[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sole for a boot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom front right perspective view of a sole for a boot showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view; and FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image. The broken line showing of a boot upper in FIGS. 1 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

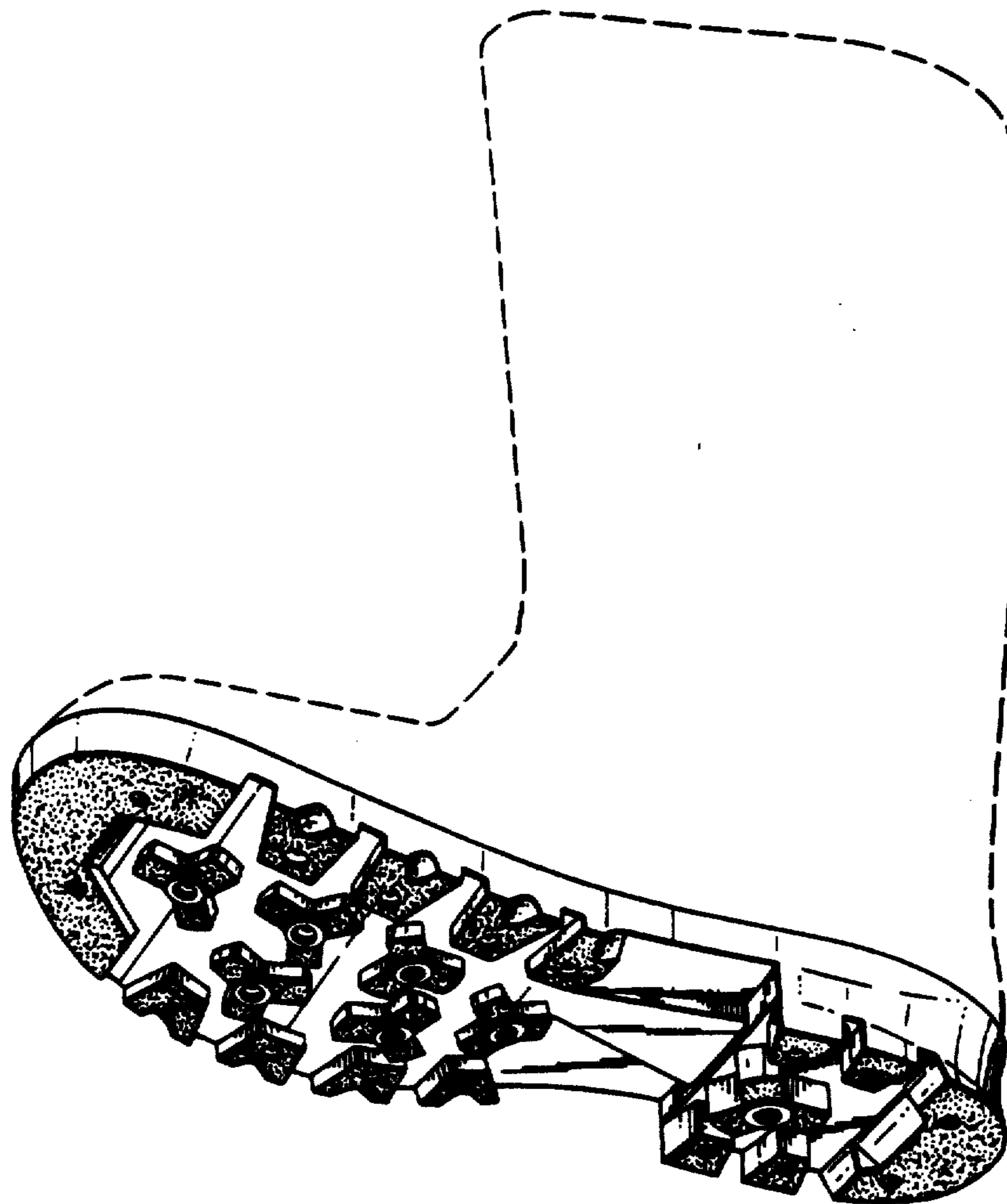

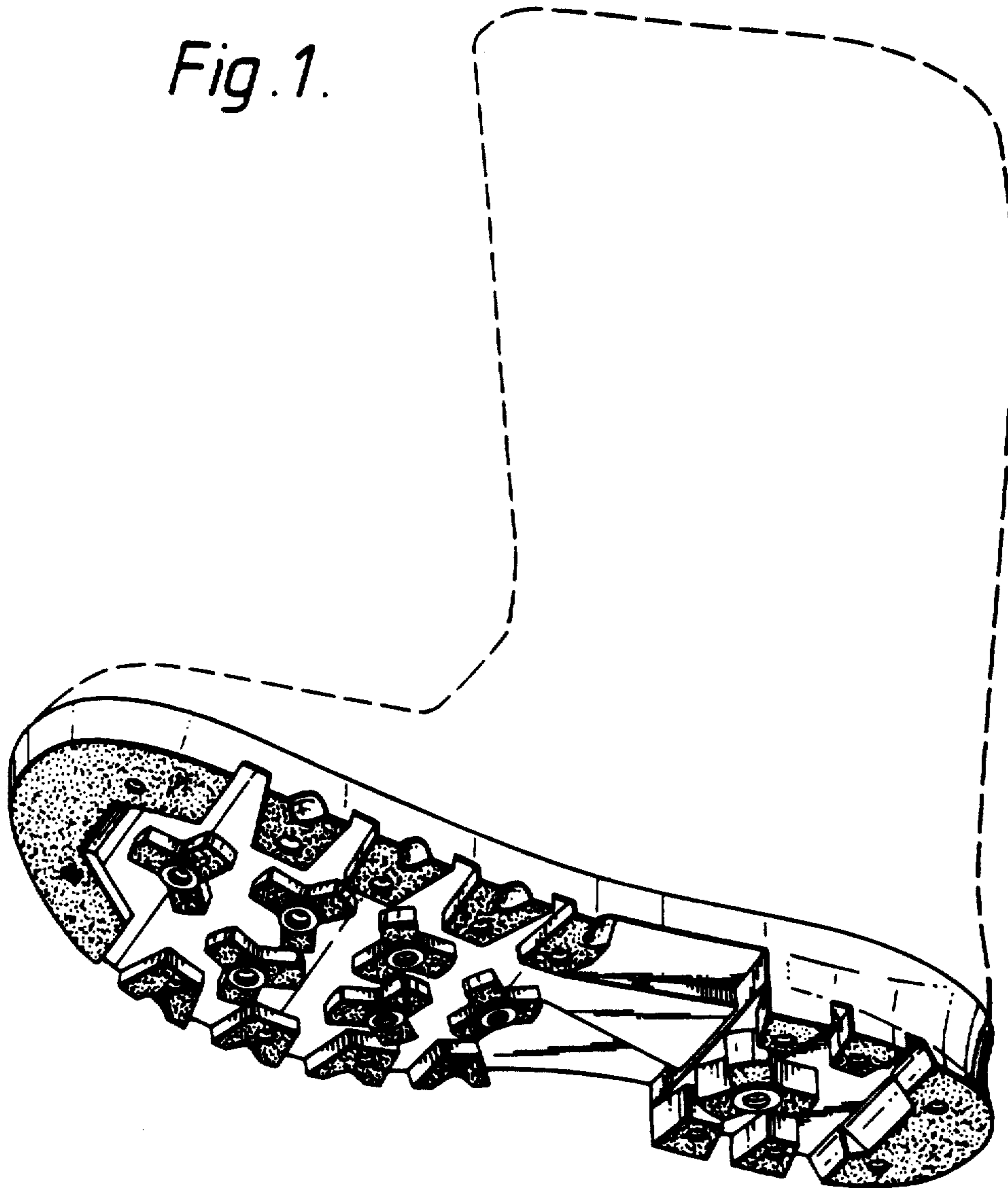

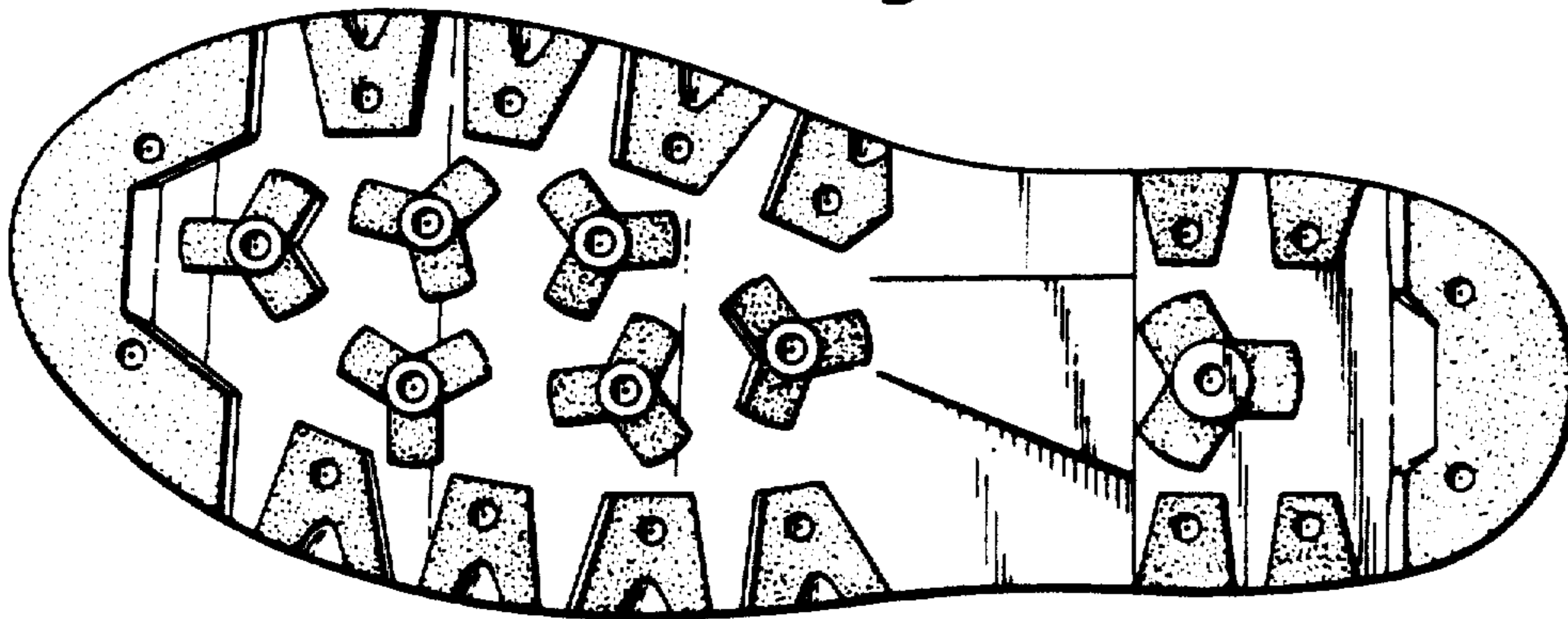
