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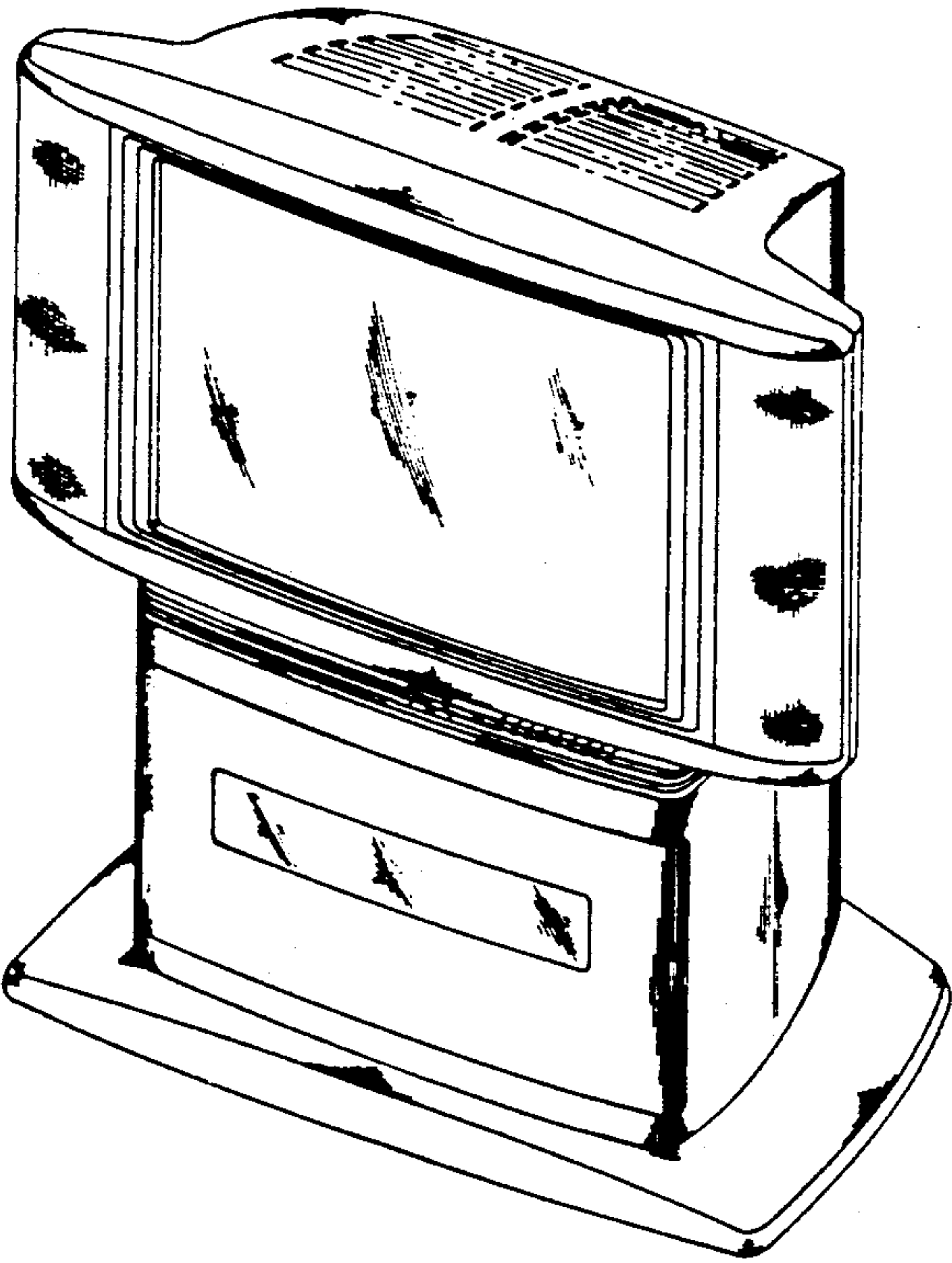
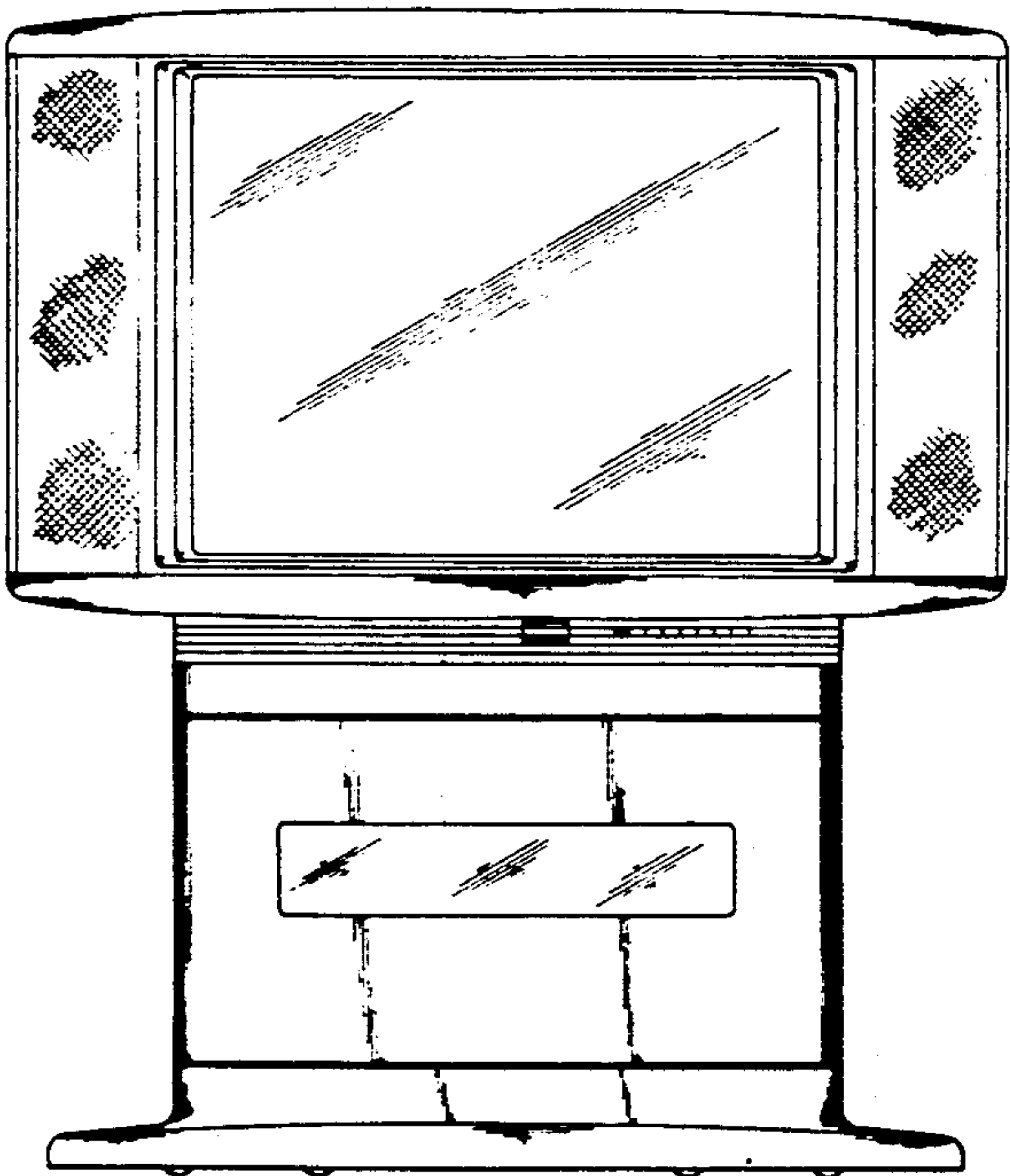

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a television receiver showing our new design;
- FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
- FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
- FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
- FIG. 5 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof; and
- FIG. 6 is a top, rear and right side perspective view thereof.
- The bottom being plane and unornamented.



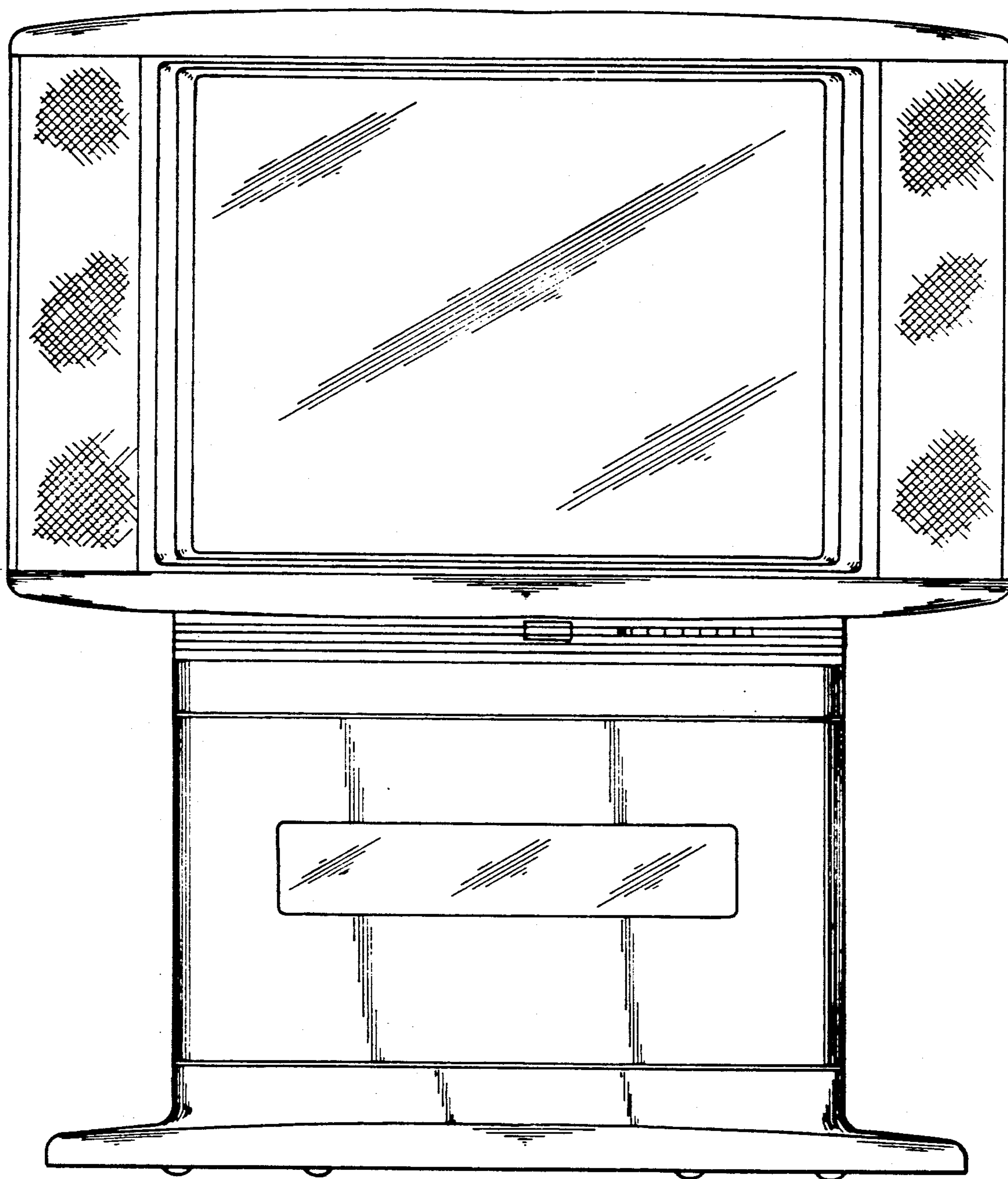

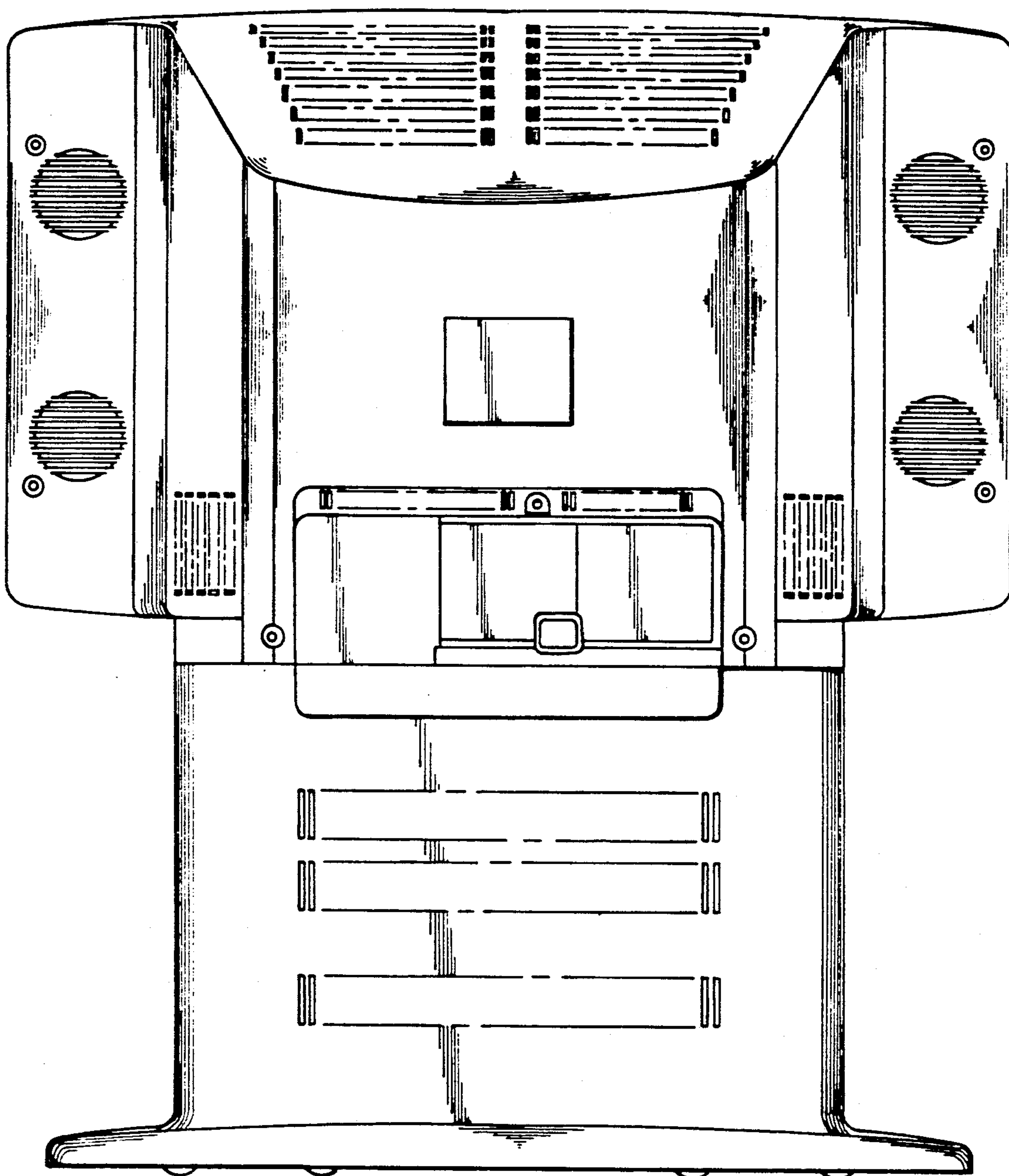

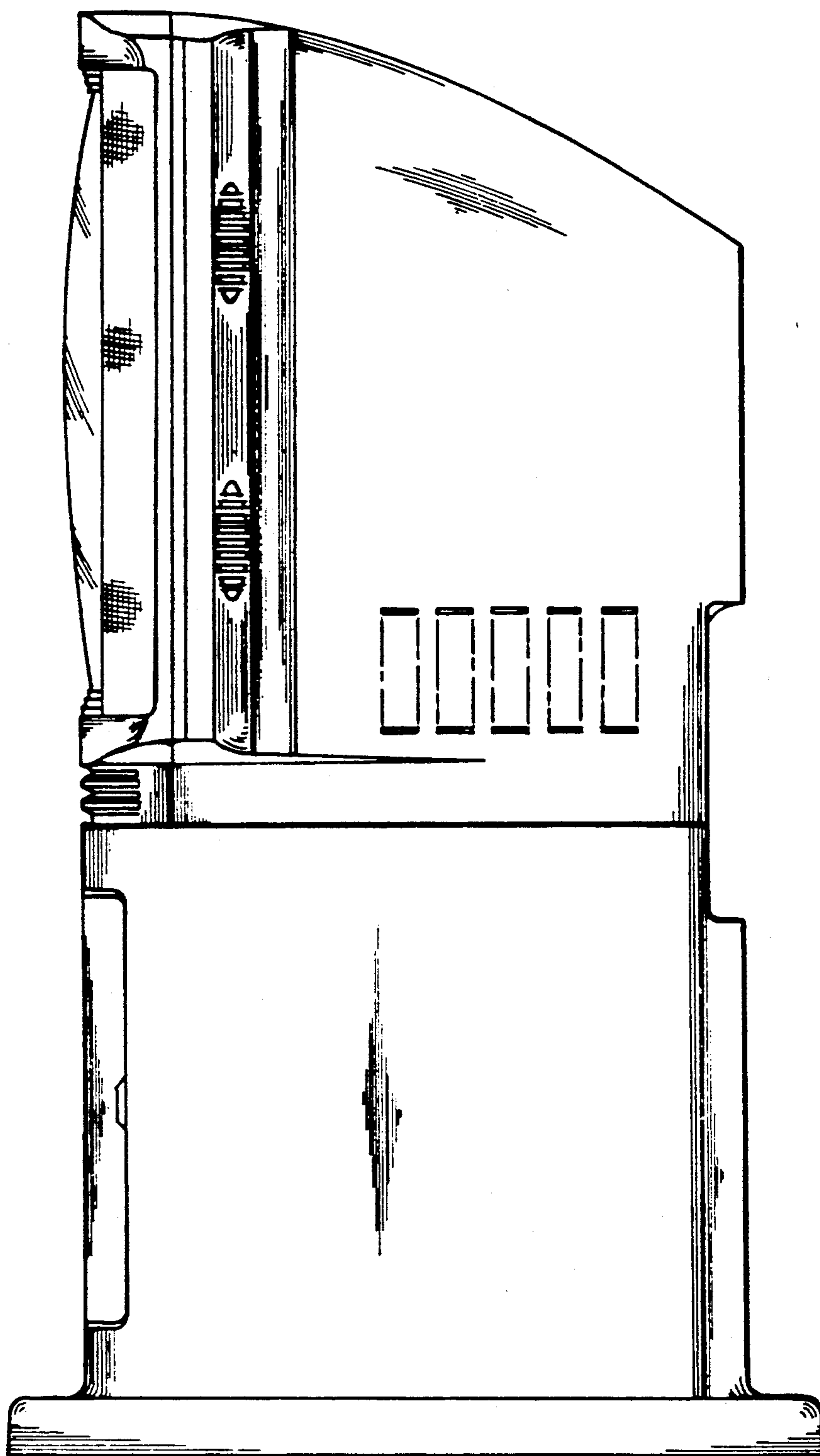

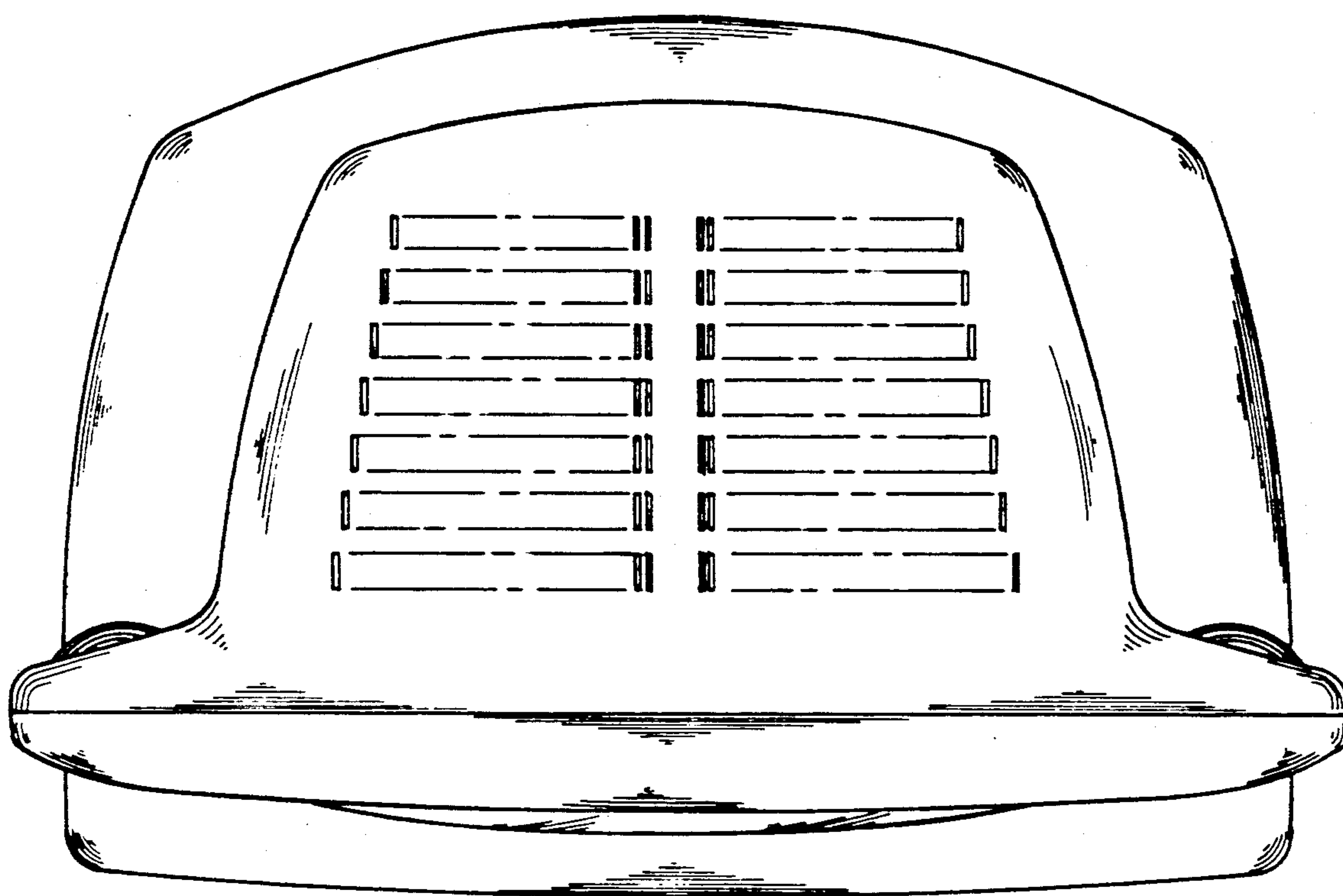

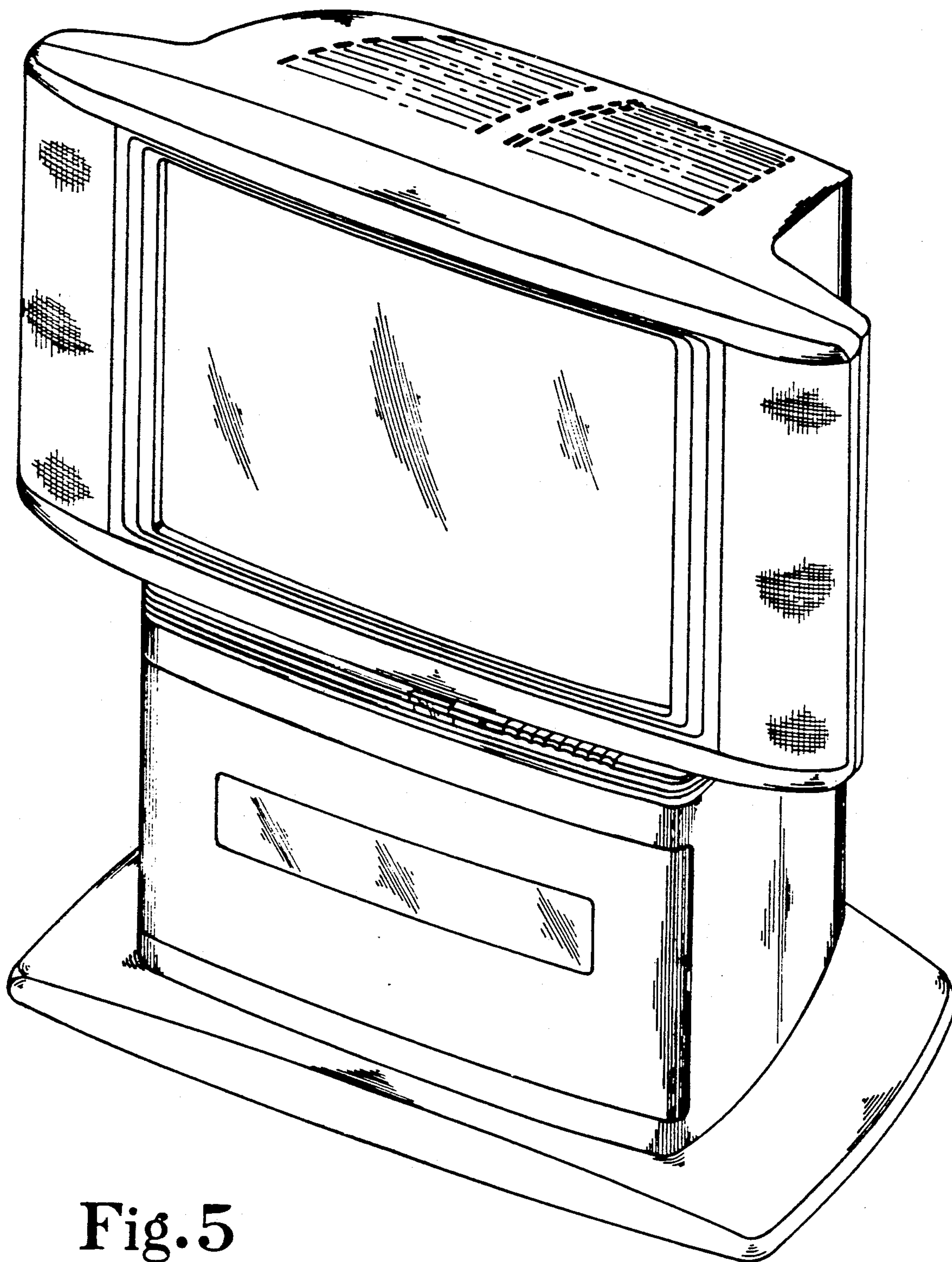

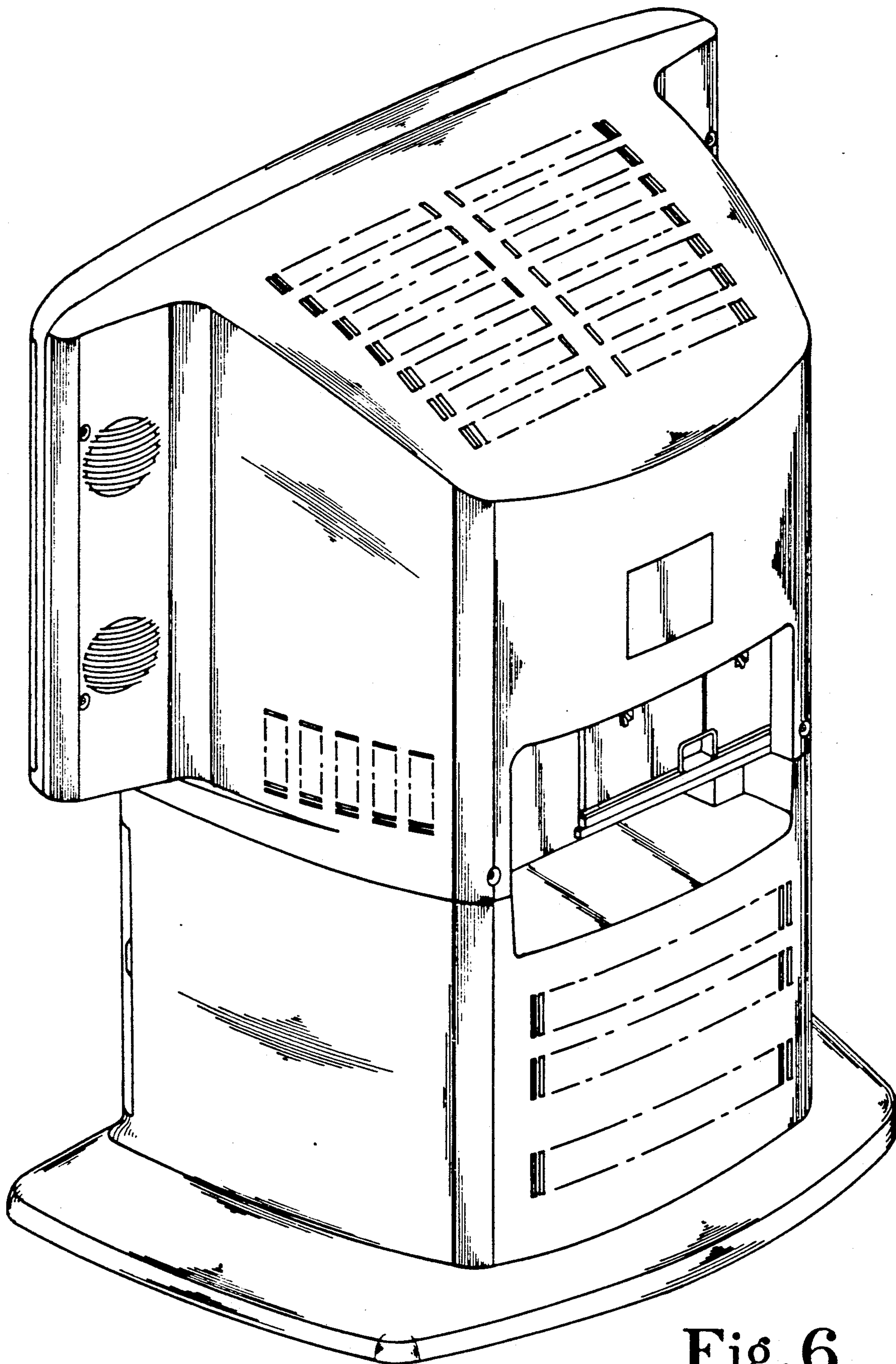
