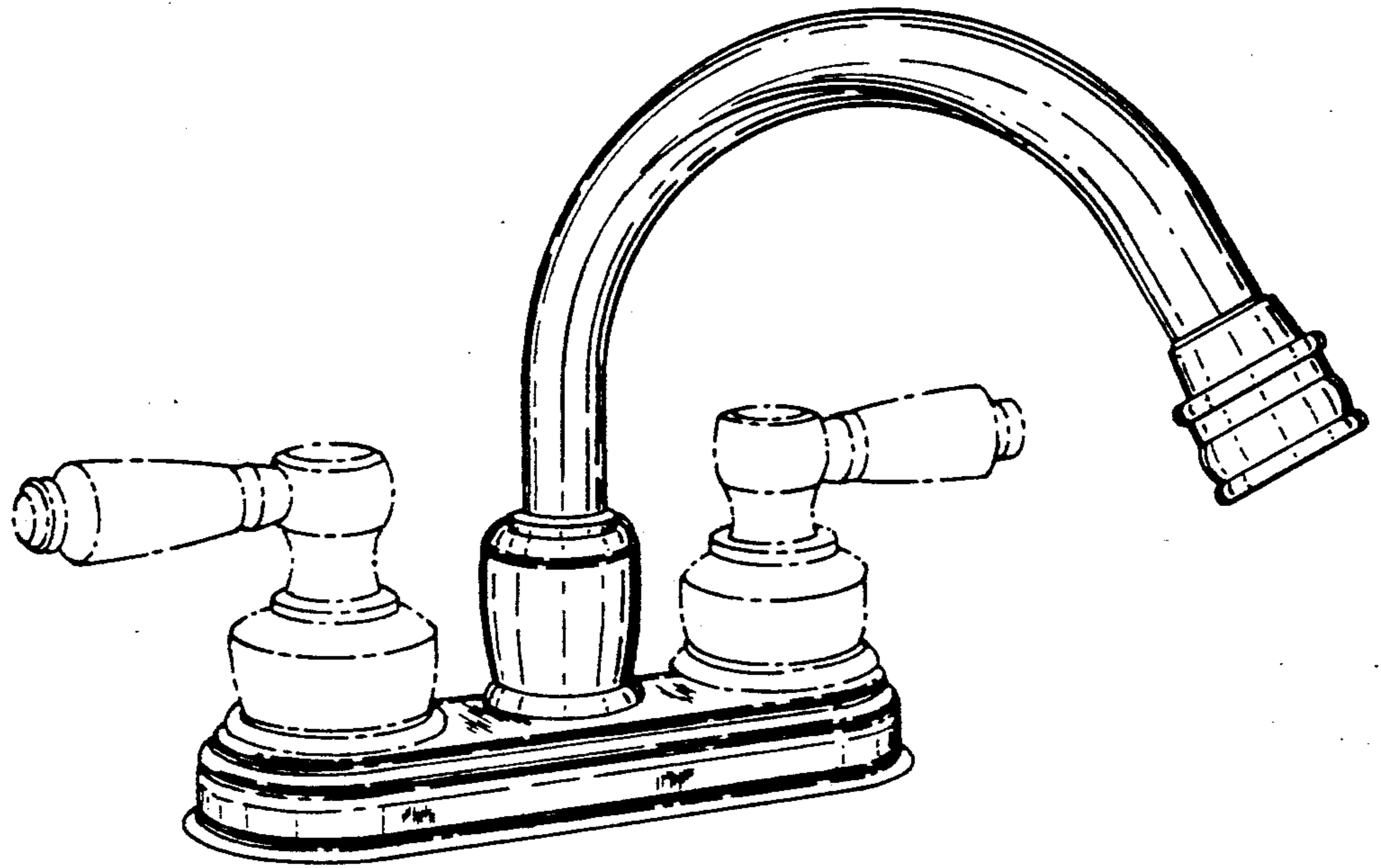

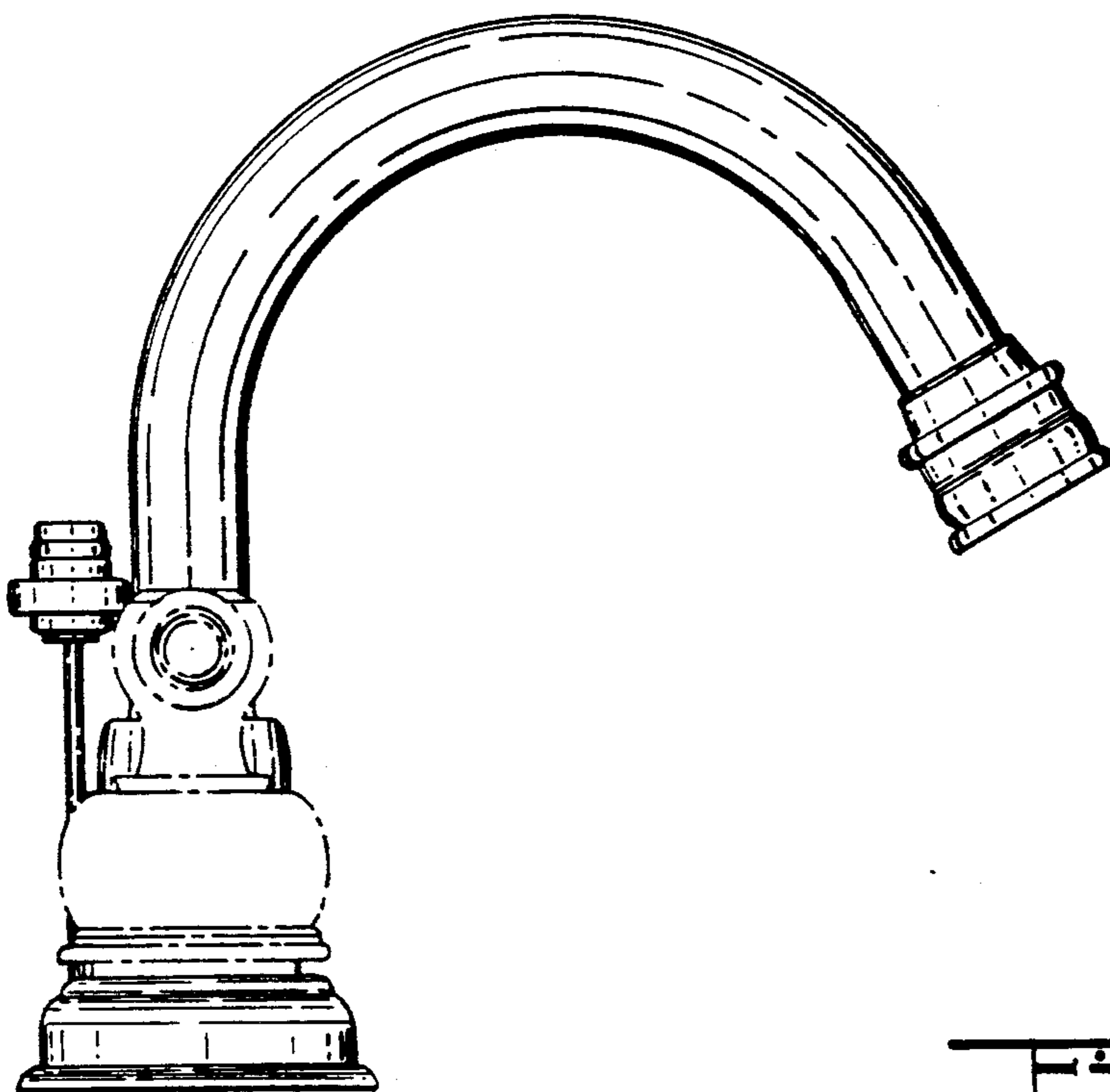

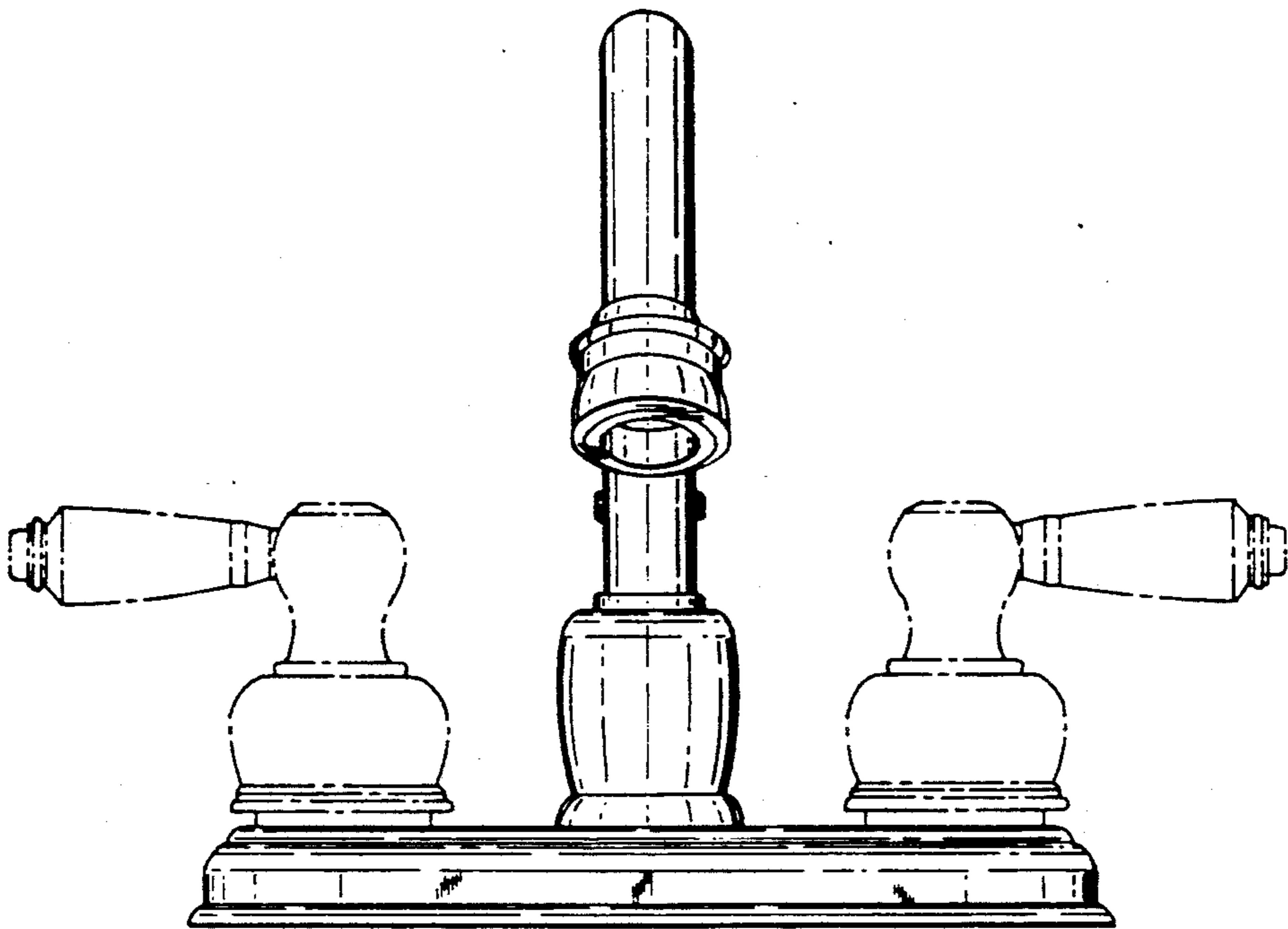

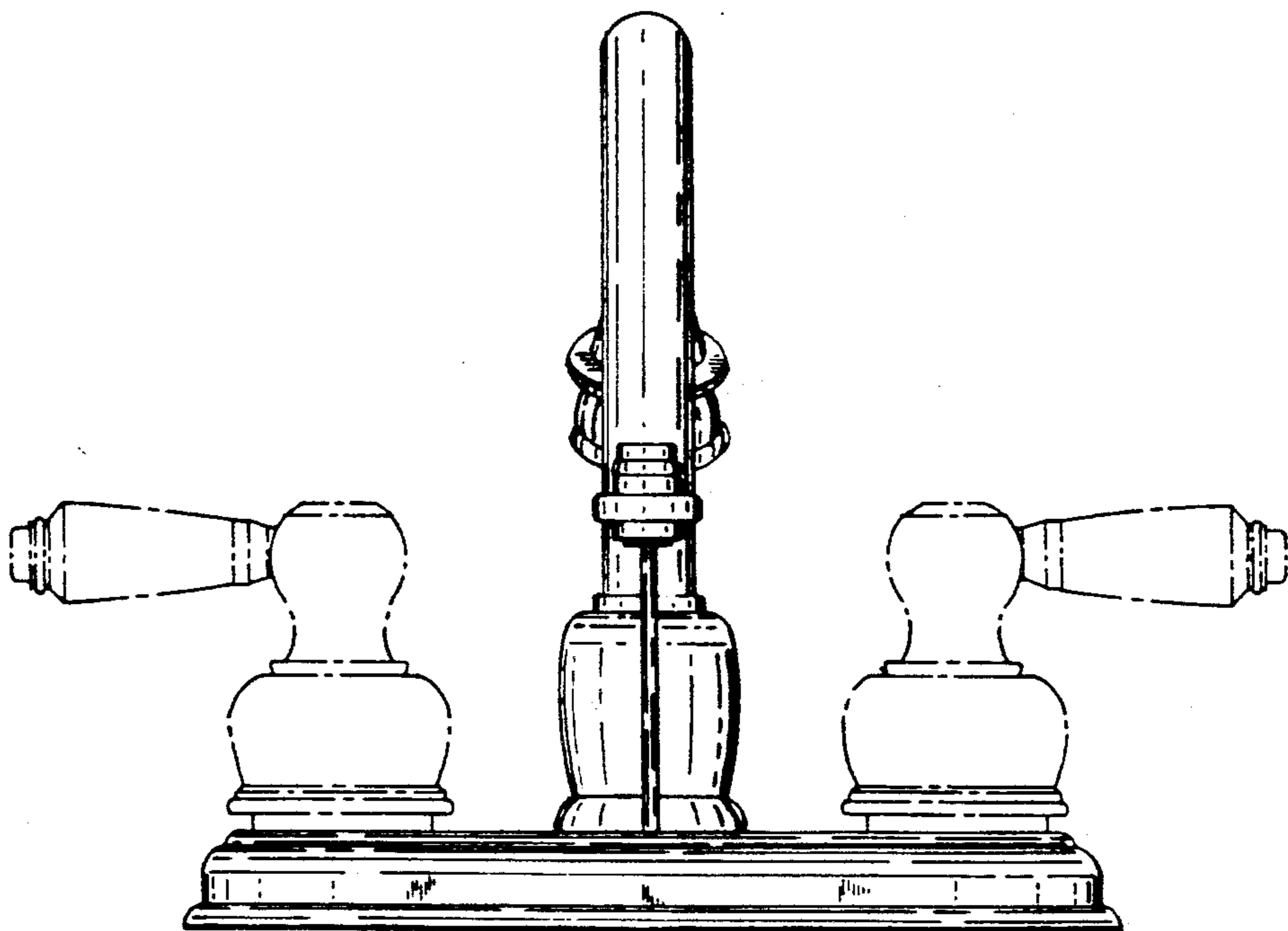

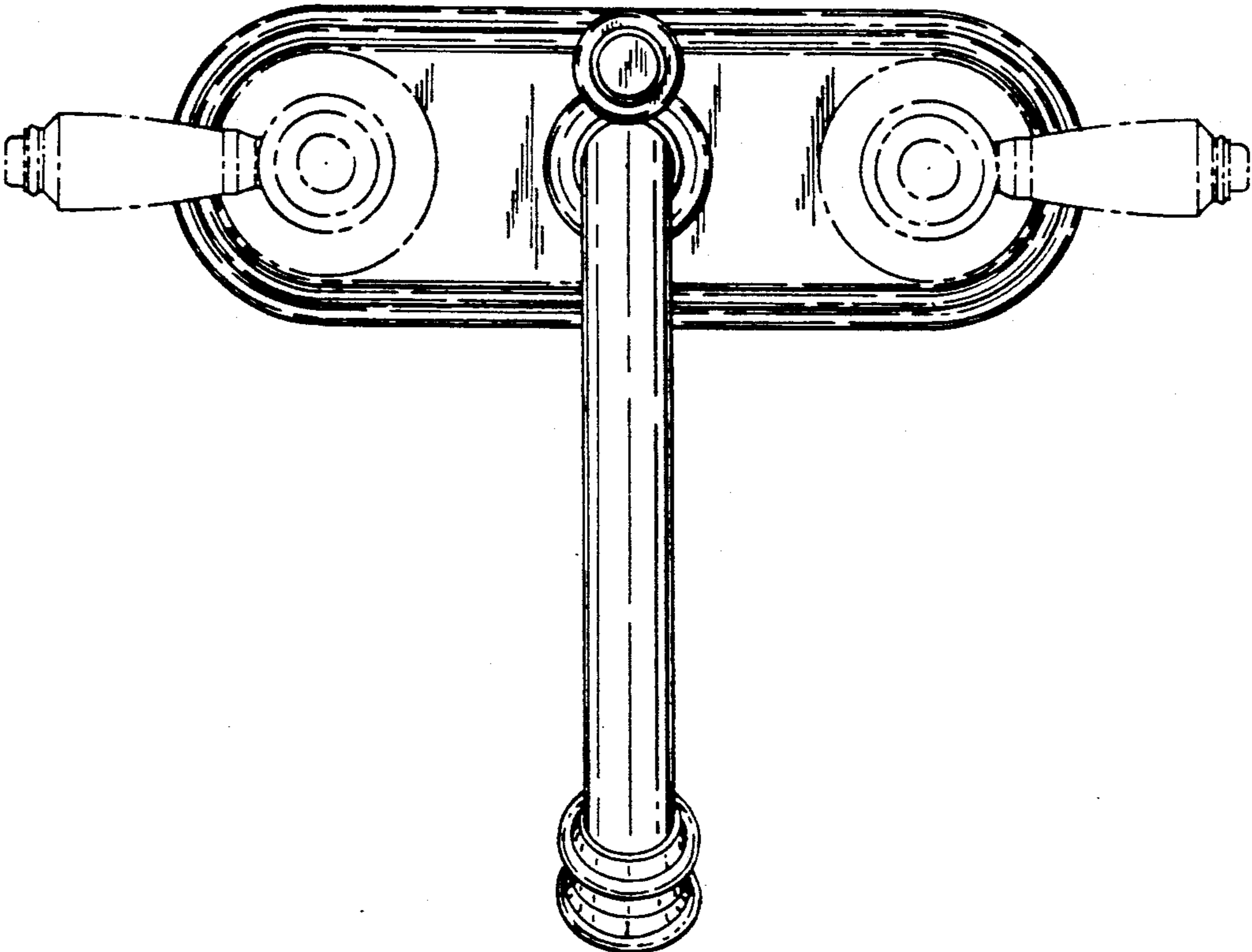

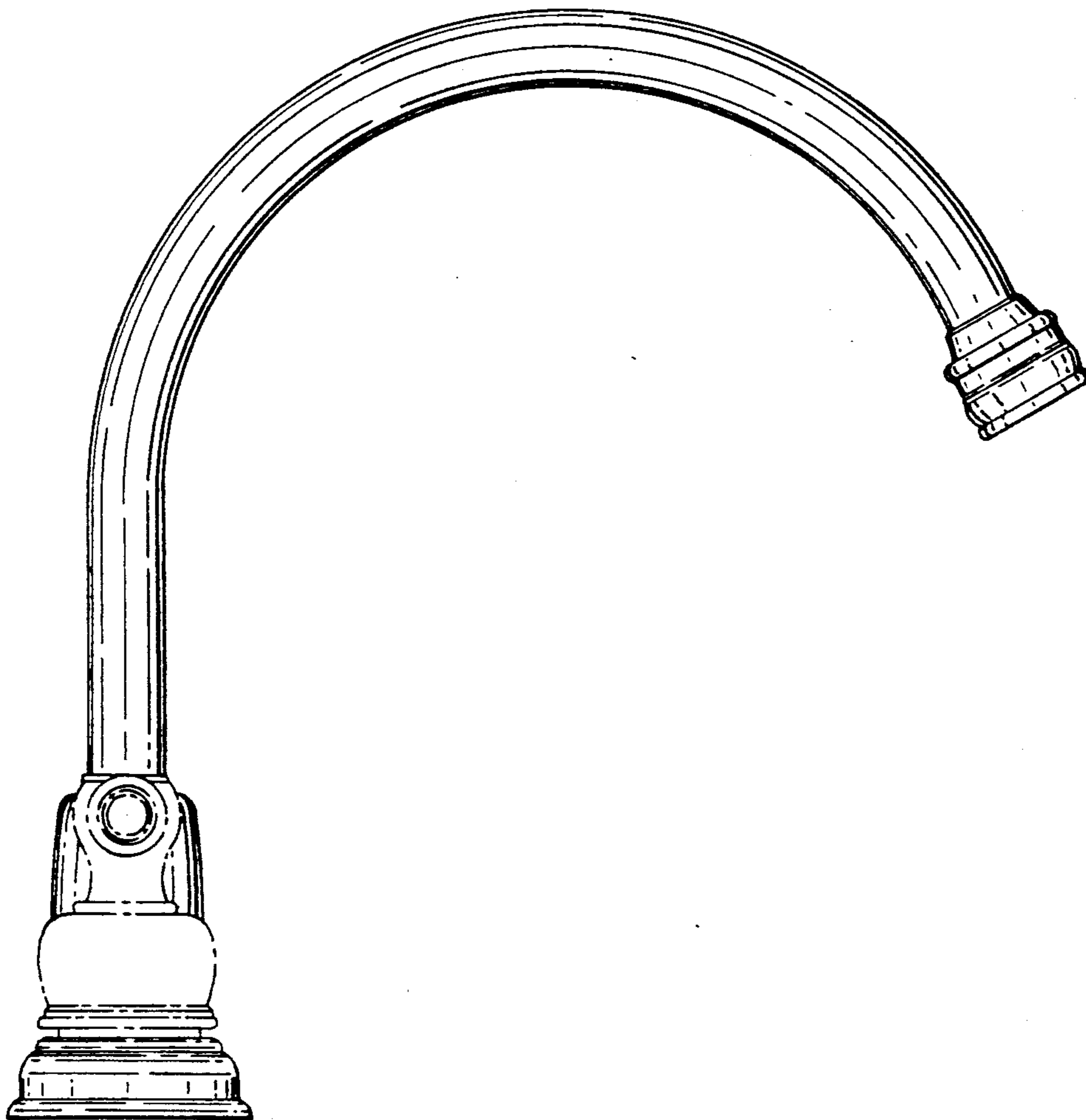
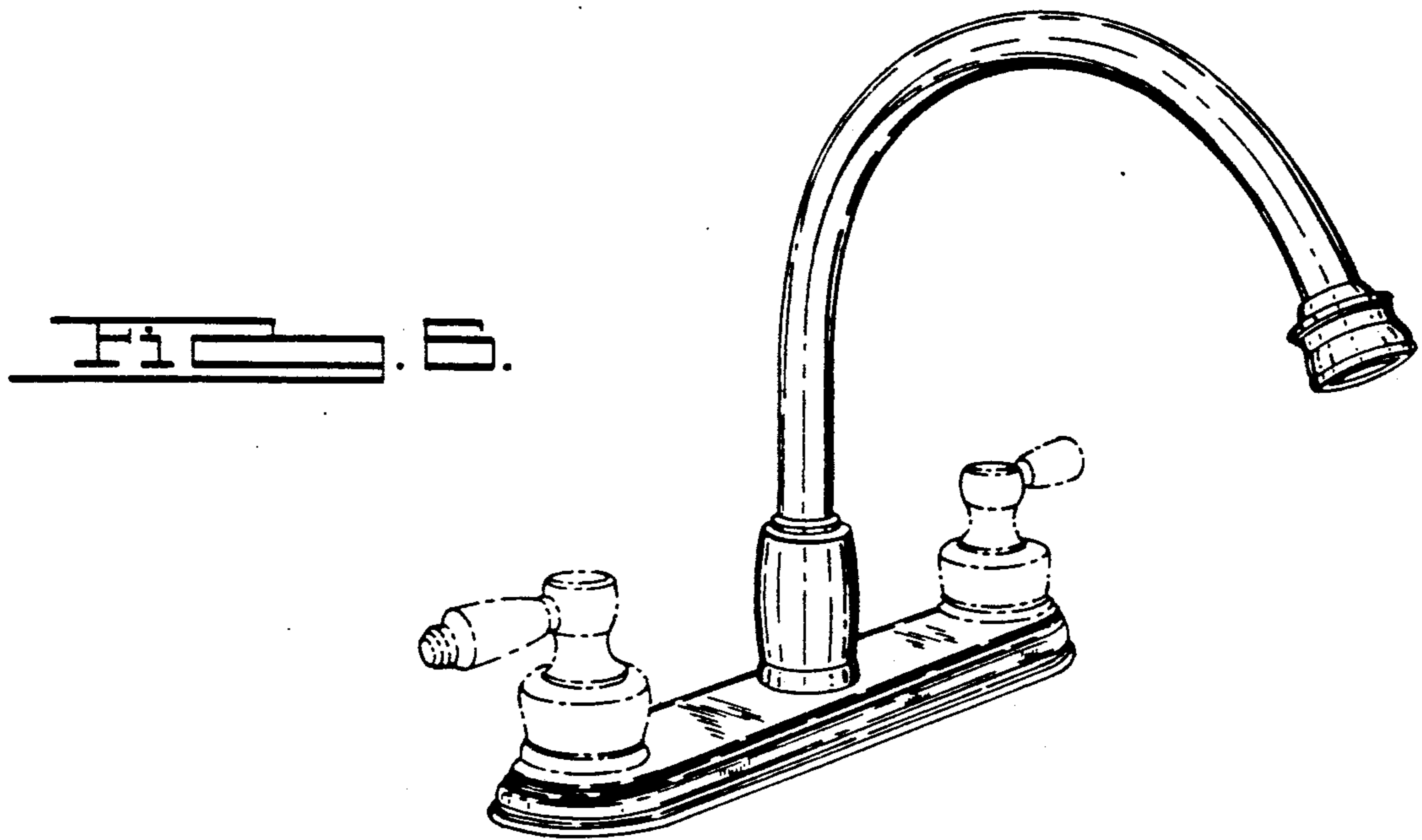
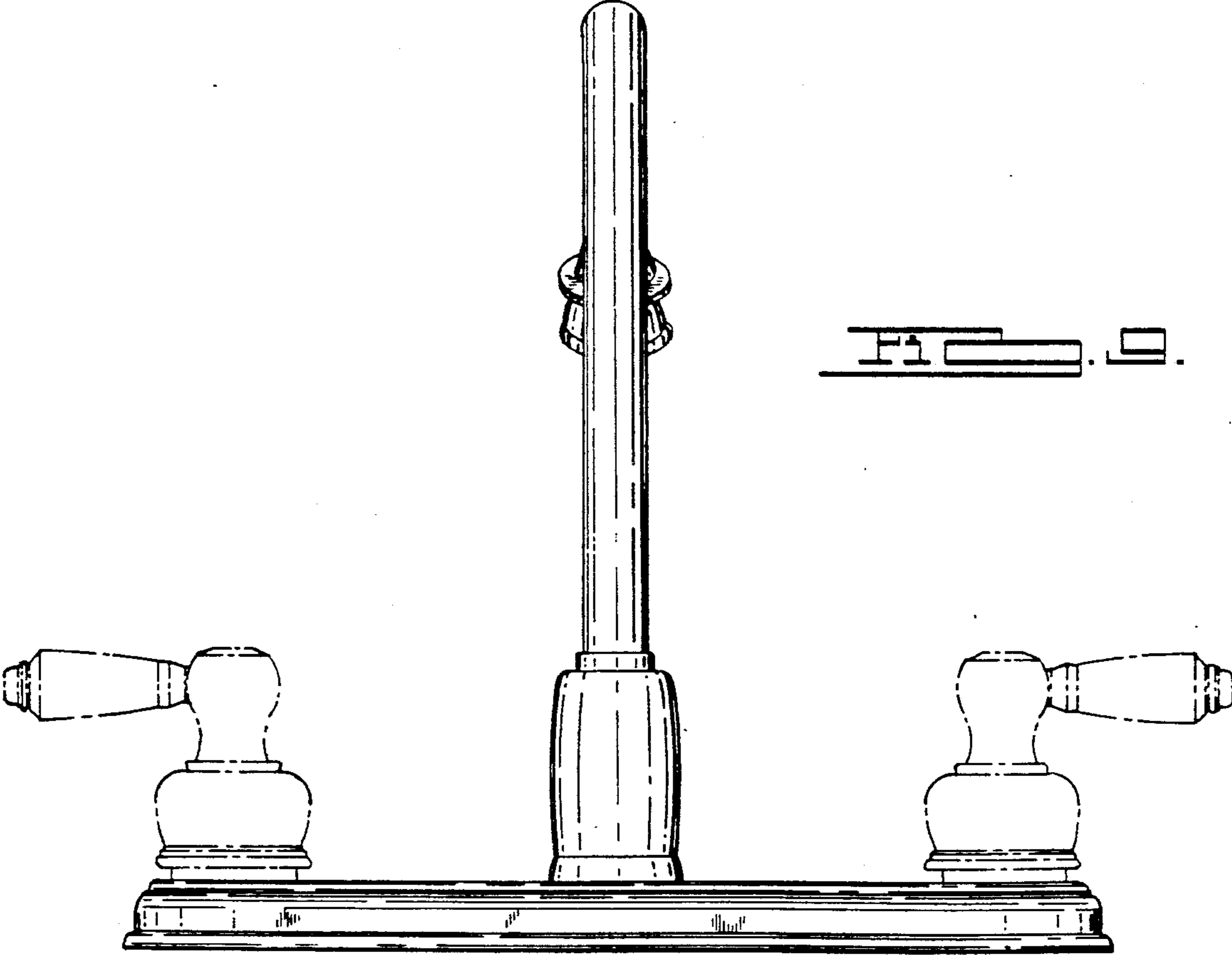
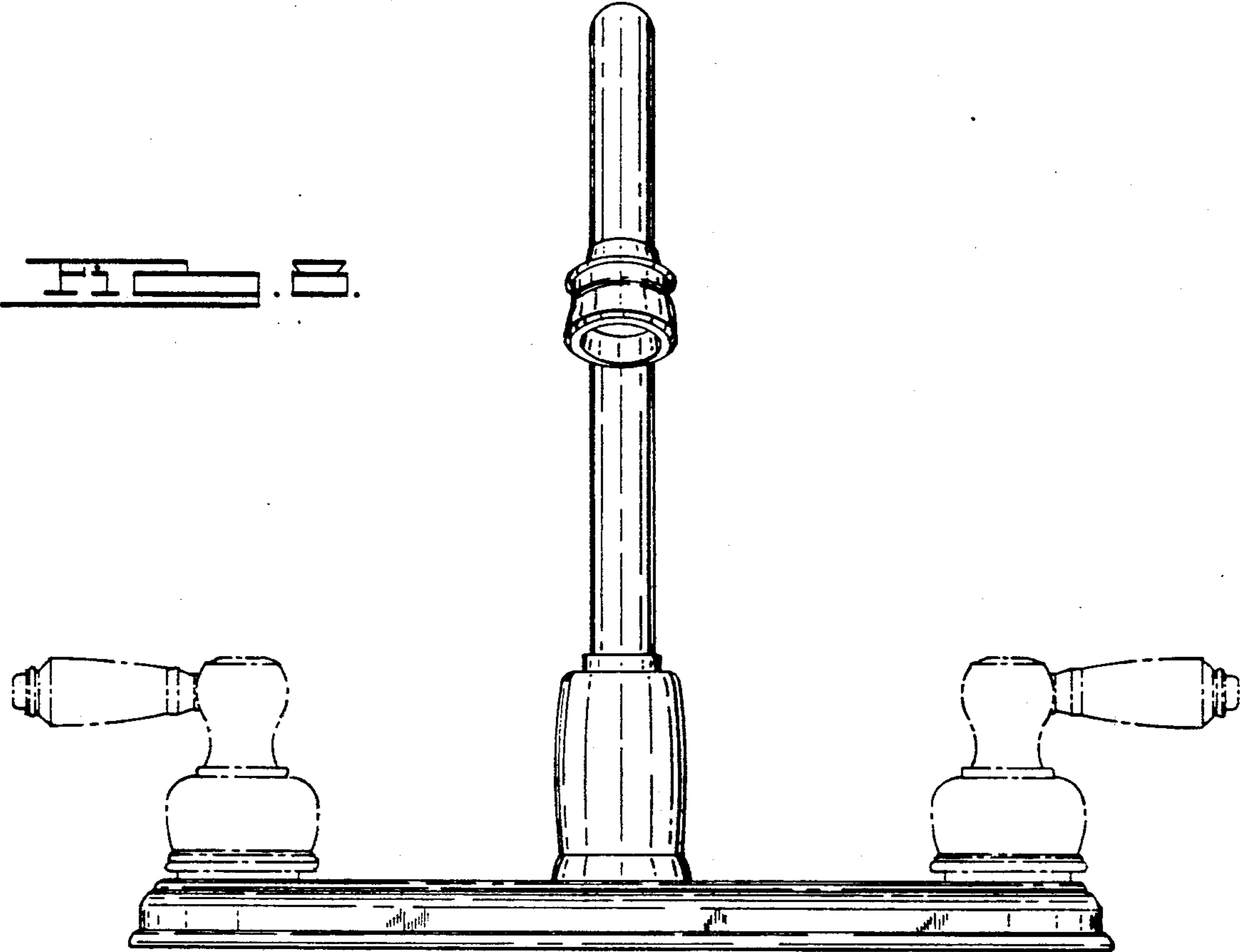

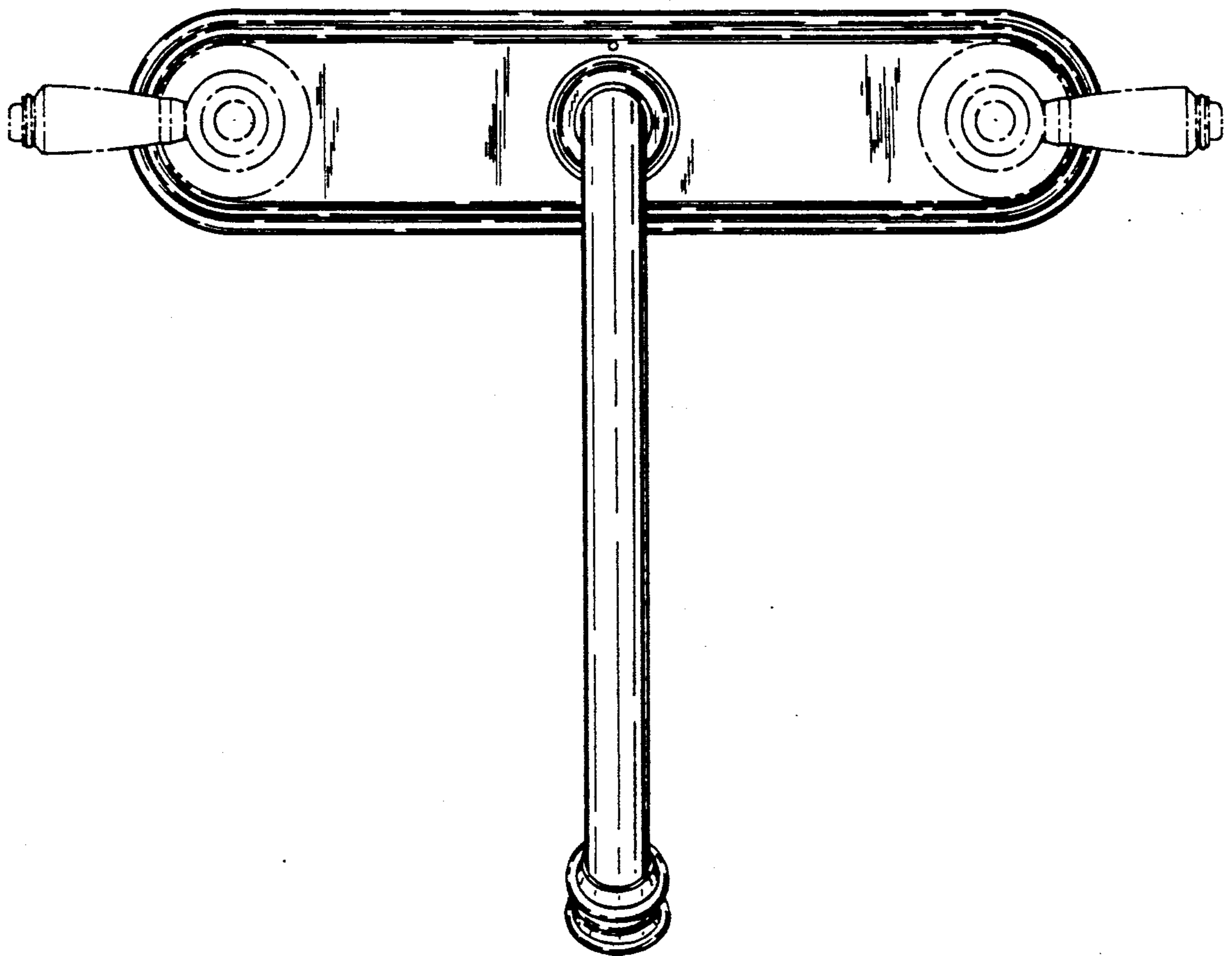
