DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a frame for an electronic instrument showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of an electronic instrument is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

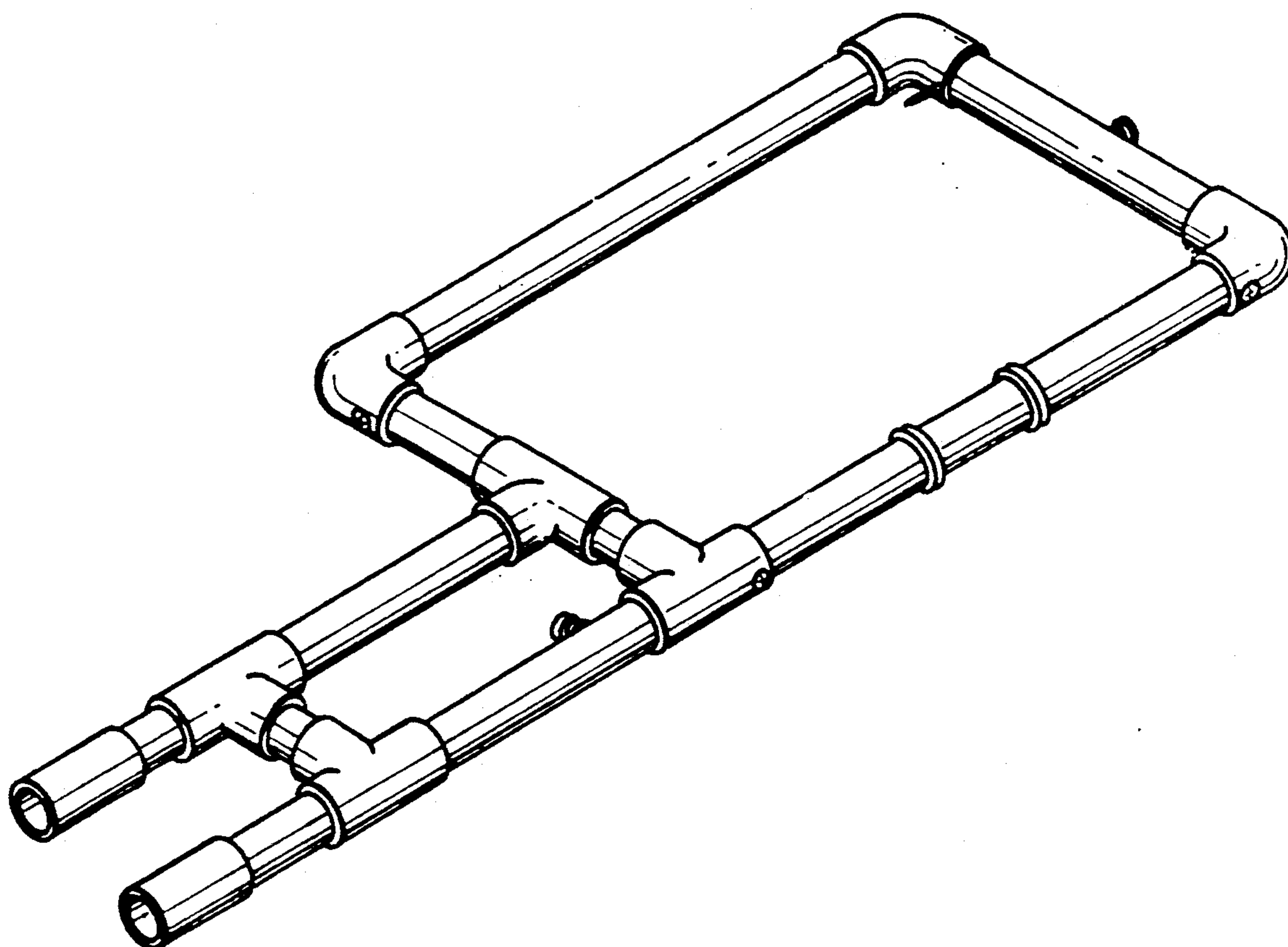

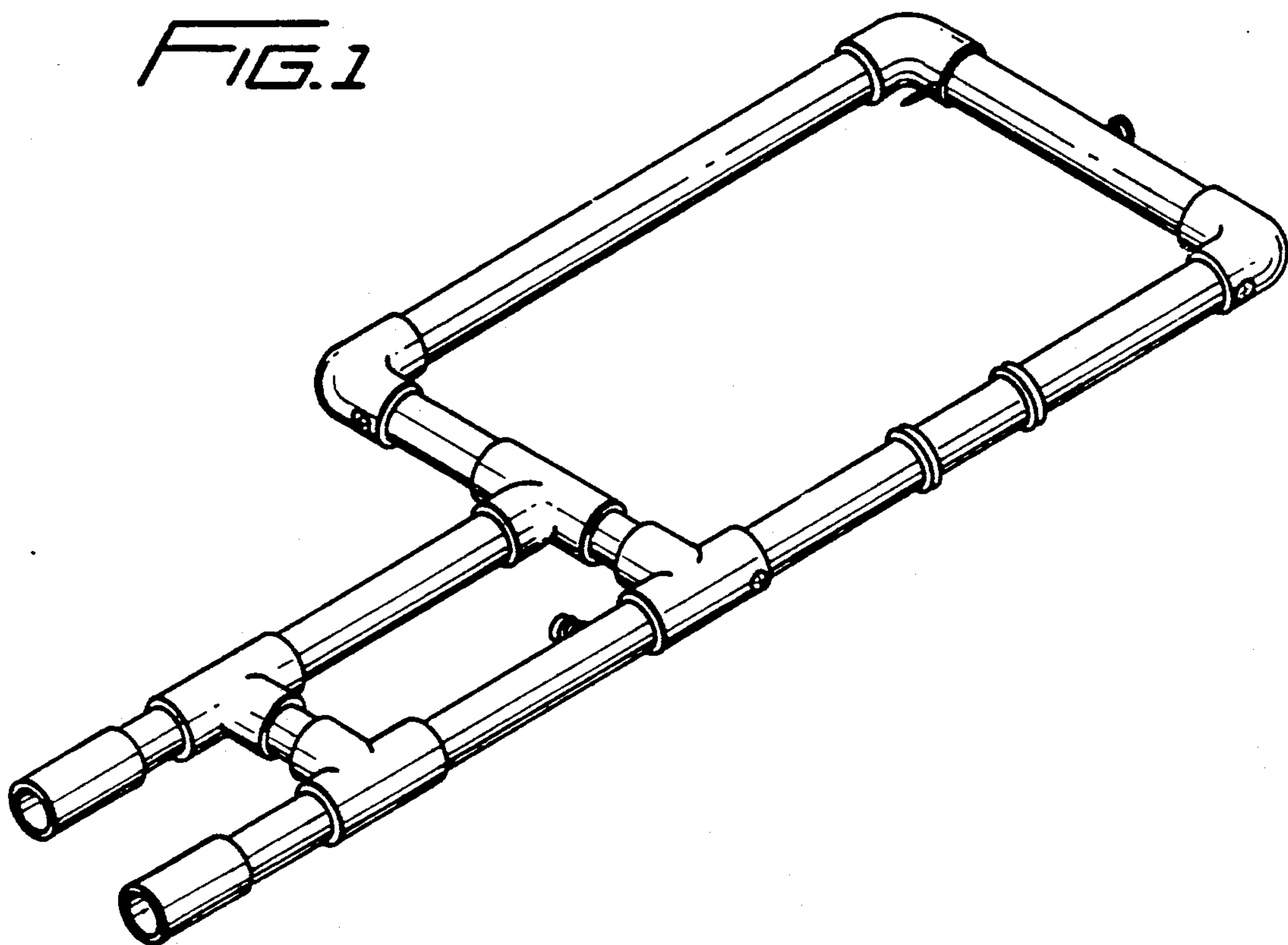

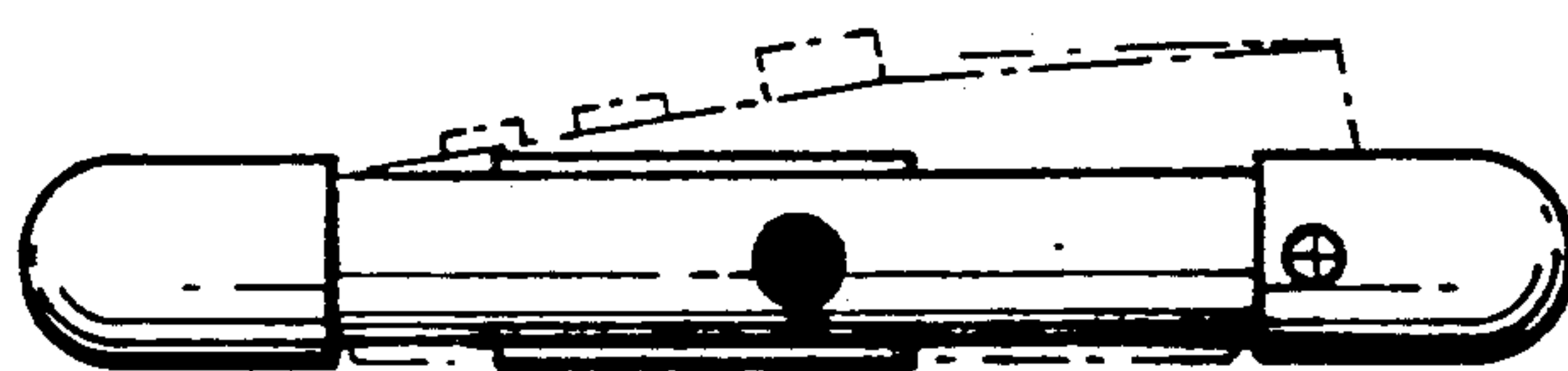
