DESCRIPTION

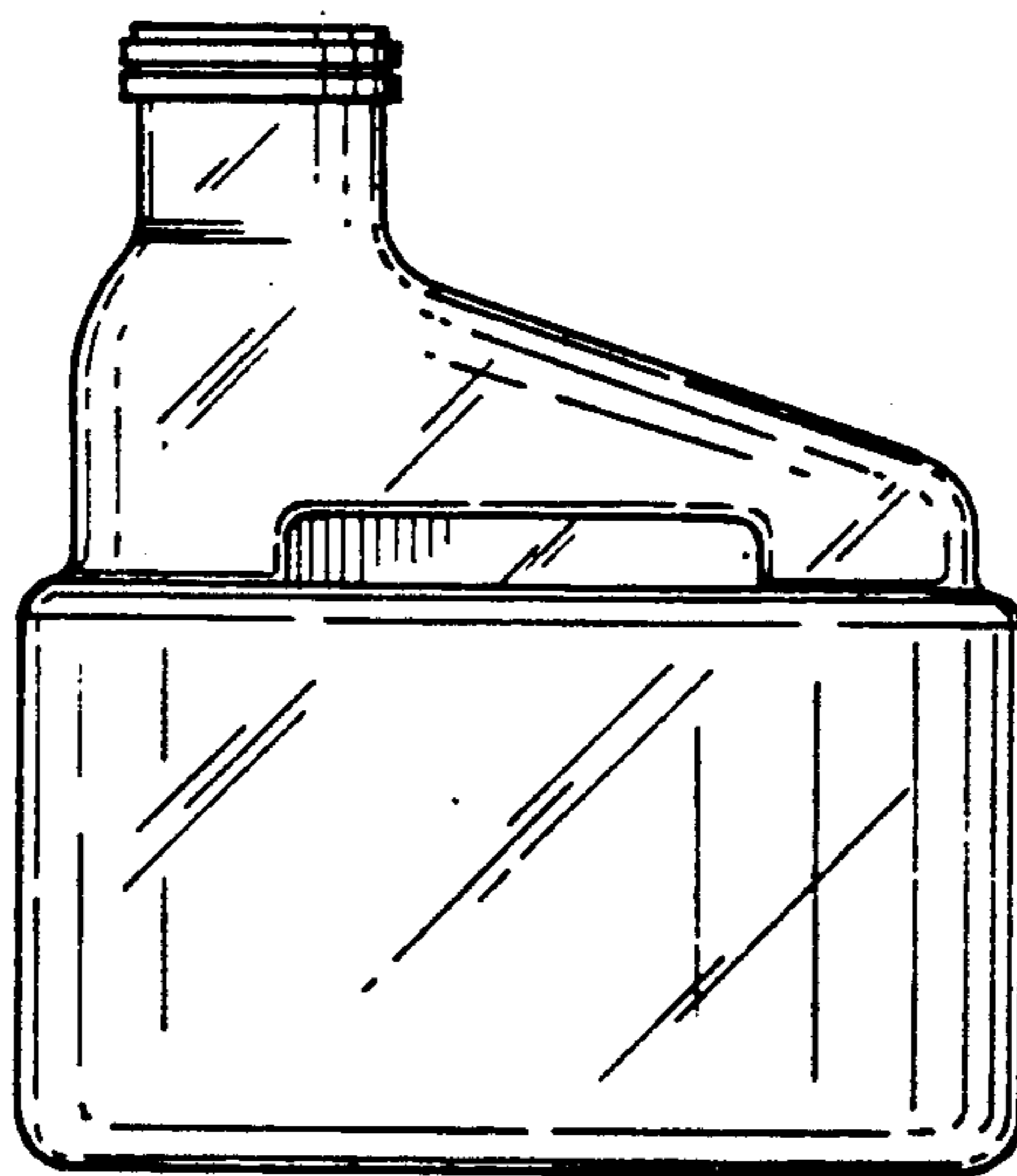
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle embodying my new design, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



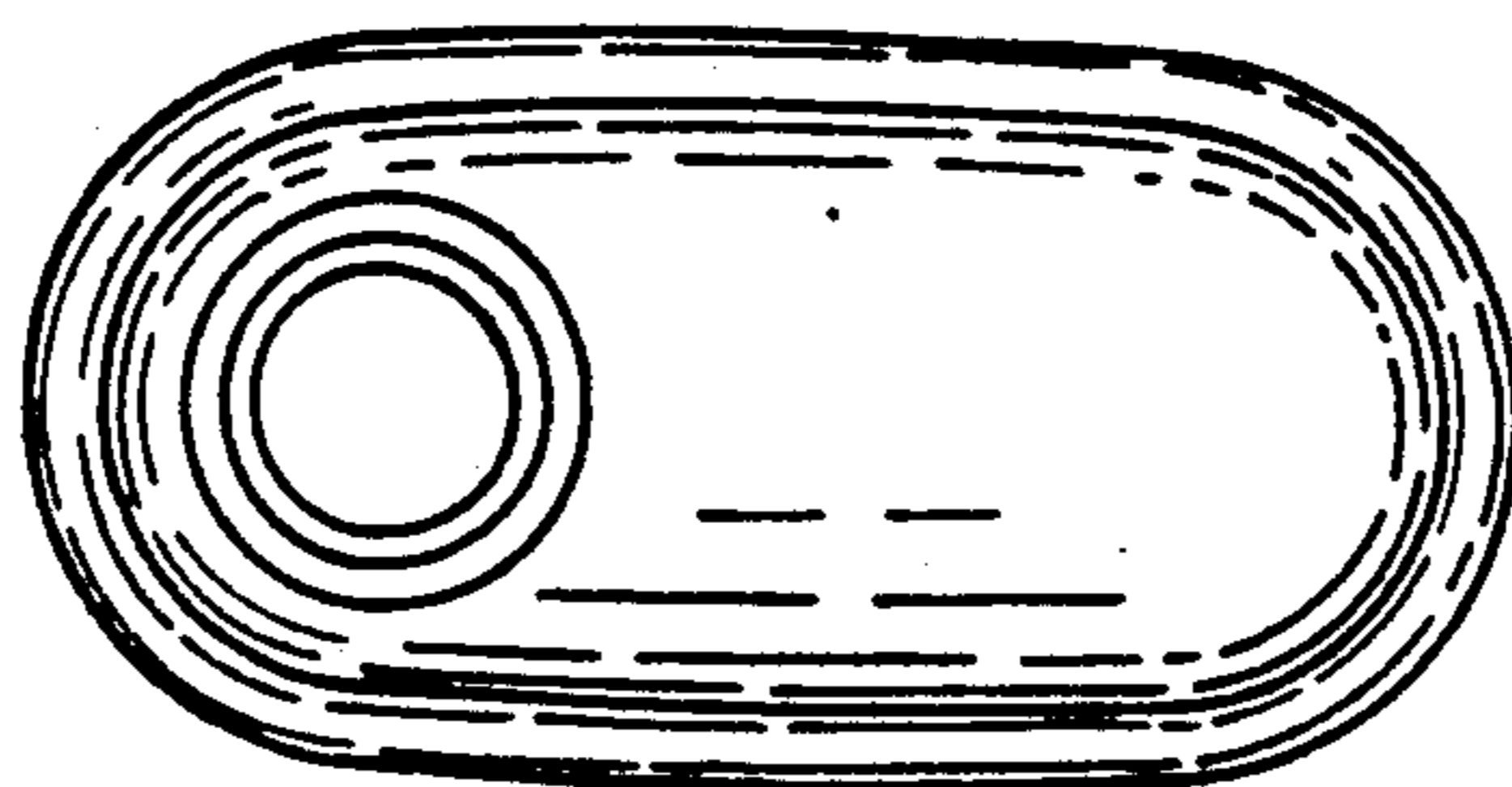

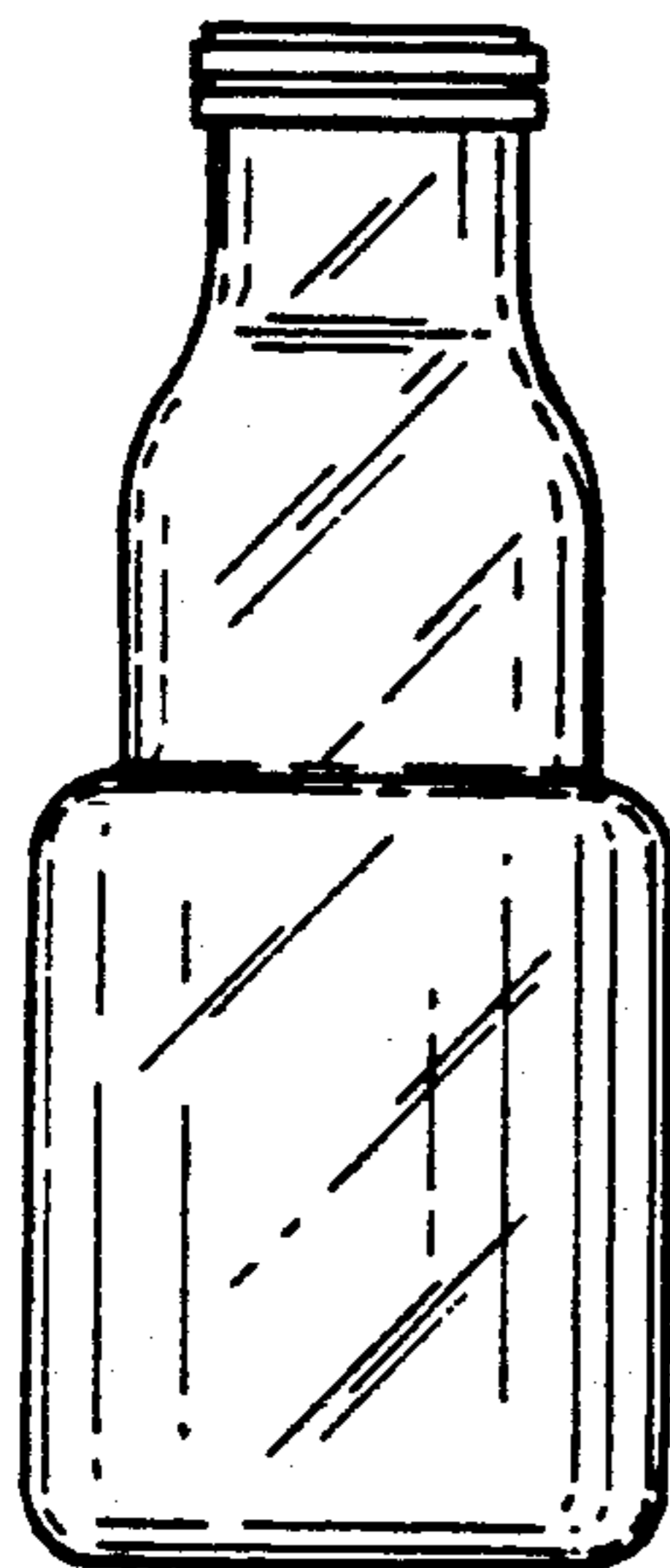

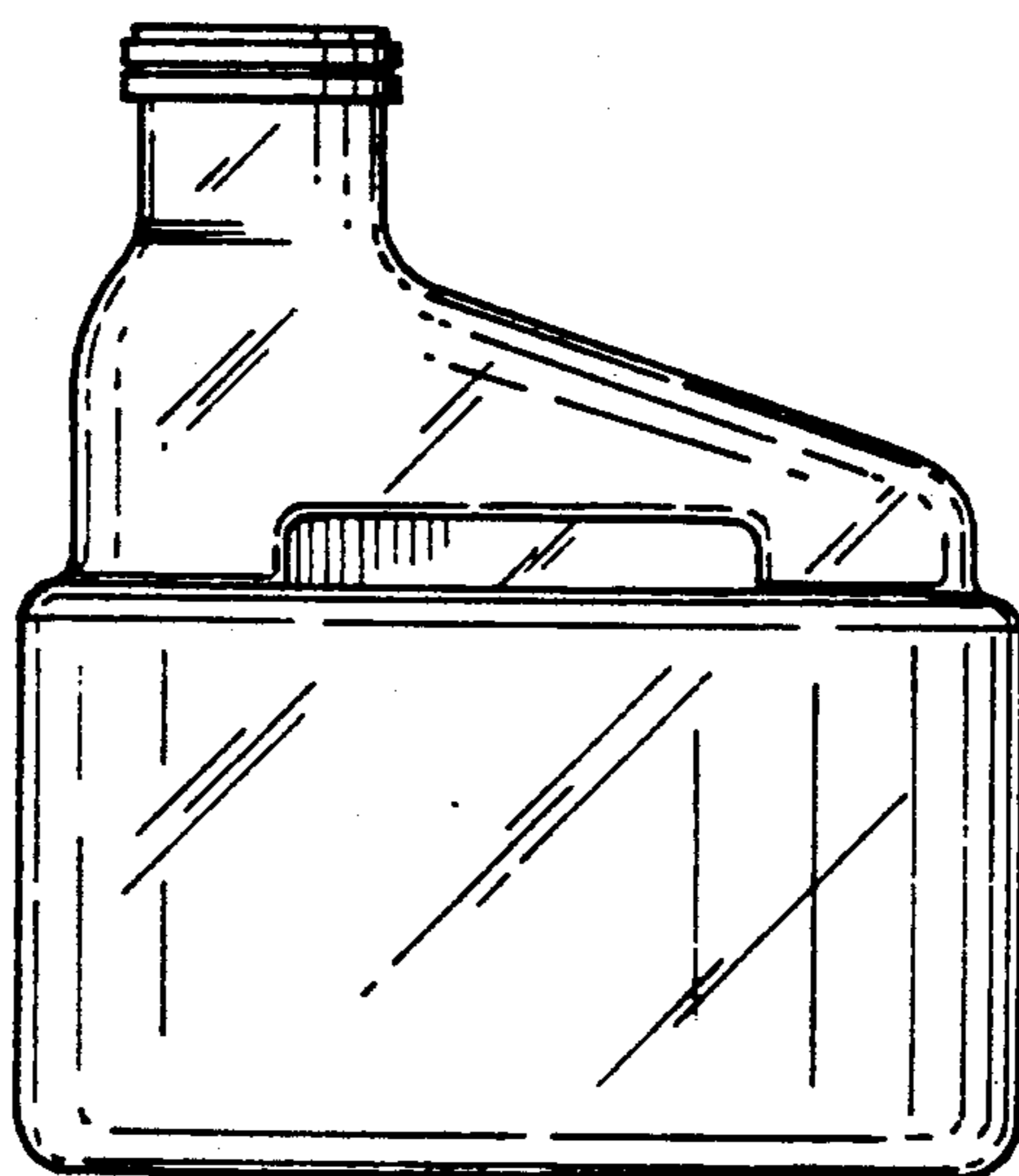

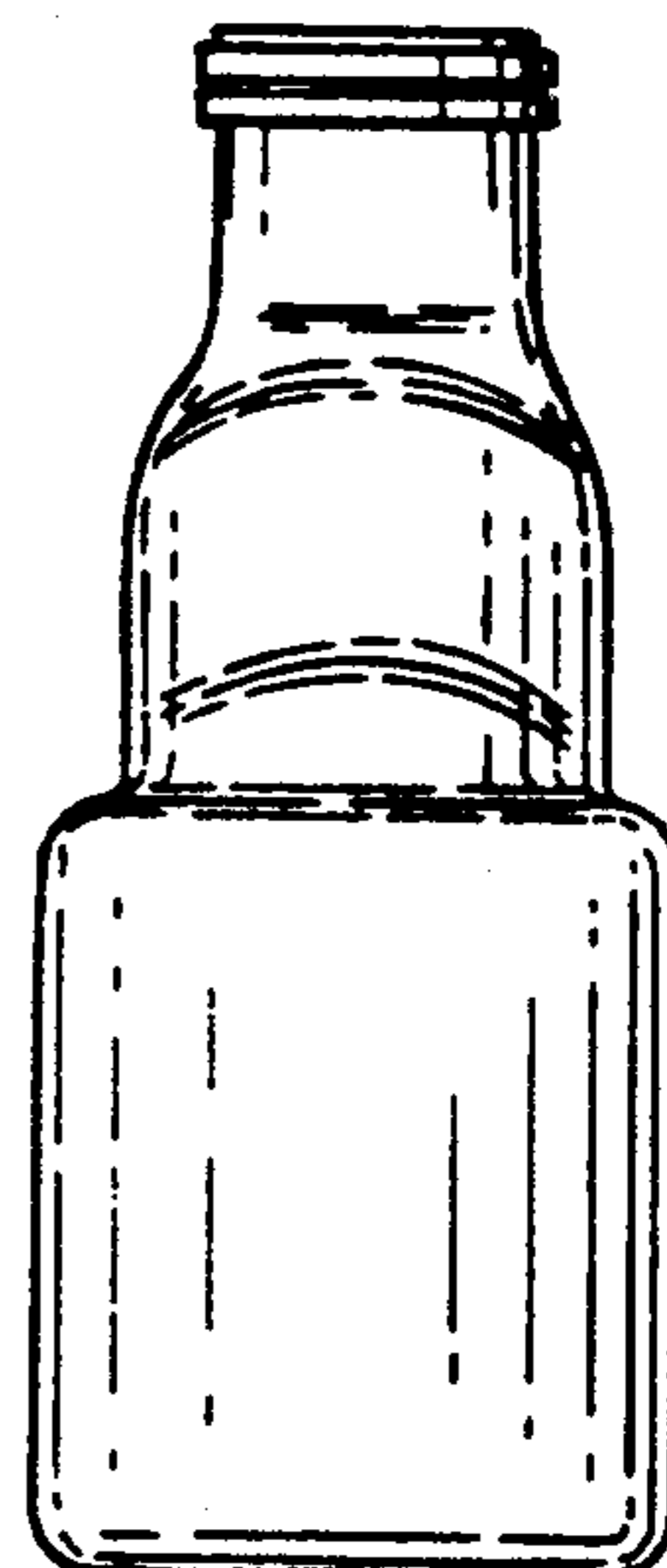

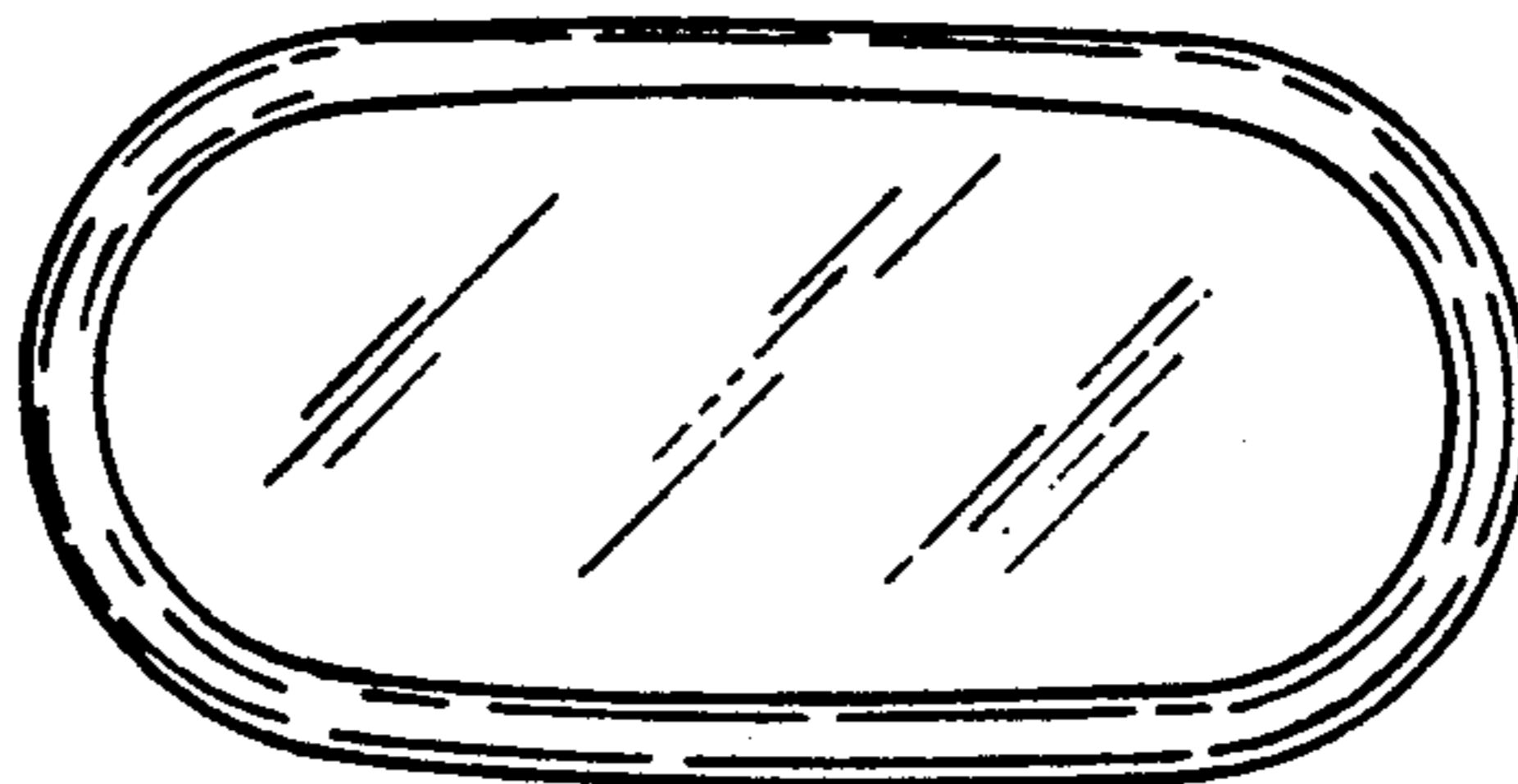
