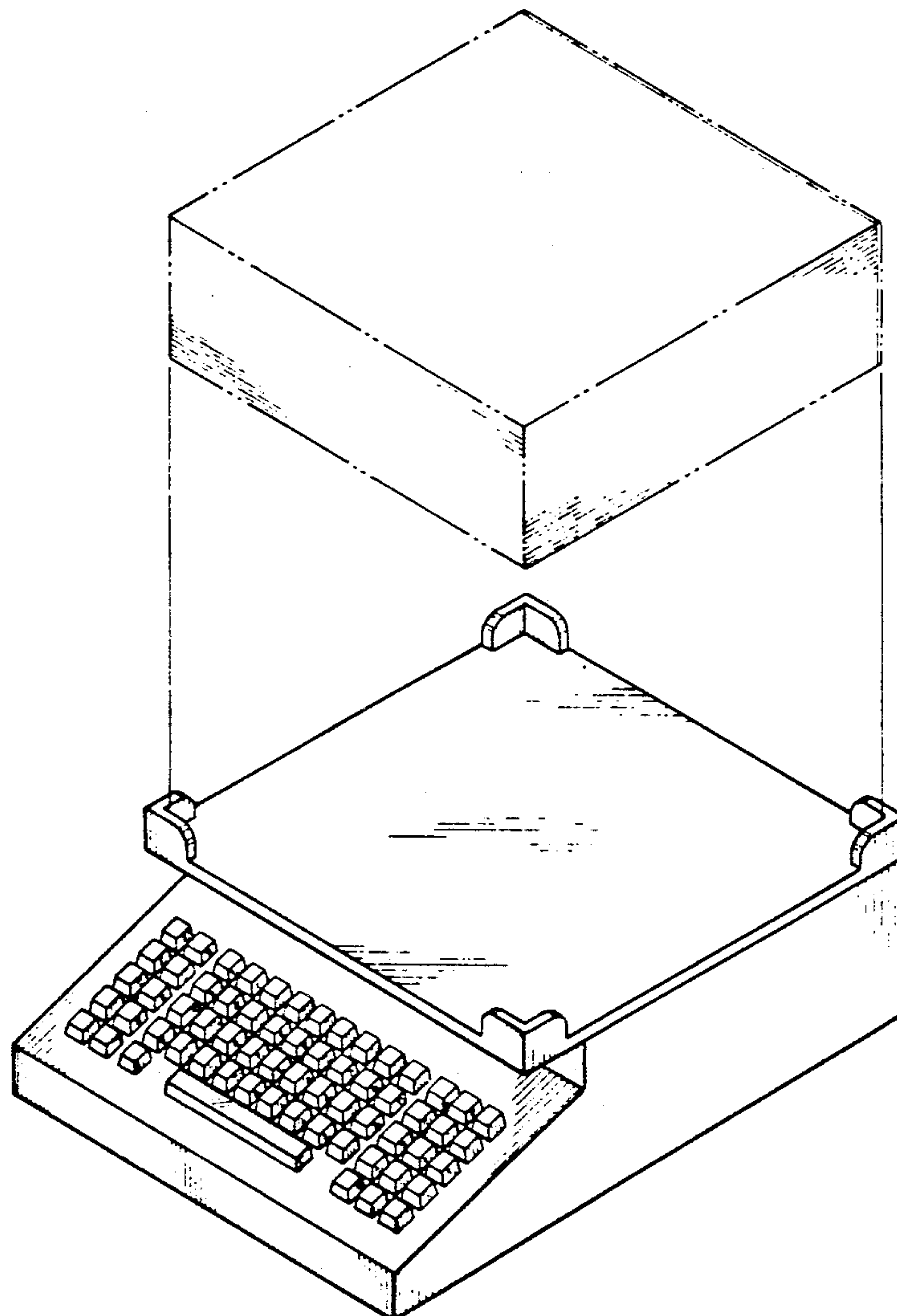

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a note pad holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a note pad holder showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
The note pad depicted by means of broken lines in FIGS. 1, 3, 4 and 6 is shown for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



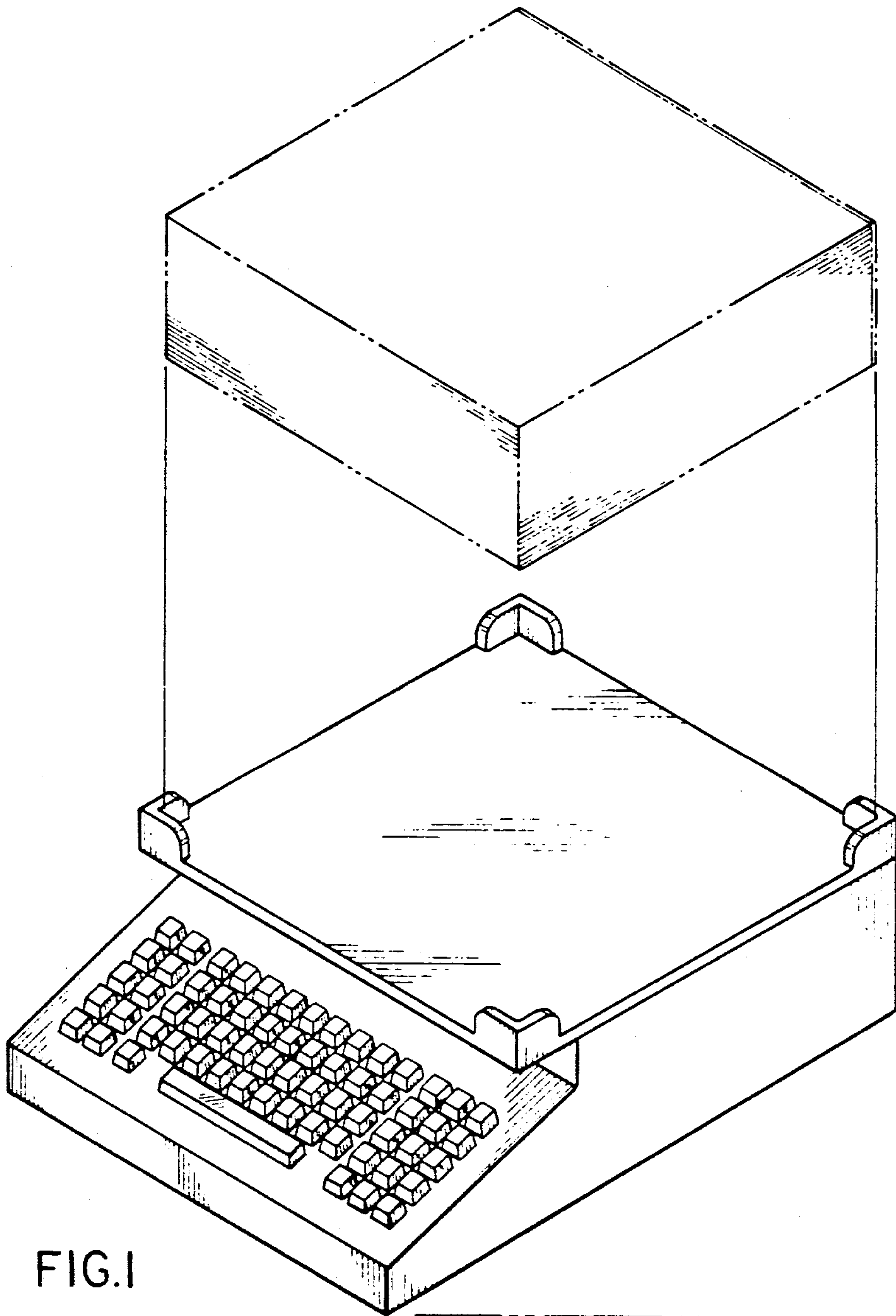

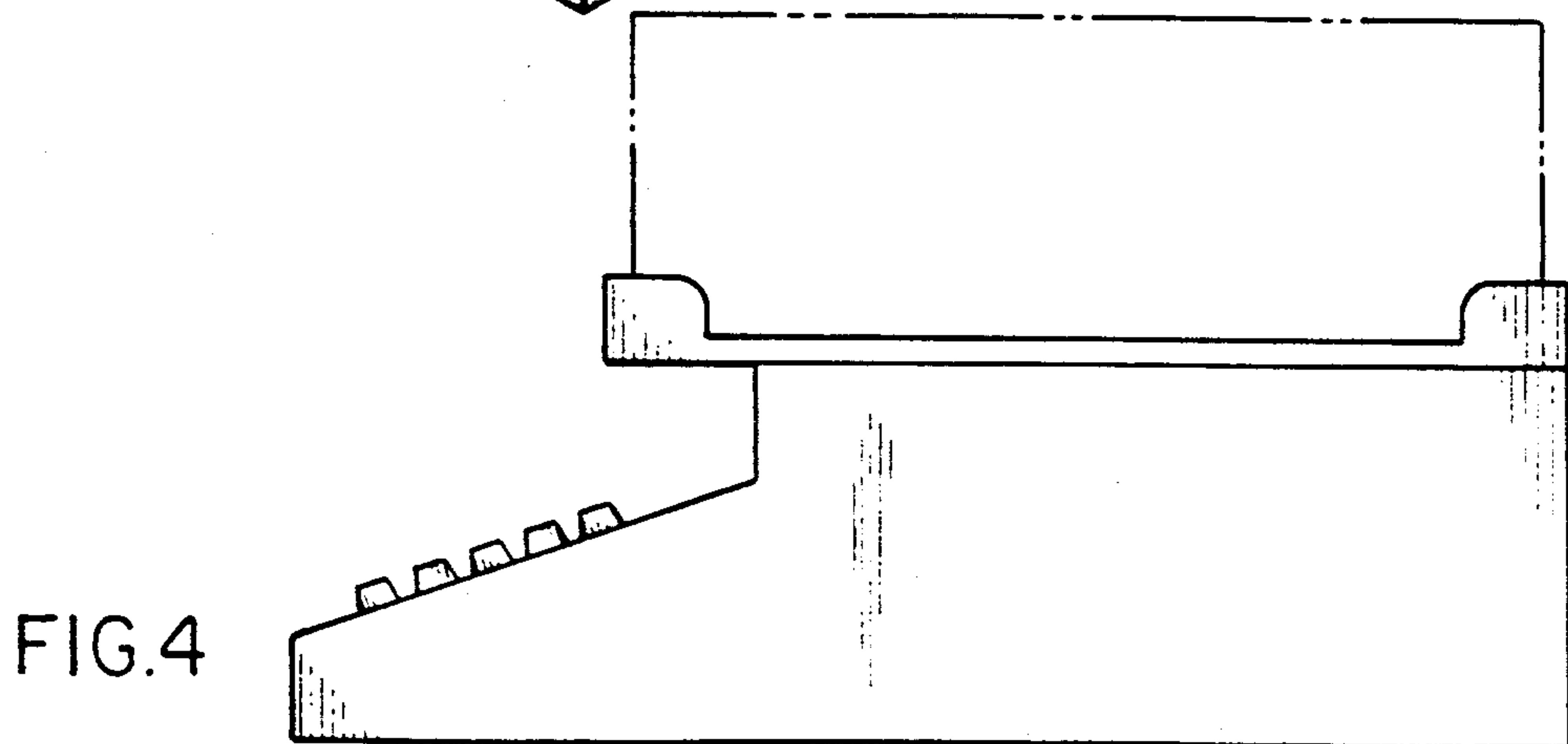

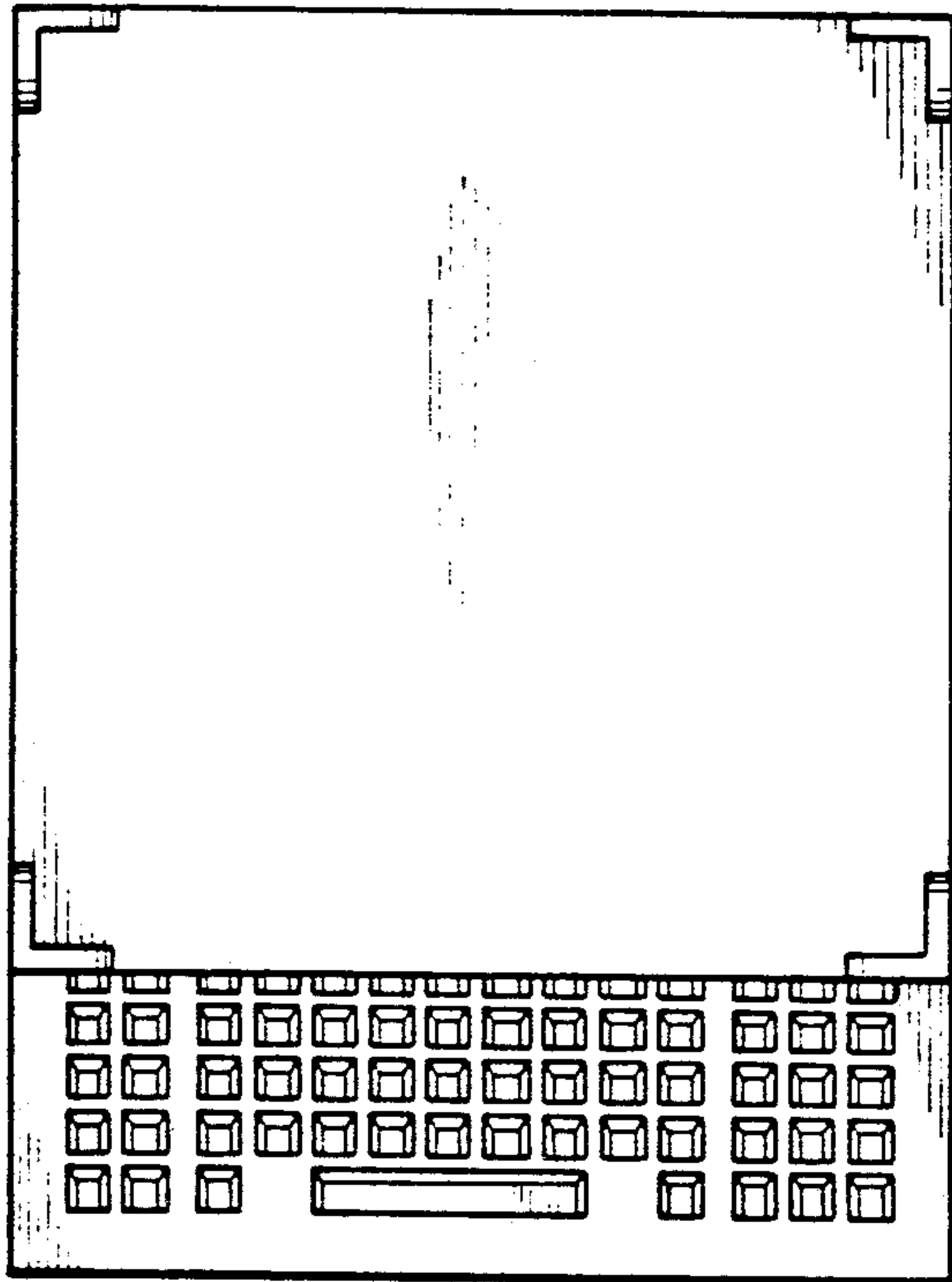

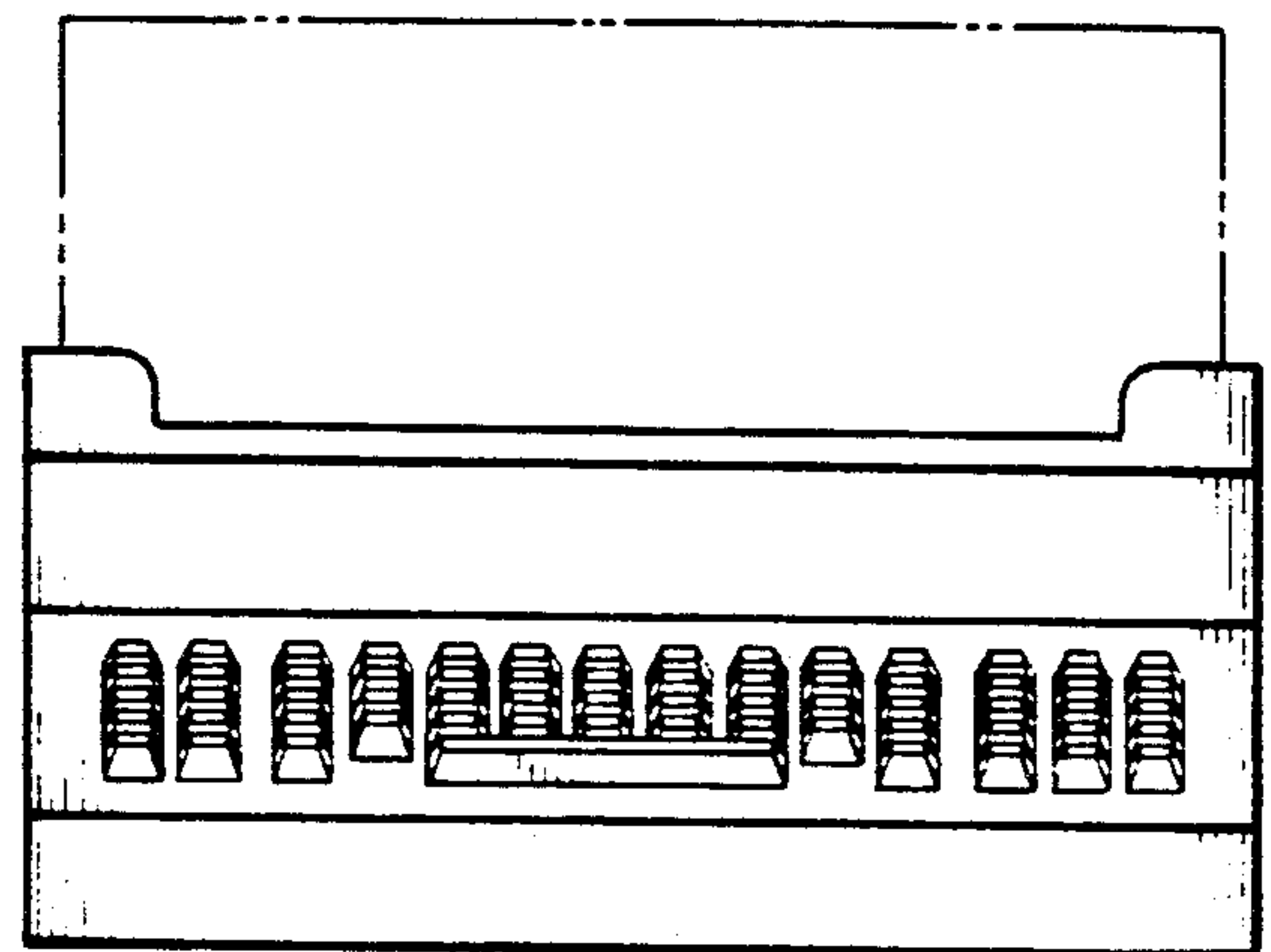

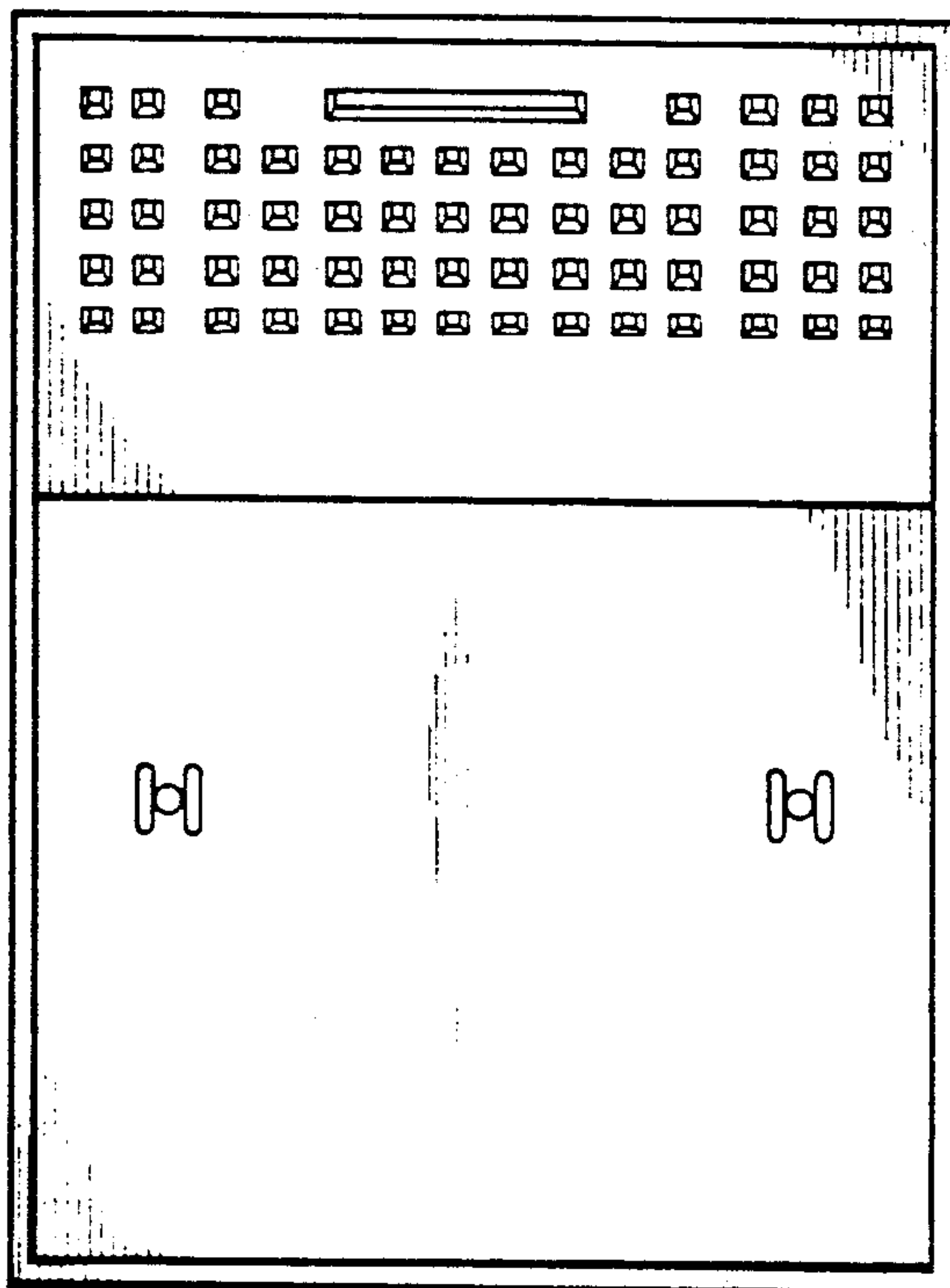

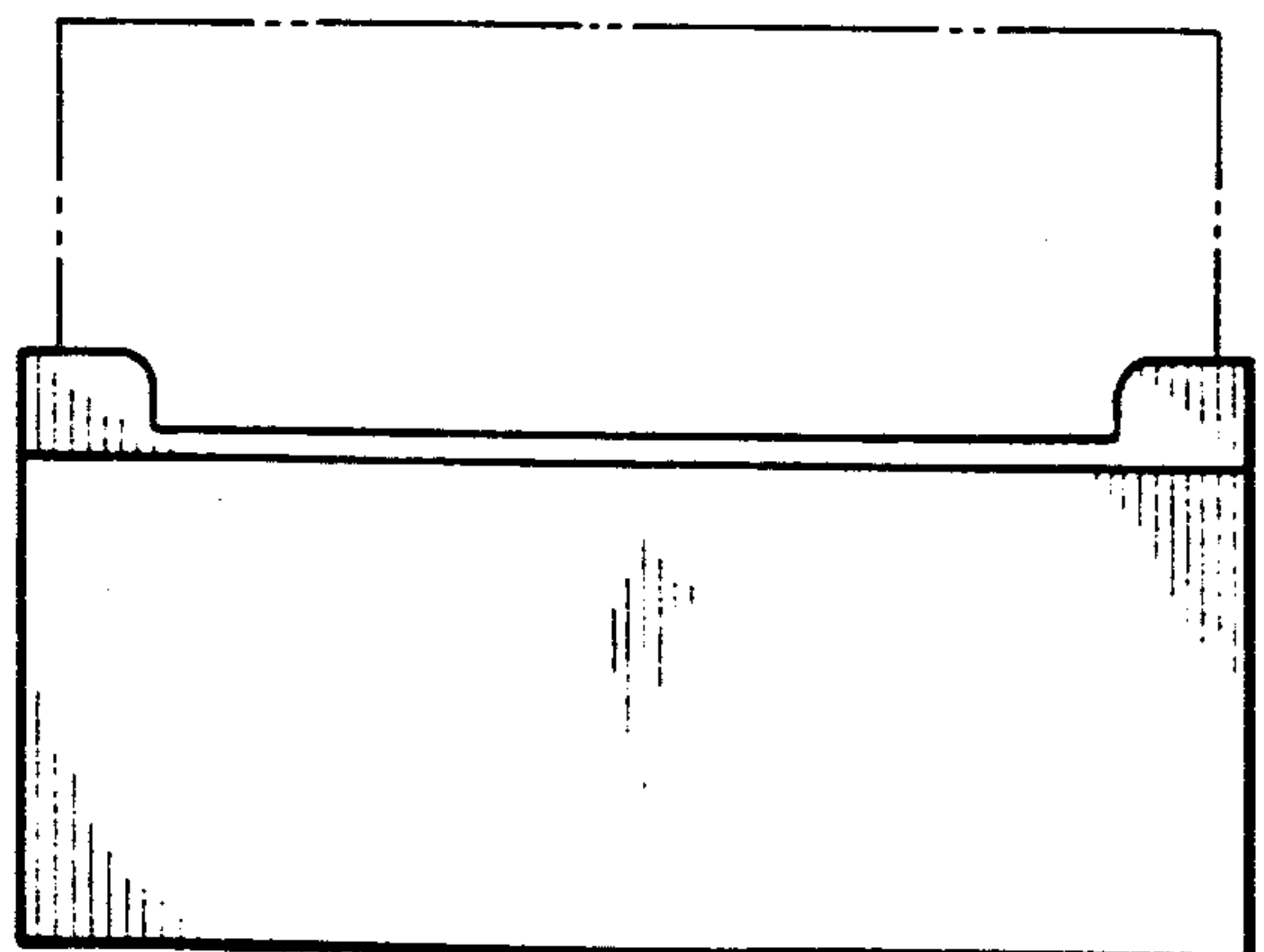
