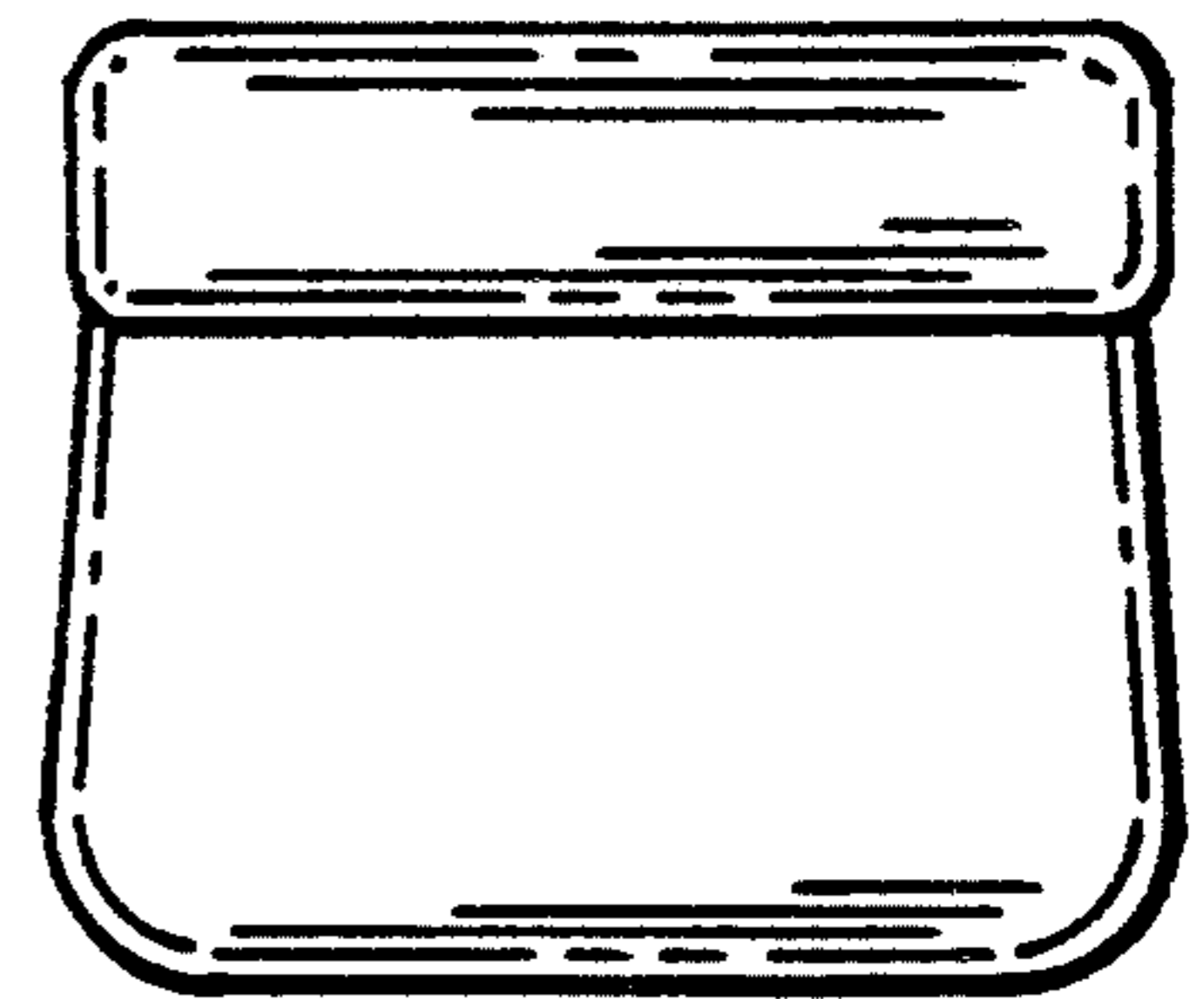
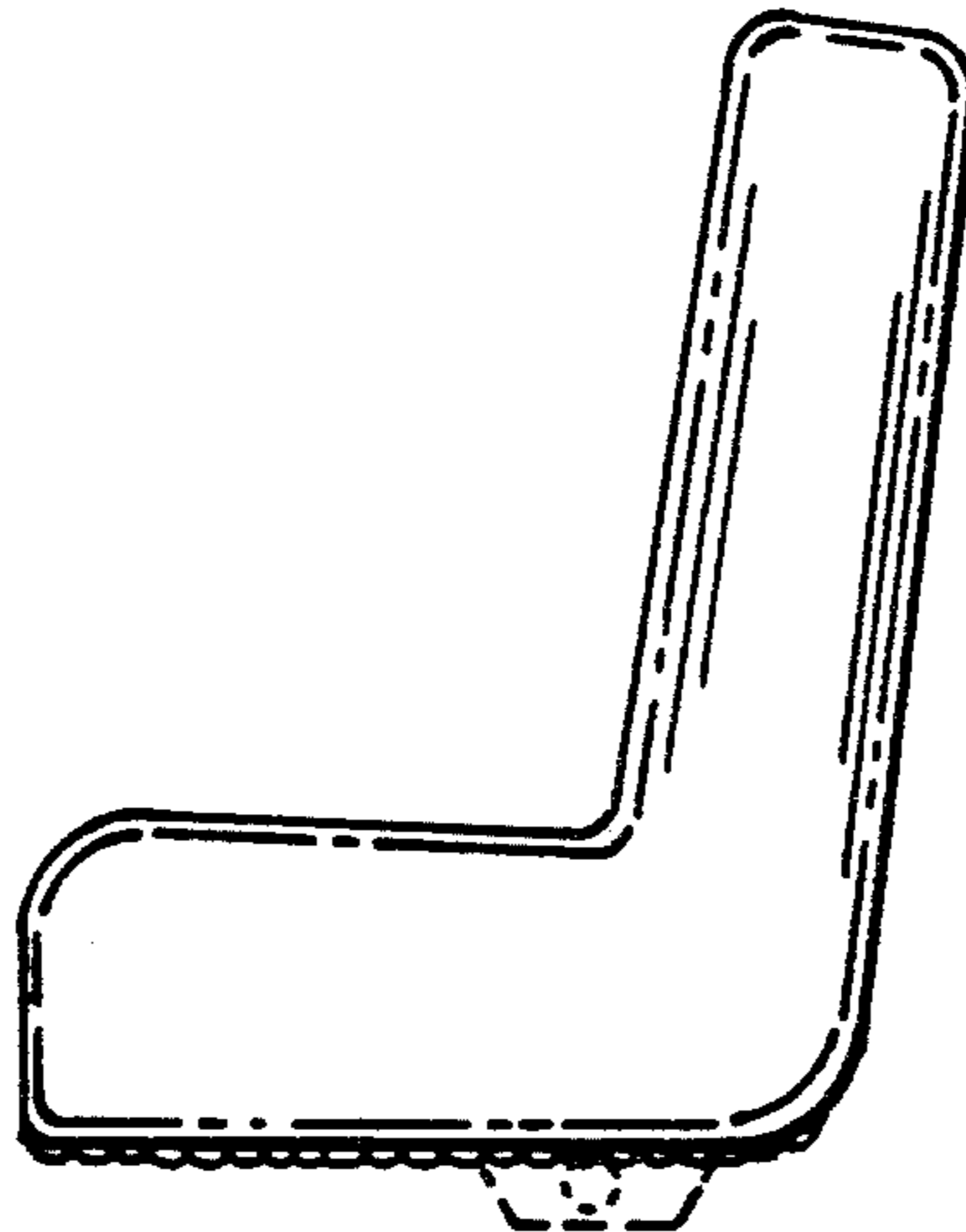
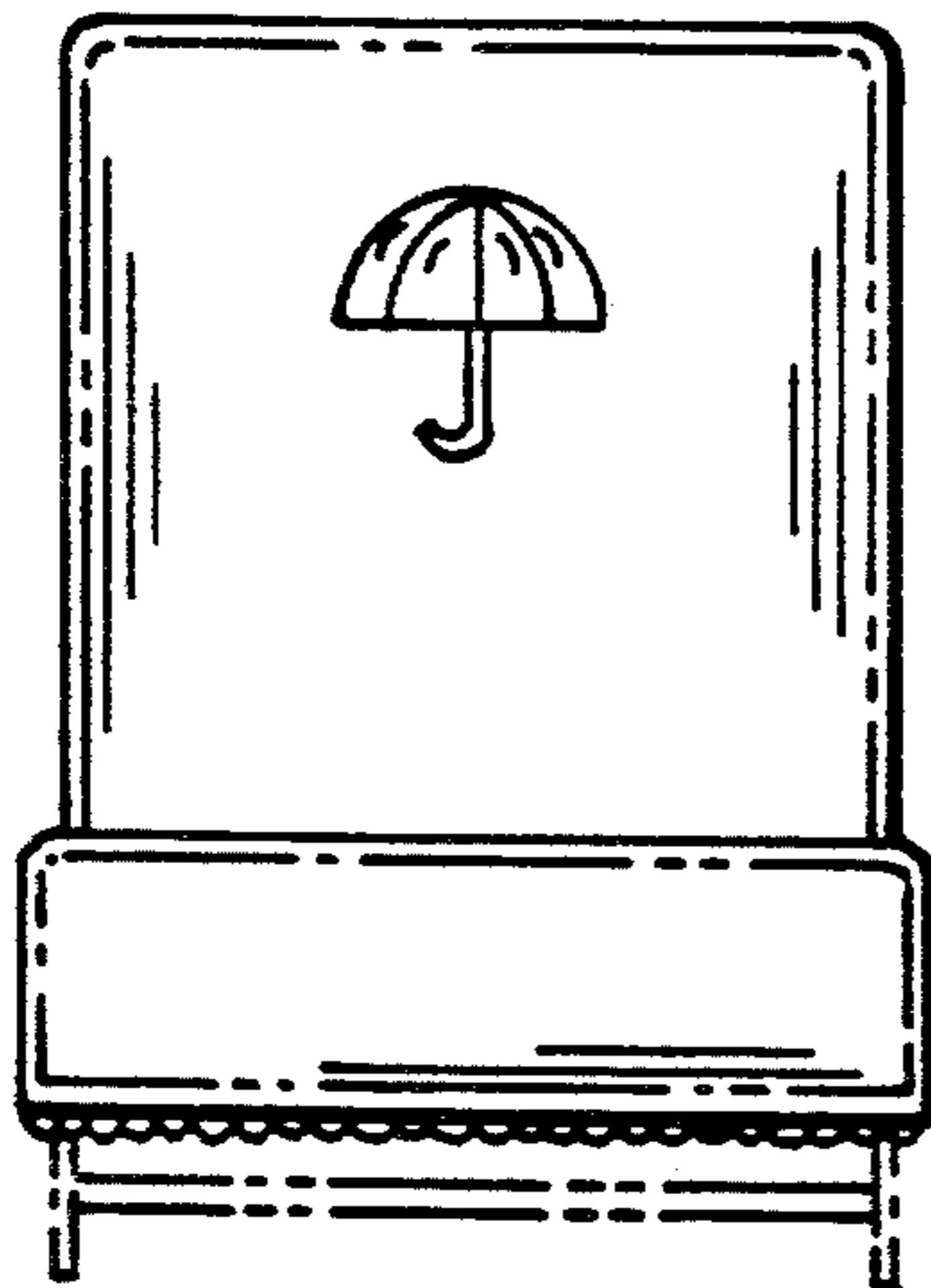

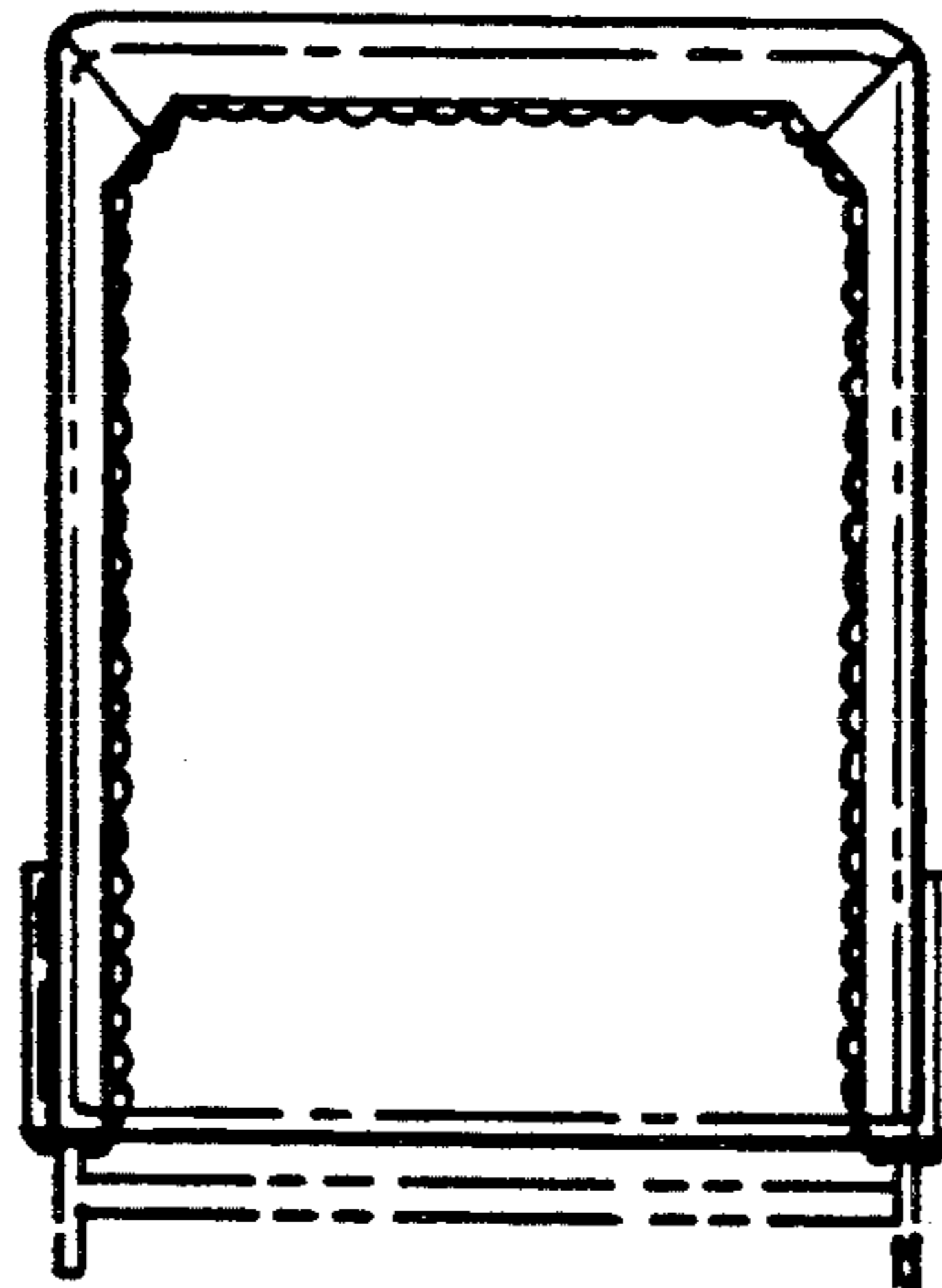
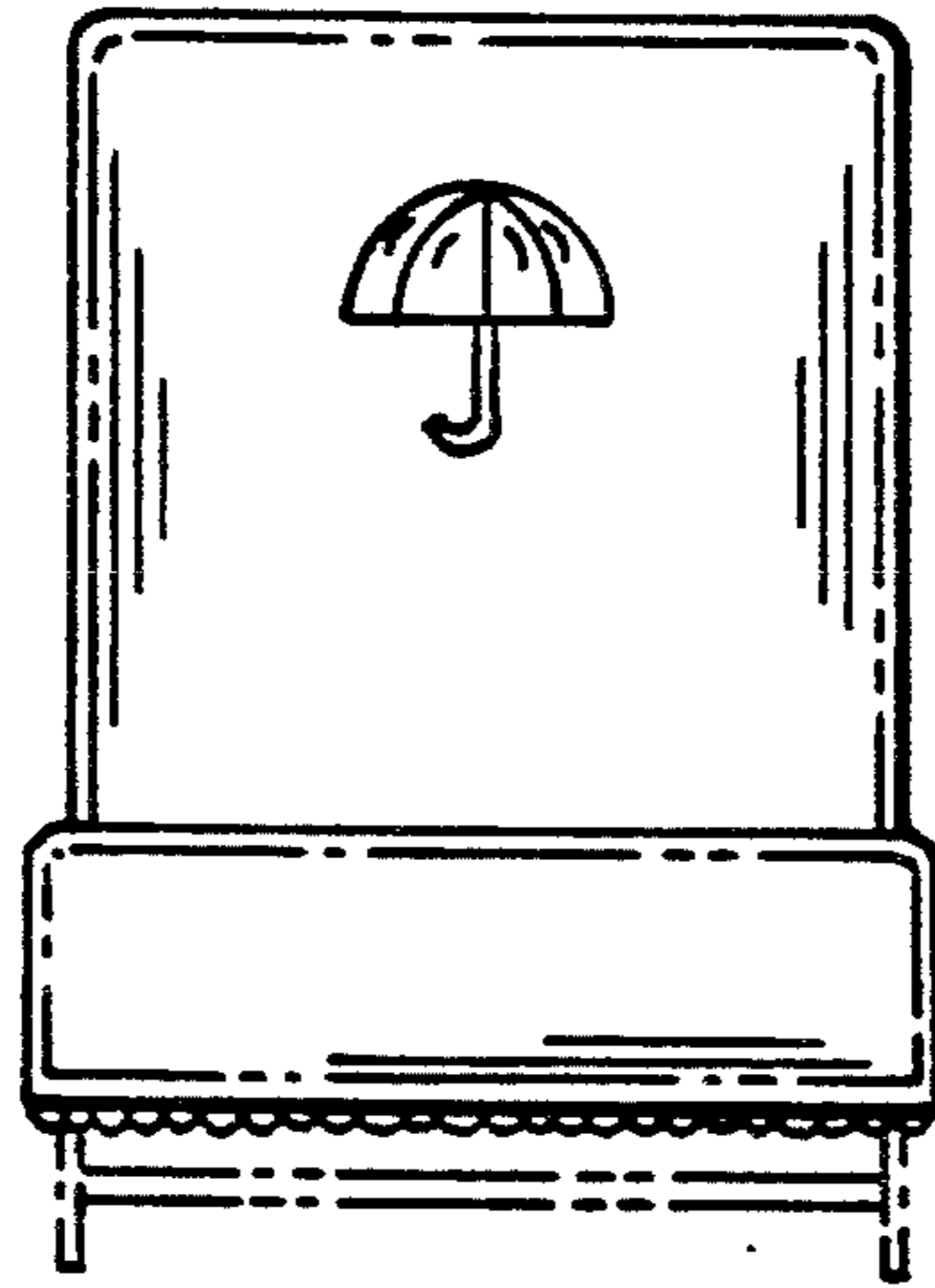

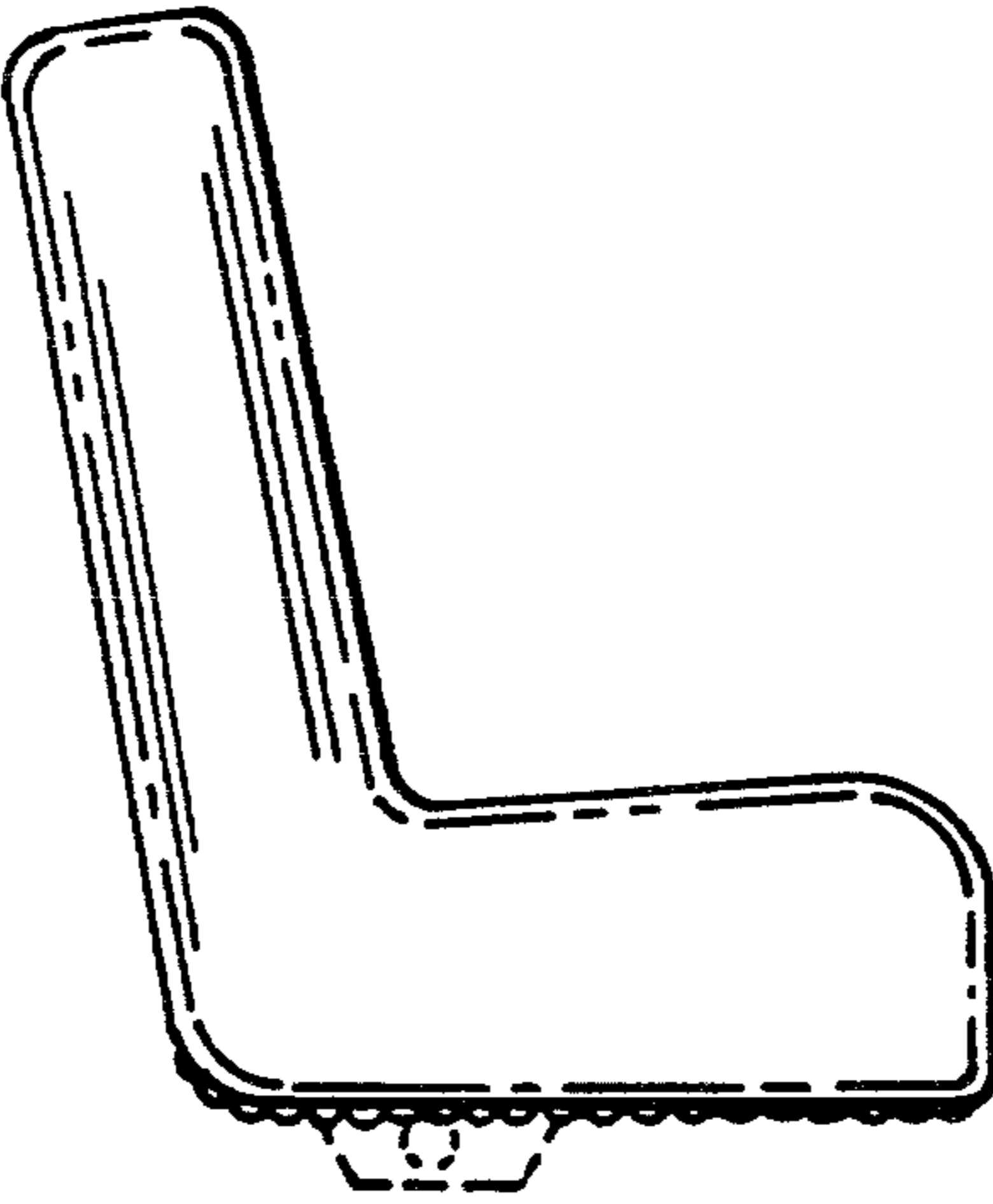
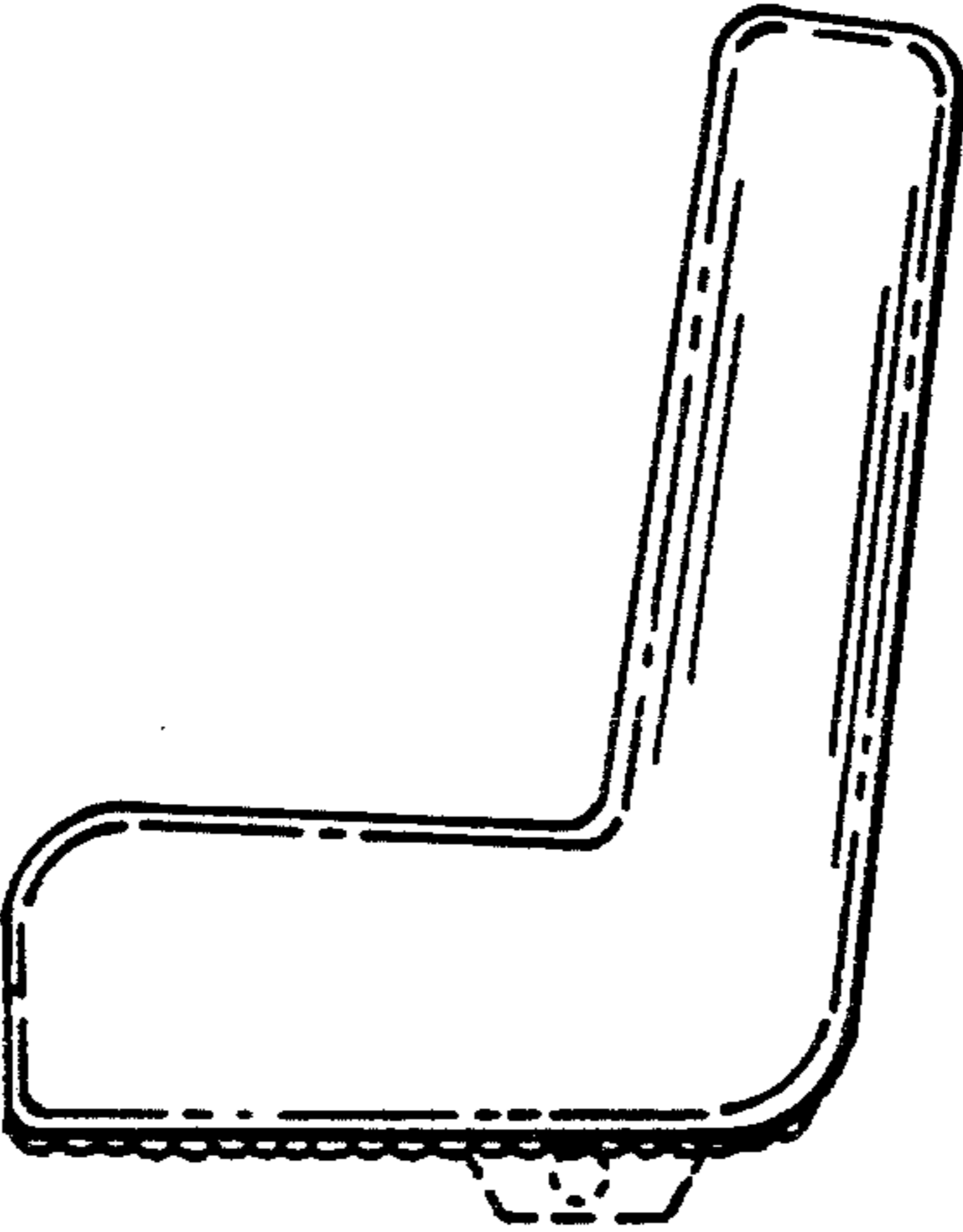
The ornamental design for a disposable car seat cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a disposable car seat cover showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken-line depiction of a portion of a seat in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.







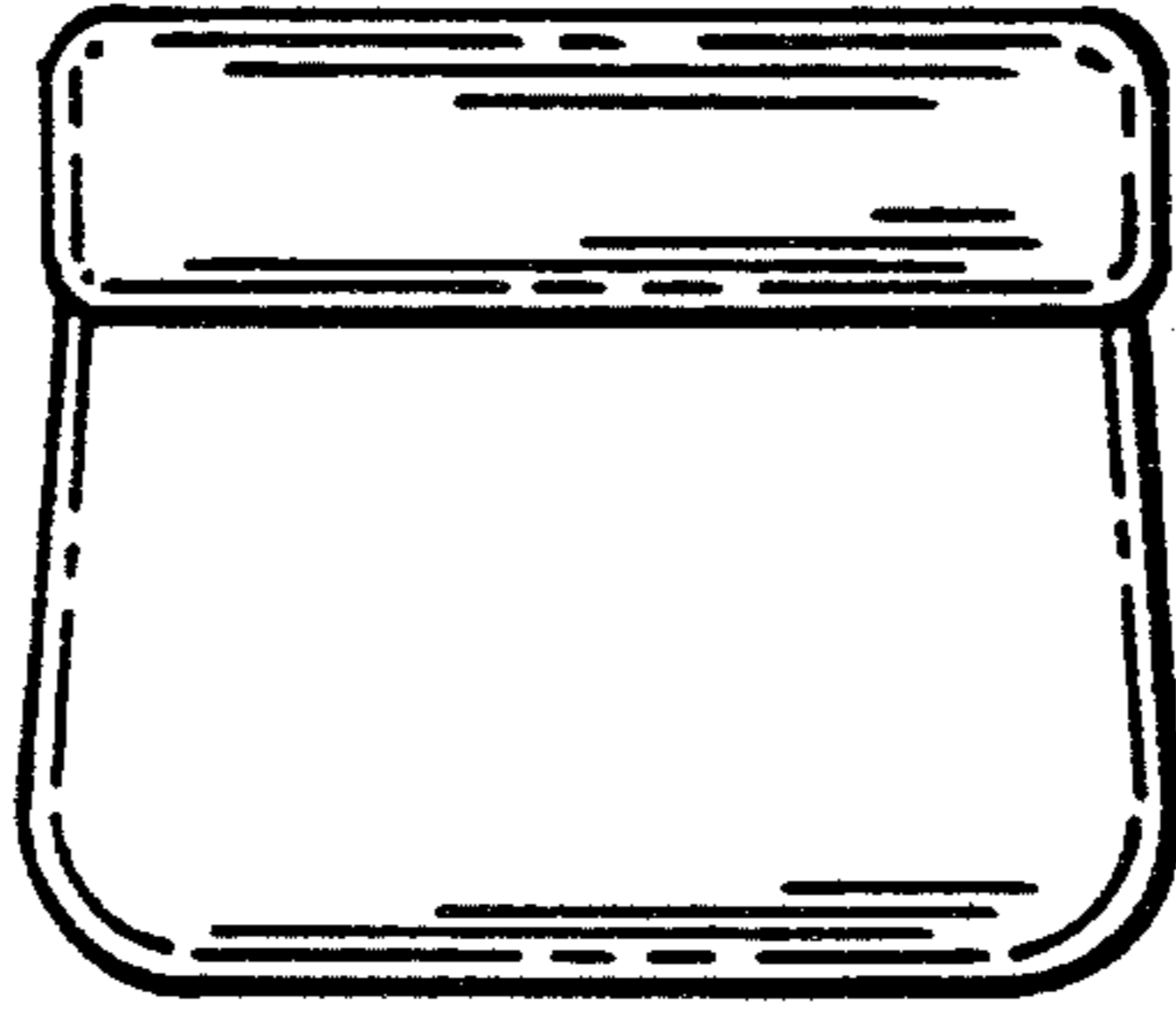

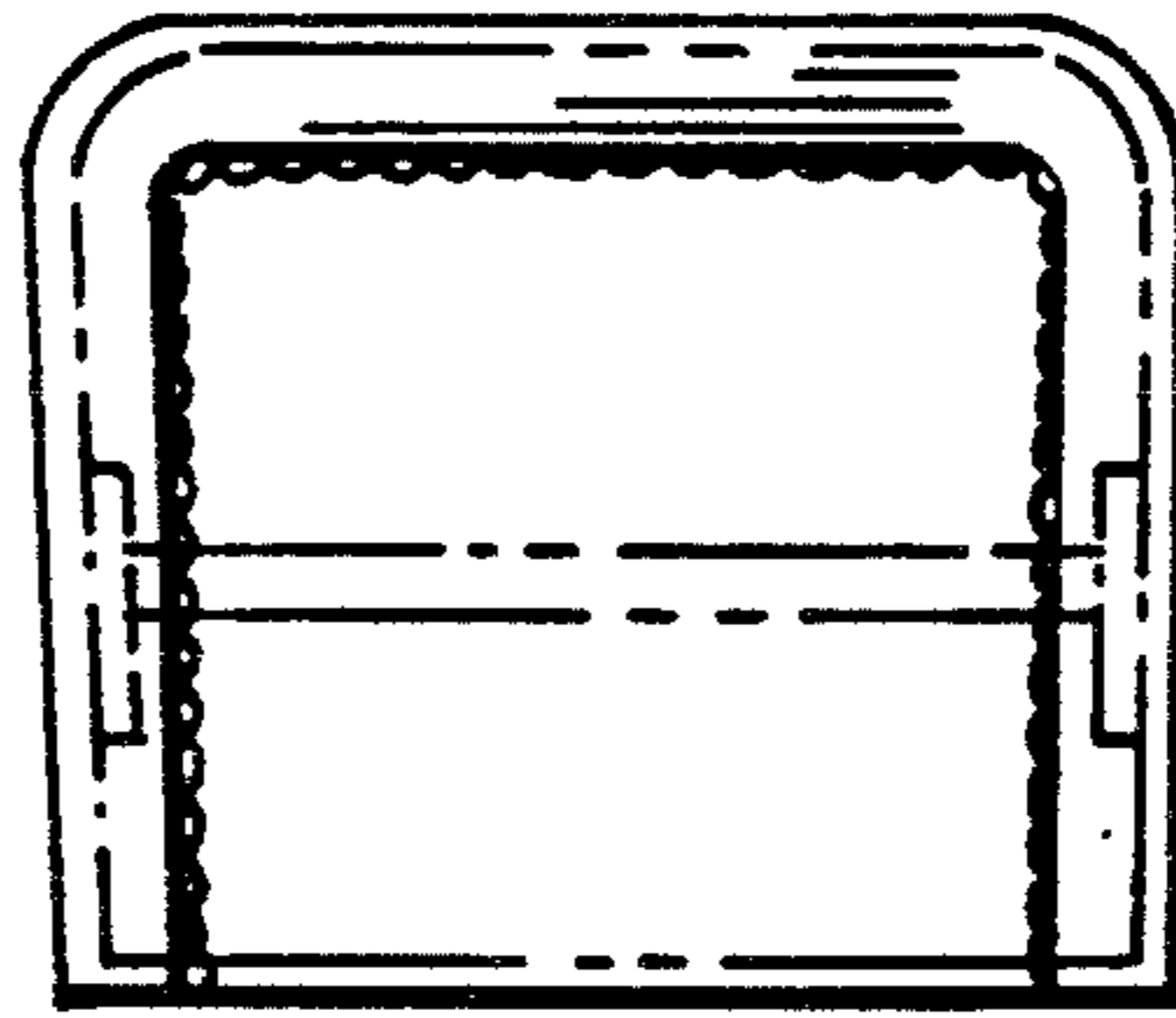
