[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a playing piece for a board game, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom perspective view of a playing piece for a board game, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a reduced left side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top, rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a further enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a further enlarged bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a reduced bottom isometric view thereof.
