DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a support base for a
desk set or similar article showing my new design in the
form of a paper weight;

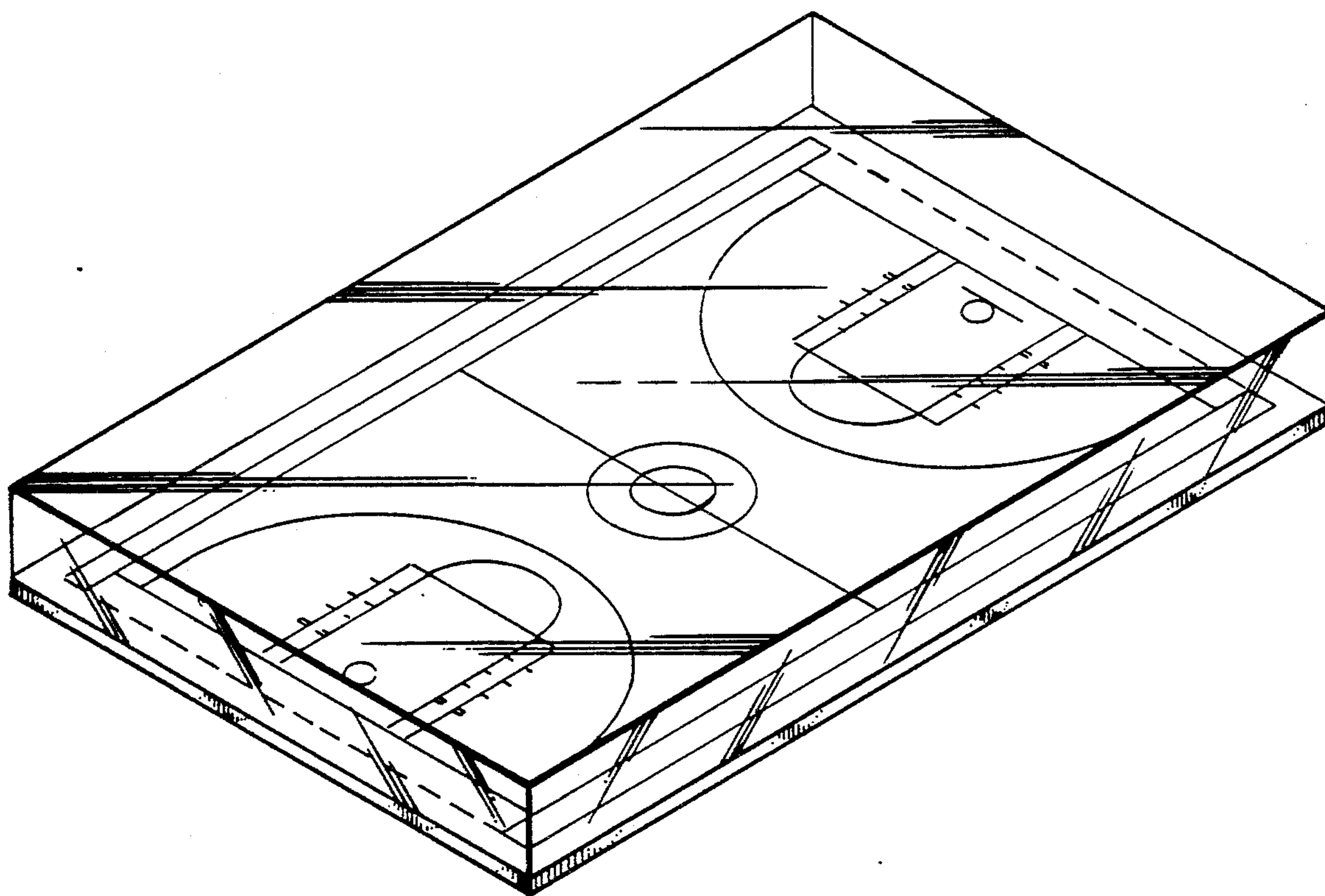
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view, the front view being a

ment holder.



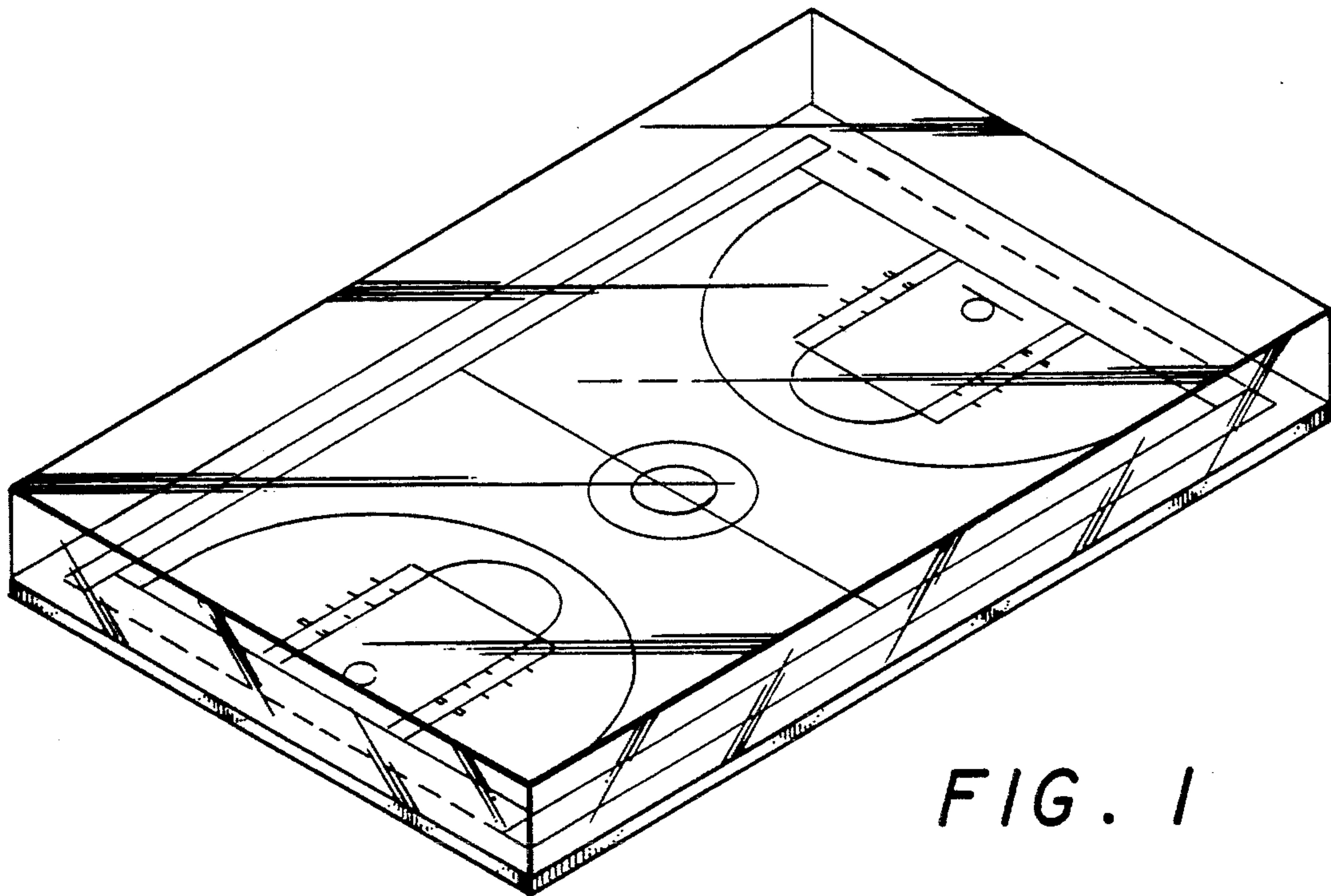

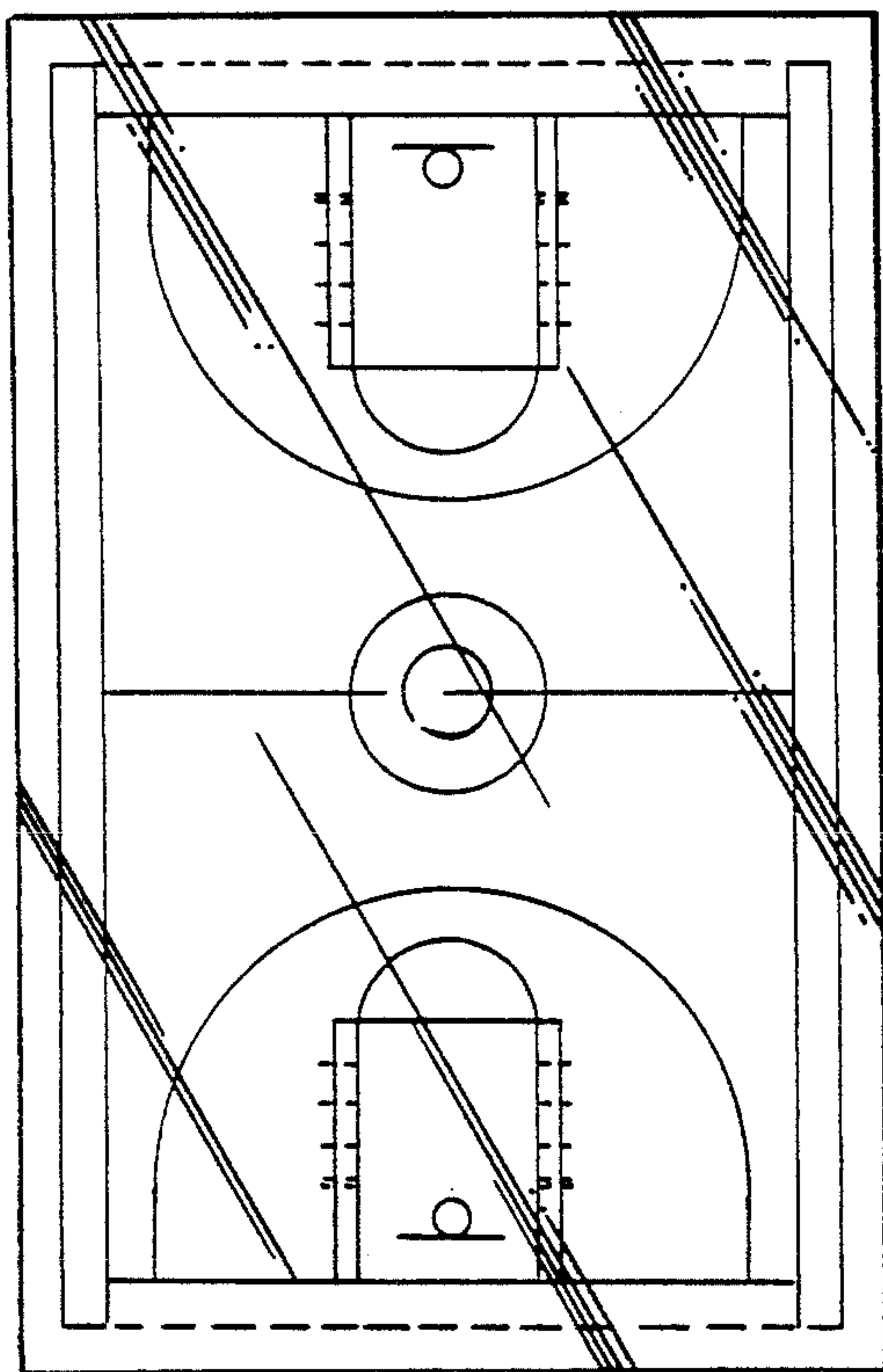
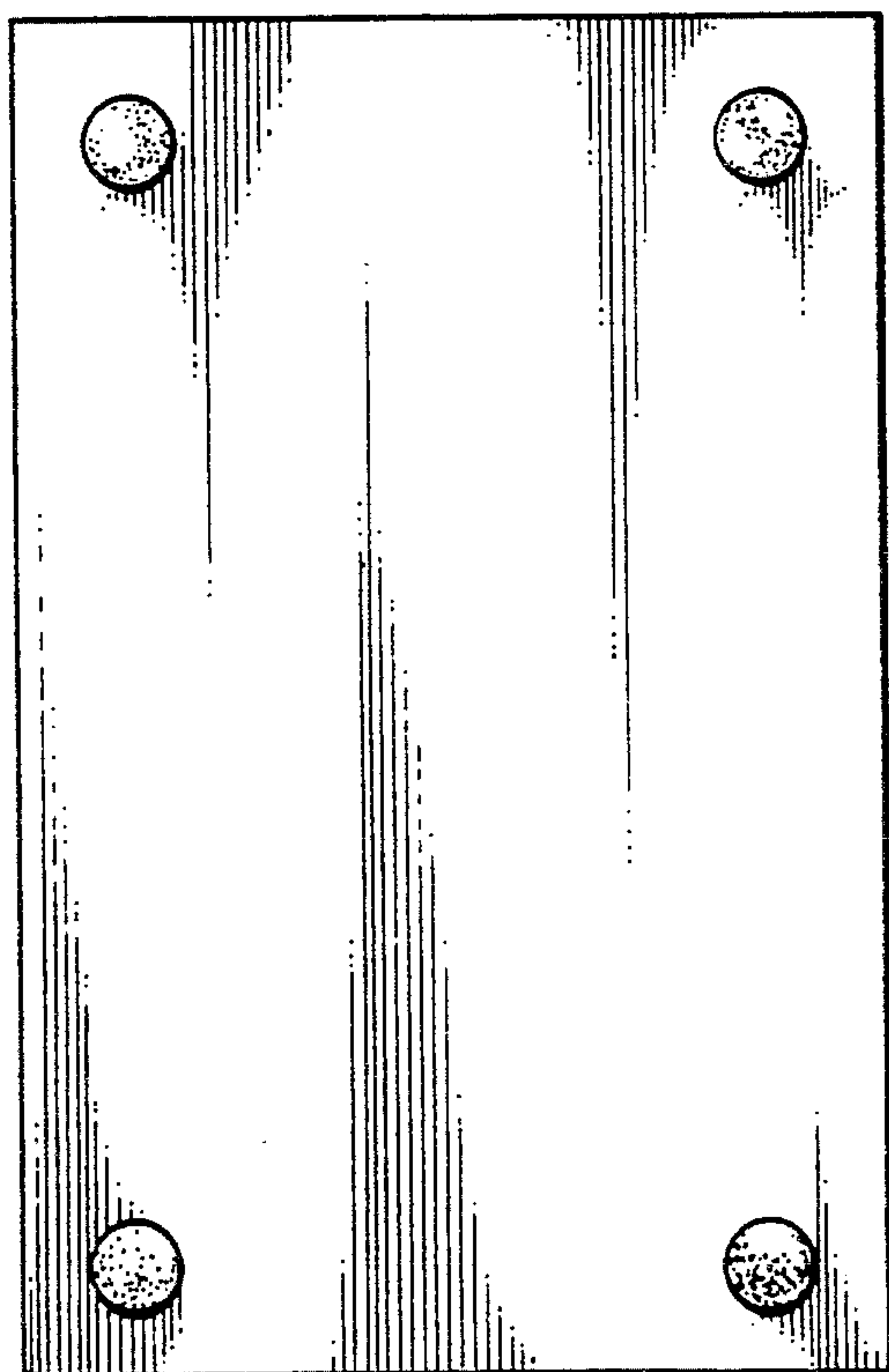

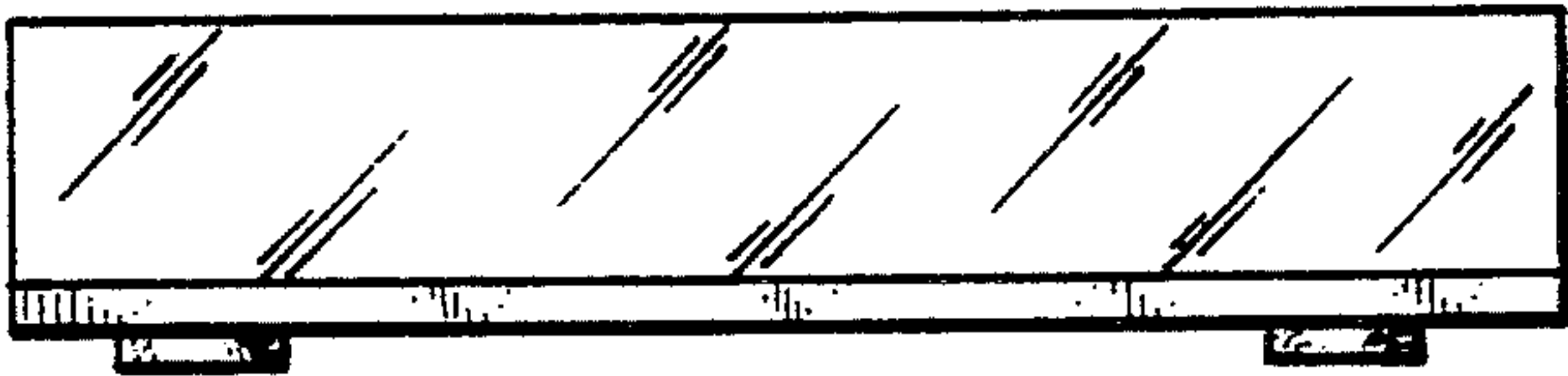

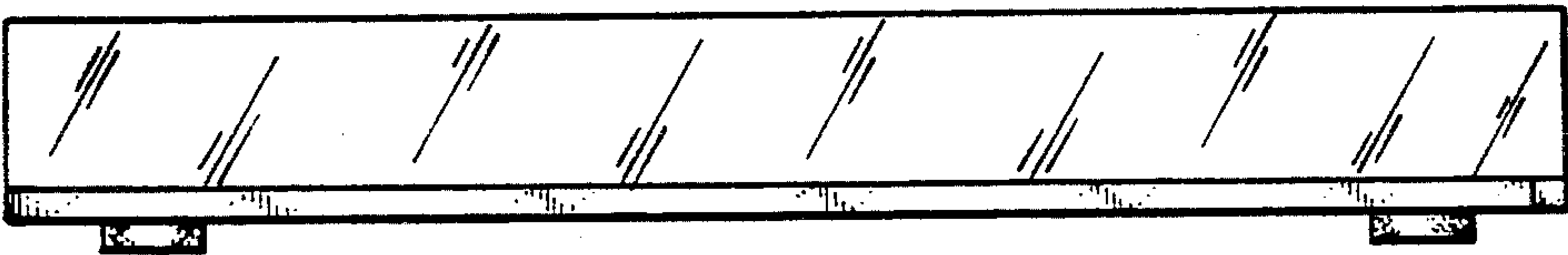

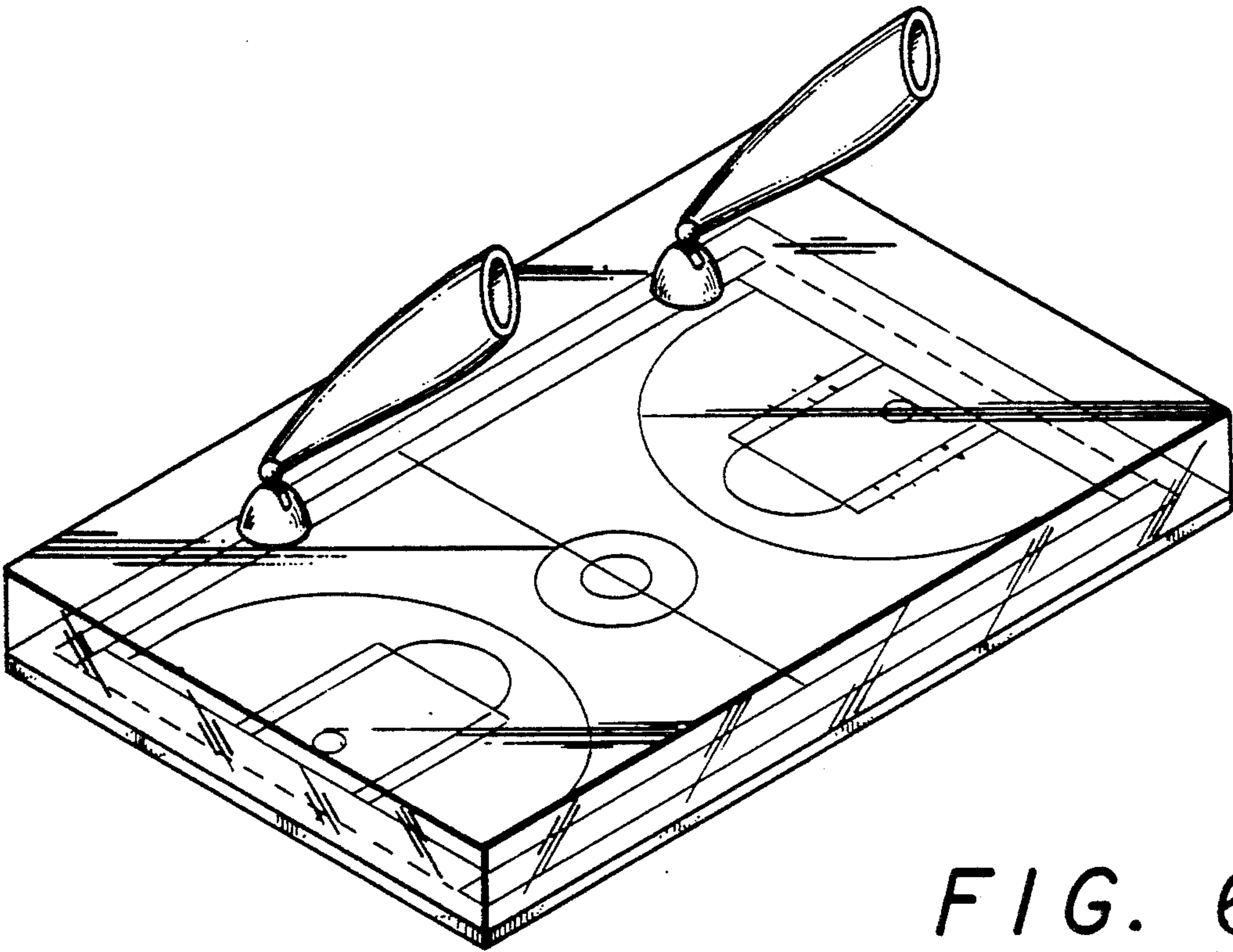
