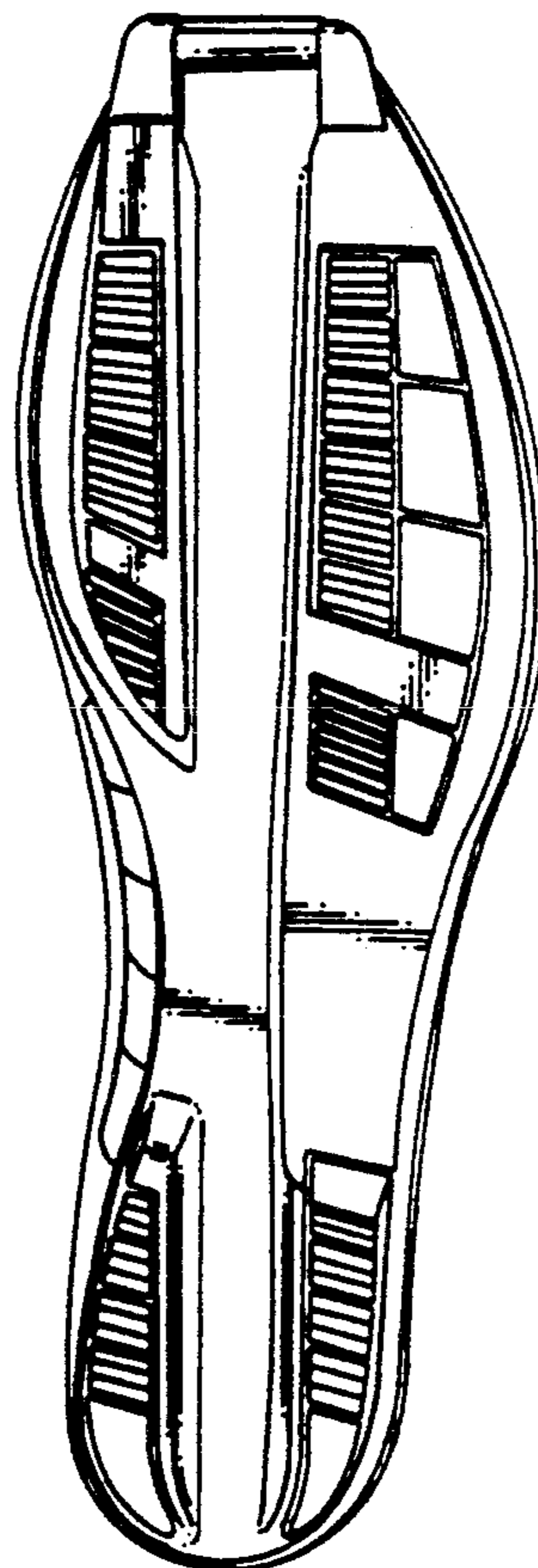

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the sole section of a sport
shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a front end elevational view.



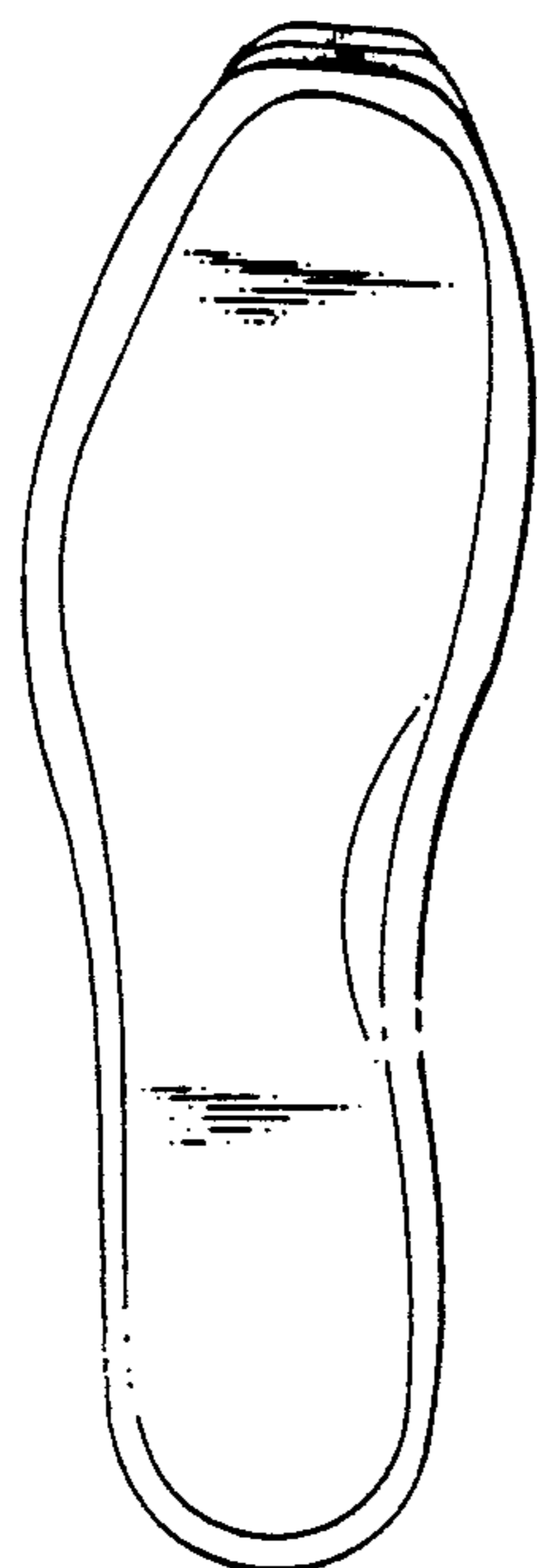

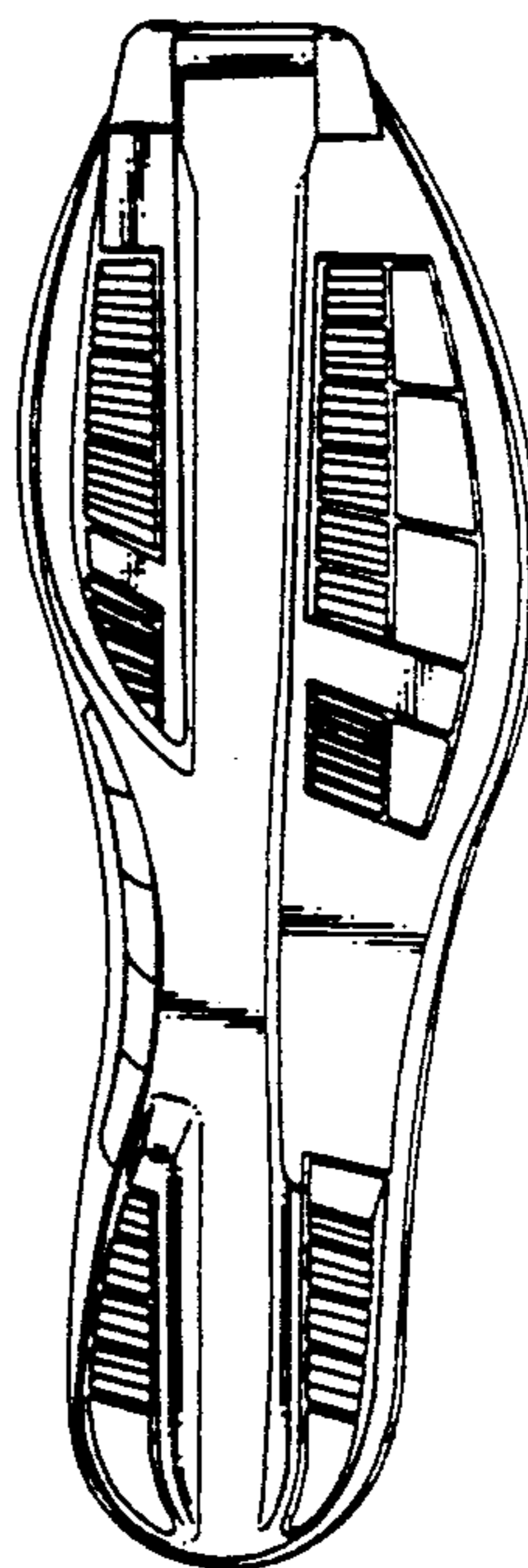

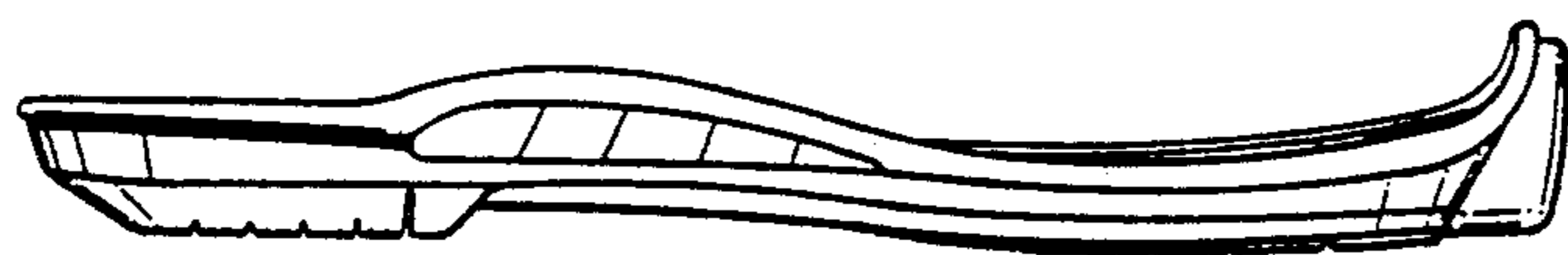

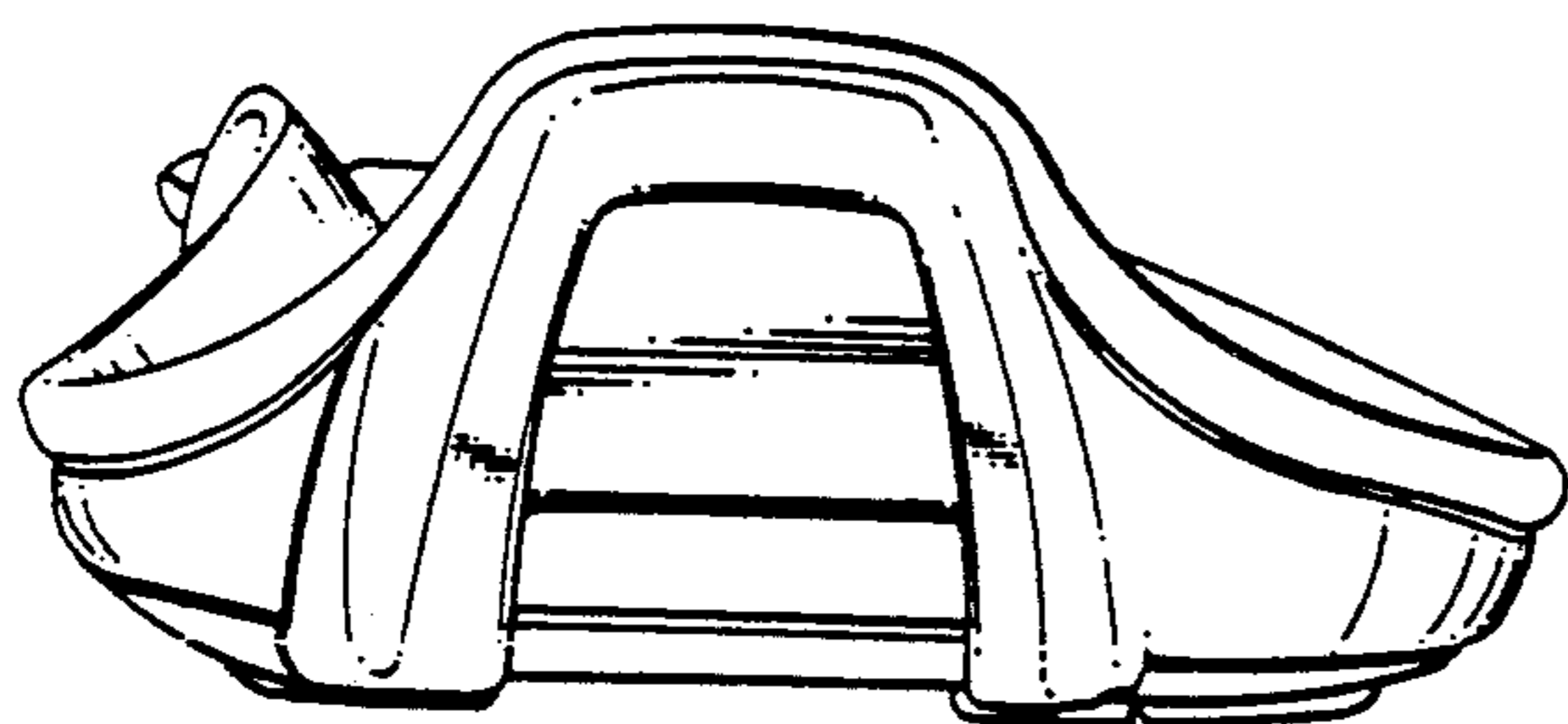
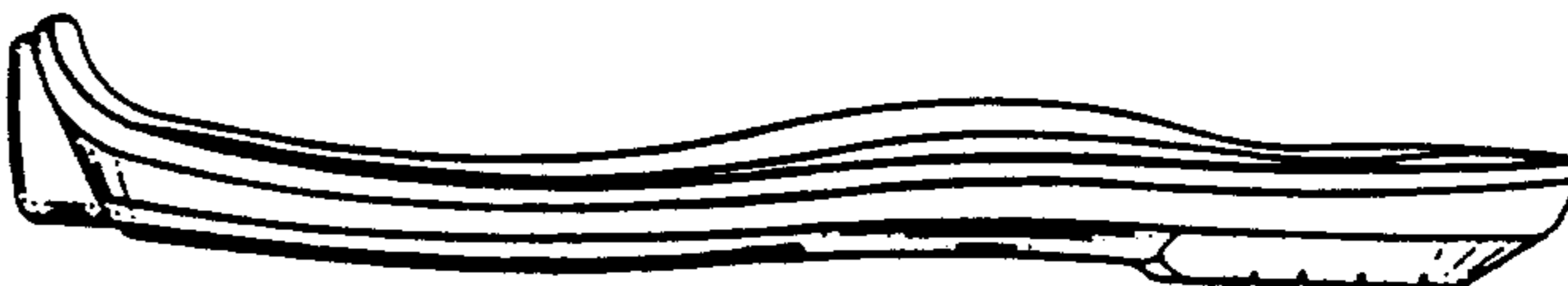

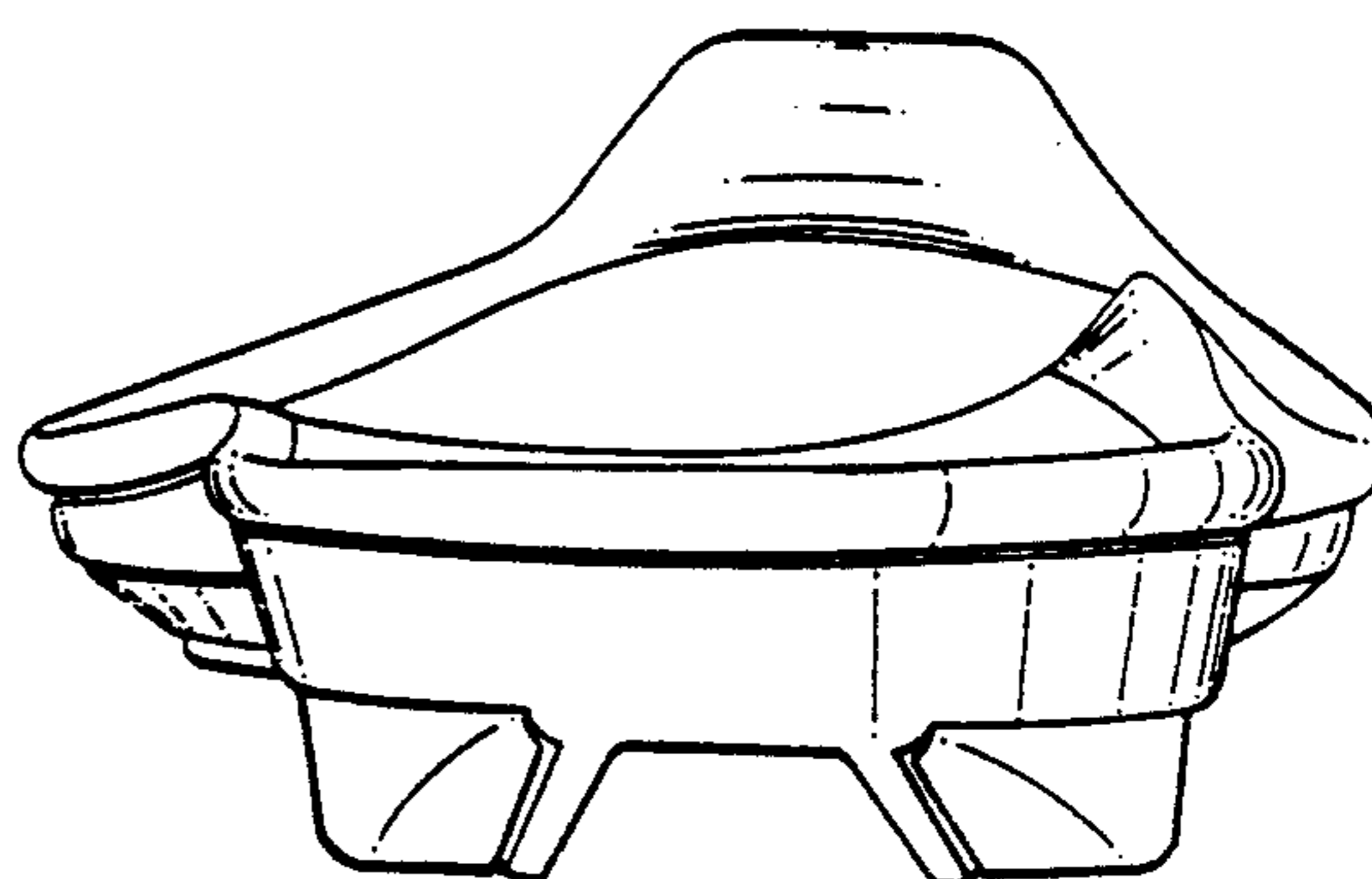
