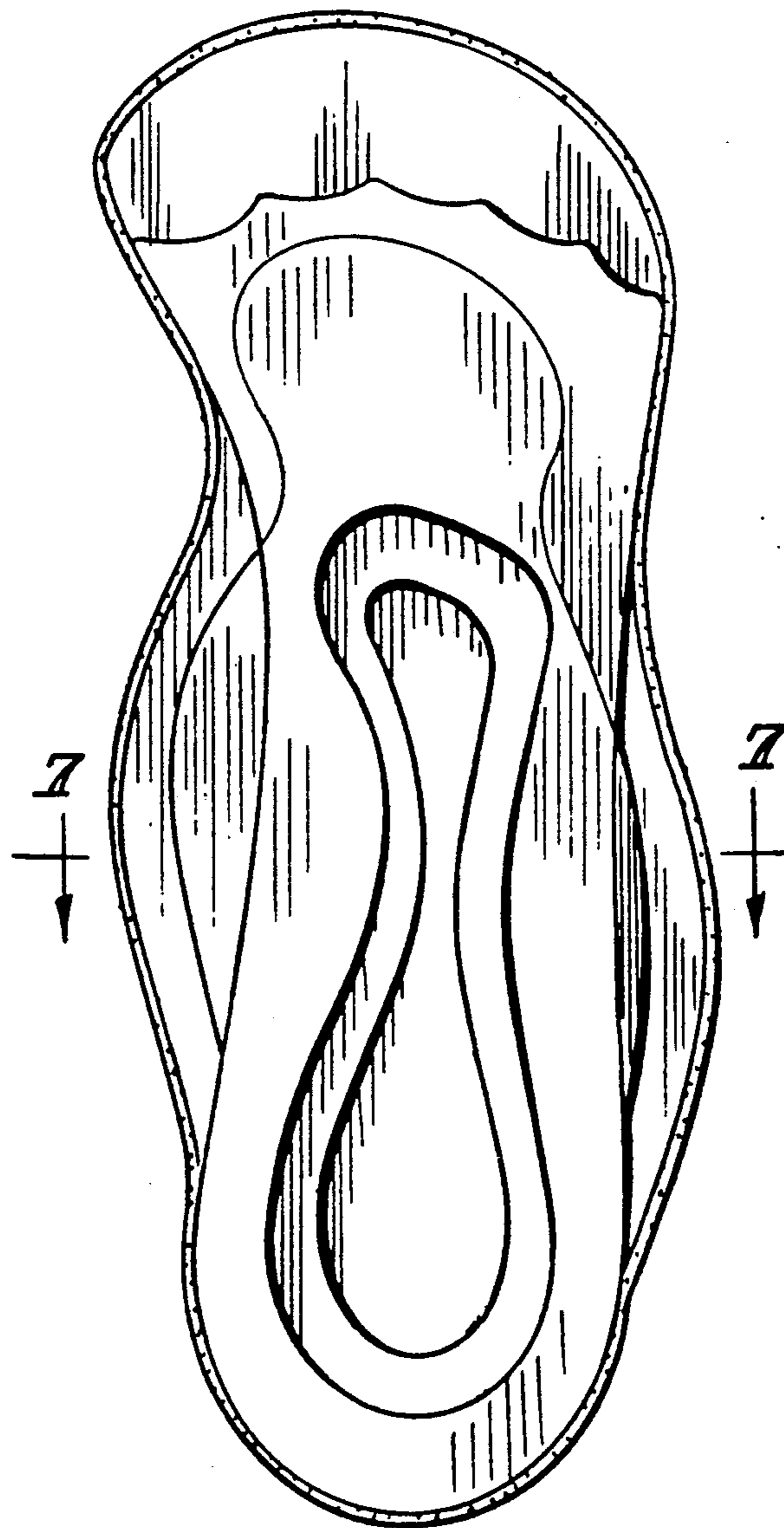

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a shoe pad showing my new design;

 FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof.



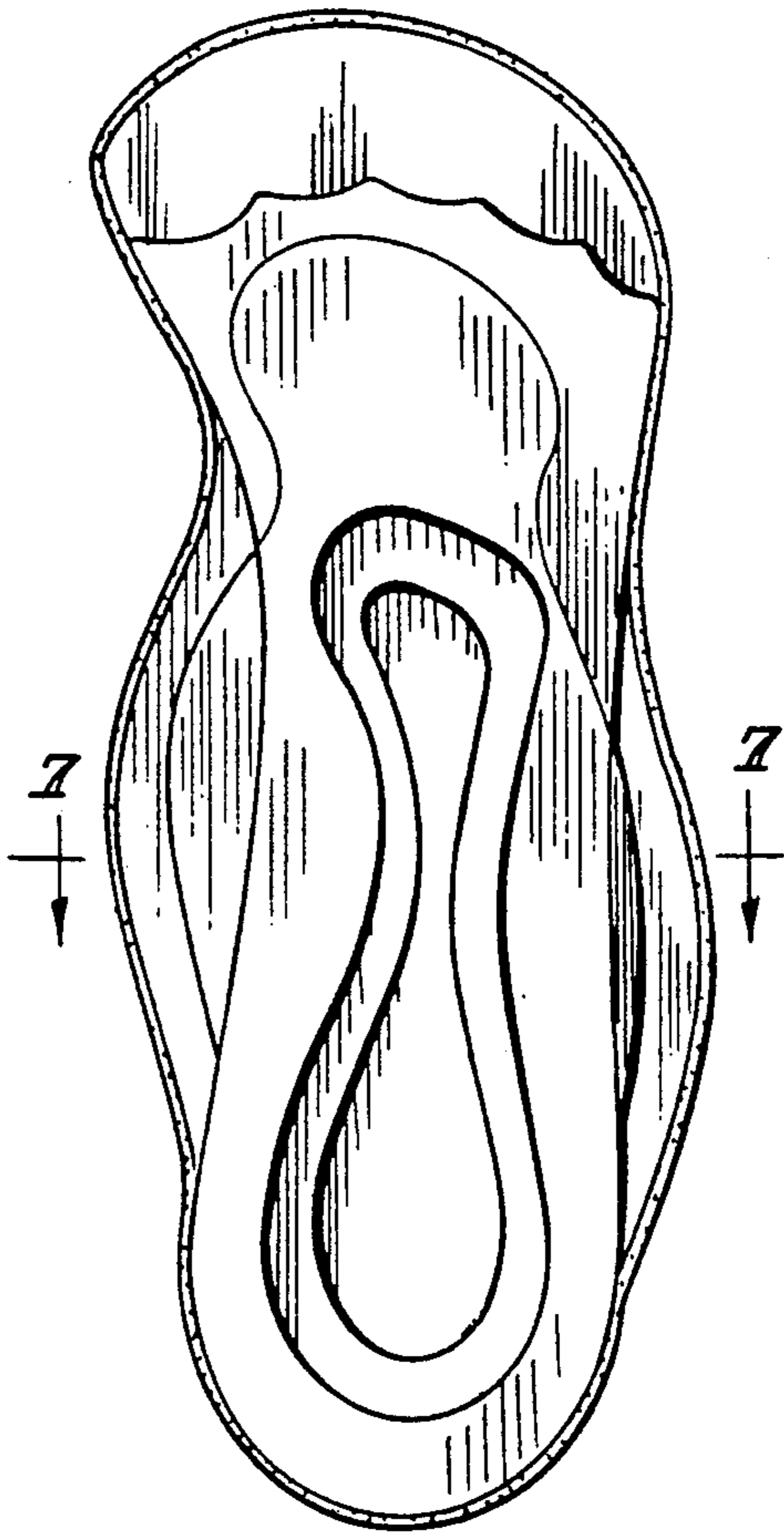
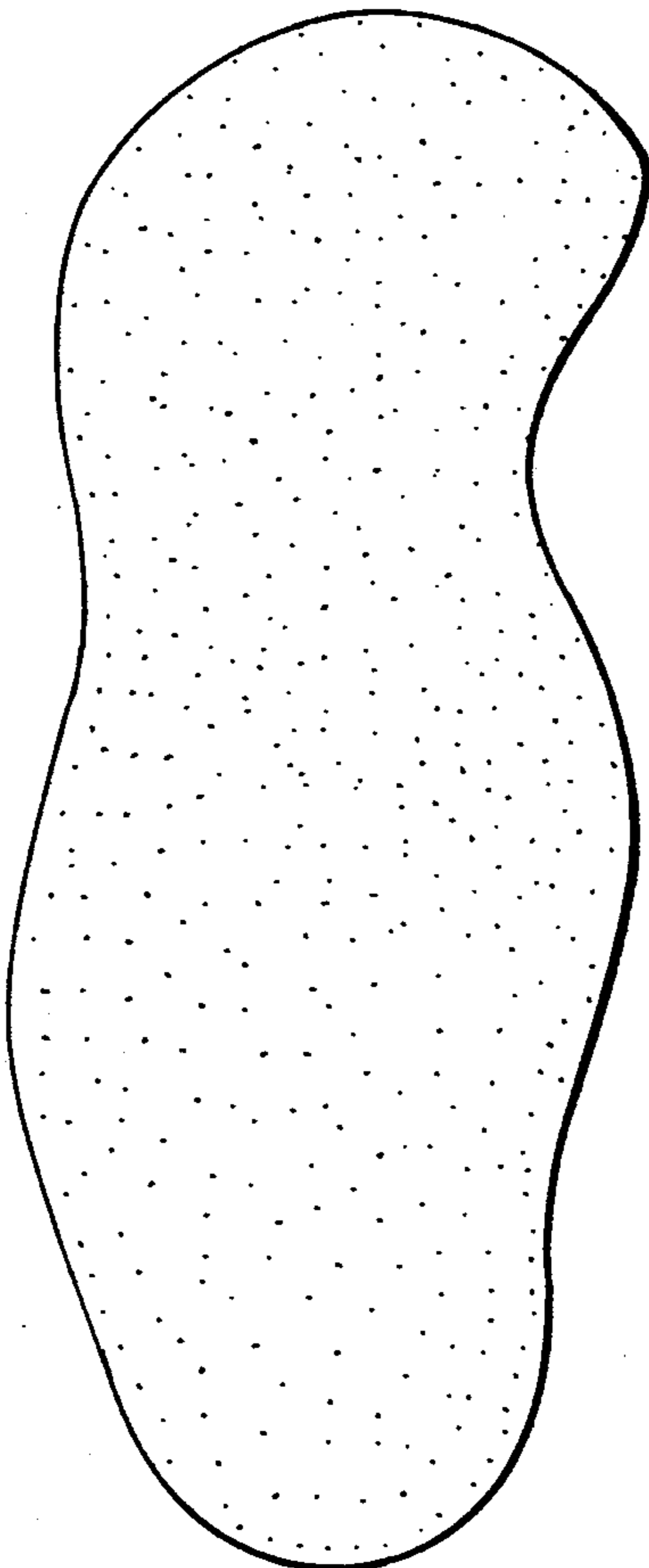

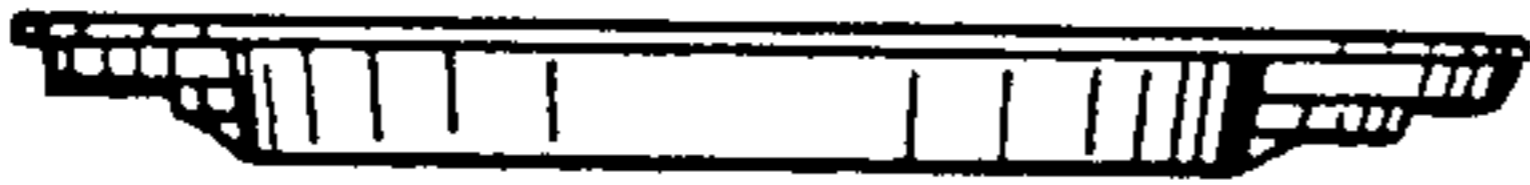

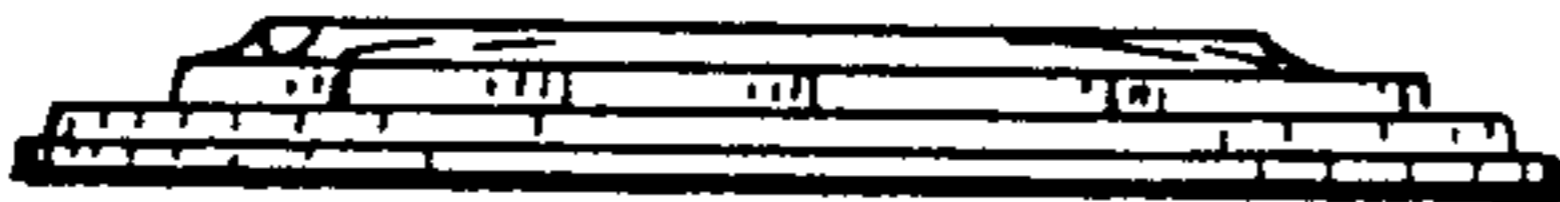

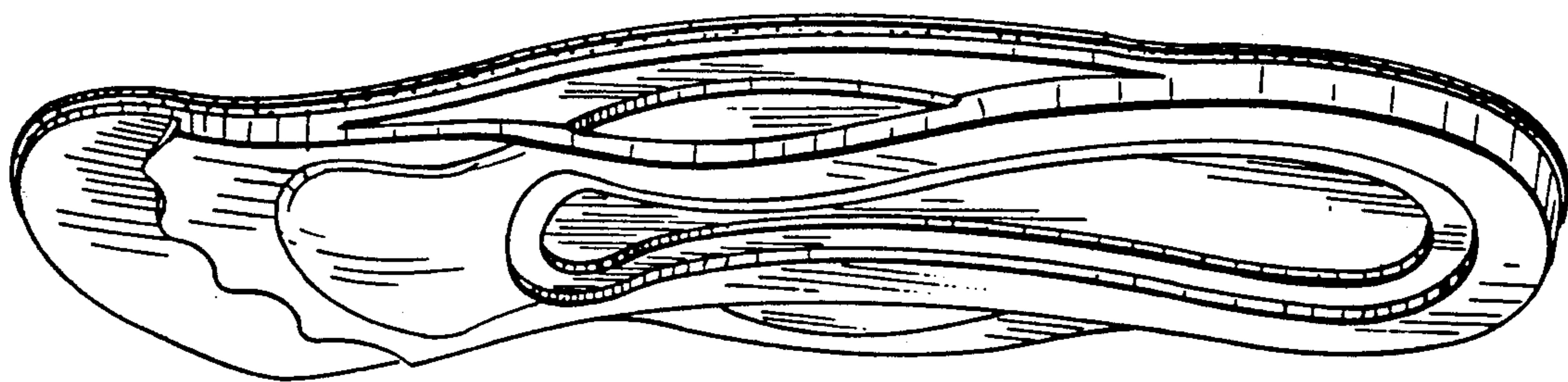
