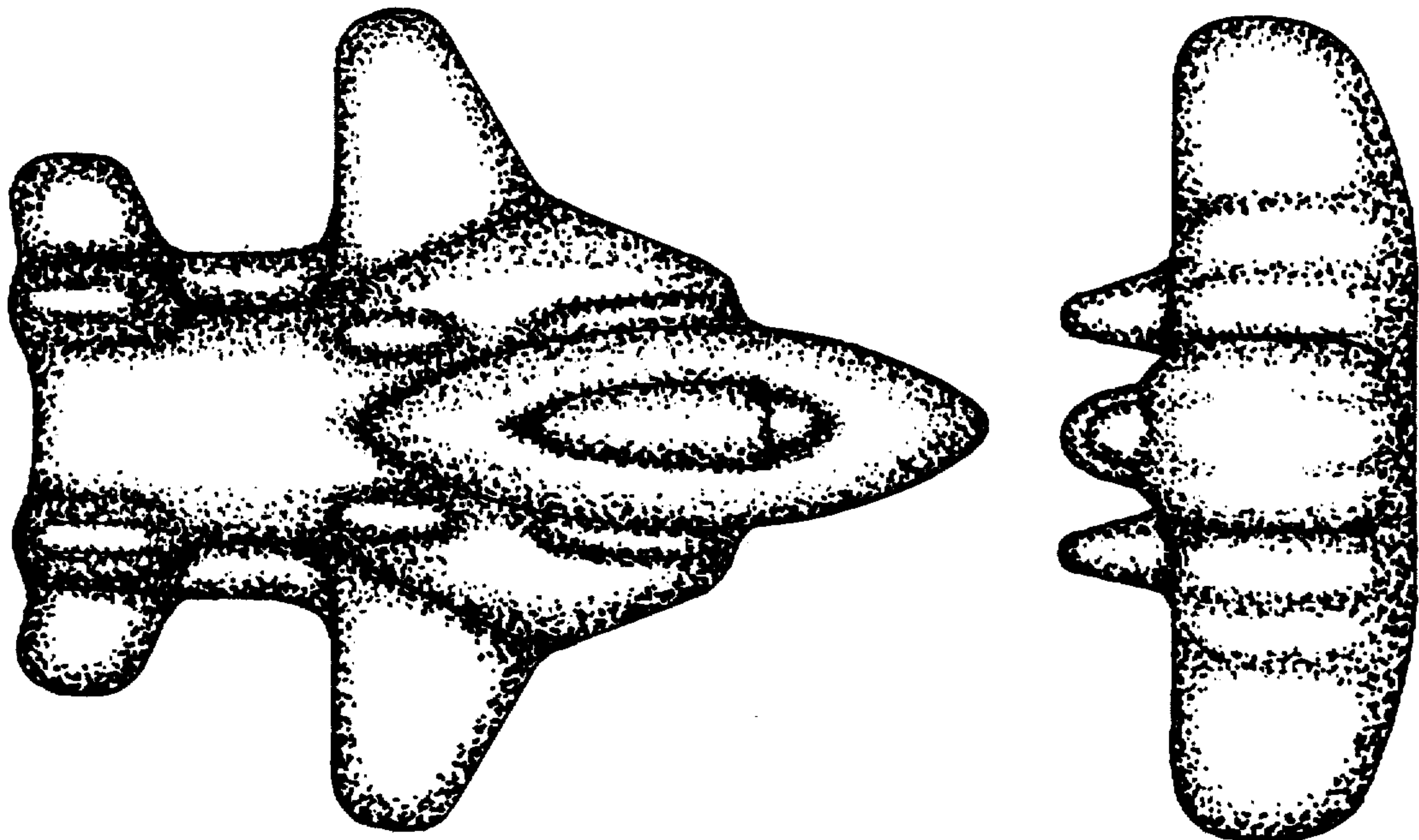

The ornamental design for a snack food product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a snack food product illustrating our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



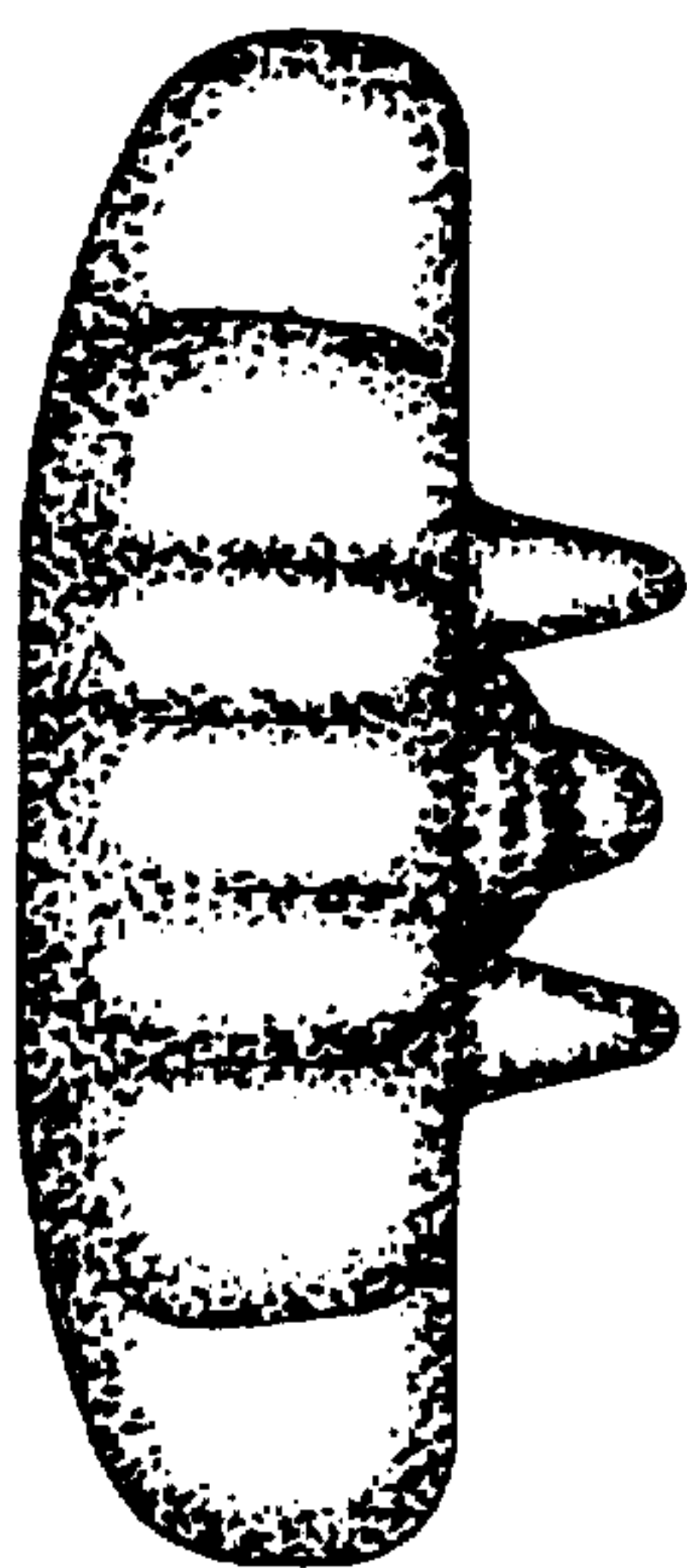

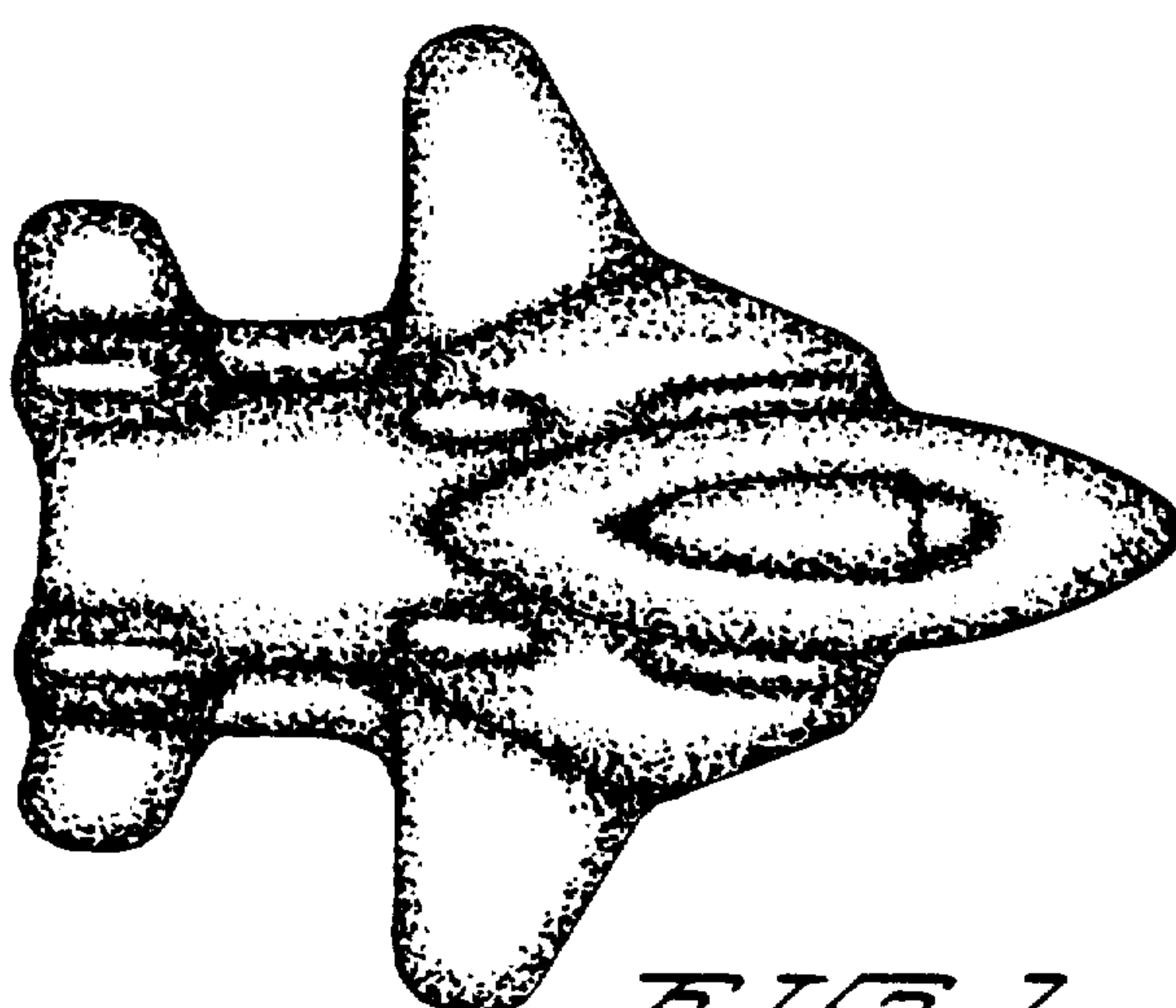

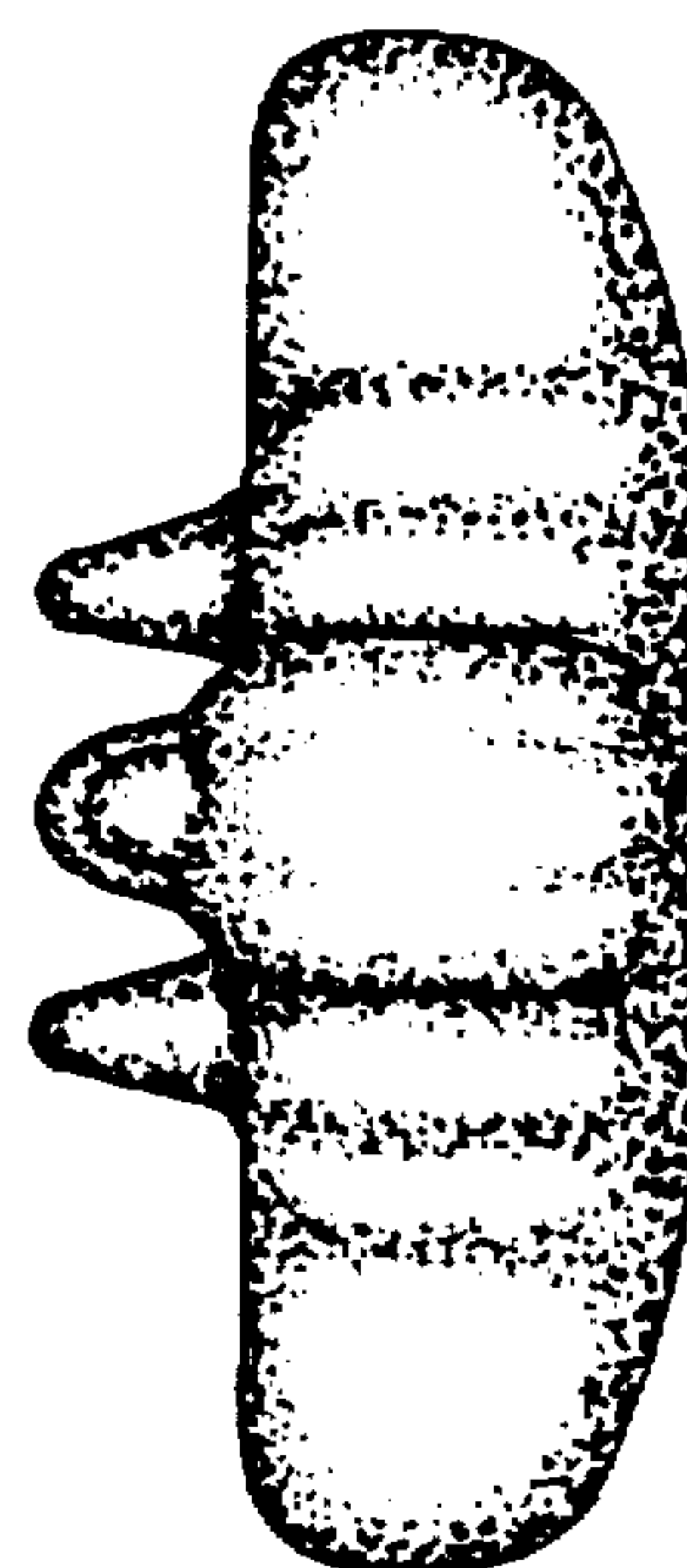

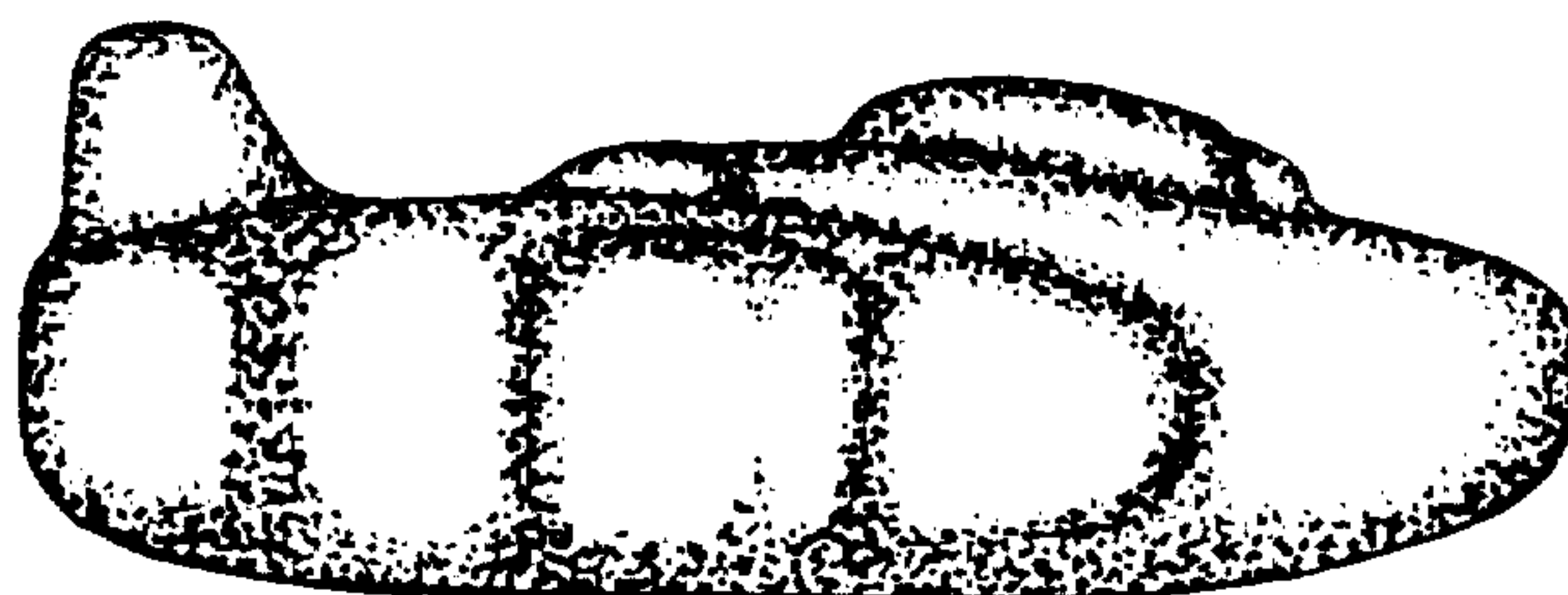

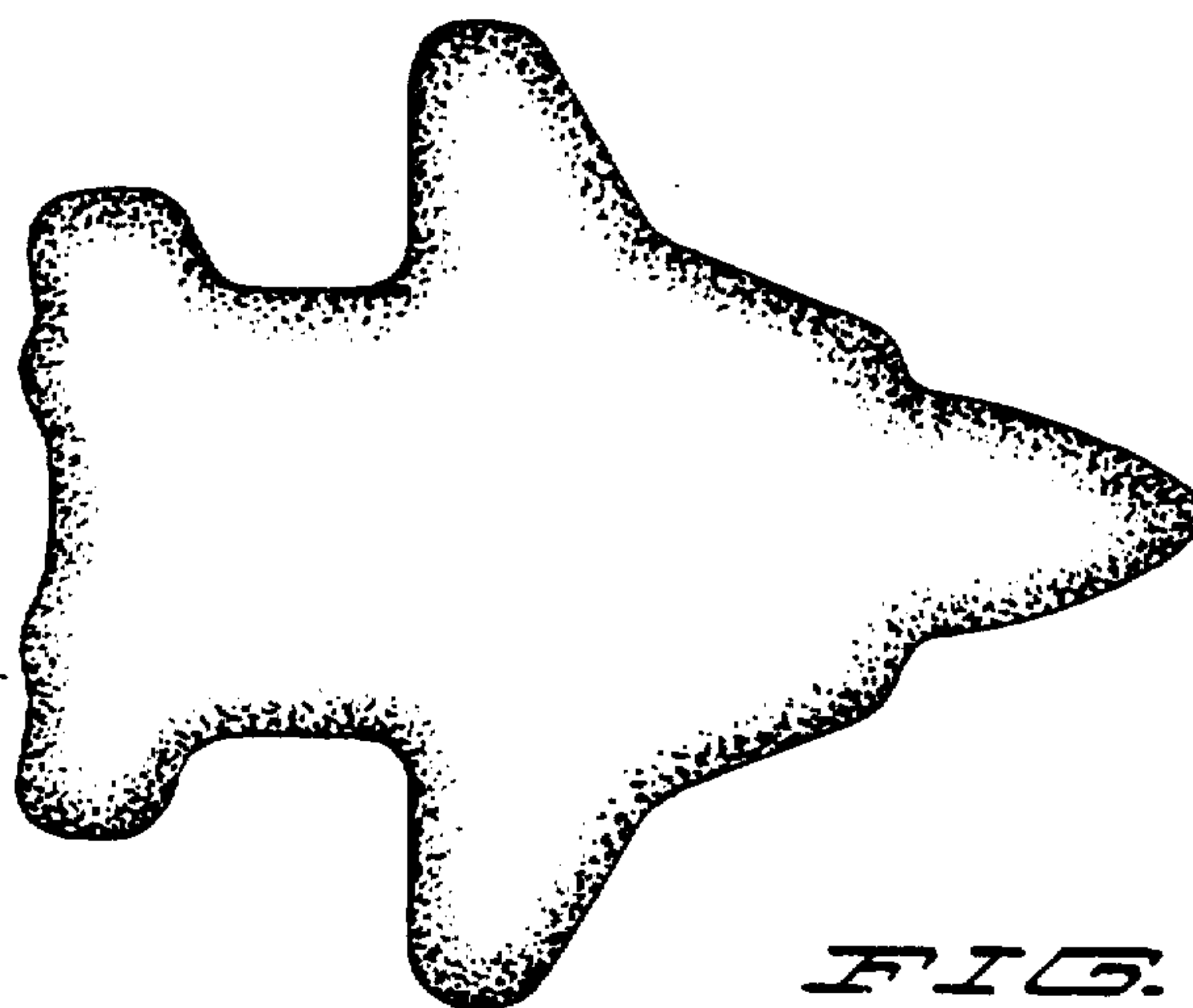
