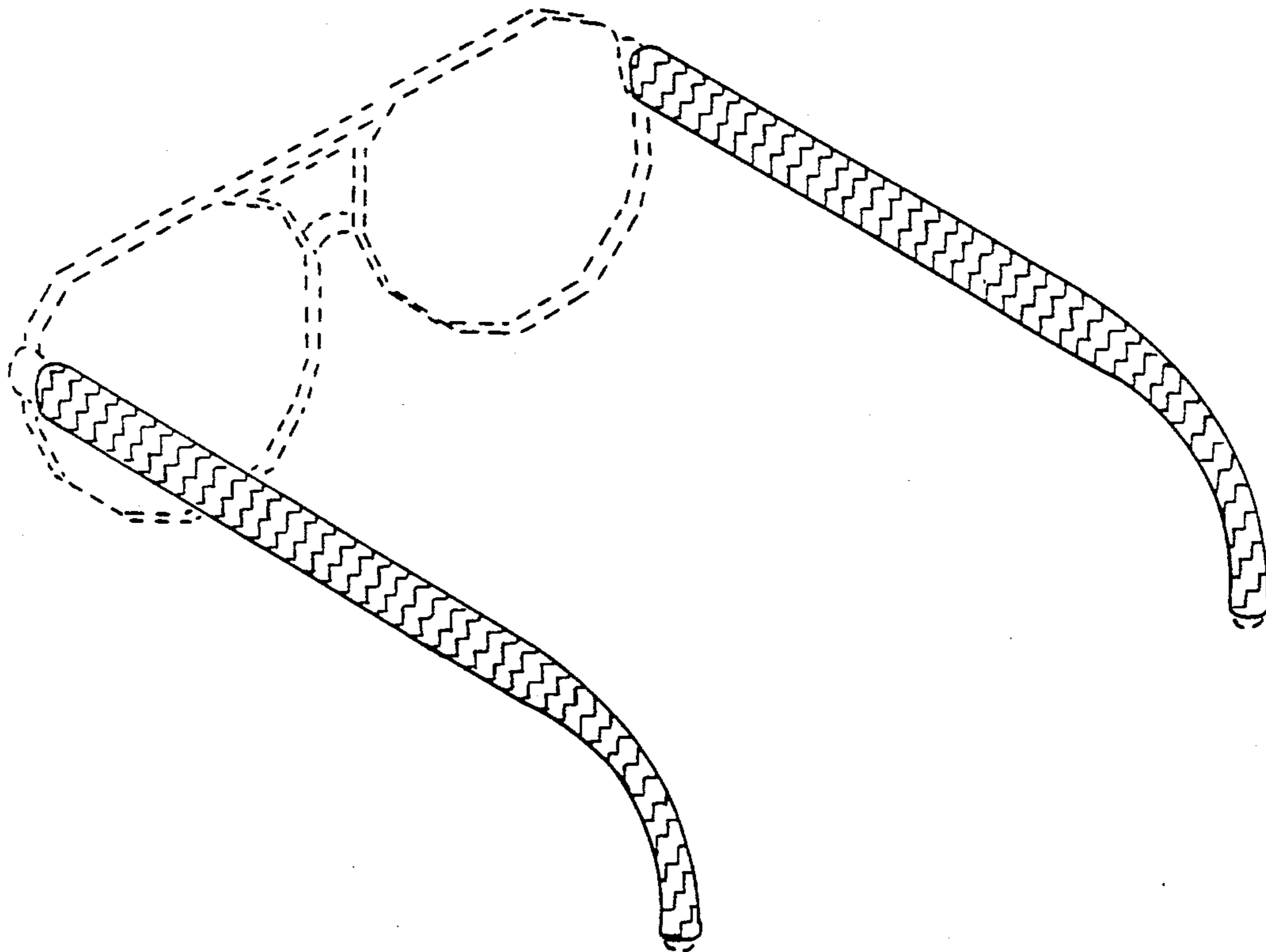
The ornamental design of eyeglass temple covers, as

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of eyeglass temple covers
showing my new design the broken line showing of the
eyeglasses in FIGS. 1-3 is for illustrative purposes only
and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side oppo-
site being substantially a mirror image; and

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view
being substantially a mirror image.



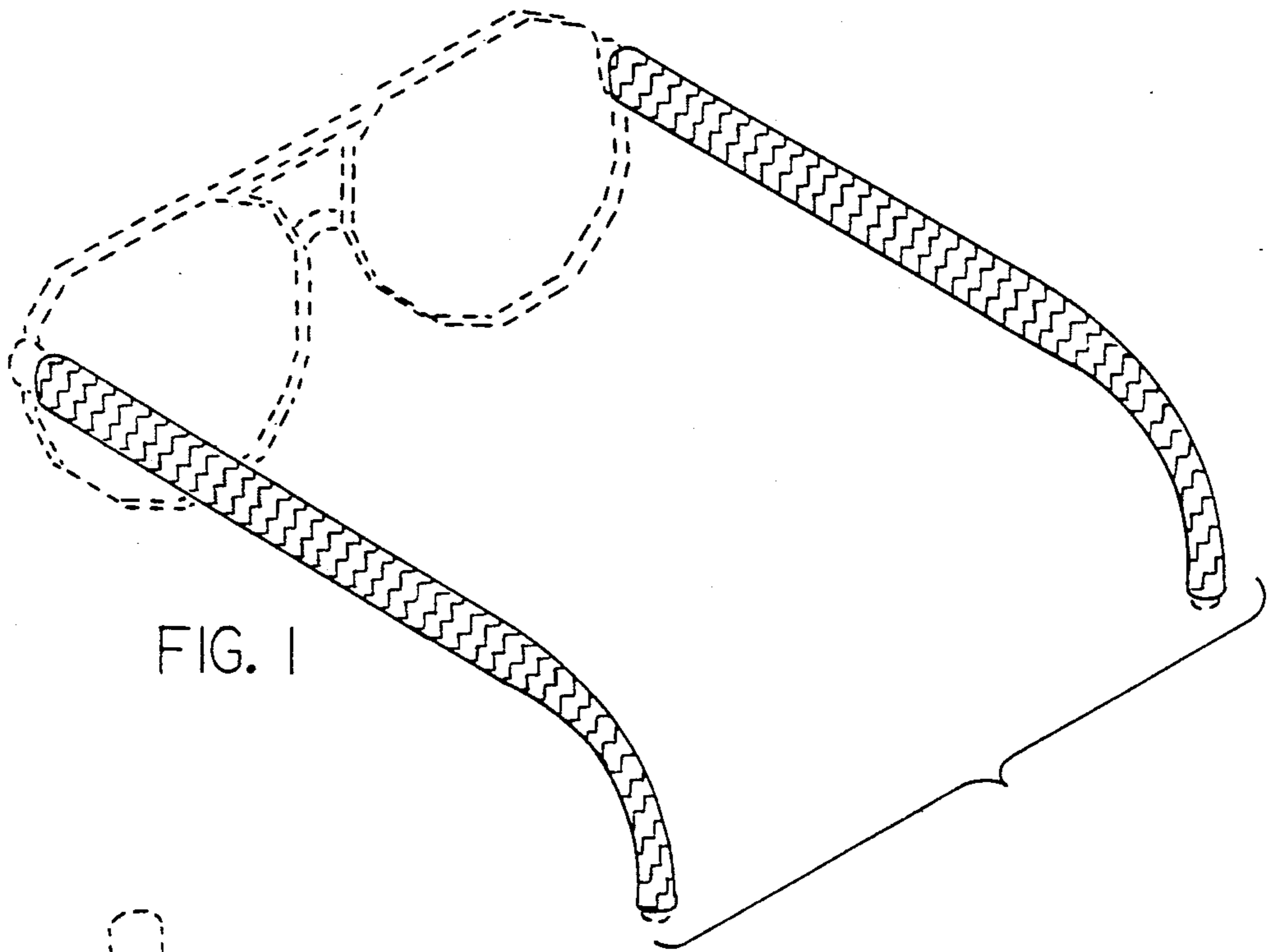

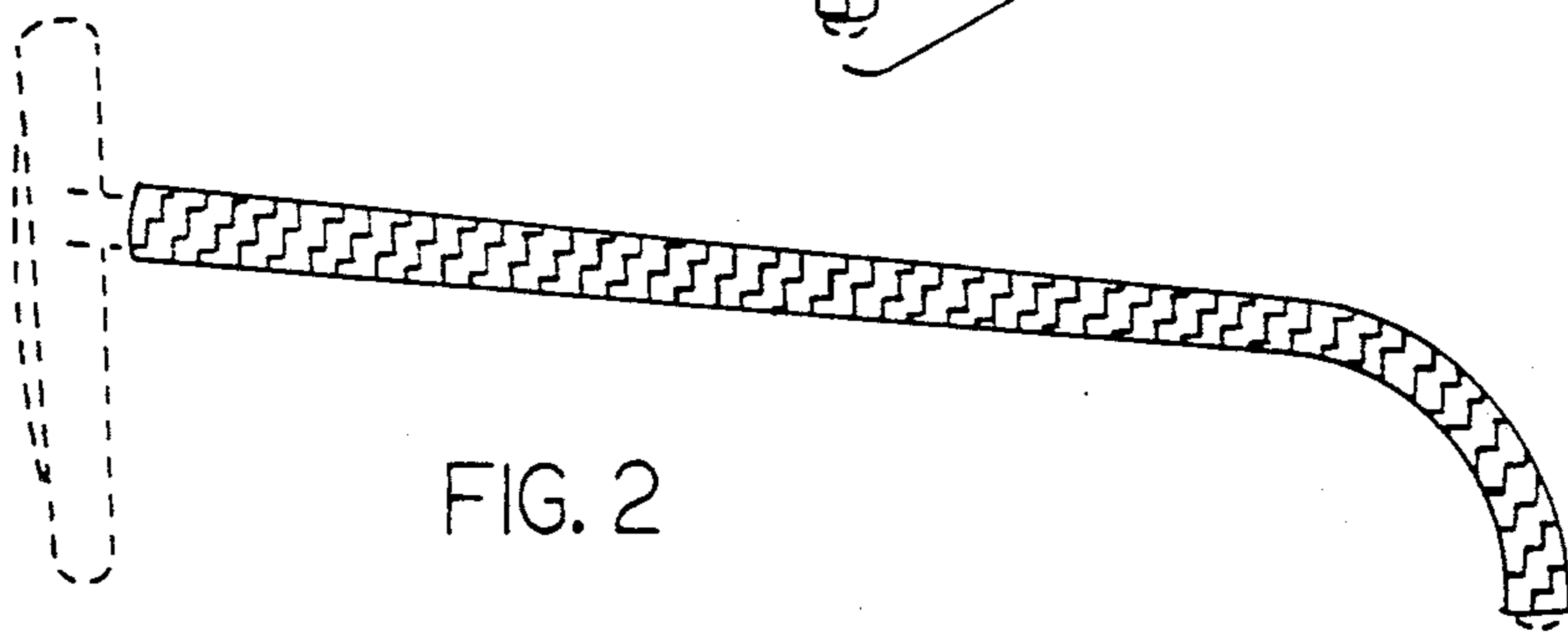

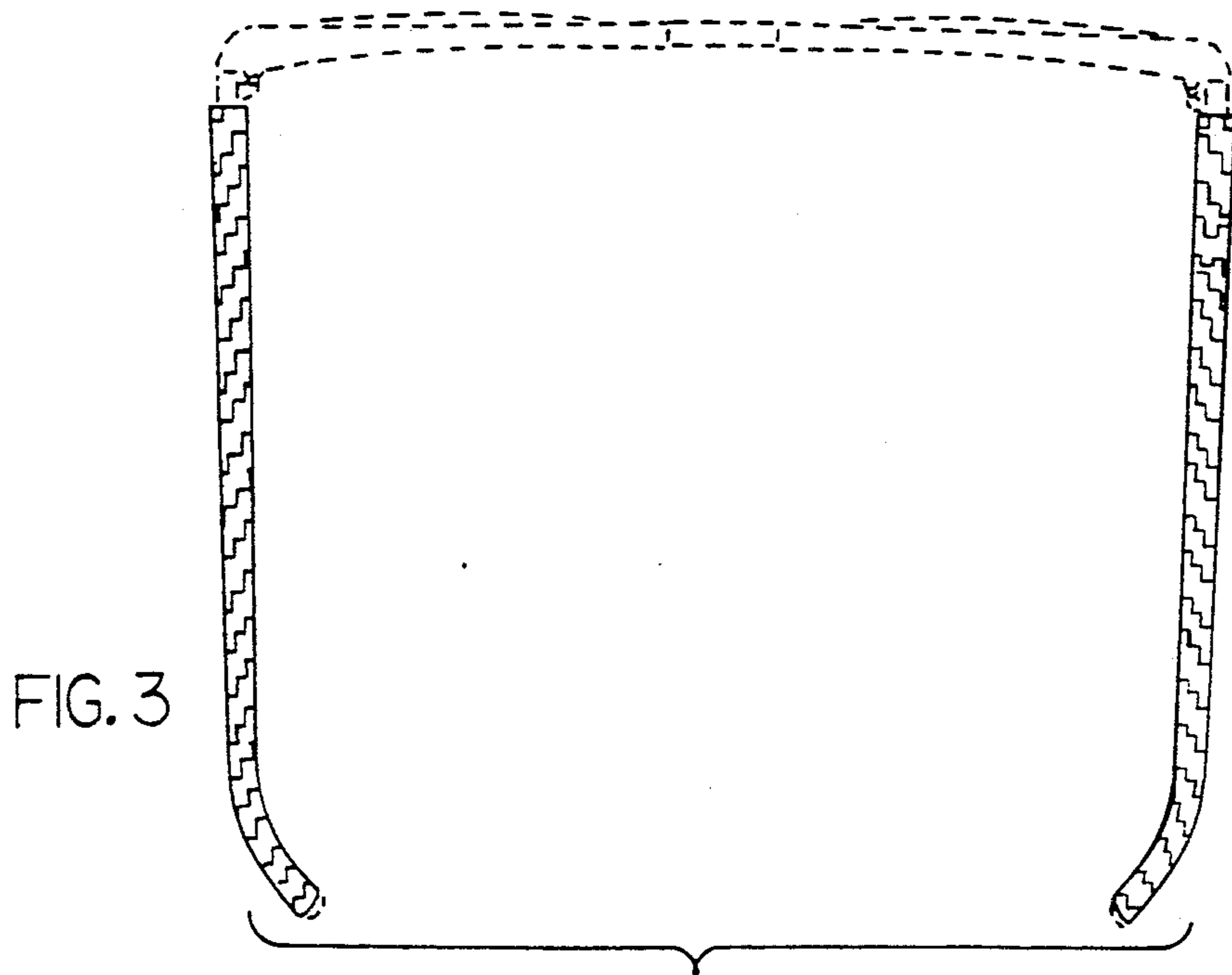
