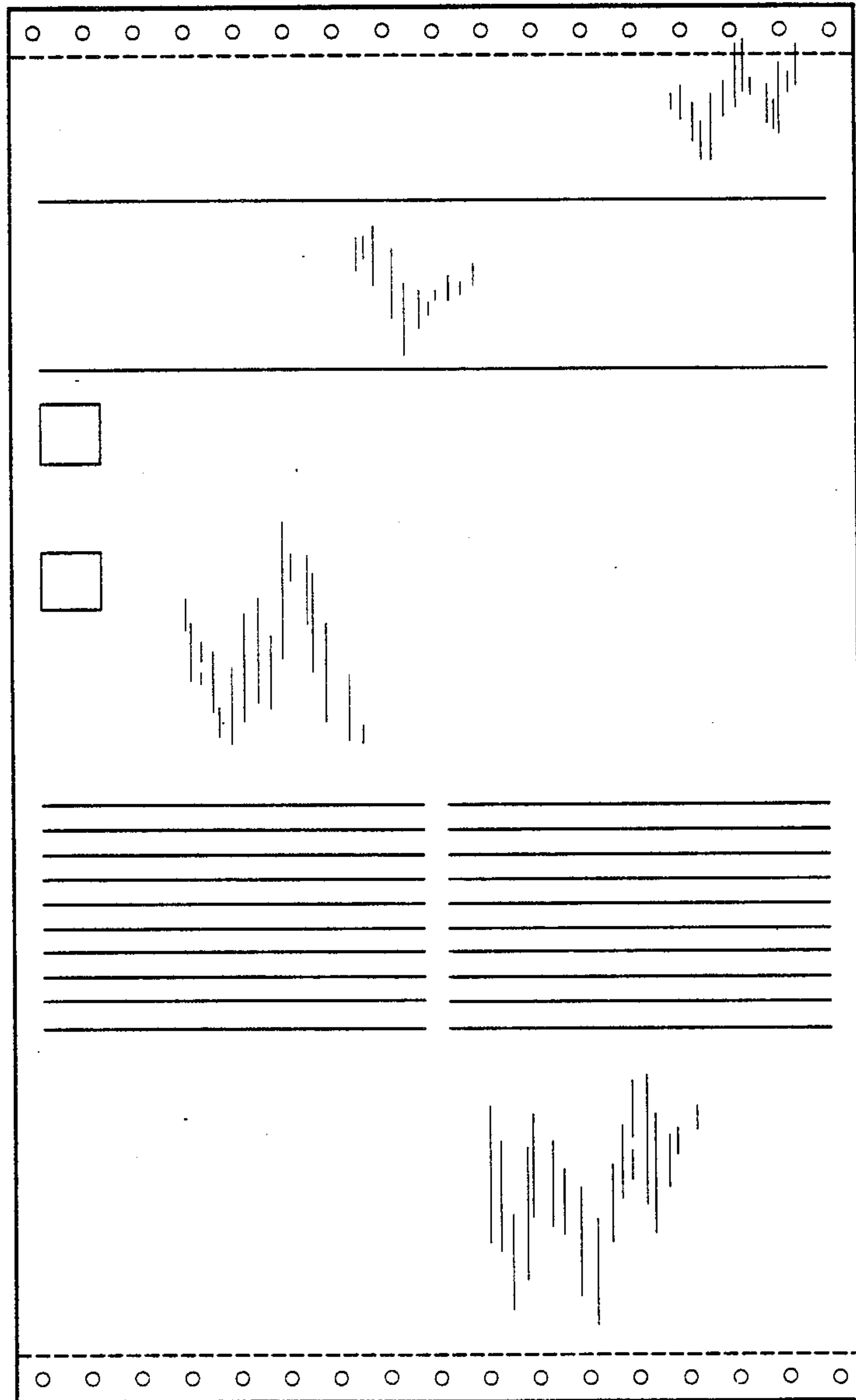
The figure is a top plan view of a business form showing

plain.






It is understood that the claimed article is of conven-
