cap members in a stored position.



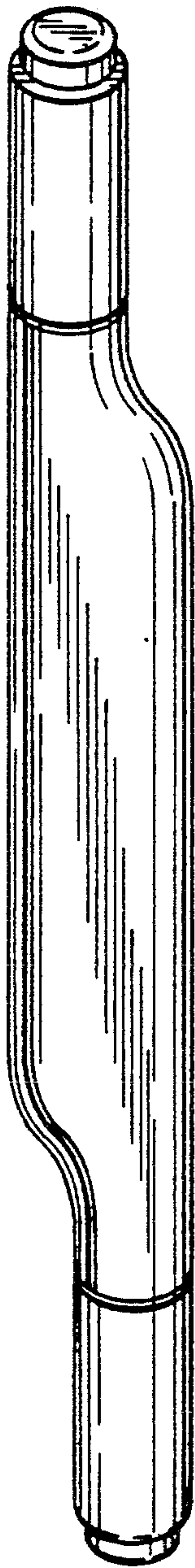

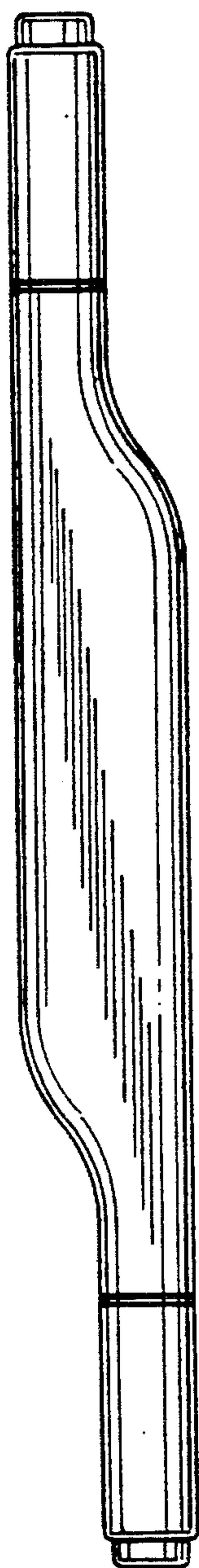

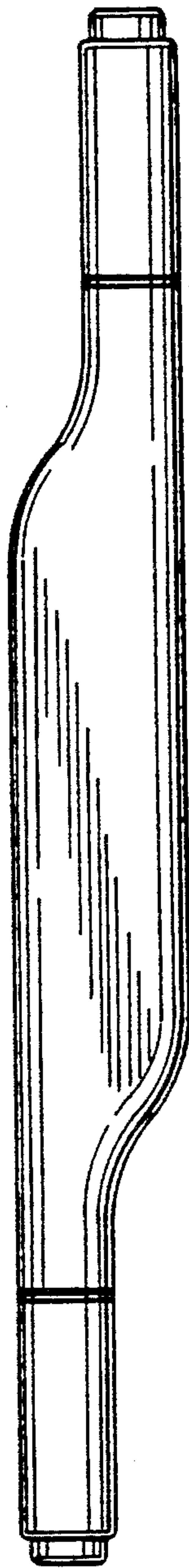

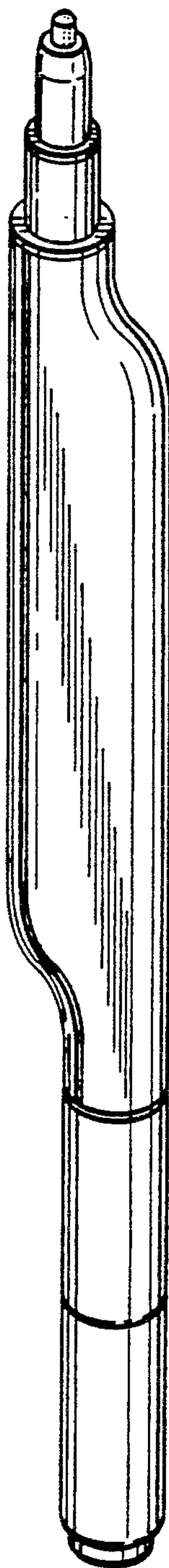
