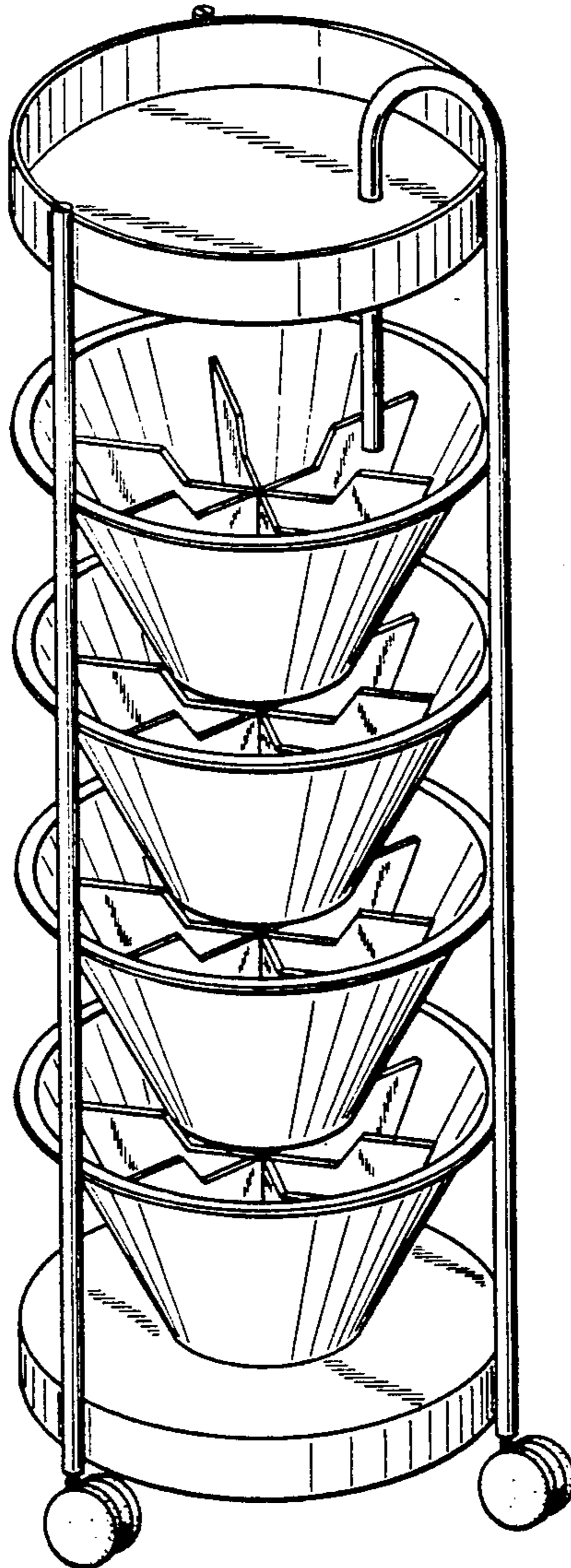
DESCRIPTION

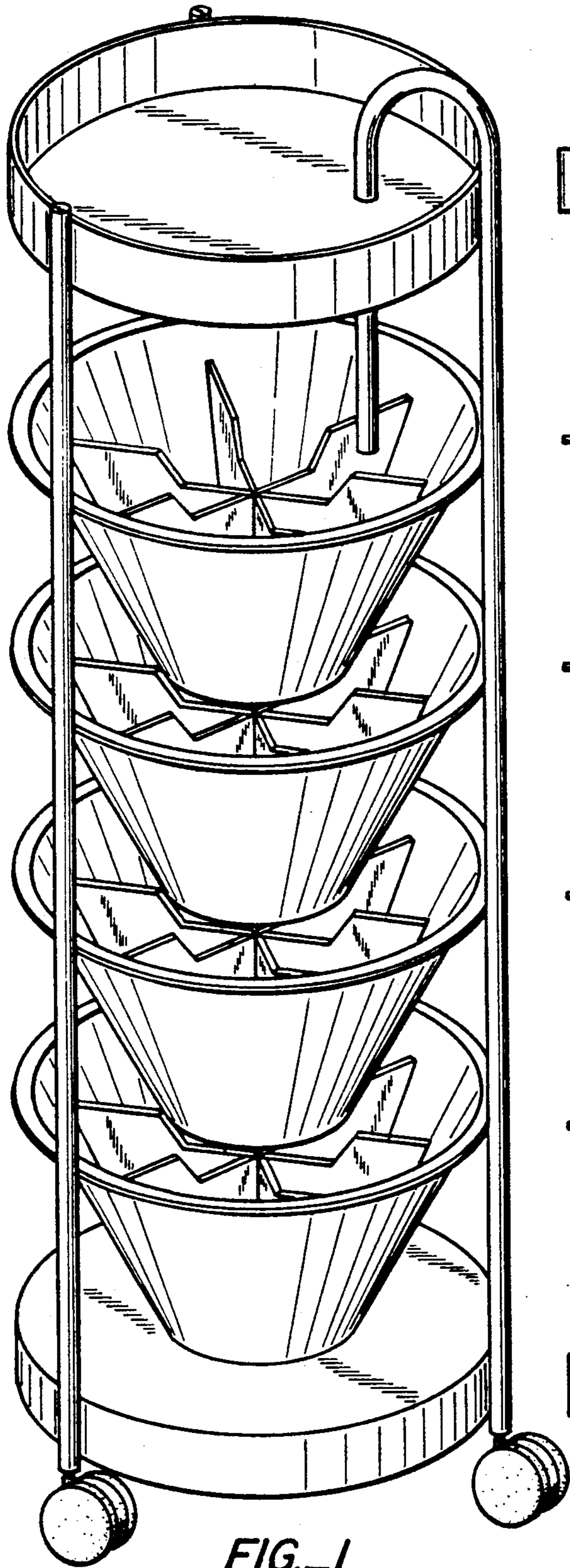

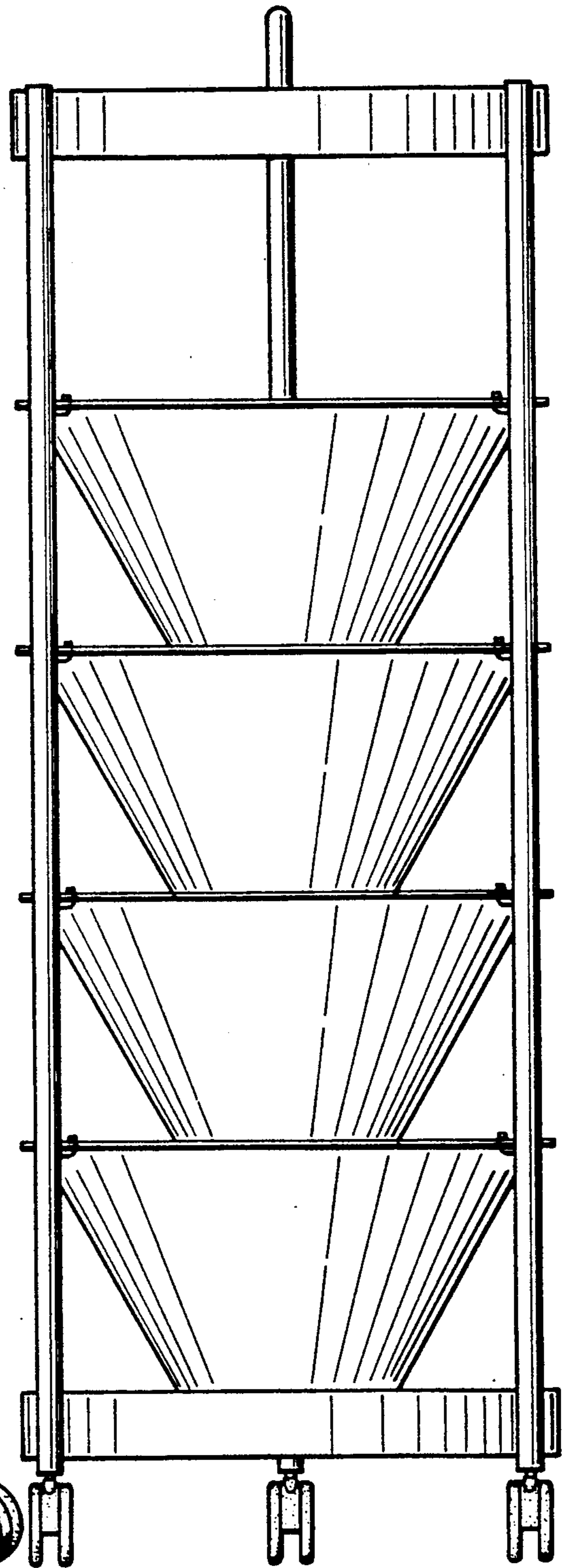

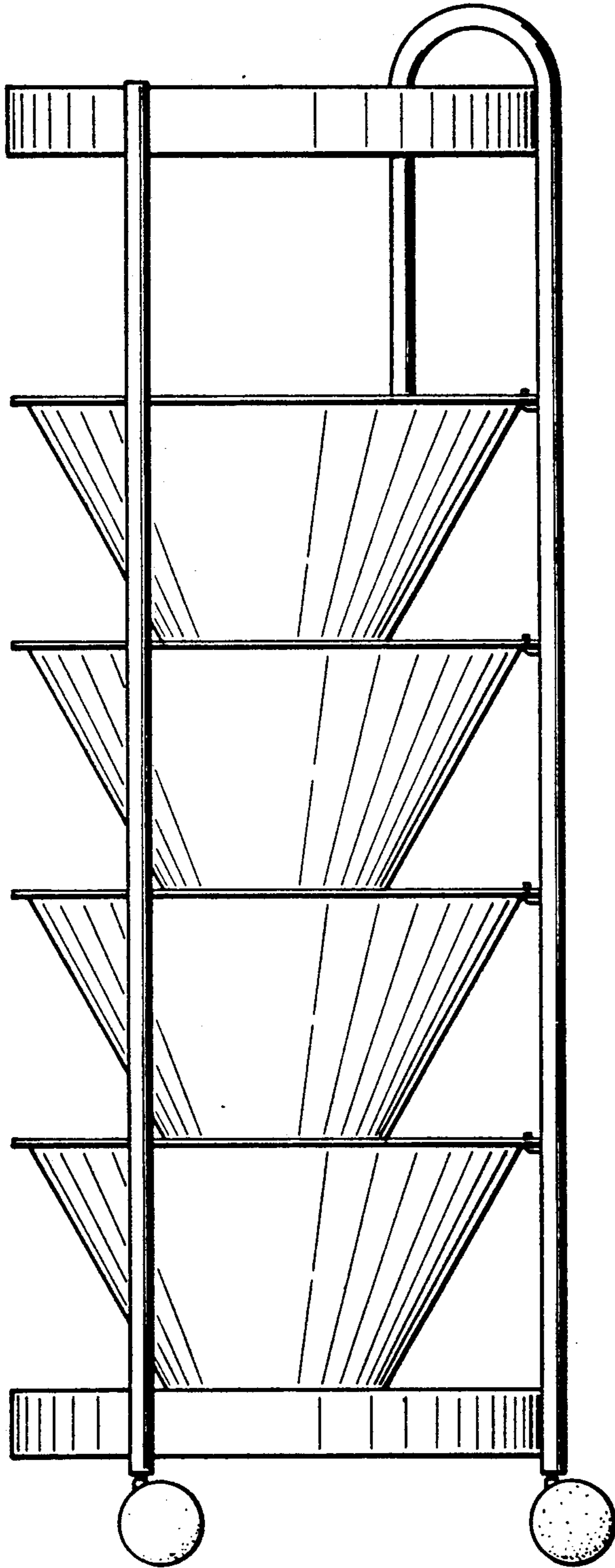

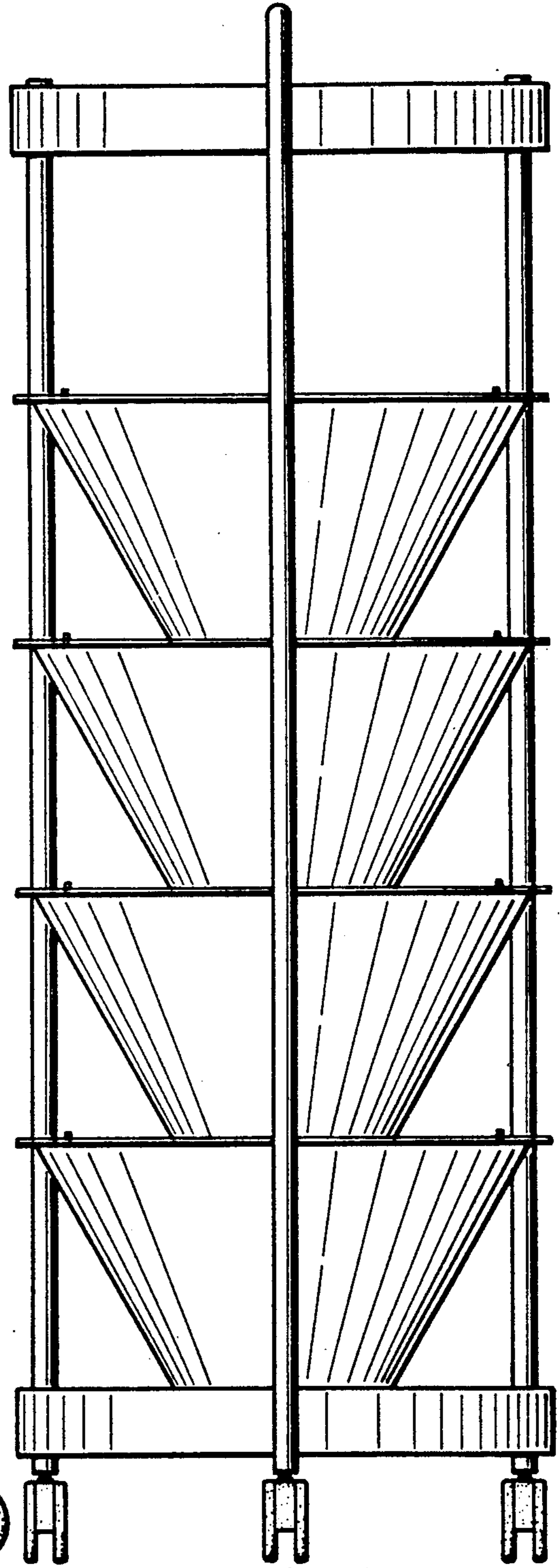

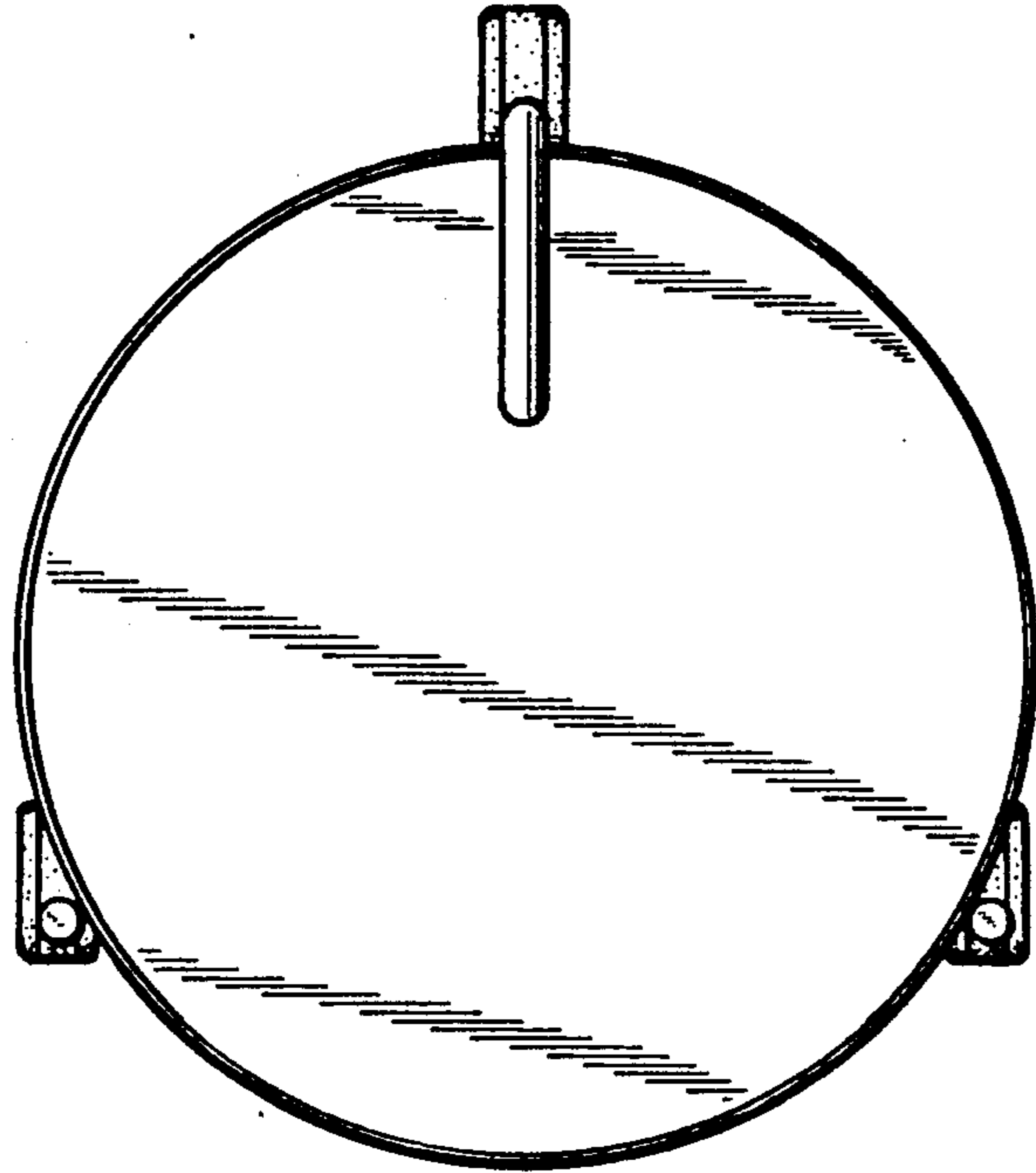

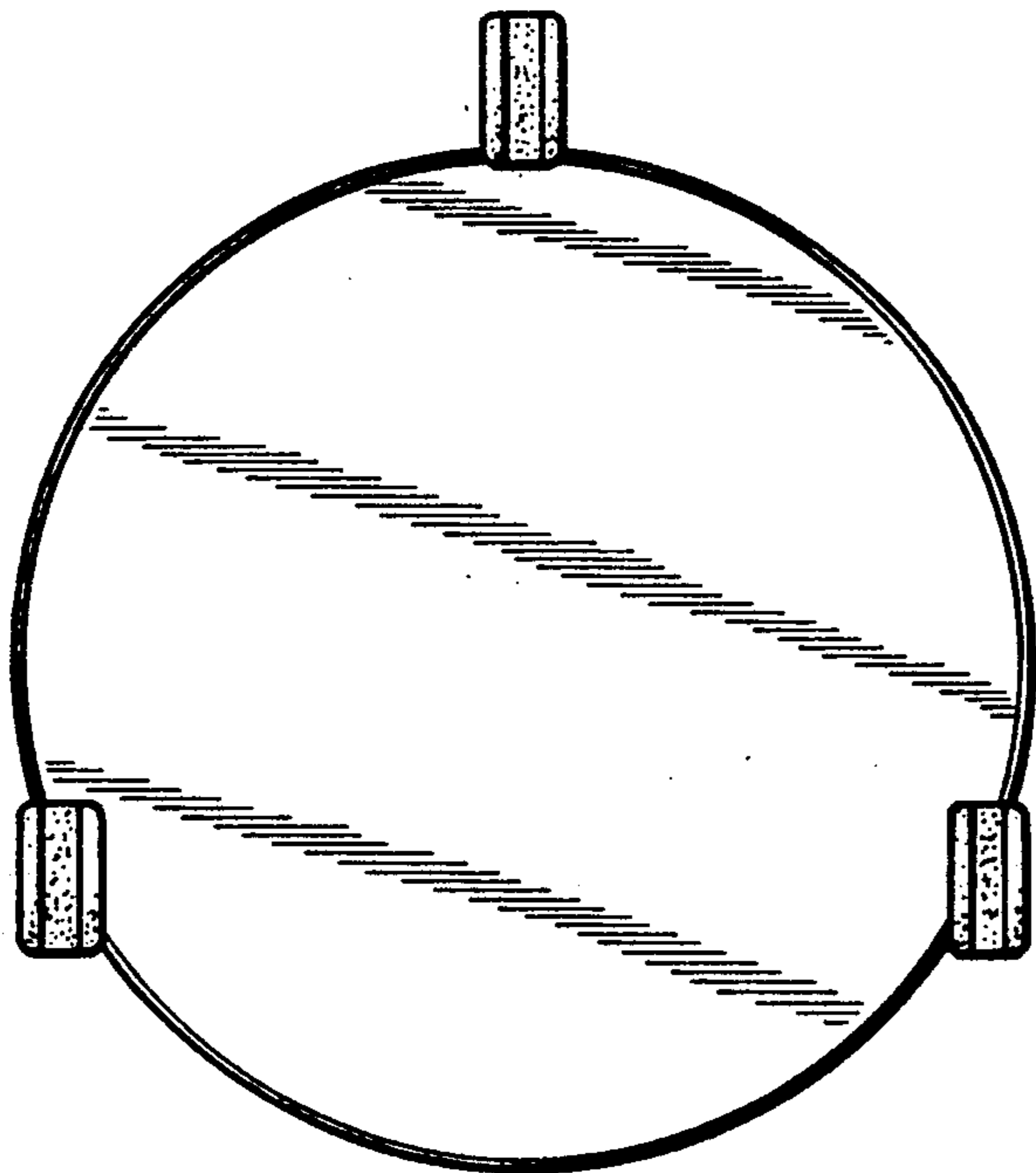
