The ornamental design for a combined can opener and rim piercer, as shown.

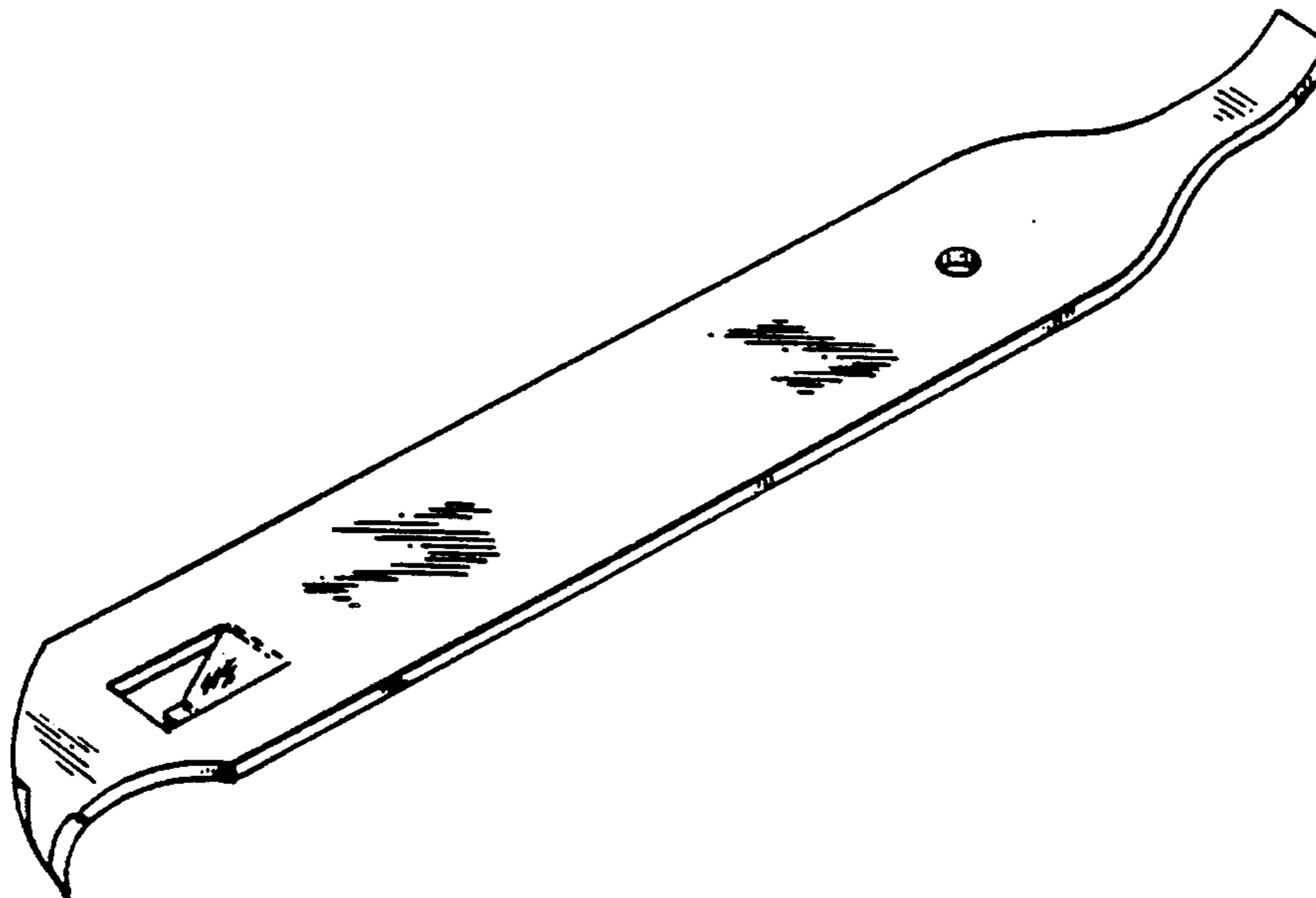
DESCRIPTION

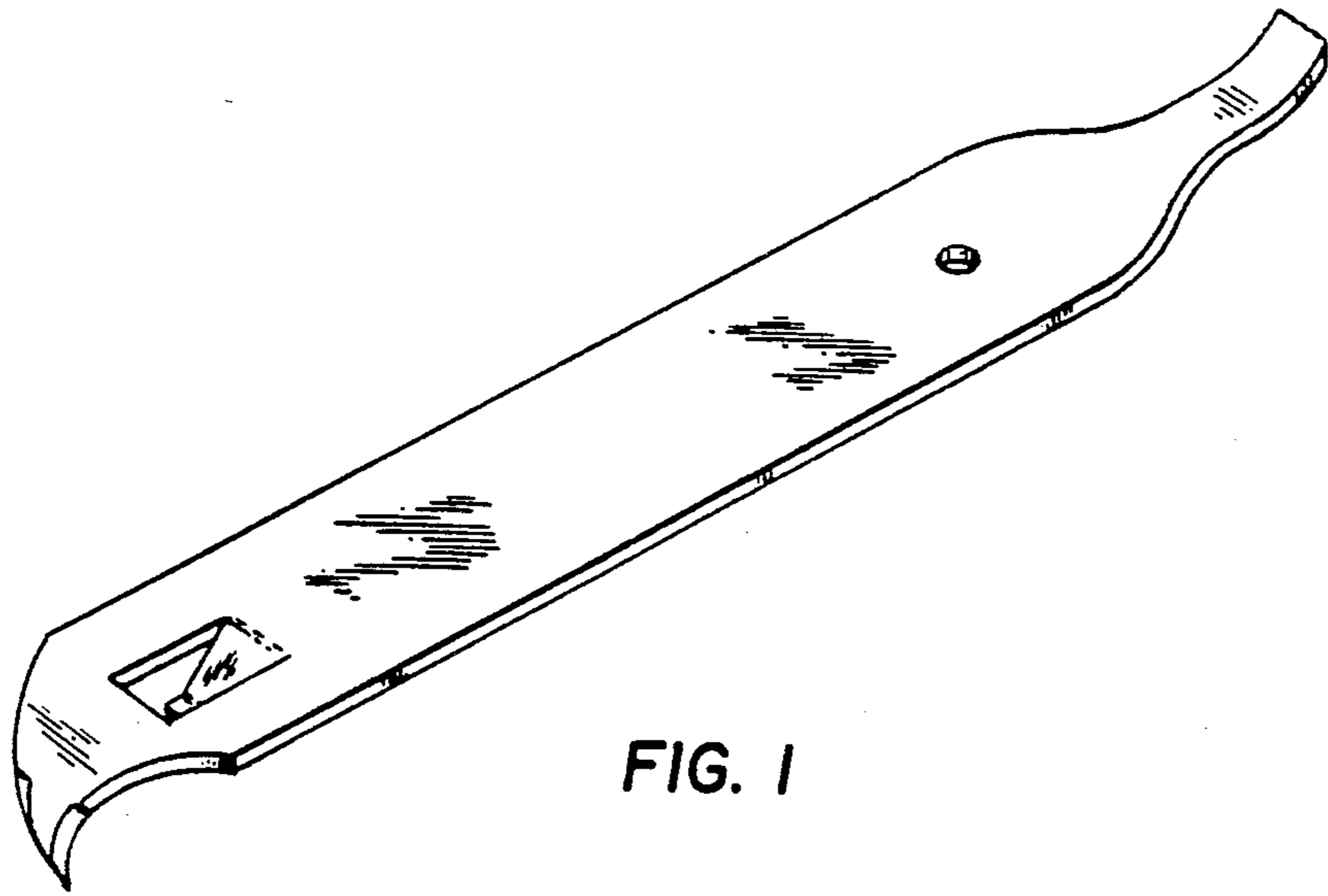

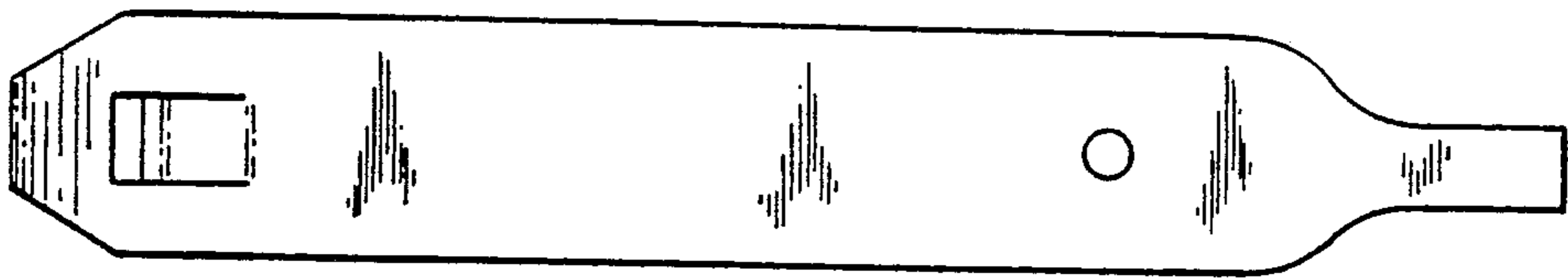

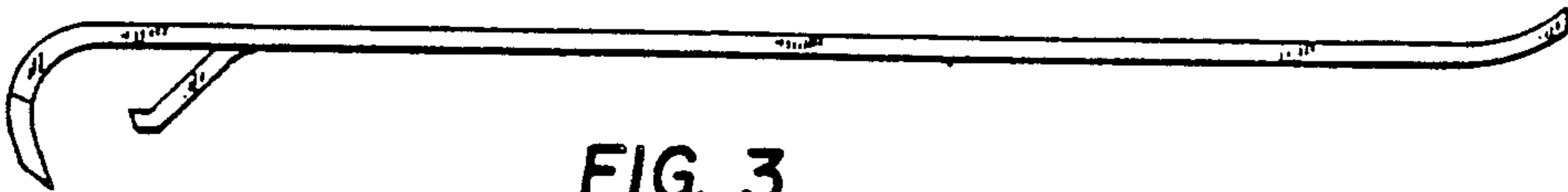

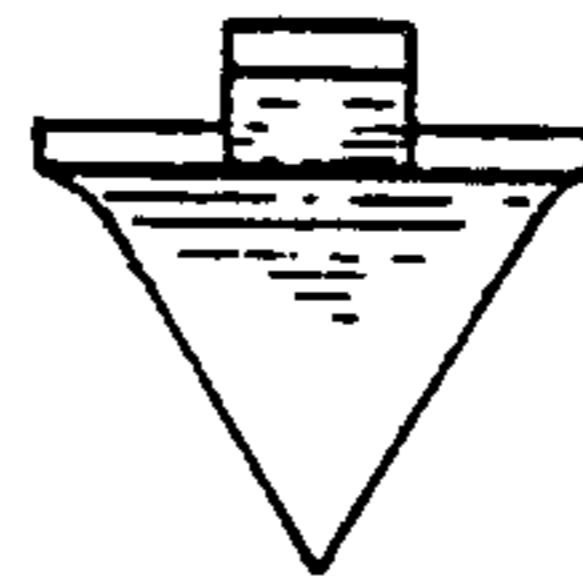

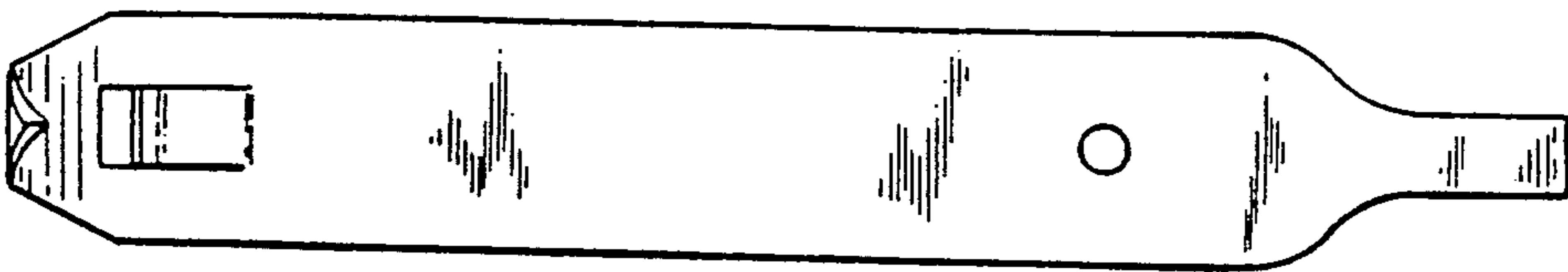
