FIG. 1 is a face view of the letters of an alphanumeric font showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a face view of the numerals of an alphanumeric font.

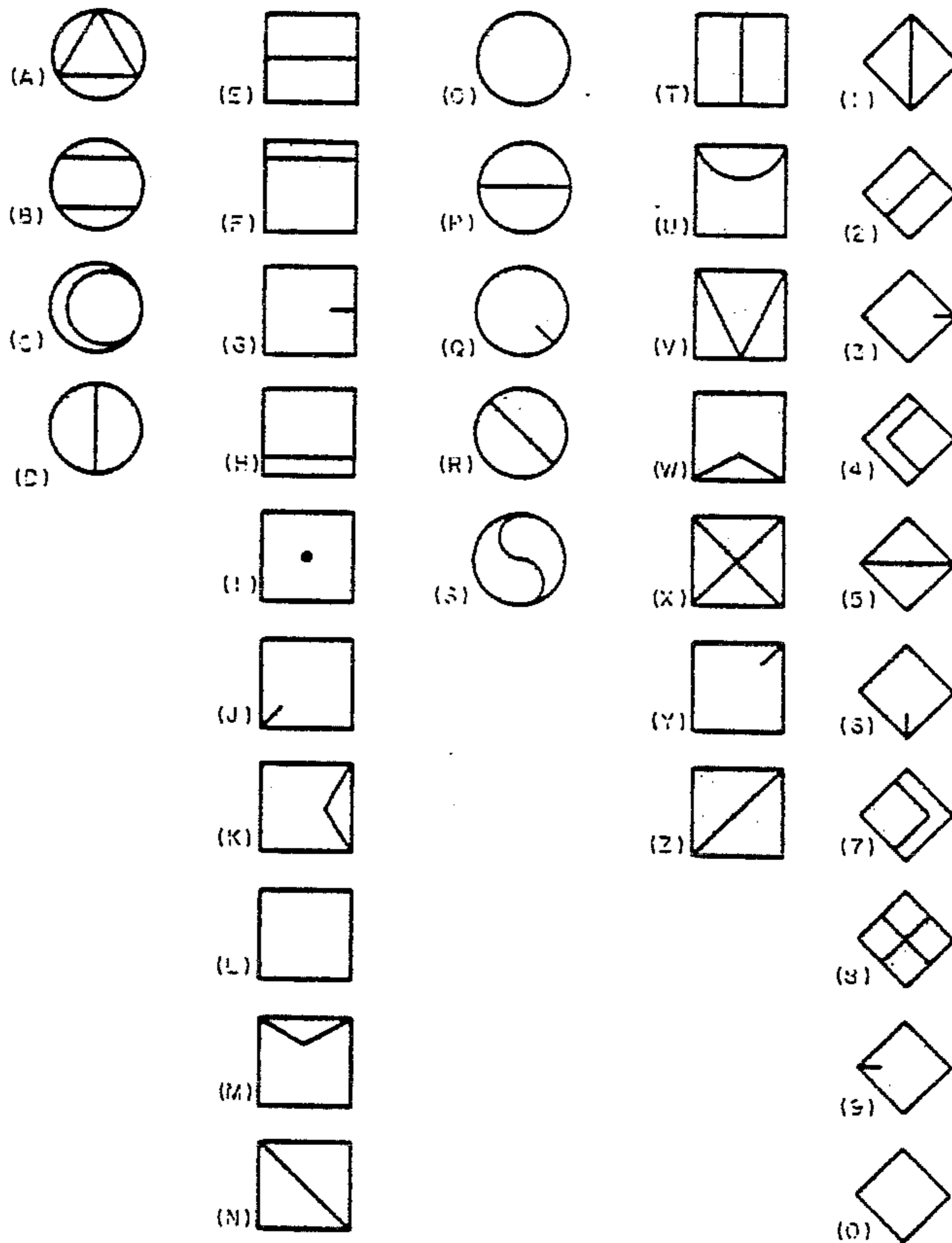

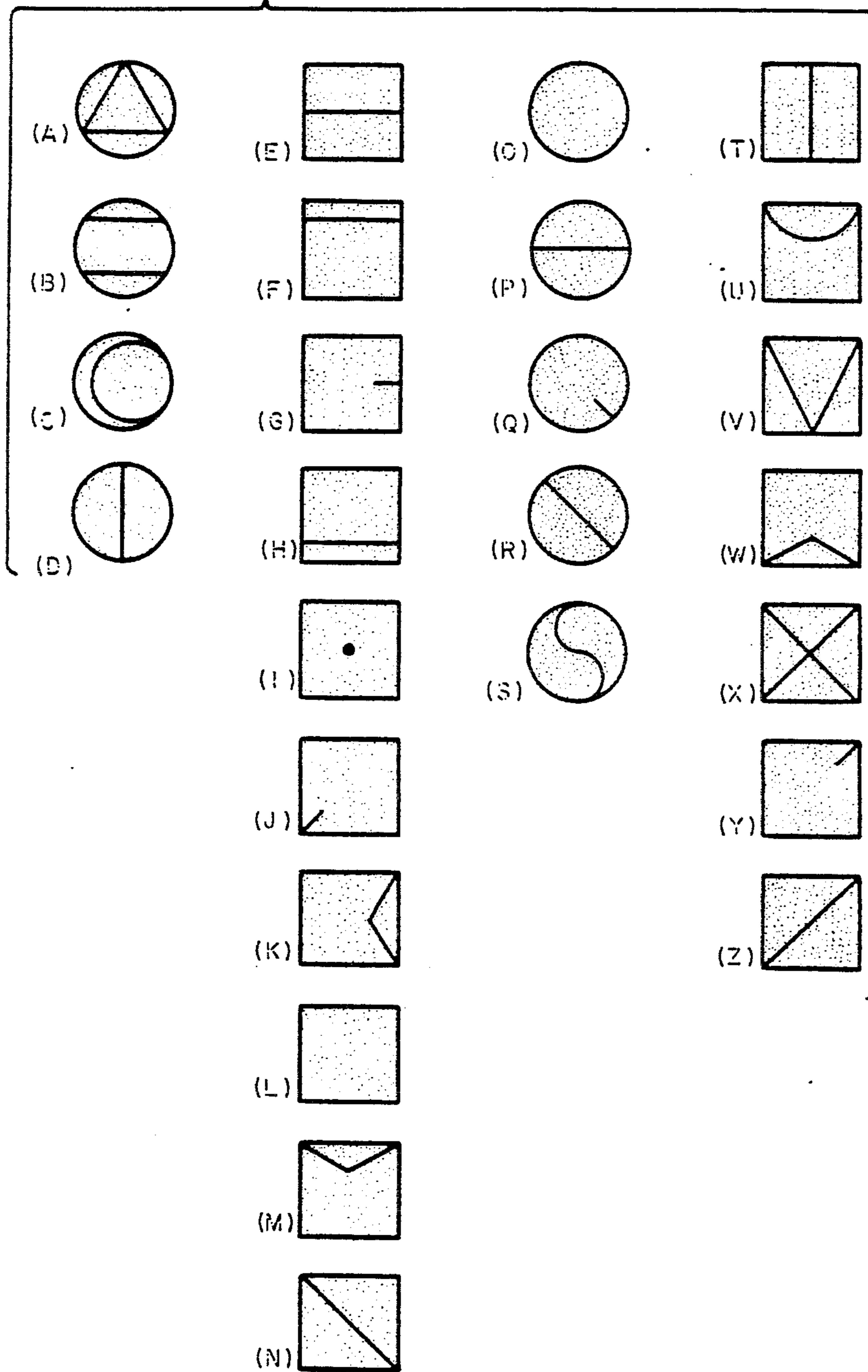
