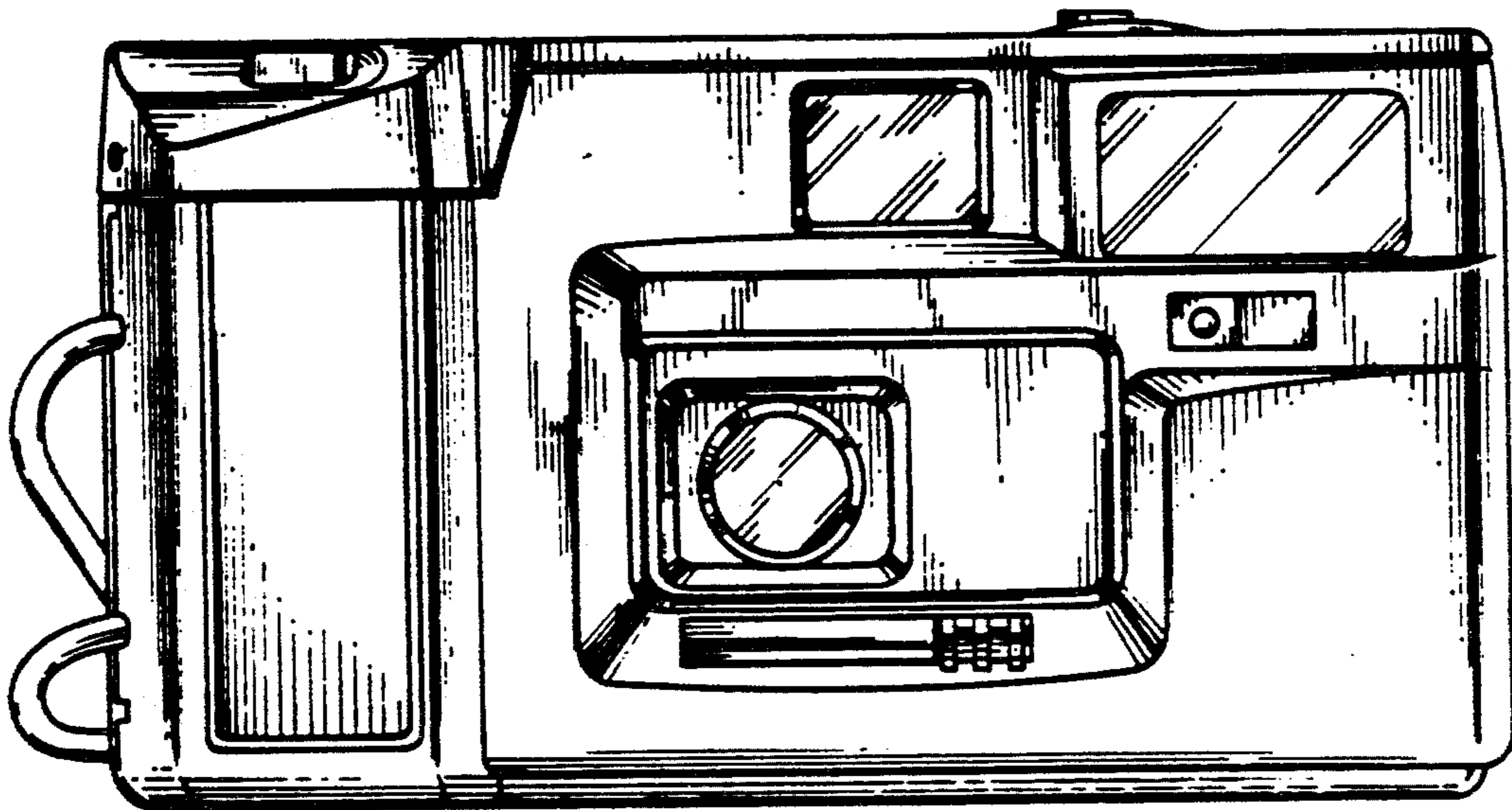

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a still camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a still camera, with its lens cover in an open position, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof, the strap being in an alternate position that shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left-side elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right-side elevation view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a front elevation view thereof, with the lens cover in a closed position.



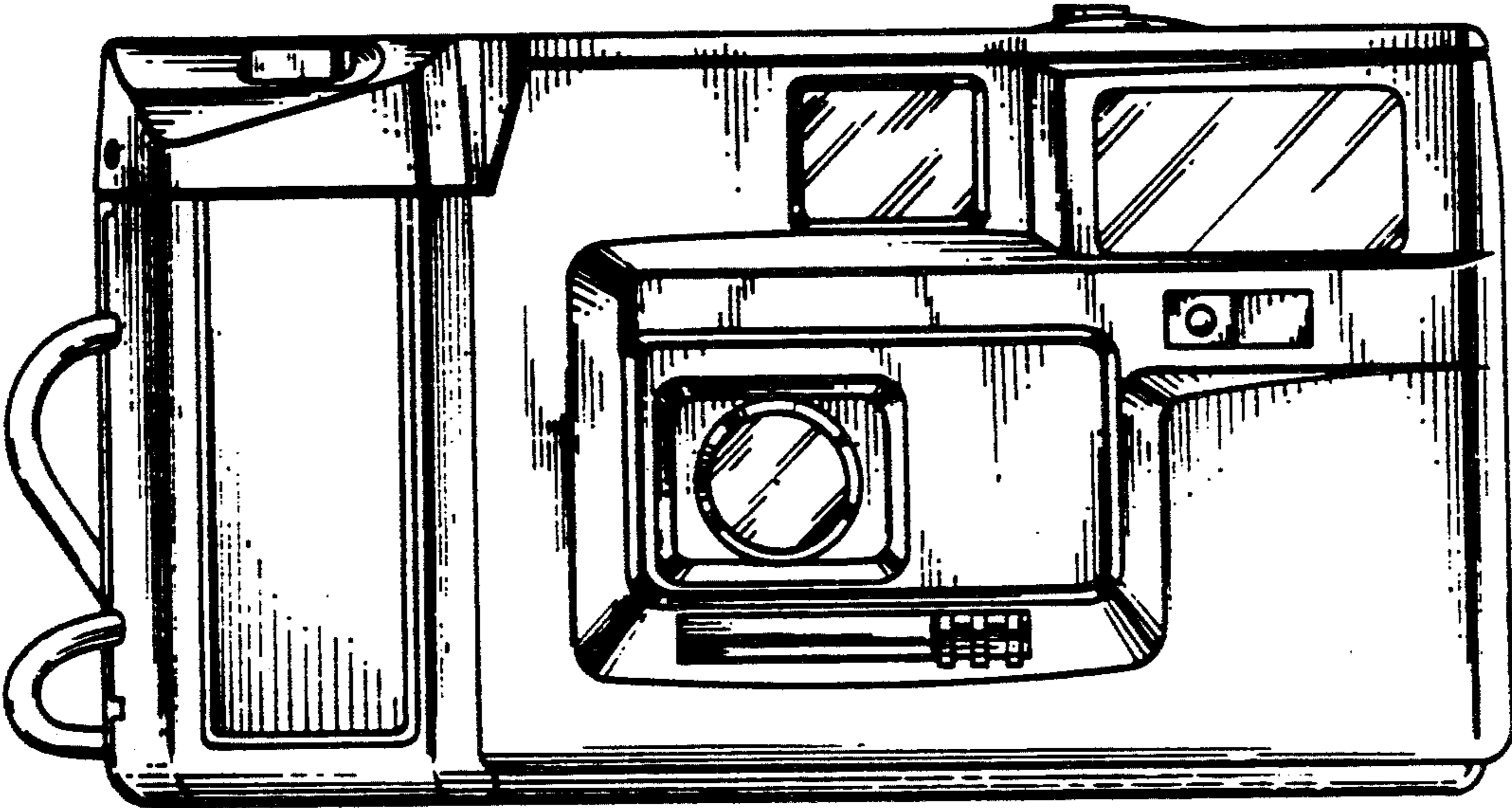

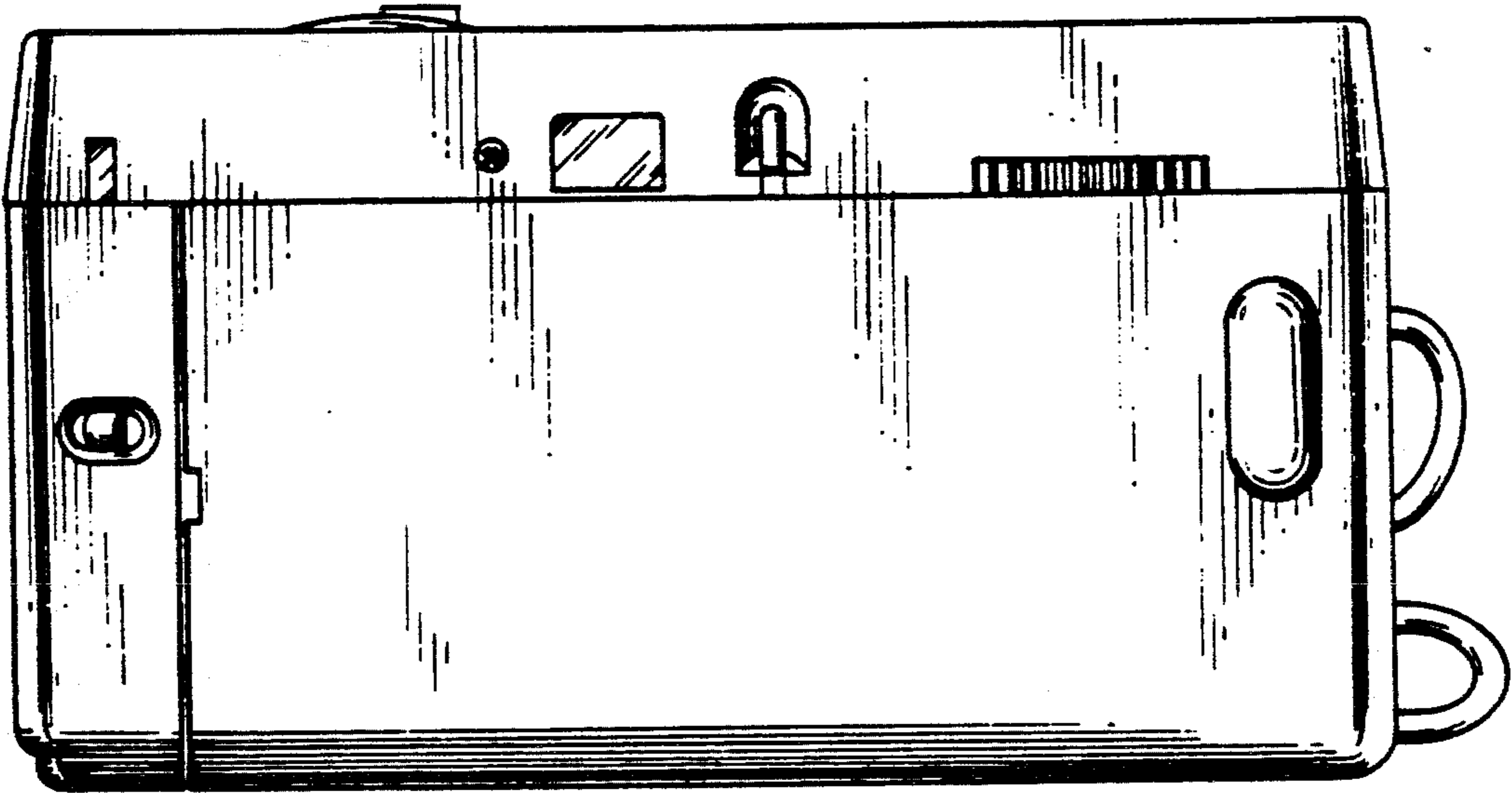

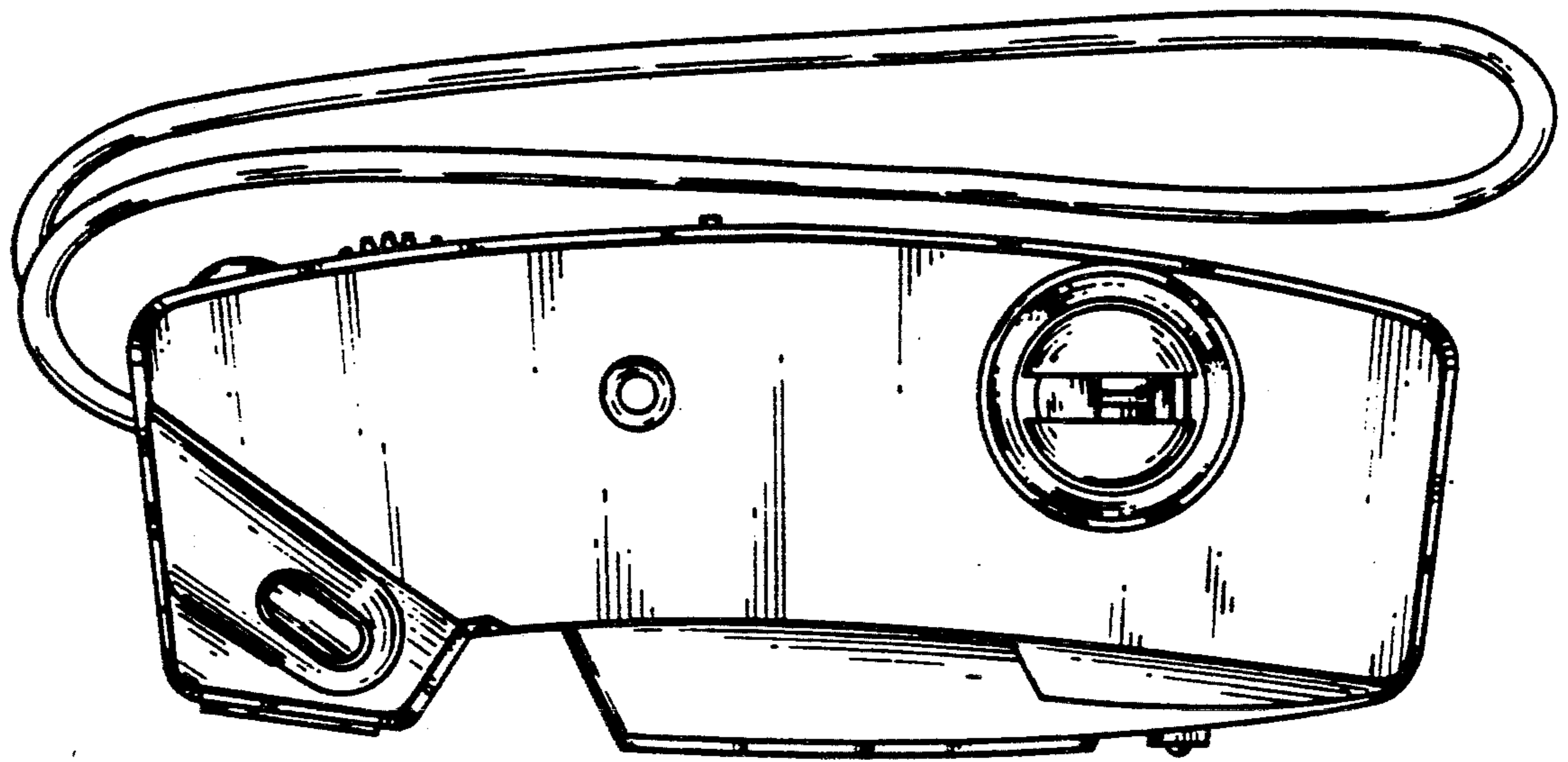

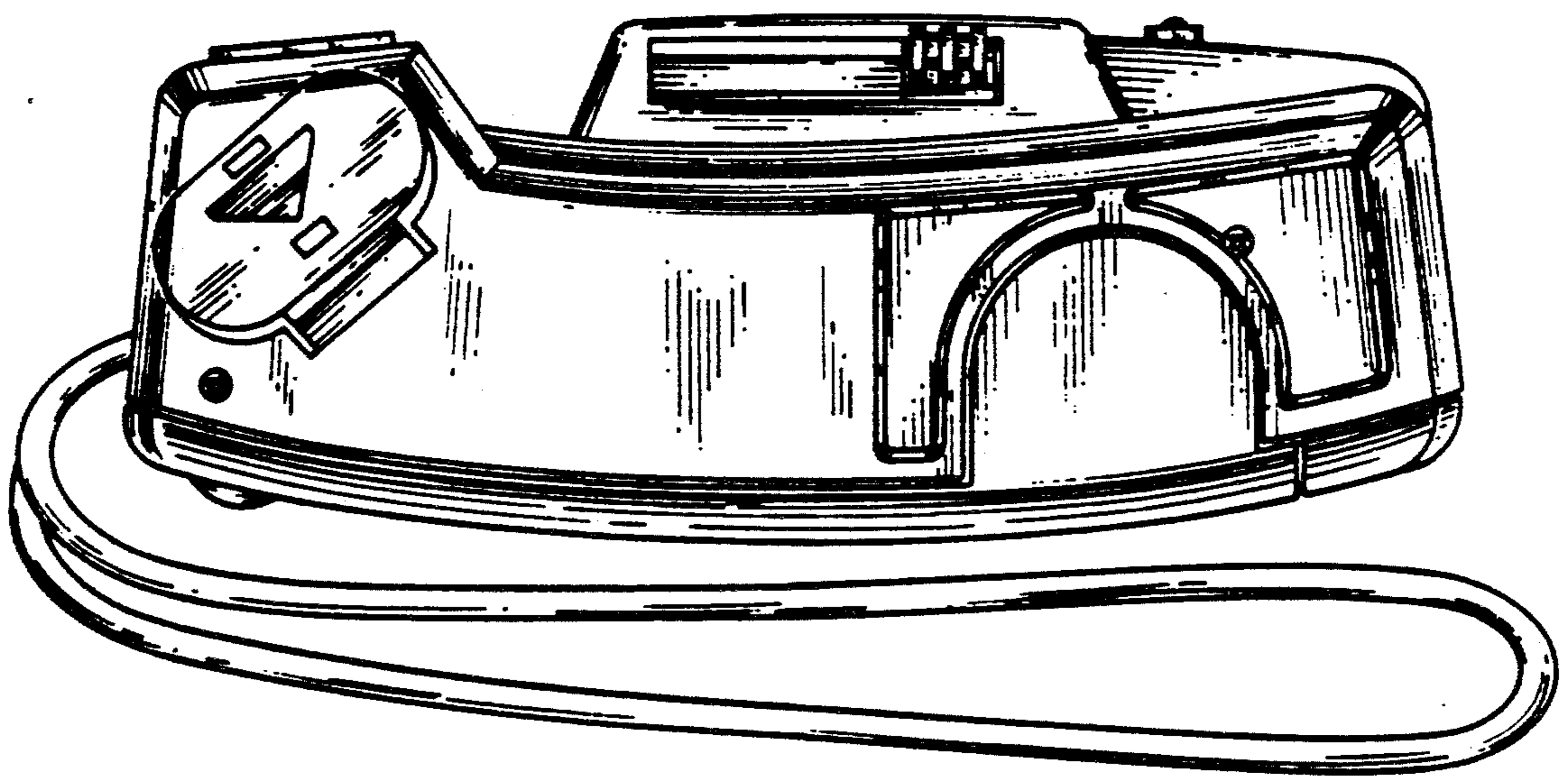

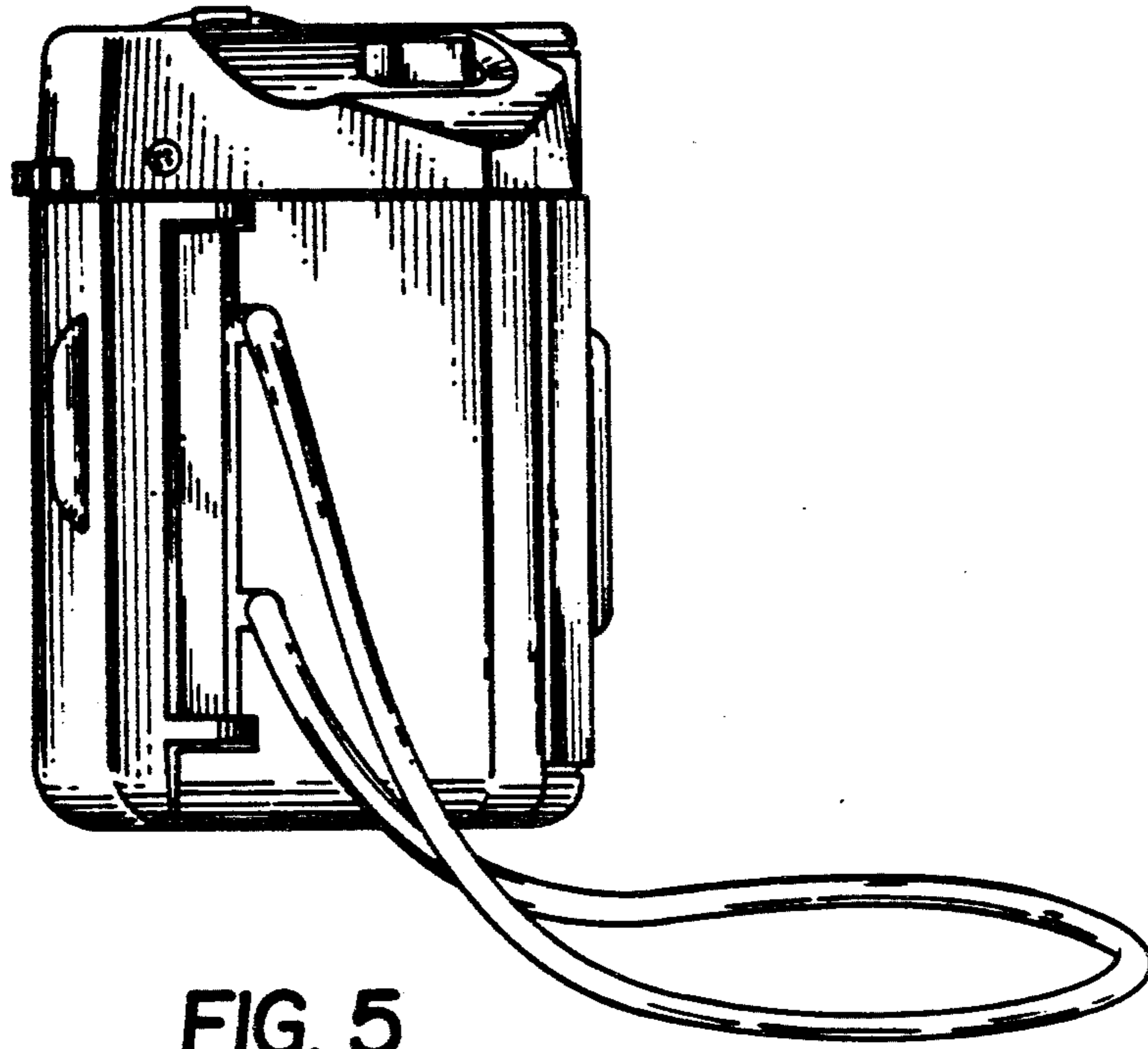

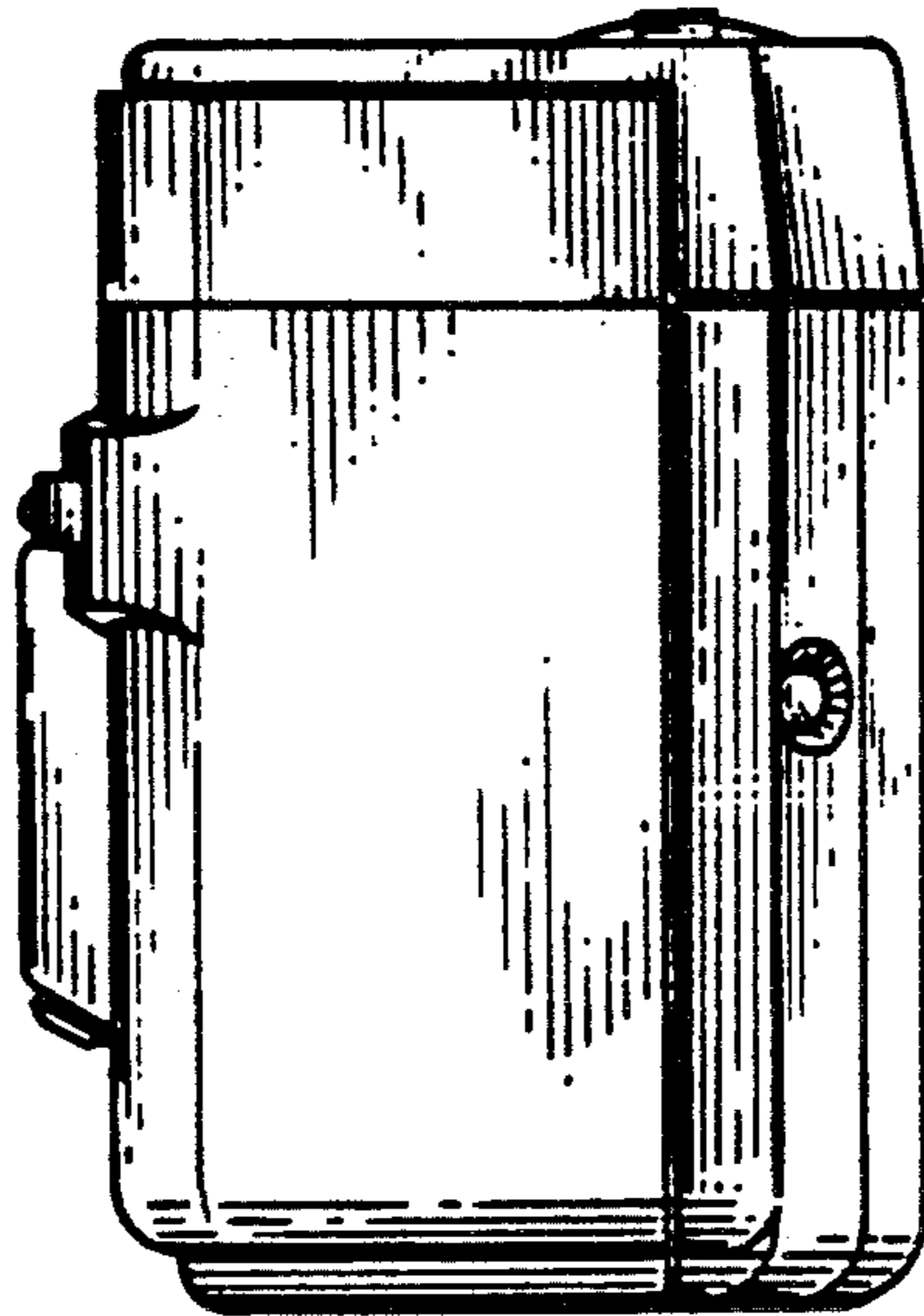

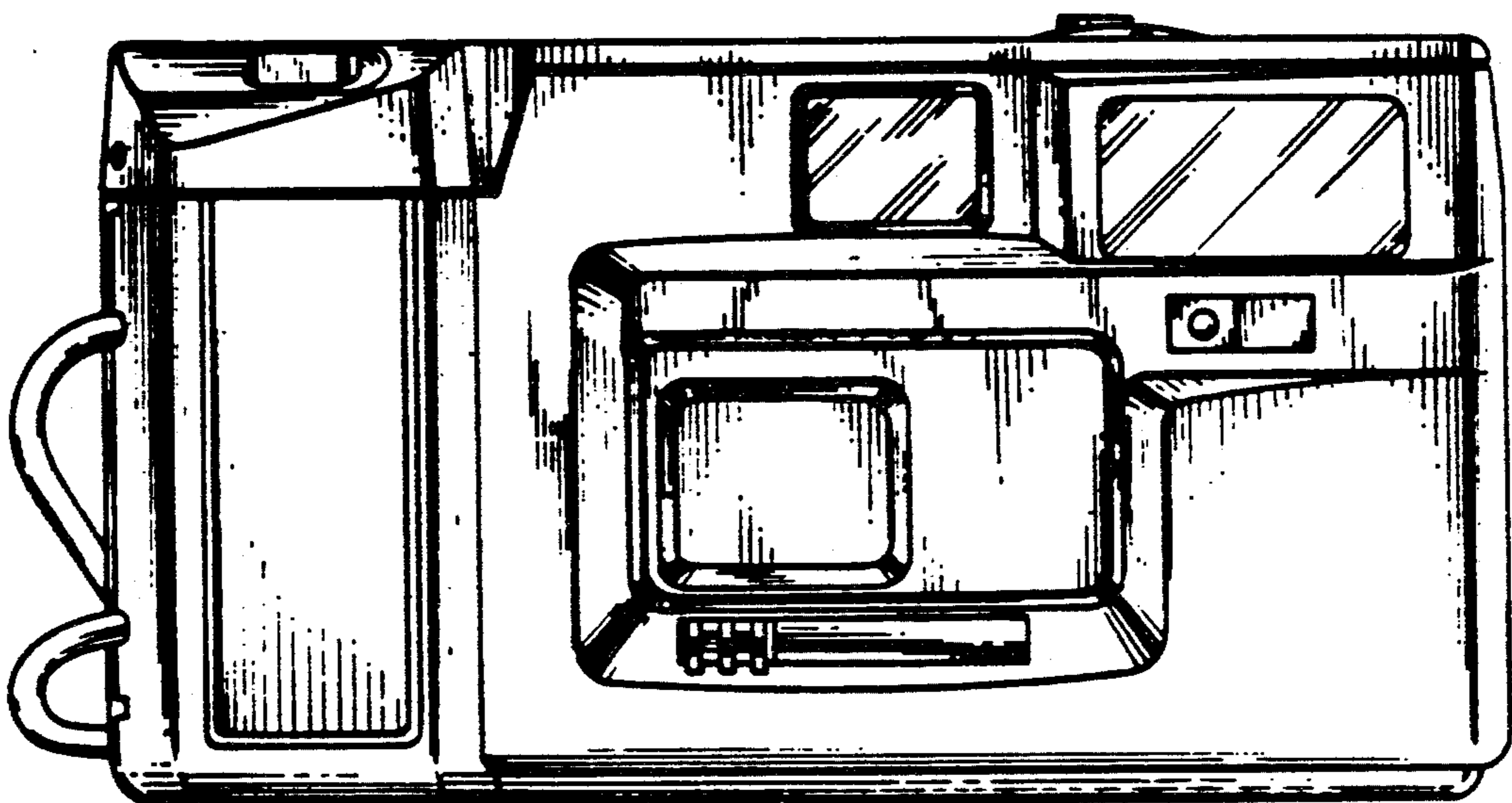
