DESCRIPTION

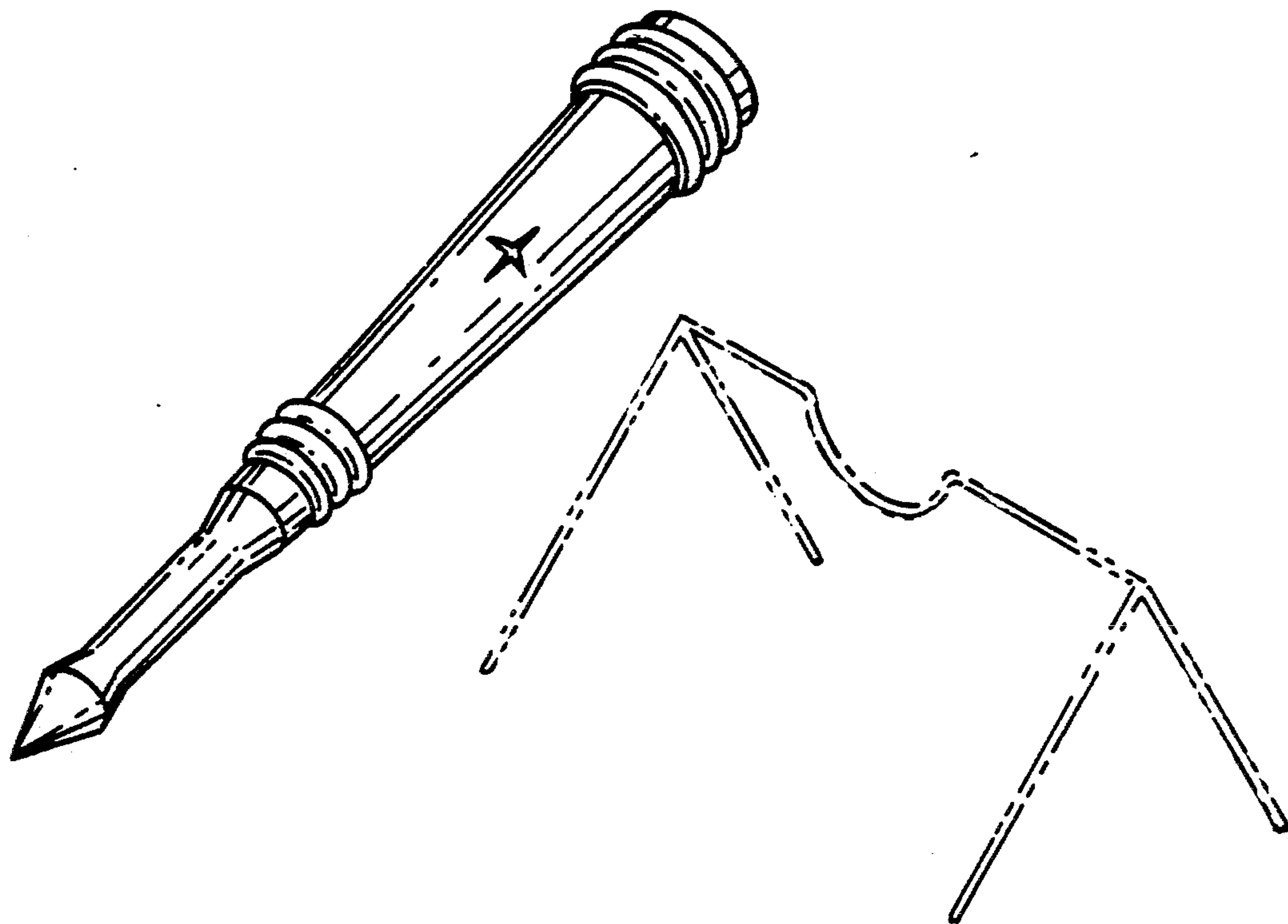
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a game piece or similar showing my new design;

The broken lines showing of support in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claim.



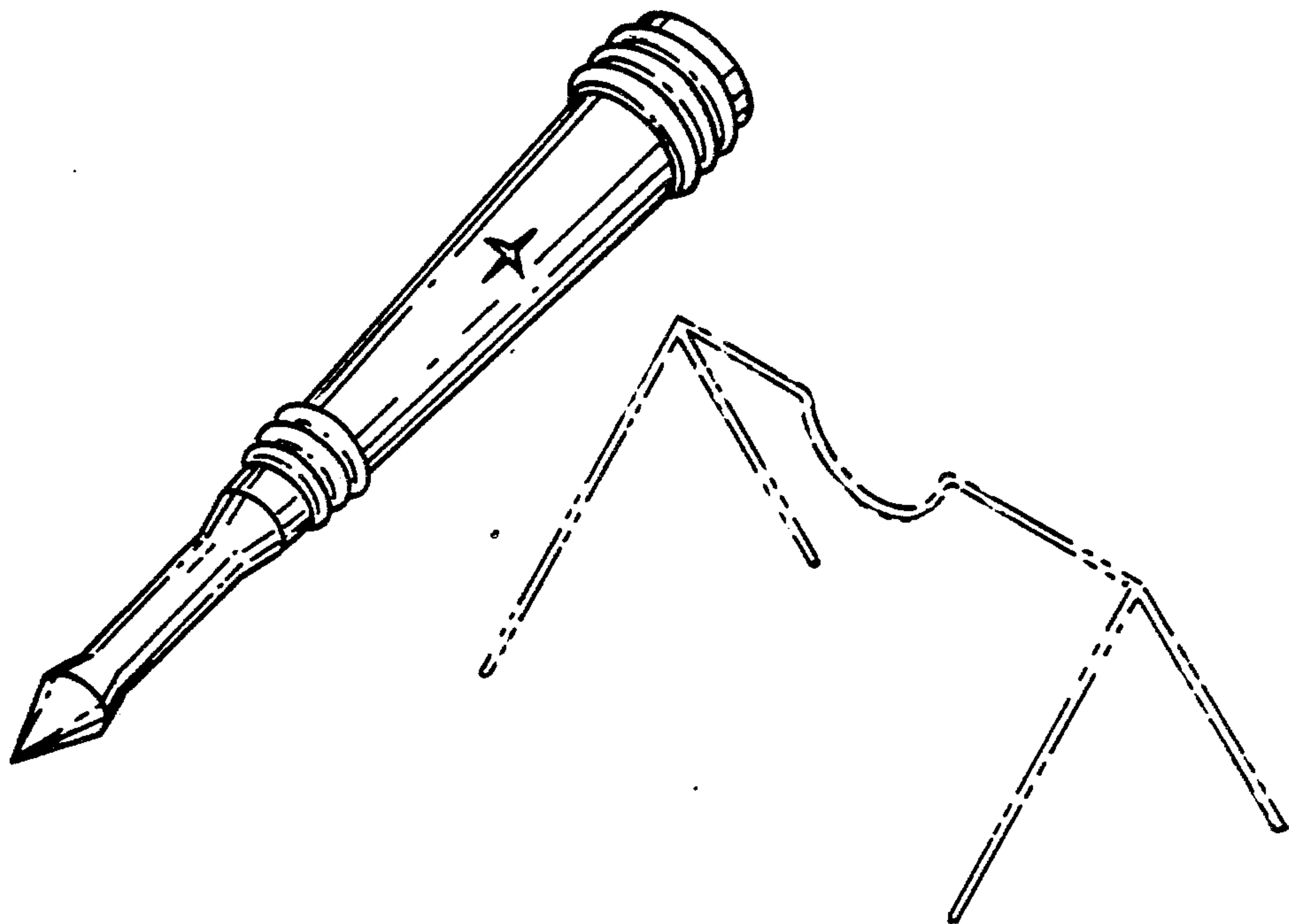

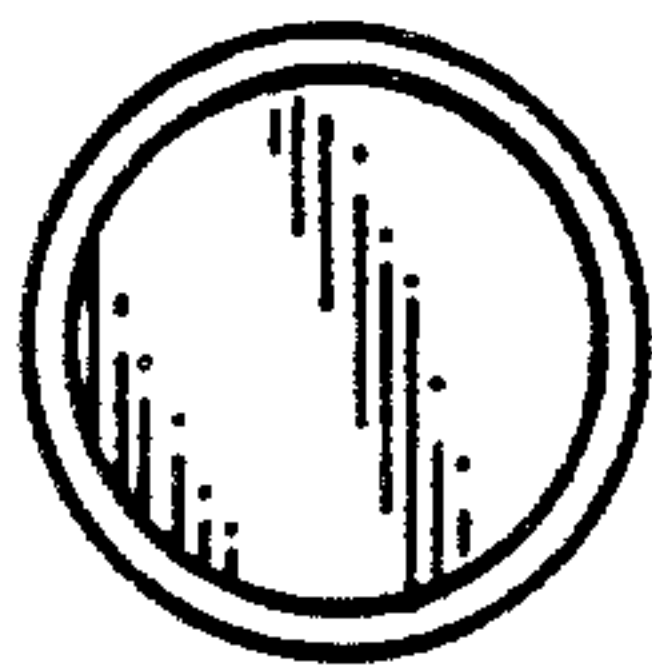

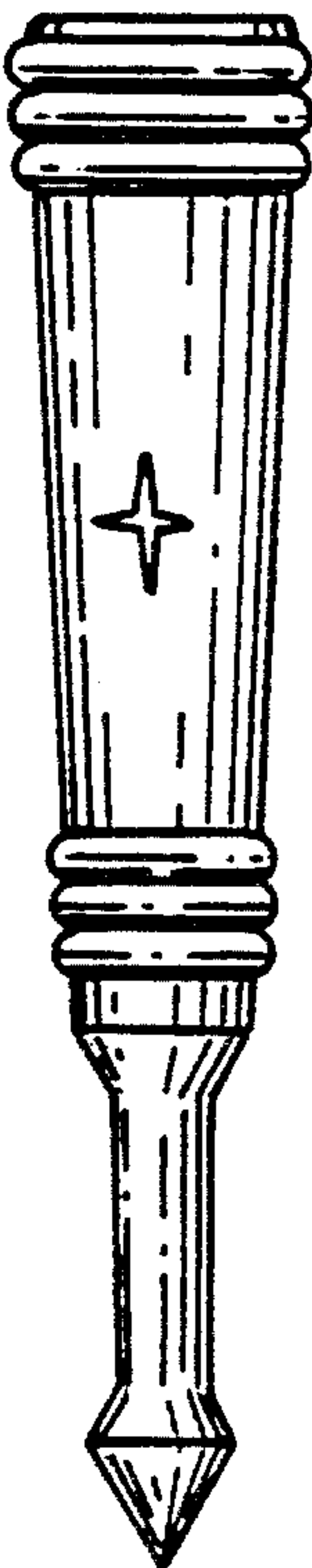
