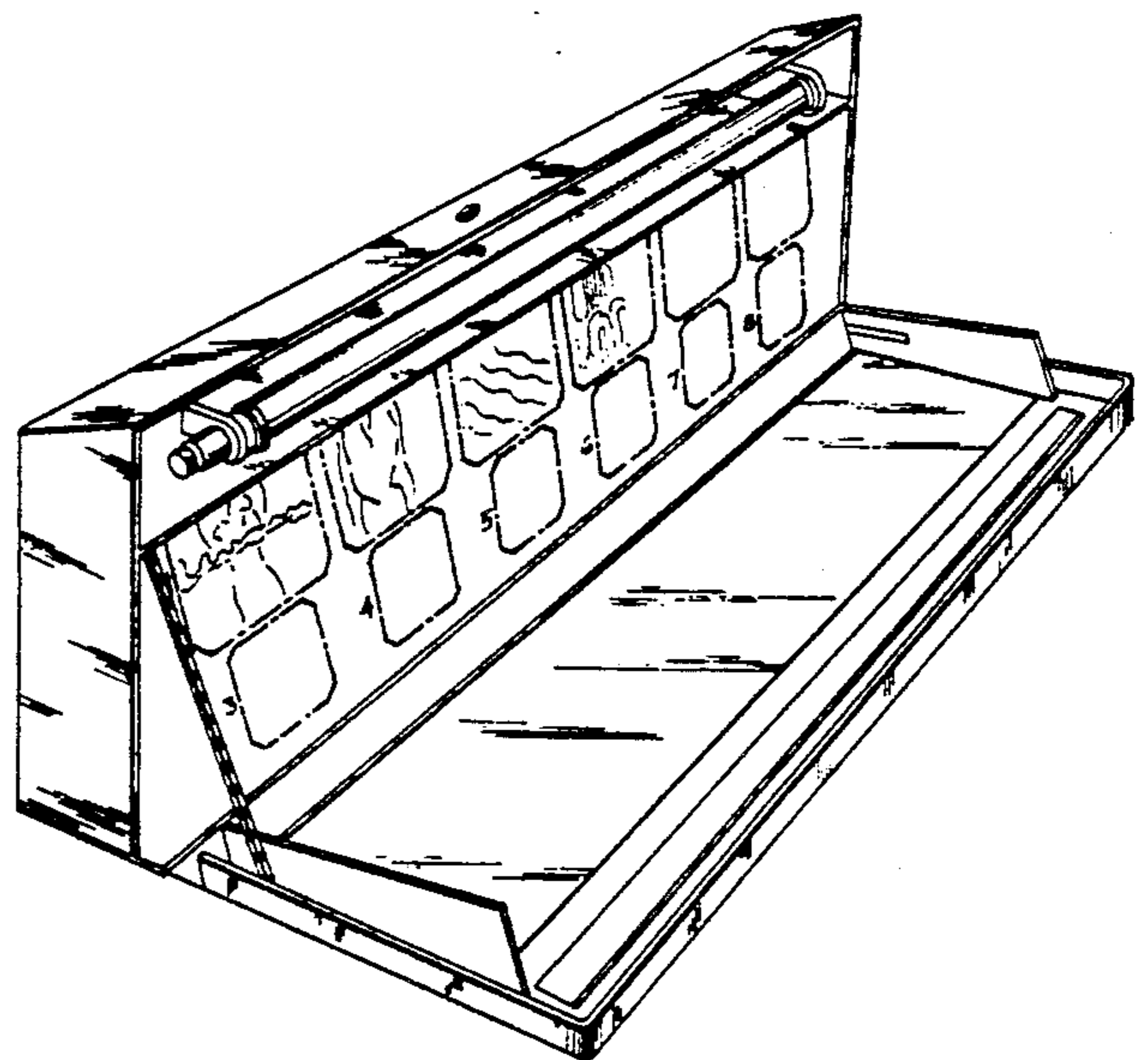
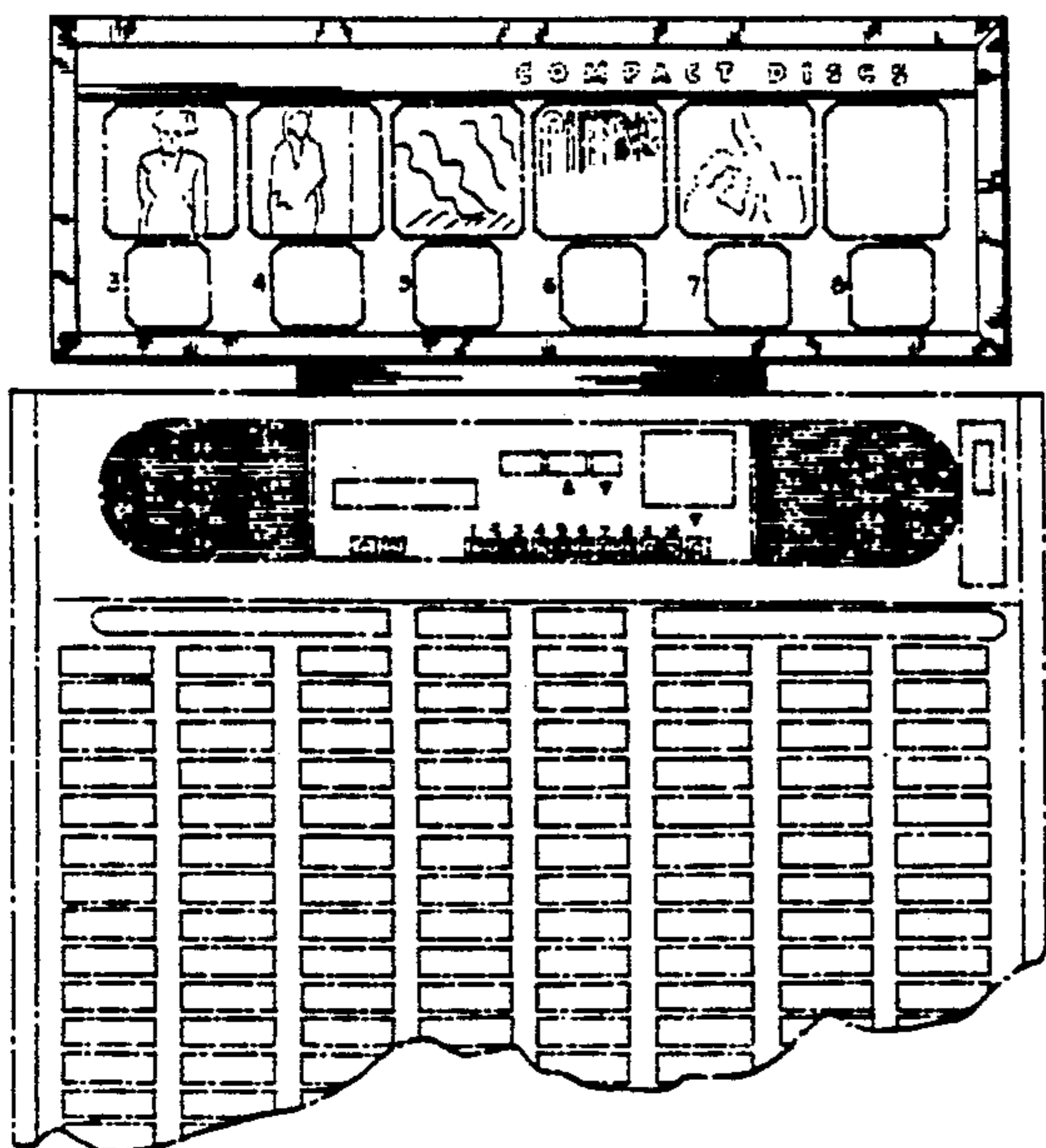

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a compact disc album cover display, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a compact disc album cover display showing our new design, with the broken line showing for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, with the album covers omitted;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof, with the cover shown in open condition;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side being a mirror image, and with the base omitted for ease of illustration;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



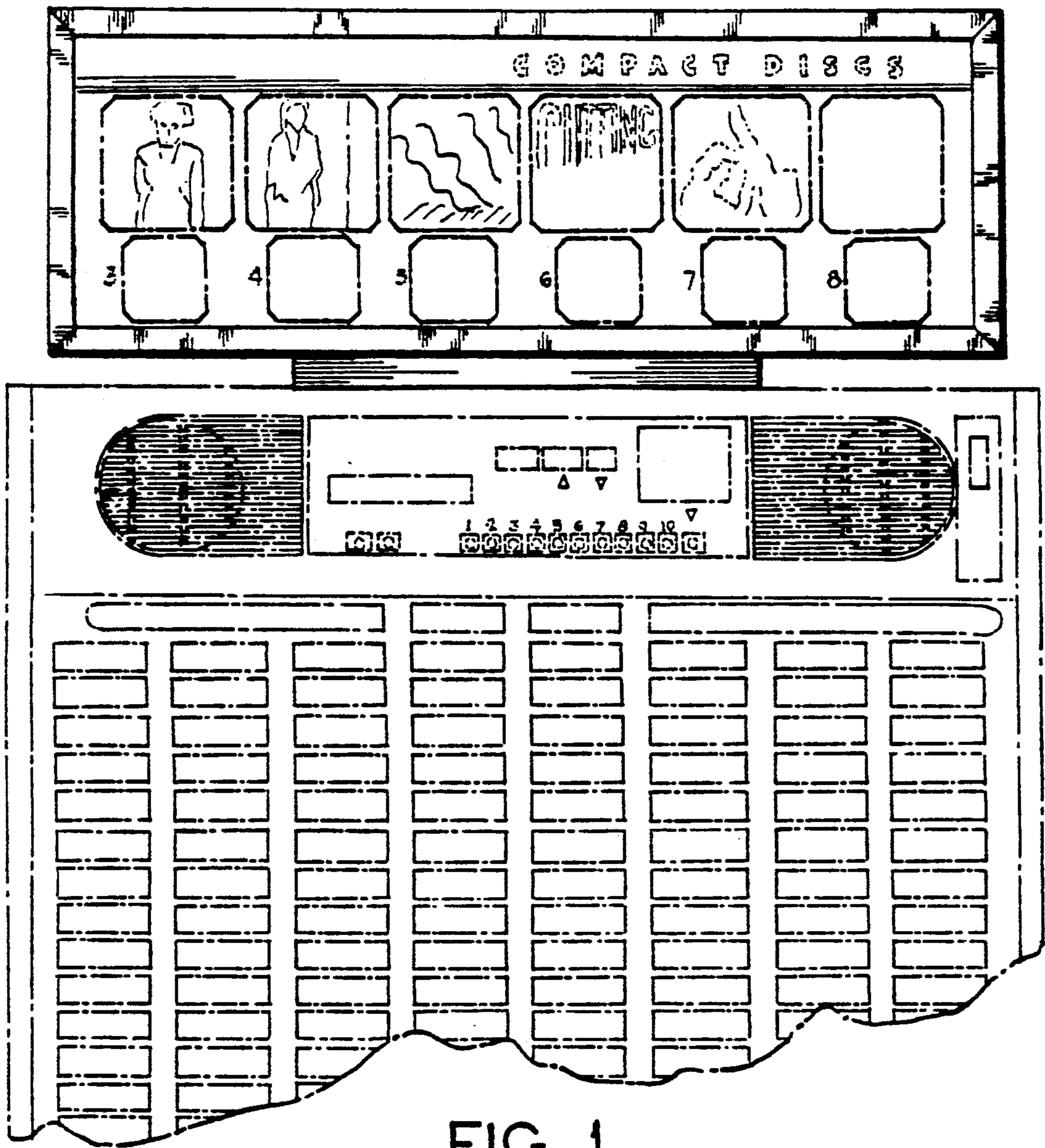

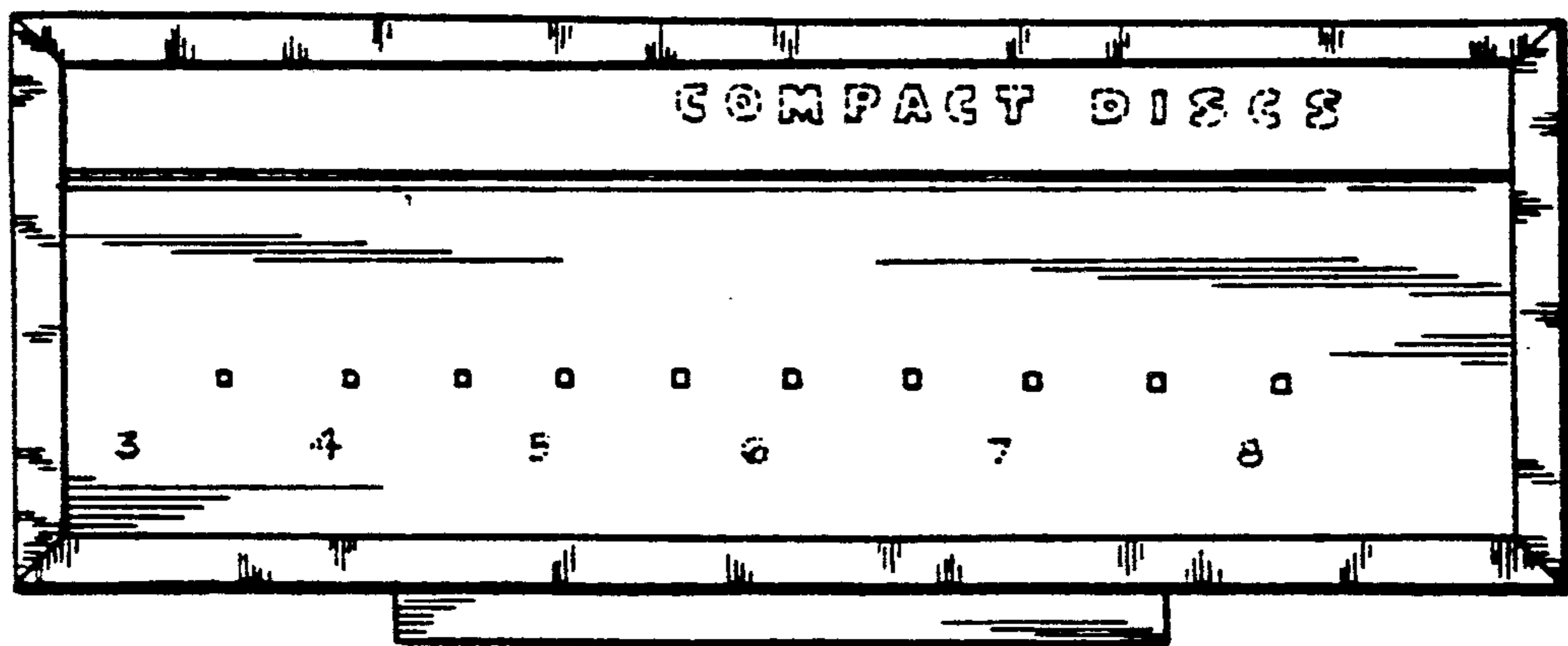

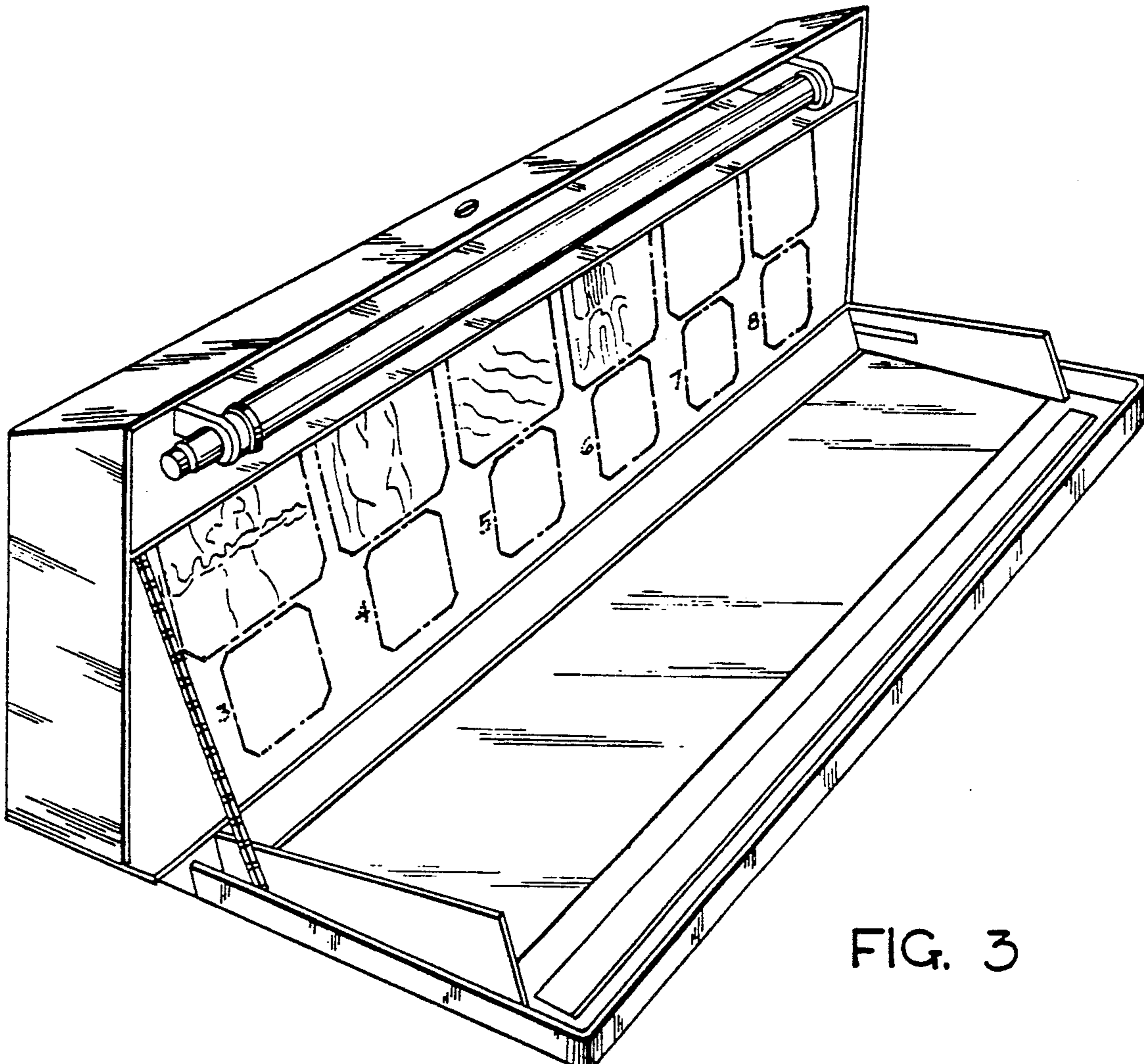

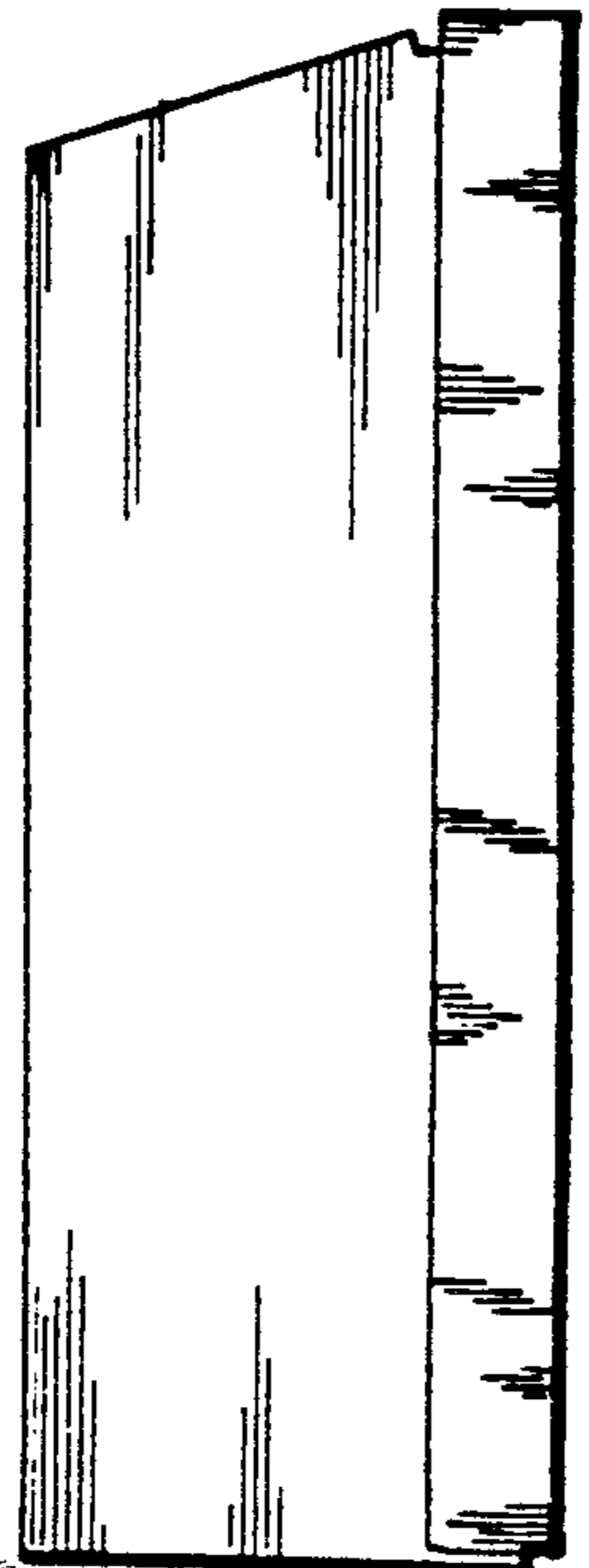

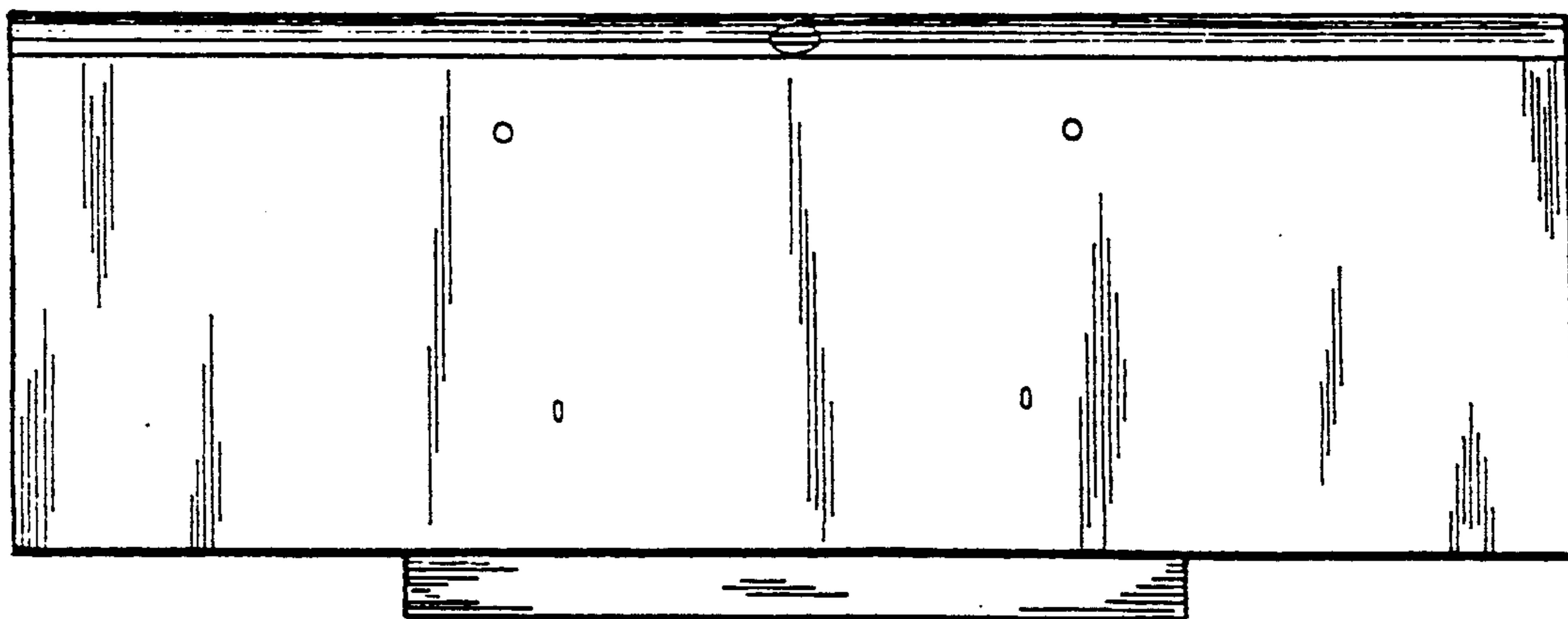

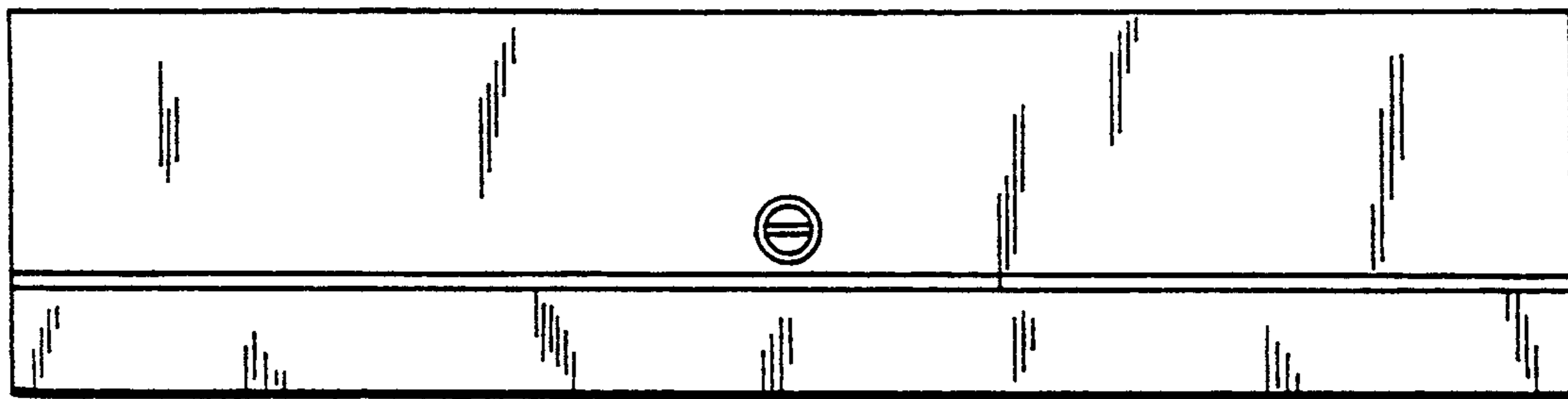
