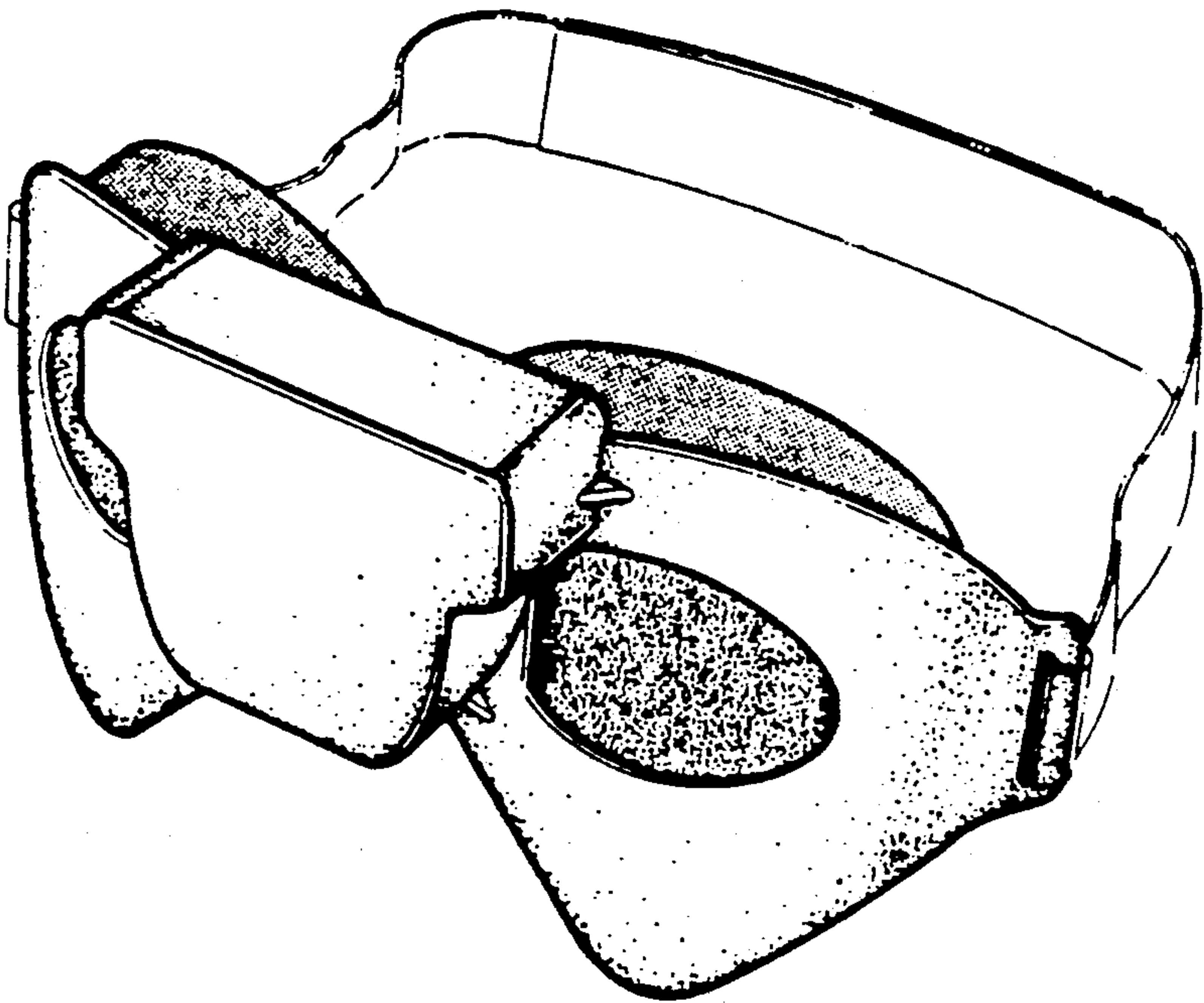

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof.



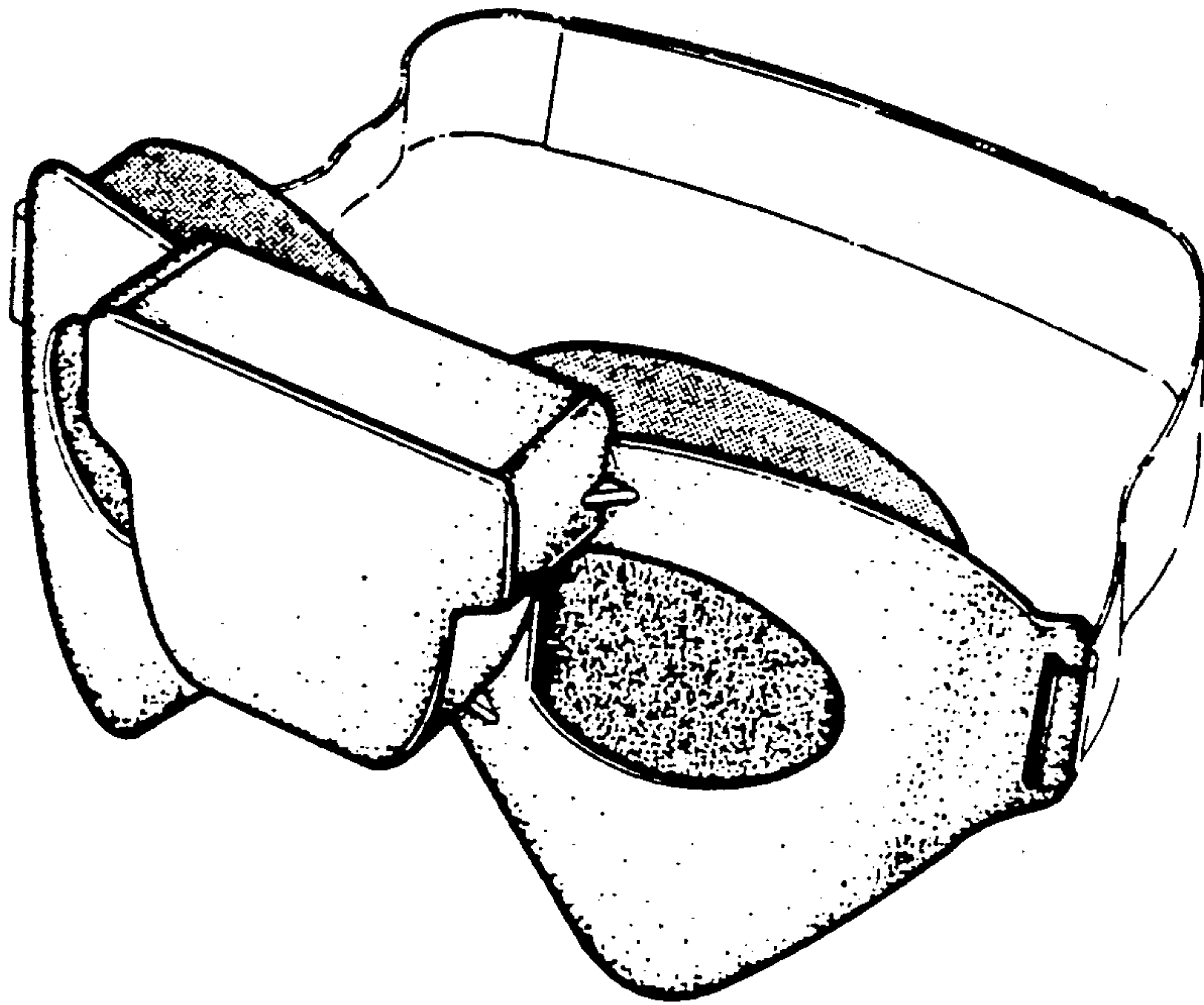

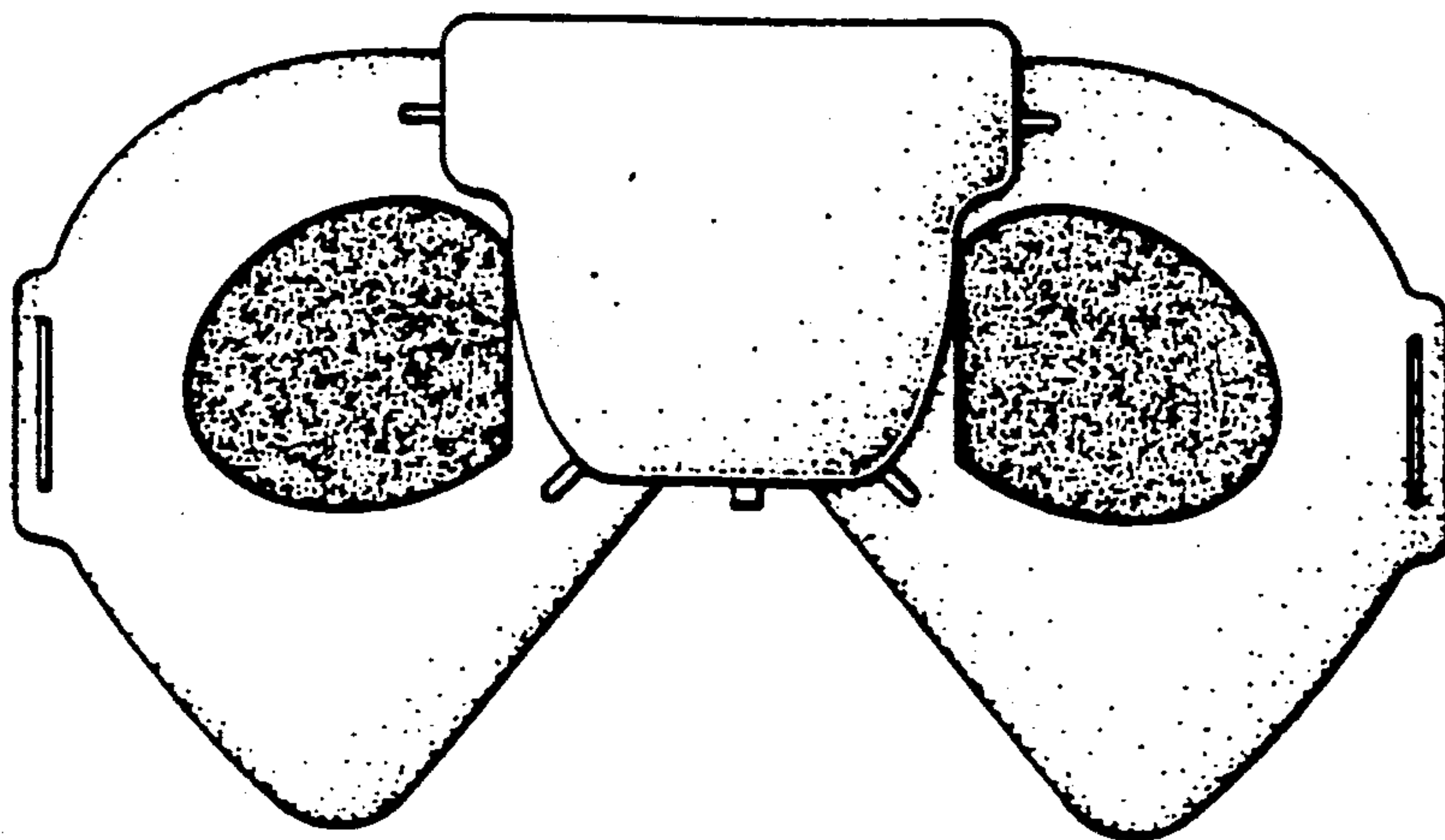

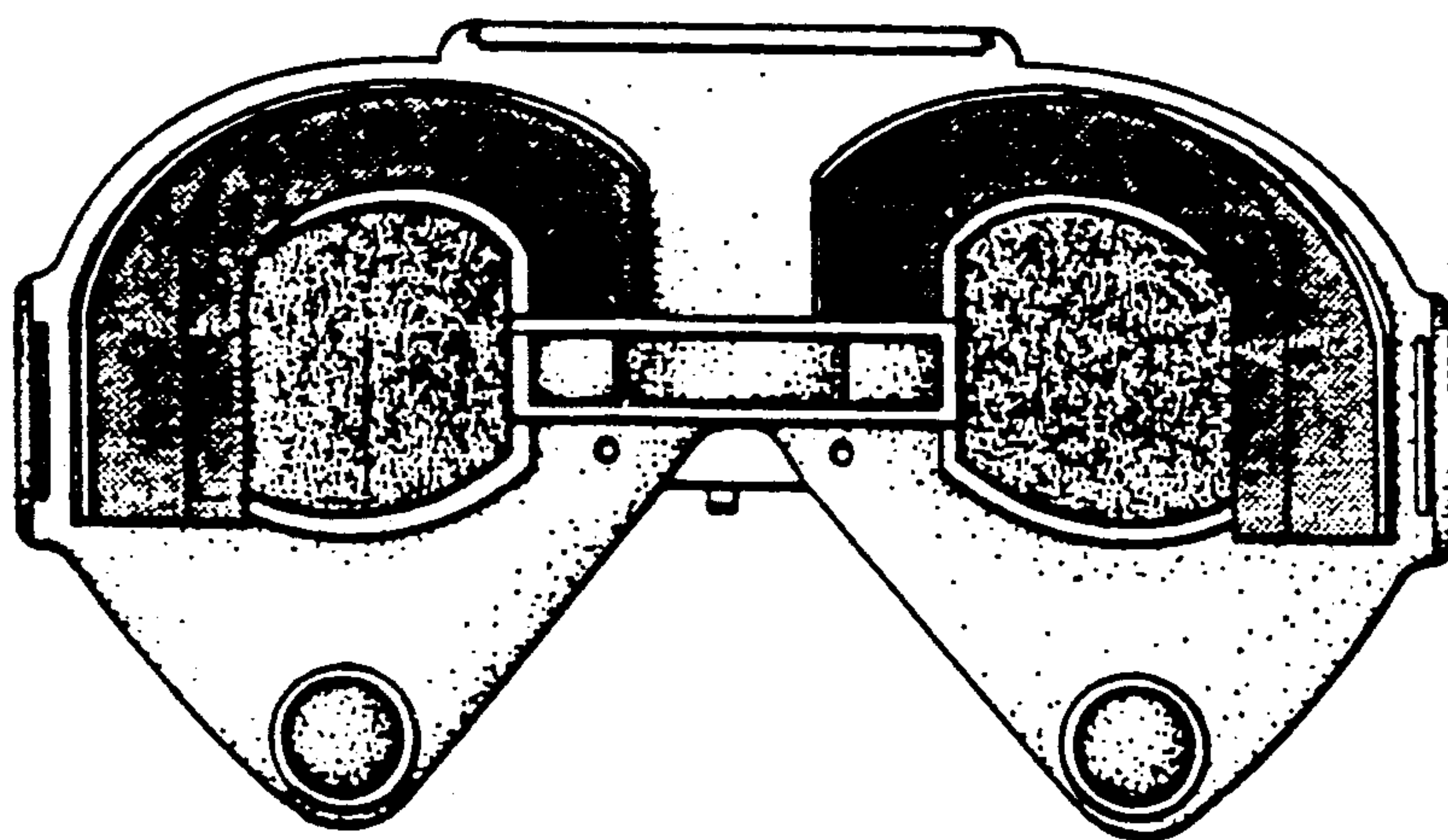

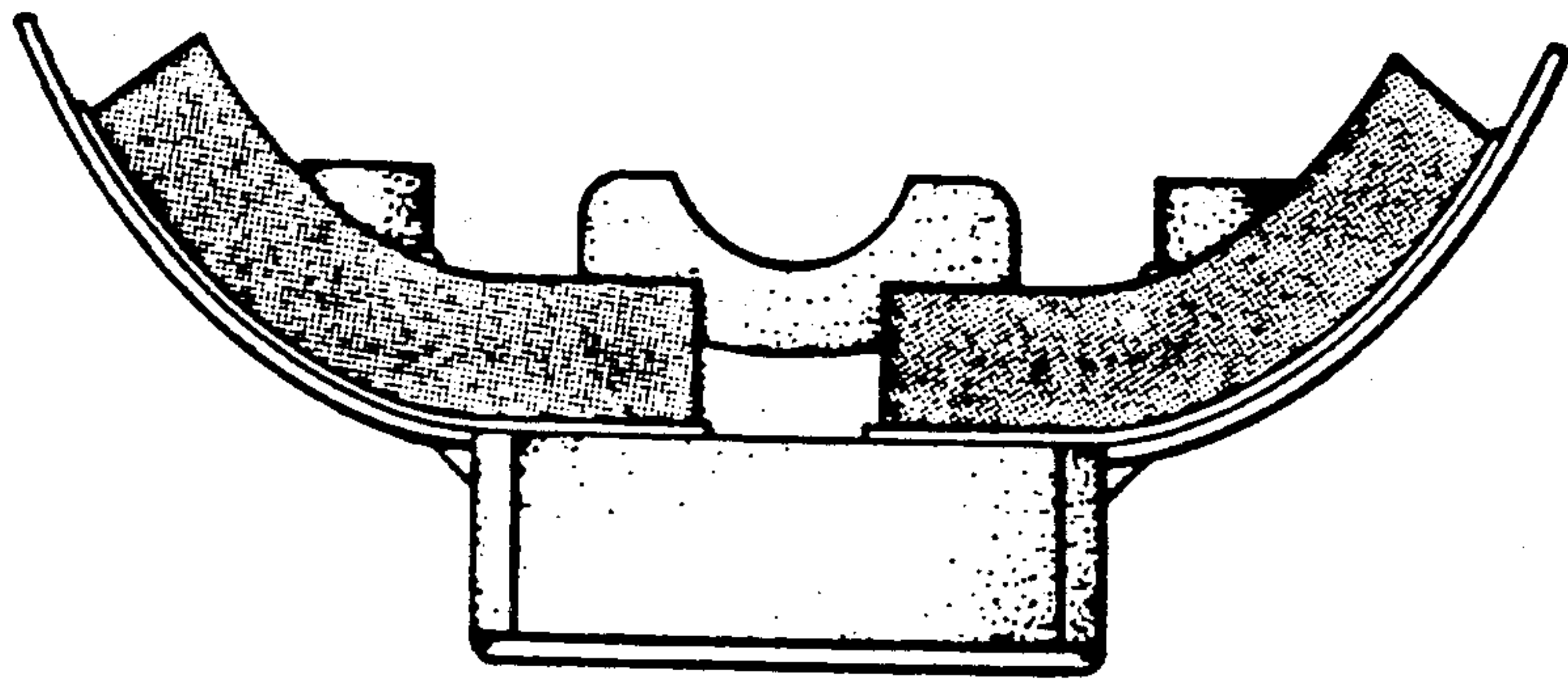

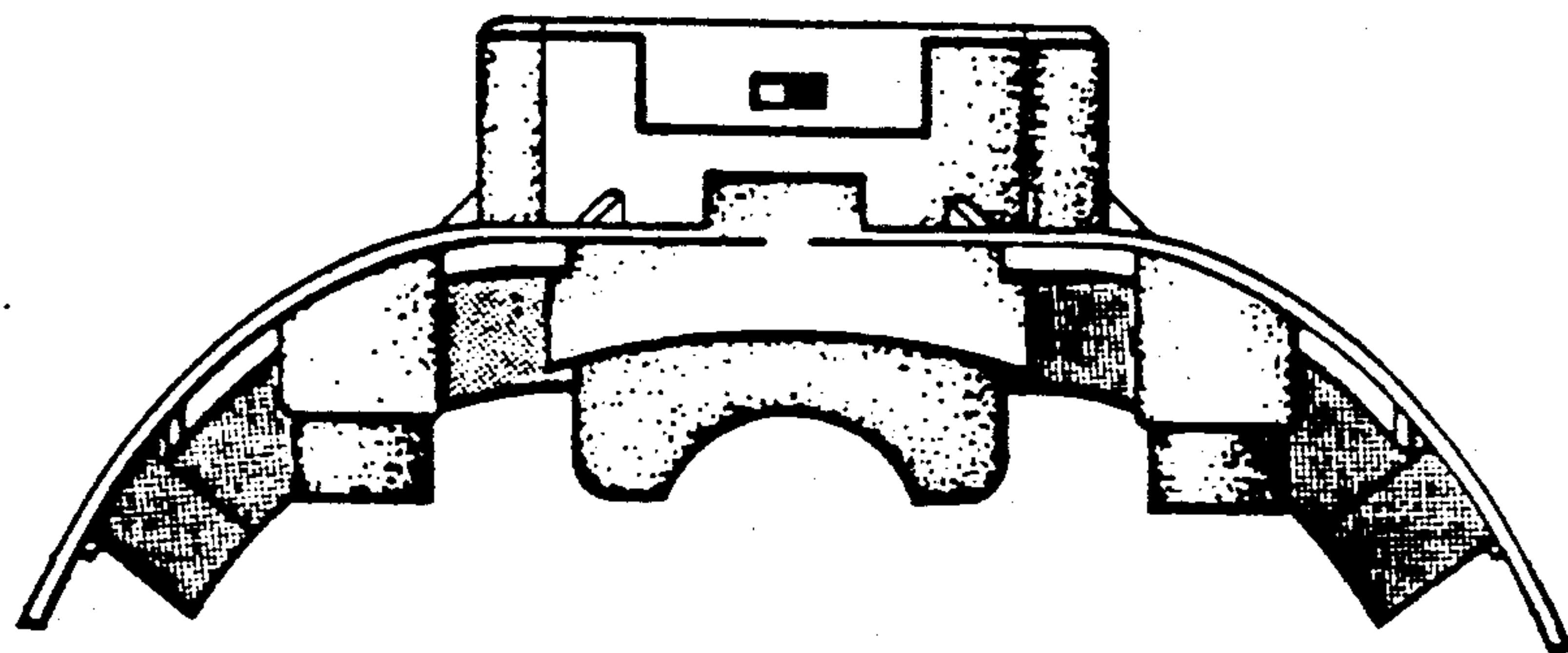

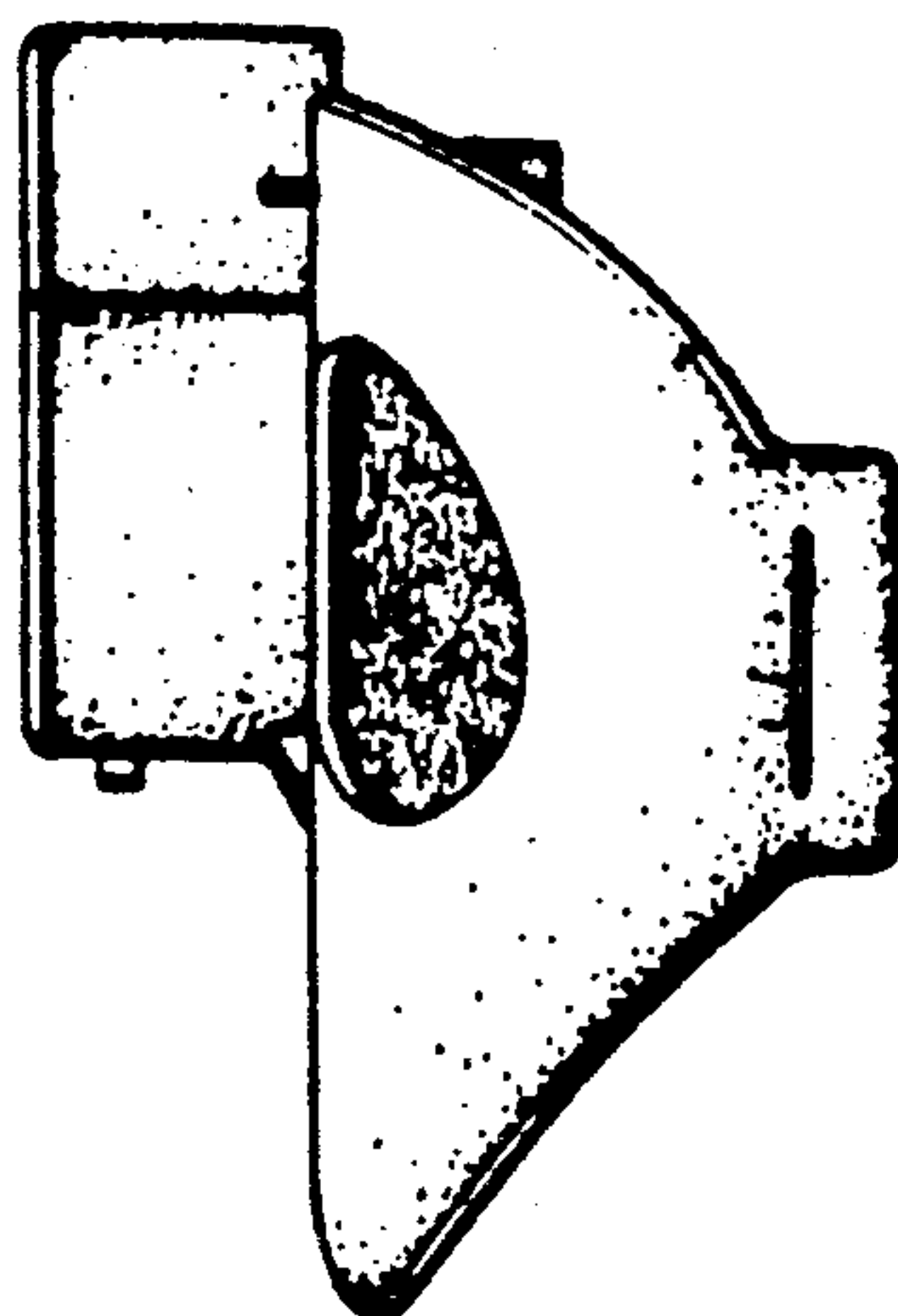
