FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;

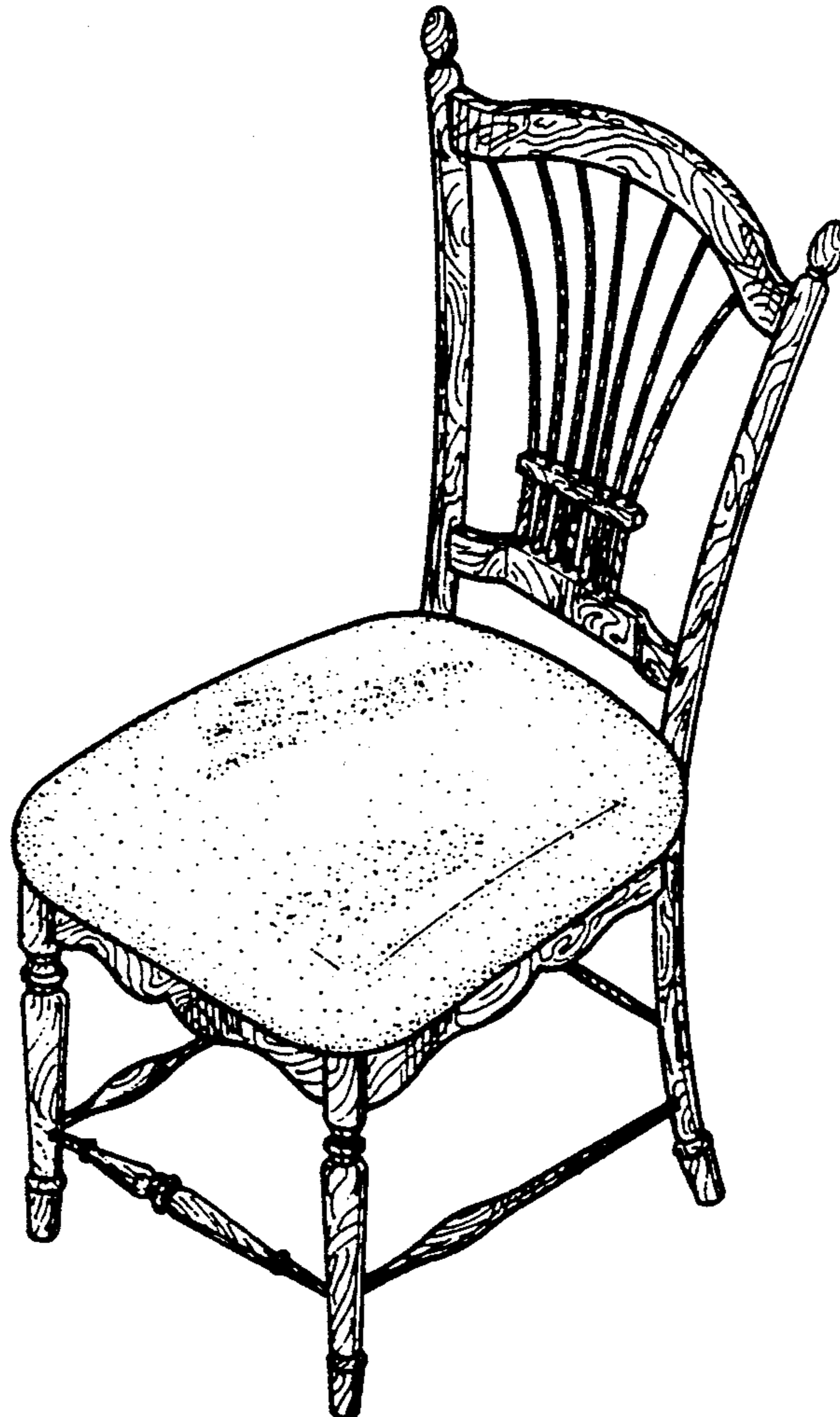
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;

FIGS. 2 through 7 have been drawn to a larger scale with respect to FIG. 1.



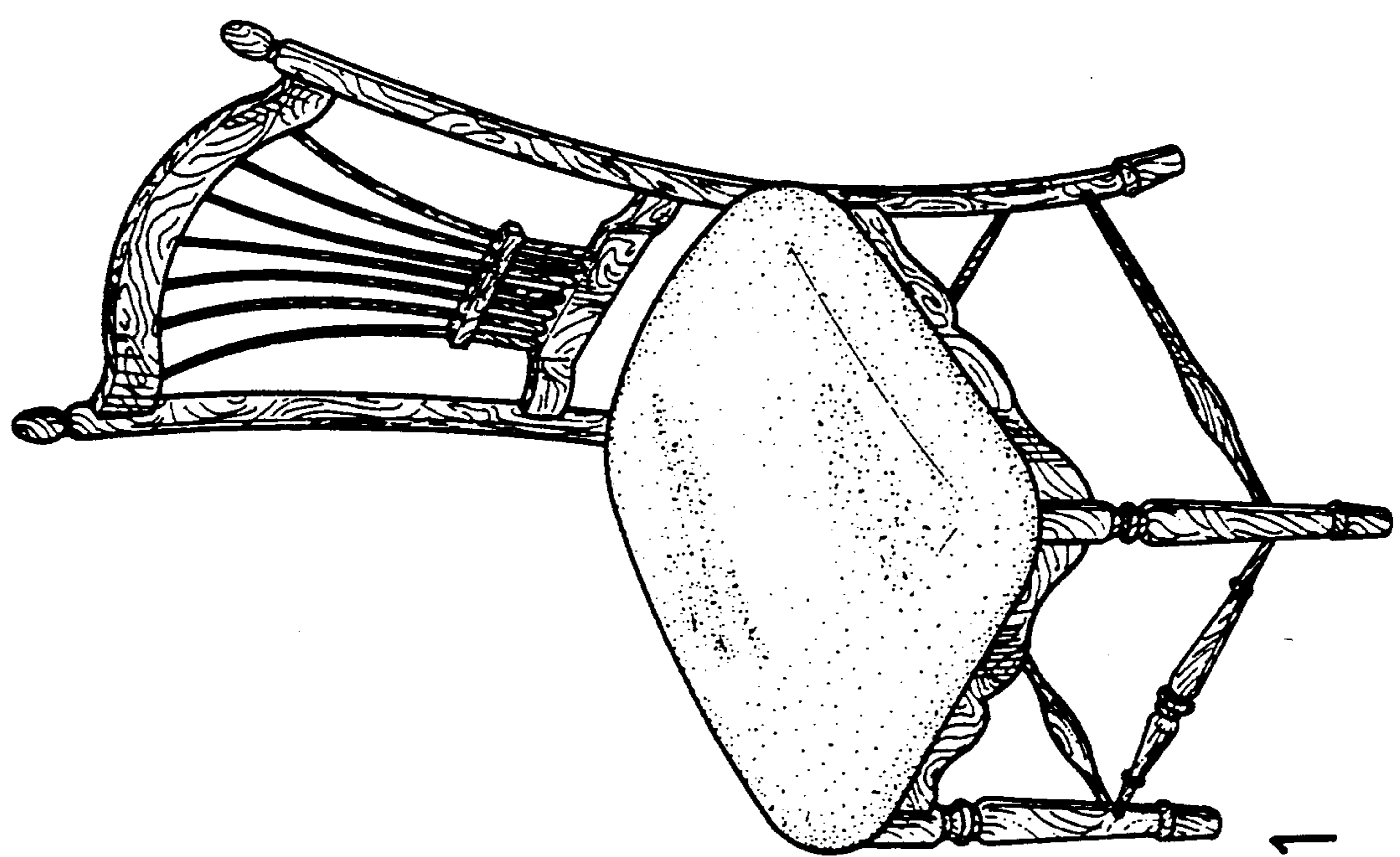

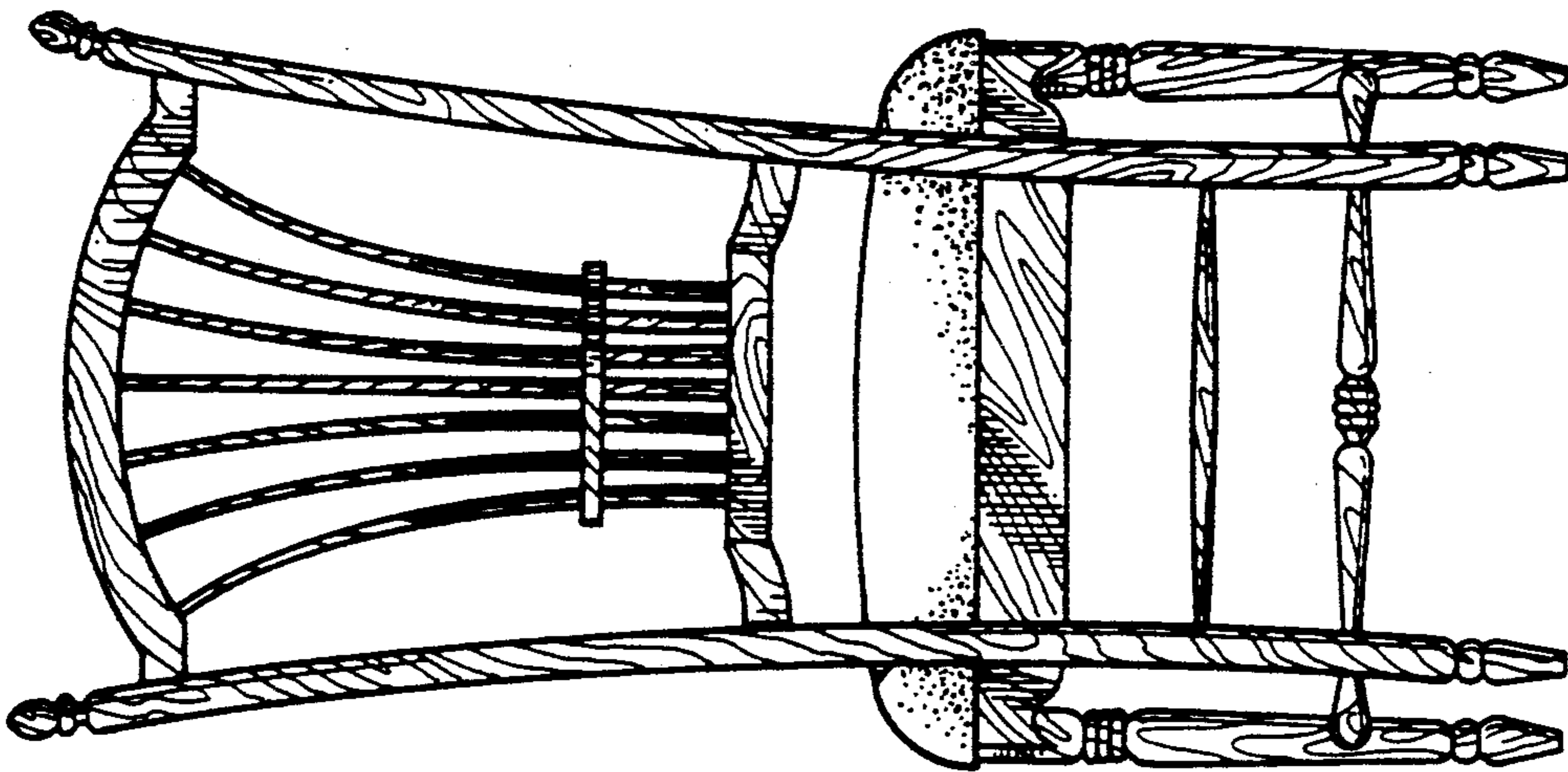

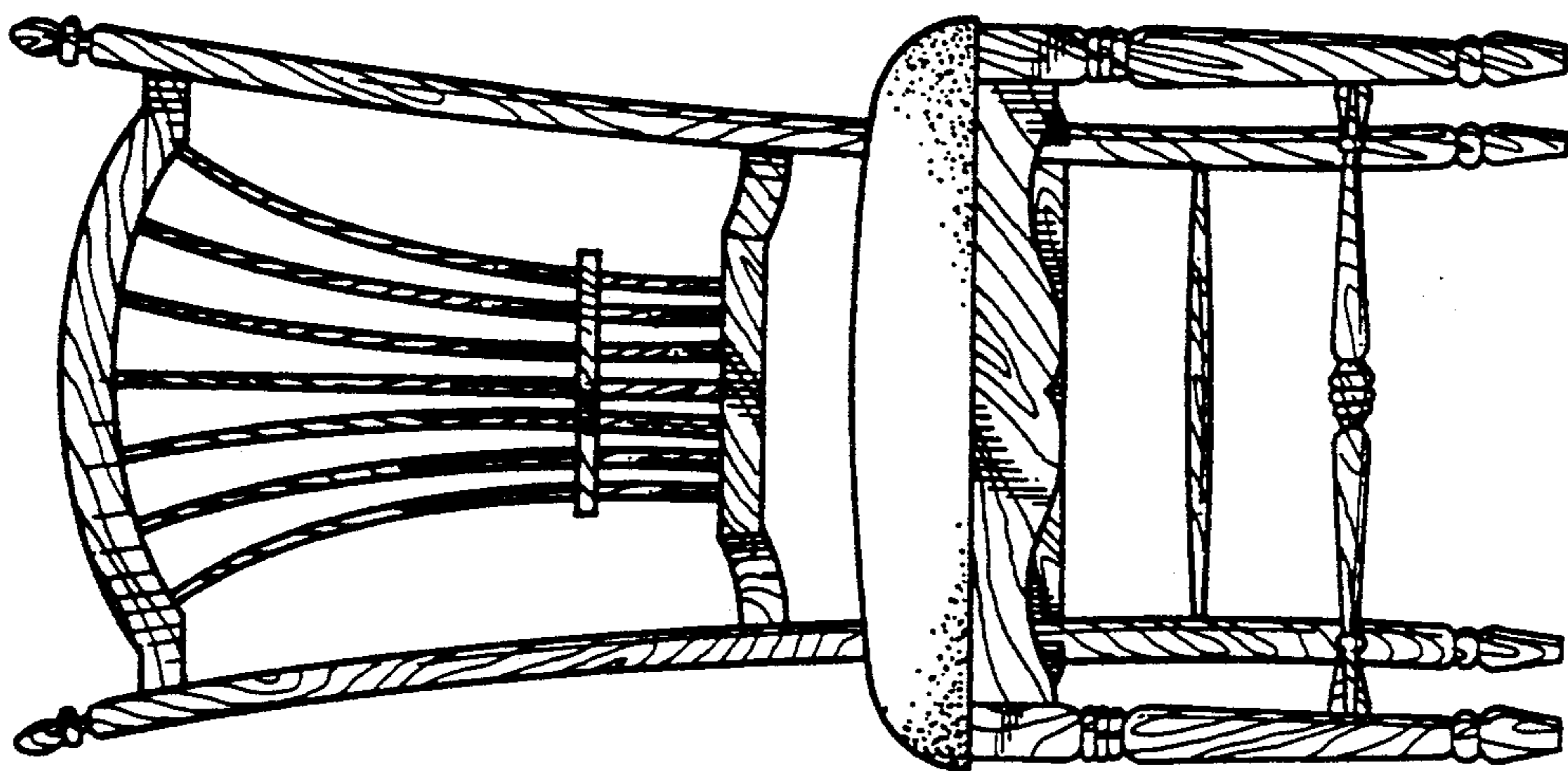

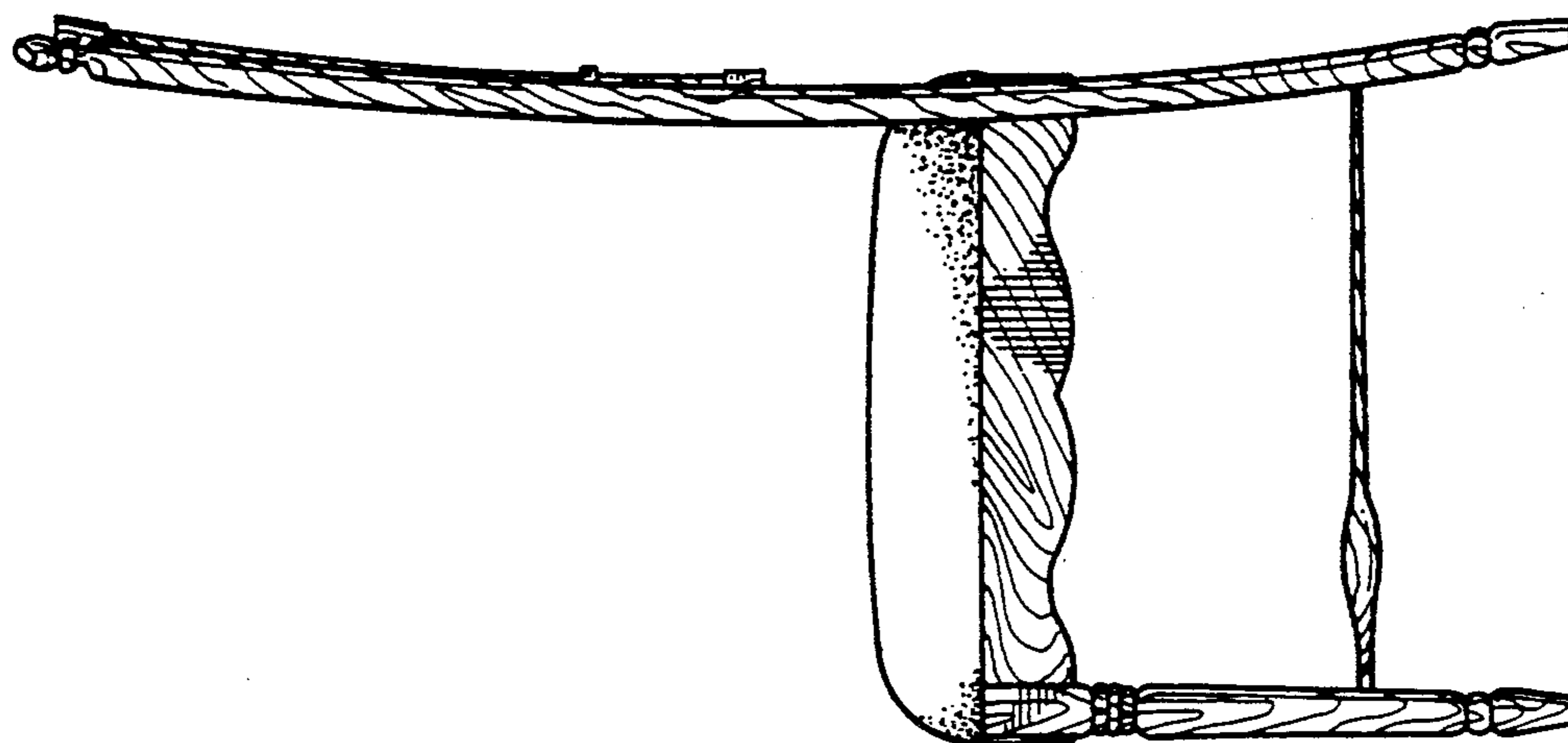

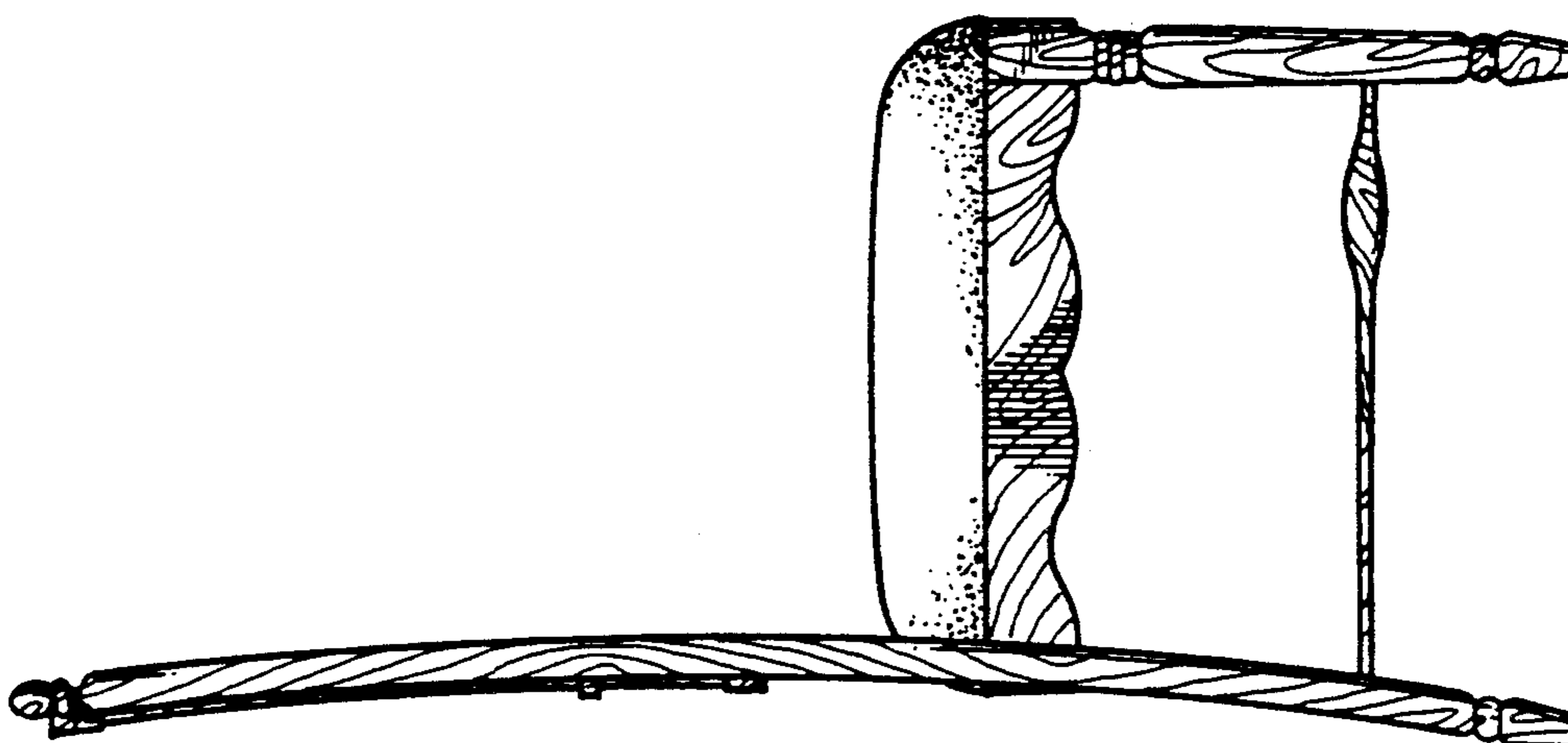

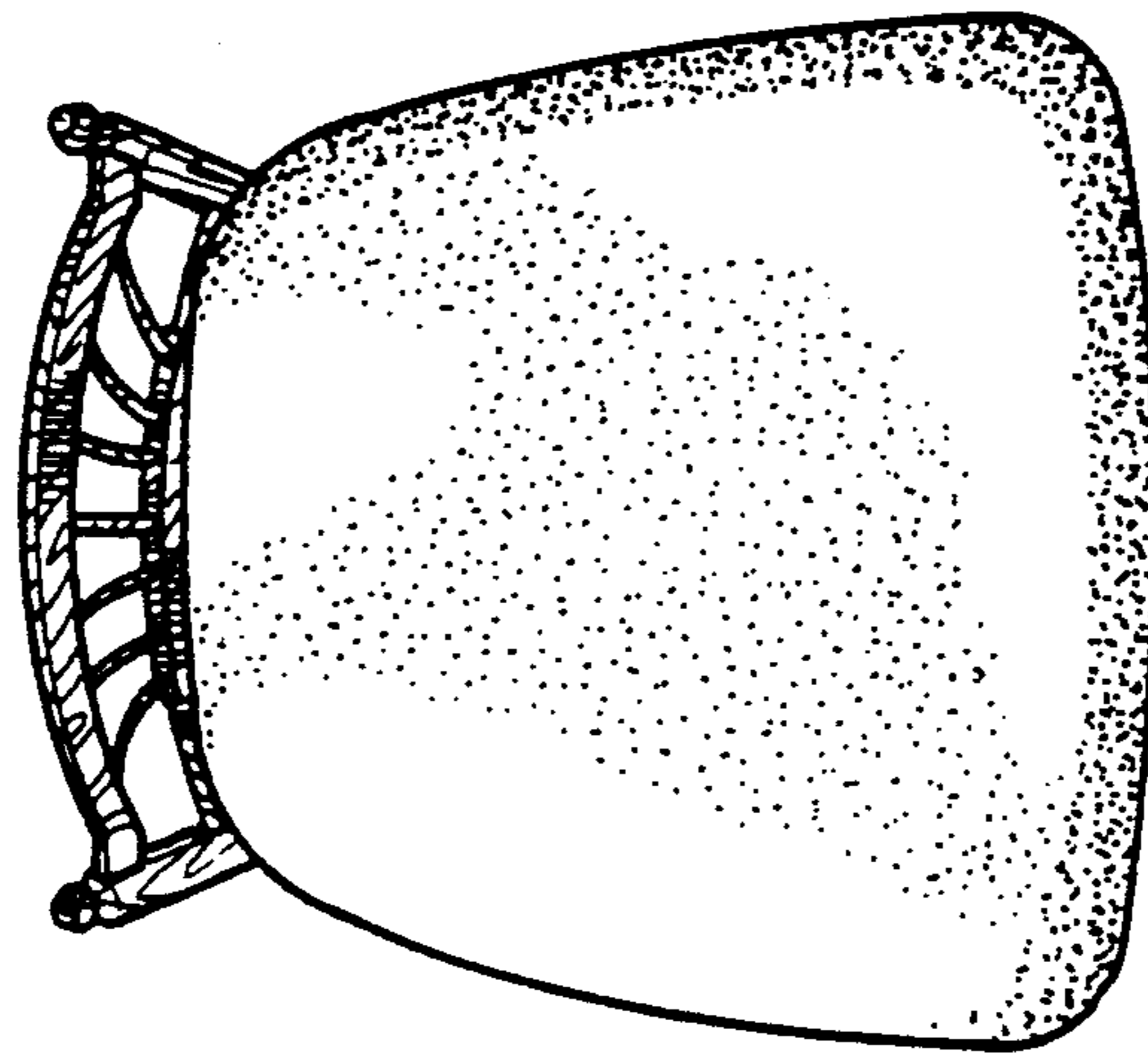

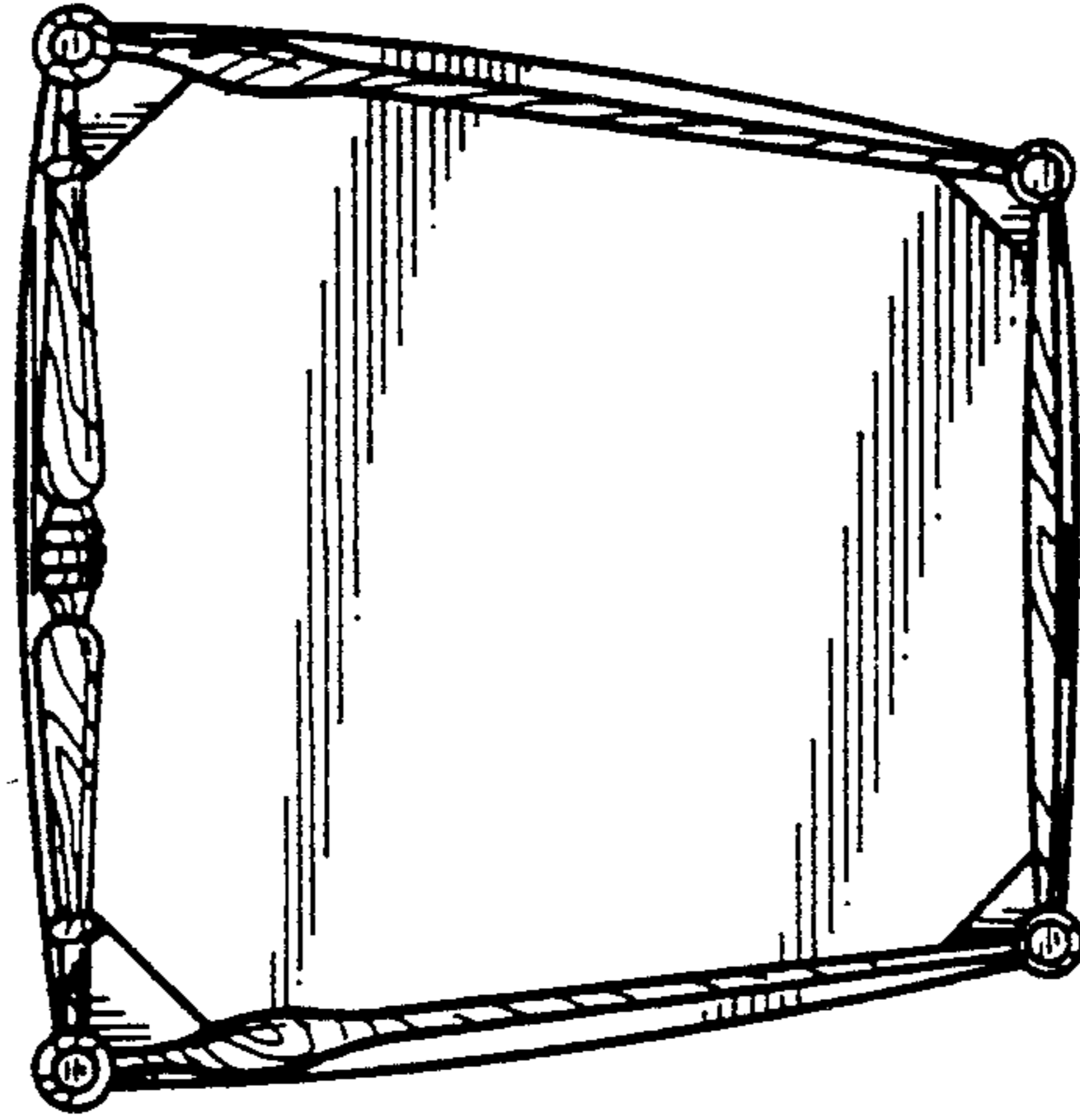
