FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

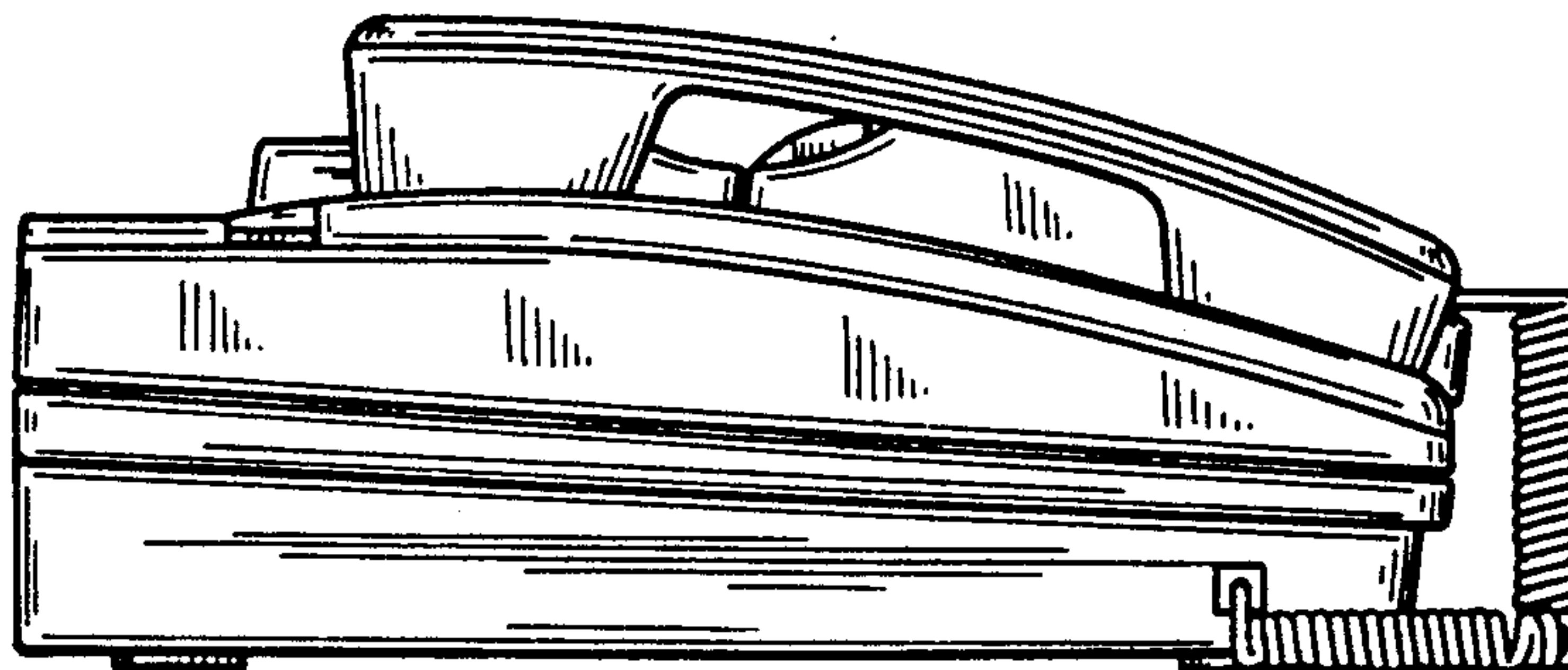
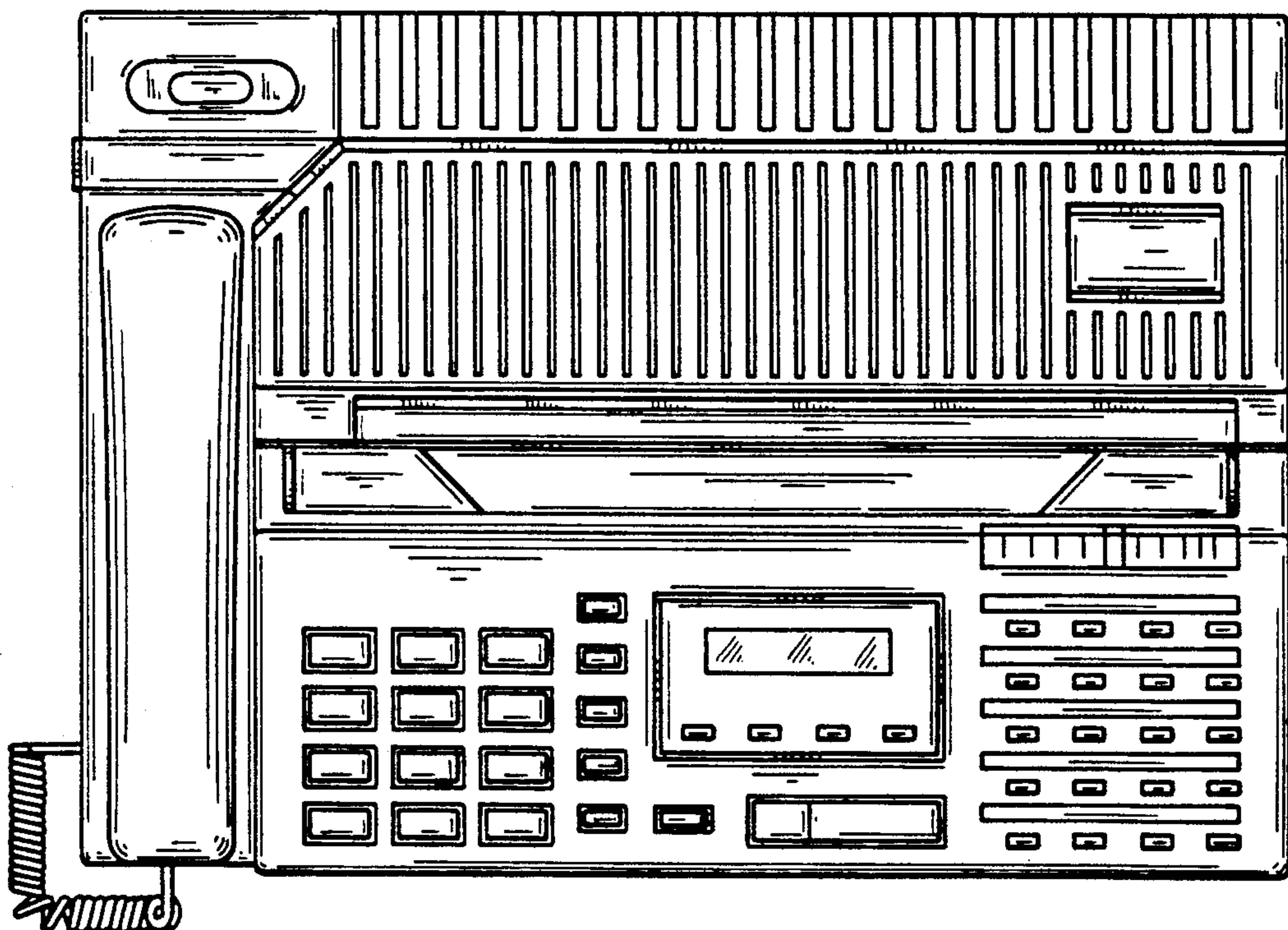
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

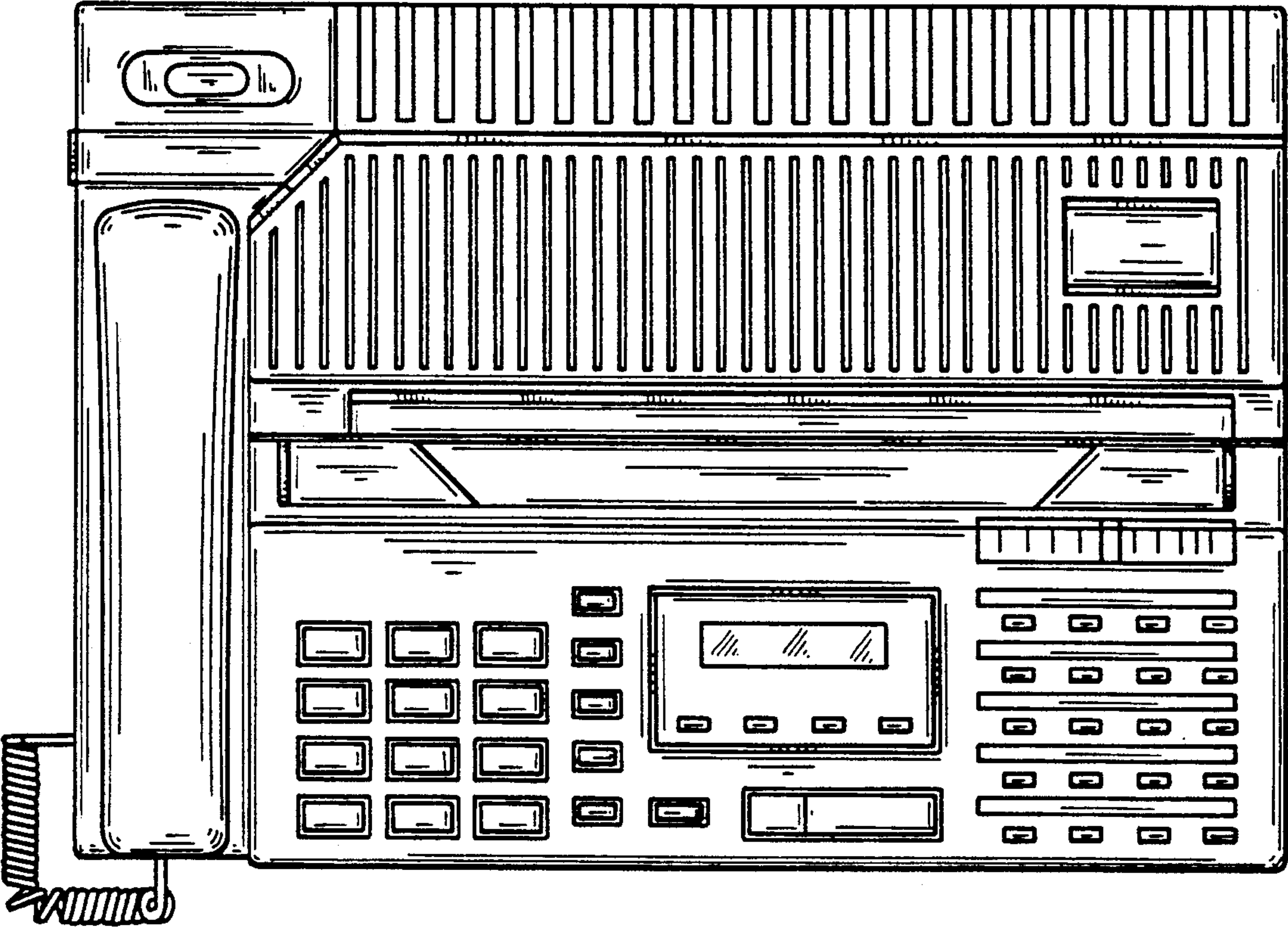

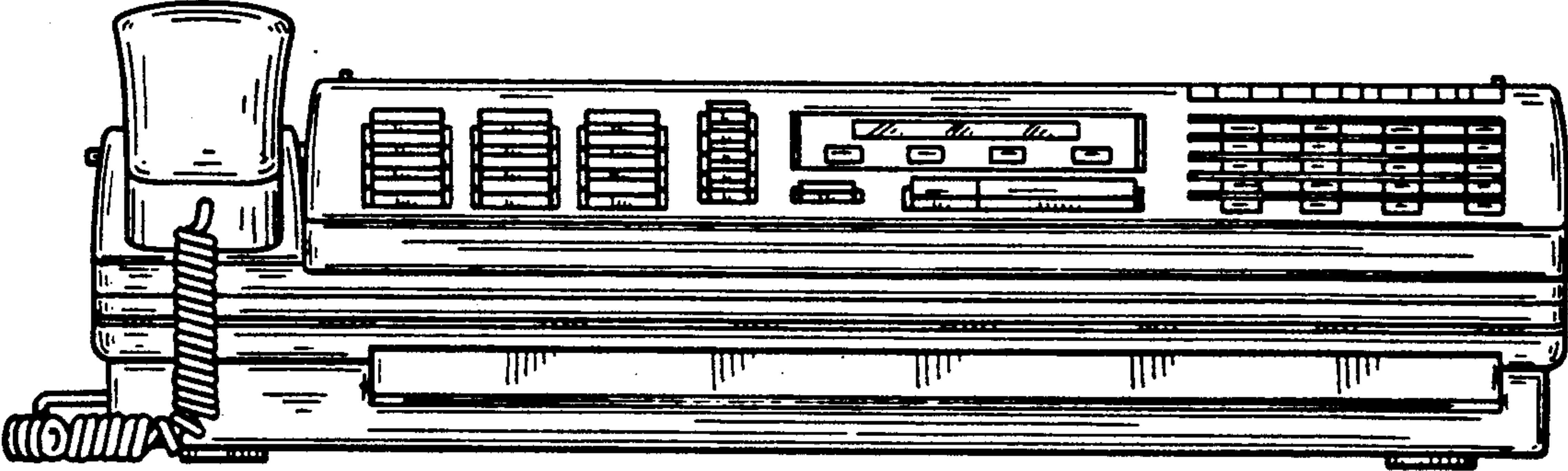

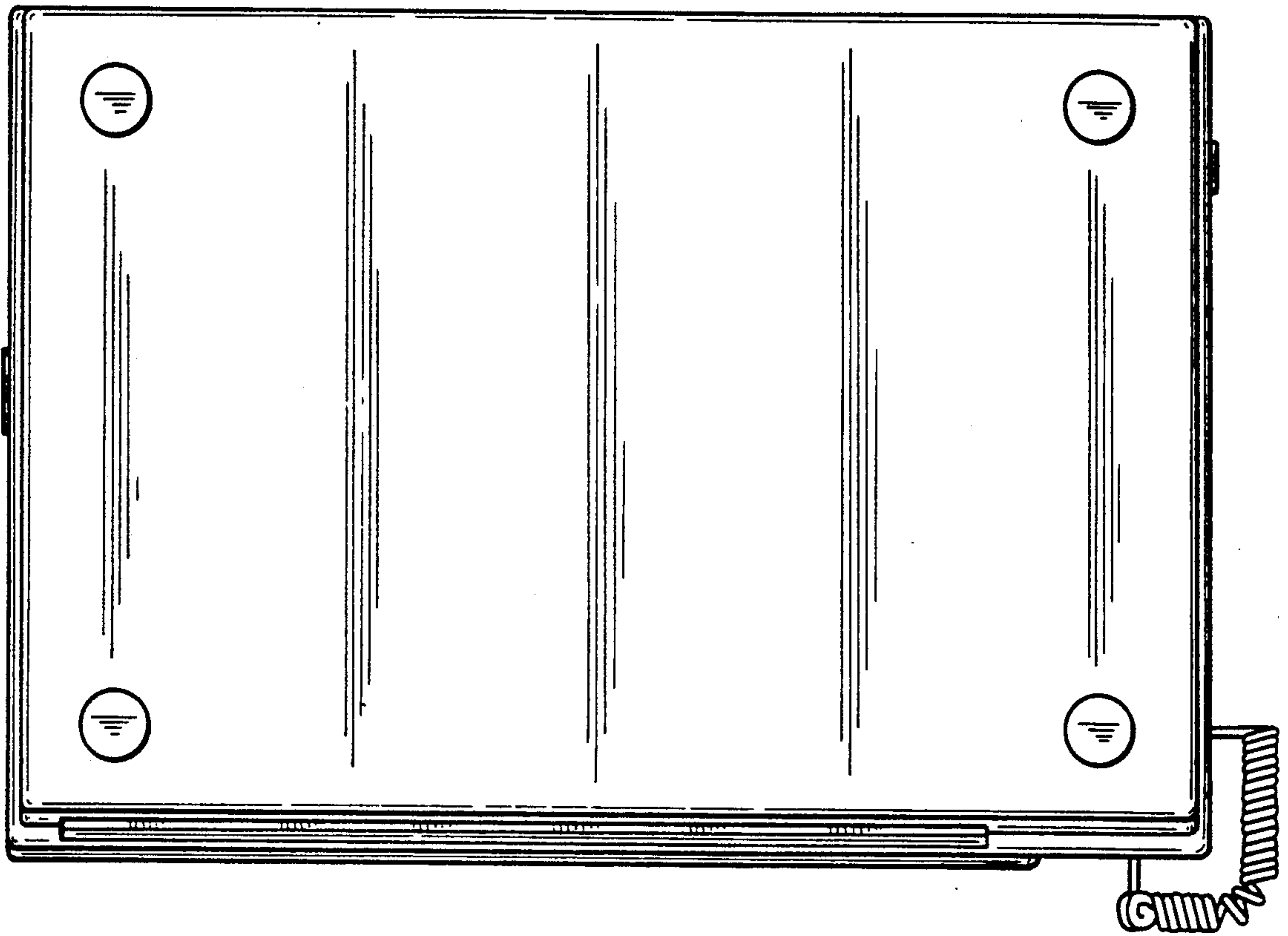




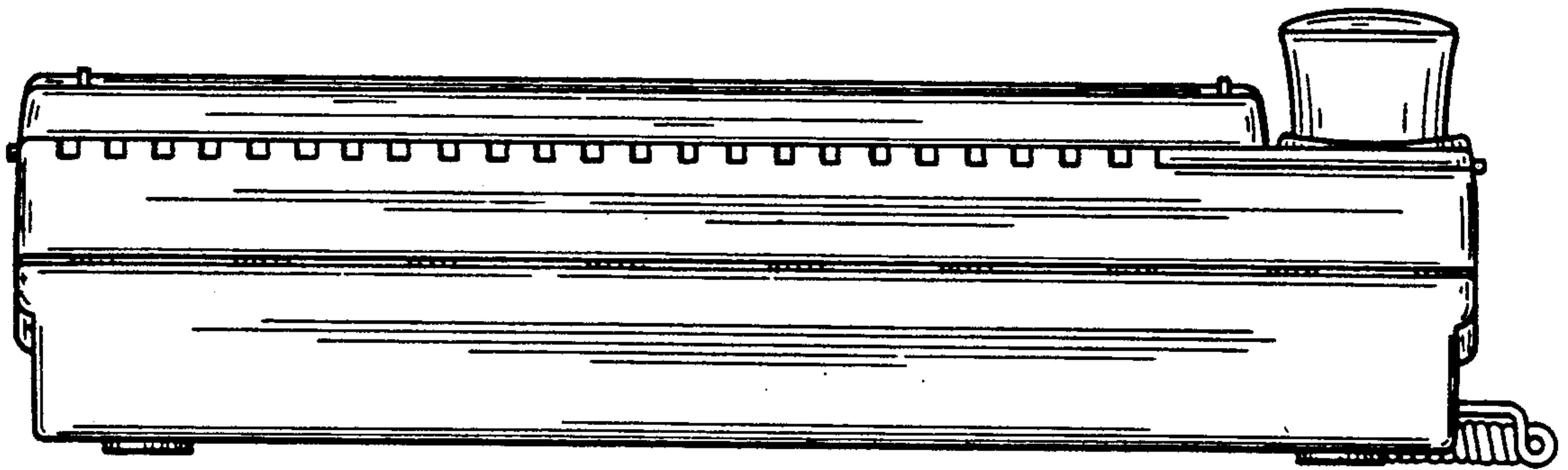

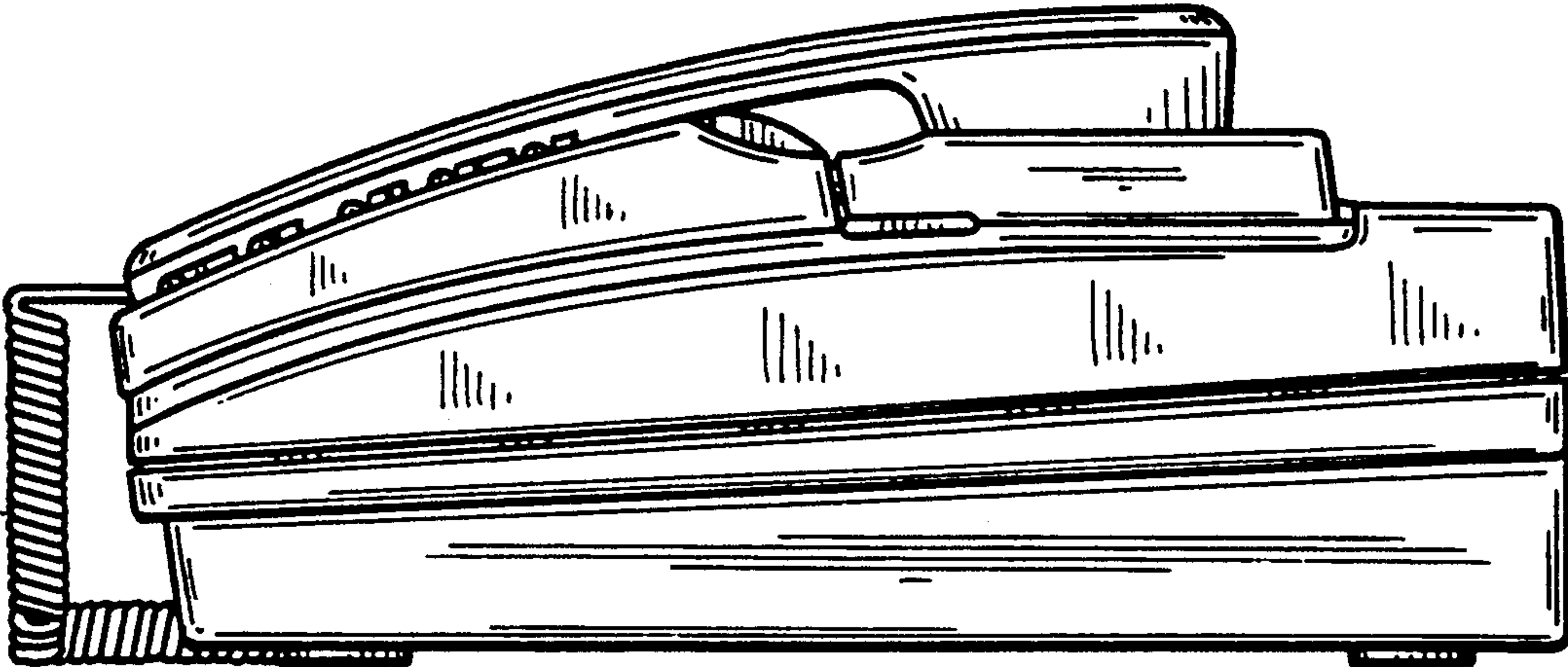

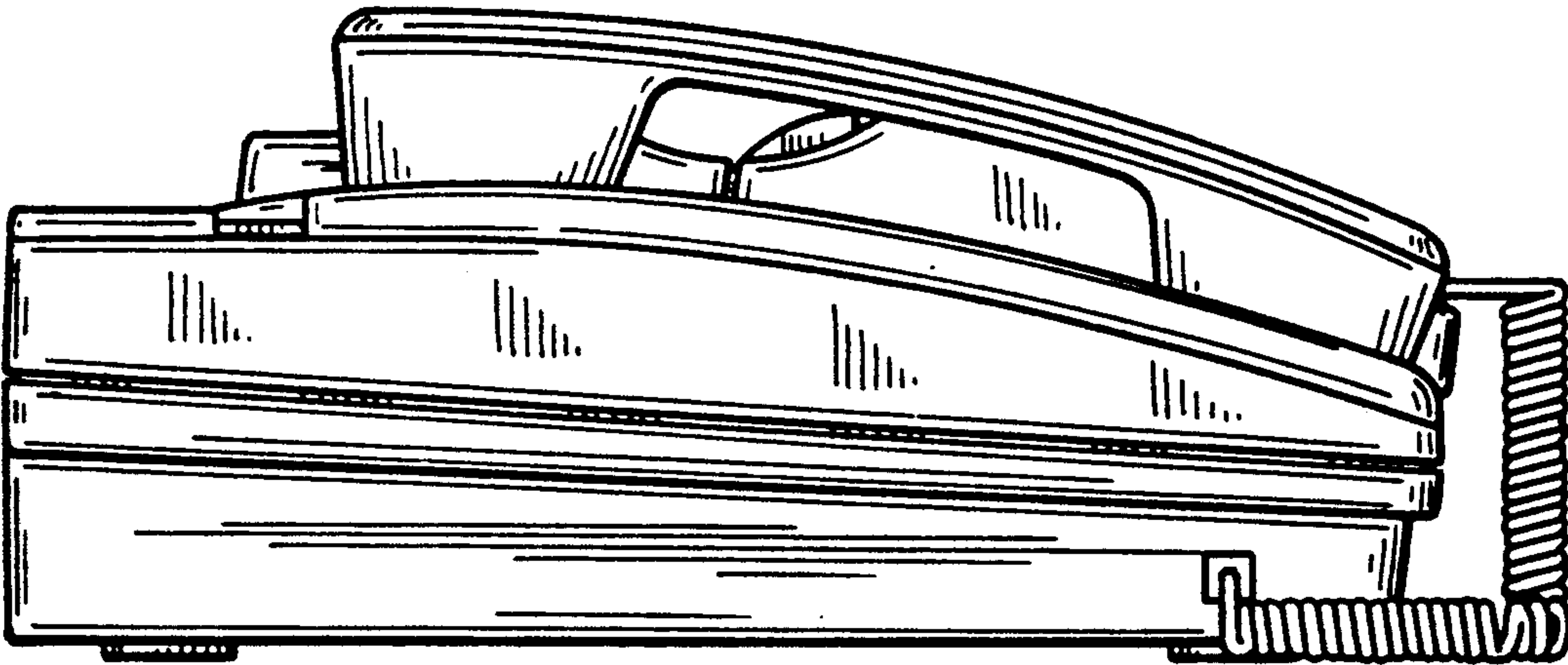
