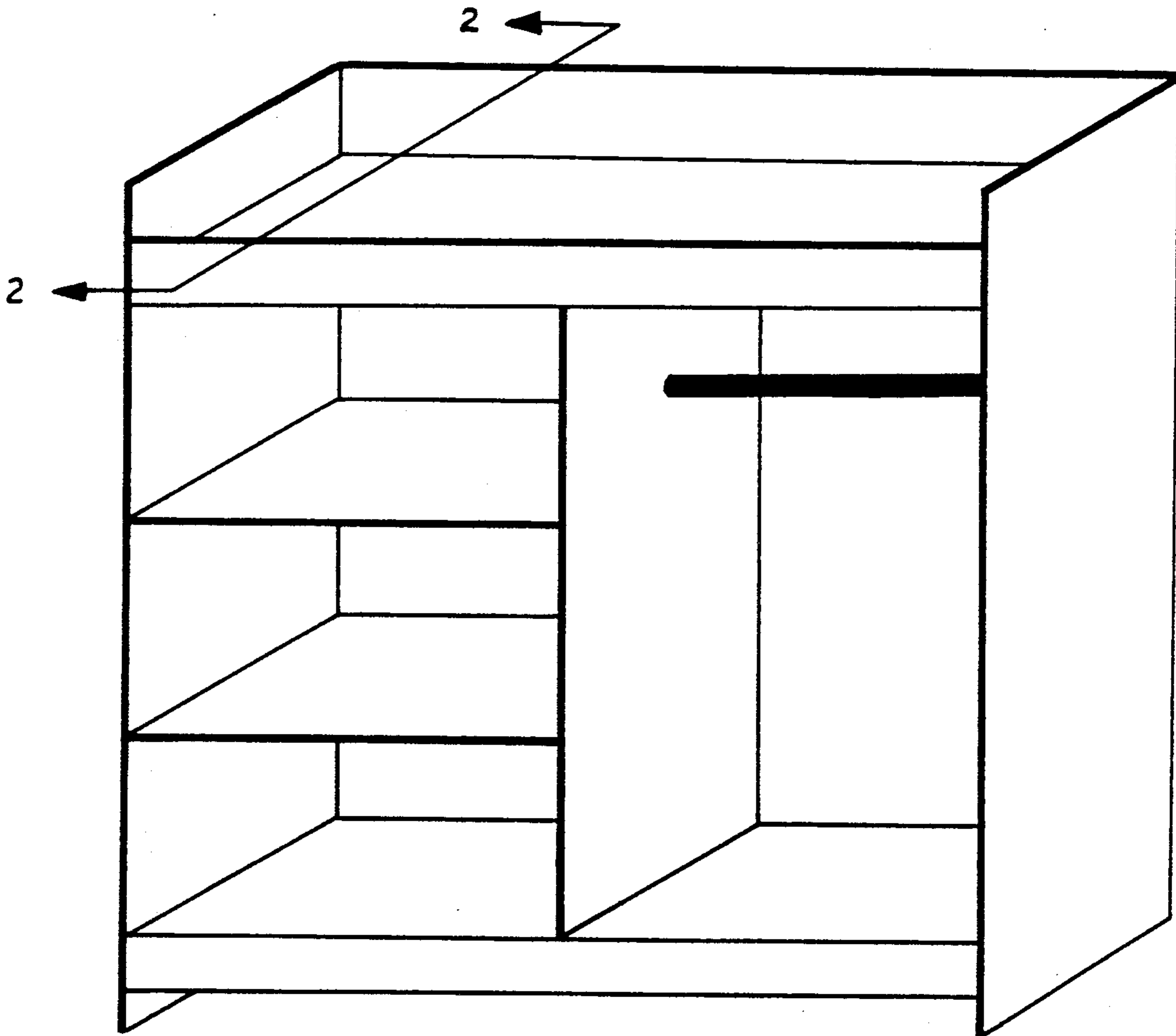

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a doll's changing table or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a doll's changing table or similar article, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a fragmentary sectional view taken along line 2-2 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of an alternative embodiment of FIG. 1.



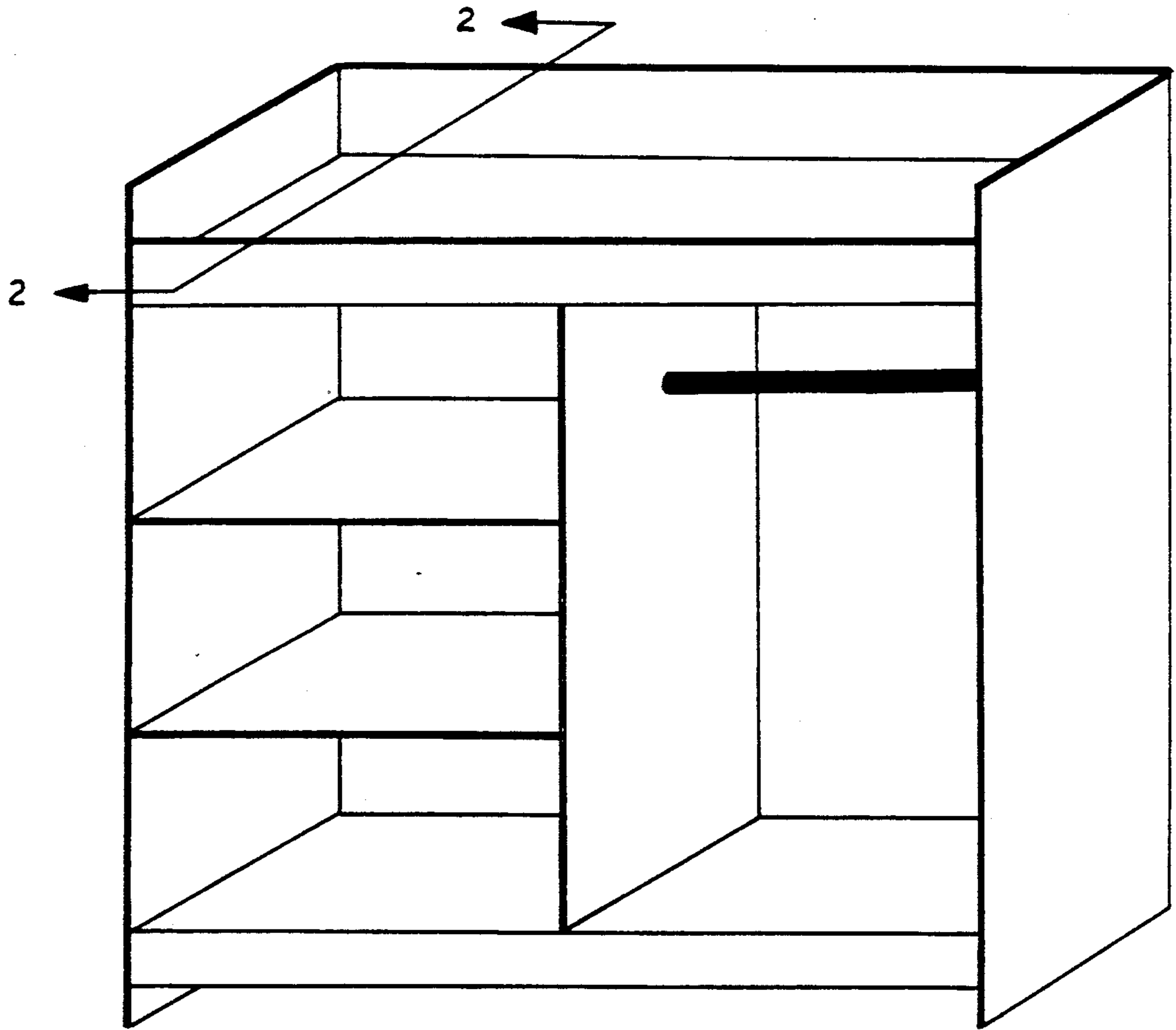

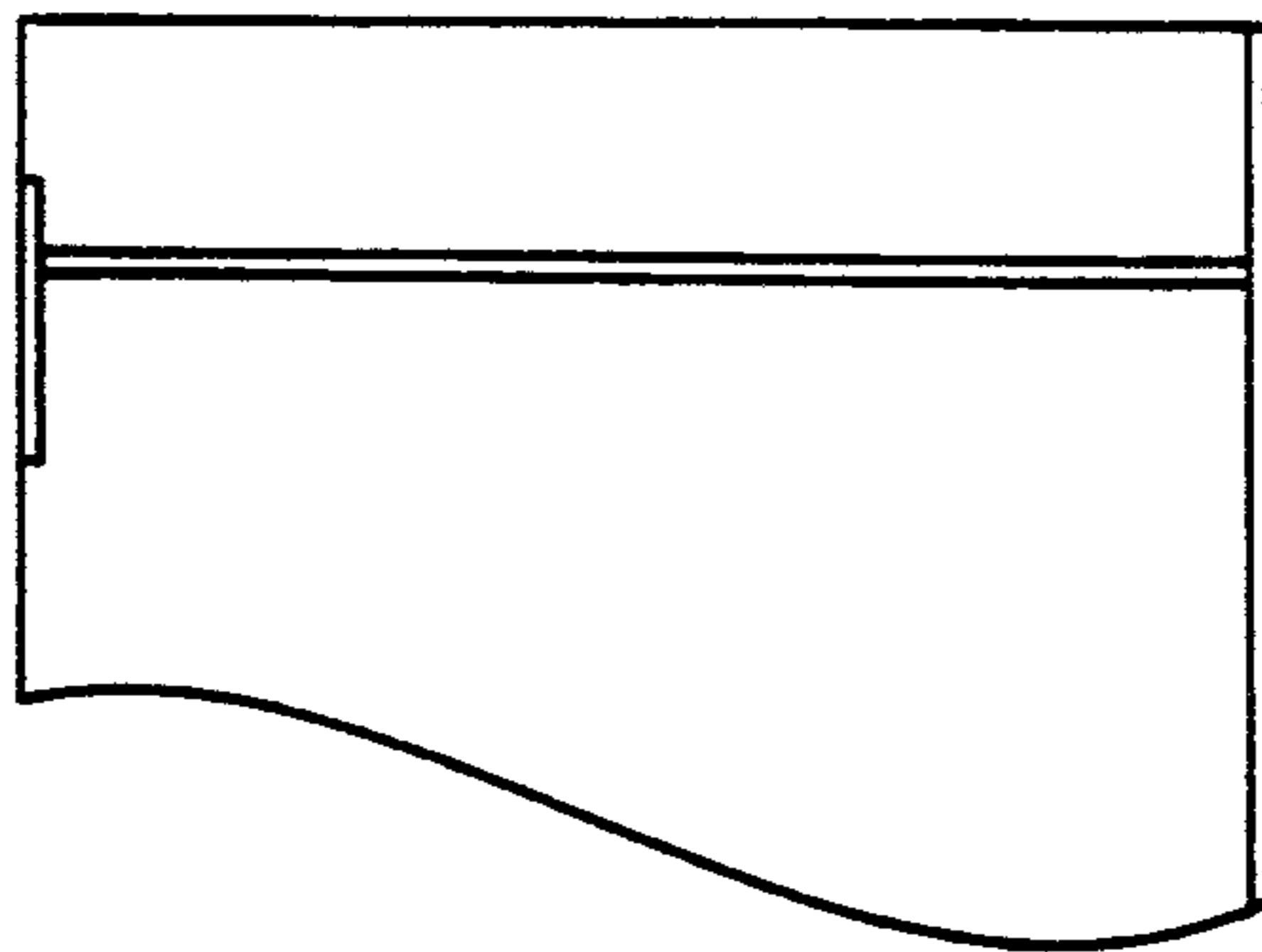

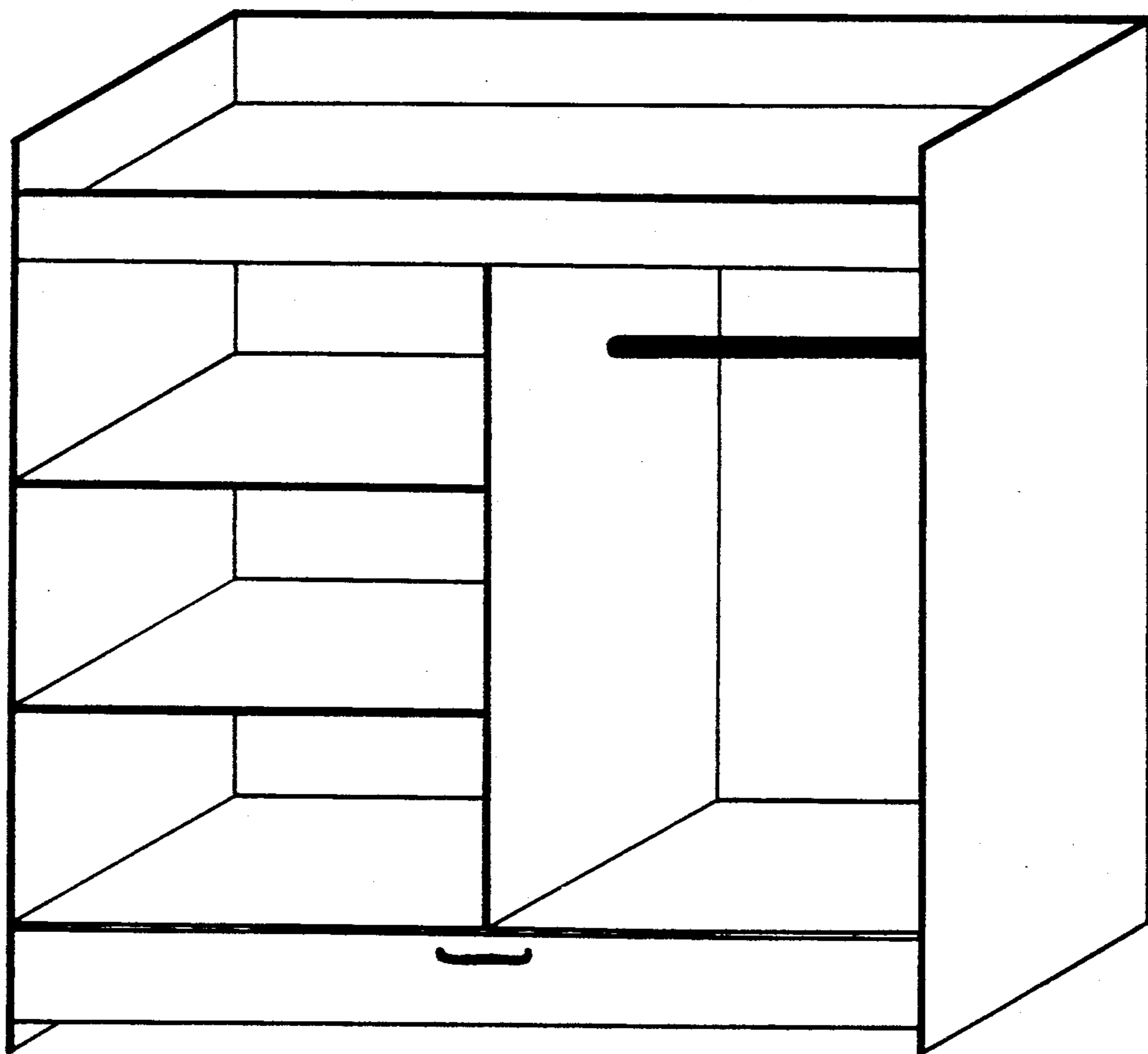
