The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

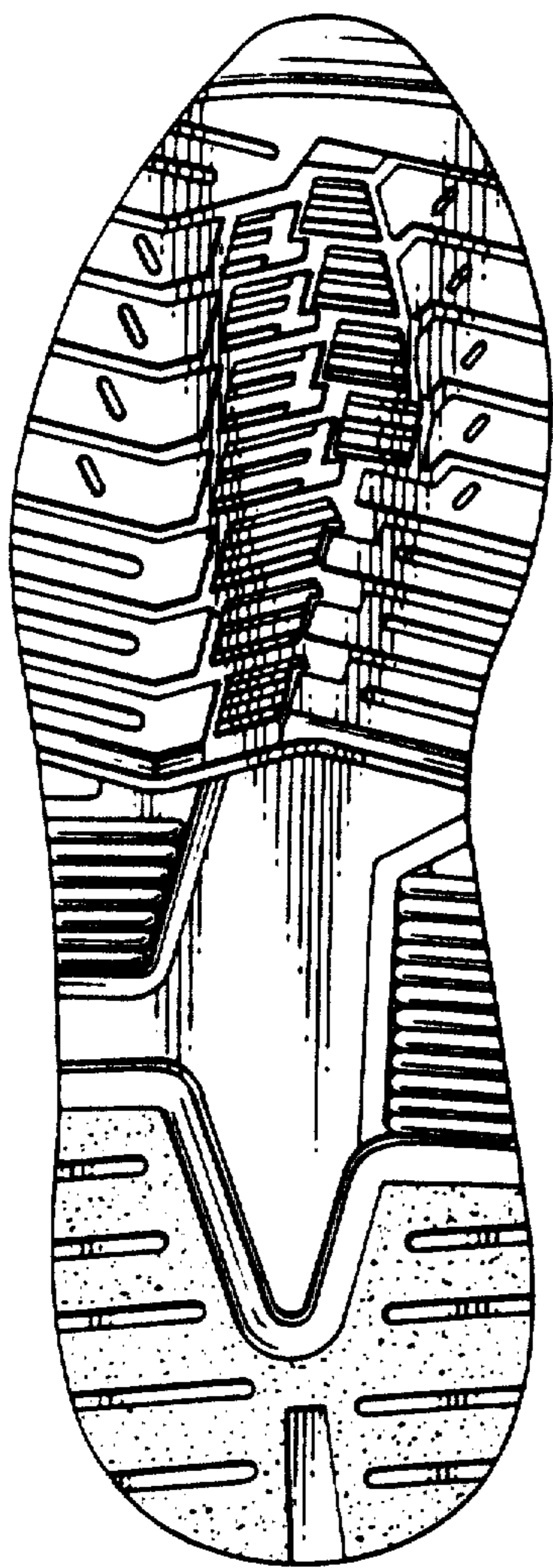


Fig. 3 Fig. 4

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe sole showing my new design in a position of use. The broken line showing of the shoe in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof.

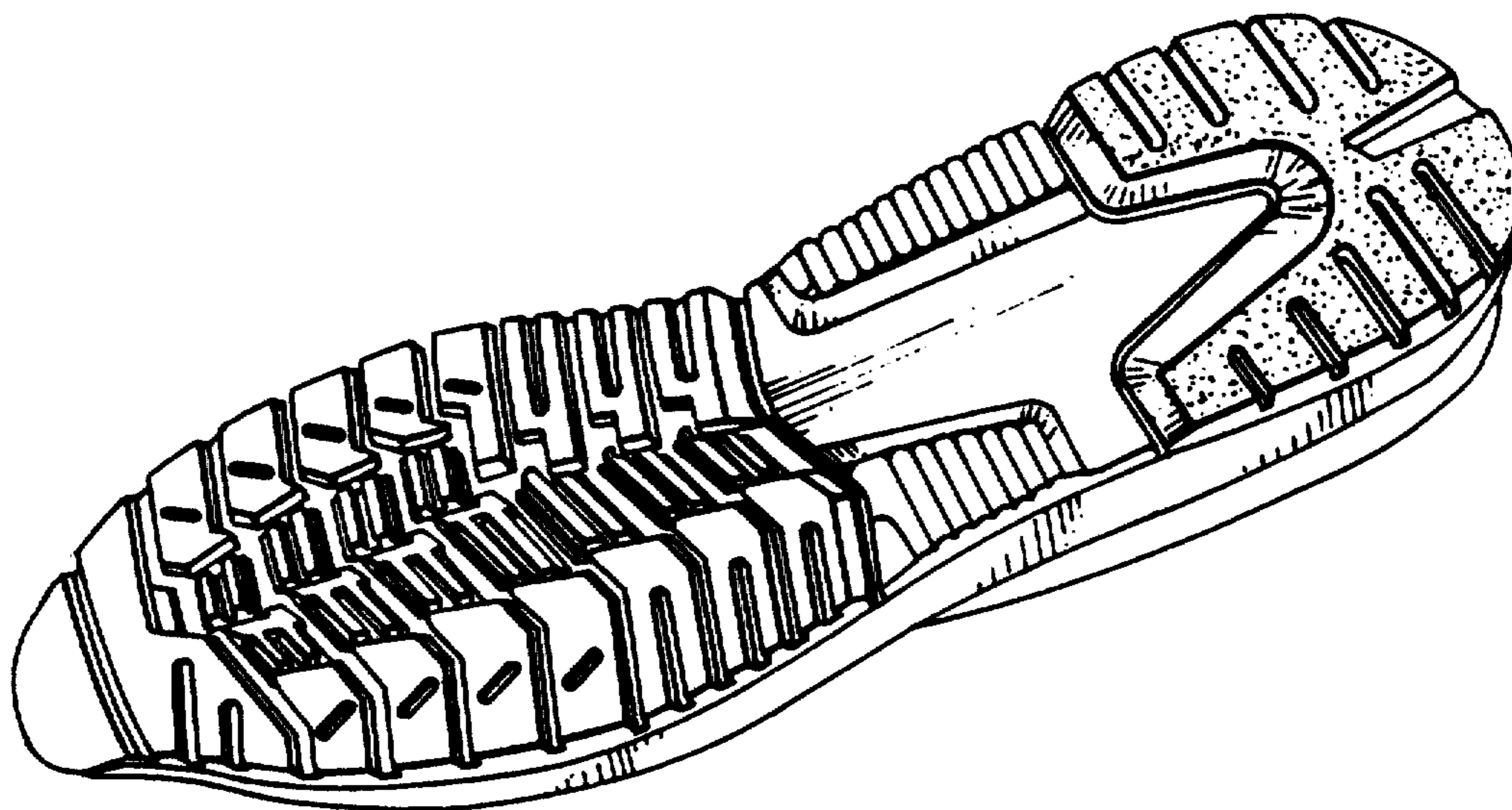

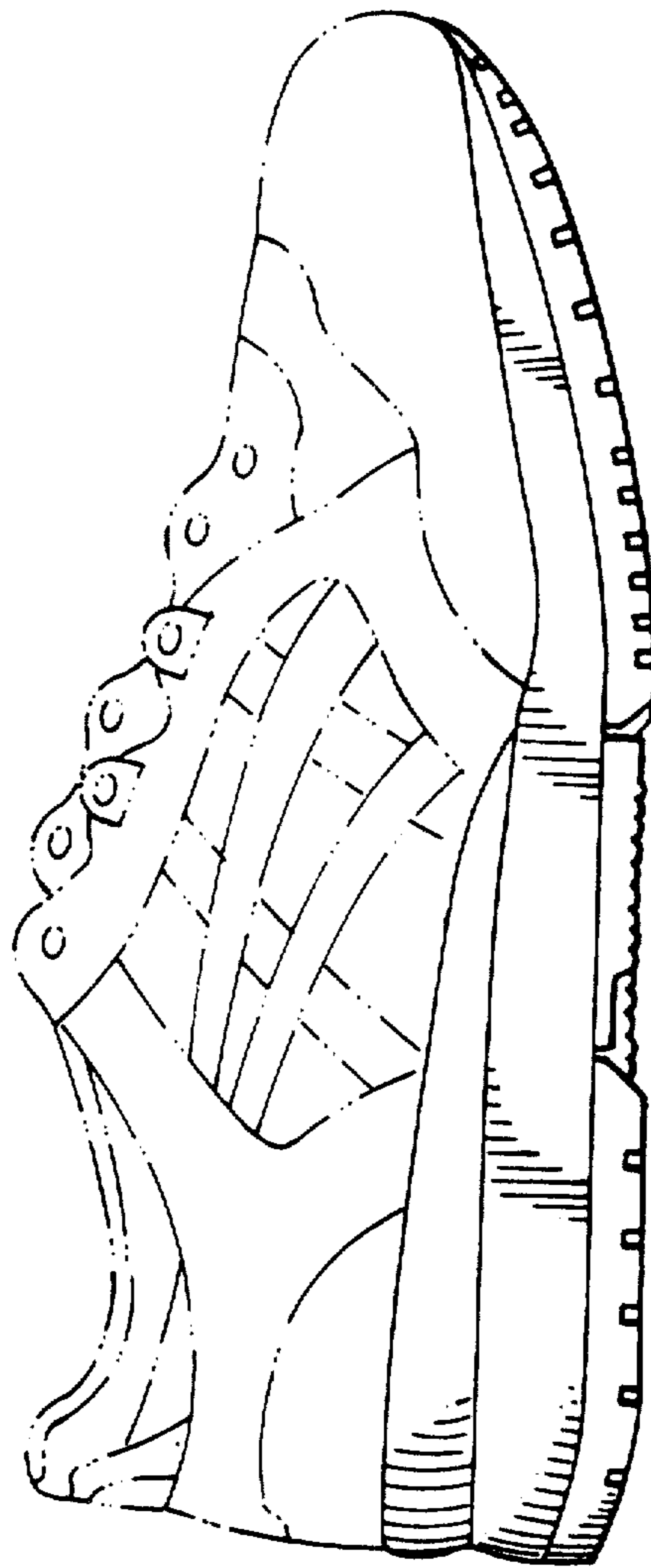

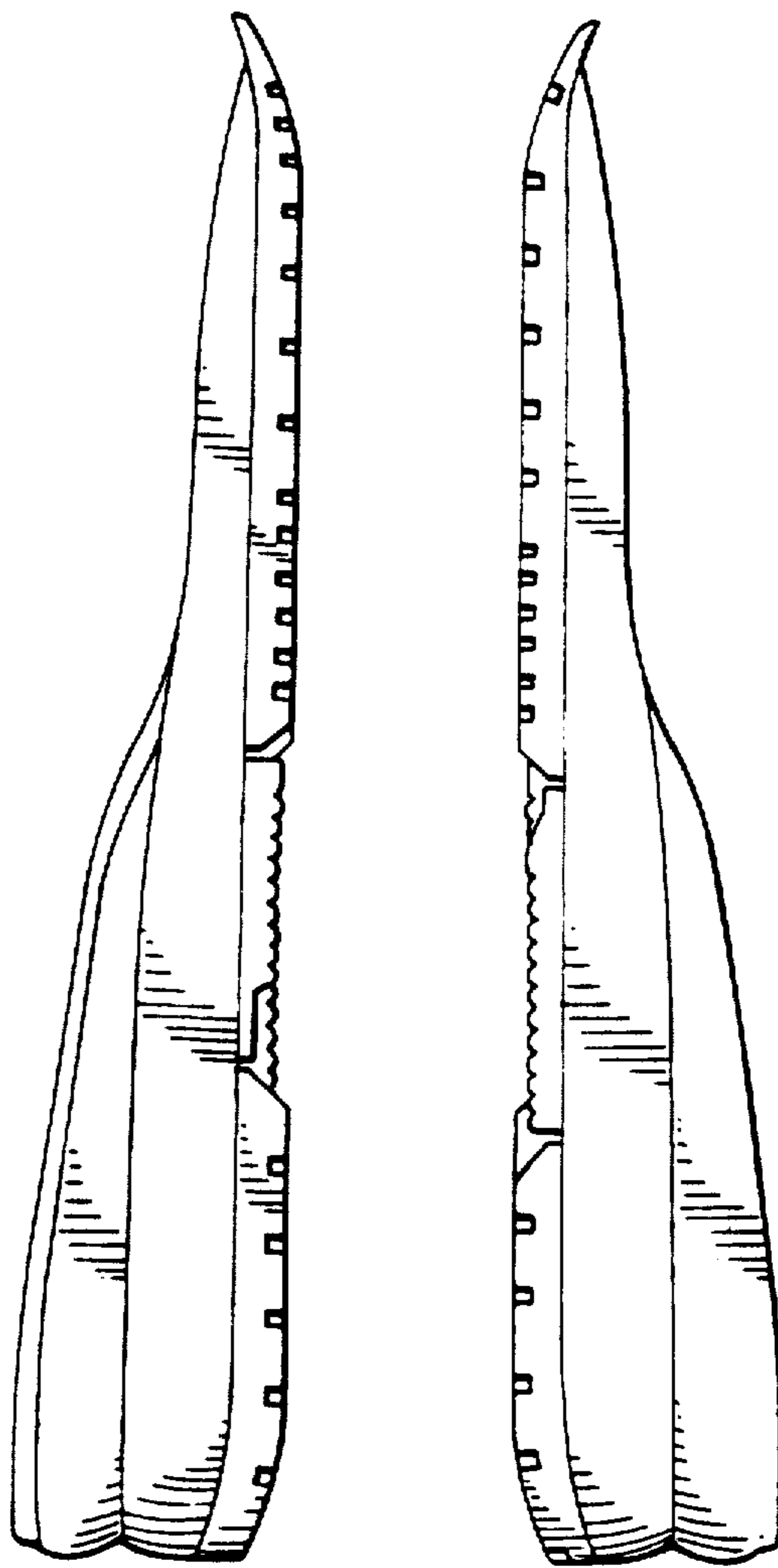

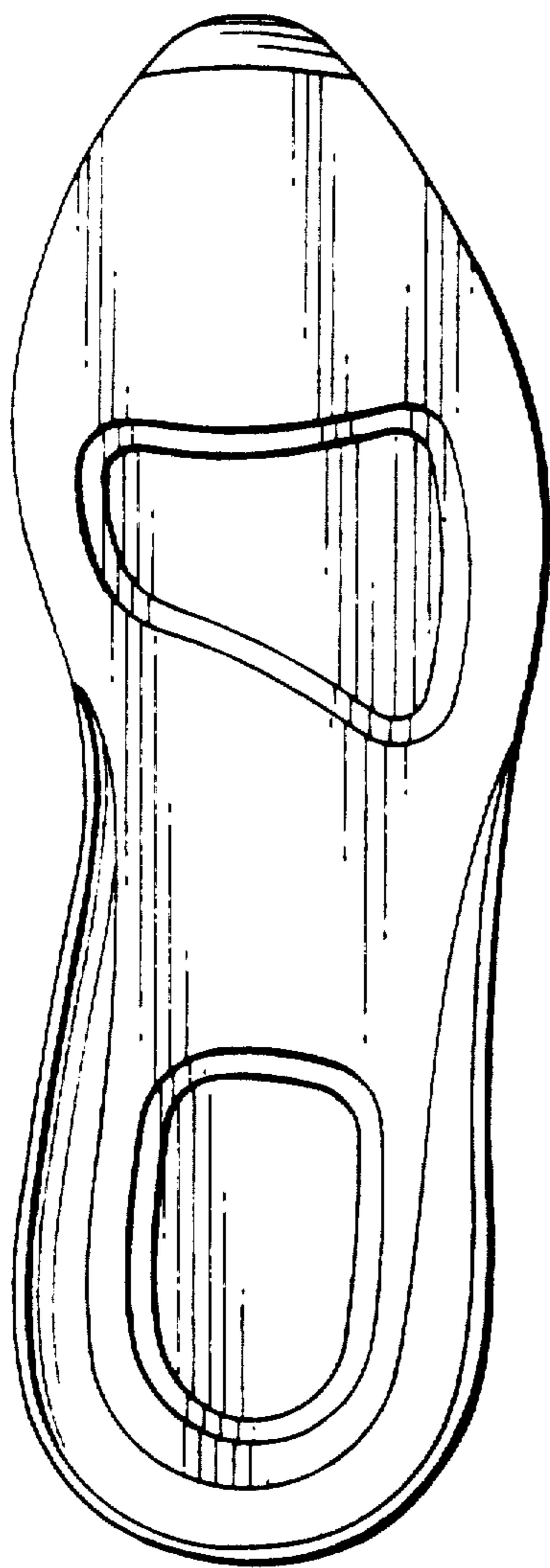

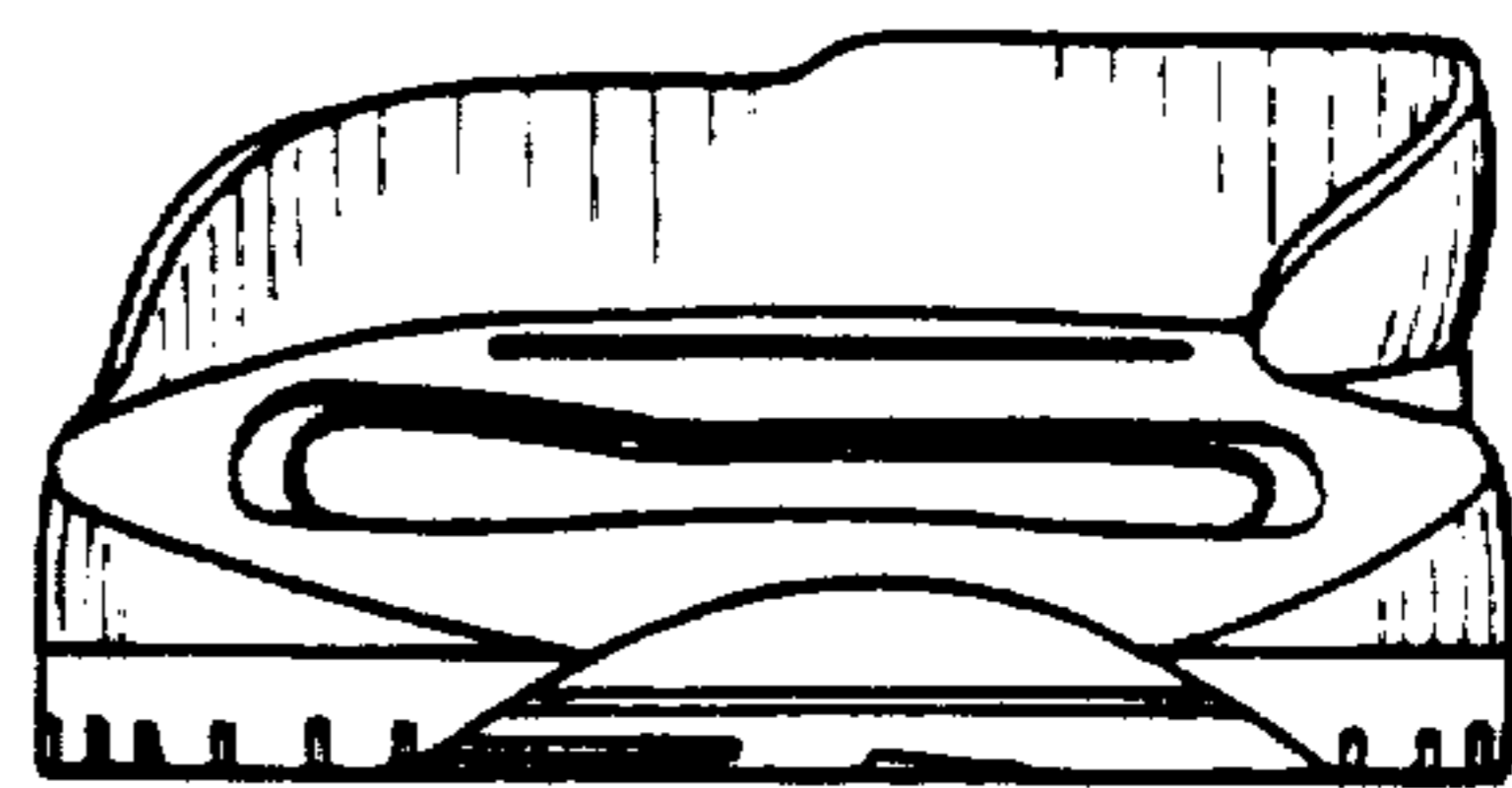

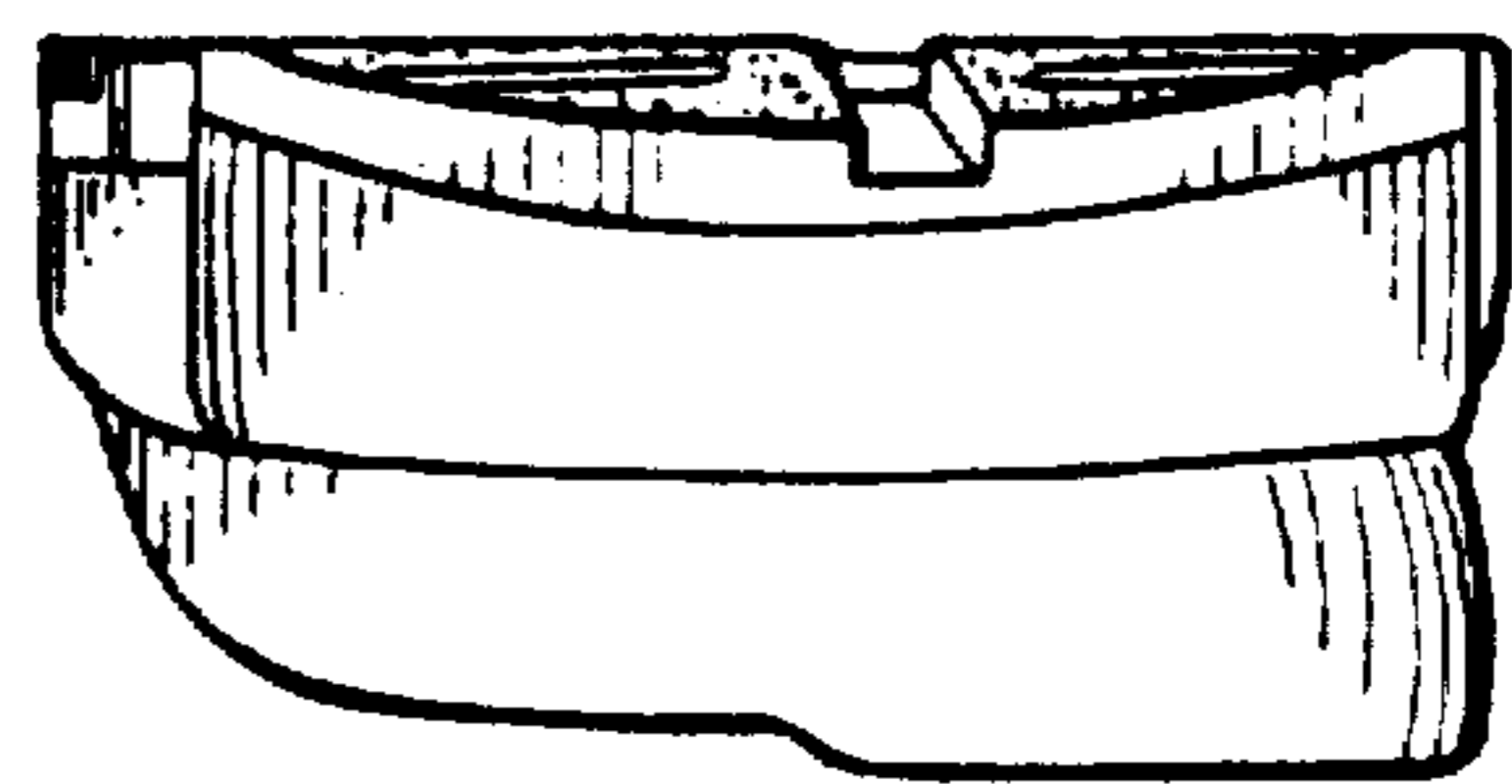
