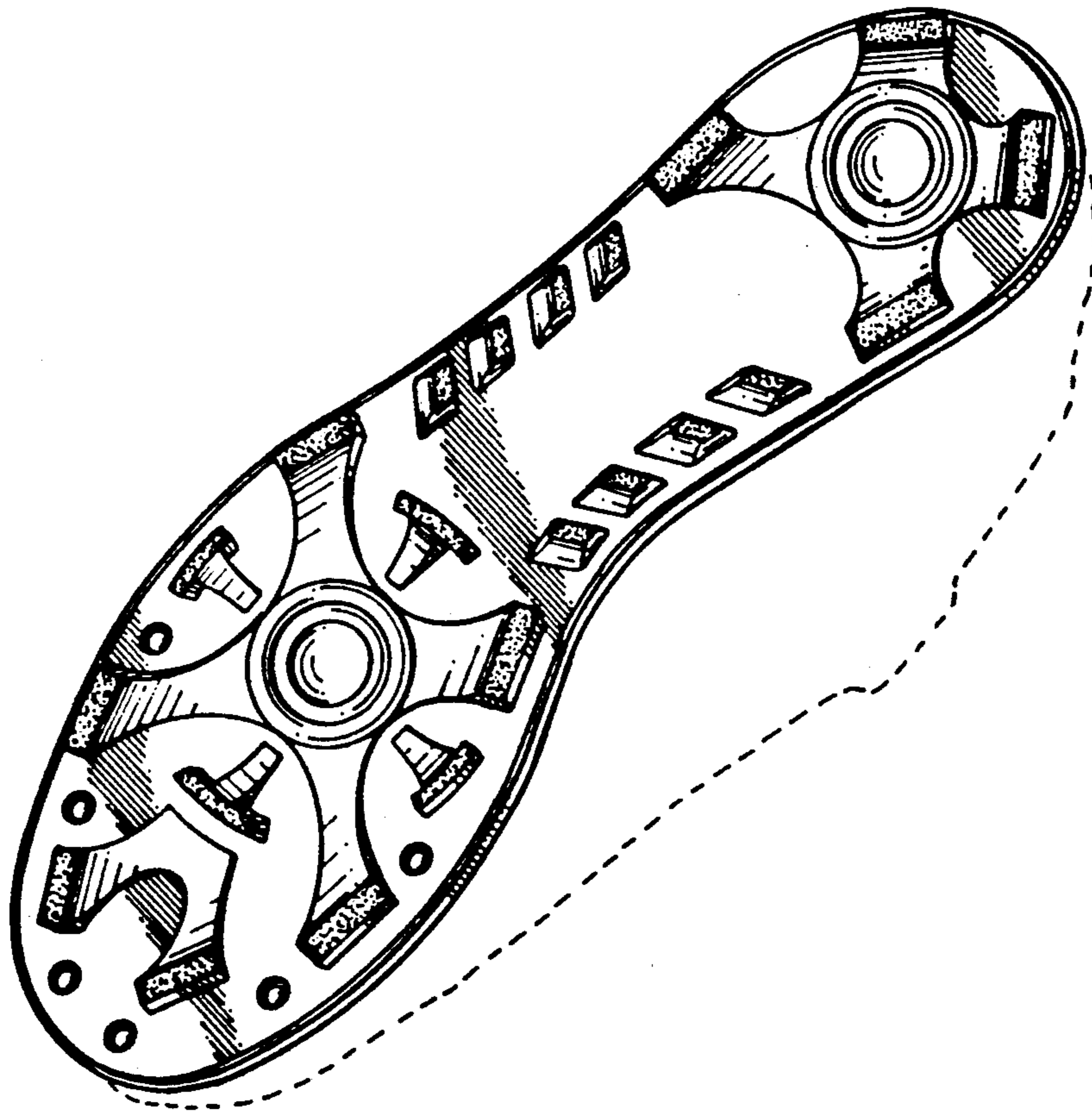
FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe sole

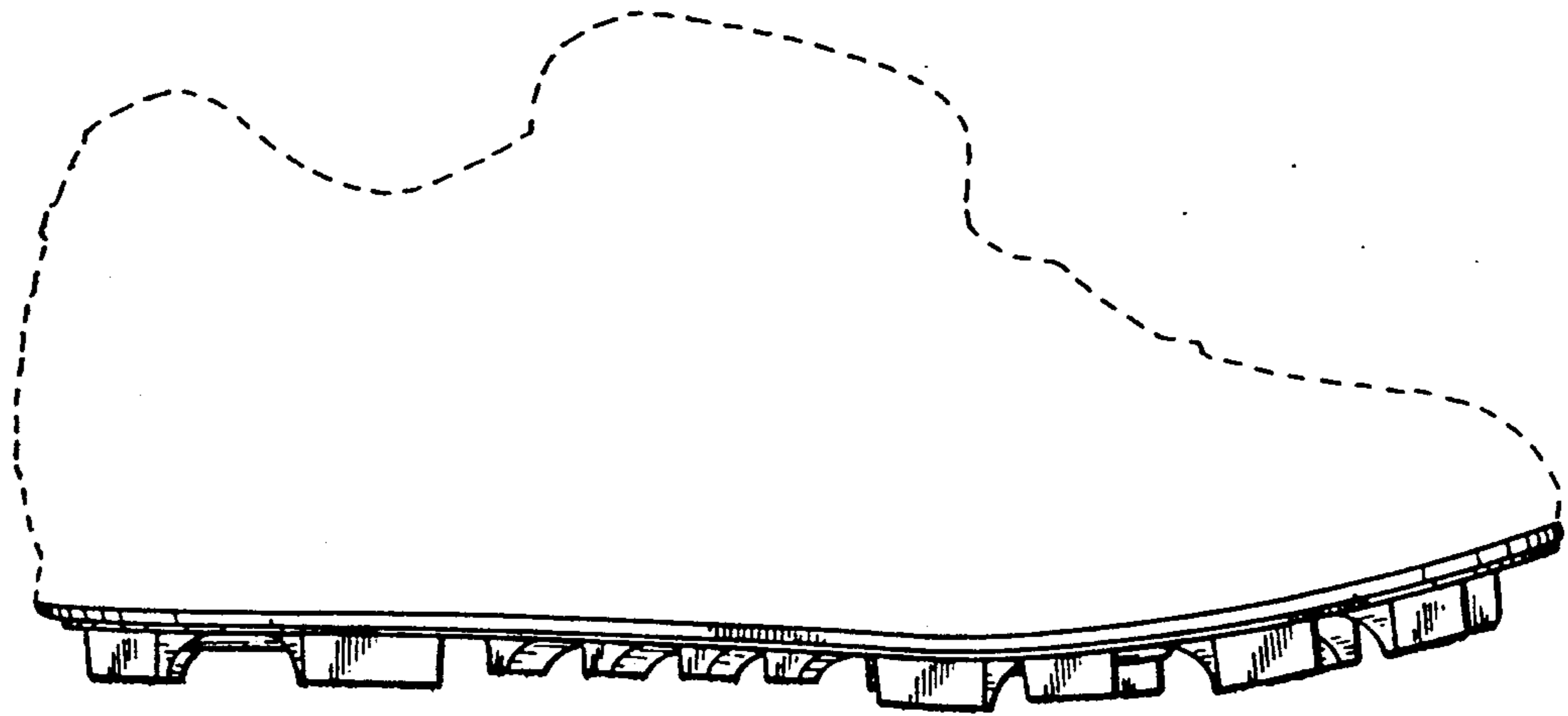

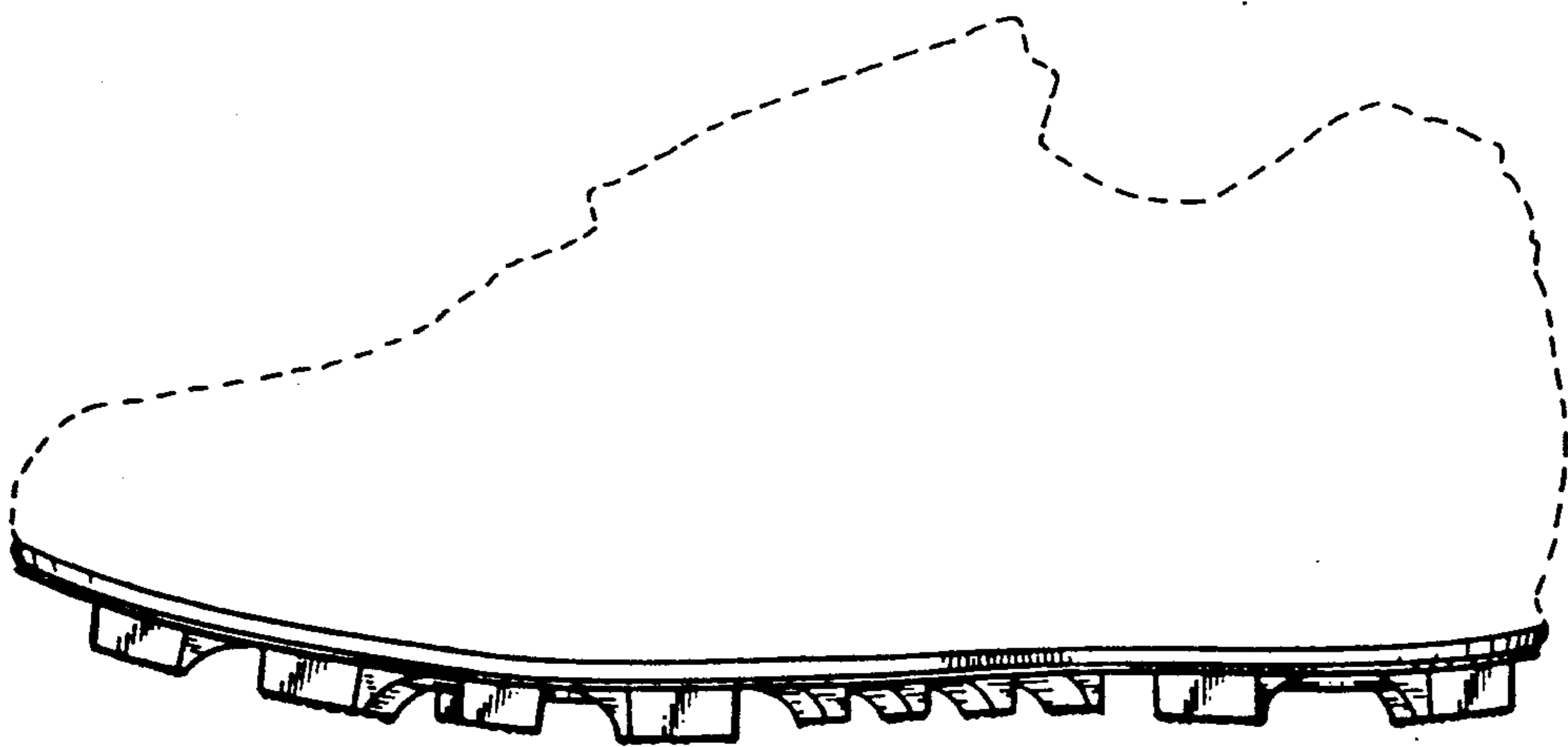

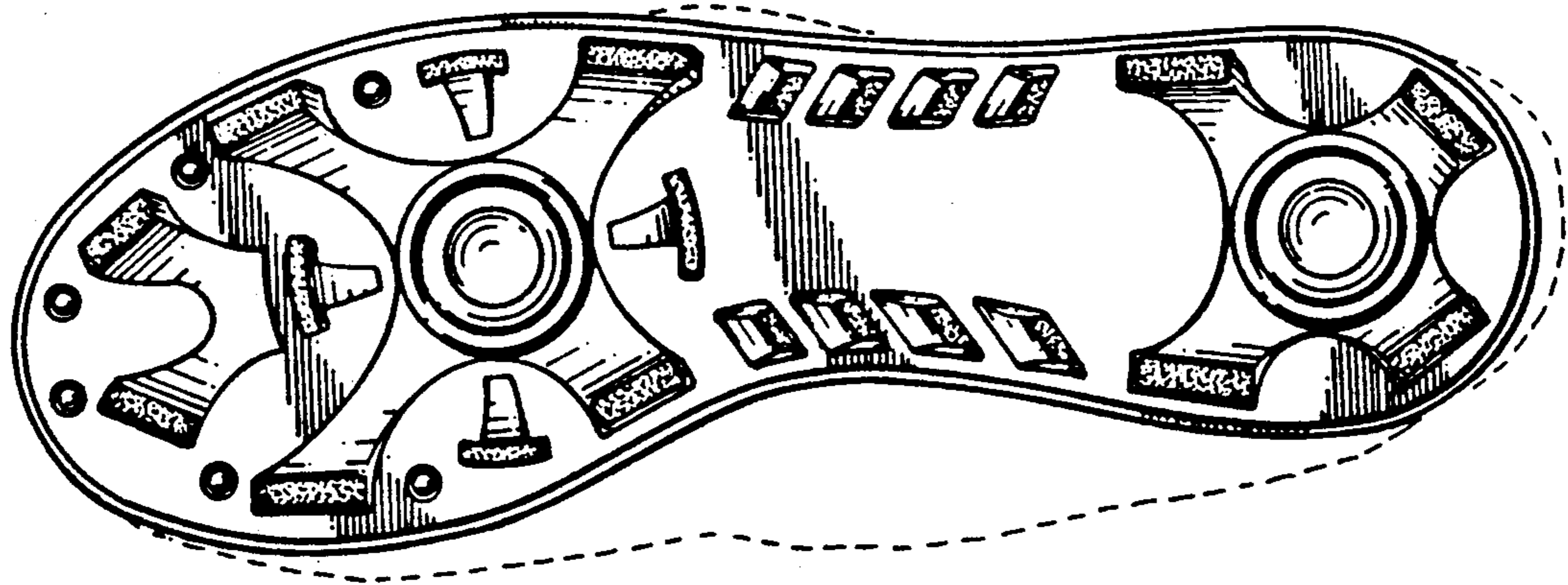

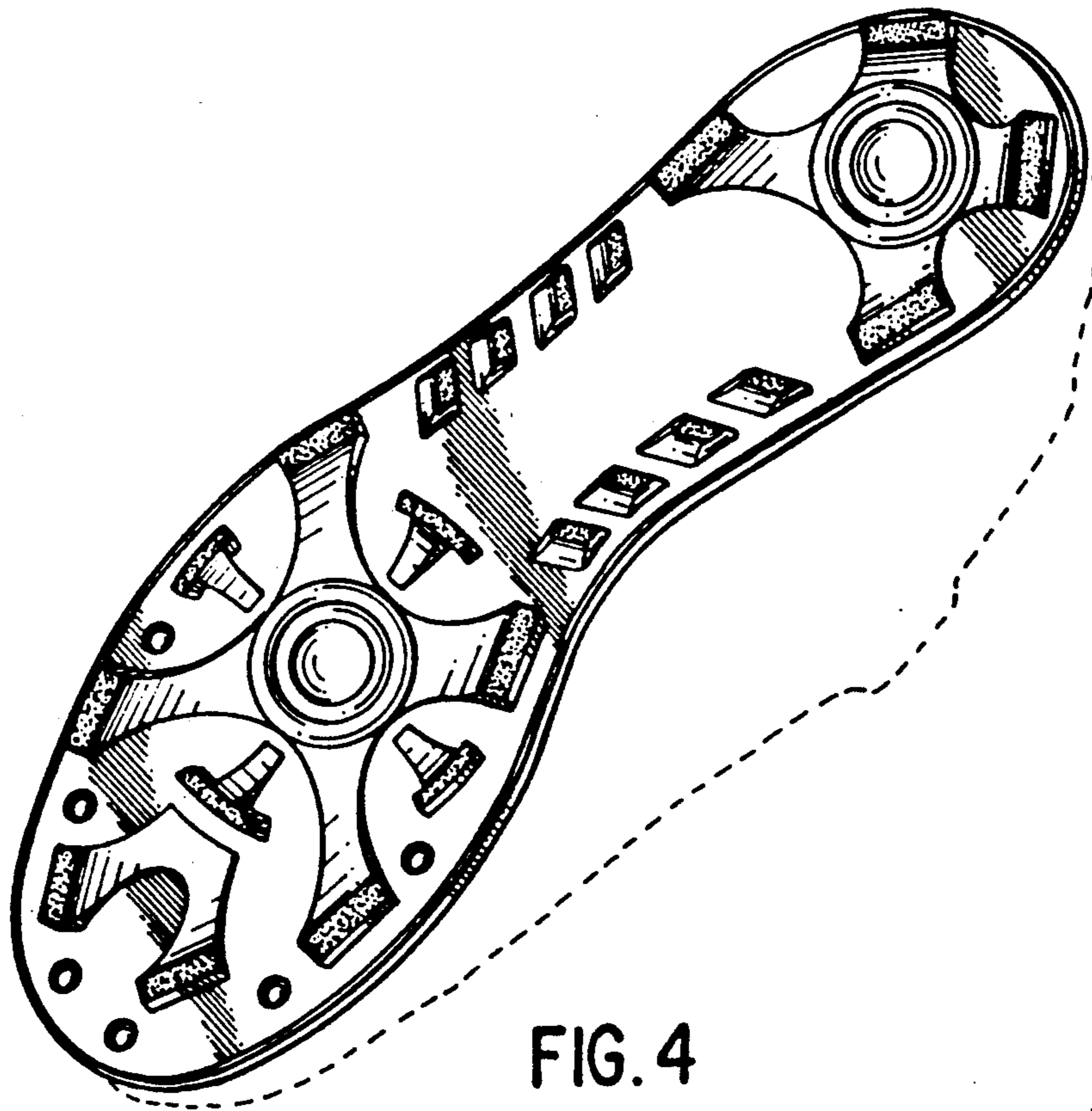

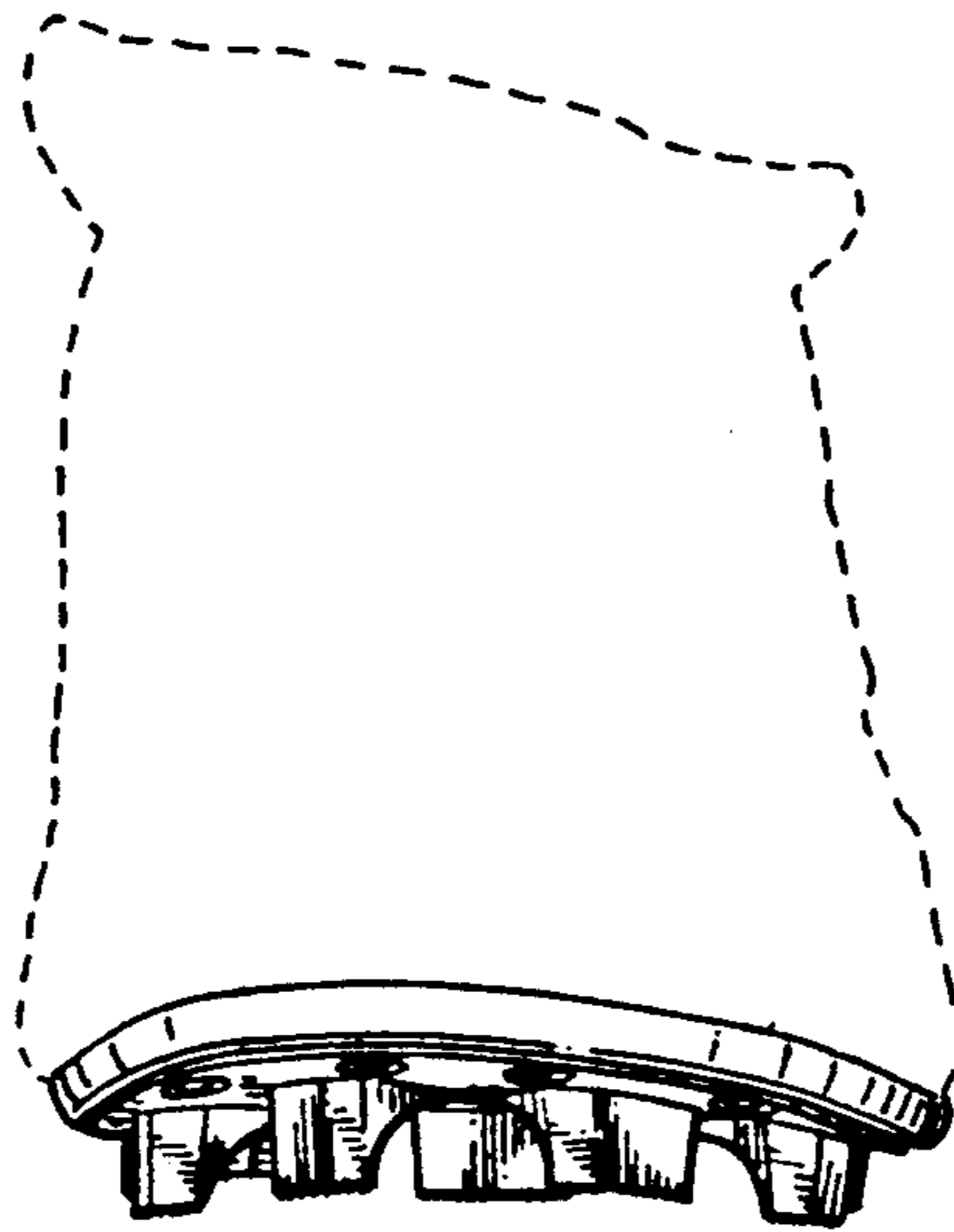

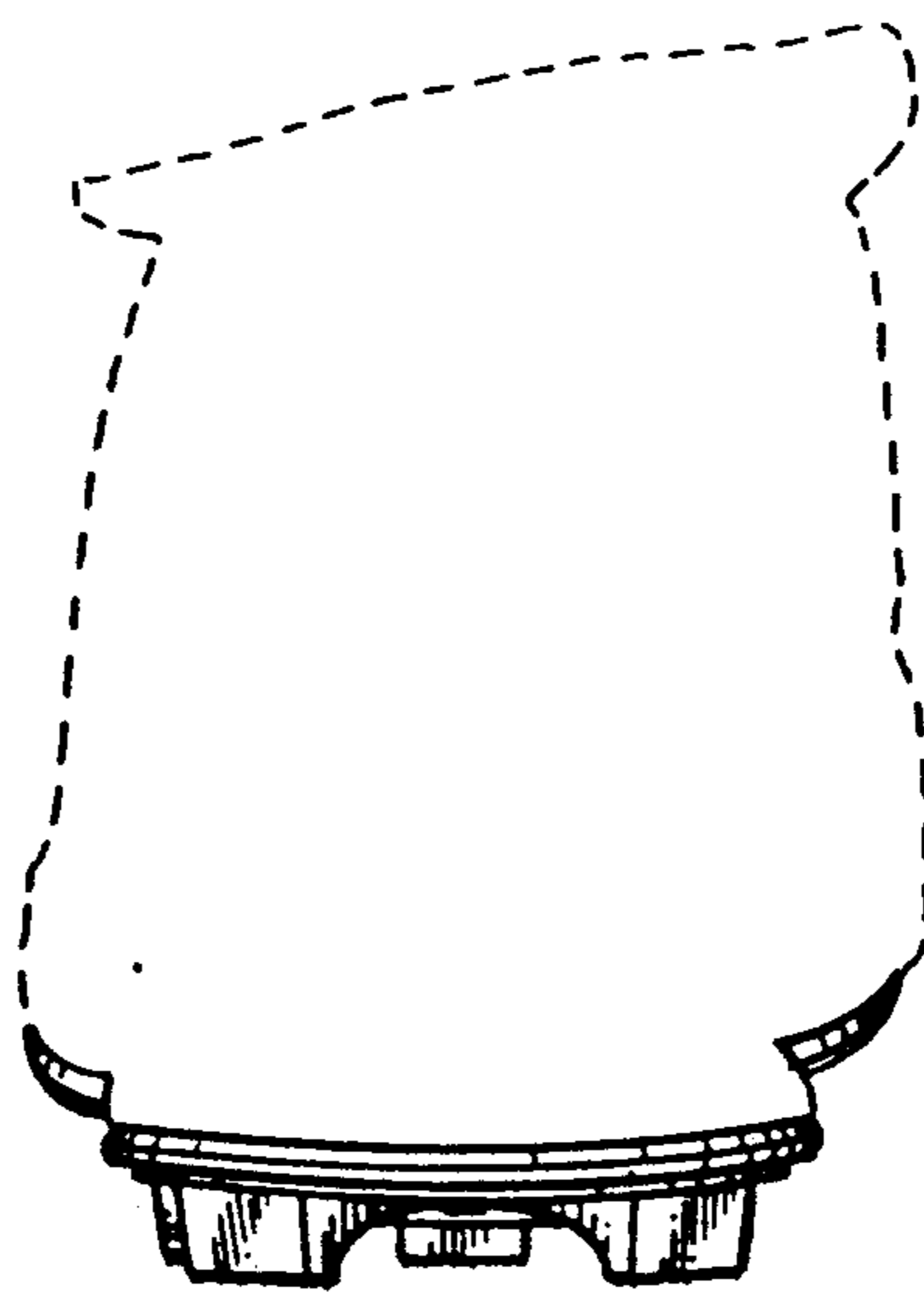
