DESCRIPTION

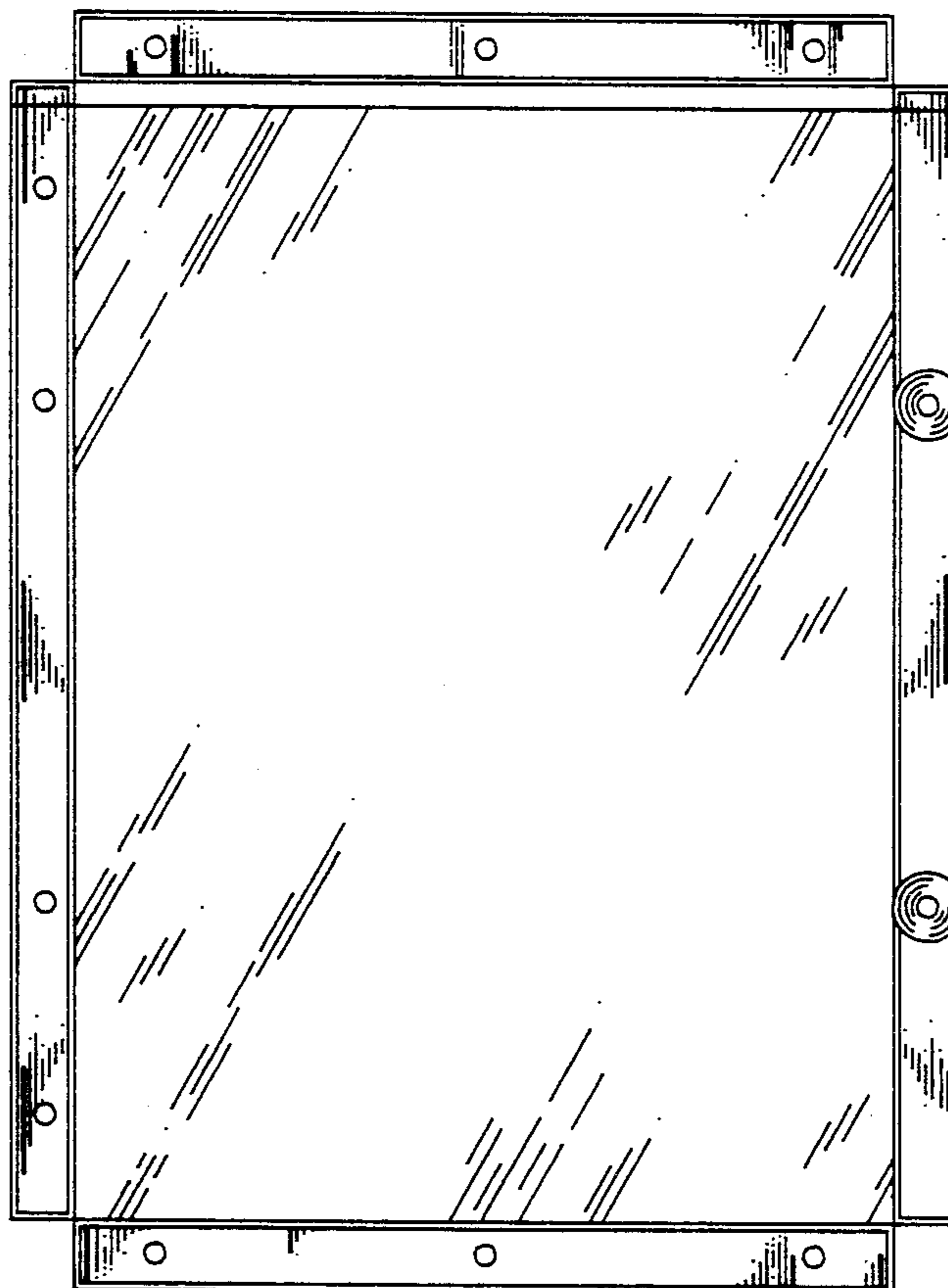
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wall display holder for comic books and the like showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



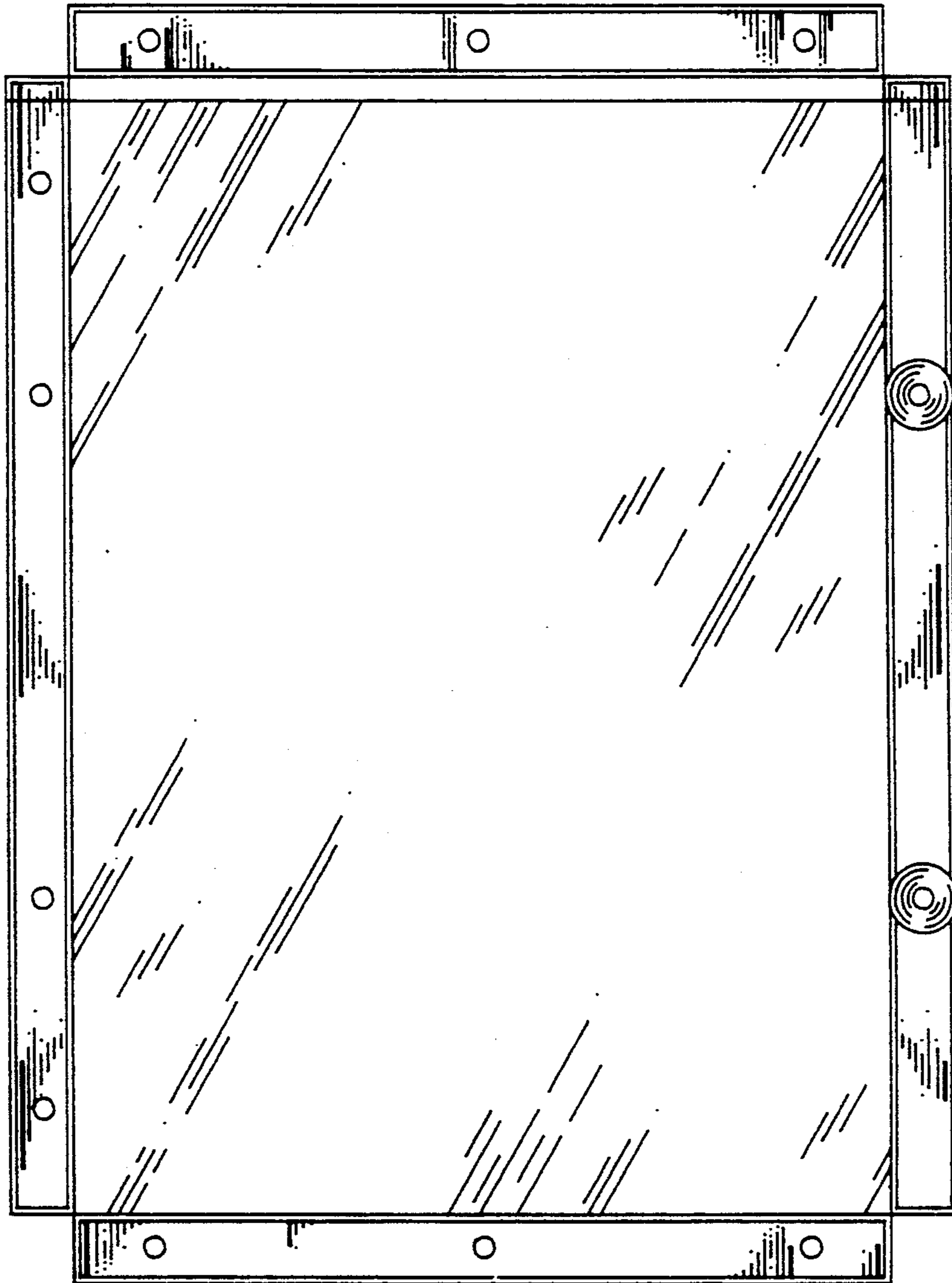

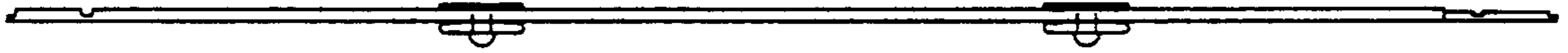

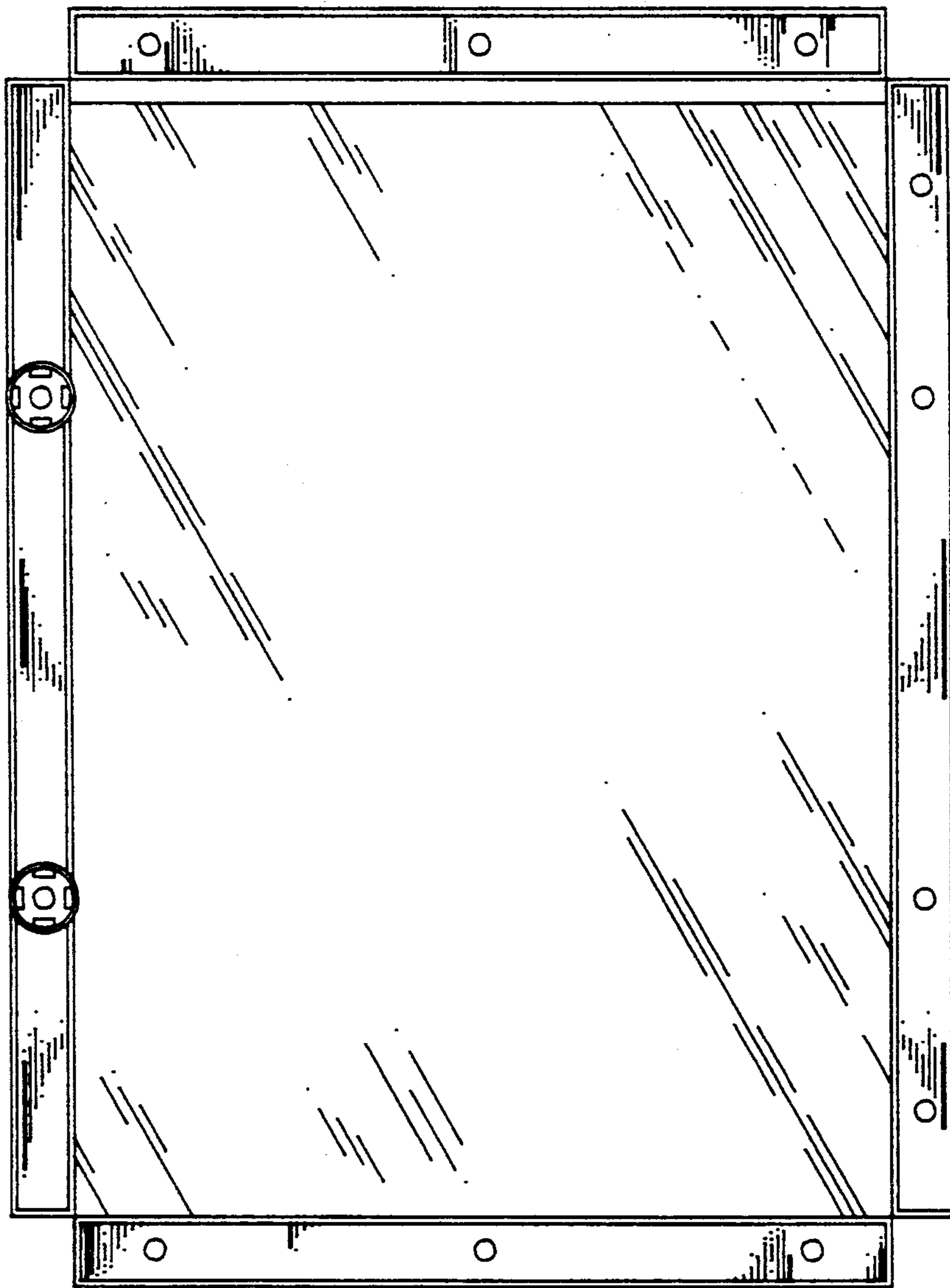
